Jagan expressed confidence in his ability to lead the state for the next 30 years, bolstered by the unwavering support of the peo-

TPN Correspondent | New Delhi Exit polls for the 2025 Delhi Assembly elections indicate a major setback for Arvind Kejriwal's Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), with most surveys predicting a shift in voter preference towards the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). Out of seven exit polls, six suggest a BJP victory, while only one gives AAP a slim chance of crossing the halfway mark.

According to Matrize, AAP could secure up to 37 seats, just two above the majority mark of 35 in the 70-member assembly. However, other surveys predict a different outcome, with four agencies estimating AAP's seat tally between 15 and 35, while BJP is projected to win between 38 and 40-plus seats. People's Pulse exit poll has forecasted a BJP sweep with 51-60 seats. The aggregate of these polls suggests 26 seats for AAP and 43 for BJP.

Congress, which once held sway in Delhi politics, remains on the margins. The highest seat projection for

the party is three, while some exit polls predict zero seats.

While exit polls are not always accurate, they had correctly predicted AAP's victories in the last two elections, albeit underestimating the party's final seat count. This time, however, the mood appears differ-

The BJP's campaign focused heavily on corruption allegations against AAP, which had risen to power on an anti-corruption plank. Over the past two years, several AAP leaders, including Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and former Deputy CM Manish Sisodia, have faced legal troubles and jail time over multiple corruption cases.

HERE SAND, SOIL BECOME OWN PROPERTY **OF CHINTAMANENI?**

- **Illegal Excavations Plague Denduluru Constituency**

Fast forward to 2024, with Naidu introducing a free sand supply scheme aimed at eliminating illegal mining. However, Chintamaneni continues to resist the government's control over the sand mafia, maintaining his hold over the sector. The issue persists despite official efforts, reflecting the difficulty in dismantling the mafia's influence.





The Denduluru constituency in Eluru district is grappling with illegal sand and soil excavations, particularly in the areas of Denduluru, Pedavegi, Pedavadu, and Eluru Rural mandals. These regions, which have a mix of delta, metta, and kolleru areas, are facing a serious environmental threat due to unchecked soil mining activities. The Polavaram right canal embankment and Tamilleru sand pits are the central points where illegal excavations are taking place.



AP Govt Forms SIT to **Investigate Liquor Irregularities During YSRCP Rule**

The Andhra Pradesh government has set up a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to look into allegations of irregularities in liquor transactions during the YSRCP regime. The allegations claim that approximately Rs. 90,000 crores were involved in cash transactions related to liquor sales from October 2019 to March 2024. Further accusations include large-scale irregularities concerning the use of holograms on liquor bottles.

In response, the government has appointed a seven-member SIT led by Vijayawada Police Commissioner Rajasekhar Babu. The SIT will receive full cooperation from the Excise Department, which has been instructed to provide detailed information on liquor sales. The investigation will be supervised by the CID DIG, and the team is mandated to submit progress reports to the government every 15 days. The appointed SIT members include Red Sandalwood Task Force SP Subbarayudu, Additional SP Kolli Srinivas, CID ASP Srihari Babu, Don DSP Srinivas, and CI Shivaji, who will work together to ensure a thorough investigation into the alleged irregularities.

The Andhra Pradesh High Court has taken a serious stance on alleged Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) violations involving Neha Reddy, daughter of former MP Vijayasai Reddy. The court has directed officials to submit a detailed report on whether her constructions in Bhimunipatnam, Visakhapatnam fall within restricted coastal

During the hearing on Wednesday, the High Court expressed strong dissatisfaction over the lack of action by CRZ officials despite complaints regarding illegal constructions. The case was brought to the court's attention through a petition filed by Janasena Corporator Murthy Yadav.

Taking serious note of the matter, the Chief Justice's bench appointed a committee consisting of the Visakhapatnam District Collector, Visakhapatnam Commissioner, and CRZ Member Secretaries to conduct a thorough inspection. The committee has been ordered to investigate:

- Whether the construction falls within CRZ limits.
- When the structures were built and whether they violate regulations.
- Actions taken (if any) to address the violations.

