In a significant step toward environmental sustainability, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has announced a statewide drive to eliminate single-use plastic by October 2 this year. During a review meeting on Circular Economy held at the Secretariat on Tuesday, the Chief Minister directed officials to enforce a complete ban on single-use plastic in Visakhapatnam, Vijayawada, Tirupati, Rajahmundry, and 17 other municipal corporations. Chandrababu Naidu directed officials to finalize a circular economy policy within two months to convert waste into valuable resources and attract green investments. As part of this, three circular economy parks will be established across the state within a year.

The first of these parks, planned on 400 acres in Visakhapatnam, will be built to international standards. The Chief Minister suggested studying similar successful models in oth-

AR Head Constable Alleges SIT Pressure in Liquor Case

In a shocking revelation, AR Head Constable Madan Reddy has written a letter to the Chief Minister, Deputy Chief Minister, and Director General of Police, alleging that he was pressured and assaulted by Special Investigation Team (SIT) officials in connection with the ongoing liquor case.

In the letter, Madan Reddy stated that he worked as a gunman for YSRCP leader and former MLA Chevireddy Bhaskar Reddy for ten years. He claimed that during his appearance before the SIT, officials coerced him into giving a statement implicating Chevireddy in the liquor case. According to him, the officials insisted he write and sign a statement dictated by them.

Further, Madan Reddy alleged that SIT officials scolded him for attending the inquiry in uniform and demanded that he falsely testify that Chevireddy was involved in the case. "When I refused to comply with their instructions and said I wouldn't give a false statement, ten SIT officials attacked me," he claimed in the letter.

- Sharmila's Phone Was Tapped??
- Calls allegedly monitored and information passed to Jagan

The sensational phone tapping case in Telangana has taken yet another dramatic turn. In the latest development, Andhra Pradesh Congress Committee (APCC) President YS Sharmila's name has surfaced among the list of those whose phones were reportedly tapped. These revelations point to a deeply rooted surveillance network that existed during the YSR Congress Party's (YSRCP) previous regime in Andhra Pradesh. According to sources close to the investigation, Sharmila's phones were allegedly tapped using sophisticated surveillance techniques during her brother YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's tenure as Chief Minister. Reports indicate that not only were her voice calls secretly recorded, but her call data and contacts were closely monitored as well. Alarmingly, it is being alleged that this data was regularly passed on to Jagan himself.



HM Anita Orders strict action, speaks to victim via video call



Andhra Pradesh Home Minister Vangalapudi Anita reacted sharply to the shocking incident in Narayanapuram village of Kuppam mandal, Chittoor district, where a woman was allegedly tied to a tree over non-payment of a debt. Terming it an inhumane and condemnable act, the minister assured full support from the government to the victim.

Home Minister Anita revealed that she immediately contacted Chittoor District SP V.N. Manikanta Chandolu and instructed him to submit a comprehensive report on the incident. She also directed the SP to ensure that the perpetrators are booked under relevant legal provisions and that the victim receives justice without delay. "This government will not tolerate attacks on the dignity and safety of women. We will ensure strict action is taken against those responsible. The victim will not be left alone—we will stand by her until justice is delivered," said Minister Anita in a statement.

The incident, which has sparked outrage across the state, has drawn attention to the ongoing issues of gender-based violence and local-level injustices in rural areas. The state government has reiterated its commitment to protecting women's rights and taking swift action in such cases.

- Woman tied to tree and assaulted over husband's debt
- Victim's son cries helplessly as mother is beaten

A disturbing incident of inhumanity has come to light in Narayanapuram under Kuppam municipality, Chittoor district, where a woman was tied to a tree and brutally assaulted over a debt incurred by her absconding husband. The heinous act has triggered widespread outrage across the region.

According to the police, Thimmarayappa, a resident of Narayanapuram, had borrowed ₹80,000 from a local named Munikannappa. Unable to repay the debt, he reportedly fled the village some time ago. His wife, Sirisha, originally from Kenchanaballa in Shantipuram mandal, has been working as a daily wage laborer in Bengaluru to support herself and her young son.

On Monday, Sirisha visited Narayanapuram to collect her son's Transfer Certificate (TC) from school. On learning of her presence, Munikannappa, along with his wife Munemma, son Raja, and daughterin-law Jagadeeswari, confronted her near the school. They demanded re-



payment of the money borrowed by her husband and, in a shocking act of brutality, forcibly dragged her to a nearby tree, tied her up, and began beating her.

A video of the incident shows the woman's young son crying helplessly as his mother was being assaulted. The sheer cruelty of the incident has sparked outrage, especially given that Sirisha had no role in the financial dealings of her husband and has been struggling to survive as a single parent.

Locals who witnessed the incident promptly alerted the police. Officers reached the spot and rescued Sirisha from the perpetrators. Chittoor police confirmed that a case has been registered against all four accused — Munikannappa, Munemma, Raja, and Jagadeeswari — and an investigation is underway.

The surveillance operation reportedly used code language to hide the identities of those under watch. Investigators believe that this was an attempt to prevent the leaks of sensitive information. Adding to the severity of the matter, it is being claimed that a senior police official even summoned individuals close to Sharmila and warned them over their association with her.

Sources say that Sharmila had already suspected that her phones were being tapped for quite some time and may possess evidence to support her claim. However, she has yet to make a formal public statement on this development.

With the SIT probe gaining momentum and more high-profile names coming to light, this case is snowballing into one of the most controversial political scandals in recent times. The public and political circles alike are now keenly watching for further revelations in what appears to be a systematic violation of privacy.

