The Andhra Pradesh government's P4 (People-Public-Private Partnership for Poverty-free Progress) scheme received a major boost on Saturday as Prasad Seeds stepped forward to fund the Kommamur lift irrigation project entirely from its own resources. Minister Narayana Launches 5 New Websites, Vows to Boost Women Entrepreneurs

Urban Development and MEPMA Minister P. Narayana unveiled a major digital push on Saturday with the launch of the Mahila Kaasam mobile app and the official MEPMA website during a oneday workshop held in Vijayawada. The initiative aims to boost transparency and streamline the delivery of welfare schemes to women's self-help groups (SHGs). Speaking on the occasion, Minister Narayana underlined the importance of data accuracy for government wel-

fare distribution. "That's the reason we launched five new websites on saturday," he said, adding that Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu envisions "a businessman in every household by 2047."

Highlighting the government's commitment to women empowerment, the Minister announced that ₹8,000 crore in loans will be extended to 80,000 DW-CRA groups across the state. He recalled the previous proposal to award sand contracts to women's groups, which could not materialize due to unforeseen issues. However, he assured that such





innovative ideas would continue to be pursued.

The Minister also revealed plans to hold review meetings in all 26 districts to assess the progress of SHG-related schemes and address challenges. "By 2029, we aim to prepare as many women entrepreneurs as possible," he stated, pointing to the government's broader strategy of grassroots economic development.

Political temperatures soared in Pithapuram on Saturday as Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and Jana Sena Party (JSP) supporters clashed during a public event in Kumarapuram village. The incident occurred during the inauguration of a CC road by Jana Sena MLC and party leader Nagababu, which turned into a flashpoint for the simmering rivalry between the two alliance partners.

As Nagababu arrived to formally open the newly laid road, large numbers of Jana Sainiks gathered and chanted slogans in support of their leader and party

chief Pawan Kalyan. In retaliation,

instead developed the area into a residential layout, blatantly violating the terms of allotment. Speaking to reporters, Harendhira Prasad said, "The land was given to promote cinema and filmbased infrastructure. But the usage has turned out to be for real estate, which is contrary to the conditions agreed upon. A notice will be issued, and they will have to explain the deviation."

He further warned that if the response to the showcause notice is found to be unsatisfactory, the district administration will not hesitate to take back the land. "The government will initiate steps to repossess the property if the explanation does not justify the change in land use," he asserted.

The Collector's announcement comes in the wake of a broader drive by the government to audit and reclaim public land allotted to private entities under special concessions. This initiative aims to ensure that all such lands are being utilized as per the original purpose.

The issue has sparked considerable discussion across the real estate and film industries in the region. All eyes are now on Ramanaidu Studio's reply to the notice, which could determine the future of the land in question.

The P4 initiative, launched on Ugadi, envisions Andhra Pradesh becoming a global leader in income equality by 2024. Pithapuram is currently one of the most high-profile battlegrounds in the state, with Jana Sena chief Pawan Kalyan contesting from this seat. Although the TDP and JSP have forged an alliance across Andhra Pradesh, seat-sharing and on-ground dynamics have triggered rivalry in specific regions, particularly where both parties hold significant

Local leadership from both sides have called for restraint and appealed to their cadres to focus on peaceful campaigning. However, the symbolic importance of locations like Kumarapuram and the prestige attached to the Pithapuram seat make such flare-ups likely in the coming days.

Police and district officials are now on high alert, with orders to monitor all political events closely to ensure peace and law and order during the crucial campaign period.

Farmers Suffer Heavy Losses as **Unseasonal Rains Damage Crops Across AP**

₹2.15 crore crop loss reported in Anantapur district alone Mango, banana, paddy, and maize among worst affected Rains to continue for the next three days, officials warn



areas, while 1,000 metric tons of drying paddy became wet and unusable. Chilli crops in G. Konduru mandal sustained partial damage.

Twelve regions reported heavy rainfall, with over 50 mm recorded in 23 areas. Maddur in Nandyal and Rallapalli in Prakasam received the highest — 111.5 mm. Kalasapadu in Kadapa, Perusomala in Nandyal, and Kondakamar in Sri Sathya Sai district also received over 100 mm. Rain was widespread across Rayalaseema and coastal Andhra.