The court has set a one-week deadline for officials to submit their findings. If the report is not presented within the stipulated time, the committee members will have to personally appear before the court. Additionally, the High Court has ordered demolition of any structures found to be in violation of CRZ rules.

The case has been adjourned for next week, with the court making it clear that failure to comply with the orders will result in strict legal consequences for the responsible officials.

Food Safety Officers Inspection at M/s. Sanjeeva Reddy Institute of Medical Sciences

On Wednesday, an inspection was conducted at the food premises of M/s. Sanjeeva Reddy Institute of Medical Sciences, located in Trovagunta, Ongole, Prakasam District. The inspection was carried out by the Assistant Food Controller, along with a Food Safety Officer. During the inspection, it was found that the kitchen conditions were unhygienic, posing a potential health risk. Furthermore, the premises lacked a valid FSSAI License, which is mandatory for food establishments under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006. In response to these findings, a notice was issued to the management of the institute under Sections 31 and 32 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006. These sections pertain to the maintenance of hygiene and licensing requirements for food businesses. To further ensure the safety of food served, a legal sample of Idly Ravva was taken from the premises, which bore the Code No. 008/PKM/DI/48205/2025. The sample will be sent to the State Food Laboratory in Nacharam, Hyderabad, for analysis. This inspection emphasizes the ongoing efforts to ensure food safety standards are upheld across food establishments. Authorities will continue to monitor and take action against any violations to protect public health and ensure compliance with food safety regulations.

High Court Orders Case Against Former Minister Vidadala Rajini

Court directs police to register FIR within two weeks

The Andhra Pradesh High Court has directed the police to register a case against former minister Vidadala Rajini within two weeks. The court issued these orders while hearing a petition filed by Pilli Koti from Chilakaluripet, who alleged that he was harassed and falsely implicated in cases for questioning Rajini during the previous YSRCP government. In his petition, Pilli Koti claimed that he was beaten up

and that she derived "demonic pleasure" from watching his torture live. He also alleged that she threatened to kill him if he continued to work for the Telugu Desam Party (TDP).

Previously, he had appealed to Palnadu SP Srinivasa Rao to take action against former Chilakaluripet CI Suryanarayana, Rajini's PA, and other officials, but no case was registered. Following police inaction, he approached the High Court, which has now ordered the police to file an FIR and submit details of the case. This legal setback for Rajini comes amid rising political tensions in Andhra Pradesh, as the YSRCP faces growing challenges from the NDA alliance. The court's decision is expected to intensify political by the police at Rajini's behest debates in the state.

AIMSA-FMSW, AP Meets Key Govt Officials to Address FMGs' Issues

- AIMSA-FMSW delegation discusses issues with Special Chief Secretary and Director of Medical Education, AP.
- Officials pledge to expedite Permanent Registrations and address concerns on new compensation letter format.
- FMGs urged to follow other states' practices for verification of compensation certificates.

A delegation from the All India Medical Students' Association - Foreign Medical Students' Wing (AIMSA-FMSW), Andhra Pradesh, met with key government officials, including Special Chief Secretary Sri T. Krishna Babu, IAS, and Dr. DSVL Narsimham, Director of Medical Education, AP, to discuss the pressing concerns of Foreign Medical Graduates (FMGs) in the state. The meeting, following a prior appointment with the Chief Minister, led to several positive assurances, although some concerns remain.

Officials assured the delegation that the process for issuing Permanent Registrations (PRs) to eligible FMGs would be expedited, pending verification of valid compensation letters. They also pledged to issue Temporary Registrations (TRs) and No Objection Certificates (NOCs) promptly, and announced a public notice to clarify counselling guidelines. In line with National Medical



Commission (NMC) regulations, officials indicated plans to revise allotment orders from two or three years to one year.

