SLBC tunnel roof collapse leaves eight people trapped.

The roof of the SLBC (Srisailam Left Bank Canal) tunnel collapsed at Domalapenta in Nagarkurnool district on Saturday morning, trapping eight people inside. As the victims have been stuck since yesterday morning, concerns over their condition are growing.

At the 14th kilometer of the tunnel, a 100-meter-long thick mud was found. Rescue teams are trying to cross the mud in the tunnel. Fishing boats, tires, wooden planks... are being used to cross the mud. Only after crossing the 100-meter-long mud will they reach the accident site.

Rescue teams have managed to advance 50 meters towards the collapse

site, but heavy mud and debris-accumulated up to 15 feet—are hindering operations. То strengthen the rescue efforts, a specialized Navy

team is set to arrive

in Srisailam on Sunday night. Ministers Uttam Kumar Reddy and Jupally Krishna Rao are closely monitoring the rescue efforts at the site.

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi called Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy to inquire about the accident. He was briefed on the situation, including details about the trapped individuals-two engineers, two operators, and four laborers-and the measures being taken to rescue them. Their conversation

lasted about 20 minutes. Rescue workers have ventured 13.5 kilometers inside Sarangam to reach the trapped victims. However, they still need to cover another half kilometer, where mud and water are creating further obstacles. Teams are working tirelessly to overcome these challenges and reach the accident site.

The mystery surrounding the sensational Rajalingamurthy murder case in Telangana has been unraveled. After an intense investigation by six special teams, Bhupalapalli police have identified the culprits behind the crime and arrested seven individuals involved in the murder conspiracy. A manhunt is still underway for a few

more absconding accused. According to police reports, the murder, which took place on the 19th of this month, was driven by a long-standing land dispute. The investigation revealed that Renukuntla Sanjeeva, along with his relatives and associates, planned and executed the killing. The police have named Renukuntla Sanjeeva as A-1, Pingali Semanth alias Bablu as A-2, More Kumar as A-3, Kothuri Kiran as A-4, Renukuntla Komurayya as A-5, Dasarapu Krishna as A-6, and Renukuntla Sambayya as A-7 in the case. The brutal murder has sparked political controversy in the state, drawing strong reactions from various quarters. The police are continuing efforts to apprehend the remaining suspects and ensure justice in the case.

Hyderabad , Feb 24 : Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka Mallu has urged Genco officials to accelerate the pending development works at Bhadradri Thermal Power Plant (BTPS) to meet the stipulated timelines. During a review meeting at Praja Bhavan

on Sunday, the Deputy CM emphasized the need for fixed timeframes for BHEL to complete electrical, mechanical, and civil works as per the agreement.

Mr. Vikramarka also proposed forming a three-member committee, consisting of a Director, Chief Engineer, and an official, to swiftly address technical issues and restore power generation in case of snags. He stressed that the commit-



tee should ensure prompt resolution of problems and submit reports within a fixed timeframe to prevent any losses. The Deputy CM also inquired about pending works like coal storage shed construction and railway line works for coal transport. He directed officials to maintain quality standards while carrying out these works and to ensure timely completion.

Additionally, he recommended recruit-

ing non-technical workers from local communities via the ITDA Project Director and encouraged tribal youth to set up brick-making units using ash from the plant. Mr. Vikramarka also instructed the development of a 3D walkway model for the BTPS.

The meeting was attended by Energy Secretary Sundeep Kumar Sultania, Genco Directors, and other senior officials.

The callers allegedly warned Raja Singh that they would "cut off his head" either on that day or the next. Additionally, they claimed that neither Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath nor Prime Minister Narendra Modi could protect him.

The first call was made at 3:30 PM, and the second followed at 3:54 PM. After receiving these threats, Raja Singh immediately informed the police and filed a formal complaint. As per the and politicians.

report, the police have registered a case and are investigating the origins of the calls and

the identity of the callers. This is not the first instance of threatening calls for the Goshamahal MLA. Previously, Singh has received similar calls, and these recurring threats have raised concerns about his safety. 

Liquor Shops Closed for Three Days in Telangana Due to Elections





Chromosomal Microarray is a test that detects chromosomal abnormalities, such as missing or extra pieces of chromosomes, which can lead to developmental delays, genetic disorders like Down Syndrome, and other syndromes.

