The Andhra Cricket Association (ACA) has landed in a major controversy after the Andhra Pradesh High Court issued an interim order halting its tender process for the Andhra Premier League (APL), following a legal challenge by six existing franchises.

The dispute emerged after ACA's recent leadership changes, where the newly elected Vijayawada MP assumed the role of ACA President through the Kurnool District Association—raising Cricket eyebrows across cricketing circles. The President further appointed Chartered Accountant as his Treasurer, while Sana Satish was named Secretary and Prashanth, linked to MLAs from Bhimavaram and Visakhapatnam, became Vice President. The developments that took place during the two visits of former AP CM YS Jagan Mohan Reddy to Palnadu district have become highly controversial. It surprised everyone that Jagan visited a person who had incurred debts due to betting and even unveiled a statue.

Jagan's speech there, in a way that seemed to appeal to the Kamma community, also surprised many. The loss of two lives during Jagan's visit has becomes a controversial issue. TDP leaders extended significant help to the families. Meanwhile, there was a lot of chaos caused by YCP workers and fans during Jagan's tour. Girls were seen filming themselves riding bikes and challenging the police. Some even went a step further by putting up posters with movie dialogues — this has now turned into the most controversial point.

A placard with the "Rapa Rapa" dialogue during YS Jagan's Palnadu tour has stirred up a storm. As soon as he comes to power in 2029, a YCP fan named Ravi Teja displayed a placard saying he would "chop the heads of the hunters just like they chopped the heads of the hunters at the Gangamma Thalli Jatara." This went viral on social media.

TDP leaders reacted strongly to this. "Who will be chopped? Why will they be chopped?" they asked. At the same time, Home Minister Anita also commented that the entire "psycho batch" is behind Jagan. During the same tour, another placard stating that "Raja Reddy's constitution started from Palnadu" also became controversial. In this context, YS Jagan held a press meet in Tadepalli following the arrest of Chevireddy Bhaskar Reddy. He claimed that the government had arrested Chevireddy by filing false cases. As an opposition leader, he questioned why the TDP was afraid of the PAR activists. He also questioned why the police had set up barricades. Jagan criticized Chandrababu for implementing diversionary tactics and said that false cases were being filed against YSRCP leaders and that people around him were being arrested through intimidation. He alleged that there was a conspiracy to destroy the properties of witnesses. He warned that if this tradition continued, then who would be spared tomorrow? Jagan also responded to a question asked by reporters about the

serious concerns about rising political interference in cricket administration.

Despite an 18-year agreement with the franchises, ratified last year by the General Body and Governing Council, ACA invited fresh tenders for APL. In response, franchise owners who have together invested over ₹30 crore without returns—moved the High Court on June 5. The Court issued a stay on June 6 and extended it on June 19 for another 10 days. The franchises, credited with sustaining the league and nurturing IPL-leveltalent, now face uncertainty. The move has triggered public outrage, with many questioning the sidelining of long-term investors. Fans and stakeholders are calling for transparency, fairness, and accountability to protect Andhra cricket's credibility.

Amaravati: After years of uncertainty and political setbacks, the muchanticipated Happy Nest project in Amaravati is finally back on track, bringing new hope to thousands of middle-class families and NRIs who invested in their dream homes. Launched on 1st November 2018 by the then TDP-led government under the Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA), the Happy Nest project consists of 1,200 modern 2 & 3 BHK apartments. The public response was nothing short of overwhelming—during the first and second phases of online bookings held on 9th November and 10th December 2018, 1,185 flats were sold within minutes, leaving only 15 units unsold.



However, with the change in government in 2019, the YSRCled administration under Mr. Y.S. Jaganmohan Reddy deprioritized Amaravati's development, proposing a controversial three-capital model that pushed Amaravati into the

hoping for political change and revival of the capital city.

With the new alliance government assuming power recently, CRDA has resumed capital development activities at full pace. Under the active leadership of Mr. K. Narayana, Minister for Municipal Administration & Urban Development, tenders have been floated and budget approvals expedited. The Happy Nest project has also been revived with NCC Ltd., the original contractor, continuing the construction work.

Given the passage of time and increase in material costs, the project costs have been reassessed and revised, triggering criticism from YSRC leaders and their aligned media outlets. Ironically, it was their own halting of the project that

led to the delays and cost escalations, which they are now blaming on the present administration.

Despite the political noise, construction has resumed with renewed Vigor. The project is slated for completion within one year. The remaining 200 flats, including the previously unsold 15 units and 185 cancelled ones, are expected to be made available for fresh online bookings in the coming months. The pricing will likely reflect current market rates.

The buyers from 2018 are jubilant. After a long wait, they are finally seeing their dream of living in Amaravati—a modern capital city—become a reality. For them, Happy Nest is not just a housing project; it is a symbol of hope, patience, and victory.

