

## **Census 2027: Date Fixed for Nationwide Population Census**

The Government of India has officially announced that the next nationwide population census will commence on March 1, 2027. This census will mark a significant change, as caste-wise data will be collected for the first time in nearly seven decades. The process will dance with the Census Act, 1948, and of the country, the reference date will years to come.

be midnight on March 1, 2027. An official notification with these dates is expected to be published in the Official Gazette on June 16, 2025.

Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnav confirmed the decision after the Cabinet Committee on Political Affairs meeting held on April 30. He emphasized that collecting caste data aims to enhance transparency and bring uniformity across the country. "Some states have conducted caste surveys transparently, while others have not, leading to discrepancies that risk social harmony," Vaishnav stated.

The last national census was conducted in 2011. Although preparations for the 2021 census were completed, the fieldwork was indefinitely postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2011 census was conducted in two phases: the house-to-house survey took place between April and September 2010, and the population count occurred in February 2011.

The reintroduction of caste-wise data collection is regarded as a historic step. The last comprehensive caste census was conducted during British rule, between 1881 and 1931. While the UPA government conducted the Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC) in 2011, the data was never fully published or officially utilized.

Experts like Poonam Muttreja, executive director of the Population Foundation of India, have underscored the importance of caste census to reveal entrenched social inequalities and enable the creation of more inclusive government policies.

This upcoming census is expected to provide critical insights for policymaking and resource allocation across India, potentially shaping so-





The Andhra Pradesh government is all set to roll out one of India's largest energy efficiency distribution programs on the occasion of World Environment Day, June 5. As part of this initiative, 11,400 Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) across the state will receive energy-efficient induction cooktops and compatible utensils in the first phase.

This landmark project is being implemented under the National Efficient Cooking Programme (NECP) with support from the Ministry of Power, Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), and Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), in collaboration with the state's Department of Women and Child Welfare.

## **Amaravati farmers to** receive returnable plots via e-lottery on June 5 TPN Correspondent | Amaravati

The Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority (AP CRDA) will conduct an e-lottery for the allotment of returnable and alternative plots on Thursday to fulfil the promises made to farmers who gave their lands for the construction of Amaravati,. The event will take place at the Ground Floor Conference Hall of the AP CRDA Headquarters, Vijayawada.

A total of 304 plots will be allotted to 119 farmers from 15 villages through a transparent online random system. These plots are being distributed as part of the land acquisition and returnable plot scheme under the Amaravati capital development project.

The e-lottery will be held in two sessions. From 10:00 am to 1:00 pm, plots will be allotted to farmers from Krishnayapalem, Navuluru 1 & 2, Kuragallu 1 & 2, Nidamarru 1 & 2, and Penumaka villages. The afternoon session, from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm, will cover farmers from Thullur 1 & 2, Nekkallu, Anantavaram, Rayapudi 1 & 2, Kondamarajupalem, Sakhamuru, Venkatapalem, Velagapudi, Mandam 1 & 2, and

## SIT Tightens... TPN Correspondent | Tirupati

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) has intensified its investigation into the sensational ghee adulteration case linked to the sacred Tirumala Srivari Laddu Prasadam. The probe, which has drawn national attention, now targets senior officials of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) and ghee suppliers suspected of serious irregularities.

The scandal erupted earlier this year after it was discovered that the ghee used in the preparation of the famed Tirumala laddu prasadam contained adulterants such as animal fats and fish oil. Outrage from devotees and the general public followed, prompting swift action from investigating agencies.

As part of the ongoing probe, the SIT has served fresh notices to Appanna, personal assistant to former TTD Chairman Y.V. Subba Reddy. Appanna has been under questioning for the past two days. Alongside him, six other TTD staff members are also being interrogated over their roles in the procurement and tendering pro-

So far, 15 individuals have been arrested in the case, including the owners and employees of dairies that supplied the adulterated ghee. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) had earlier arrested four key accused in February 2025. Those taken into custody include the managing director of AR Dairy in Tamil Nadu, two representatives of Bhole Baba Dairy from Uttarakhand, and an executive from Vaishnavi Dairy based in Srikalahasti.

