

Delhi Sees Higher Voter Turnout Compared to 2020

Delhi's voter turnout stands at 57.7%, higher than 54.2% in 2020.

> Kejriwal's New Delhi seat records 54.27%

Atishi's 51.81%, Sisodia's Jungpura 55.23%.

Exit polls predict a BJP sweep.

PM in today's assembly election, surpassing the 54.2% recorded during the same period in 2020. The final turnout in the 2020 polls stood at 62.82%, lower than the 67.47% recorded in 2015. The election will determine the fate of 699 candidates contesting across 70 constituencies.

Arvind Kejriwal's New Delhi constituency registered a 54.27% turnout by 5 PM, while Chief Minister Atishi's seat saw 51.81% voting. The Jungpura constituency, previously held by former Deputy CM Manish Sisodia, recorded 55.23%, and Health Minister Saurabh Bharadwaj's Greater Kailash seat saw 52% polling.

Over 1.5 crore eligible voters in Delhi are choosing their representatives in a direct contest between the AAP, BJP, and Congress. While AAP seeks a third consecutive term, the BJP hopes to capitalize on anti-incumbency, and Congress has focused its campaign on the legacy of its 15-year rule under Sheila Dikshit. The polling day saw accusations between AAP and BJP, with AAP alleging money distribution by BJP, while BJP accused AAP of facilitating "fake voters." However, Delhi's Chief Electoral Officer stated that the election process was proceeding smoothly. In the 2020 elections, AAP won 62 seats, BJP secured eight, and Congress failed to win any. Exit polls today predict a BJP sweep in Delhi, with AAP expected to take second place.

TPN Correspondent | New Delhi Exit polls for the 2025 Delhi Assembly elections indicate a major setback for Arvind Kejriwal's Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), with most surveys predicting a shift in voter preference towards the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). Out of seven exit polls, six suggest a BJP victory, while only one gives AAP a slim chance of crossing the halfway mark. According to Matrize, AAP could secure up to 37 seats, just two above the majority mark of 35 in the 70-member assembly. However, other surveys predict a different outcome, with four agencies estimating AAP's seat tally between 15 and 35, while BJP is projected to win between 38 and 40-plus seats. People's Pulse exit poll has forecasted a BJP sweep with 51-60 seats. The aggregate of these polls suggests 26 seats for AAP and 43 for BJP. Congress, which once held sway in Delhi politics, remains on the margins. The highest seat projection for

the party is three, while some exit polls predict zero seats.

While exit polls are not always accurate, they had correctly predicted AAP's victories in the last two elections, albeit underestimating the party's final seat count. This time, however, the mood appears different.

The BJP's campaign focused heavily on corruption allegations against AAP, which had risen to power on an anti-corruption plank. Over the past two years, several AAP leaders, including Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and former Deputy CM Manish Sisodia, have faced legal troubles and jail time over multiple corruption cases.

First Batch of 104 Indians Deported by US Lands in Amritsar

US military aircraft carrying 104 deported Indians landed in Amritsar.

Deportees included 30 each from Punjab, Haryana, and Gujarat.

48 individuals were below the age of 25.

Deportation comes ahead of PM Modi's visit to Washington.

TPN Correspondent | Amritsar A US military aircraft carrying 104 Indian nationals deported from the United States landed at Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport in Amritsar on Wednesday. The deportees, primarily from Punjab, Haryana, and Gujarat, were sent back amid heightened security.

According to officials, the flight, which took off from San Antonio, Texas, also carried 11 crew members and 45 US officials overseeing the deportation. Among the deported individuals, 30 were from Haryana and Gujarat, while 30 others were from Punjab. Additionally, there were two people each from Uttar Pradesh and Chandigarh, and three from Maharashtra. The deportees included 25 women and 12 minors, with the youngest being just four years old. A total of 48 individuals were below the age of 25.

A senior Punjab official stated that

most deportees from the state belonged to districts such as Gurdaspur, Amritsar, Tarn Taran, Jalandhar, Nawanshahr, Patiala, Mohali, and Sangrur. Some of them had entered the US illegally, while others overstayed their visas. The deportation coincided with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's upcoming visit to Washington, marking his first visit since Donald Trump assumed office for a second term.

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar had earlier stated that India was open to the legitimate return of its nationals residing illegally abroad. He conveyed to US Secretary of State Marco Rubio that India was willing to accept these migrants post-verification. President Trump, defending his administration's strict immigration stance, had remarked last month, "For the first time in history, we are locating and loading illegal aliens



into military aircraft and flying them back to the places from which they came."

According to data from the Pew Research Center, nearly 7.25 lakh Indian nationals live in the US illegally, making them the third-largest group of unauthorized immigrants after Mexico and El Salvador. Many of the deportees, particularly from Punjab, had used illegal routes such as the "donkey route" to enter the US by paying large sums of money. The Trump administration has intensified its crackdown on illegal immigration since returning to power.

