What's going on in Vijayawada? The capital region of Andhra Pradesh is losing its image because of the negligence of a few Police officials and the lenience given by a few politicians. On human trafficking, Deputy CM Mr. Pawan Kalyan pointed out the issue before the elections, and Chief Minister Mr. N. Chandrababu Naidu has also spoken about this issue many times. But what about human trafficking from other states to Andhra Pradesh? The girls caught in the raid belong to Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, and Delhi. What signals are we giving to the country about our state?

The POINT had given a detailed story on Chalasani Bhargav earlier. We had mentioned all the allegations arising in Vijayawada. The Government did not react at all, but Mr. Bhargav's team threatened legal action against POINT. Now, the Police raid has proven that those allegations were true. ### **CM Naidu Holds Key Meeting** on Chilli Farmers' Issues



- CM Chandrababu discusses chilli farmers' concerns with traders
- Efforts to stabilize chilli prices amid ٠ export challenges

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu held a crucial meeting with chilli farmers and traders on Saturday to address ongoing concerns about chilli prices and market stability. Officials from the Agriculture, Marketing, and Animal Husbandry Departments, including Special Chief Secretary Guruthu Rajasekhar, Agriculture Director Delhi Rao, and Marketing Director Vijaya Sunitha, participated in the discussions.

The price of chilli has been declining due to increased cultivation in Sri Lanka, Malaysia, and China, key export destinations for Andhra Pradesh's produce. However, market experts anticipate a price hike as crop yields in these countries it through central agencies. He are not meeting expectations. CM also assured financial assistance Naidu assured traders and farm- for farmers storing chillies in cold ers that the government is actively working to prevent distress sales and stabilize prices. Amidst demands from YSRCP chief Jagan to fix chilli prices, CM Naidu recently met Union Agriculture Minister in Delhi, securing a commitment from the Central Government to support farmers. Following this, the CM's meeting with traders in Guntur aimed to ensure that farmers receive fair prices and are not affected by speculative pricing.

#### **CM Assures Support** to Chilli Farmers

Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has pledged support to chilli farmers struggling with price fluctuations. He urged traders and exporters to cooperate with the government in ensuring fair prices.

The CM announced that if the chilli price drops below ₹11,781 per quintal, the government will procure storages, facilitating bank loans to prevent distress sales. To boost exports, the government has approved chilli transportation via Krishnapatnam Port, improving market access. During his visit to the Guntur chilli market yard, Chandrababu expressed displeasure over lorry owners' actions, stressing the need for fair trade practices. He directed officials to resolve market issues and ensure transparent transactions. The government is committed to stabilizing chilli prices and safeguarding farmers from market uncertainties.

That is why they have registered many cases against us. Even now, people affiliated with them are targeting us. The Inspector who registered the case against me now had also faced allegations and was sent to VR. Now he has been posted in the same station—I don't know how."

Eight persons, including two engineers from Robbins Tunnel Boring Machines Manufacturing Company, are trapped inside the Srisailam Left Bank Canal (SLBC) tunnel after a collapse near Domalapenta in Amrabad Mandal, Nagarkurnool, early this morning.

#### CM Revanth Reddy Orders SLBC **Rescue Ops**

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has responded to the SLBC tunnel accident, expressing shock over the tunnel roof collapse. He directed the Nagarkurnool District Collector, SP, Fire Department, Hydra, and Irrigation Department officials to take immediate rescue measures. Telangana Irrigation Minister N. Uttam Kumar Reddy, accompanied by Minister Jupally Krishna Rao, visited the mishap site and assured that the government would make every effort to rescue those trapped. He confirmed that assistance from the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) is being sought to expedite the rescue operations.

Addressing a press conference, Uttam Kumar Reddy stated that the trapped individuals include two engineers, two machine operators, and four workers. Among them, six workers hail

from Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand, while the engineers are employed with Robbins.

Minister revealed that 42 workers had managed to escape. According to him, 50 workers had entered the tunnel at 8 am, and the boring machine was started at 8:30 am. One of the machine operators noticed water seeping into the tunnel and immediately raised an alarm, enabling 42 workers to move to safety. However, before others could escape, a significant portion of the earth collapsed, trapping the remaining eight on the other side.

Rescue operations are underway, with authorities working tirelessly to ensure the safe evacuation of those trapped.

#### PM Modi Calls CM Revanth Reddy

Prime Minister Narendra Modi called Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy to inquire about the SLBC tunnel accident near Domalapenta in Nagarkurnool district. Several workers were injured, while eight remain trapped inside the collapsed tunnel.

During the call, Revanth Reddy briefed the Prime Minister on the ongoing rescue efforts. He informed Modi that Ministers Uttam Kumar Reddy and Jupally Krishna Rao were at the site, overseeing operations. Modi assured full cooperation from the Centre in the rescue efforts.





# **AP Assembly Budget Sessions Begin Feb 24th**

Governor to address both Houses on the first day

The Andhra Pradesh Assembly Budget Sessions are set to begin on February 24, with the state budget scheduled for presentation during these sessions. On the first day, the Governor will address both Houses, followed by a Business Advisory Committee (BAC) meeting, which will determine the duration of the session.