Judiciary **Doesn't Have Right to Amend** Constitution

Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar asserted that the judiciary does not have the authority to amend the Constitution, emphasizing that only Parliament and state legislatures hold that right. Speaking at the inauguration of the Constitution Awareness Year celebrations, he underscored the importance of nationalism, urging people to prioritize the nation above politics and personal interests.

Dhankhar warned against external influences in India's democratic system, referring to recent reports of alleged USAID funding aimed at influencing voter turnout. "By getting funds from outside, the democratic system is being made unholy. The persons of their choice are made to win polls. This is dangerous and cannot be tolerated," he remarked.

Highlighting the importance of constitutional awareness, he praised the Constitution's framers for their meaningful dialogue and high-level debates. "They never let the prestige of the temple of democracy go down," he said, while criticizing disruptions in parliamentary proceedings.

"The more we learn about the Constitution, the more we will turn towards nationalism," Dhankhar stated, adding that fundamental rights must be nurtured responsibly. He also recalled the Emergency of 1975 as the "darkest hour" in India's democratic history, condemning the Supreme Court's decision at the time to uphold the government's stance. Referring to the historical significance of the Constitution, he noted that it contains 22 demonstrative images representing India's rich cultural heritage, including Lord Ram, Lord Krishna, and Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Reiterating the supremacy of elected legislatures in constitutional amendments, Dhankhar stated, "No one else has this right, not even the judiciary.

Udit Raj seeks protection over threats from BSP workers

- Udit Raj said Mayawati should be "throttled".
- He approached Delhi Police, citing threats from BSP workers.
- A viral video allegedly called for his killing with a ₹1 lakh reward.
- He claims unusual movements near his house and seeks security.

Congress leader Udit Raj has approached the Delhi Police, seeking protection against alleged threats from Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) workers, including its leader Akash Anand. The move follows a controversy over his recent remarks against BSP chief Mayawati.

In a letter to the Delhi Police Commissioner, Udit Raj claimed that a video circulating on the YouTube channel 'Bahujan Dastak' features an interviewer inciting the public to attack him. "The interviewer has openly called for my throat to be slit and even announced a reward of ₹1 lakh for such an act," he stated.

He further alleged that since the release of the video, he has noticed unusual movements near his house, raising serious concerns about his safety. "I apprehend that any untoward incident may occur if adequate security is not provided immediately," he wrote, urging the police to file an FIR and take strict legal action against those responsible.

Udit Raj, who also heads the All India Unorganised Workers and Employees Congress (KKC) and the Dalit, OBC, Minority, and Adivasi Parisangh (DOMA Parisangh), revealed that he has been receiving threatening calls



since February 17, the day after his controversial remarks against Mayawati.

He claimed that on the evening of February 17, a caller allegedly told his PSO that Mayawati and Akash Anand had ordered him to harm Udit Raj. The Congress leader insists that the threats have escalated, making immediate police intervention necessary.

The controversy erupted after Udit Raj's remarks in Lucknow, where he suggested that Mayawati should be "throttled" for allegedly suppressing social welfare movements. His statement triggered a strong backlash from Mayawati, who accused the

Congress of historically opposing the ideology of B.R. Ambedkar.

Political reactions have been swift. BJP national spokesperson Shahnawaz Hussain criticized Udit Raj, saying, "Congress is insulting Dalits with this statement. They are targeting a prominent Dalit leader like Mayawati. This will cost them dearly."

JD(U) leader Rajeev Ranjan Prasad also condemned the remark, stating, "Such statements are unacceptable in a democracy. The Congress is speaking out of frustration."

As tensions rise, Udit Raj awaits police action, demanding both security and accountability for the alleged threats.

In response to the Belagavi incident, Karnataka police arrested four individuals for assaulting the conductor, Mahadevappa Mallappa Hukkeri. However, the conductor has also been booked under the POCSO Act following a counter-complaint by the 14-year-old girl, alleging derogatory remarks.

Belagavi Police Commissioner Iada Martin Marbaniang assured a neutral investigation, stating that law and order would be maintained. Meanwhile, pro-Kannada activists staged protests, blocking roads and burning effigies, while Marathi groups condemned the assault on the MSRTC driver. The Belagavi region has long been a flashpoint due to border disputes and linguistic tensions, with this latest episode adding to the ongoing friction.