The investigation has revealed that the accused had submitted forged documents to win contracts and bypassed eligibility norms, despite lacking the capacity to supply the required quality and quantity of ghee. Alarmingly, SIT suspects that certain TTD officials may have facilitated these contracts in violation of tendering rules.

### Ambati Rambabu's **Clash With Police Goes Viral**

Back-Stab Day protest sparks heated exchange between YCP leader and officer

A tense altercation between senior YSR Congress Party (YCP) leader Ambati Rambabu and a police officer during a protest in Andhra Pradesh has gone viral on social media, drawing public attention and sparking debate. The incident took place during YCP's attempt to organize a 'Back-Stab Day' protest across various parts of the state on Wednesday. The protests were intended to mark what the party claims as a betrayal by political opponents. However, police forces were deployed to prevent any unauthorized gatherings, leading to friction between law enforcement and party leaders. At one protest site, Ambati Rambabu was seen arguing with police personnel who tried to stop the demonstration. According to visuals circulating online, Rambabu engaged in a heated verbal exchange with a police officer, pointing fingers and using harsh language in defiance of the police instructions. The confrontation intensified as the officer stood his ground firmly, refusing to back down despite the political pressure. By standers and party supporters captured the exchange on video, which quickly went viral on social media platforms. Viewers noted the officer's calm but firm demeanor even as the situation escalated. "An officer who never gives up," some netizens praised, sharing clips of the face-off widely. YCP has claimed the protest was their democratic right, while authorities argue it was unauthorized and could disturb public order. Meanwhile, political analysts say the clash may further strain relations between the opposition and police in the state. As the video continues to spread, it remains to be seen whether any official action or response will follow from either side.

## YSRCP Leader Botsa collapses during rally in Vizianagaram

MLC collapses at event in Cheepurupalli; rushed to hospital

YSR Congress Party senior leader and MLC Botsa Satyanarayana fell seriously ill while participating in a party rally in Cheepurupalli, Vizianagaram district on Wednesday. The incident occurred during a "Back-Stab Day" program organized by the YSRCP, drawing concern among party leaders and workers.

According to eyewitnesses, Botsa collapsed while addressing the gathering from the stage. Party members and local leaders reacted swiftly, rushing him to a nearby hospital for immediate medical attention. Initial reports suggest that he may have suffered from heat-related exhaustion or a spike in body temperature. Videos of the incident have gone viral on social media, showing the moment Botsa stumbled and fell, alarming onlookers. Hospital sources stated that he is currently under medical supervision and undergoing necessary tests to determine the cause of the illness. Preliminary indications suggest it is a minor condition, but further tests are underway for confirma-

Party sources confirmed that Botsa,

who previously served as a minister in Andhra Pradesh and held the post of AP Congress Committee president before joining YSRCP in 2015, had been dealing with mild health issues in recent days. The intense heat during the outdoor rally may have aggravated his condition. Botsa Satyanarayana remains a prominent figure in Andhra Pradesh politics, known for his experience and influence, especially in North Andhra. News of his sudden illness has prompted concern among supporters, with several senior YSRCP leaders reportedly contacting the hospital for updates on his condition. As of now, doctors are monitoring his health closely, and an official health bulletin is expected soon. Party cadres

across the district are praying for his

speedy recovery.

#### Taking on the TDP-led coalition, Sharmila criticized the government's lack of action on key poll promises. She dubbed June 4 as the "Day of Andhra Pradesh Public Deception," saying the trio of Modi, Chandrababu, and Pawan Kalyan had tricked voters into believing in reconstruction and reform. "After a year in power, they are blaming the debt situa-

tion and offering excuses for stalled welfare programs. The Super Six promises have been shelved, and people are burdened with soaring electricity bills," she said. Sharmila slammed Chandrababu for not raising the issue of special category status with the Centre and failing to deliver on partition promises.