#### Jagan and YSRCP MLAs **Expected to Attend Assembly**

Amid these sessions, YSRCP chief Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy and several party MLAs are expected to attend the Assembly. This development follows recent remarks by AP Assembly

Speaker Chintakayala Ayyannapatrudu and Deputy Speaker Raghurama Krishnam Raju, who stated that MLAs absent for 60 consecutive working days face disqualification. With Jagan's prolonged absence, his legislative membership is reportedly at risk.

# **Amaravati Capital Works to Commence From March 15th**

Govt plans to complete capital works in 2.5 years

#### **TPN Correspondent** Amaravati, Feb 23

The construction of Amaravati, Andhra Pradesh's capital, is set to begin on March 15, marking a significant milestone in the state's development. Officials have confirmed that 30,000 workers will be deployed for the project by the first week of April.

The finalization of tenders was delayed due to orders from the Election Commission (EC), which had issued instructions to halt the process. Despite this, the CRDA and ADC have called tenders for 62 works, with projects worth ₹40,000 crores currently under process. Additionally, tenders for 11 more works will be called soon.

Since coming to power, the coalition government has prioritized Amaravati's development. CM Chandrababu Naidu and Minister Narayana have personally toured the region, inspecting stalled projects. A team of experts



from IIT Chennai and IIT Hyderabad conducted a structural study of key buildings like the Secretariat and Assembly, confirming their stability. Their report also affirmed the strength of MLA and MLC quarters, IAS and IPS buildings.

The government has cleared encroachments and jungle overgrowth in the region, ensuring smooth progress. With work set to begin in March, officials are optimistic that the entire Amaravati project will be completed within 2.5 years.

# **Three Senior IPS Officers from Telangana Directed to Report at AP**

The Union Home Ministry has issued orders directing three senior IPS officers currently serving in Telangana to report to Andhra Pradesh. This decision follows the recommendations of the Khandekar Committee, which was consti-

tuted in 2024 to oversee the redistribution of officers between the two states. The officers who have been instructed to move to Andhra Pradesh are:

- Anjani Kumar (1990 batch) Chairman of the Road Safety Authority
- Abhilasha Bist (1994 batch) Director of the Telangana Police Academy

Abhishek Mohanty (2011 batch) - Commissioner of Police, Karimnagar

The transfer of these officials is seen as a crucial administrative step in balancing the police cadre between Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, following the bifurcation of the united state in 2014. The Khandekar Committee, after reviewing the staffing patterns and vacancies in both states, had recommended the reallocation of certain officers to ensure a more equitable distribution of senior police personnel.

This latest directive from the Union Home Ministry is expected to strengthen Andhra Pradesh's police administration by adding experienced officers to key positions. The officers are likely to take charge of their new assignments soon, aligning with the state's ongoing efforts to enhance law and order.

With these transfers, the Andhra Pradesh government is expected to reinforce its police force, ensuring that critical departments receive the necessary leadership and expertise.



New Ration Cards to Be **Issued from Next Month:** Minister Nadendla Manohar

State Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar announced that new ration cards will be issued across Andhra Pradesh from next month, featuring QR codes with modern technology.

The minister, accompanied by Minister Anam Ramanarayana Reddy and MP Vemireddy Prabhakar Reddy, participated in various development programs in Nellore district. As part of his visit, he inspected a rice mill in Sangam and reviewed stock supplies at Jenda Dibba stock point, inquiring about grain procurement, stock details, and supply chain management. Speaking with local women, Minister Manohar emphasized the government's commitment to women's welfare and encouraged their active participation in development programs. He reiterated that the government, under CM Chandrababu Naidu, has fulfilled the Deepam-2 scheme promise from the election manifesto, providing free gas cylinders to 4 lakh beneficiaries in Nellore district alone. Statewide, 93.42 lakh gas connections have been issued, with a target of 1.50 crore connections this year. The minister also assured that good quality rice will be distributed for midday meal schemes in welfare hostels and schools starting in May. The ration card issuance process will be facilitated through village and ward secretariats, ensuring a transparent and efficient system for beneficiaries.

Union Minister of State for Steel and Heavy Industries Bhupathi Raju Srinivasa Varma emphasized that workers are key to achieving the vision of Developed India-2047 under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership. He highlighted the government's efforts toward the welfare of unorganized sector workers and their role in building a self-reliant India (Atmanirbhar Bharat).

Speaking as the chief guest at the

15th Triennial Inaugural Meeting of the Public Sector Employees National Confederation (affiliated with Bharatiya Mazdoor Sangh - BMS) in Bhubaneswar, he acknowledged that 30 crore workers have registered on the e-Shram portal launched by the Central Government to promote their economic self-reliance.