However, a significant point of contention was the new format for compensation letters required for PR issuance. AIM-SA-FMSW raised concerns about the logistical difficulties in obtaining these letters, especially since universities would need to reissue them in a new format. This could lead to delays, further affecting the timelines for PR issuance. The association emphasized that other states have successfully issued PRs by verifying the genuineness of previously issued compensation certificates, urging Andhra Pradesh to follow a similar approach to avoid further delays.

Officials assured that the new compensation letter format would be available on the APMC website in the next 1-2 days, with the revised process taking effect immediately.

AIMSA-FMSW expressed gratitude for the government's attention to these issues and is hopeful that the revised procedures will enable FMGs to begin their postgraduate studies promptly.

Excise Commissioner Nishanth Kumar Reviews Operations in Machilipatnam and Vuyyuru

- Strict action against illicitly distilled (ID) liquor offenders.
- Application deadline for excise licenses extended to February 8, 2025.
- Emphasis on law enforcement and transparency in excise operations.

Excise Commissioner Nishanth Kumar conducted inspections at the Machilipatnam and Vuyyuru Excise Stations on February 5, 2025, to review the excise department's operations, law enforcement, and the ongoing application process.

During his visit to Machilipatnam, Commissioner Kumar emphasized a zero-tolerance policy for illicitly distilled (ID) liquor and directed officials to take strict action against those involved in such illegal activities. He highlighted the importance of effective implementation of Navodayam 2.0, ensuring that all excise policies were followed diligently. In response to requests from applicants, the application deadline for excise-related licenses has been extended until 5 PM on February 8, 2025, providing them with additional time to complete the process.

At the Vuyyuru Excise Station, Kumar engaged with appli-



cants, receiving positive feedback on the simplified application procedure, which has been streamlined for greater efficiency.

The Commissioner also issued stern directives regarding individuals under "Bind Over" orders. He instructed staff to work closely with Revenue officials to recover bond

amounts from those who persist in criminal activities, reinforcing the seriousness of law enforcement.

Kumar reaffirmed the government's commitment to curbing illegal liquor activities, ensuring transparency in the excise process, and taking proactive steps to maintain law and order.

Heavy Ration Rice Seized In Gannavaram Constituency

- · 26 tons of PDS rice seized in Kotha Mallavalli Industrial Area.
- · Veeravalli Police inspect lorries, uncover illegal transport of rice.
- · Police and revenue officials investigate the case.

In a routine check, the Veeravalli Police seized approximately 26 tons of Public Distribution System (PDS) rice from two Eicher lorries parked in the Kotha Mallavalli Industrial Area under the limits of Veeravalli Police Station in Bapulapadu Mandal. The lorries were found to be carrying around 500 PDS rice bags, which were confiscated during the inspection.

Upon discovering the large quantity of rice, the Veeravalli Police took both lorries into custody and notified the PDS District Team (DT) for further action. Police and revenue officials are currently working together to gather full details regarding the origin and intended destination of the seized rice.

The authorities are continuing their investigation to determine whether this was an illegal diversion of government-subsidized rice meant for public distribution.



Resurvey to Follow Legal and Natural Justice Principles, Says CCLA Chief Commissioner

She also warned that errors would not be tolerated and that strict action would be taken against

those responsible for any lapses. pany. During an inspection, food safety officials accused him of selling adulterated soda and demanded ₹25,000 to drop the case. Unable to bear the pressure, Sai Gokul approached the ACB, which set a trap to catch the officials.

On Wednesday, as Sai Gokul handed over ₹22,000 at the food safety office, ACB officials raided the premises and caught Kavya Reddy and Pullarao red-handed. Upon further investigation, officials found ₹87,000 in cash, tied in six bundles, inside their car.

ACB DSP V Subbaraju stated that the total amount seized was ₹1.9 lakh, and further searches were being conducted at their residences. However, no additional incriminating evidence had been found in their homes so far.



