A significant number of votes have been declared invalid in the Telangana Legislative Council election from the Medak-Nizamabad-Adilabad-Karimnagar Graduates' constituency, as the counting process continued for the second consecutive day on Tuesday.

According to election officials, more than 21,000 votes were deemed invalid due to errors in marking preferences on the ballot papers. Many voters wrote their preferences in words instead of numbers, leading to their votes being rejected. The counting staff has

However, with the new state in-charge making it clear that senior Congress members will be given precedence, it appears that the high command is taking steps to checkmate Revanth Reddy's influence within the party.

Further fueling the controversy, BJP MLA Maheshwar Reddy recently made a sensational statement, claiming that Meenakshi Natarajan was appointed with the specific agenda of replacing the Chief Minister. His remarks have added weight to the speculation that the Congress leadership is planning a major political shake-up in Telangana.

Senior Congress leader and Nalgonda MP Uttam Kumar Reddy also made a noteworthy comment, suggesting that the appointment of a new in-charge is part of a well-crafted master plan. He went on to predict that a change in the Chief Minister's post is inevitable and is likely to happen between June and August.

The growing dissent within the Congress has created uncertainty in the party's leadership in Telangana. Many grassroots workers and leaders are deeply concerned that these internal conflicts could weaken the party's hold on power. The differences between the Revanth faction and senior Congress loyalists have only widened in recent weeks, and with the high command now intervening, the situation appears to be heading towards a major political showdown.

As the internal battle intensifies, all eyes are now on the Congress leadership in Delhi to see how they will handle the crisis. Will Revanth Reddy manage to retain his grip on power, or will the party opt for a leadership change to quell the ongoing strife? The coming months will be crucial in shaping the future of the Congress party in Telangana.

Large Number of Votes Declared Invalid in Graduates' MLC Election

that the counting of first-preference votes will begin after the sorting process is completed. If a candidate secures more than 50 percent of the first-preference votes, they will be declared the winner. Otherwise, second-preference votes will be counted to determine the winner. The contest in the Medak-Nizamabad-Adilabad-Karimnagar Graduates' constituency is seen as a direct battle between the ruling Congress party and the opposition BJP. Congress has fielded V. Narender Reddy, who is pitted against BJP's C. Anji Reddy. This seat is currently held by senior Congress leader and former minister T. Jeevan Reddy.

Meanwhile, results have been announced for the teachers' constituencies, where the BJP-backed candidate Malka Komaraiah won the Medak-Nizamabad-Adilabad-Karimnagar teachers' seat with a margin of over 5,700 first-preference votes. Komaraiah secured 12,959 votes, while his nearest rival Vanga Mahender Reddy of the PRTU (TS) polled 7,182 votes. Of the total 25,041 votes polled, 897 votes were declared invalid.

In the Warangal-Khammam-Nalgonda teachers' constituency, PRTU (TS) candidate P. Sripal Reddy won after the second-preference vote count, securing 13,969 votes. Sitting MLC Narsi Reddy of UTF finished second in the race. Out of 25,797 registered voters, 24,135 cast their ballots.

The BJP, which contested in all three constituencies, celebrated its victory in the Medak-Nizamabad-Adilabad-Karimnagar teachers' seat. Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay Kumar said that teachers had placed their trust in the BJP. He accused the Congress and BRS of having a secret understanding to defeat the BJP but claimed that their efforts had failed.

Bandi Sanjay, who is also a Member of Parliament from Karimnagar, asserted that the BJP's victory in the teachers' constituency was a sign of growing support for the party in Telangana. He expressed confidence that the BJP would come to power in the state in the near future.

Telangana Government Issues Key Directives on Yassangi Crop and Water Management



ED Files Prosecution Complaint in MMTC Ltd Fraud Case Involving Rs 504.34 Crore

Hyderabad, Mar 05: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has filed a prosecution complaint before the Special Court (PMLA), Hyderabad, against MBS Jewellers, Musaddilal Gems & Jewels, and others for defrauding MMTC Ltd. of Rs 504.34 crore in a gold purchase scam. The court accepted the complaint on March 1.

The case stems from an investigation initiated by the CBI's Anti-Corruption Bureau, Hyderabad, against Sukesh Gupta and his companies for allegedly obtaining gold bullion from MMTC on a buyer's credit ba-

sis without fulfilling the necessary margin money requirements. This caused a loss of Rs 549.06 crore to MMTC.