She also condemned the BJP-led Centre for reducing the Polavaram project height and neglecting its commitment to Visakhapatnam Steel Plant. "They claimed to save Vizag Steel but have instead left 4,000 workers jobless. Their support for the controversial Waqf Bill is another betrayal to the Muslim community," she added.

#### Taking a final dig at Jagan, she said his protests on issues like the liquor scam were nothing but empty noise. "You cry thief while knowing who actually initiated the liquor scam. You won't even come forward to testify in the assembly," she said, accusing him of hypocrisy and self-preservation.

Minister Lokesh Focuses on Jobs and Investments ₹9.5 lakh crore investment agreements signed in 11 months, says Lokesh Goal set to generate 8.5 lakh jobs through new industries and MSMEs

Andhra Pradesh Minister for IT, Education, and Electronics Nara Lokesh has directed officials to accelerate the construction of a world-class cricket stadium in Amaravati, with support from the BCCI. The stadium is expected not only to elevate the state's sporting infrastructure but also open new employment avenues, he stated during a meeting of the Committee of Employment Ministers and senior officials held at his residence in Undavalli. Presiding over the meeting, Lokesh highlighted that the Praja Government led by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has made remarkable progress in attracting investments. He revealed that in just 11 months, the state has signed investment agreements worth ₹9.5 lakh crore, a feat

the previous YSRCP government failed to achieve in five years.

Of the total, 78 major industries worth ₹9.20 lakh crore and 1,19,580 MSMEs worth ₹13,895 crore have committed to invest, which is expected to create 8.5 lakh jobs across the state.

Minister Lokesh emphasized the need for skill training for youth to match the workforce demands of the incoming industries. He proposed the creation of a comprehensive skill ecosystem in the state and suggested special Project Monitoring Units (PMUs) in the Economic Development Board (EDB) to oversee large investments from companies such as NTPC, BPCL, Reliance, and Tata Power.He also recommended streamlining the approval process for industrialists, integrating WhatsApp governance, and speeding up infrastructure provisions for renewable energy projects.

Tourism was also a key focus area. Lokesh noted that Andhra Pradesh's extensive coastline holds great potential for beach tourism, and directed officials to grant quick permissions for the construction of luxury hotels like Oberoi and Varun Beach Sands in Visakhapatnam. He stressed the need for infrastructure such as electricity and water to be provided on priority. In mining, Lokesh urged officials to explore opportunities in beach sand and coal gasification sectors, highlighting their potential for both investment and employment.

Recognizing the significant role of MSMEs in job creation, he advised linking them with the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Pro-

gramme (PMEGP) for financial assistance. With the Chandrababu-led government nearing one year in office, Lokesh insisted on quick implementation of already sanctioned projects and reinforced the government's commitment to 'Speed of Doing Business' and 'Investor Friendly' policies. State Agriculture and Animal Husbandry Minister Kinjarapu Atchannaidu said that June 4 will be remembered as a historic day that gave a new direction to democracy in Andhra Pradesh. According to Atchannaidu, villages are now witnessing a festive atmosphere with farmers smiling, women returning home safely at night, and youth moving away from drugs. Students are getting quality education and citizens better healthcare. He also cited new initiatives like Mitra-WhatsApp governance and drone technology in agriculture. The minister concluded by thanking the people for their support and participation in the state's development. "This people's government under Chandrababu Naidu will continue to work relentlessly. ### **"Stadium Capacity** 35,000 But 2-3 lakh Turned Up": Siddaramaiah On **RCB Tragedy**

In the aftermath of a tragic stampede that killed 11 people during Royal Challengers Bangalore's IPL victory celebrations, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah expressed deep sorrow and admitted that the crowd turnout far exceeded expectations. He said the grief caused by the incident has overshadowed the joy of RCB's long-awaited win.

Speaking at a press conference on Tuesday evening, Siddaramaiah said the tragedy occurred at the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium, which has a seating capacity of around 35,000. However, an estimated two to three lakh people gathered at the venue, leading to the deadly stampede.