SIT terms Madhan Reddy's allegations completely baseless

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the high-profile Madhyam Kumbakonam liquor scam has refuted the allegations made by AR Head Constable Madhan Reddy, calling them "completely untrue and politically motivated." In an official press release issued from the SIT office in Vijayawada on June 17, the team clarified that no threats or physical coercion were used during the questioning of Madhan Reddy, who served as a gunman (PSO) to former Chandragiri MLA Chevireddy Bhaskara Reddy for nearly ten years.

The SIT stated that Madhan Reddy, who was summoned as part of the ongoing investigation into the liquor scam registered under multiple sections of IPC and the Prevention of Corruption Act, refused to cooperate during questioning and even threatened investigating officers. The case, originally registered at Mangalagiri CID police station under Crime No. 21/2024, has led to several arrests including prime accused Kessireddy Rajasekhara Reddy alias Raj. According to the SIT, evidence has surfaced that large sums of bribe money collected by Raj were routed to Chevireddy Bhaskara Reddy and allegedly distributed during elections. Based on this, the SIT called Madhan Reddy for questioning to gather further details, given his long-standing association with Chevireddy. In response to media reports and a petition filed by Madhan Reddy in the High Court alleging police harassment, the SIT has claimed that this is part of a broader conspiracy to hinder the probe. "These false narratives, including a recent habeas corpus petition regarding Balaji Kumar Yadav, seem to be orchestrated attempts to pressure the SIT and derail the investigation," the press note said.

Only 100 People Including Jagan Allowed: Palnadu SP Jagan to attend event in **Rentapala village**

YCP chief and former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy is scheduled to attend the unveiling of YCP activist Naga Malleswara Rao's statue in Rentapala village of Sattenapalli Rural Mandal, Palnadu district on Tuesday. However, Palnadu District SP Kanchi Srinivasa Rao has announced that only 100 people, including Jagan, will be permitted to attend the program due to security and logistical constraints.

Sattenapalli YCP in-charge Sudhir Bhargav Reddy had formally applied for police permission regarding Jagan's participation in the event. In response, SP Srinivasa Rao addressed the media, stating that while YCP leaders estimate a crowd of around 30,000 for the ceremony, the location does not support such a gathering.

"The road leading to the statue unveiling site is only ten feet wide and is flanked by residential houses on both sides. Given this limitation, accommodating a large crowd is not feasible," the SP explained. He further added that the decision to restrict the number of attendees was based on security assessments and past incidents at similar events elsewhere in the state.

To ensure smooth movement and avoid congestion, SP Srinivasa Rao mentioned that only three additional vehicles would be allowed to accompany Jagan's convoy.

He also warned that permissions were granted after thorough technical assessments and reiterated that any violations of the prescribed rules would invite legal action. "Our focus is on maintaining law and order and ensuring the safety of the leader and the public," he emphasized.

Outsourced teachers working in tribal Gurukul schools have raised serious concerns over the government's move to merge 1,143 tribal teacher posts into the General Mega DSC, which, as per Gurukul Bylaws, should be filled only through a special recruitment process. Teachers allege this action violates recruitment norms and has led to immense injustice to

those working under outsourcing contracts in tribal educational institutions.

These tribal Gurukul teachers have been receiving just ₹14,000 per month despite having higher qualifications, and the minimum time scale, as prescribed under the 10th, 15th, and 22nd PRC recommendations, is yet to be implemented. They pointed out that the outsourcing system is meant only for fourth-class employees, and no such arrangement will be strictly enforced during the event.

Chevireddy Detained at Bangalore Airport

YCP senior leader and former MLA Chevireddy Bhaskar Reddy has been detained by police at the Bengaluru International Airport in connection with the liquor scam case currently under investigation by the Special Investigation Team (SIT).

Sources said that a lookout notice had already been issued against Chevireddy as part of the probe. Acting on credible intelligence that he was arriving at the airport, police teams were deployed in advance and intercepted him upon arrival.

Chevireddy, who is accused of playing a role in the alleged irregularities in the liquor syndicate, has been under the scanner for several weeks. His movements were being closely monitored by the authorities after he reportedly evaded multiple summons issued by the SIT.

As per initial reports, the former MLA is likely to be shifted to the SIT office in Vijayawada for further questioning. Officials are yet to release an official statement, but more details are expected to emerge in the coming hours as the investigation progresses. The liquor scam has rocked political circles in Andhra Pradesh, and the detention of a prominent YCP leader like Chevireddy Bhaskar Reddy marks a significant development in the case.

Dangerous APK Files Can Empty Bank Accounts, Warns DGP

Andhra Pradesh DGP Shri Harish Kumar Gupta has warned citizens about the growing threat of cybercrime through malicious APK (Android Package) files being circulated on platforms like WhatsApp and Telegram. As smartphone usage and internet penetration increase, cybercriminals are exploiting unsuspecting users by sending fake app files that appear to be from trusted sources like PM Kisan Yojana, ICICI Bank, or SBI.

The DGP explained that these APKs, when installed, activate hidden malware or spyware that gains access to personal data including banking information, OTPs, passwords, contact lists, messages, and even gallery files. With this infor-



mation, criminals are draining entire bank accounts in a single click and, in some cases, resorting to blackmail.