The minister praised BMS founder Datto Pant, recognizing the organization's 70-year legacy of standing by workers. He reiterated that the NDA government has taken significant steps, such as amending the Maternity Act to increase leave from 12 to 20 weeks, raising the minimum wage from ₹10,000 to ₹21,000, and enhancing contract workers' wages in public sector enterprises from ₹12,000 to ₹18,000.

Further reforms include revising the Employees' Pension Scheme, increasing the minimum pension to ₹1,000 per month, and raising the gratuity limit from ₹10 lakh to ₹20 lakh since 2018. Additionally, the death insurance coverage for ESI subscribers has been raised from ₹3.6 lakh to ₹6 lakh, benefiting many workers, including those in the unorganized sector. Srinivasa Varma noted that the pre-

vious budget extended e-Shram portal benefits to gig workers, including those from Swiggy and Zomato, impacting over one crore workers. He assured that the government will continue introducing new reforms for workers' welfare.

### **Gudivada Municipality Mutation Scam No Action Despite Multiple Investigations**

Revenue officials siphon off Rs. 2 crore through mutation fraud Two investigations completed, but no action taken yet Allegations of cover-up and involvement of political leaders

A massive mutation scam has come to light in Gudivada Municipality, where revenue officers and staff allegedly misappropriated Rs. 2 crore through fraudulent property mutations during the financial year 2023-24.

Acting on orders from the Municipal Administration Department, Tadigadapa Municipal Commissioner Bhavani Prasad conducted two separate inquiries on January 24 and February 12. However, despite the completion of investigations, no action has been taken against those responsible, raising suspicions about whether the real culprits will face consequences or if junior staff will be scapegoated.

The mutation process involves changing the name of the property owner in municipal records, requiring payment of 1% of the market value as tax. Under the previous YSRCP government, certain permanent municipal employees, allegedly with political

When questioned, Municipal Commissioner B. Srinivasa Rao stated that a report would be submitted to the Municipal Regional Director (RD) and further action would be taken based on orders from higher authorities.

### Police Seize Gold Worth ₹5 Crore in Mangalagiri

In a major breakthrough, Guntur district police cracked a 5 kg gold theft case within six days, recovering 4 kg and 8 grams of gold ornaments, ₹2 lakh in cash, and two two-wheelers. A total of eight accused have been arrested for their involvement in the meticulously planned theft. The police formed six special teams to investigate the case and successfully recovered gold ornaments worth ₹5 crore.

The theft took place when Ramu, the owner of DVR Jewelers in Vijayawada, entrusted his employee Nagaraju with a bag containing gold ornaments meant for delivery to various jewelry shops in Nalgonda, Suryapet, and Naker-

ekallu. However, Nagaraju later claimed the bag was stolen and informed his employer over the phone.

Following the investigation, the police identified Nagaraju as the main culprit. His accomplices, Bharat, Naveen, Irfan, Mohan, Lokesh, Chandu, and Arun, assisted in executing the crime. Some of the stolen gold was melted into lumps to avoid detection, but the police successfully recovered a major portion of it.

One of the accused, Irfan, is still absconding, and efforts are underway to recover the remaining gold from him. Guntur District SP Satish Kumar congratulated the police teams for their swift action and successful resolution of the case.

Strict Action Against Illegal Soil and Gravel Excavation: District Collector Warns TPN Correspondent Rajamahendravaram, Feb 23

District Collector P. Prashanthi has issued a stern warning against illegal soil and gravel excavation, stating that violators will face strict legal action under the Andhra Pradesh Small Scale Minerals Rules, 1966. In a statement on Saturday, she emphasized that quarrying and mineral transportation without proper authorization from the Mines and Geology Department is punishable by law.

The official procedure for securing a quarry lease or temporary permit includes:

Online application at www.mines. ap.gov.in with required documents (Aadhaar, PAN, land details, etc.). Advance payment of cess, DMF & MER-

IT fees, and applicable taxes. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the local Tahsildar and a field inspection to verify mineral availability.

Approval of Mining Plan, Environmental Clearance (EC), and Consent to Operate (CTE & CTO).

Under MOEF guidelines (S.O. 1224(E), dated 28.03.2020), the following activities do not require environmental clearance:

Excavation for village roads, ponds, and MGNREGA projects.

Digging wells for irrigation or drinking water.

Foundation digging for buildings. NHAI roadwork approved before March 21, 2024.

Farmers can level cropland for agriculture without permission. However, selling or transporting excavated soil requires approval from the Mines Department. The Collector cautioned that any unauthorized mineral excavation or transportation within the district limits will result in legal consequences, including action against landowners and lessees violating the Small Scale Minerals Rules, 1966.

### Kapu Movement Leader Tsavatapalli Nagabhushanam Arrested in Mummidivaram

Kapu movement leader and Aqua Rythu State Association advisor Tsavatapalli Nagabhushanam, who is also a Janasena Party supporter, was arrested by Katrenikona police on Saturday. The arrest follows a case registered against him on January 16. According to Katrenikona police, a dance program was organized by some youths in Cheyeru village, Katrenikona mandal, on Kanuma night as part of the Sankranti festival celebrations. Upon learning about the event, SI Avinash intervened and stopped the program. During this time, Nagabhushanam arrived at the scene and engaged in a heated argument with the SI. Based on a complaint filed by Head Constable Chinna Rao, a case was registered against Nagabhushanam, leading to his arrest on Saturday. He was produced in the Mummidivaram court later that day.