PM Modi Takes Holy Dip at Maha Kumbh


TPN Correspondent | Bengaluru The 15th edition of Asia's premier aerospace and defence exhibition, Aero India 2025, is set to take place from February 10 to 14 at the Air Force Station in Yelahanka, Bengaluru. The biennial event will showcase India's growing aerospace capabilities, promote global collaborations, and strengthen the country's position

in the global defence industry. The first three days, February 10-12, will be reserved for business engagements, providing Indian and international companies a platform for strategic partnerships and defence agreements. The last two days, February 13-14, will be open to the general public, featuring aerial displays, static exhibitions, and interactive

showcases of advanced military platforms.

Before heading for his dip, the PM urged voters in Delhi to "participate enthusiastically in this festival of democracy and cast their valuable votes." BJP Leaders, Foreign Dignitaries at Maha Kumbh Union Home Minister Amit Shah and his family had also taken a holy dip at the Kumbh last week, just days before the stampede. Meanwhile, Bhutan's King Jigme Khesar Namgyal Wangchuk visited Prayagraj for the Kumbh, taking part in spiritual activities and exploring the Digital Mahakumbh Experience Centre. Weeks before the event, Modi had inaugurated ₹5,500 crore worth of development projects in Prayagraj, including investments in roads, sanitation, and security measures for the Maha Kumbh.

Milkipur Bypoll Records Over 65% Turnout, Surpasses 2022 Figures

The Milkipur assembly bypoll witnessed a voter turnout of over 65% by 5 PM on Wednesday, surpassing the turnout recorded in the 2022 assembly elections. Polling began at 7 AM and concluded at 5 PM, with voters in queue before the deadline allowed to cast their ballots. The final turnout is expected to be higher once the Election Commission releases the updated figures.

The bypoll saw an intense battle be-

tween the Samajwadi Party (SP) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) for the politically significant seat in Ayodhya district. With 3.70 lakh registered voters, the constituency had 4,811 first-time voters, including 1.93 lakh men, over 1.78 lakh women, and eight third-gender voters.

SP chief Akhilesh Yadav alleged fake voting and electoral rigging, posting an audio clip on social media that he claimed exposed a sting operation in-

volving presiding officers facilitating bogus voting for the ruling party. He termed it a "murder of democracy" and called for immediate action.

However, Ayodhya SSP Raj Karan Nayyar dismissed the allegations, clarifying that the image Yadav shared showed police verifying the identity of a polling agent, not voters. IG Pravin Kumar also assured that voting remained peaceful, with paramilitary forces deployed at key polling stations.

Mustafabad emerged as the constituency with the highest voter turnout in the Delhi Assembly elections, recording 56.12% till 3 PM on Wednesday. The riot-affected constituency is witnessing a fierce four-way contest involving the BJP, AAP, Congress, and AIMIM. Overall, Delhi registered a 46.55% turnout, with the Northeast district recording the highest participation at 52.73%, while the New Delhi district saw the lowest at 43.10%. Karol Bagh recorded the lowest turnout among constituencies at 39.05%.

Unlike the traditional AAP-BJP battle, Mustafabad presents a unique contest. The BJP has fielded Mohan Singh Bisht, a five-time MLA from Karawal Nagar, while AAP has nominated journalist-turned-politician Adil Ahmad trol, and economic recovery.

Khan. Congress is banking on Ali Mehdi, son of former MLA Hasan Mehdi, while AIMIM has put forth Tahir Hussain, a former AAP councillor currently jailed for his alleged role in the 2020 Delhi riots.

Tahir Hussain, who was granted sixday custody parole, campaigned under police escort but was barred from visiting his Karawal Nagar home or making public statements regarding his legal cases. The Supreme Court directed him to pay ₹2.47 lakh per day to cover security costs.

Mustafabad, with a 40% Muslim population, is largely home to factory workers, small business owners, and laborers. While the 2020 riots remain a backdrop, key issues for voters include infrastructure, sanitation, crime con-

AAP is seeking a fourth consecutive term, while BJP aims for a comeback after being out of power in Delhi since 1998. Congress, which once dominated the capital, continues to struggle.

How Accurate Were the 2015 and 2020 Delhi Exit Polls?

As polling for the Delhi Assembly elections concludes today, attention now shifts to exit polls, which will predict the likely outcome ahead of the official results on February 8. Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) dominated the last two elections, but how accurate were the exit polls in 2015 and 2020?

2015 Delhi Assembly Election Exit Polls

In 2015, Arvind Kejriwal-led AAP secured a landslide victory, winning 67 out of 70 seats, while the BJP managed only 3, and Congress failed to open its account.

Rahul Gandhi Slams PM Modi, **Calls 'Make in India' a Failure**

Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi launched a fresh attack on Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday, accusing him of failing to deliver on the 'Make in India' initiative. Reacting to Modi's speech during the Motion of Thanks to the President, Gandhi pointed out that the PM did not mention the flagship manufacturing initiative, which he claims has not yielded results. "Prime Minister, in your speech, you didn't even mention 'Make in India'! The prime minister should acknowledge that 'Make in India', although a good initiative, is a failure. Manufacturing has fallen from 15.3% of GDP in 2014 to 12.6% — the lowest in 60 years," Gandhi posted on X. The Congress leader said India's youth desperately need jobs, and neither the

The AAP, which currently holds over 60 seats, is seeking re-election based on its governance record. The New Delhi seat, a high-profile battleground, features a three-way contest between AAP's Arvind Kejriwal, BJP's Parvesh Verma, and Congress's Sandeep Dikshit.