Highlighting a recent case, the DGP shared that a farmer from Kana-

ceived a fake APK file named after the PM Kisan Yojana via WhatsApp. Mistaking it for an official app, the farmer downloaded and installed it, leading to a theft of ₹94,000 from his SBI account by cybercriminals. The DGP outlined the method used by these fraudsters: first, the user unknowingly downloads the app. Once installed, the malware activates and immediately begins harvesting personal and financial data. This stolen information is then used for unauthorized transactions or to impersonate the victim for further fraud.

To avoid falling victim, the DGP advised the public to strictly avoid downloading APK files from unknown sources, use only verified apps from the Google Play Store,

ganipally in Sathya Sai district re- and carefully check app permissions. He recommended keeping "Play Protect" turned on in the Play Store settings and installing trusted antivirus apps such as Avast, Norton, or Bitdefender.

> He also urged people to remain vigilant while using banking apps and to conduct transactions only through official applications. Stressing that awareness is the first line of defense, the DGP said cybercrimes can be prevented if citizens avoid suspicious links, ignore calls from unknown numbers, and never share sensitive information. Anyone who becomes a victim of

such fraud is encouraged to report immediately by calling the cybercrime helpline 1930 or lodging a complaint at www.cybercrime.gov. in.



Kanna lashes out at Jagan's Sattenapalli visit

TDP MLA Kanna Lakshminarayana has reacted sharply to former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's proposed visit to Sattenapalli in Palnadu district on Wednesday. The visit, intended for unveiling the statue of YSRCP leader Nagamalleshwara Rao who died by suicide last year, has stirred political heat in the region.

Kanna launched a scathing attack, stating, "If you trust Jagan, all that remains is destruction. He has not only betrayed his party workers but also ruined the lives of people who believed in him, including their families." He questioned the morality of unveiling a statue for a leader who allegedly took his own life due to losses in election betting.

Kanna highlighted that Nagamalleshwara Rao ended his life after reportedly losing Rs. 10 crore in election-related betting based on fake surveys propagated by



Jagan's team. "Unable to bear the harassment from lenders, he died by suicide on June 9, 2024. Now Jagan has come to unveil his statue—this is shameful," Kanna said.

The political drama intensified with four YSRCP municipal councilors from Sattenapalli joining the Telugu Desam Party just a day ahead of Jagan's visit. Kanna emphasized that the shift is a clear indication of dissatisfaction within the YSRCP's ranks. "Even his own party men have lost faith. If anarchic leaders like Jagan continue to mislead, his party will struggle to retain even 11 seats in the future," he said.

Kanna also reiterated that the people of Andhra Pradesh have already rejected the YSRCP's rule due to what he termed as its "anarchy and misrule," and that the 2024 general election result was a verdict against Jagan's leadership. The timing of Jagan's visit and the councilors' defection is expected to further intensify political developments in the region.

Vidadala Rajini slams govt for farmer suicides

Former minister Vidadala Rajini expressed deep concern over the suicides of two farmers in Nadendla mandal of Palnadu district. She said the deaths occurred due to the lack of Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for crops and rising debt burdens. After consoling the bereaved families at Chilakaluripet Government Hospital, she addressed the media and squarely blamed the ruling coalition government for these deaths, calling them "government murders." Rajini stated that the two farmers, Gopal Rao and Adinarayana, cultivated chilli, cotton, and tobacco but couldn't get fair prices for their produce. As a result, they fell into severe debt and ended their lives. She criticized the government for its year-long failure to provide MSP for any crop, despite repeated protests by farmers. She reminded that YS Jagan had recently visited Guntur Mirchi Yard and Podili Tobacco Auction Centers, demanding fair prices for farmers and warning of mass protests. She demanded immediate ex-gratia for the victims' families and reminded that during YS Jagan's tenure, support was extended through Rythu Bharosa Kendras and price stabilization funds. Rajini also condemned the incident in Kuppam where a woman was tied to a tree by a TDP worker, questioning the state's law and order.

Women are not safe under TDP rule: MLC Varudu Kalyani

Devotees Being Robbed in The Name of Parking

No action from officials despite repeated complaints Parking contractors illegally collect money on public roads Authorities remain silent despite videos going viral

Devotees visiting the famous Kanaka Durga temple in Vijayawada are being openly looted under the guise of parking charges, with little to no response from the authorities. Those who have taken contracts for parking management have not only occupied the allotted spaces but have also encroached upon public roads, including the road near the Ratham Center. Vehicles are being parked on both sides of the road, and exorbitant fees are being collected without any regulation.

Thousands of devotees visit temple every day, and the number surges during weekends. While parking facilities were officially allocated at

Rajagopuram Road and Omkaram on Ghat Road, private individuals managing these contracts have extended their control beyond the permitted zones. Shockingly, the road leading from the barrage to the bus stand — a key route for visitors — has also been turned into an illegal parking zone. Those who question the charges or practices are being threatened and, in some cases, physically attacked. The situation has worsened for locals and traders in One Town, the city's wholesale hub, who are being charged dou-

ble the parking fee. Even those who stop briefly to pick up elderly family members or children are being forced to pay. If they refuse, they are threat-

ened that their vehicles will not be allowed to move unless the demanded amount is paid.

People capturing these incidents on their phones and sharing them on social media are also being threatened by the parking staff. Despite repeated complaints to Durgagudi officials, the Vijayawada Municipal Corporation, and the police, no corrective action has been taken. It is alleged that both temple and municipal parking contractors are colluding in this unchecked exploitation.

These unlawful activities are not only causing immense inconvenience to devotees and traders but also damaging the public image of the newly



formed coalition government. The silence of the concerned departments is raising serious questions.