"We did not expect such a huge crowd. Neither the cricket association nor the government anticipated this. While over one lakh people gathered in front of Vidhana Soudha without incident, the situation at the stadium turned fatal," the Chief Minister said.

The celebrations were jointly organised by the state government and the Karnataka State Cricket Association following RCB's historic IPL win. Siddaramaiah announced a compensation of ₹10 lakh to the families of the deceased and assured free medical treatment for the injured.

The tragedy has triggered sharp political criticism, with the opposition BJP demanding accountability. Karnataka BJP President Vijayendra Yediyurappa slammed the Congress government, accusing it of prioritising publicity over public safety.

"Was it not the responsibility of the state government to be prepared for this? More than 11 lives have been lost. The Chief Minister must answer," said Yediyurappa in an interview with NDTV.

He pointed out that during the last World Cup, the state successfully managed large crowds, with over one lakh attendees. "The government knew that a huge crowd would gather. They should have made proper arrangements. Unfortunately, they were more interested in gaining publicity than ensuring safety," he added.

## "Absolutely Heartrending": PM On Bengaluru **Stampede Deaths During RCB Event**

A joyous celebration turned tragic in Bengaluru as a stampede outside the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium claimed the lives of at least 11 people and injured over 30 others. The crowd had gathered in massive numbers to celebrate Royal Challengers Bangalore's (RCB) historic IPL victory after 18 years. The unexpected surge in attendance overwhelmed the arrangements, leading to chaos and loss of life.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed deep sorrow over the incident, calling it "heartrending." In a post shared by the Prime Minister's Office on X, he said, "The mishap in Bengaluru is absolutely heartrending. In this tragic hour, my thoughts are with all those who have lost their loved ones. I pray that those who are injured have a speedy recovery."

As fans rushed to catch a glimpse of the RCB players, the stadium premises, which could accommodate only around 35,000 people, saw an estimated crowd of over two to three lakh, leading to the fatal stampede.

The incident has sparked a political blame game. The BJP accused



the Congress-led Karnataka government of mismanagement and poor planning. Union Minister and senior BJP leader Pralhad Joshi criticized the administration, stating, "It's heartbreaking to see such loss because of poor planning and crowd mismanagement. Celebrations are one thing, but the State government failed in its responsibility by not coordinating with emergency services."

He added that the government must be held accountable for the tragedy.

In response to the criticism, Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar said, "They are there to allege, we are here to protect," and mentioned that he was on his way to visit the injured in the hospital. Chief Minister Siddaramaiah also

expressed his grief and announced a magisterial inquiry into the incident. "Nobody expected such a huge turnout," he said, acknowledging that the scale of the crowd far exceeded expectations.

The tragedy has cast a somber shadow over RCB's long-awaited victory, raising serious concerns about public safety and event preparedness.

## **Axiom-4 Launch Delayed Again**

## Pak wanted India on its knees in 48 hrs, folded up in 8 hrs to talk: CDS

Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) General Anil Chauhan on Tuesday revealed that Pakistan had aimed to cripple India within 48 hours through a coordinated military operation, but the plan collapsed within just eight hours, forcing Pakistan to seek dialogue.

Speaking at a lecture titled 'Future Wars and Warfare' at Savitribai Phule Pune University, General Chauhan detailed the sequence of events surrounding Pakistan's they picked up the phone and Operation Bunyan al-Marsoos, launched in response to India's Operation Sindoor. According to the CDS, the Pakistani operation began at around 1 am on May 10, with the objective of overwhelming India through multiple attacks in a short span of time.

"Their aim was to bring India down to its knees within 48 hours," General Chauhan said. "However, the operation failed rapidly. Within just eight hours,

Chauhan explained that while India had targeted only terror-related infrastructure in its operations, Pakistan chose to escalate the situation into the military domain. This miscalculation, he noted, led to a swift and firm response from Indian forces, compelling Pakistan to reconsider its aggressive stance.

most rational actors in conflict situations," Chauhan said, reflecting on why Pakistan decided to de-escalate. "There were likely two reasons. One, they realized that if they continued down this path, they stood to lose far more. It led to uncertainty and hesitation, prompting their desire for dialogue."