As the exit polls pour in for the Delhi Assembly elections, the Congress party is staring at yet another electoral disaster, with most projections suggesting a third consecutive wipeout. According to six exit polls, two have predicted that Congress could fail to secure any seats in the Delhi Assembly, continuing its struggle to regain political relevance in the national capital.

The Congress's decline in Delhi began in 2015 when it lost all 70 seats, a result that was replicated in 2020. Once a formidable force under the leadership of Sheila Dikshit, the party has seen its influence erode significantly, with the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) dominating the political scene. This trend is expected to persist, according to the latest exit polls, all of which predict a poor showing for Congress.

Exit poll projections for Congress vary slightly, but the consensus remains bleak. Matrize, JVC, and Pmarq predict 0-1 seat for the party, while People's Pulse and WeePreside forecast zero seats. Mind Brink, the only poll showing a glimmer of hope for Congress,



predicts one seat. If these predictions hold hiatus, may stage a major comeback in the true, Congress will once again fail to make its presence felt in the Delhi Assembly. In contrast, the exit polls have painted a more optimistic picture for the BJP and AAP. Three exit polls suggest that the BJP, after a 27-year



Sikkim CM Dismisses Merger Rumors with Darjeeling, Stresses Article 371F Protection

Amid growing rumors about a potential merger between Sikkim and Darjeeling, Sikkim Chief Minister Prem Singh Tamang has firmly denied these claims, labeling them as false. Following a session in the Sikkim Legislative Assembly, the Chief Minister stated that Sikkim's special status under Article 371F of the Indian Constitution would continue to safeguard the state's autonomy.

"This is well-known to every Sikkimese. Even those spreading these rumors have been asked about the merger and they have confirmed it will never happen. It is not possible. The opposition lacks real issues to address, and so they resort to such baseless claims," he asserted.

On Tuesday, during the foundation day celebration of the Sikkim Krantikari Morcha (SKM), Mr. Tamang reiterated his stance,



saying, "There is no merger between Sikkim and Darjeeling. We are protected by Article

371F. No state can take over Sikkim, and no region can merge with us. Sikkim has its own identity, just as Darjeeling has its own."

The Chief Minister also clarified that the upcoming delegation traveling to New Delhi on February 10 to demand tribal status for 12 marginalized communities would not include representatives from Darjeeling hills. This, he explained, is in contrast to previous delegations, such as the Limboo Tamang tribal status demand in the early 2000s, which did include Darjeeling representation. "The meeting was initially scheduled in Kolkata, as the committee's chairman is from there. However, we decided to change the venue to New Delhi due to our infrastructure at Sikkim House. The Legislative meeting that finalized this decision did not include representatives from Darjeeling," Tamang said. He clarified that only Sikkimese communities would be represented in the upcoming meeting with the concerned ministry.

Following the release of exit poll predictions showing a clear majority for the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in the Delhi Assembly elections, Ramesh Bidhuri, BJP's candidate from Kalkaji, expressed strong confidence in his party's victory. He attributed the projected success to what he described as a "Modi wave" and emphasized that the BJP would surpass the 50-seat mark in the Assembly.

The exit polls came soon after the voting concluded across all 70 constituencies in Delhi on February 5, with the majority indicating a BJP-led government in the national capital. "This is Modi wave. The people of Delhi want development just like there has been development across the rest of the country under PM Narendra Modi. The hard work put in by our party workers and the guidance and strategy of our leaders have reaped fruit," Bidhuri said to ANI, reiterating his belief that the BJP's seat count will exceed pro-

jections.

Bidhuri's remarks followed the exit poll projections that placed the BJP in a commanding position, with the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) trailing behind. In a video shared by ANI, he confidently stated, "I don't believe in these exit polls, the



number of our seats will rise further. BJP will cross the 50-seat mark."

Similarly, Parvesh Verma, BJP's candidate from New Delhi, echoed this optimism, stating, "It is certain that Lotus will bloom on 8th February. We will give good governance, clean Yamuna, and employment in Delhi. Arvind Kejriwal is confident that he is losing."

The exit polls from multiple pollsters suggested a clear victory for the BJP. The Matrize Exit Poll forecasted that the BJP would secure between 35 and 40 seats, while the AAP was expected to win between 32 and 37 seats. Congress was predicted to win 0-1 seat.



18 Indian Nationals Rescued from Libya Arrive in New Delhi After Ordeal

A group of 18 Indian nationals, who had been stranded in Libya's Benghazi for several weeks, safely landed in New Delhi early on Wednesday morning, following a successful rescue operation facilitated by the Indian embassy in Libya. The group arrived on a Turkish Airlines flight at the Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport in New Delhi.