It is imperative that the Endowments Department, Corporation authorities, and police officials act immediately to put an end to this public exploitation.

Residents of New Ambapuram in NTR District have raised serious concerns over increasing anti-social activities near the Vikram Publishers junction on Pipe Road. With no functional streetlights in the area, the stretch has turned into a haven for miscreants—ranging from blade-wielding groups to ganja addicts and petty thieves—who have been harassing locals and creating an unsafe environment, especially after dusk.

Locals report that the area becomes a hub for activities such as public drinking, extortion, theft, and even harassment of women under the influence of substances. "There's no proper lighting. Men come drunk, threaten workers returning home, steal belongings and behave vulgarly with women," said a distressed resident. "We've approached the local Sarpanch Seethaiah several times, but he has only given us false assurances," another added.

Adding to the issue, residents say that heavy lorries frequently halt on this stretch at night, where some drivers reportedly indulge in immoral activities with women, taking advantage of the darkness and lack of surveillance. The combination of criminal behavior and infrastructure neglect has created a climate of fear among women who commute through this road for work or daily needs. The residents have appealed to officials including the local Electricity Department's AE and AD, the Police Department Commissioner, Circle Inspector, and the village Sarpanch Seethaiah, to urgently install streetlights and repair the pothole-ridden road. They believe that better lighting and a drivable road surface will discourage these unlawful activities and restore safety to their locality.

Coalition's Push Gets ₹2,787 Crore Sanctioned for Amaravati Projects

Women's Commission Committed to Protection and **Empowerment of Women: Dr. Archana Majumdar**

During her visit to Siddhartha Medical College, she inquired whether an ICC had been constituted and directed the management to set one up within a week. She also recommended that display boards with women safety measures and helpline numbers be installed across the college premises.

Helpline Boards and Awareness Urged

Dr. Archana stressed that problems faced by students, faculty, and employees should be addressed through the ICC first. "The Commission is focused not only on action but also on awareness and prevention. Women should feel safe, empowered, and heard at all levels," she stated.

State Women's Commission Chairperson Dr. Rayapati Sailaja, who accompanied her, said that if women do not receive justice from the ICC, they should escalate the issue to the State or National Women's Commission. "We are committed to ensuring that every woman works in a peaceful and harassment-free environment. Any form of sexual or dowry harassment will face strict consequences," she said.

The visit included interactions with college principal Dr. A. Edukondala Rao, ICDS officials, faculty members, and staff, where they discussed the steps to be taken to improve women's safety and institutional accountability.



China's Military Aggression: White Paper Reveals Underlying Pressures

Recent sightings of China's aircraft carriers—Liaoning and Shandong—operating near Japan's southern islands have triggered alarm across the Indo-Pacific. Simultaneously, an uptick in Chinese Coast Guard patrols near disputed Japanese territories has raised fears, especially after new Chinese guidelines permitted use of lethal force to enforce maritime claims.

A deeper look into China's newly released national security white paper offers insight into Beijing's growing belligerence. The document outlines a mix of internal vulnerabilities and external threats that Beijing believes endanger national stability. Central to this are economic concerns, geopolitical rivalries—especially with the US-and internal discontent.

Former US President Donald Trump's trade policies and continued economic decoupling have destabilized China's export-led growth model. This economic strain threatens the informal social contract where the Chinese middle class trades political freedoms for economic prosperity. Though the government projects around 5% GDP growth, economists like Gao Shanw-



en question the credibility of Externally, Beijing perceives deeper malaise.

Domestically, China fears color revolutions, religious and ethnic unrest, and growing dissent. These anxieties are compounded by turbulence within lia—appear to be calculated the People's Liberation Army (PLA), with high-level suspensions, disappearances of key military figures, and allegations of corruption. For India, the message is clear: it must remain alert and adapt its China strategy to navigate this increasingly complex regional landscape.

Beyond Utopia: Is India Addressing Inequality Effectively?

India's rise to become the world's fourth-largest economy in 2025, with a GDP of \$4.19 trillion, marks a major milestone. Yet, amid this economic success, questions persist: Is the growth inclusive? And is India doing enough to tackle inequality?

The Gini coefficient, a key measure of inequality, suggests some progress. According to the 2024-25 Economic Survey, rural inequality dropped from 0.266 in 2022-23 to 0.237 in 2023-24, while urban inequality fell from 0.314 to 0.284 in the same period. How- control just ever, critics argue that consumption-based metrics understate long-term wealth inequality, especially as lower-income groups tend to spend more than they earn. Reports offer mixed perspectives. Bhalla and colleagues (2022) observed that inequality in India had returned to levels seen in the early 1990s. Yet, the World Inequality Lab estimates that the top 1% earn 22.6% of the income and hold over 40% of the nation's wealth. while the bottom 50%

poorest—provides a roadmap. Government schemes like Ayushman Bharat and Poshan have helped reduce healthcare-related poverty risks. Between FY15 and FY22, public health spending rose significantly, while out-of-pocket costs dropped from 62.6% to 39.4%.

Additionally, India's success in reducing multidimensional poverty and supporting first-generation entrepreneurs through initiatives like Start-up India reflects a pragmatic approach to inclusion. Sustainconcerns about concentrated wealth and able economic growth, paired with investments in education, health, nutrition, and skill-building, can bridge social and economic gaps. In essence, while inequality may persist to some degree in any economy, India's challenge lies in ensuring upward mobility and equitable access to opportunity—not by hindering growth, but by empowering those at the bottom to become active participants in the nation's progress.