"Rapa Rapa" placard. He claimed that the activist holding the placard belonged to the TDP. He wondered aloud whether even a TDP supporter would switch to PAR out of anger at Chandrababu. However, referring to the dialogue taken from the movie Pushpa, he questioned whether it was wrong to use it. He did not deny the controversial message on the placard. In fact, he appeared to justify it, stating that the TDP people would be beheaded like rams — and called it a good thing.

With this, it appears that Jagan was indirectly saying that attacks might be inevitable once he returns to power. Phrases like "they will be beheaded... my sons... we will see" are being circulated as if they were movie dialogues.

In short, a major tussle is now unfolding between the TDP and YSRCP leaders.

The Kadapa Municipal Corporation general meeting will be held after six months. The controversy that started with the mayor and MLA Madhavi Reddy being seated on the stage in the general meeting hall eventually turned into a storm of chaos. As a result, three meetings turned into heated debates, and on December 30, 2024, Kadapa MLA Madhavi filed a complaint with the Chief Minister and DGP offices, accusing Mayor Suresh Babu of corruption for assigning work to his family members. Vigilance officials conducted an investigation and found that Mayor Suresh Babu had violated the provisions of the Municipal Corporation Act. The investigation revealed that Vardhini Constructions, which belongs to his family members, had completed seven out of ten tenders for the works and received bills worth Rs. 33.65 lakhs. Based on this report, the Municipal Administration Department disqualified him. The Andhra Pradesh Municipal Administration Department Chief Secretary issued orders to this effect, stating that Suresh Babu was being removed from the post of Kadapa Mayor based on the vigilance report. However, the YSRCP approached the court on this matter. The High Court refused to interfere with the order given by the Chief Secretary of the Municipal Administration Department. However, Suresh Babu got relief after the Divi-



sion Bench stayed the verdict given ing this. The Division Bench ordered by the Single Bench.

General Assembly Meeting Not Held for Six Months:

The general assembly meeting has been turning into a heated affair due to the ongoing row in the Kadapa Municipal Corporation. As a result, the meeting has not been held for six months. But as per the rules, if it is not held again within six months, the governing body is likely to be dissolved. Now, with the deadline approaching, the current developments are creating great excitement.

Municipal Department Sends Notices Again:

The office had stated earlier that the orders would come into effect two weeks after the mayor was removed from office. The mayor appealed to the High Court Division Bench regard-

that he be given another opportunity to present his case. Accordingly, the municipal department sent another notice to the mayor on June 16, but Suresh Babu refused to accept it. It is reported that he said he would accept it on Wednesday. However, it is also reported that he took his lawyer with him and presented his case to the municipal department. Since the matter is within the jurisdiction of the court, the municipal department cannot take further action at this stage.

YCP Corporators' Plea for Security: As per the YCP's plea, the court has issued orders to provide security to the corporators and ensure that the meeting runs smoothly. Following the court's orders, it is the responsibility of the authorities to ensure that

the general meeting of the municipal corporation is conducted in an orderly manner. The YCP corporators have already submitted a petition to the Collector and SP, requesting security arrangements to ensure a smooth meeting. They alleged that the authorities have been acting as puppets of the TDP by not organizing the municipal corporation's budget and general meetings for the past six months, and that they have not responded to repeated requests for access to the council meeting hall over the past two months. They accused the authorities of acting in a dictatorial manner by allowing the commissioner to retain control over the council meeting hall. They said the authorities are acting as they please, without implementing decisions made in previous meetings, and claimed that not a single rupee has been sanctioned to the municipal corporation since the coalition government came to power. They also criticized that the tax paid by the public through the General Fund is being diverted for other programs. Both Parties Ready for the General Meeting:

While the general meeting of the Kadapa Municipal Corporation has become a hot topic since the coalition government came to power, both parties are now prepared for the meeting scheduled on Friday. With the court issuing orders to conduct the meeting smoothly, both parties have instructed their workers to be available. The YCP corporators brought to the court's attention that TDP workers were entering the meeting hall and obstructing the proceedings. The court, in response, ordered that the YCP corporators be provided with protection. In this context, the authorities and police have become the focus of attention in how they will handle the conduct of this crucial meeting.



Chevireddy appears in **ACB** court in AP liquor scam case

In a surprising turn in the AP liquor scam case, YSR Congress Party senior leader and former Chandragiri MLA Chevireddy Bhaskara Reddy personally argued his case before the ACB court. Produced by the SIT officials on Wednesday, Chevireddy contested several claims made against him and requested the court for certain facilities in jail due to health reasons.

During the proceedings, Chevireddy clarified that Balaji, who the SIT claims to be his personal assistant, is actually a government employee. He also highlighted that those in nominated posts are not permitted to use official vehicles during elections, adding that the Election Commission closely monitors such violations.