US Navy Successfully Tests High-Energy Laser Weapon, HELIOS



The US Navy has achieved a major milestone in its efforts to incorporate cost-effective laser weaponry into its arsenal. In 2024, the Navy successfully tested its High-Energy Laser with Integrated Optical Dazzler and Surveillance (HELIOS) system aboard the Arleigh Burke-class destroyer USS Preble, marking a significant step towards enhancing the US military's defense capabilities against emerging threats.

HELIOS, developed by Lockheed Martin, is a high-powered laser weapon designed to counter a range of threats, including drones, fast attack boats, and missiles. The system is versatile, offering two modes of attack: Hard Kill, which directly destroys a target, and Soft Kill, which disrupts electronic components to disable enemy systems. According to Lockheed Martin, HELIOS is characterized by its "deep magazine, low cost per kill, speed-of-light delivery, and precision response," with the ability to generate over 60 kilowatts of directed energy, potentially reaching 120 kilowatts with future upgrades.

The successful test saw HELIOS engage an aerial drone, validating its operational capabilities in a real-world setting. While the exact location and date of the test remain classified, a photo included in the Pentagon's annual Director, Operational Test and Evaluation (DOT&E) report captured the moment the laser engaged its target. This test was designed to assess the system's functionality, perfor-


mance, and overall capability.

HELIOS is particularly important because it provides a more affordable alternative to traditional missile defense systems, which rely on costly ammunition. In regions like the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden, where Iranian-backed Houthi rebels have launched drone and missile attacks against US and allied warships, the need for advanced defensive technology is increasingly urgent. Vice Adm. Brendan McLane pointed out that directed-energy weapons, such as HELIOS, could effectively counter asymmetric threats posed by groups like the Houthis.

Despite the success of this test, there are still challenges to overcome. One major hurdle is the power supply required to support high-energy lasers aboard ships. Additionally, environmental conditions such as fog, wind, and other weather factors could impact the performance of the laser. Another challenge is integrating HELIOS with existing defense systems on naval vessels.

The Department of Defense has invested \$1 billion annually into high-energy lasers, and while progress has been slow, the success of HELIOS represents a significant step toward expanding directed-energy weapons in the Navy's arsenal. The ability to disable drones and missiles affordably could fundamentally change naval warfare, reducing reliance on expensive interceptors while providing more efficient defense systems.

The Deep State and the Great Game: Echoes of Power and Espionage



In 1900, Rudyard Kipling wrote *Kim*, placing the titular character at the heart of the Great Game, the covert struggle for control and influence between the British Empire and Tsarist Russia in Central Asia. Set in the late 19th century, the novel explores the complexities of espionage and political intrigue, following Kimball O'Hara, an Irish orphan in Lahore, who becomes embroiled in the shadowy world of spies. Kim befriends a Tibetan lama and is eventually recruited by Mahbub Ali, a Pashtun horse trader working for the British Secret Service, to gather intelligence in Afghanistan and Tibet.

Though the so-called Great Game is often viewed as a period of strategic competition, with British imperialists fearing Russian expansion in Central Asia, the reality of this geopolitical struggle is debated by historians. The British Empire, particularly through figures like

Viceroy George Curzon, depicted Tsarist Russia as a looming threat to British interests in India. National papers, including The Civil and Military Gazette in Lahore and The Statesman in Calcutta, reflected this sentiment, supporting the narrative of Russian encroachment. However, a century later, many historians question the extent and authenticity of the Great Game, suggesting that the geopolitical tensions may have been exaggerated to justify British military and diplomatic endeavors.

The concept of the "deep state" bears striking similarities to the Great Game, both involving shadowy power structures and covert agendas. While the Great Game revolved around imperial interests in Central Asia, the modern discourse surrounding the deep state focuses on the hidden forces that supposedly control or influence national policy and international relations.

Whether or not the deep state truly exists, operates in every country, or connects through global networks like the dark web remains unclear. The idea often becomes a matter of ideological debate rather than empirical analysis.