The Disaster Management Authority has forecast continued scattered rain with thunder and lightning over the next three days. Light showers are expected in Alluri, East Godavari, Kakinada, Annamaya, and Chittoor on Saturday, with moderate rain in North Andhra on Sunday and thundershowers in several coastal districts by Monday.

Farmers are urging the government to provide immediate relief and assess the damage on priority to help them recover from this unexpected blow.

Unseasonal rains across Andhra Pradesh have brought devastation to farmers. damaging key crops and leading to significant financial losses. The sudden downpour accompanied by strong winds affected several districts on Thursday night, Friday morning, and Saturday just as farmers were preparing to harvest. In Anantapur district, losses have

crossed ₹2.15 crore. Horticultural crops worth ₹1.24 crore across 60.77 hectares. including banana, watermelon, sugarcane, and kalingara, were damaged in 11 mandals. Additionally, paddy and maize cultivated in 114 hectares by 71 farmers in Shettur, Garladinne, Narpala, and Anantapur rural areas were also hit, amounting to ₹91.84 lakh in losses.

Vijayawada and surrounding rural mandals also bore the brunt. Mango orchards in the flowering-to-fruit transition stage suffered damage, with 10% of fruits falling due to the wind. About 50 acres of mango plantations in Vijayawada Rural Mandal were impacted. Banana plantations collapsed in several

Trump Tariffs Impacting AP Aqua Sector, Says CM Naidu

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu expressed concern over the impact of US-imposed tariffs, commonly referred to as "Trump tariffs," on Andhra Pradesh's economy. He said that these tariffs are severely damaging the state's aqua sector, which is heavily dependent on exports. The CM assured that the government will conduct periodic reviews to mitigate the negative effects and support the affected industries.

While addressing the public, Chandrababu emphasized the importance of balancing welfare with development. He reiterated that pensions are now being disbursed on the first of every month and highlighted several self-employment schemes launched to empower citizens. "A nation can progress only when its leadership is forward-thinking. No one should remain in poverty," he said.

He underlined the state government's commitment to women's welfare through Dwakra associations and urged financially successful individuals to give back to society. He recalled the Janmabhoomi days when everyone contributed to development and said that the government is now advancing with the P4 model.

The Chief Minister reaffirmed his commitment to completing Amaravati and Polavaram and imple-



menting the Super 6 promises. Among the initiatives, he announced that three LPG cylinders will be provided free of cost annually under the Deepam scheme. Additionally, financial assistance will be extended to families under the "Mother's Salute" scheme based on the number of children. Criticizing the previous YSRCP government, Chandrababu accused them of damaging lift irrigation projects and stealing essential equipment like pumps and starters. "Their thinking must change," he said, calling for responsible governance focused on long-term progress.

Chelluboyina Venugopala Krishna Slams CM Naidu Over State Division and Polavaram Damage

Former Minister Chelluboyina Venugopala Krishna launched a scathing attack on Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, accusing him of betraying the people of Andhra Pradesh during the state's bifurcation. Addressing the media, Chelluboyina alleged that Chandrababu, despite claiming decades of experience, insisted on the division of the state and failed to safeguard its interests during the crucial Assembly debates on the state's future.

He criticized Chandrababu for not participating in discussions concerning the state's demands and needs during bifurcation. "It was Chan-



drababu's selfish politics that weakened Andhra Pradesh," he said.

Chelluboyina also blamed the TDP government for damaging the Polavaram project. He alleged that an engineering blunder during Chandrababu's previous term, where a gap was left in the coffer dam, led to the washing away of the diaphragm wall. Although the Centre gave permission to reconstruct the damaged part, he said the current TDP government has reduced the project's height, thereby compromising its intended capacity.

Targeting actor-turned-politician Pawan Kalyan, the former minister questioned his silence. "Why is Pawan, who always claims to be a questioning force, not speaking up now? Why is he silent when the people are suffering?" he asked.