Chevireddy further stated that he frequently travels to Colombo as part of his export business and was unaware of any legal case against him. He claimed he was stopped at the Bangalore airport by immigration authorities who informed him about a Look-Out Circular (LOC) in his name.

Alleging coercion by the police, Chevireddy said that his gunman Giri was pressured into giving a statement favorable to the SIT, while another gunman, Madan Reddy, was assaulted for not complying and is currently receiving treatment in hospital.

Following the arguments and submission of the remand report by SIT, Chevireddy pleaded with the court for special facilities in jail, citing severe back pain. Considering the request, the ACB magistrate granted him permission to have a bed, pillow, blanket, and mosquito net during his remand period.

Second Round RTE Lottery **Results to Be Released Today**

Final selection list for 2025–26 admissions under 25% RTE quota

Over 28,000 students eligible, fresh SMS alerts to be sent

Admissions to be confirmed by June 30 at allotted schools

The final selection list of students under the second round of the lottery process for free admissions into private schools through the Right to Education (RTE) 25% reservation will be released today (June 20, 2025). This was announced by B. Srinivasa Rao, IAS, State Project Director, Samagra Shiksha. As per the notification, the RTE admissions were open for

Class 1 from May 2 to May 19 for the 2025-26 academic year. Out of 37,427 applications received, 28,561 children were found eligible after verification. In the first round of the lottery, 23,118 students were allotted seats, and 15,541 of them have already joined their respective schools.

Relief For PSR In Kadambari Jethwani Case

High Court stays action, merges petition with other accused

In a major relief to IPS officer PSR Anjaneyulu, the Telangana High Court has issued interim orders staying all further proceedings against him in the Kadambari Jethwani case. The case, which was registered by the Ibrahimpatnam police, involves serious allegations made by the film actress against several police officials, including three IPS officers. Justice N Harinath, who issued the interim orders, also di-

rected the High Court Registry to merge PSR Anjaneyulu's petition with the pending petitions of other accused officers in the same case — IPS Kantirana Tata, Vishal Gunni, ACP K Hanumantha Rao and CI M Satyanarayana. The court had already granted a stay on proceedings against them in May this year. The case stems from a complaint lodged by actress Kadambari Jethwani, who alleged that the Ibrahimpatnam police filed a false case against her based on a complaint by YSR Congress Party leader Kukkala Vidyasagar. She accused the police of harassing her and acting in coordination with political interests. Unlike the others, Anjaneyulu had earlier been denied anticipatory bail and was subsequently arrested and sent to judicial remand as per court directions. With the latest High Court order, he now gets temporary relief from further legal proceedings in the matter. The High Court's decision to club all related petitions for a consolidated hearing is seen as a significant step in addressing the allegations comprehensively. Further hearings in the case are expected to take place in the coming weeks.

High Court's Jolt to Harsha Kumar in Pastor Praveen PIL Bench questions need for fresh PIL, asks for ₹5 lakh deposit

The Andhra Pradesh High Court on Wednesday delivered a significant blow to former MP Harsha Kumar over his public interest litigation (PIL) filed in connection with the controversial death of Pastor Praveen Pagadala. The court, while admitting the PIL, raised serious concerns over its maintainability and questioned the necessity of filing a new PIL when two others on the same matter were already pending.

Thakur and Justice Chimalapati Ravi heard the arguments presented by Harsha Kumar's counsel. During the proceedings, the bench critically examined the basis of the petition, asking whether there was any concrete evidence that Pastor Praveen was murdered.

Referring to photographic and situational evidence showing Praveen visiting a liquor shop and driving a vehicle afterward, the bench remarked that such actions were a "dangerdrawn without facts.

The judges also questioned Harsha Kumar's locus standi in the case, noting that he was neither a family member nor directly connected to the deceased. "Why is a third PIL necessary on the same issue when two others are already under consideration?" the bench asked. In a move that surprised many, the court ordered Harsha Kumar to deposit ₹5 lakh with the High Court Registry within two weeks if he The division bench compris- ous combination," suggesting wished to pursue the matter.

The High Court's questioning has cast a shadow on Harsha Kumar's petition, raising doubts about its intent and legal merit.

Is the US Planning to Attack Iran?



Tensions between the United States and Iran have reached a boiling point, especially following recent statements by US President Donald Trump. On Tuesday, Trump took to social media, calling for Iran's "UNCONDITIONAL SURRENDER" and even threatened Iran's Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, stating that the US knew where he was hiding but "didn't want him killed for now." These alarming threats came shortly after Trump cut short his participation at the G-7 summit in Canada, focusing instead on America's strategy in Israel's ongoing conflict with Iran.