Sukesh Gupta, the mastermind of the fraud, used his companies to mislead MMTC officers, continuing to receive gold despite outstanding payments. He diverted the proceeds from the gold sales to various entities within his business group.

ED had previously conducted searches at Gupta's residences and business premises, seizing jewellery and cash worth Rs 149.10 crore and Rs 1.96 crore, respectively, and attaching assets worth Rs 363.50 crore.

Hyderabad Police Arrest Serial Offender Linked to 21 Cases

Hyderabad, Mar 05: A 32-year-old serial offender, identified as Jabri, was arrested by the Hyderabad police on Tuesday for his involvement in 21 criminal cases, including forgery, land grabbing, attempted murder, and cheating. Modi Govt's Plan for the 'World's Largest Museum' Raises Many Red Flags

The Narendra Modi government's ambitious plan to create the "largest museum in the world," the Yuga Yugeen Bharat National Museum (YYBNM), in partnership with France has sparked significant debate. While details remain scarce due to a cloud of secrecy, early proposals and public statements suggest that the museum may serve as a platform to align India's history with the BJP's ideological agenda, which emphasizes Hinduism as eternal, portrays Muslim rulers as villains, and promotes 'Bharat' as the origin of modern concepts like democracy.

The YYBNM will be housed in the North and South Block buildings, part of the Central Vista Project, and will be a massive through of the YYBNM at the Internation-1,55,000 square meters in size. This move has generated excitement due to the museum's scale and its collaboration with France. However, concerns have emerged about the lack of transparency surrounding the museum's design and curatorial direction. The Ministry of Culture has refrained from answering detailed queries, and there is little clarity about the budget, design plans, or how artifacts will be transported and stored.

The Challenges and Future of Manipur Under President's Rule



With President's Rule now in place in Manipur, it is crucial to assess the underlying forces that have shaped the state's political landscape and what this new development means for its future. The imposition of central rule, combined with the resignation of Chief Minister N. Biren Singh, has sparked both hope and skepticism regarding the resolution of the ongoing ethnic conflict that has plagued the state since May 2023.

What next after President's Rule?

While the removal of N. Biren Singh is seen by many as a necessary step toward peace talks, the Kuki-Zomi groups are skeptical that a new Chief Minister, regardless of their background, can bridge the deep divides. A non-Maitei Chief Minister is unlikely, and even then, such a leader may not be seen as a neutral party. The Kuki-Zomi communities have long felt marginalized by the Maitei-dominated government, and this tension traces back to historical grievances over territorial and cultural rights.

The Kuki-Zomi groups have welcomed President's Rule, viewing it as a potential opportunity to address the root causes of the ethnic violence that has simmered for decades. The Zomi Council, in a February 2025 statement, highlighted the need for a careful evaluation of the discriminatory and communal administration that contributed to the current crisis. However, protests have erupted in the Maitei-dominated valley districts, where demands for the rollback of



President's Rule underscore the ongoing divisions within the state.

The historical context is key to understanding the current unrest. In 2015, under N. Biren Singh's leadership, the government introduced controversial bills that bypassed tribal consultations, fueling protests and violence. The fallout from these bills continues to impact the political landscape, with the Kuki-Zomi groups seeing the bills as a direct attack on their rights and autonomy.

For the central government, the path forward involves addressing conflicting narratives and reconciling deeply entrenched divisions. While talks and ceasefire agreements between the government and Kuki-Zomi groups provide a framework for dialogue, the government's challenge is to create a more inclusive solution. The possibility of granting greater autonomy to tribal areas under constitutional provisions is one option, but this will require careful consideration and input from all stakeholders.

Ultimately, the government's success in Manipur will depend on its ability to engage in meaningful dialogue and offer a politically viable solution that promotes peace and national integration.



Is China Driving Trump Towards Putin?

In a surprising turn of events, US President Donald Trump's foreign policy has been increasingly shaped by his focus on China, shifting away from traditional alliances and concerns about Russia. Trump's decision to abandon Ukraine and ease tensions with Russia has raised questions about his strategy, especially after his confrontation with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky at the White House. Despite European leaders pushing for stronger support for Ukraine, Trump remains angered with Zelensky, pausing military aid and refusing to commit to further support.