Regarding state finances, Chelluboyina accused the TDP of misleading the public. "When in opposition, Chandrababu lied about the state's debt. After coming to power, he initially claimed it was ₹14 lakh crore, then reduced it to ₹12 lakh crore. The government now finds itself stuck—unable to lie further or speak the truth in the budget," he said.

He concluded by stating that the people of Andhra Pradesh will not tolerate such double standards and deception much longer.

Waqf Owns Most Land After Railways & Defense, Says MP Purandeshwari

BJP AP President and MP Daggubati Purandeshwari emphasized that the Modi government is committed to inclusive governance, asserting that the Waqf Amendment Bill was passed in both the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha with wide consultation. She stated that the bill aims to make the Waqf Board more accountable and efficient, with no interference in religious matters. Purandeshwari reminded that the bill was passed after inputs from Waqf Boards in 25 states were gathered by the Joint Par-



liamentary Committee. "Everyone talks about Muslims, but it is Modi who worked for their welfare," she remarked, citing the abolition of triple talaq as a major reform. She clarified that the bill only amends administrative provisions, such as introducing women's representation in the Waqf Board—something long overdue.

Highlighting the scale of Waqf properties, she said, "After Railways and Defense, Waqf owns the most land. Yet its reported income is just ₹163 crore. The Sachar Committee stated that if properly managed, Waqf lands could generate ₹16,000 crore." She alleged that lack of oversight allowed misuse, and stressed that the reforms will benefit the backward Muslim minority and ensure transparent use of Waqf assets.

Purandeshwari slammed Congress leaders Sonia Gandhi, Rahul Gandhi, and Priyanka Gandhi for their absence during the debate, questioning their criticism. She said the previous Congress government diluted the Waqf Board's autonomy in 2013 for vote bank politics.

Paying tribute to Babu Jagjivan Ram on his birth anniversary, she praised his legacy and credited the Modi government for implementing schemes inspired by his vision. She highlighted PMAY, Startup India, and DICCI as examples of welfare and empowerment programs for SCs, STs, and women. Purandeshwari reiterated that BJP is not against Muslims but is focused on their real progress, asking people to reject parties that politicized their welfare for decades

Vempalli Satish Reddy Slams Sharmila's Allegations on Jagan

Former MLC and YSRCP leader Vempalli Satish Reddy came down heavily on Andhra Pradesh Congress chief Y.S. Sharmila for her recent allegations against YSRCP chief Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy. Delay in Post-Mortem Report Raises Suspicions in Praveen Pagadala Case - Harsha Kumar

Former MP Harsha Kumar has raised serious concerns over the delay in the release of the post-mortem report in the suspicious death of Praveen Pagadala. Speaking to media, he questioned why the report, which is usually released within three days, has not been made public even after several days have passed.



"In any normal case, a post-mortem report should be available by the third day. What is the reason for the delay here?" Harsha Kumar asked, expressing deep suspicion over the handling of the case by authorities.

He demanded an answer from the state government and police department, questioning whether Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu was giving secret instructions to suppress the investigation. "Is the CM directing the police to hold back facts?" he asked.

Harsha Kumar firmly stated that he and his supporters believe this was not a natural death, but a clear case of murder. He criticized the police for their failure to investigate the case from multiple angles, alleging that only one version was being pushed.

He also revealed that he was prevented from demanding a re-post-mortem examination. "Why was I stopped when I asked for a re-post-mortem? What are they trying to hide?" he questioned, warning that such suppression of facts would not go unnoticed.