Who Truly Stands by India in Times of **Crisis?**

In the evolving global power game, recent events have laid bare an uncomfortable reality for Indian diplomacy: while Pakistan can count on China as a steadfast "all-weather friend," India finds itself increasingly isolated during moments of crisis. The May 2025 conflict with Pakistan, sparked by the Pahalgam terror attack, underscored this stark imbalance.

China's support for Pakistan was not only vocal but strategic. Beijing offered diplomatic backing and reportedly aided Islamabad with air defense and satellite intelligence. It even hinted at using the Brahmaputra waters as leverage after India threatened to revise the Indus Waters Treaty. China's motivations are clear: Pakistan is a key customer for its arms industry, a central node in its \$68 billion Belt and Road Initiative via the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor, and a means to counter India's regional influence and its deepening ties with the United States.

Meanwhile, India struggled to find strong allies. The U.S. under President Trump intervened during the conflict not in India's favor but with a neutral posture, promoting itself as a peace broker and even reviving the idea of international mediation on Kashmir—something India has long opposed. The result: India's diplomatic messaging was undercut, and the conflict was perceived internationally as a draw, not a deterrent success.

Even Russia, once a reliable partner, showed ambivalence. It remained silent on the terror attack and bolstered ties with Pakistan, launching infrastructure projects and train routes linking Lahore to Moscow. At the UN, India failed to gather support to raise concerns over Pakistan's use of international aid, while Pakistan secured influential UN posts.

Ironically, while India faces military threats from China

Only Israel and, briefly, Afghanistan, voiced clear support for India. But relying solely on transactional diplomacy and avoiding formal alliances may have weakened India's strategic leverage. As the China-Pakistan axis grows stronger, New Delhi may need to reconsider its approach to partnerships—because in a world of shifting alliances, transactional friendships may not be enough.

A Birthday Bash Amid Unrest: Trump's **Parade Overshadowed by Protests**

June 15, 2025, marked a turbulent turning point in American politics, coinciding with President Donald Trump's 79th birthday and a grand military parade in Washington, D.C., celebrating the 250th anniversary of the U.S. Army. The \$45-million spectacle, replete with tanks and troops, was intended as a display of national pride. Instead, it served to deepen political divides, as protests against recent immigration crackdowns escalated across California and beyond. The demonstrations, sparked by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) raids that began on June 6, quickly grew in scale and intensity. Protesters decried what they see as a militarised campaign targeting undocumented migrants. The situation worsened after 4,000 National Guard troops and 700 Marines were deployed to Los Angeles to suppress the largely peaceful protests—a move widely viewed as excessive and provocative.

California Governor Gavin New-



som and Los Angeles Mayor Karen Bass both voiced strong opposition to the federal crackdown, calling it an abuse of power. Their objec-

tions, however, were brushed aside by President Trump, who appears to be using federal muscle to assert his authority and silence dissent. Critics

argue that this approach not only undermines democratic norms but also risks further inflaming tensions. Ironically, Trump—who granted par-

dons to many involved in the January 6, 2021 Capitol riot—now presides over an administration using military force against peaceful American demonstrators. His actions have triggered concern over the growing politicisation of the armed forces and the erosion of constitutional checks on executive power.

While Trump's parade projected an image of strength, it has been overshadowed by nationwide outrage and a growing sense of unease. The use of the military to police domestic unrest evokes comparisons to authoritarian regimes and undermines the democratic ideals the parade was meant to honour.

What was meant to be a birthday celebration has instead revealed deep fractures within American society and governance. Rather than unifying the country, the events of the day have amplified fears of executive overreach and the dangerous blurring of lines between political power and military force.



PM Modi Arrives in Canada for G7 Summit Amid Renewed Diplomatic Engagement

Prime Minister Narendra Modi arrived in Canada on June 16, 2025, to attend the G7 Summit at Kananaskis, marking his first visit to the country in a decade. The summit, hosted by Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney, comes at a critical juncture in global geopolitics and bilateral relations. Mr. Modi is also scheduled to hold several bilateral meetings on the sidelines of the summit, including discussions on energy security, technology, innovation, and the AI-energy nexus.

The visit comes just over a month after India's Operation Sindoor, which targeted terrorist infrastructure in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir in retaliation for the April 22 Pahalgam terror attacks. The operation underscored India's commitment to national security and has been a focal point of international dialogue, including at the G7.

India Expands Nuclear Edge Over Pakistan with Canisterised, MIRV-Ready Missiles: SIPRI Report



relentless heatwave as heavy rain and strong winds swept the region on Tuesday, June 17. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) issued a red alert for Delhi, Noida, Ghaziabad, Faridabad, and surrounding areas in Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, and Rajasthan, warning of thunderstorms, hailstorms, and wind speeds reaching up to 70 kmph.

The change in weather brought welcome relief, with visuals from Noida and parts of Delhi showing heavy showers and cooler conditions. However, the IMD's red alert indicates potential risks due to intense weather activity, including flash flooding, falling trees, and power disruptions. The alert was issued around 2 PM and forecasted storms within two hours for several parts of North India.

The IMD advisory also warned that flight operations at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport could be disrupted due to adverse weather. "Our on-ground teams are coordinating with all stakeholders. Passengers are advised to contact their airlines for the latest updates," a statement from airport authorities read.

Following Tuesday's red alert, a yellow alert has been issued for the following days, indicating the possibility of continued rain and storms through Thursday.

Meanwhile, the city's air quality showed improvement, with the AQI recorded at a 'satisfactory' 96, and temperatures ranging from a minimum of 29°C to a maximum of 34°C.