Trump's primary goal appears to be isolating China, which he considers the United States' main strategic threat. His administration's actions, including tariffs on Chinese goods and efforts to secure critical minerals from countries like Ukraine, reveal a clear pattern. China controls over 60% of vital minerals, such as lithium and cobalt, essential for modern technology and military applications. Trump is particularly concerned about China's dominance in these sectors and has been working to secure alternative sources of supply, including deals with Ukraine, which possesses large reserves of critical min-

Trump's stance on Russia also appears to be driven by his desire to wean Moscow away from China, reminiscent of the US strategy to split the Soviet Union and China in the 1970s. He aims to rebuild US-Russia relations, with discussions about potentially readmitting Russia to the G-7 once a peace deal with Ukraine is reached. However, European leaders remain cautious, viewing Russia as a persistent security threat.

As for China, Trump's policies are framed by national security concerns, including the exploitation of US technology and the destabilizing impact of Beijing's global economic practices. His administration has also ramped up actions to combat the import of fentanyl from China, further complicating the relationship.

For India, Trump's shifting foreign policy could be a double-edged sword. While the potential thaw in US-Russia relations could ease New Delhi's concerns over Moscow's growing ties with Beijing, India must navigate its own complex relationship with China.

Insiders, outsiders, and land, Uttarakhand closes off while J&K opens up



Uttarakhand has joined the growing list of states in India that have imposed restrictions on the purchase of agricultural land by outsiders. Following in the footsteps of states like Himachal Pradesh, Nagaland, and Sikkim, the Uttarakhand government has introduced the Uttarakhand (Uttar Pradesh Zamindari Abolition and Land Reforms Act, 1950) (Amendment) Act, aiming to protect the state's resources, cultural heritage, and identity. Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami heralded the move as a historic step to safeguard the region's "original identity."

However, the new legislation has sparked tensions between the hill districts and the plains, particularly in areas like Haridwar and Udham Singh Nagar, which have been excluded from the new law's scope. Critics argue that the law has deepened the divide between highlanders and plainspeople, with many in the plains opposing the provisions.

Uttarakhand's land ownership laws have evolved over time, reflecting the state's unique geography and history. Before it became a separate state in 2000, Uttarakhand was part of Uttar Pradesh, where landholdings were largely governed by the Zamindari system. Under British rule, the region saw a mixture of systems, with peasants in hill districts holding proprietary rights to land. After independence, the UP Zamindari Abolition Act, 1950, impacted these areas, leading to reforms in land ownership. Following the creation of Uttarakhand, there were demands for a law similar to Himachal Pradesh's, which restricts non-residents from purchasing land.





Very big step': India, Belgium aim to seal defence cooperation pact this year

India and Belgium aim to finalize a defence agreement Proposed a task force to accelerate the agreement process.

India and Belgium are working towards finalizing a defence agreement by the end of this year to enhance cooperation between their armed forces and strengthen defence industrial collaboration. This announcement was made by Belgian Defence Minister Theo Francken on Tuesday during a media briefing in New Delhi.

Francken, alongside Belgian Foreign Minister Maxime Prévot, was part of a delegation led by Princess Astrid, which met with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi. During the briefing, Francken described the agreement as a "very big step" towards establishing structural cooperation between the two countries' armed forces and creating a framework for collaboration between their defence industries. Prime Minister Modi proposed the formation of a task force to expedite the process,

urging both sides to finalize the agreement as soon as possible. "Your prime minister asked us to form the task force here in New Delhi and in Brussels to conclude the agreement before the end of the year," Francken shared. In addition, Belgium plans to appoint a defence attaché at its embassy in New Delhi, which will serve as a point of contact for India's military and defence industries.

Francken emphasized the importance of mutual growth in defence capabilities between the two nations. He noted that both countries could learn from each other in terms of military technology, and he reiterated the need for "peace through strength" in today's geopolitical landscape.

Foreign Minister Prévot highlighted the evolving global situation, mentioning the shifting policies of the U.S. administration. He stressed the need to

Accused seen dragging suitcase with Congress worker's body inside

- CCTV footage shows accused hauling suitcase on deserted road

Days after Congress worker Himani Narwal was found murdered and stuffed inside a suitcase, chilling CCTV footage has surfaced showing the accused dragging the luggage on a deserted road.

The footage, recorded at 10:16 pm on February 28, shows a masked man hauling a hard-shell black suitcase. The body of Narwal, who was in her late 20s, was found near the Rohtak bus stand on Saturday.