Waqf Amendment Bill 2025: Balancing Justice, Reform, and Rights



The Waqf (Amendment) Bill 2025, officially titled the UMEED Act, represents a landmark step towards streamlining the management of Waqf properties while upholding justice, transparency, and constitutional safeguards. More than a simple amendment, the Act aims to rectify long-standing administrative and legal loopholes in India's Waqf system. The Act abolishes Section 40 of the original 1995 Waqf Act, which allowed Waqf Boards to unilaterally declare any property as Waqf land, often without due process. This provision had led to thousands of disputes and was criticized by the Sachar Committee in 2006 for undermining justice. The 2025 amendment replaces this arbitrary system with a structured legal mechanism: district collectors now have the authority to adjudicate such matters, with a right to appeal to the High Court within 90 days. Home Minister Amit Shah emphasized this during parliamentary debate, underscoring that clause 35(9) of the new bill introduces statutory appeals and aligns with Article 14's principles of equality and Article 32's protection of legal remedies. The claim that the bill undermines Waqf's inalienable status is countered by judicial precedents that distinguish religious practice from administrative functions. In Sardar Syedna Taher Saifuddin Saheb v. State of Bombay (1962), the Supreme Court clarified that

governance tasks do not equate to worship. The 2025 Act introduces a 12-year limitation period for claims, mirroring the Limitation Act, 1963, thus preventing indefinite litigation and potentially unlocking around 9.4 lakh acres of land worth ₹1.2 lakh crore. This land, currently tied up in over 13,000 pending cases, could be redirected towards educational and healthcare initiatives benefiting economically disadvantaged sections of the Muslim community. Another reformative step is the inclusion of two Muslim women on every Waqf Board, addressing the historical underrepresentation—only 2% female participation noted by the Sachar Committee. This democratization aligns with Articles 15(3) and 16(2), which support affirmative action and gender equity in public institutions. The Act also introduces limited representation for non-Muslims—two of the 11 members on a Waqf Board—to enhance transparency, without infringing on religious autonomy, as permitted under S.R. Bommai v. Union of India (1994). Claims under Article 26—that the bill interferes with religious practices—are further dispelled through precedents like Raja Bira Kishore Deb v. State of Orissa (1964) and Durgah Committee, Ajmer v. Syed Hussain Ali (1961), where the Supreme Court upheld state regulation of secular aspects of religious institutions.

Karnataka's Pay Hike for Crorepati Lawmakers

In a move that has sparked widespread criticism, the Karnataka government has approved a sweeping pay hike for its legislators—even as the state grapples with a mounting financial crisis. On March 21, the Congress-led Assembly passed bills doubling salaries and allowances for the Chief Minister, ministers, and members of both legislative houses. The Chief Minister's monthly salary was raised from ₹75,000 to ₹1.5 lakh, while ministers now receive ₹1.25 lakh, up from ₹60,000. MLAs and MLCs have seen their pay double from ₹40,000 to ₹80,000. Even pensions have been hiked from ₹37,500 to ₹75,000 per month. Altogether, this revi-

borrowing to keep basic services running. The decision to reward lawmakers so generously seems all the more tone-deaf when placed against the backdrop of their personal wealth. According to a recent report by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR), Karnataka has the highest number of ultra-wealthy MLAs in India, with 31 legislators possessing assets exceeding ₹100 crore. The state's MLAs have an average net worth of ₹63.5 crore, and a staggering 97% of sitting MLAs are crorepatis. Deputy Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar alone has declared assets worth over ₹1,413 crore, making him the richest legislator in the state and

the second richest in India.

Among Congress MLAs, 132 out of 135 are crorepatis, with an average wealth of ₹67.13 crore. BJP MLAs also follow suit—63 of 66 are in the same category, averaging ₹44.36 crore. Janata Dal (Secular) is not far behind, with 18 of its 19 MLAs owning assets worth over ₹1 crore. In this context, the state's generous pay hike appears unnecessary and sends a mes-

sage of detachment from the financial realities faced by ordinary citizens. Meanwhile, the government's welfare schemes are under stress. Payments under flagship initiatives such as the Gruha Lakshmi Yojane have reportedly been delayed for five months. Pending dues to electricity supply companies (Escoms) remain unpaid, and Local Area Development Fund allocations to MLAs are stuck. Public infrastructure projects, including metro and bus services, are struggling due to lack of funds.