Despite Their Attacks Giorgia Meloni Backs Modi, Trump At CPAC

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni delivered a sharp critique of the global Left, accusing liberals of hypocrisy and reacting with "hysteria" to the rise of right-wing leaders. Speaking via video link at the Conservative Political Action Conference (CPAC) in Washington DC, she praised US President Donald Trump and Vice President JD Vance while condemning left-wing "elites."

PM Meloni argued that liberals have grown increasingly frustrated with the electoral success of conservative leaders, especially following Trump's return to the White House.

"When Bill Clinton and Tony Blair created the global leftist liberal network in the 90s, they were called statesmen," she remarked. "Today, when Trump, Meloni, (Javier) Milei, or maybe (Narendra) Modi talk, they are called a threat to democracy. This is the Left's double standard, but we are used to it. And the good news is people no longer believe in their lies. Despite all the mud they throw at us, citizens keep voting for us," she said.

She described Trump as a resilient leader committed to global conservative cooperation, able to defend Italian and European interests

claiming that left-wing forces were growing anxious. "The Left is nervous, and with Trump's victory, their irritation has turned into hysteria. Not only because conservatives are winning, but because conservatives are now collaborating globally," she added.

As leader of the far-right Brothers of Italy party, PM Meloni was the only EU head of government to attend Trump's inauguration in January.

Her participation in CPAC drew strong opposition in Italy, particularly after Steve Bannon, Trump's former chief strategist, appeared to use a Nazi salute during the conference. Critics, including opposition MPs, called on Meloni to cancel her address, pointing to French far-right leader Jordan Bardella's decision to withdraw from the event over Bannon's gesture.

Elly Schlein, leader of Italy's center-left Democratic Party, condemned Meloni's association with CPAC. "She should have the decency to disassociate herself from this neo-fascist gathering," Schlein said. "She has not said a word for days about Trump's insults and frontal attacks on Ukraine and the European Union. She is un-

Israeli Jets Fly Over Hezbollah **Chief's Funeral Amid Mass Gathering**

Israeli fighter jets flew over Beirut today as thousands gathered for the funeral of Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah, nearly five months after his death in an Israeli airstrike. The low-flying aircraft momentarily drowned out the chants of Hezbollah supporters, intensifying the tension surrounding the event.

Visuals from the funeral showed four Israeli F-16 jets passing over the stadium, an act seen as a show of dominance by Israel. Meanwhile, the Israeli army marked the occasion with a post on X, stating, "Today is Hassan Nasrallah's funeral. Today the world is a better place."

Nasrallah, who led Hezbollah for decades, was killed in an Israeli strike that dealt a severe blow to the Iran-backed militant group. His death was part of a broader Israeli offensive that significantly weakened Hezbollah's command structure. The mass funeral, held at the 55,000-seat Camille Chamoun Sports City stadium in Beirut's

southern suburbs, was attended by a sea of Hezbollah supporters carrying flags and portraits of their slain leader.

Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei issued a statement vowing continued resistance against Israel. "The enemy should know that resistance against oppression and arrogance is not over. It will continue until the desired goal is achieved," he declared.

Hezbollah has faced a series of setbacks in recent months, with much of its leadership eliminated and its military strength eroded. The impact was worsened by the fall of its key ally, Bashar al-Assad, in Syria, disrupting Hezbollah's supply routes.

Despite these challenges, supporters at the funeral vowed to keep the movement alive.

"We may have lost a great leader, but we have not lost the spirit of resistance," said Hassan Nasreddine, a mourner who traveled from southern Lebanon for the event. The ceremony also honored Hashem Safieddine, who briefly led Hezbollah after Nasrallah's death but was killed in an Israeli strike before he could be officially named as his successor. Nasrallah was initially buried next to his son, Hadi, who died fighting for Hezbollah in 1997. His formal funeral was postponed until the withdrawal of Israeli forces from southern Lebanon, as part of a U.S.-brokered ceasefire that ended last year's war.

The remarks come amid secret U.S.-Russia discussions in Saudi Arabia on restoring ties and exploring a possible Ukraine ceasefire—talks that notably excluded Kyiv and European allies.