The accused, Sachin, believed to be a friend of the victim, was arrested earlier today. Police say he allegedly strangled Narwal with a mobile phone charger after a heated argument. Additional DGP K K Rao stated that there was a monetary issue between them, but the

exact details are yet to be confirmed. "After strangling her, Sachin took her jewellery and laptop, rode her scooter to Jhajjar to hide these items, and later returned to her home," said Mr Rao. He then stuffed her body into a suitcase, took an auto-rickshaw, and dumped the bag near the Sampla bus stand to mislead investigators.

Narwal was cremated on Monday evening after her family initially refused to perform the last rites until the accused was arrested.

Former Haryana Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda spoke to Rohtak's Superintendent of Police regarding the investigation. Congress MLA BB Batra described Narwal as an active party worker and demanded strict punishment for those responsible for her

Calling someone 'Miyan-Tiyan' or 'Pakistani' not an offence

SC closes case, says remarks may be in poor taste but not illegal

The Supreme Court on Tuesday ruled that calling someone 'Miyan-Tiyan' or 'Pakistani' may be inappropriate but does not constitute an offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC). A bench of Justices BV Nagarathna and Satish Chandra Sharma made the observation while quashing a case against a man accused of using the terms against a government servant in Jharkhand.

The complaint was filed by an Urdu translator and acting clerk, who alleged that the accused had insulted



was furnishing information related to a Right To Information (RTI) application. The FIR against the accused

included charges under IPC Sections 298 (hurting religious sentiments), 504 (insult intended to provoke breach of peace), and 353 (assault or criminal force to deter a public servant from duty). However, the Supreme Court overturned a previous Jharkhand High Court order, stating that while the remarks were in poor taste, they did not amount to hurting religious sentiments. The bench observed that there was no act on the accused's part

him based on his religion while he that could have incited violence or a breach of peace.

With this ruling, the case against the accused has been dismissed.

Bihar budget inflated, written with ink dipped in lies": Tejashwi Yadav

RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav on Monday strongly criticized the Bihar Budget 2025-26, calling it "inflated" and drafted with "ink dipped in lies." He claimed that the BJP-led NDA government was misleading people with exaggerated figures and that the ruling alliance would be voted out in the upcoming elec-

Shortly after Deputy Chief Minister Samrat Choudhary presented the budget, Yadav told reporters outside the Vidhan Sabha that the ₹3.71 lakh-crore budget was unrealistic. "Despite no revenue generation, the budget size keeps increasing. They could have made it ₹5 lakh crore as well, given the way they fabricate numbers," he said.

He further termed the budget a "lost opportunity" for the NDA, stating that it failed to introduce pro-people measures. "We had urged the government to announce a ₹2,500 monthly stipend for women and 200 units of free electricity. They missed the chance, but the RJD will ensure these benefits when we form the next government," he asserted.

Yadav also took a swipe at Chief Minister Nitish Kumar for appreciating Choudhary inside the House. "This is his style. Whenever he is with younger leaders, he says in a self-effacing manner—'the future belongs to you.' But people have seen through his politics," Yadav remarked, recalling how Kumar had once called him his political successor before suddenly switching sides to the BJP.

Turning War Into Graft Meat Grinder": Elon Musk Calls Zelensky "Evil"

Billionaire entrepreneur Elon Musk has launched a sharp attack on Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, calling him "evil" and accusing him of deliberately extending the war with Russia for personal and political gain. Musk's remarks came in response to a Truth Social post by former US President Donald Trump, who criticized Zelensky's handling of the conflict.


"Zelensky wants a forever war, a never-ending graft meat grinder. This is evil," Musk posted on X, echoing Trump's frustration. The statement coincided with Trump's decision to suspend military aid to Ukraine, further pressuring Kyiv to consider peace negotiations. Trump also warned that he would not tolerate Zelensky's stance much longer, stating that the Ukrainian leader should be more grateful for US support.

Reports suggest Trump is pushing Zelensky to enter peace talks, but diplomatic progress remains uncertain. Tensions between the two leaders have intensified, especially after a contentious White House meeting attended by US Vice President JD Vance. Zelensky's recent statement that an end to the war remains "very, very far away" further fueled the rift. Trump labeled the remark "the worst statement that could have been made," warning that US patience was wearing thin.

Musk, a long-time critic of Zelensky, reiterated his belief that the Ukrainian leader is rejecting opportunities for peace. "Two years ago, I said Ukraine should seek peace or suffer severe loss of life for no gains. The latter was Zelensky's choice. Now, he wants to do that again. This is cruel and inhumane," Musk wrote on X.