Some individuals, like former intelligence officers AS Dulat and Asad Durrani, have presented themselves as central figures within the deep state. In their 2018 book *The Spy Chronicles: RAW, ISI and the Illusion of Peace*, they discuss their roles in the tense relationship between India and Pakistan. However, their self-appointed stature as arbiters of this complex geopolitical relationship has drawn heavy criticism. Much like the figures in Kipling's *Kim*, those who claim insider knowledge of shadowy power structures may shape the narrative, but the true extent and influence of these forces remain open to interpretation.

Delhi Assembly Polls 2024: A Three-Way Battle Between AAP, Congress, and BJP

The upcoming Delhi Assembly elections are set to be a fierce three-way contest between the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), and the Indian National Congress (INC). As the first of two crucial state assembly elections this year, the political atmosphere in the national capital is charged with high stakes and intense rivalry.

AAP, led by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, has decided to contest the elections independently, fueling speculation about a possible rift within the opposition alliance, I.N.D.I.A. The party's focus remains on local governance issues, with Kejriwal pushing for demands like reservations for Delhi's Jat community, aiming to garner support from this crucial vote bank. Kejriwal's strategy of playing on regional identity and local concerns is expected to be central to his campaign in the face of strong opposition.

On the other hand, the BJP is banking on issues like the alleged liquor excise policy scam and ongoing pollution problems in Delhi to gain political mileage. The party hopes to capitalize on these issues to secure an edge over AAP, who has been under scrutiny for its handling of both matters. The BJP's national leadership, including figures like Delhi BJP chief Manoj Tiwari, are expected to focus heavily on these local grievances, portraying the AAP as failing in its governance duties.

Meanwhile, Congress, which has struggled to make significant inroads in Delhi in recent years, is attempting to assert itDelhi votes...



self in this election. While the party has distanced itself from any formal alliance with AAP or BJP, it has not hesitated to attack its erstwhile partners. Congress aims to make a comeback by targeting both the AAP and the BJP for their handling of governance issues in the capital, including the state of the economy and social welfare.

With multiple contenders in the fray, the Delhi Assembly election promises to be a high-octane contest, as AAP defends its reign, BJP seeks to capitalize on local issues, and Congress looks to revive its fortunes in the national capital. As the exit polls pour in for the Delhi Assembly elections, the Congress party is staring at yet another electoral disaster, with most projections suggesting a third consecutive wipeout. According to six exit polls, two have predicted that Congress could fail to secure any seats in the Delhi Assembly, continuing its struggle to regain political relevance in the national capital.

The Congress's decline in Delhi began in 2015 when it lost all 70 seats, a result that was replicated in 2020. Once a formidable force under the leadership of Sheila Dikshit, the party has seen its influence erode significantly, with the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) dominating the political scene. This trend is expected to persist, according to the latest exit polls, all of which predict a poor showing for Con-

Exit poll projections for Congress vary slightly, but the consensus remains bleak. Matrize, JVC, and Pmarq predict 0-1 seat for the party, while People's Pulse and WeePreside forecast zero seats. Mind Brink, the only poll showing a glimmer of hope for Congress,

TTD Takes Action Against Employees for Non-Hindu Practices

The Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD), the administrative body overseeing the famous Tirupati temple, has taken significant action against 18 employees for allegedly engaging in non-Hindu religious practices,

despite having taken an oath to uphold the Hindu faith upon joining the institution. These employees have been barred from participating in any religious activities or events related to the temple, which is one of the holiest sites for Hindus.

The TTD board, committed to maintaining the spiritual sanctity of the temple and its activities, has issued orders to transfer these employees to roles outside the reli-

gious operations of the temple. This could involve redeploying them to various government departments or offering them an option for Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS).