Despite these discussions, the Kremlin has made it clear that it will "never" give up occupied territories in eastern Ukraine. Peskov reaffirmed Russia's stance, citing Moscow-held referendums widely condemned as illegitimate. "No one will ever sell off these territories. That's the most important thing," he declared.

Meanwhile, Putin marked Rus-

in Ukraine as a divine mission. Addressing Russian servicemen, he stated, "Fate willed it so, God willed it so. A mission as difficult as it is honorable-defending Russia-has been placed on our and your shoulders." The statement came just a day before the third anniversary of the war, as Russia escalated attacks on Ukraine. Kyiv reported that Moscow launched a record 267 drone strikes overnight, with 138 intercepted and 119 lost, while multiple regions, including the capital, were hit.

Trump's engagement with Putin and his harsh rhetoric against Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky have unsettled Western allies. Trump has falsely claimed that Kyiv started the war and questioned Zelensky's popularity. In response, Zelensky urged continued Western unity, stating, "We must do our best to achieve a lasting and just peace for Ukraine. This is possible with the strength of all partners—Europe, America, and all who seek peace."

Moscow, however, has seized on Trump's attacks on Zelensky. Peskov dismissed the Ukrainian leader's criticism of Trump, saying, "No president would tolerate that kind of treatment. So his reaction is completely understandable."

NASA Lowers Risk of Asteroid 2024 YR4 Impact in 2032



TPN Correspondent | Washington, D.C. NASA has significantly reduced concerns regarding asteroid 2024 YR4, revising its estimated impact probability in 2032 from 1 in 32 to 1 in 360. The 55-meter-wide asteroid, initially considered the most hazardous object on NASA's Center for Near-Earth Object Studies (CNEOS) Sentry Risk Table, now has a 99.72% chance of completely missing Earth. The reassessment follows new observational data collected between February 18 and February 20, allowing for refined calculations of the asteroid's trajectory. As a result, NASA has downgraded its classification to Level 1 on the Torino Scale, which assesses the threat posed by near-Earth objects. Richard Binzel, creator of the Torino Scale, indicated that further observations might move 2024 YR4 to Level 0, signifying no risk. Despite the risk reduction, asteroid 2024 YR4 remains the most concerning object on the Sentry Risk Table, followed by asteroid 1950 DA, which has a 0.039% chance of impacting Earth in the year 2880. Experts stress that continuous monitoring will provide greater clarity, especially when the asteroid makes another approach in 2028.

David Rankin, an astronomer with the Catalina Sky Survey, explained that small uncertainties in measurements could result in large trajectory shifts over time. However, he reassured that additional observations will likely continue lowering any remaining impact probabilities.

NASA also acknowledged a minor possibility that 2024 YR4 could collide with the Moon, though the likelihood remains extremely low. The asteroid is now moving away from Earth and will not be visible to ground-based telescopes until 2028, when further tracking will refine its projected path. Scientists remain confident that it will continue its orbit around the Sun without posing any danger to Earth.

Amazonian Town Faces Crisis as Massive Sinkholes Expand

The city of Buriticupu in Brazil's northeastern Amazon is facing a growing crisis as massive sinkholes continue to expand, threatening the homes of at least 1,200 residents. The municipal government recently declared a state of emergency as the situation worsened.

In a decree issued earlier this month, officials warned that the sinkholes have been expanding "exponentially" in recent months, putting more homes at risk. Several buildings have already collapsed, and the danger continues to increase. The issue has been unfolding for nearly 30 years due to heavy rains eroding sandy soils, worsened by deforestation and poorly planned construction. Known as "vocoroca" in Brazil—a term of indigenous origin meaning "to tear the earth"—these sinkholes have now reached a critical stage.

The situation is particularly dire during the current rainy season, according to geographer Marcelino Farias of the Federal University of Maranhao. Longtime resident Antonia dos Anjos, 65, expressed her fears, saying, "There's this danger right in front of us, and nobody knows where the next hole will open up."

Buriticupu's secretary of public works, Lucas Conceicao, admitted that the municipality lacks the resources to handle the crisis. "The challenges range from stopping the erosion to relocating people from risk areas," he said.

Record Number Of Olive Ridley Turtles Arrive For Nesting At Odisha Beach

The Rushikulya river mouth in Odisha's Ganjam district has witnessed a record-breaking mass nesting of endangered Olive Ridley turtles, with over 6.82 lakh turtles laying eggs so far. This surpasses the previous high of 6.37 lakh turtles recorded in 2023.