The United States has already ramped up its military presence in the Middle East, with the deployment of a US Navy Carrier Strike Group, led by the USS Nimitz, and A key factor fueling these tensions is the

B-2 Spirit bombers stationed at Diego Garcia in the Indian Ocean. These bombers are capable of carrying massive bunker-buster bombs, specifically the GBU-57 MOP, which can be used to target Iran's underground nuclear facilities.

This escalation comes amid growing fears of a broader conflict. Trump's rhetoric has sparked speculation that the US might launch airstrikes on Tehran or other key locations in Iran. Trump's call for the evacuation of Tehran has led to massive congestion on the city's roads as citizens scramble to flee. Many countries, including India, have issued advisories urging their citizens to leave Iran.

PM Modi's Canada Visit: **A Diplomatic Reset Under Carney's Leadership**

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent visit to Canada has marked a significant diplomatic shift between New Delhi and Ottawa, with India's firm stance and patient diplomacy finally yielding results. Following a period of strained relations under Justin Trudeau, Canada's new Prime Minister, Mark Carney, has made crucial moves to recalibrate ties, signaling a thaw in what was once a frosty relationship.

The turning point came with Carney's recognition of India's concerns regarding terrorism, particularly the activities of Khalistani extremists within Canada. Unlike Trudeau, whose rhetoric often fueled tensions, Carney adopted a more pragmatic approach. During Modi's visit, Carney acknowledged issues of "transnational repression" while also addressing the sensitive Nijjar case with caution. This careful tone was a stark contrast to Trudeau's earlier political theatrics, which had caused a significant rift.

One of the major outcomes of the summit was an agreement between the two countries to resume regular diplomatic services, including the designation of new high commissioners. This deal also included a pact for intelligence sharing on terrorism and organized crime, directly addressing India's longstanding concerns about Khalistani militants and other extremists operating in Canada.

Modi's diplomatic approach, focusing on clear red lines without responding to provocations, has proven successful. His steady, non-confrontational stance ensured that India's core concerns—security, terrorism, and criminal activities were front and center in discussions. By not engaging in unnecessary theatrics, Modi allowed the facts to speak for themselves, compelling Canada to acknowledge the reality of the situation.

Why It's Best To Expect the **Unexpected From Israeli Warfare**





One of the most crucial lessons in understanding conflicts in the Middle East is that conventional wisdom often fails when it comes to Israel. Time and time again, Israel has defied expectations with its audacious and unorthodox military strategies, demonstrating a unique approach that reflects its existential need for survival.

The 1967 Six-Day War is perhaps the most glaring example of Israel's ability to turn the tide in its favor against seemingly overwhelming odds. At the time, most Indian and international publications, particularly those sympathetic to the Arab cause, were confident that Israel would soon be crushed by the combined might of Egypt, Syria, and Jordan. Yet, within six days, Israel had transformed the Middle East's map, capturing Jerusalem, the Golan Heights, and the Sinai Peninsula. The decisive factor was Israel's preemptive strike, which wiped out the Egyptian air force, ensuring the conflict was all but won in the first hours of the war.

Since then, Israel's military actions have been marked by a consistent pattern of doing the unexpected, whether through the swift retaliation against Palestinian terrorists responsible for the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre or the surgical strikes against Hezbollah's leadership in recent years. These operations are not just about military might but reflect a deeper survival instinct— Israel operates under the constant threat of annihilation, and its unorthodox tactics reflect this existential struggle.

The current conflict with Iran underscores Israel's strategic unpredictability. Despite not sharing a common border with Iran, Israel views the regime in Tehran as a grave threat to its existence. Iran's ambitions, particularly its nuclear program, are seen as a direct challenge to Israel's security. Israel's goal, however, extends beyond merely dismantling Iran's nuclear capabilities. It seeks the overthrow of Iran's theocratic regime, a shift towards democracy, and the end of Iran's hegemonic ambitions in the Middle East.

What's particularly alarming is that Israel's air force enjoys almost complete dominance over Iranian skies, and with its reputation for boldness, one must expect the unexpected in the coming phases of this conflict. The outcome remains uncertain, but Israel's drive to survive will likely ensure that its strategies remain unorthodox and surprising.

Is India Addressing Inequality Amid Economic Growth?

However, some experts argue that the Gini coefficient, based on consumption, fails to capture long-term wealth inequality, as high-income households tend to save more than they spend.

Reports such as Bhalla Surjeet's "Pandemic, Poverty, and Inequality" (2022) indicate that inequality has actually decreased in recent years, but concerns remain about the concentration of wealth among the top 1%. According to the World Inequality Lab, the top

Justice Yashwant Varma Faces Impeachment Call Over Cash Scandal

SC Panel Finds Misconduct Proven

New Delhi, June 19, 2025 — A Supreme Court-appointed panel has found serious misconduct against Justice Yashwant Varma, currently serving in the Allahabad High Court, and recommended his removal over the discovery of a large amount of half-burnt cash at his official residence. The inquiry, led by Chief Justice Sheel Nagu of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, concluded that Justice Varma and his family had "covert or active control" over the store room where the money was stored.