Musk has previously accused Zelensky of exploiting the war, alleging without evidence that he operates a "massive graft machine feeding off the dead bodies of Ukrainian soldiers." He suggested that Zelensky's reluctance to end the conflict stems from his desire to maintain international attention and financial support. A week earlier, Musk reignited criticism of Zelensky by mocking his 2022 Vogue photoshoot with First Lady Olena Zelenska. The photos, taken in war-ravaged Ukraine, were meant to highlight the country's resilience. "He did this while kids are dying in trenches on the war front," Musk commented on X, reacting to the resurfaced images.

Russia lauds 'best contribution' by US as Trump freezes Ukraine aid amid war

Russia has welcomed the United States' decision to pause military aid to Ukraine, calling it a significant step toward ending the ongoing war. The Kremlin on Tuesday described the suspension as the "best contribution to peace," following escalating tensions between US and Ukrainian lead-

The move, which went into immediate effect on Monday, impacts military supplies worth hundreds of millions of dollars that were in the process of being sent to Ukraine, according to The New York Times.

Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov

stated, "If the United States stops (military supplies), this would probably be the best contribution to peace. It is a solution that could really push the Kyiv regime towards a peace process." He further noted that the US has been Ukraine's primary military supplier since Russia launched its offensive in February 2023. "We will see how the situation on the ground evolves," Peskov added.

The pause in aid comes amid a public dispute between former US President Donald Trump and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, highlighting growing uncertainty over continued Western support for Ukraine in its conflict with Russia.

FBI's "Most Wanted" Drug Lord, "Narco of Narcos," **Handed Over to US by Mexico**

In a significant move, Mexico has extradited some of its most notorious drug lords to the United States, including Rafael Caro Quintero, the infamous "Narco of Narcos." Caro Quintero, 72, was on the US Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) list of 10 most-wanted fugitives until his capture in 2022. He is accused of ordering the kidnap, torture, and murder of US Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) special agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena in the

1980s. A total of 29 cartel figures were handed over to US authorities as Mexico seeks to prevent sweeping tariffs that former US President Donald Trump has linked to illegal migration and drug trafficking. The US Department of Justice stated that if convicted, Caro Quintero and several others could face the death penalty. Prosecutors are also considering terrorism charges against

The extradition of such a high number of suspects at once was described as "historic" by former DEA official Mike Vigil. "In the past, Mexico would extradite only a few suspects at a time," he noted, adding that the move was likely aimed at easing ongoing trade negotiations with the US.

Major Cartel Leaders Among Those Extradited

The list of extradited criminals includes some of the most dangerous



figures in Mexico's drug underworld. Among them are Omar and Miguel Angel Trevino Morales, former leaders of the ultra-violent Zetas cartel, Vicente Carrillo, ex-boss of the Juarez cartel, and a brother of Nemesio Oseguera, head of the powerful Jalisco New Generation Cartel.

The DEA welcomed Caro Quintero's extradition with special enthusiasm, as his role in Camarena's killing had remained an unresolved wound for the agency. DEA acting administrator Derek S. Maltz called it an "extremely personal" moment for the organization.

US and Mexico Strengthen An-

ti-Drug Efforts

The extradition announcement came during a high-level visit by Mexican officials to Washington, where they met US Secretary of State Marco Rubio and other top American officials. According to the

Mexican government, both countries agreed to take coordinated actions to combat drug trafficking, particularly fentanyl smuggling, and illegal firearms trade.

Mexican President Claudia Sheinbaum has pledged to collaborate with the US on these issues while rejecting any "invasion" of her country's sovereignty. She has also expressed optimism that the two nations can avoid the tariffs imposed by Trump.

Trump's Tough Stance on Cartels Since returning to office in January, Trump has designated eight Latin American drug trafficking organizations as terrorist groups, including six Mexican cartels. He has signed an executive order labeling the cartels a national security threat, raising speculation about potential US military action against them.

Amid increasing US pressure, Mexico has recently carried out large-

Bombay HC stays FIR against ex-SEBI chief **Madhabi Buch**



- HC grants relief in alleged market fraud case
- Special court's decision deemed "mechanical" and
- lacking specific attribution. SEBI calls complainant a habitual litigant.