According to the Sri Lankan President's Office, the Mitra Vibhushana medal was specially instituted to acknowledge extraordinary global friendships and reflects the depth of the longstanding ties between the two nations. This event also marks a diplomatic milestone, as Prime

Minister Modi is the first international leader to be officially hosted by Sri Lankan President Anura Kumara Dissanayake since he assumed office in September 2024. The warm welcome and the honour bestowed upon Modi underscore Colombo's strategic emphasis on deepening its engagement with New Delhi. Notably, this is the 22nd international honour Modi has received from a foreign government, further solidifying his stature as a respected global statesman. The recognition from Sri Lanka adds to a growing list of accolades for his proactive foreign policy and leadership in regional cooperation. President Dissanavake highlighted Modi's pivotal role in championing regional unity and acknowledged India's consistent support in areas ranging

from infrastructure development to humanitarian aid and cultural exchange. The medal ceremony also served as a symbolic reaffirmation of the two nations' shared historical legacy rooted in Buddhism, trade, and people-to-people connections. Violence Erupts at Bokaro Plant Protest

Online ticketing platform BookMyShow has reportedly removed all content related to stand-up comedian Kunal Kamra from its website. The move follows a complaint letter from Yuva Shiv Sena leader Rahool N Kanal, who raised objections to Kamra's controversial content, particularly a recent joke that was labeled as "anti-national" by critics.

According to reports by India Today, Kamra's profile has been removed, and no upcoming shows featuring the comedian are currently listed on the platform.

This action comes in the wake of a letter dated April 2, in which Rahool Kanal urged BookMyShow to refrain from promoting or selling tickets Kamra's performances. Kanal described Kamra as someone with a "documented history of habitual offensive behavior," alleging that his content consistently crosses the line of decency and decorum.

In his letter, Kanal wrote, "I am addressing this letter in my individual capacity as a concerned citizen to bring to your attention a matter of significant public interest concerning the operations of BookMyShow." He went on to say that Kamra has used his platform to engage in a "vili-



fication campaign" targeting prominent public figures, including the Prime Minister, deputy chief ministers, and other leaders.

The controversy reportedly stems from a recent standup routine where Kamra cracked a joke that some interpreted as mocking national sentiment and leadership. Social media users and certain political outfits criticized the content, labeling it "traitorous," sparking calls for a boycott and further amplifying demands for action against the comedian.

While Kunal Kamra has not officially responded to Book-MyShow's action or the political letter, he has been known to defend his right to free speech in the past, often pointing out the role of satire in a healthy democracy.


The incident has once again sparked a debate around censorship, freedom of expression, and political influence in entertainment spaces. BookMyShow has yet to issue a public statement on the matter.

Tensions flared in Bokaro on Mahto's family. The roots of Thursday as a protest demanding employment at the Bokaro Steel Plant (BSP) turned violent, resulting in the tragic death of a 23-year-old youth and injuries to at least 15 others, including one person currently in the ICU.

The deceased, Prem Mahto, was part of a demonstration organized by the Visthapit Apprentice Sangh (VAS)—a union representing youth displaced during the establishment of the steel plant. Mahto allegedly succumbed to injuries after being struck on the head during a CISF lathi charge as protesters tried to breach barricades near the plant's main gate. The protest triggered a city-wide shutdown from Thursday night and brought plant operations to a standstill, with thousands of workers stranded inside. Authorities responded quickly to the escalating situation. Bokaro Deputy Commissioner Vijaya Jadhav confirmed that a three-member inquiry committee has been formed to investigate the incident. An order has also been issued for the arrest of the BSP's Chief General Manager. The district administration has announced a velopment. compensation of ₹20 lakh for

the unrest lie in long-standing grievances of displaced families. According to protester Sahdev Sao, the plant was set up in 1967-68 on 34,000 acres of acquired land with promises of over 20,000 jobs for displaced locals. However, many of these promises remain unfulfilled. "We've been demanding jobs since 2016. Back then, we even breached the canal in protest, which led to the arrest of 52 protesters for seven months," said Sao. Another youth, speaking anonymously, stated that in 2016, the government identified 4,328 displaced persons eligible for employment. However, only 1,500 were offered apprenticeships between 2016 and 2022, with the number of recruitments decreasing in each phase. Despite an official meeting held in February, no progress followed. Frustrated by delays, youth and their families launched a fresh sitin protest on April 3, which ultimately culminated in Thursday's violent confrontation. The incident has raised serious concerns over the state's handling of displacement and job promises tied to industrial de-