The individuals had been lured by fake recruitment agents with promises of lucrative job opportunities in Libya, only to find

themselves stranded and exploited by a contractor, said to be a Libyan national operating from Dubai. They were transported to Libya without visas, making their situation even more complicated.

Upon arriving in Libya, the group of workers, mostly from Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, began working at the Libyan Cement Company's Benghazi plant in September of last year. Their ordeal began after they had a dispute with the contractor over unpaid wages. Following their protest about their working conditions, the workers claimed

they were mistreated and subjected to harsh treatment, with their wages withheld. In addition to these grievances, they alleged that they were physically beaten and kept in confinement under what they described as "prison-like" conditions.

The workers' situation worsened as they had entered the country without proper visas, making their legal status precarious. However, the Indian embassy in Libya intervened and secured their release through an "exit permit mechanism," a process that took time. The Libyan authorities provided assistance during this period, and the embassy ensured the workers' basic daily needs were met while they awaited their departure.

An official from the embassy explained the process, saying, "Since they had no visa, we secured their release through exit permit mechanism, which took some time. We were assisted by the Libyan authorities all along. During that period, our Embassy in Libya took care of them and fulfilled all their basic daily requirements at the Embassy."

This successful operation highlights the Indian government's commitment to protecting its nationals abroad, particularly in regions where they may be vulnerable to exploitation. The Indian embassy's prompt response and cooperation with Libyan authorities ensured the safe return of the workers, marking the end of their harrowing ordeal in Libya.

NIA Arrests Four Naxal Operatives In Chhattisgarh

The arrested individuals, identified as Anish Khan alias Annu Khan, Anil Kumar Netam, Jaysing, and Raghuveer, are Over Ground Workers (OGWs) accused of supporting the terror outfit by providing logistical aid and harboring its members.

Authorities have revealed that the planned attack on a police party was foiled when two armed Maoist cadres were apprehended before they could carry out the assault.

The arrests highlight the NIA's continued efforts to dismantle Maoist networks in Chhattisgarh, where the insurgent group has maintained a presence for years. The CPI (Maoists) is known for carrying out violent attacks against security forces and government establishments in a bid to impose their ideological agenda. The agency's actions have been a part of broader counter-insurgency operations aimed at eliminating Maoist influence in the region.

Maoists Kill Two Men in **Chhattisgarh on Suspicion of Being Police Informers**

Corruption Scandal Unfolds in Bhopal: 52 Kg of Gold and **Rs 11 Crore in Abandoned Car**

Bhopal, the capital city of Madhya Pradesh, has become the epicenter of a sensational corruption scandal that has shocked the nation. The discovery of 52 kilograms of gold and Rs 11 crore in cash from an abandoned car has sparked intense speculation and raised a critical question: Who does it belong to?

At the heart of the investigation is Saurabh Sharma, a former constable with the Madhya Pradesh Transport Department. His case has attracted the attention of multiple investigative agencies, including the Enforcement Directorate (ED), Income Tax Department (IT), Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI), and the Lokayukta police. Sharma's downfall began with a raid in December 2024, which led to the discovery of assets worth nearly Rs 8 crore, including cash, jewellery, and property documents. This was only the beginning of what would unravel into a vast network of corruption.

ED has taken over key parts of the investigation, citing possible violations under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

Despite several agencies being involved in the investigation, no one has come forward to claim the abandoned gold and cash. The car was registered to Chetan Singh Gaur, a close associate of Sharma, but Gaur has denied any involvement, claiming that he merely lent the vehicle to a driver who has yet to be identified. CCTV footage captured the car near Sharma's residence on the night of the raids, but the Lokayukta failed to intercept it, allowing it to be abandoned later. This has led to speculation that insiders may have tipped off the suspects.

As the investigation grows, authorities are now probing potential links to illegal gold smuggling operations. Sharma's financial dealings have raised red flags, with possible connections to Dubai, Switzerland, and Australia. Transactions worth Rs 100 crore have surfaced, impli-Things took a dramatic turn cating transport officials across 52 districts.

According to an official statement from the NIA, these individuals are hardcore members of the CPI (Maoists) and played a crucial role in arranging safe shelters and supplying incriminating materials, including explosives and detonators, to Maoist cadres. The arrests were made in connection with an ongoing investigation into the recovery of arms and explosives from Maoist cadres in the Kuyemelari area committee of the CPI (Maoists) in Kanker district.

The NIA's probe has further uncovered that members of the Maoist group, identified as DVC Sonu and DVC Prasad, were involved in planning attacks and calling for election boycotts in With the arrests of these OGWs. the NIA has significantly weakened the logistical and support networks that facilitate Maoist operations. The agency has assured that the investigation will continue to target the group's members and supporters in a bid to further disrupt their activities.

As the investigation unfolds, the NIA is expected to bring further details to light about the network and the extent of Maoist activity in the region, particularly in the context of the upcoming elections in the state.