TPN Correspondent | Mumbai The Bombay High Court on Tues-

day granted relief to former SEBI chairperson Madhabi Puri Buch and five others by staying a special court's order directing the registration of an FIR in an alleged market fraud case. The court observed that the lower court's order was passed mechanically without detailing the specific roles of the accused.

Justice Shivkumar Dige, presiding over the case, stayed the March 1 special court order for four weeks and granted time for the complainant, journalist Sapan Shrivastava, to file his affidavit in response to the petitions seeking quashing of the order. The petitions were filed by Ms. Buch, SEBI directors Ashwani Bhatia, Ananth Narayan, and Kamlesh Chandra Varshney, along with Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) Managing Director and CEO Sundararaman Ramamurthy and former BSE chairman Pramod Agarwal.

The case stems from allegations of fraud related to a company's listing on the BSE in 1994. A special court had directed the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) to file an FIR, citing "prima facie evidence of regulatory lapses and collusion requiring a fair and impartial probe." The court noted that the allegations warranted an investigation due to the perceived inaction by SEBI and law enforcement agencies.

On Monday, the High Court had already restrained the ACB from taking action until the hearing was concluded. Solicitor-General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the SEBI directors, argued that the special court's order was "manifestly erroneous, patently illegal, and beyond jurisdiction."

In response, SEBI reaffirmed its commitment to regulatory compliance and announced its intention to challenge the order. The market regulator dismissed the allegations as frivolous, pointing out that the complainant had a history of filing baseless litigation, some of which had previously been dismissed with penalties.

Meanwhile, the BSE also rejected the allegations, calling them "frivolous and vexatious." The High Court will take up the matter again after four weeks.

Suzuki Motorcycle India's domestic sales dip, exports rise by 19%

Suzuki Motorcycle India Pvt. Ltd. SMIPL) reported a mixed performance in February 2025, with domestic sales witnessing a 7.4% decline compared to February 2024, while exports surged by 19%.

The company recorded total sales of 90,206 units last month, comprising 73,455 units sold in the domestic market and 16,751 units shipped overseas. In contrast, Suzuki sold 97,435 units in February 2024, with 83,304 units domestically and 14,131 units in exports.

Commenting on the sales, Devashish Handa, Executive Vice President – Sales,



said, "February sales reflect a mix of market dynamics with exports showing growth. Although the domestic sales witnessed a temporary slowdown, our Marketing, and After Sales at SMIPL, focus remains on offering products that

align with customers' expectations while continuously improving the overall ownership experience."

Despite the slowdown in domestic demand, Suzuki remains optimistic about future growth, driven by its recent launches at the Bharat Mobility Global Expo 2025. The company introduced its first electric scooter, the e-Access, alongside the ICE variant of the Access 125. Suzuki also

launched the Gixxer SF 250 Flex Fuel, India's first E85-compatible bike. These new models are expected to boost Suzuki's sales momentum in the coming months.

Tencent Raises Stake in FromSoftware Parent Kadokawa to 7.97%

Thinese tech giant Tencent Holdings has increased its stake in Kadokawa Corporation, the parent company of renowned game developer FromSoftware. According to reports, Tencent acquired an additional 1.11 percent of Kadokawa shares on Monday, raising its ownership from 6.86 percent to 7.97 percent. This move follows Tencent's initial investment in 2021, when it acquired a stake in the Japanese firm for JPY 30 billion (approximately Rs. 1,757 crore).

through SixJoy Hong Kong Limited, a Tencent subsidiary, which submitted a large shareholding report to the Kanto Finance Bureau. According to a report from Nikkei, the acquisition is part of an ongoing capital and business alliance between the two companies.

The share purchase was carried out in Kadokawa. Sony invested JPY 50 billion (\$320 million or roughly Rs. 2,722 crore) to acquire new Kadokawa shares, aiming to strengthen its collaboration with the publishing giant and maximize the global impact of their intellectual properties (IP).

Tencent's increased stake in Kadokawa signals its growing interest in the gaming sector, reinforcing its position in the Japanese gaming market while competing with Sony for influence over the publisher's future. With both tech giants expanding their stakes, Kadokawa's role in shaping the gaming industry is expected to become even more significant in the coming years.

Apple Set to Launch MacBook Air M4 with AI Features This Week



Apple is ready to unveil its highly anticipated MacBook Air M4 this week, confirming the launch via social media on Monday. The new laptop will succeed the MacBook Air M3, which debuted only a year ago in March 2024. The MacBook Air M4 is expected to come in two sizes—13-inch and 15-inch models—and will be powered by the new M4 chipset.