TTD Chairman BR Naidu emphasized that the Tirumala temple must remain a symbol of Hindu faith and that the integrity of religious practices must be preserved. According to a statement from the board, the employees in question have been accused of participating in non-Hindu religious practices, which, according to the board, adversely affects the sentiments of millions of Hindu devotees. Their involvement in Hindu religious events like fairs, festivals, and functions, while adhering to non-Hindu practices, has been deemed inappropriate and detrimental to the sanctity of the temple's rituals.



India's AI Ambitions: Minister Vaishnaw Meets OpenAI's Sam **Altman for Key Talks**

Sikkim CM Dismisses Merger Rumors with Darjeeling, Stresses Article 371F Protection

Amid growing rumors about a potential merger between Sikkim and Darjeeling, Sikkim Chief Minister Prem Singh Tamang has firmly denied these claims, labeling them as false. Following a session in the Sikkim Legislative Assembly, the Chief Minister stated that Sikkim's special status under Article 371F of the Indian Constitution would continue to safeguard the state's autonomy.

"This is well-known to every Sikkimese. Even those spreading these rumors have been asked about the merger and they have confirmed it will never happen. It is not possible. The opposition lacks real issues to address, and so they resort to such baseless claims," he asserted.

On Tuesday, during the foundation day celebration of the Sikkim Krantikari Morcha (SKM), Mr. Tamang reiterated his stance,



saying, "There is no merger between Sikkim" and Darjeeling. We are protected by Article

371F. No state can take over Sikkim, and no region can merge with us. Sikkim has its own identity, just as Darjeeling has its own."

The Chief Minister also clarified that the upcoming delegation traveling to New Delhi on February 10 to demand tribal status for 12 marginalized communities would not include representatives from Darjeeling hills. This, he explained, is in contrast to previous delegations, such as the Limboo Tamang tribal status demand in the early 2000s, which did include Darjeeling representation. "The meeting was initially scheduled in Kolkata, as the committee's chairman is from there. However, we decided to change the venue to New Delhi due to our infrastructure at Sikkim House. The Legislative meeting that finalized this decision did not include representatives from Darjeeling," Tamang said. He clarified that only Sikkimese communities would be represented in the upcoming meeting with the concerned minis-

Bidhuri's remarks followed the exit poll projections that placed the BJP in a commanding position, with the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) trailing behind. In a video shared by ANI, he confidently stated, "I don't believe in these exit polls, the



number of our seats will rise further. BJP will cross the 50-seat mark."

Similarly, Parvesh Verma, BJP's candidate from New Delhi, echoed this optimism, stating, "It is certain that Lotus will bloom on 8th February. We will give good governance, clean Yamuna, and employment in Delhi. Arvind Kejriwal is confident that he is losing."

The exit polls from multiple pollsters suggested a clear victory for the BJP. The Matrize Exit Poll forecasted that the BJP would secure between 35 and 40 seats, while the AAP was expected to win between 32 and 37 seats. Congress was predicted to win 0-1 seat.





Elon Musk Given 'Read-Only' Access to Treasury Payments Data

US Treasury confirms access amid concerns over government efficiency reforms.

- Team can view but not alter Treasury payment data as part of a cost-cutting review.
- Democratic lawmakers demand an investigation, citing legal and ethical concerns.
- Lawsuits filed to block Musk's team from accessing taxpayer information.

Elon Musk, the world's wealthiest individual, has been granted "read-only" access to the US Treasury Department's highly sensitive payment system, which manages trillions of dollars in transactions, including Social Security, Medicare payouts, and federal salaries. The move has raised concerns among Democratic lawmakers, prompting calls for an investigation into the decision.

Musk, who is leading the federal cost-cutting initiative under the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE), reportedly pushed for his team to gain access to the Treasury's payment system as part of his efforts to streamline government operations. His request was approved by Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent, allowing Musk's IT executive Tom Krause to lead the team with access to the payment system.

In response to growing concerns, Senators Elizabeth Warren and Ron Wyden sent a letter to the congressional watchdog agency, urging an investigation into how Musk and his team were granted access. The Democratic lawmakers have expressed apprehension over the ethical and legal implications of allowing private individuals, such as Musk, to view government financial data.