The villagers alerted the authorities the following morning, and a police team arrived issued by the Maoist group's Jagargunda area committee was discovered at the location, accusing the victims of working as informers for the police. The pamphlet stated that Raju, who had once been an active Maoist, had surrendered and was leading a normal life in the village. Munna had been targeted before by the Maoists, who had assaulted him after accusing him of working with the police. Munna's elder brother had also been killed by Maoists a few years ago in Potali village, located in the neighbouring Dantewada district.

This gruesome incident highlights the increasing violence in the region, as Maoists have been targeting tribal villagers and accusing them of being cle of violence in the region.

Maoist violence has taken a heavy toll on the local civilian population. In 2024, 68 civilians were killed in Maoist attacks across the Bastar region. However, security forces have had significant success in combating the Maoist insurgency, with 50 Maoists being killed in separate encounters this year alone. Despite these losses, the Maoists continue to target villages and individuals they accuse of collaborating with the authorities, perpetuating a cy-

when a white Toyota Innova was found abandoned in the Mendori jungle near Bhopal, containing the aforementioned gold and cash. What initially began as an investigation into one individual's corruption has now expanded to uncover a broader network involving senior government officials and real estate dealings across Madhya Pradesh.

Adding to the intrigue, discrepancies have emerged in the Lokayukta's reporting of the seized assets. Early claims suggested that Rs 7.98 crore in cash was recovered, but a later statement from a DSP-level officer reduced the amount to just Rs 55 lakh, along with jewellery and silver. These inconsistencies have raised questions of negligence or possibly deliberate misrepresentation in the probe. Consequently, the

The controversy has caught the attention of former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Digvijay Singh, who has called for a judicial probe led by the Chief Justice of the Madhya Pradesh High Court. Singh also criticized the handling of the case and urged for exclusive control of the investigation by the ED and IT Department. Chief Minister Mohan Yadav has defended his administration's efforts, stating that the government remains committed to combating corruption at every level.

For now, Saurabh Sharma, along with his associates Chetan Gaur and others, faces an uncertain future as the investigation continues to unfold.

Hit The Streets Again: RG Kar Victim's Mother Ahead Of Daughter's Birthday

The mother of the junior woman doctor who was raped and murdered at Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital last year has made a heartfelt plea for justice, urging the public to join a protest on February 9, the birthday of her late daughter. In a video message released on Wednesday, the grieving mother, visibly emotional, made an impassioned appeal for the people of West Bengal to take to the streets in support of her fight for justice.

"My daughter died on August 9. Her birthday is on February 9, six months after the horrific incident. We are yet to get justice in the matter. We will be on the streets on February 9. The people have been beside us for the last six months. So I appeal to the people again to hit the streets on February 9," the victim's mother said in the video, while her face, along with her husband's, was blurred for privacy. Her emotional words echoed the deep pain and frustration felt by the family after the tragedy.

In addition to the public protest, the victim's mother also requested that the people of West Bengal honor her daughter's memory by planting flower saplings. "My daughter was very fond of flower saplings. So I request



each of you to plant a sapling either at your home or at your workplace," she said, emphasizing the symbolic importance of this gesture.

The mother made it clear that she and her husband would continue their fight for justice. "We will not be quitting. We will go to the extreme to get justice. Our only goal is to get justice for our daughter," she insisted, expressing their unwavering determination to see the case through.

The parents' stance on the death pen-

alty for the sole accused, Sanjay Roy, has sparked controversy. Despite the proposal for capital punishment from both the West Bengal government and the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), the victim's parents have expressed opposition to the death sentence. This position has led to criticism from several Trinamool Congress leaders, including a controversial remark by party legislator Madan Mitra, who suggested that the family might be seeking compensation rather than focusing solely on justice.





Elon Musk Given 'Read-Only' Access to Treasury Payments Data

US Treasury confirms access amid concerns over government efficiency reforms.

- Team can view but not alter Treasury payment data as part of a cost-cutting review.
- Democratic lawmakers demand an investigation, citing legal and ethical concerns.
- Lawsuits filed to block Musk's team from accessing taxpayer information.

Elon Musk, the world's wealthiest individual, has been granted "read-only" access to the US Treasury Department's highly sensitive payment system, which manages trillions of dollars in transactions, including Social Security, Medicare payouts, and federal salaries. The move has raised concerns among Democratic lawmakers, prompting calls for an investigation into the decision.

Musk, who is leading the federal cost-cutting initiative under the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE), reportedly pushed for his team to gain access to the Treasury's payment system as part of his efforts to streamline government operations. His request was approved by Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent, allowing Musk's IT executive Tom Krause to lead the team with access to the payment system.

In response to growing concerns, Senators Elizabeth Warren and Ron Wyden sent a letter to the congressional watchdog agency, urging an investigation into how Musk and his team were granted access. The Democratic lawmakers have expressed apprehension over the ethical and legal implications of allowing private individuals, such as Musk, to view government financial data.

The Treasury Department clarified in a letter to Congress that the access granted to Musk's team is "read-only," which



alter it. The department emphasized that this type of access is similar to the permissions granted to auditors reviewing Treasury systems.