The three-judge panel—comprising Justices G.S. Sandhawalia and Anu Sivaraman alongside Justice Nagu-conducted a 10-day investigation, recorded statements from 55 witnesses, and reviewed surveillance and physical evidence. The blaze that uncovered the scandal broke out on March 14 at 11:35 p.m. at Varma's residence at 30 Tughlak Crescent, New Delhi.

In its 64-page report, the panel cited "strong inferential evidence" proving that the charred

'Razor Blade Throat' Covid Variant Nimbus (NB.1.8.1) **Spreads In Indian**

TPN Correspondent | Delhi New Delhi, June 19, 2025 – A new COVID-19 subvariant, NB.1.8.1 — nicknamed Nimbus or the "razor blade throat" variant — is rapidly gaining attention globally and in India. This emerging strain is known for its particularly painful sore throat symptom, which some patients have described as feeling like "swallowing razor blades."

Although the World Health Organization (WHO) has designated Nimbus as a "variant under monitoring," current data suggests it may not be more severe than previous strains. However, it is spreading swiftly across multiple regions and contributing to a noticeable uptick in COVID-19 cases.

Where Has Nimbus Spread? Originally detected in parts of China and Hong Kong, Nim-

India's ICE Dominance Shields Auto Sector from China's Rare Earth Export Curbs

India's automotive sector is expected to remain largely unaffected by China's recent restrictions on rare earth material (REM) exports, thanks to its overwhelming reliance on internal combustion engine (ICE) vehicles. According to a report by Nuvama, over 95% of vehicles in India are ICE-powered, which drastically reduces the country's vulnerability compared to nations with higher electric vehicle (EV) adoption.

China's April 2025 decision to restrict the export of seven critical rare earth elements-including samarium, dysprosium, and scandium—was primarily targeted at the defence sector. However, the impact is expected to ripple through the auto, aerospace, and industrial sectors globally, especially in EV manufacturing.

The report highlights that REMs are essential for producing permanent magnets used in EV motors, especially Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motors (PMSMs). These motors depend heavily on rare earths



to function effectively at high temperatures. REM demand varies by vehicle type—electric vehicles use around 0.8 kg per unit, hybrids 0.5 kg, and ICE vehicles just 0.1 kg.

As a result, India's EV and hybrid segments will bear the brunt of the supply restrictions. However, with EV penetration still low—about 7% in two-wheelers and 3% in passenger vehicles-the overall impact on the auto sector is expected to be minimal. EV sales have grown at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 25% between FY23 and FY25, but this growth comes from a relatively small base. Automakers relying on rare earth-based components will now be required to secure end-user certifications from the Chinese government, a process estimated to take up to 45 days. Despite these hurdles, India's current vehicle mix and slow EV transition act as a buffer against potential supply chain shocks caused by China's REM policy shift.

Speaking amid widespread Indian outrage over the Trump-Munir meeting, Tharoor said, "Some US lawmakers may have welcomed the Pakistani delegation, but surely the American people have not forgotten how Pakistan shielded bin Laden." His message was clear: Pakistan cannot be trusted, given its track record of supporting cross-border terrorism, including attacks in India.

The Thiruvananthapuram MP added that he hoped Trump used the meeting to firmly warn Munir against supporting terrorist operations targeting India. "I hope

dined, he got all these messages... because that would also be in America's interest," Tharoor said.

The timing of the meeting has raised concerns in India, especially after General Munir's incendiary remarks calling Kashmir Pakistan's "jugular" and boasting about a "superior culture" just days before the Pahalgam terror attack that killed 26. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar condemned Munir's extremist rhetoric, attributing the deadly Pahalgam assault to the Pakistani Army chief's radical influence. The Indian government claims to possess clear evidence that the attack was orchestrated by Pakistan's deep state.

Further reports suggest Pakistani-backed terrorists were also behind recent attacks in London and Moscow.India has reiterated its stance that Kashmir is a bilateral issue and rejected third-party mediation, with Prime Minister Modi firmly conveying this to President Trump during a recent phone call. Despite this, Trump continued to claim credit for a ceasefire in the region-drawing criticism for undermining India's position.





Trump Acknowledges India-Pakistan Ceasefire Was Their Decision, Not His

In a rare shift from previous statements, U.S. President Donald Trump on Wednesday acknowledged that the decision to halt the recent military conflict between India and Pakistan was made by the two nations' leaders themselves—Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Pakistan Army Chief General Asim Munir.