The Treasury Department clarified in a letter to Congress that the access granted to Musk's team is "read-only," which



alter it. The department emphasized that this type of access is similar to the permissions granted to auditors reviewing Treasury systems.

Despite this assurance, Democratic lawmakers and labor unions have voiced their opposition to Musk's involvement in the Treasury's operations. Some groups have filed lawsuits against DOGE, arguing that it is illegal for Musk or his team to access personal taxpayer information, demanding that a federal judge block this access.

In a post on X, Musk defended the move, stating that "the only way to stop fraud

means they can view the data but cannot and waste of taxpayer money is to follow the payment flows and pause suspicious transactions for review." Musk's cost-cutting initiative has faced increasing resistance, with critics raising concerns over the potential misuse of sensitive government data.

Could Change History: Israel's Netanyahu On Trump's Gaza Take Over Plan

As China Slaps US With Retaliatory Tariffs, The Trade War Begins

Trade tensions between the United States and China have reached new heights, as China retaliates with counter-tariffs on US imports in response to President Donald Trump's 10% tariff on Chinese goods. The intensification of this trade war has reignited concerns about the impact on the global economy. China's Finance Ministry has condemned the US tariffs, claiming that they violate World Trade Organization (WTO) rules.

In a strongly worded statement, China warned that it may be forced to take additional countermeasures, asserting that there are "no winners in a trade war." In a surprising move, China has also launched an antitrust investigation into Google, accusing the tech giant of monopolistic practices. This probe is seen as a strategic response to the escalating trade conflict, with China's State Administration for Market Regulation alleging that Google violated the country's Anti-Monopoly Law.

The tariffs, which came into effect on Tuesday, are part of President Trump's broader strategy to pressure China into curbing the flow of illicit drugs, particularly fentanyl. The White House stated that the tariffs are intended to hold countries like China accountable for failing to halt illegal immigration and drug trafficking. However, China has countered by urging the US to address the issue from its own perspective and focus on the demand side of fentanyl rather than blaming other countries.

India's Adani Wilmar bets on urban revival, quick grocery delivery to boost growth

SEBI Introduces New Rules for Algorithmic Trading and API Usage

The Securities and Exchange Board of India that prohibited activities, such as market ma-SEBI) has introduced new regulations requiring stock exchanges to empanel algorithmic trading providers and establish guidelines for the use of application programming interfaces (APIs). These steps are part of SEBI's ongoing efforts to streamline the algorithmic trading environment and address the risks posed by existing regulatory gaps.

Algorithmic trading, or algo trading, involves executing trading orders through computer programs that follow predefined rules, enabling traders to place orders at speeds and frequencies far beyond human capabilities. This method is already widely used in India, particularly by institutional investors, but has previously lacked adequate regulatory oversight, leaving room for potential risks and irregularities.

To address these concerns, SEBI has mandated that all algorithmic trading providers must be empaneled by the stock exchanges. This means brokers can only partner with algo trading providers that meet the criteria set by the exchanges. Additionally, brokers must seek approval from the exchanges before implementing algorithmic trading strategies. They will also be required to establish mechanisms for handling grievances and ensuring

A significant development in the new regulations is the formation of a framework by the Brokers' Industry Standards Forum. The forum is tasked with developing a set of industry standards for algorithmic trading, which will be implemented before April 1, 2025. These standards will take effect from August 1, 2025, and will focus on improving transparency and accountability within the algo trading landscape.

These measures are designed to enhance investor protection by closing the loopholes that existed in previous regulations. SEBI's focus on enforcing stricter oversight and requiring exchanges to play a more active role in regulating algorithmic trading is expected to reduce market manipulation risks, improve trading transparency, and increase overall market efficiency.

As algorithmic trading continues to grow in India, these regulatory updates aim to strike a balance between innovation and investor protection, ensuring that the benefits of advanced trading technologies do not come at the expense of market integrity.