Despite this assurance, Democratic lawmakers and labor unions have voiced their opposition to Musk's involvement in the Treasury's operations. Some groups have filed lawsuits against DOGE, arguing that it is illegal for Musk or his team to access personal taxpayer information, demanding that a federal judge block this access.

In a post on X, Musk defended the move, stating that "the only way to stop fraud

means they can view the data but cannot and waste of taxpayer money is to follow the payment flows and pause suspicious transactions for review." Musk's cost-cutting initiative has faced increasing resistance, with critics raising concerns over the potential misuse of sensitive government data.

India A Very Important Market For AI, Can Be A **Leading Force: Sam Altman**

The event comes as OpenAI has announced a monumental \$500 billion project called 'Stargate' aimed at building new AI infrastructure in the US over the next four years, alongside major partners like SoftBank, Oracle, and MGX. Altman emphasized that India, with its immense potential, should be a leader in the AI space, particularly in large language models (LLMs).

Altman also addressed his previous comments on India's ability to develop large language models, clarifying that his statement had been "taken out of context." He affirmed that India's growth in AI is possible, acknowledging that while AI models are still expensive, they are becoming more accessible.

Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw spoke about India's ambition to make significant innovations in AI, similar to the success of missions like Chandrayaan. He highlighted the country's drive to bring AI solutions that reduce costs, making them more accessible to entrepreneurs, researchers, and students. In line with this vision, the Indian government is working towards launching an indigenous AI model within the next six months. This model aims to be not only safe and secure but also affordable, positioning India as a leading global player in ethical AI solutions.

The IndiaAI initiative is rapidly progressing, with efforts underway to customize AI solutions that address the unique needs of the Indian context, including Indian languages. Scientists, researchers, and developers are currently working on foundational models, and the AI computation facility has already been equipped with 10,000 GPUs. Additional GPUs are set to be added to further enhance the model's capacity.

As China Slaps US With

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu made headlines on Tuesday when he praised US President Donald Trump's proposal for the United States to take control over the Palestinian territory of Gaza. Speaking at a joint press conference held at the White House, Netanyahu described the plan as an idea that could "change history."

Netanyahu's remarks came as he responded to Trump's suggestions, which have raised eyebrows internationally. He emphasized the significance of the proposal, hinting at the potential transformative effect it could have on the region. While Netanyahu did not go into extensive detail, he stressed that it was a development that deserved serious consideration, acknowledging the gravity of the moment.

The idea, if implemented, would mark a dramatic shift in the longstanding geopolitical situation in Gaza and the broader Israeli-Palestinian conflict. Since the early 2000s, Gaza has been a flashpoint for tensions, with the Palestinian group Hamas controlling the area, leading to frequent conflicts and humanitarian concerns. The US plan, by potentially placing the region under American oversight, would be a historic departure from previous strategies and proposals surrounding the governance and future of the territory.

Netanyahu's statement hints at the evolving dynamics of Israeli politics and its relationship with the United States. Trump's administration has been a vocal supporter of Israel, and this latest proposal is seen by some as a further deepening of the bond between the two countries. However, the plan's implications could extend far beyond bilateral relations, affecting the broader Middle East peace process and the ongoing struggles of the Palestinian people.

The White House press conference, held at a critical time in the Middle East, signaled the possibility of a new direction in US foreign policy under Trump's leadership, particularly in relation to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. While the exact details of the plan remain unclear, Netanyahu's endorsement of it suggests that Israel may be open to significant changes in how the region is governed in the future.



Tulsi Gabbard Clears Senate Intelligence Committee Vote for DNI Nomination

Former U.S. Representative Tulsi Gabbard has passed a significant hurdle in her bid to become the next Director of National Intelligence (DNI), clearing the Senate Intelligence Committee vote. The vote, which was closely contested, passed 9-8 along party lines, bringing Gabbard one step closer to full Senate confirmation.

After the vote, Senate Intelligence Committee Chair Tom Cotton (R-Ark.) expressed his confidence in Gabbard's nomination, saying, "The Intelligence Committee just voted for Tulsi Gabbard's nomination to be the Director of National Intelligence favourably to the full United States Senate. We look forward to her confirmation and working with her to keep America safe." This marks a crucial moment in Gabbard's journey to leading the U.S. intelligence community, a position responsible for overseeing the nation's 17 intelligence agencies.

The vote came on the heels of an important announcement from Senator Todd Young (R-Ind.), a pivotal swing vote in the process. Young publicly declared his support for Gabbard, endorsing her nomination via social media. He praised her ability to engage with him on key issues, ensuring that U.S. intelligence professionals would be supported under her leadership and that policymakers would receive unbiased information. His endorsement played a significant role in tipping the balance in favor of Gabbard's nomination.

Gabbard, who served as a U.S. Representative from Hawaii from 2013 to 2021, has been a prominent figure in American politics. Known for her independent views, she has often taken a more non-interventionist stance on foreign policy and criticized U.S. military involvement abroad. Her nomination to lead the U.S. intelligence community has garnered attention for her unconventional political career and her potential to reshape how intelligence is gathered and analyzed at the highest levels of government.