Speaking after hosting General Munir for lunch at the White House, Trump said, "I want to thank him for not going into the war, for ending the war. And I want to thank Prime Minister Modi as well. Two very smart people decided not to keep going with that war. That could have been a nuclear war."

This marks the first time Trump has publicly refrained from tak- trade deals with both India and



ing credit for the May 10 ceasefire between the nuclear-armed neighbors. Previously, he had repeatedly claimed to have brokered peace and suggested the U.S. role was central to defusing tensions. On several occasions, he linked the de-escalation to potential

Trump added that the U.S. is "working on a trade deal" with both countries, underscoring Washington's broader diplomatic and economic interests in South Asia. The statement came just days after Indian Foreign Secre-

tary Vikram Misri released a video clarifying India's stance. Misri said that during a 35-minute phone conversation between Modi and Trump—held while Trump was attending the G7 Summit in Canada—Modi made it clear that India had not discussed any U.S. mediation in the conflict, nor was a trade deal linked to military de-escalation.

"India will never accept third-party mediation on issues with Pakistan. This position has full political consensus in India," Misri emphasized.

Tensions between India and Pakistan had flared during Operation Sindoor earlier this year, raising fears of a wider regional conflict. The May 10 ceasefire appears to have brought a tentative calm to the region, now acknowledged as a diplomatic effort led independently by the two nations.

Israel Strikes Iran's Nuclear Reactor After Missile Attack Hits Hospital Netanyahu Vows Retaliation

Tensions between Israel and Iran escalated sharply on Thursday after a barrage of Iranian missiles struck residential areas near Tel Aviv and severely damaged Soroka Medical Centre in Beersheba. In response, Israel launched airstrikes targeting Iran's Arak heavy water reactor an integral part of its nuclear infrastructure.

According to Israel's Health Ministry, over 240 people were injured in the Iranian missile attack, including more than 70 patients from the hospital, although no serious casualties occurred at the medical facility. Soroka Hospital, which



serves nearly one million people, was forced to limit services to life-threatening cases after an old surgical wing sustained damage.

Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz blamed Iran's Supreme Leader Aya-

"Won't Surrender": Iran Warns US Of 'Irreparable **Damage' If It Intervenes**

As tensions escalate between Iran and Israel, Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei has issued a defiant warning to the United States, vowing never to surrender and threatening "irreparable damage" if Washington intervenes. The statement came in direct response to U.S. President Donald Trump's call for Iran to surrender unconditionally amid an intensifying regional conflict.

Speaking from an undisclosed location, Khamenei addressed the Iranian public and sent a clear message to the U.S. and Israel. "Tehran will never surrender," he declared, reinforcing Iran's resolve in the face of mounting pressure and military threats. His warning came after President Trump publicly stated that the U.S. knows Khamenei's location and could target him, "but not yet," urging Iran to halt missile attacks on civilians and American personnel.

President Trump, in a series of remarks and a Truth Social post, accused Iran of squandering opportunities for diplomacy. He warned that the U.S. possesses unmatched military capabilities and that Israel, heavily armed with American technology, "knows how to use it." Trump further reminded Khamenei that other Iranian hardliners "spoke bravely" before being eliminated, suggesting Iran's leadership could face a similar fate.

The crisis erupted on Friday when Israel launched airstrikes targeting Iran's military and nuclear sites. Iran retaliated by firing hundreds of ballistic missiles into Israeli cities, including Jerusalem and Tel Aviv, many striking civilian zones. In response, Israel warned Tehran of more strikes, urging civilians to evacuate areas near military infrastructure.

Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz emphasized that civilians were not Israel's intended targets but warned that those near regime facilities in Tehran could be at risk. "We will continue to protect our citizens," he said, underscoring Israel's readiness for prolonged conflict. The situation remains volatile as both nations prepare for further military action and diplomatic options narrow.

SpaceX Starship Explodes During Test in Texas, No Injuries Reported

A SpaceX Starship rocket exploded late Wednesday night during a routine ground test at the company's Starbase facility in Boca Chica, Texas, sending a massive fireball into the night sky. Fortunately, no injuries were reported, and an investigation into the incident is currently underway.

The incident occurred around 11:00 p.m. on June 18 as the spacecraft was undergoing pre-flight checks ahead of its planned tenth test launch. According to a statement from SpaceX, the vehicle "experienced a major anomaly" while on the test stand.

"A safety clear area around the site was maintained throughout the operation and all personnel are safe and accounted for," SpaceX confirmed on its official X (formerly Twitter) account. The company emphasized that there is no danger to nearby communities and urged the public to avoid approaching the test site.

The dramatic explosion lit up the skies above the Texas coastline and was visible for miles, sparking concern among local residents and space enthusiasts. Law enforcement and emergency services were on-site quickly, but no evacuations or road closures were necessary.