Amid growing concerns over safety, Air India has cancelled two more international Boeing 787 Dreamliner flights one from Delhi to Paris and another from Ahmedabad to London — just days after the tragic crash of flight AI-171. The cancellations have heightened scrutiny around the airline's Dreamliner fleet, which has faced multiple technical snags in recent days.

Air India's Delhi-Paris flight (AI 143), scheduled for Tuesday, was grounded after mandatory pre-flight checks revealed a technical issue. The return flight (AI 142) from Paris to Delhi, planned for Wednesday, has also been cancelled due to the delay, which would breach night-time flying restrictions at Paris' Charles de Gaulle airport.

"We regret the inconvenience and are arranging alternate travel and hotel accommodation for affected passengers. Full refunds or complimentary rescheduling are also being offered," the airline said in a statement.

Earlier on Tuesday, the airline cancelled its Ahmedabad-London Gatwick service, citing airspace restrictions and precautionary checks in the aftermath of the AI-171 crash — a Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner that tragically crashed seconds after take-off from Ahmedabad on June 12, killing 241 of the 242 people on board. The aircraft crashed into buildings near the airport, including a college hostel, killing 33 people on the ground as well. Air India has since retired the "AI 171" call sign in tribute to the victims.

Following the crash, at least three other India-bound Boeing 787s operated by Air India, British Airways, and Lufthansa were forced to return to their departure airports due to technical faults. One Air India flight from Hong Kong to Delhi (AI-315) returned just 15 minutes after take-off due to an unspecified issue. Other incidents involved Dreamliners flying from Frankfurt to Hyderabad and London to Chennai.

On Tuesday, a San Francisco-Mumbai flight via Kolkata also experienced a left engine snag, prompting deplaning of passengers in Kolkata.

Investigators have recovered the Cockpit Voice Recorder and Flight Data Recorder from the crashed aircraft, and analysis is underway to determine the cause of the fatal incident.

India has strengthened its strategic edge over Pakistan by expanding its nuclear arsenal and advancing its delivery systems, according to the latest annual report by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), released on June 17, 2025.

The report estimates that India now possesses approximately 180 nuclear warheads, up from 172 in 2024. Alongside this modest expansion, India has made significant strides in modernising its nuclear delivery platforms. Notably, India is developing 'canisterised' missile systems, which allow nuclear warheads to be pre-mounted on missiles and safely transported even during peacetime. This technological leap enhances the readiness and survivability of India's nuclear arsenal.

Among the most advanced additions is the Agni Prime (Agni-P), a new-generation ballistic missile with a range of 1,000 to 2,000 km. It is fully canisterised and more accurate than its predecessors. India also successfully tested the MIRV-capable Agni-5 missile, capable of delivering multiple warheads to independent targets at distances exceeding 5,000 km. Prime Minister Narendra Modi hailed the success of this test, calling it a proud moment for India's defence establishment.

In addition, India tested a submarine-launched ballistic missile (SLBM) with a range of about 3,500 km, marking progress toward a credible second-strike capability.

SIPRI also observed that Pakistan, while continuing to develop its own nuclear platforms and increasing fissile material production, has not kept pace with India's recent advancements. The think tank warned of heightened escalation risks, referencing a brief India-Pakistan military confrontation in early 2025, which raised fears of potential nuclear miscalculation.

SIPRI further noted that China is rapidly expanding its nuclear arsenal, adding about 100 warheads annually and constructing around 350 new ICBM silos. China could match U.S. and Russian missile capabilities by 2030, SIPRI warned.

Globally, the total number of nuclear warheads stood at 12,241, with 9,614 in military stockpiles. Around 3,912 are deployed, with 2,100 on high operational alert. The report highlights a troubling global trend: while the dismantlement of warheads has slowed, deployment and modernisation efforts are accelerating across all nine nuclear-armed states.







Israeli Airstrike Kills Iran's Top Commander Ali Shadmani, Close Aide to Khamenei

In a significant escalation of the ongoing conflict, Israel announced on Tuesday that its military had killed Ali Shadmani, Iran's top military commander and a close aide to Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, in an overnight airstrike. The Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) confirmed that Shadmani, who served as Iran's wartime Chief of Staff, was eliminated during a targeted strike on a command center in the heart of Tehran.

According to a statement released by the Israeli military, the attack took place after "a sudden opportunity" emerged overnight. The airstrike targeted a key military installation, resulting in Shadmani's death. The IDF described Shadmani as "the most senior military commander" and one of the closest figures to Khamenei, playing a central role in both the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and the Iranian armed forces. The killing of Shadmani is seen as a major blow to Iran's military leadership. As the wartime Chief of Staff, he was responsible for coordinating operations between various military branches and playing a pivotal role in Iran's military strategy. His death will likely have profound implications for Iran's military operations, especially in the ongoing tensions with Israel.

Israel's military leadership emphasized that the strike was part of its broader efforts to neutralize high-ranking officials involved in planning and executing military operations that threaten Israeli security. Shadmani's death follows a series of Israeli airstrikes targeting key Iranian military figures and installations amid rising tensions in the region. This targeted strike underscores the intensifying conflict between Israel and Iran, with both nations engaged in a dangerous escalation of military actions that have already led to significant casualties on both sides. The situation remains volatile, and the geopolitical consequences of Shadmani's death are yet to unfold.