Waqf Bill Passed, 8.8 Lakh Properties Listed



The waqf (amendment) bill 2025 has been passed by parliament with ease in both houses, ushering in new rules that may affect over 73,000 disputed waqf properties across the country, the bill, which underwent more than 12 hours of debate, marks a major update in how waqf assets—properties endowed by muslims for religious or charitable purposes—are recorded and managed.

according to data from the ministry of minority affairs, there are a total of 8.8 lakh waqf properties listed across 30 states and union territories, based on entries in the waqf assets management system of india (wamsi), the government's official database.

out of the total, more than 6.2 lakh properties—roughly two-thirds—are classified as graveyards, agricultural land, mosques, shops, or houses. graveyards make up 17.3%, while agricultural land and mosques account for 16% and 14%, respectively.


n interestingly, while up has the most waqf properties, punjab has the highest proportion of disputed properties, suggesting sharp regional contrasts in land contention. these disputes now fall under the new framework of the amended legislation.

a waqf is a unique form of property in islamic tradition, where the ownership is believed to rest with god, while the property is managed for a religious, charitable, or community purpose. the amended bill is expected to bring greater transparency, digitization, and dispute resolution mechanisms.

the move has stirred public debate and political activity, particularly in regions with ongoing land disputes involving waqf properties. in some areas, the passage of the bill has even triggered shifts in local political affiliations, including christian groups joining the bjp amid related disputes.

JP Morgan Predicts U.S. Recession Due to **New Tariffs; India's Exports May Be Impacted**

- · U.S. GDP expected to shrink and unemployment may rise to 5.3%.
- Fed Chair Powell warns tariffs could worsen inflation and slow growth.
- India faces a 26% tariff on exports starting April 9.

P Morgan has forecasted that the United States is likely to enter a recession this year, primarily driven by the economic effects of newly imposed tariffs, as announced by President Donald Trump. In a note to investors released on Friday, Michael

Feroli, the firm's chief U.S. economist, predicted that the country's gross domestic product (GDP) will contract due to the weight of these tariffs.

Feroli further stated that this economic downturn could push the U.S. unemployment rate to 5.3%, as a result of reduced economic activity. This prediction comes after President Trump revealed on April 2 that his administration would be imposing reciprocal tariffs on various countries as part of a broader strategy to rebalance trade relations with major U.S. trading partners.

The Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell also voiced concerns over the potential impact of the new tariffs. During a business journalism conference on Friday, Powell warned that these tariffs could cause more significant economic damage than previously anticipated.

He explained that the tariff hikes would likely lead to higher inflation and slower economic growth, complicating the Federal Reserve's ongoing

efforts to control inflation.

According to Trump's tariff plan, a 10% tariff will be applied to imports from all countries beginning on April 5. Additionally, countries with the largest trade deficits with the U.S. will face individualized, higher tariffs starting April 9. India, in particular, will be affected by a 26% tariff on its exports.

Despite this negative outlook, global brokerage firm Jefferies has taken a more optimistic view regarding the impact on India.

The firm noted that key sectors of Indian exports, such as information technology (IT) services, pharmaceuticals, and automobiles, will not be directly affected by the new tariffs.



However, Jefferies warned that a potential slowdown in the U.S. economy could still negatively impact Indian exports, particularly in IT services, due to weakened demand. While the 26% tariff on Indian goods may seem "reasonable" compared to other countries' tariffs, the broader economic challenges in the U.S. could pose greater risks.

Death Toll from Myanmar Earthquake Surpasses 3,300, UN Urges Global Aid

The death toll from the devastating earthquake in Myanmar has risen to over 3,300, according to state media reports on Saturday. The earthquake, which struck on March 28, caused widespread destruction across the country, leaving 3,354 people dead and over 4,500 injured. Additionally, 220 people are still missing, with many survivors left without shelter.