This marks a setback for SpaceX's ambitious Starship program, which aims to revolutionize space travel with a fully reusable launch system capable of carrying both crew and cargo to the Moon, Mars, and beyond. The Starship vehicle involved was preparing for what would have been its tenth flight testpart of ongoing efforts to refine the rocket's design and performance.

Despite the explosion, SpaceX remains committed to the Starship program. The company stated that it is working closely with local authorities and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to determine the cause of the failure and to prevent future incidents.

Israeli Forces Kill Over 50 People Near Gaza Aid Site Amid Escalating Crisis



On June 17, 2025, Gaza's civil defense agency reported that Israeli forces killed more than 50 individuals near an aid distribution site in the southern city of Khan Yunis, marking the latest in a series of deadly incidents near humanitarian facilities in the Palestinian territory. The attack is a grim reminder of the worsening situation in Gaza, which has been embroiled in over 20 months of intense conflict between Israel and Hamas.

The ongoing war has left the region devastated, with critical shortages of essential resources such as food, fuel, and clean water. As the humanitarian crisis deepens, the United Nations and various global aid organizations have repeatedly raised alarms about the dire conditions faced by Gaza's population. Despite efforts to provide relief, the conflict continues to obstruct aid deliveries and exacerbate the already dire situation on the ground.

In early March, Israel imposed a total blockade on aid entering Gaza, further complicating efforts to alleviate the suffering of the local population. Although the blockade was partially eased in late May, restrictions on the delivery of essential supplies have remained in place, exacerbating the humanitarian crisis. Gold Prices May Fall 10% in Two Months and Up to 30% in a Year, **Say Experts**

¬ old prices, after soaring nearly **U**30% this year to above \$3,350 per ounce, are showing signs of losing steam. According to financial experts and market analysts, the yellow metal may be heading toward a significant correction, with predictions of a short-term dip of 8–10% and a possible longterm decline of up to 30% over the next year.

Despite rising geopolitical tensions—particularly conflicts in the

Middle East and the Black Sea—gold has remained relatively flat in recent weeks. Experts believe this indicates that the metal has already factored in major global risks, including central bank buying, ETF demand, and the trend of de-dollarisation.

Ajay Kedia of Kedia Advisory noted that while gold briefly surged following the outbreak of the Israel-Iran conflict, it failed to maintain momentum despite worsening conditions. He emphasized that gold would need to cross \$3,500 per ounce to regain bullish momentum but warned that a near-term correction to around \$2,700-\$2,800 is highly likely. In a scenario where global tensions ease, gold could even drop to \$2,400—more than 30% below current levels.

NET WT 1000g

has revised its gold forecasts downward, trimming its 3-month target from \$3,500 to \$3,300 and its 6–12-month outlook to \$2,800. Retailers are already seeing a shift in consumer behavior. India's Inflation Falls to 2.8% in May, But Rising Core Inflation Raises **Concerns: CRISIL** personal care. Tndia's retail inflation,

I measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI), dropped to 2.8% in May 2025, signaling a positive development for the economy. This marks one of the lowest inflation readings in recent months, driven largely by a slowdown in food and fuel prices. However, according to CRISIL, the moderation in headline inflation may be masking a more complex picture -

a rise in core inflation that could pose fresh macroeconomic challenges.

While the decline in headline CPI offers relief to policymakers and consumers alike, core inflation which excludes volatile food and energy prices — is showing signs of upward movement. CRISIL has cautioned that this could complicate the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) approach to interest rates and monetary policy.

The drop in overall inflation reflects easing prices in key sectors such as vegetables, cereals, and edible oils, as supply-side



conditions improved and global commodity prices softened. Fuel inflation also moderated due to relatively stable international crude oil rates. These factors contributed to the broader decline in consumer prices, offering some respite to households struggling with the cost of living.

However, the concern lies beneath the surface. Core inflation, typically seen as a more stable indicator of long-term inflation trends, is edging higher, suggesting underlying price pressures are building up in non-food, non-energy segments such as health, education, housing, and

According to CRISIL, this divergence between headline and core inflation could lead to policy dilemmas for the RBI. A soft headline number might call for a more accommodative monetary stance to support growth, but rising core inflation may prevent any aggressive rate cuts.

Economists also note that sticky core inflation could erode purchasing power in the long term and limit the effectiveness of short-term fiscal measures aimed at boosting con-

sumption.