'Iran a source of instability': G7 **expresses support for Israel**

The Group of Seven (G7) nations issued a statement late Monday expressing strong support for Israel and condemning Iran as a principal source of instability in the Middle East. The leaders of the G7, comprising major global economies, reiterated Israel's right to self-defense and called for broader de-escalation in the region as hostilities between Iran and Israel intensified.

The conflict, which erupted on Friday when Israel launched airstrikes on Iran, marks a new chapter in the ongoing tensions between the two Middle Eastern nations. Israel's airstrike was described as a preemptive move aimed at halting Iran's potential nuclear weapon development. Since then, the two countries have exchanged attacks, with Iranian officials reporting over 220 deaths, mostly civilians, while Israel con-



firmed the deaths of 24 civilians on ity and terror." The statement also underscored that Iran "can never its side.

In the G7 statement, the leaders reaffirmed their commitment to Israel's security and labeled Iran as "the principal source of regional instabiling its right to peaceful nuclear technology under the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT). Israel, which is not a signatory to the NPT, is widely believed to possess nuclear weapons, although it neither confirms nor denies the claim.

As the situation in the Middle East worsens, U.S. President Donald Trump announced plans to leave the G7 summit early due to the escalating crisis. While the U.S. maintains it is not directly involved in the Israeli strikes, Trump praised Israel's actions, calling them "excellent." Washington has also warned Tehran against targeting U.S. interests or personnel in the region.

The G7 urged the resolution of the Iranian crisis to lead to a broader de-escalation of hostilities, including a ceasefire in Gaza, and vowed to work together to stabilize energy markets affected by the conflict.

Germany, France, and UK Offer Immediate **Nuclear Talks to Iran Amid Middle East Tensions**

Germany, France, and the United Kingdom have offered to hold immediate negotiations with Iran regarding its nuclear program in a bid to ease escalating tensions in the Middle East. German Foreign Minister Johann Wadephul, currently visiting the region, emphasized the urgency of de-escalating the conflict between Israel and Iran through diplomatic engagement.

Speaking to German broadcaster ARD on Saturday, Wadephul expressed hope that Iran would accept the offer for talks, despite Tehran's previous reluctance to engage constructively. Iran Accuses Israel of Sabotaging Nuclear Talks Amid Rising Conflict

Iran's Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi accused Israel of deliberately trying to derail ongoing nuclear negotiations with the United States as tensions between the two nations escalated sharply. The comments came after Israel launched deadly strikes on Iranian nuclear and military sites, killing several and sparking retaliatory missile attacks by Iran on Israeli territory.

Araghchi stated that Iran's

missile barrages on Israel would cease only if Israel ended its military campaign against Iran. He emphasized that Iran's actions were purely in self-defense and that Tehran did not seek to expand the conflict to neighboring countries unless forced. However, he warned that Israeli strikes on the South Pars gas field shared by Iran and Qatar—were a dangerous provocation aimed at widening the war beyond Iranian borders.

The foreign minister condemned Israel for crossing a "new red line" by attacking Iran's nuclear facilities, which he said was a blatant violation of international law. He further accused Israel of sabotaging the sixth round of Iran-US nuclear talks, which had been scheduled for Sunday but were postponed due to the recent escalations. Araghchi insisted that Israel does not want a diplomatic resolution or an



agreement on the nuclear issue.

Araghchi also accused the United States of backing Israel's military campaign, claiming Iran has solid evidence that American forces and bases supported Israel's attacks. He expressed skepticism over U.S. denials and called on Washington to condemn the Israeli strikes on Iran's nuclear sites to demonstrate true goodwill.

Finally, the Iranian minister criticized the United Nations Security Council for its perceived indifference toward Israel's attacks. He said Western nations have unfairly condemned Iran instead of Israel, despite Iran being the party whose sovereignty was violated. The escalating conflict continues to cast a shadow over delicate nuclear negotiations and regional stability.

Russian Missile and Drone Strike on Kyiv Kills 15

Injures Over 100 in One of the Deadliest Attacks of 2025

In a devastating overnight assault, Russia launched a massive missile and drone attack on Ukraine, killing at least 15 people and injuring 116 others, Ukrainian officials reported on Tuesday, June 17. The brunt of the attack hit the capital, Kyiv, where explosions rocked the city for hours, leaving widespread destruction and panic.

Tymur Tkachenko, head of the Kyiv City Military Administration, confirmed that 14 people were killed and 99 injured in Kyiv alone. A nine-story residential building was directly hit, collapsing dozens of apartments and trapping residents under rubble. Emergency crews, including over 2,000 personnel, rushed to the scene to rescue survivors and tend to the wounded.

In the southern port city of Odesa, a separate Russian drone strike killed one person and injured 17 more, according to Oleh Kiper, head of the regional administration.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy condemned the assault as "one of the most terrifying strikes on Kyiv" and revealed that Russian forces had launched more than 440 drones and 32 missiles in the overnight bombardment. He accused Russian President Vladimir Putin of prolonging the war intentionally and criticized global leaders for failing to act decisively.



"There's no military infrastructure here - nothing. Just civilians dying at night," said Olena Lapyshniak, a 49-year-old Kyiv resident whose building was nearly leveled. Witnesses described hearing a whistling sound followed by powerful blasts that destroyed windows and doors in nearby homes.

Interior Minister Ihor Klymenko revealed that a U.S. citizen died in the attack due to shrapnel wounds. Fires also broke out in multiple districts after Ukrainian air defenses shot down several drones, causing debris to fall across the city.