Retaliatory Tariffs, The Trade War Begins

Trade tensions between the United States and China have reached new heights, as China retaliates with counter-tariffs on US imports in response to President Donald Trump's 10% tariff on Chinese goods. The intensification of this trade war has reignited concerns about the impact on the global economy. China's Finance Ministry has condemned the US tariffs, claiming that they violate World Trade Organization (WTO) rules.

In a strongly worded statement, China warned that it may be forced to take additional countermeasures, asserting that there are "no winners in a trade war." China's Permanent Representative to the United Nations, Ambassador Fu Cong, criticized the US decision, calling it an "unwarranted increase" and affirming that it breaches international trade norms.

To counter the US tariffs, China has imposed its own set of retaliatory measures. These include a 15% tariff on US coal and liquefied natural gas exports, as well as a 10% tariff on crude oil, agricultural machinery, and large-displacement cars. These new tariffs are set to take effect on February 10. Additionally, China has implemented export controls on rare metals, such as tungsten, tellurium, ruthenium, and molybdenum, citing national security concerns.

In a surprising move, China has also launched an antitrust investigation into Google, accusing the tech giant of monopolistic practices. This probe is seen as a strategic response to the escalating trade conflict, with China's State Administration for Market Regulation alleging that Google violated the country's Anti-Monopoly Law.

The tariffs, which came into effect on Tuesday, are part of President Trump's broader strategy to pressure China into curbing the flow of illicit drugs, particularly fentanyl. The White House stated that the tariffs are intended to hold countries like China accountable for failing to halt illegal immigration and drug trafficking. However, China has countered by urging the US to address the issue from its own perspective and focus on the demand side of fentanyl rather than blaming other countries.

The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has presented a record-breaking budget of over Rs 74,000 crore for the financial year 2025-26. This budget, described as the "biggest budget" in the civic body's history, was unveiled by BMC Commissioner Bhushan Gagrani on Tuesday. A significant highlight of this year's budget is the proposal for the construction of a giant Ferris wheel, dubbed the *Mumbai Eye*, inspired by London's city, offering visitors a unique

The *Mumbai Eye* will be built under a public-private partnership (PPP) model. Though no specific budget has been allocated for the project yet, the BMC intends to bring this ambitious plan to life in the near future. The location of the Ferris wheel is still to be decided, but the project is likely to occupy about two to three acres of land. The *Mumbai Eye* is expected to provide a breathtaking bird's eye view of the perspective of India's financial capital.

The Ferris wheel will feature air-conditioned, sealed passenger capsules, ensuring a comfortable experience for tourists and locals alike. The project was initially proposed in 2008 by Shiv Sena leader Ravindra Waikar. In 2022, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMR-DA) suggested constructing the wheel at the Bandra Reclamation promenade, but the plan was put on hold due to opposition from local residents. Now, with the BMC revisiting the idea, it remains to be seen where the final location will be determined.

The BMC's budget for the upcoming financial year is being touted as a "citizen-centric" one, with an emphasis on shaping the future of Mumbai. According to Commissioner Gagrani, this budget aims to reflect the corporation's commitment to innovation, inclusivity, and sustainability. It also seeks to provide the best civic services and amenities to citizens at minimal or no cost, ensuring these are accessible in real time.







US Navy Successfully Tests High-Energy Laser Weapon, HELIOS



The US Navy has achieved a major milestone in its efforts to incorporate cost-effective laser weaponry into its arsenal. In 2024, the Navy successfully tested its High-Energy Laser with Integrated Optical Dazzler and Surveillance (HELIOS) system aboard the Arleigh Burke-class destroyer USS Preble, marking a significant step towards enhancing the US military's defense capabilities against emerging threats.

HELIOS, developed by Lockheed Martin, is a high-powered laser weapon designed to counter a range of threats, including drones, fast attack boats, and missiles. The system is versatile, offering two modes of attack: Hard Kill, which directly destroys a target, and Soft Kill, which disrupts electronic components to disable enemy systems. According to Lockheed Martin, HELIOS is characterized by its "deep magazine, low cost per kill, speed-of-light delivery, and precision response," with the ability to generate over 60 kilowatts of directed energy, potentially reaching 120 kilowatts with future upgrades.

The successful test saw HELIOS engage an aerial drone, validating its operational capabilities in a real-world setting. While the exact location and date of the test remain classified, a photo included in the Pentagon's annual Director, Operational Test and Evaluation (DOT&E) report captured the moment the laser engaged its target. This test was designed to assess the system's functionality, perfor-


mance, and overall capability.

HELIOS is particularly important because it provides a more affordable alternative to traditional missile defense systems, which rely on costly ammunition. In regions like the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden, where Iranian-backed Houthi rebels have launched drone and missile attacks against US and allied warships, the need for advanced defensive technology is increasingly urgent. Vice Adm. Brendan McLane pointed out that directed-energy weapons, such as HELIOS, could effectively counter asymmetric threats posed by groups like the Houthis.