Going forward, CRISIL advises close monitoring of inflation trends, especially in the services sector, and suggests that any monetary easing should be approached cautiously to avoid fueling underlying inflationary pressures. While the current figures are encouraging on the surface, persistent core inflation may indicate that the inflationary battle is far from over.

iPhone 17 Pro Geekbench Scores Leak: A19 Pro Chip Outpaces Snapdragon 8 Elite SoC

Apple's upcoming iPhone 17 Pro series is generating major buzz ahead of its expected September launch. The latest leak, coming from tipster Digital Chat Station on Weibo, reveals alleged Geekbench scores for the iPhone 17 Pro and iPhone 17 Pro Max—and they appear to outperform both Apple's current A18 Pro and Qualcomm's flagship Snapdragon 8 Elite chipsets.

According to the leak, the A19 Pro SoC—expected to power the iPhone 17 Pro series—will retain the 3nm fabrication process seen in its predecessor but deliver significantly better performance. The bench-

mark scores suggest a single-core score exceeding 4,000 and a multi-core score surpassing 10,000, representing a notable leap over the iPhone 16 Pro Max's Geekbench scores of 3,203 (single-core) and 7,846 (multi-core).

In comparison, the Samsung Galaxy S25 Ultra, equipped with the latest Snapdragon 8 Elite SoC, scored 3,054 (single-core) and 9,832 (multi-core). While Qualcomm's chip remains highly competitive, Apple's A19 Pro appears to take a slight lead in raw processing power, according to these early results.

Beyond performance, design leaks suggest the iPhone 17 Pro models may feature a thicker chassis—possibly to accommodate



a larger battery or a VC (vapor chamber) cooling system, which would be a first for Apple. Rumors also hint at a redesigned camera module and enhancements to display technology across the lineup, including the new iPhone 17 Air, a lightweight model poised to rival Samsung's Galaxy S25 Edge.

These upgrades are expected to complement Apple's recently announced Liquid Glass UI, a visually immersive interface that increases processing demands with transparency effects and transitions.

If the leaks hold true, Apple's iPhone 17 Pro series is shaping up to deliver both style and substance in its next-generation flagship smartphones.



Swiggy's 'Dilli Se Hu BLCK' **Ad Sparks Backlash Over Slang Reference**

Cwiggy's latest ad campaign to pro-**J**mote its premium membership service, One BLCK, in Delhi has stirred controversy rather than celebration. The food delivery platform recently ran a full-page newspaper ad featuring the bold tagline "Dilli Se Hu BLCK" — a play on a well-known Hindi slang phrase. While intended to grab attention, the phrase drew sharp criticism online for its perceived insensitivity and suggestive language.

The phrase appeared on the front page of a provocative marketing. prominent newspaper, prompting outrage among many Delhi residents and social media users who found the ad inappropriate and offensive. Journalist Sanket Upadhyay voiced his disapproval on X (formerly Twitter), describing the advertisement as "notorious" and accusing it of normalizing abusive language in mainstream media. He questioned how such messaging was deemed acceptable in a reputable publication.

His post quickly gained traction, with many agreeing that Swiggy had crossed a line. One commenter stressed the need for clear advertising guidelines to prevent such messaging, while another argued that the primary responsibility lies with advertisers, not just publishers. "Normalising bad is the new good," one user remarked, referencing a growing trend of



However, not everyone saw the issue the same way. A few users defended the campaign, suggesting the outrage was exaggerated. "This is the most non-issue issue," one user commented, criticizing the backlash as misplaced.

Swiggy's One BLCK is positioned as an elite, invite-only service that builds on the existing Swiggy One membership. It offers premium benefits such as faster deliveries, complimentary add-ons during dine-outs, and dedicated customer support.

Despite the marketing misstep, the service aims to appeal to high-end customers seeking enhanced convenience. However, this incident has reignited the debate over the limits of creativity in advertising and cultural sensitivity.

Aryna Sabalenka **Frustrated** After Berlin **Open Match** Halted Due to Poor Light and Dew

World No. 1 Aryna Sabalenka expressed her frustration after her second-round match at the Berlin Open against Switzerland's Rebeka Masarova was suspended on Wednesday due to poor light and dew. Sabalenka's irritation comes shortly after her emotionally charged French Open final loss to Coco Gauff. Following that match, she sparked controversy by saying, "I don't think she won the match because she played incredibly well, but because I made all those mistakes." She later retracted those comments in an interview with Eurosport, calling them "completely unprofessional" and

admitting she let her emotions take over.

Despite her world No. 1 ranking, Sabalenka is still chasing her first WTA title on grass and has never reached the final at Wimbledon.

Elsewhere at the Berlin Open, former finalist Ons Jabeur cruised past Jasmine Paolini 6-1, 6-3 to reach the quarterfinals — her first win over a topfive player since Wimbledon 2023. Eighth seed Paula Badosa also advanced with a 7-6 (7/2), 6-3 win over Emma Navarro.

The Berlin Open, one of the oldest women's tennis tournaments, switched to grass courts in 2021 and now serves as a key Wimbledon warm-up event.