The attack coincided with the G7 Summit in Canada, which Zelenskyy was scheduled to attend. However, U.S. President Donald Trump unexpectedly returned to Washington early due to rising tensions in the Middle East. Peace talks between Russia and Ukraine have seen little progress, except for planned prisoner exchanges expected next week.



Russian Oil Freight Rates Ease, EU Price Cap Could Shift Trend



 $F^{\rm reight}$ rates for Russian oil shipments from Baltic ports to India have eased from late May to early June, primarily due to increased tanker availability. However, this downward trend may be reversed if the European Union's newly proposed sanctions, including a reduction in the Group of Seven (G7) price cap on Russian crude oil, are implemented.

The EU has put forward a fresh sanction package targeting Russia over the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. A key element is the proposal to lower the G7 price cap on Russian crude from \$60 per barrel to \$45 per barrel. The G7 and EU initially introduced the \$60 price ceiling in late 2022 to limit Moscow's oil revenues by restricting access to Western shipping and insurance services for crude sold above that price.

Since early April, the price of Russia's flagship Urals crude has remained below the \$60 cap, allowing Western shipowners, especially from Greece, to resume transporting Russian oil. This has significantly boosted tanker availability, which in turn has pressured freight rates downward.

As of mid-June, Urals crude prices at Russia's Baltic ports, including Primorsk and Ust-Luga, hovered around \$54.72 per barrel. Correspondingly, shipping costs from these ports to India dropped to between \$5.5 million and \$5.7 million per one-way voyage, down from approximately \$6 million in April and May, and much lower than the \$8 million recorded in early March. Despite the easing, freight rates remain elevated compared to January levels, when shipping costs were between \$4.7 million and \$4.9 million per trip. The increase earlier this year followed new U.S. sanctions introduced in January targeting Russian energy interests, which forced Russian oil exporters to seek alternative tankers to replace those affected by restrictions. The potential implementation of the EU's proposed lower price cap could tighten market conditions once again, pushing freight rates higher and complicating shipping logistics for Russian crude to India and other destinations.

New Steel Import Rule May Disrupt Supply Chains, Increase Costs for MSMEs: GTRI

The Global Trade Research Initiative (GTRI) has raised concerns over a recent regulation issued by India's Ministry of Steel, warning that the new rule could disrupt supply chains and impose significant compliance costs on the country's

micro, small, and medium enterprises (MS-MEs).

According to GTRI, the sudden implementation of the regulation has caused panic among MSMEs reliant on imported semi-finished steel, with fears of substantial financial losses and potential factory closures. The rule, announced on June 13, mandates that not only finished or semi-finished steel products but also the raw materials used in their manufacture must comply with Indian Standards (IS) and be registered on the Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS) portal.

This regulation affects all products under India's Quality Control Orders (QCOs). Previously, foreign exporters were required to obtain Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) certification only for finished steel products. Now, raw materials such as billets, slabs, or hotrolled coils must also meet BIS standards be-



fore import.

For example, if a Malaysian firm supplies steel slabs to a Vietnamese company that processes them into steel sheets for export to India, both companies must now obtain BIS certification. GTRI pointed out that many

importers have already paid advances for shipments scheduled to arrive between June and August, which now risk being deemed non-compliant despite contracts being finalized months earlier.

The report also criticized the exemption of finished products like welded pipes from the traceability requirement, calling it inconsistent, especially since BIS officials already inspect and certify finished products at overseas factories.

GTRI highlighted that BIS certification for upstream suppliers can take six to nine months, yet the ministry enforced the new rule with only three days' notice and no stakeholder consultation. The organization urges the government to reconsider the move, warning that without relief or an extension, widespread factory closures and financial distress among MSMEs could follow.

the father penguin endures the brutal their documentary Secrets of the Pen-Antarctic winter without food, never abandoning the egg-not even for a moment.



At the WTC final at Lord's, ICC Chair Jay Shah reportedly expressed support for sanctioning four-day Tests starting with the 2027–29 cycle. However, marquee series like the Ashes, the Border-Gavaskar Trophy, and the newly named Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy between England and India will maintain the traditional five-day format. The Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy is set to debut with the first Test at are set to play multiple five-day Headingley this Friday.



Tn a landmark judgment, the Supreme Court of India has allowed the release of Thug Life in Karnataka, pulling up the state government for yielding to mob pressure and failing to uphold the rule of law. The film, starring Kamal Haasan and directed by Mani Ratnam, was caught in controversy following Haasan's remarks on the Kannada language, which triggered protests from pro-Kannada groups.

As tensions rose, the Karnataka Film Chamber of Commerce (KFCC) halted the release of the film, citing threats of violence. The Supreme Court took strong exception to this, stating that a film cleared by the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) cannot be blocked due to mob pressure, political sentiments, or threats of unrest. The Court transferred the case to itself, overriding the Karnataka High Court, which had controversially suggested that Haasan issue an apology — a move the apex court called an "overreach" of judicial boundaries.

The Court also directed the Karnataka government to ensure police protection for theatres choosing to screen Thug Life and demanded a compliance report by June 18, 2025. This ruling is being hailed as a significant win for artistic freedom and a bold stance against mob censorship and unofficial bans.

Despite the legal green light, the film's release date in Karnataka is yet to be confirmed. Meanwhile, Thug Life has underperformed at the box office, with mixed reviews and a lukewarm audience response. Industry sources suggest that the film may arrive on OTT platforms soon.

This Supreme Court intervention reinforces the constitutional protection of creative expression, sending a strong message against the rising trend of mob vetoes in India's entertainment industry.