However, Nagabhushanam's arrest has sparked political speculation, with some Janasena activists alleging that it is linked to the upcoming MLC elections. They claim that the arrest was orchestrated to create dissatisfaction among the Kapu community and affect the chances of alliance MLC candidate Perabathula Rajasekhar, who is from the Kapu

community. Some activists believe that Mummidivaram MLA Datla Subbaraju is behind this move to weaken the support for Rajasekhar. There are also social media posts in Janasena circles urging voters not to support the alliance candidate as a response to Nagabhushanam's arrest.

With tensions rising, it remains to be seen how the alliance leaders will address the situation and counter the political fallout.

#### Eluru Municipal Corporation Commissioner Bhanu Pratap Measures to Ensure Water Supply

Eluru Municipal Corporation Commissioner A. Bhanu Pratap has assured that proactive measures are being taken to prevent water shortages in Eluru during the upcoming summer season. On Saturday, the Commissioner, along with Electrical AE Sambasiva Rao and Co-option Member SMR Pedababu, inspected the water works tanks at Denduluru, which play a crucial role in supplying water to Eluru city. He noted that water reserves have decreased due to insufficient inflow from the Godavari through the Eluru canal. To address the situation, a review meeting was held last month with MLA Badeti Chanti, City Mayor Noorjahan Pedababu, and engineering officials. As part of the monitoring process, officials are regularly tracking water levels in the storage tanks. Commissioner Bhanu Pratap emphasized that pumping motors are being utilized to transfer water from the Godavari canal to the Denduluru tanks, ensuring that Eluru residents do not face drinking water shortages in the summer months.

He urged officers to identify and dismantle cannabis transportation networks, ensure error-free case registration, and follow legal procedures rigorously to increase conviction rates.

Joint Collector S. Sethu Madhavan has directed officials to conduct the re-survey process in the presence of farmers to ensure transparency and accuracy.



Behind the scenes, the RSS played a pivotal role in strengthening the BJP's ground game, providing real-time feedback and strategizing minute-to-minute adjustments. The RSS's intense outreach, particularly through data-driven campaigns and local gatherings, ensured that every voter received key messages directly related to their concerns.

# A Window of Opportunity: President's **Rule and the Future of Manipur**

The imposition of President's Rule in Manipur marks a critical juncture in the state's turbulent political and ethnic landscape. With Chief Minister Biren Singh's resignation on February 9, 2025, amid political instability and escalating ethnic violence, the state has entered a period of governance under direct control of the Union Government. This presents a crucial opportunity for the BJP and the Centre to address the underlying causes of the ongoing conflict and lay the foundation for lasting peace between the Meitei and Kuki-Zo communities.

The violence in Manipur has claimed over 200 lives and displaced more than 50,000 people. The need for constructive intervention has never been more urgent. The BJP, having failed to form a consensus on a successor to Biren Singh, opted for President's Rule to stabilize the situation and avoid a constitutional crisis. The central leadership now has a window to take the necessary steps to address ethnic tensions and create a sustainable political environment for the state.

One of the first priorities for the Centre is the role of Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla. With his neutral stance-neither aligned with the Meitei nor the Kuki-Zo community—Bhalla's leadership can facilitate dialogue and reconciliation between these divided groups. His efforts thus far, including visiting relief camps and engaging with displaced people, set the tone for a more inclusive approach to restoring peace. However, while President's Rule has garnered support from Kuki-Zo groups, it has been met with opposition from



the Congress and Meitei organizations. The Centre must, therefore, balance these diverse views and ensure a fair and comprehensive peace process. To this end, the BJP must take proac-

tive steps. First, it needs to re-engage with the Kuki-Zo legislators who have distanced themselves from the party

since the ethnic violence erupted. Establishing communication between the Meitei and Kuki-Zo factions within the party is critical for fostering unity. A new peace committee, inclusive of all stakeholders, must also be formed to facilitate meaningful dialogue. Previous efforts have faltered due to lack of

action and resistance from influential groups like Kuki-Inpi and COCOMI. A more robust and dynamic approach is required this time.

The BJP's next chief ministerial candidate will likely be from the Meitei community, which dominates the state assembly. However, the party must en-

sure that the selected leader represents all communities and is capable of making decisions in the broader interest of the state, fostering a sense of inclusivity. Moreover, extending an olive branch to the Kuki People's Alliance (KPA), which had withdrawn support from the BJP due to disagreements with Biren Singh, could signal a commitment to reconciliation. Restoring ties with this faction will send a positive message to the Kuki-Zo community and help heal the rift that has deepened over the past year. Finally, the Centre must take a firm stance against militant groups from both the Meitei and Kuki-Zo communities. The recent crackdown on militants is a step in the right direction, but it must be sustained without compromise. The continued dismantling of armed groups will play a pivotal role in ensuring long-term peace and stability in Manipur.