Over a week after the disaster, survivors are still struggling to find adequate housing. Many are sleeping outdoors as their homes were either destroyed or are too unsafe to occupy due to the risk of further collapses. According to a United Nations estimate, more than quake, exacerbating the country's already dire situation, which has been complicated by four years of ongoing civil war.

Trump Imposes 25% Tariff on Imported Vehicles to the U.S.

resident Donald Trump has unveiled a new 25% tariff on cars and car parts that are imported into the United States, marking a significant change from the current 2.5% import tax. The tariff will apply to vehicles and car components from countries outside the U.S., further intensifying trade tensions with global partners. The new tariff policy follows a series of similar trade measures introduced by Trump since taking office. The administration has implemented tariffs on various goods, including steel and aluminum, in an effort to protect U.S. manufacturers from what it sees as unfair competition. harm American consumers by raising the cost of imported goods, leading to higher prices for cars and car parts in the domestic market.

India remains attractive destination for global capital: Experts



pealing destination for global capital, buoyed by a strong economic outlook, progressive policy reforms, and a resilient market, experts said on Saturday.

Despite the recent reciprocal tariffs imposed by the US on Indian goods, experts noted that these measures remain relatively modest compared to other Asian countries. This situation preserves India's competitive edge and provides a strong proposition for viable export opportunities.

Manoj Purohit, Partner and Leader, FS Tax, Tax and Regulatory Services at BDO India, highlighted India's position as one of the fastest-growing economies in the world. He noted that India benefits from a large consumer market, a skilled workforce, and a government that is committed to implementing business-friendly reforms. The government's emphasis on infrastructure, digital growth, and ease of doing business has further bolstered investor confidence.

One of the recent steps in reinforcing India's investment climate was the RBI's decision to maintain the existing corporate bond and G-sec limits for foreign portfolio investors (FPIs). This move signals the government's

India continues to stand as an ap- intent to keep India's market accessible to offshore investors, ensuring continued foreign inflows.

> Trade diversification and strategic partnerships have also created new avenues for investment, making India an attractive market for longterm investment despite potential short-term challenges such as tariffs. Purohit pointed out that India's robust economic fundamentals make it resilient to temporary disruptions like rising inflation, tight earnings, and high valuations.

> The upcoming week is critical, with key domestic and global events on the horizon. Investors are likely to track developments related to tariff tensions, and domestic economic indicators, including the IIP and CPI data, will be closely watched. Additionally, the Q4 earnings season kicks off with IT giant TCS scheduled to announce its results on April 10.

Cautious Start Amid US Tariff Hikes and Geopolitical Concerns

The new financial year (FY26) has begun on a cautious note, largely driven by the unexpected imposition of higher tariffs by the US, market experts noted on Saturday. While the initial market sentiment remains subdued, any positive developments from the ongoing India-US bilateral trade talks could provide a potential catalyst to support the market's recovery.

Sectors like IT and metals have significantly underperformed compared to the broader market, reflecting growing concerns about the US economy's outlook and the possibility of retaliatory trade actions from other countries. Vinod Nair, Head of Research at Geojit Investments Limited, highlighted that investors will be closely watching for any countermeasures taken by global trade partners, which could escalate geopolitical and economic uncertainty. This cautious sentiment is reflected in the rally of gold and bond prices, as investors flock to safe-haven assets in response to the growing risk of a trade war. On Friday, benchmark indices ex-



tended their losses, with the Nifty falling 345.65 points, or 1.49%, to 22,904.45. The fear of a trade war, fueled by US President Donald Trump's reciprocal tariffs, has led to widespread concern that aggressive trade policies could result in retaliatory measures, disrupt global supply chains, and hinder global economic growth.

The broader markets experienced a sharp decline, with the Nifty Midcap 100 and Nifty Smallcap 100 indices dropping 2.91% and 3.56%, respective-

cant losses, particularly IT, Auto, Pharma, PSU Bank, Realty, Oil and Gas, and Metals, which saw declines between 3% and 6%.