In a teaser shared on X (formerly Twitter), Apple CEO Tim Cook posted a video with the tagline, "There's something in the AIR," hinting at the arrival of the new MacBook Air. While the design of the new laptop is expected to remain largely unchanged from its predecessor, the major update will be the introduction of the M4 processor, which is expected to boost performance and efficiency.

The MacBook Air M4 is rumored to offer two display sizes—13inch and 15-inch—codenamed J713 and J715, respectively. The laptop will likely feature the same Liquid Retina display as the current model, though there are speculations that Apple could introduce a new nano-texture coating, which it currently offers on the Mac-Book Pro (M4, 2024), to the Mac-Book Air M4. Additionally, the upcoming model may see an upgrade in connectivity, with Thunderbolt 4 ports replacing the Thunderbolt 3 ports found in the current MacBook Air.

Another significant upgrade for the MacBook Air M4 could be the introduction of Apple Intelligence—Apple's suite of AI-powered features. This would likely require a minimum of 8GB of RAM, aligning with Apple's specifications for running its AI suite. This upgrade hints at a more powerful, AI-enhanced experience for users.

The news of the M4 chip was first reported by Bloomberg's Mark Gurman in October 2024, and the launch of the Mac-Book Air M4 is expected to be followed by the release of an M4-powered Mac Studio, which may debut between March and June 2025.

YouTube Working on Netflix-Like Redesign to Compete With Amazon Prime Video



YouTube is reportedly developing a redesigned version of its smart TV app that could resemble Netflix and Disney+, aiming to make it easier for users to discover paid content from third-party streaming services. This move is seen as an effort to compete with Amazon Prime Video, which already integrates external services like Apple TV+ and Paramount+ within its interface.

According to a report from The Information (via The Verge),

the Alphabet-owned platform plans to spotlight paid content from third-party providers directly on the YouTube home page, offering users a more seamless content discovery experience. YouTube already allows US customers to subscribe to services like Max, Paramount+, and Crunchyroll through its "Primetime Channels" feature in the Movies and TV tab. However, the redesign could expand this integration significantly. Amazon's Prime Video currently highlights content from external platforms throughout its app and allows users to purchase subscriptions within the interface. YouTube appears to be following a similar strategy to boost engagement and make its app a more comprehensive entertainment hub.

Kurt Wilms, Senior Director of Product Management at You-Tube, confirmed that the company is working on a unified viewing experience. "The vision is that when you come to our app and you're looking for a show, it'll just blend away whether that show is from a Primetime Channel or that show is from a creator," he told The Information.

The move comes amid growing competition among streaming services, with platforms like Netflix, Disney+, and Amazon Prime Video constantly refining their user experience. By enhancing its smart TV app to integrate third-party services more prominently, YouTube aims to position itself as a key player in the premium streaming market.

Giving Up Your Phone For Just 3 Days Can Change Brain, Study Shows



recent study has revealed and the neurotransmitter Athat giving up your smartphone for just three days can lead to significant changes in brain activity. The research, conducted by scientists from Heidelberg University and the University of Cologne in Germany, involved 25 young adults aged 18 to 30. Participants were asked to limit their phone use to essential communication and work tasks for a period of 72 hours. Before and after the three-day "phone diet," participants underwent MRI scans and psychological tests. The aim of the study was to observe how restricting smartphone use would affect brain patterns, particularly focusing on addiction-related neurotransmitter systems. The results showed notable changes in brain activation associated with these systems, indicating that even short-term phone restrictions can influence neural respons-

The researchers used a longitudinal approach to examine the effects of smartphone restriction, as detailed in their published paper. They found associations between changes in brain activation over time

systems related to addiction. Participants were shown various images during the scans, including pictures of smartphones (both on and off) and neutral images like boats and flowers, to examine their brain responses.

The study suggests that smartphone use has a profound effect on brain activity, even in the short term. These findings provide valuable insight into how digital devices shape our neural patterns. However, the researchers caution that their data does not fully distinguish between craving smartphone use and craving social interaction, two processes that are often closely intertwined in today's digital age.

While the study reveals robust findings, the researchers highlight the need for future research to further explore these aspects, particularly to clarify how smartphone use affects both our craving for devices and the social connections we seek through them. This study adds to the growing body of evidence that points to the powerful influence of smartphones on our brains.