Five More Cheetahs Released Into Madhya Pradesh's Kuno National Park

On Wednesday, five adult cheetahs were released into the wild at Kuno National Park (KNP) in Madhya Pradesh, marking another significant step in India's ambitious cheetah reintroduction program. The release took place during a special event attended by Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, organized by the state's Forest Department at the park in She-

The preparation for the cheetah release was meticulously carried out under the supervision of a steering committee and senior forest officials. This marks the second time adult cheetahs have been released into an open boma (enclosure) at KNP. With this release, a total of seven out of 12 adult cheetahs have now been successfully set free in the park, bringing the reintroduction project closer to its goal of restoring cheetah populations in India after their extinction over 70 years ago.

In an exciting development, five-year-old South African cheetah, Veera, gave birth to two healthy cubs just a day before the release, adding to the growing cheetah population at



Kuno. The first batch of cheetahs, consisting of eight individuals brought from Namibia, was released by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 17, 2022. A second batch of 12 cheetahs from South Africa arrived on February 18, 2023.

The Chief Minister expressed optimism that the expanding cheetah population will not only boost wildlife conservation efforts but also positively impact Madhya Pradesh's tourism industry. "With the increase in cheetah numbers, tourism in Madhya Pradesh is getting a boost and opening new doors for employment," he

However, reports suggest that the third batch of 18 cheetahs, scheduled to be relocated from South Africa in February 2025, may face delays as authorities are waiting for updates on the progress of the cheetah population. The new batch is expected to be relocated to both Kuno National Park in Sheopur and Gandhi Sagar in Mandsaur.

India's Project Cheetah is part of a bold conservation effort to reintroduce the species to the country, with plans for further releases and support for their long-term survival.

Woman Scammed of Rs 93,600 While Booking Hotel Through **Fake Google Listing**

Tn a recent online scam, a ■woman lost Rs 93,600 while attempting to book a hotel stay through a fraudulent Google listing. The incident occurred when content creator Shreya Mitra was planning a trip to Puri and searched for hotels online. She came across a listing for Mayfair Heritage Puri and, trusting its legitimacy, clicked on the first result that appeared on Google.

After finding the contact number, Mitra called to inquire about booking a stay, and the scammers provided pictures and details of the room, convincing her to proceed with the payment. They even sent her a fake invoice for the booking. However, when she requested an email confirmation, the fraudsters cited a system outage as an excuse and assured her the booking was secure.

The following day, she received another call from the scammers, instructing her to use Google Pay and enter a provided booking ID to receive confirmation. Sensing something was wrong, Mitra refused to com-



ply and insisted on an official email confirmation. The fraudsters abruptly ended the call, leaving her suspicious of the situation.

Realizing she had been scammed, Mitra took immediate action and searched for the official contact details of Mayfair Heritage Puri. Upon contacting the hotel, she confirmed that the listing she had used was indeed fake.

Mitra shared her experience on Instagram, urging others to be cautious and warning travelers,



especially those looking to book accommodations in the East, to avoid falling for similar scams. She highlighted that the scammers' phone number remains active, and they are using multiple bank accounts to carry out fraudulent transactions.

The fake Google listing has since been taken down by the Cybercrime department, but the incident serves as a reminder to always double-check online listings and verify contact details before making any payments.

Rashid Khan Breaks T20 World **Record, Becomes Highest Wicket-Taker in History**

Afghanistan's Rashid Khan has etched his name in cricket history by surpassing Dwayne Bravo to become the highest wicket-taker in T20 cricket. Rashid achieved this feat during MI Cape Town's Qualifier One match against Paarl Royals in the SA20 league.

During the match, Rashid took 2/34 in four overs, dismissing Dunith Wellalage and Dinesh Karthik, as MI Cape Town successfully defended their total of 200 runs. This took Rashid's overall tally to 633 wickets in 461 matches, at an astonishing average of 18.07, with best figures of 6/17.