Market analysts suggest that the key support level for the Nifty lies around 22,700-22,800. Holding above this level will be crucial for a potential recovery towards the previous week's high of 23,565. However, failure to maintain support could lead to a further decline, potentially reaching 22,300.

In the coming week, investors will also focus on the Reserve Bank of India's monetary policy meeting and the resumption of the Q4 FY25 earnings season. A positive outcome from the MPC meeting could benefit rate-sensitive sectors, while key economic indicators, such as inflation figures and US jobless claims, will offer critical insights into the health of the global economy.

India Ranks 10th in Private AI Investment, **Improves Position in Tech Readiness:UN**

India has emerged as a significant player in the global AI landscape, ranking 10th in private investments in AI in 2023, according to the United Nations' 2025 Technology and Innovation Report. The report, published by the UN Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), highlights that India is one of only two developing countries with substantial private AI investments, alongside China.

The report reveals that the US leads global AI investment, contributing USD 67 billion, which accounts for 70% of worldwide private investment. China follows in second place with USD 7.8 billion, while India ranks tenth with USD 1.4 billion. This marks a notable achievement for India in the evolving field of AI, with the technology expected to reach a market value of USD 4.8 trillion by 2033, transforming industries worldwide.

India has also shown improvement in the UNCTAD's Readiness for Frontier Technologies Index, rising from 48th place in 2022 to 36th in 2024. This index measures a country's ability to adopt and deploy cutting-edge technologies, combining factors like ICT deployment, research and development (R&D), skills, industrial capacity, and access to finance. India performed particularly well in R&D, ranking 3rd globally, but still faces challenges in ICT infrastructure (99th) and skills development (113th).

Despite these challenges, the report notes that India, along with other de-

veloping countries like China and Brazil, is outperforming its income level in technology readiness. The report emphasizes that AI and other frontier technologies, while offering productivity gains, could also exacerbate inequality if not managed properly. To mitigate this risk, the report stresses the importance of investing in workforce reskilling and adaptation.

AI is expected to reshape global economies, and while access to AI infrastructure remains concentrated in a few developed countries, nations like India are beginning to carve out their place in the AI revolution. The future, according to the report, will require global collaboration to ensure that AI benefits not just capital but workers as well, creating new industries and jobs.

Companies defend India's startup proposition after Piyush Goyal's jibe stirs debate

Several prominent Indian entrepreneurs rallied in defense of the startup ecosystem after Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal questioned the value and innovation of Indian startups. His remarks, made at a recent Startup Mahakumbh event, sparked a debate, especially from figures like Zepto CEO Aadit Palicha and Zoho founder Sridhar Vembu, who defended the contributions of startups in India.

Goyal had suggested that Indian startups should shift focus from consumer-based businesses like food delivery and ice cream production to high-tech sectors such as robotics, AI, and semiconductors. He criticized food delivery startups for creating jobs that, in his view, only turned youth into "cheap labor" for wealthy consumers. He further pointed to China's advancements in electric mobility and AI as a model for India to aspire to, urging Indian startups to be bolder in their approach.

Palicha, who co-founded Zepto, hit back, emphasizing that consumer internet companies like his have made significant contributions to job creation, foreign direct investment (FDI), and innovation in India's supply chain. He noted that Zepto alone



had created over 1.5 lakh jobs and contributed more than ₹1,000 crore in taxes annually. "We need to build great local champions in the internet sector," he argued, suggesting that consumer internet companies were integral to scaling technologies like cloud computing and AI, as seen with global giants like Amazon and Face-

Zoho's Sridhar Vembu supported Palicha, viewing Goyal's challenge as a call for engineers to solve India's technological hurdles. Vembu emphasized that smart engineers could overcome these challenges and bring India clos-

er to technological excellence.

Paytm founder Vijay Shekhar Sharma also chimed in, highlighting the maturity differences between India's startup ecosystem and those of more developed markets like the U.S. and China. He noted that India's ecosystem is still evolving, and its startups are playing to their strengths as they gradually mature.

While Goyal's remarks stirred controversy, the entrepreneurs underscored that India's startup ecosystem, though still developing, holds vast potential for future innovation and growth.