In conclusion, President's Rule in Manipur offers a temporary yet crucial opportunity for the BJP and the Centre to address the root causes of the state's ethnic strife. By taking strategic actions-engaging in dialogue, restoring trust, and fostering political consensus—the BJP can pave the way for a more peaceful and stable future for Manipur. The next few months are critical, and how the Centre handles this period will shape the state's trajectory for years to come.





### 'Why are we caring about India's turnout?'

Former US President Donald Trump has once again criticized the \$21 million USAID funding for 'voter turnout' in India, questioning why American taxpayers' money is being spent on foreign elections. His remarks, made during an address to US governors, mark the third time he has publicly raised concerns over the issue.

"USD 21 million going to my friend Prime Minister Modi in India for voter turnout. Why are we caring about India's turnout? What about us? I want voter turnout too," Trump said in a video shared by National Desk. He also took aim at another USAID allocation, stating, "\$29 million to strengthen the political landscape in Bangladesh went to a firm that nobody ever heard of."

On Friday, Trump went further, calling the funding a "kickback scheme." He said, "Why do we need to spend \$21 million for voter turnout in India? I guess they were trying to get somebody else elected." He also compared the controversy to allegations of Russian interference in US elections, adding, "When we hear that Russia spent about two thousand dollars on internet ads here, it was a big deal. But this is a total breakthrough."



#### India's response

The Indian government has taken note of Trump's statements, with the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) confirming that the matter is under review. MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal stated, "Relevant departments and authorities are looking into the information put out by the American ad-

ministration regarding certain US activities and funding. These are obviously very deeply troubling."

The issue has raised concerns about the transparency of foreign funding in political processes, with both Trump's campaign and Indian authorities closely monitoring further developments.

### **Drive Against Illegal Poppy Cultivation** in Arunachal Faces **Death Threats**

A large-scale crackdown on illegal poppy cultivation in Arunachal Pradesh has uncovered direct links between narcotics and insurgency for the first time. Led by the Central Bureau of Narcotics (CBN) and supported by security forces and the state government, the operation targeted poppy plantations across multiple districts, including Lohit, Namsai, and Changlang.

Over 6,000 hectares of poppy fields were destroyed in the past two months, despite insurgent groups issuing death threats to officials and workers involved in the operation. The estimated value of the destroyed poppy plantations exceeds ₹500 crore. Insurgent outfits such as the NSCN (K-YA) and ULFA (Independent) reportedly threatened those participating in the drive, warning them to withdraw or face fatal consequences. These threats led to a shortage of workers, affecting the operation's overall progress.

Despite these challenges, security forces, particularly the Assam Rifles, played a crucial role in ensuring the operation proceeded as planned. However, due to bad weather and other logistical issues, officials were able to achieve only 60% of their initial target.



### **Over 150 Nepalese Students Leave Odisha University After Student's Death**

Days after the alleged suicide of a Nepalese student at Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) in Odisha, 159 Nepalese students have returned home, citing miscrossed the Raxaul border, according to Assistant Chief District Officer of Parsa, Suman Birgunj and Bhairahawa, Lamsal's home dis-Kumar Karki. Prakriti Lamsal, a 20-year-old third-year B-Tech (Computer Science) student, was found dead in her hostel room on February 16. Following her death, unrest broke out on campus, and Nepalese students claimed they were forced to vacate the hostel under harsh conditions. A group of students who returned to Nepal alleged they were subjected to "inhuman treatment" by university staff and security guards.

"We were beaten up in the presence of university teachers and forced to leave immediately," they said, adding that they no longer felt safe to continue their studies at KIIT despite reassurances from the administration. ### BBC World Service India Fined ₹3.44 **Crore For Foreign Exchange Violation**

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has imposed a penalty of ₹3.44 crore on BBC World Service India for allegedly violating foreign direct investment (FDI) regulations. The agency has also fined three of its directors ₹1.14 crore each under the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA).

A BBC spokesperson, responding to PTI, stated that neither the company nor its directors had received any adjudication order from the ED. "The BBC is committed to operating within the rules of all countries we are based in, including India. We will carefully review any order when it is received and consider next steps as appropriate," the spokesperson added.

The adjudication follows a show-cause notice issued on August 4, 2023, to BBC WS India, its three directors, and the finance head for alleged violations. The ED's FEMA probe was initiated a few months after an Income Tax survey at the BBC's Delhi office in February 2023.

According to sources, BBC WS India, a 100% FDI company, was engaged in streaming news and current affairs on digital media but did not com- taxed. ply with the FDI limit of 26% mandated by the Indian government under the Press Note 4 of 2019 issued by the Department for Promotion of Industry



and Internal Trade (DPIIT).

The total penalty includes ₹5,000 per day for non-compliance beyond October 15, 2021. The three fined directors—Giles Antony Hunt, Indu Shekhar Sinha, and Paul Michael Gibbons—were allegedly responsible for overseeing operations during the period of violation.