Despite the success of this test, there are still challenges to overcome. One major hurdle is the power supply required to support high-energy lasers aboard ships. Additionally, environmental conditions such as fog, wind, and other weather factors could impact the performance of the laser. Another challenge is integrating HELIOS with existing defense systems on naval vessels.

The Department of Defense has invested \$1 billion annually into high-energy lasers, and while progress has been slow, the success of HELIOS represents a significant step toward expanding directed-energy weapons in the Navy's arsenal. The ability to disable drones and missiles affordably could fundamentally change naval warfare, reducing reliance on expensive interceptors while providing more efficient defense systems.

Echoes of Power and Espionage



In 1900, Rudyard Kipling wrote *Kim*, placing the titular character at the heart of the Great Game, the covert struggle for control and influence between the British Empire and Tsarist Russia in Central Asia. Set in the late 19th century, the novel explores the complexities of espionage and political intrigue, following Kimball O'Hara, an Irish orphan in Lahore, who becomes embroiled in the shadowy world of spies. Kim befriends a Tibetan lama and is eventually recruited by Mahbub Ali, a Pashtun horse trader working for the British Secret Service, to gather intelligence in Afghanistan and Tibet.

Though the so-called Great Game is often viewed as a period of strategic competition, with British imperialists fearing Russian expansion in Central Asia, the reality of this geopolitical struggle is debated by historians. The British Empire, particularly through figures like

Viceroy George Curzon, depicted Tsarist Russia as a looming threat to British interests in India. National papers, including The Civil and Military Gazette in Lahore and The Statesman in Calcutta, reflected this sentiment, supporting the narrative of Russian encroachment. However, a century later, many historians question the extent and authenticity of the Great Game, suggesting that the geopolitical tensions may have been exaggerated to justify British military and diplomatic endeavors.

The concept of the "deep state" bears striking similarities to the Great Game, both involving shadowy power structures and covert agendas. While the Great Game revolved around imperial interests in Central Asia, the modern discourse surrounding the deep state focuses on the hidden forces that supposedly control or influence national policy and international relations. Whether or not the deep state truly exists, operates in every country, or connects through global networks like the dark web remains unclear. The idea often becomes a matter of ideological debate rather than empirical analysis.

Some individuals, like former intelligence officers AS Dulat and Asad Durrani, have presented themselves as central figures within the deep state. In their 2018 book *The Spy Chronicles: RAW, ISI and the Illusion of Peace*, they discuss their roles in the tense relationship between India and Pakistan. However, their self-appointed stature as arbiters of this complex geopolitical relationship has drawn heavy criticism. Much like the figures in Kipling's *Kim*, those who claim insider knowledge of shadowy power structures may shape the narrative, but the true extent and influence of these forces remain open to interpretation.

To address these concerns, SEBI has mandated that all algorithmic trading providers must be empaneled by the stock exchanges. This means brokers can only partner with algo trading providers that meet the criteria set by the exchanges. Additionally, brokers must seek approval from the exchanges before implementing algorithmic trading strategies. They will also be required to establish mechanisms for handling grievances and ensuring

nipulation, are monitored and avoided

A significant development in the new regulations is the formation of a framework by the Brokers' Industry Standards Forum. The forum is tasked with developing a set of industry standards for algorithmic trading, which will be implemented before April 1, 2025. These standards will take effect from August 1, 2025, and will focus on improving transparency and accountability within the algo trading landscape.

These measures are designed to enhance investor protection by closing the loopholes that existed in previous regulations. SEBI's focus on enforcing stricter oversight and requiring exchanges to play a more active role in regulating algorithmic trading is expected to reduce market manipulation risks, improve trading transparency, and increase overall market efficiency.

As algorithmic trading continues to grow in India, these regulatory updates aim to strike a balance between innovation and investor protection, ensuring that the benefits of advanced trading technologies do not come at the expense of market integrity.

The Chief Minister expressed optimism that the expanding cheetah population will not only boost wildlife conservation efforts but also positively impact Madhya Pradesh's tourism industry. "With the increase in cheetah numbers, tourism in Madhya Pradesh is getting a boost and opening new doors for employment," he However, reports suggest that the third batch of 18 cheetahs, scheduled to be relocated from South Africa in February 2025, may face delays as authorities are waiting for updates on the progress of the cheetah population. The new batch is expected to be relocated to both Kuno National Park in Sheopur and Gandhi Sagar in Mandsaur.

India's Project Cheetah is part of a bold conservation effort to reintroduce the species to the country, with plans for further releases and support for their long-term survival.

Realizing she had been scammed, Mitra took immediate action and searched for the official contact details of Mayfair Heritage Puri. Upon contacting the hotel, she confirmed that the listing she had used was indeed fake.

Mitra shared her experience on Instagram, urging others to be cautious and warning travelers,

especially those looking to book accommodations in the East, to avoid falling for similar scams. She highlighted that the scammers' phone number remains active, and they are using multiple bank accounts to carry out fraudulent transactions.

The fake Google listing has since been taken down by the Cybercrime department, but the incident serves as a reminder to always double-check online listings and verify contact details before making any payments.