The mass nesting began on February 16, and the numbers are expected to increase further, said Berhampur Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Sunny Khokkar.

Favorable climatic conditions are believed

to be a key factor behind the increased nesting activity. "The better climatic conditions this year have helped more turtles lay eggs in the Rushikulya river mouth, which is emerging as a major rookery," said senior scientist Bivas Pandav from the Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Dehradun.

Experts also anticipate a higher number of hatchlings due to the timely nesting. "Since the mass nesting has occurred on time, we expect a good number of hatchlings," said Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) scientist Basudev Tripathy.

Meanwhile, conservation efforts are in full swing. The government has installed protective fencing along a 9-km stretch from New Podampeta to Prayagi to safeguard the eggs from predators. "We have taken utmost care to protect the eggs, which may hatch after 45 days," said Dibya Shankar Behera, Range Officer of Khallikote.

Additionally, researchers have recaptured over 330 turtles that were GPS-tagged between 2021 and 2023, providing valuable insights into their migratory patterns, said ZSI scientist Anil Mohapatra. 

Call filters were first introduced with the 159.0.718038457-publicbeta-pixel2024 update of the Phone app last month. At that time, it was limited to beta users with no official announcement on a public rollout. The latest report indicates that the feature is now becoming widephased rollout controlled via a server-side update. As a result, some users, including Gadgets 360 staff members, have yet to see the feature on their devices, including Pixel phones.

Additional Spam Protection Features

The new call sorting feature adds to Google's ongoing efforts to improve spam protection and enhance user convenience. One of the key tools in this regard is the Call Screen feature available on Pixel devices. It acts as an intermediary, screening calls by asking the caller their name and reason for calling, then providing a transcript to the receiver before they decide whether to answer.

Another notable feature is reverse lookup, which helps users identify unknown numbers and filter out spam calls. These measures are part of Google's broader strategy to reduce call spam and improve the overall calling experience for Android users.







Virat Kohli's 51st ODI century powers India past Pakistan in Champions Trophy clash



Virat Kohli once again proved his dominance in high-pres-sure encounters, smashing his 51st ODI century to lead India to a commanding six-wicket victory over Pakistan in the Champions Trophy 2025. The win not only strengthened India's hold on the top spot in Group A but also virtually secured their place in the semifinals.

Chasing a target of 242, Kohli anchored the innings with an unbeaten 100 off 111 balls, featuring seven fours. He found valuable support from Shreyas Iyer (56 off 67) and Shubman Gill (46 off 52) as India comfortably overhauled the total with more than seven overs to spare.

The match began with Shaheen Shah Afridi giving Pakistan a brief moment of hope, dismissing Rohit Sharma (20) with a toe-crushing yorker. However, Kohli remained unfazed, expertly handling Pakistan's pace attack and playing cautiously against leg-spinner Abrar Ahmed. His partnership with Iyer, worth 114 runs for the third wicket, effectively shut Pakistan out of the contest.

Earlier, Pakistan struggled to accelerate despite a fighting half-century from Saud Shakeel (62 off 76) and a steady 46

from skipper Mohammad Rizwan. The duo added 104 runs for the third wicket, but tight bowling from Kuldeep Yadav (3/40) and Hardik Pandya (2/39) restricted them to 241.

Babar Azam (23) looked promising but edged behind while attempting an expansive drive off Pandya. Imam-ul-Haq (10) was run out after a mix-up, leaving Pakistan at 47/2. Their innings stagnated as India's disciplined bowling attack denied them easy runs, with a 55-ball stretch without a boundary in the middle overs.

Shakeel and Rizwan stabilized the innings before India struck back. Rizwan was bowled by Axar Patel, while Shakeel holed out attempting a pull shot off Pandya. The lower order, including Shaheen and Naseem Shah, fell cheaply to Kuldeep's spin, while Khushdil Shah's late 38-run cameo pushed Pakistan past 240.

Despite brief injury concerns for Mohammed Shami and Rohit Sharma during Pakistan's innings, India remained in full control. Kohli, underlining his big-match temperament, became the fastest player to reach 14,000 ODI runs during his innings, adding yet another feather to his illustrious cap.