Following the 2023 Income Tax survey, the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) stated that the income and profits reported by BBC's entities were "not commensurate" with their Indian operations and that certain foreign remittances had not been

### "Cheating Passengers": Shivraj Chouhan Slams Air India Over "Broken" Seat

Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan on Saturday criticized Air India for allotting him a "broken" seat during his flight from Bhopal to Delhi. The Minister alleged that despite the airline being aware of the seat's poor condition, it was still sold to passengers.

Chouhan, who was traveling to Delhi to inaugurate the "Kisan Mela" and attend meetings on natural farming, shared his experience on X. He stated that he was assigned seat 8C on Air India flight AI436, which was damaged and uncomfortable.

"When I asked the airline staff why the seat was broken, they admitted that the management had already been informed about it and that it should not have been sold," Chouhan wrote in Hindi. He further claimed that multiple seats on the flight were in a similar condition.

Despite being advised by co-passengers to switch to another seat, the former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister chose to complete his journey in the same seat, arguing that he did not want to inconvenience another passenger.

Expressing his disappointment, Chouhan remarked, "I thought Air India's service would improve after Tata took over, but I was mistaken." He also criticized the airline for



charging passengers full fare while offering defective seating, calling it "unethical" and equating it to "cheating passengers."

Air India responded to his complaint, apologizing for the inconvenience and assuring that the issue would be addressed to prevent such occurrences in the future. The airline also requested an opportunity to discuss the matter with Chouhan.

The BBC had then maintained that it would continue cooperating with authorities and hoped for a resolution soon.

### Bhutan PM Calls Modi 'Elder Brother, **Mentor' at Leadership Conclave**

India's strong response underscores its firm stance against any external interference in its territorial matters.

### **Trump Announces Reciprocal Tariffs on India and China**

Former US President Donald Trump has announced plans to impose reciprocal tariffs on countries like India and China, stating that the United States will match the tariffs these nations impose on American goods.

"We will soon impose reciprocal tariffs—they charge us, we charge them. Whatever a company or a country, such as India or China, charges, we want to be fair; hence, reciprocal," Trump said during a press conference on Friday. He added that the US was prepared to take this step earlier but was interrupted by the Covid-19 pandemic.


Before his recent bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Trump had criticized India's tariff structure, calling it the "highest" and describing the country as a difficult place to conduct business. He reiterated these concerns when discussing Tesla CEO Elon Musk's meeting with PM Modi. "India is a very hard place to do business because of the tariffs. They have the highest tariffs... It's a hard place to do business," he remarked.

Trump also referenced India's past trade policies, citing the example of Harley-Davidson motorcycles, which faced high import duties, forcing the company to establish manufacturing units in India. "India charges tremendous tariffs. I remember when Harley-Davidson couldn't sell their motorbikes in India because the tax was so high. Harley was forced to build," he said, according to US Network Pool via Reuters.

His comments reflect long-standing concerns about India's trade practic-

# **Kash Patel Sworn In as FBI Director, Takes Oath** on Bhagavad Gita

Indian-American Kash Patel has been sworn in as the ninth Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), taking his oath on the Bhagavad Gita. Patel, confirmed by the US Senate, succeeds Christopher Wray in leading the agency.

The ceremony took place at the Eisenhower Executive Office Building, where US Attorney General Pam Bondi administered the oath. Patel's family and girlfriend stood beside him, with other relatives seated in the front row.

Following the oath, Patel spoke about his journey, calling it a testament to the American dream. "Anyone who thinks the American dream is dead, look right here. You are talking to a first-generation Indian who is about to lead the law enforcement agency of the greatest nation on earth," he said. He also promised accountability within the FBI, both internally and externally.

US President Donald Trump praised Patel's appointment, calling him

"tough and strong" and highlighting the respect he commands among FBI agents. "He will go down as the best ever at that position," Trump said. He added that Patel's approval was easier than expected, citing strong endorsements, including one from former congressman Trey Gowdy.

The White House welcomed Patel's confirmation, stating that it aligns with Trump's agenda to restore integrity and uphold the rule of law. In a post on X, the White House wrote, "@ FBIDirectorKash Patel's confirmation as FBI Director is a crucial step in executing President Trump's agenda to restore integrity and uphold the rule of law."

Patel, a close ally of Trump, expressed gratitude for the support of the President and Attorney General Bondi, vowing to rebuild the FBI as a "transparent, accountable, and committed" agency.

His nomination faced opposition from Republican Senators Lisa Murkowski and Susan Collins, but he secured confirmation with a narrow 51-49 vote, as all Senate Democrats voted against him.

As Germany approaches its national election this Sunday, a notable shift is underway among Generation Z voters, born between 1997 and 2012, who are increasingly favoring rightof-center parties. Once staunch supporters of environmental and social justice causes, young Germans are now prioritizing immigration, a faltering economy, and the fallout from the Ukraine war, marking a dramatic departure from their 2021 preferences.

Germany's right-wing political spectrum includes the moderate CDU/ CSU coalition, currently the second-largest party with strongholds in the west, and the far-right Alternative für Deutschland (AfD), which is gaining traction, particularly in the east. In last year's eastern regional elections, the AfD saw significant support from 18- to 24-year-olds, outpacing the Greens, according to polling institute infratest dimap. The CDU/CSU, focusing on immigration and economic stability, topped the youth vote in the 2024 European elections, with the AfD close behind.

This shift contrasts sharply with 2021, when the Greens, bolstered by the Fridays for Future movement, led among young voters with their green energy and multicultural agenda. However, backlash against these policies has eroded their support. Unlike older generations tied to party loyalty, Gen Z voters are pragmatic, seeking solutions to immediate concerns. Analysts note that this cohort, distanced from World War II's legacy, views the AfD's rise with less apprehension than their predecessors.

Social media, particularly TikTok, has amplified this trend, with both the AfD and far-left Die Linke leveraging platforms to polarize and mobilize young voters. Recent surveys underscore this rightward lean, though 30% of all voters remain undecided, potentially deciding the election's outcome. As Europe tilts right, immigration remains a flashpoint, challenging left-leaning parties' liberal stance. With the CDU/ CSU and AfD capitalizing on these shifts, Germany's political landscape faces a transformative moment this weekend.

#### **New Bat Coronavirus Found in China** Scientists Assess Human **Transmission Risk TPN Correspondent | Beijing**

A new bat coronavirus, HKU5-CoV-2, has been discovered in China, raising concerns about its potential to infect humans. The virus, identified by a team of virologists led by Shi Zhengli, shares similarities with SARS-CoV-2, the virus responsible for the COVID-19 pandemic.

According to the South China Morning Post (SCMP), HKU5-CoV-2 belongs to the merbecovirus subgenus, which also includes the Middle East respiratory syndrome (MERS) virus. The researchers found that it can bind to human ACE2 receptors, a key mechanism used by SARS-CoV-2 to infect human cells.

Lab tests revealed that the virus could infect human cell cultures in mini-organ models, suggesting a potential zoonotic risk. The study, published in Newsweek, stated that "bat merbecoviruses, which are phylogenetically related to MERS-CoV, pose a high risk of spillover to humans, either through direct transmission or facilitated by intermediate hosts." However, it emphasized that the possibility of human transmission "remains to be investigated."

Despite the discovery, experts caution against panic. Dr. Michael Osterholm, an infectious disease expert at the University of Minnesota, called concerns about another pandemic "overblown," citing increased immunity in the population against SARS-like viruses since 2019.







# **Ex-RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das Appointed Principal Secretary to PM**

TPN Correspondent | New Delhi Former Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Shaktikanta Das has been appointed as the Principal Secretary to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, according to a government notification issued on Saturday. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) confirmed that Das' tenure will be co-terminus with the term of the Prime Minister or until further orders, whichever is earlier. His appointment comes as a significant move, given his vast experience in economic policy and governance.

Das, who served as RBI Governor management and economic policyfor six years since December 2018,

played a crucial role in steering India's financial policies, particularly during the COVID-19 crisis. His tenure saw critical interventions in monetary policy, liquidity management, and regulatory reforms aimed at stabilizing the economy amid global and domestic challenges.

A 1980-batch Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer of the Tamil Nadu cadre, Das has held key positions in the central and state governments in areas including finance, taxation, infrastructure, and industry. His expertise in fiscal making was instrumental in shap-

ing several government initiatives. In another key decision, the government extended the tenure of NITI Aayog CEO BVR Subrahmanyam by one year, starting from February 24, 2025. A 1987-batch IAS officer, Subrahmanyam was initially appointed for a two-year term in February 2023. His extension signals continuity in policy advisory at the country's premier think tank.

With Das assuming the crucial role of Principal Secretary to the PM, his experience in macroeconomic management and financial governance is expected to further strengthen the decision-making process at the highest level of government.

# **CIE Automotive India Q4 2025 Profit Rises 9.49% Yoy Despite Revenue Dip**

CIE Automotive India reported its Q4 2025 financial results on February 20, 2025, posting a profit of ₹184.98 crore, reflecting a 9.49% year-over-year (YoY) increase. However, revenue declined 5.82% YoY to ₹2,109.95 crore.

Quarter-over-quarter, revenue fell 1.16%, and profit declined 5.25%, indicating a slowdown. Operating income also witnessed a 12.9% q-o-q and 12.41% YoY decline. Meanwhile, Selling, General & Administrative expenses increased 0.67% q-o-q but dropped 1.42% YoY. Earnings per share (EPS) for Q4 stood at ₹4.72, up 1.29% YoY, signaling financial stability despite revenue pressures. CIE Automotive India's stock performance has been mixed, delivering a 0.27% return in the last week, but experiencing a 26.48% decline over six months and 10.6% yearto-date losses. The company holds a market capitalization of ₹15,995.81 crore, with its stock trading between a 52-week high of ₹622.4 and a low of ₹405.3. Analysts maintain a 'Buy' recommendation, signaling long-term confidence despite near-term revenue challenges.

#### Coldplay Concert Black Marketing Controversy

The show-cause notice against Zomato comes shortly after a similar controversy involving Book-MyShow over the alleged black marketing of Coldplay concert tickets. The concert, held between January 19-21, 2025, faced backlash after fans accused BookMyShow of enabling third parties to resell tickets at exorbitant prices. Advocate Amit Vyas filed a complaint against the platform, alleging that genuine users were logged out or blocked, allowing scalpers to sell tickets initially priced at ₹2,500 for up to ₹3 lakh. BookMyShow had started selling Coldplay concert tickets on September 22, 2024, and they were sold out within minutes. The platform later issued warnings against illegitimate resellers. With growing concerns over black marketing, the Maharashtra Cyber Cell is expected to tighten regulations further, ensuring that ticketing platforms comply with transparency measures.

Debock Industries Reports ₹0.2 Cr Loss in Q3 2025 as Revenue Plunges 97.01% YoY Debock Industries announced its Q3 2025 financial results on February 21, 2025, re-



Earnings per share (EPS) for Q3 stood at ₹-0.01, marking a 125% YoY decline, emphasizing the ongoing financial downturn.

Despite a 0.39% return in the last week, Debock Industries has seen a 63.87% decline in the past six months and a negative 17.83% year-to-date return.

The company currently holds a market capitalization of ₹41.99 crore, with its stock trading between a 52-week high of ₹9.6 and a low of ₹2.43.

Officials have raised concerns that omitting buyer names on tickets could lead to potential security risks and unauthorized resales. According to an NDTV report, the cyber cell has sought an explanation from Zomato regarding this practice and whether it violates ticketing regulations.

However, Zomato has denied the allegations, stating that it has not received any notice yet. In response to the controversy, a company spokesperson told Livemint, "This is not true. We have not received any notice yet. As and when we receive it, we will work with the authorities to demonstrate that our practices comply with applicable laws. We have always adMyShow to print buyers' names on tickets for major events to prevent resale at inflated prices.

# NASA Lowers Risk of Asteroid 2024 YR4 **Impact in 2032**



TPN Correspondent | Washington, D.C. NASA has significantly reduced concerns regarding asteroid 2024 YR4, revising its estimated impact probability in 2032 from 1 in 32 to 1 in 360. The 55-meter-wide asteroid, initially considered the most hazardous object on NASA's Center for Near-Earth Object Studies (CNEOS) Sentry Risk Table, now has a 99.72% chance of completely missing Earth.

The reassessment follows new observational data collected between February 18 and February 20, allowing for refined calculations of the asteroid's trajectory. As a result, NASA has downgraded its classification to Level 1 on the Torino Scale, which assesses the threat posed by near-Earth objects. Richard Binzel, creator of the Torino Scale, indicated that further observations might move

2024 YR4 to Level 0, signifying no risk. Despite the risk reduction, asteroid 2024 YR4 remains the most concerning object on the Sentry Risk Table, followed by asteroid 1950 DA, which has a 0.039% chance of impacting Earth in the year 2880. Experts stress that continuous monitoring will provide greater clarity, especially when the asteroid makes another approach in 2028.

David Rankin, an astronomer with the Catalina Sky Survey, explained that small uncertainties in measurements could result in large trajectory shifts over time. However, he reassured that additional observations will likely continue lowering any remaining impact probabilities.

NASA also acknowledged a minor possibility that 2024 YR4 could collide with the Moon, though the likelihood remains extremely low. The asteroid is now moving away from Earth and will not be visible to ground-based telescopes until 2028, when further tracking will refine its projected path. Scientists remain confident that it will continue its orbit around the Sun without posing any danger to Earth.

## **Amazonian Town Faces Crisis as Massive Sinkholes Expand**

The city of Buriticupu in Brazil's northeastern Amazon is facing a growing crisis as massive sinkholes continue to expand, threatening the homes of at least 1,200 residents. The municipal government recently declared a state of emergency as the situation worsened.

In a decree issued earlier this month, officials warned that the sinkholes have been expanding "exponentially" in recent months, putting more homes at risk. Several buildings have already collapsed, and the danger continues to increase. The issue has been unfolding for nearly 30 years due to heavy rains eroding sandy soils, worsened by deforestation and poorly planned construction. Known as "vocoroca" in Brazil—a term of indigenous origin meaning "to tear the earth"-these sinkholes have now reached a critical stage.

The situation is particularly dire during the current rainy season, according to geographer Marcelino Farias of the Federal University of Maranhao. Longtime resident Antonia dos Anjos, 65, expressed her fears, saying, "There's this danger right in front of us, and nobody knows where the next hole will open up."

Buriticupu's secretary of public works, Lucas Conceicao, admitted that the municipality lacks the resources to handle the crisis. "The challenges range from stopping the erosion to relocating people from risk areas," he said.