General Chauhan's remarks offer insight into the strategic dynamics between India and Pakistan, especially in the face of high-stakes military posturing. His comments also underscore the preparedness and restraint shown by Indian forces even in the face of provocation.

### **Another Arrest Made in Hindutva Worker Suhas Shetty Murder Case**

The Mangaluru City Crime Branch (CCB) has made another arrest in the ongoing investigation into the murder of Hindu activ-

apprehended is Abdul Razak, a 59-year-old resident of Mangaluru. This arrest brings the total number of individuals taken into custody in connection with the case to 16, according to police sources.

Suhas Shetty, a known Hindutva activist and

also a registered rowdy sheeter, was killed in Mangaluru last month in what police have described as a premeditated attack involving multiple assailants.

Police officials confirmed that Abdul Razak is the father of one of the key accused, Mohammed Muzammil, and the fatherin-law of Nausad Vamanjoor, also known as "Chotte Nausad," another suspect in the case. Razak is accused of actively conspiring with the main accused and others in planning the murder. Authorities allege that he

hosted meetings at his residence where the conspiracy was hatched and later assisted the accused in evading arrest.

"The role of Razak was not just limited to ist Suhas Shetty. The latest individual to be harboring the accused. He was involved

in the initial planning of the murder as well," a senior police official said.

The police have maintained that the killing of Suhas Shetty was a coordinated and deliberate act, and investigations are ongoing to uncover the full extent of the conspiracy. Multiple teams have been deployed to trace other ab-

sconding suspects believed to be involved.

The murder has drawn significant attention due to Shetty's association with the Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP) and his notoriety in local criminal circles. Authorities have stated that they are treating the case with utmost seriousness and will ensure that all individuals involved, directly or indirectly, are brought to justice.

Further arrests and revelations are expected as the investigation progresses.

## Musk calls Trump's tax-cut and spending bill 'a disgusting abomination'

#### **Sparking Republican Divisions**

Billionaire Elon Musk sharply criticized President Donald Trump's sweeping tax and spending bill on Tuesday, calling it a "disgusting abomination" that will worsen the federal deficit. His strong condemnation has echoed the concerns of fiscally conservative Republicans in the Senate, complicating the bill's prospects.

On his social media platform X, Musk wrote, "This massive, outrageous, pork-filled Congressional

spending bill is a disgusting abomination. Shame on those who voted for it: you know you did wrong." Musk's comments resonated with

The House passed the bill narrowly last month, despite the Congressional Budget Office projecting it would add \$3.8 trillion to the already massive \$36.2 trillion federal debt. The Senate, also controlled by Republi-

cans, aims to pass the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act" by July 4 but is expected to revise the House version.

Senate Republicans on the Finance Committee are meeting with Trump to discuss making business tax breaks permanent—an idea analysts warn would significantly increase the bill's cost. However, Senate Majority Leader John Thune dismissed Musk's criticism, insisting the bill will pass on schedule to fulfill campaign promises.

House Speaker Mike Johnson also rejected Musk's views, calling them "terribly wrong."

Musk's vocal opposition comes after his recent departure from a federal government efficiency role, marking a test of his political influence. Despite spending nearly \$300 million supporting Trump and other Republicans last year, Musk has signaled a pullback from political funding to focus on Tesla.

Senate Republicans remain split: deficit hawks demand deeper cuts, while others want to protect Medicaid and green energy investments. With a slim 53-47 majority, Republicans cannot afford to lose more than three votes, making compromise essential but challenging ahead of the July 4 deadline.



### Bilawal Bhutto-Zardari Calls for Pakistan-India Intelligence Cooperation to Curb Terrorism

Pakistan Peoples Party Parliamentarians (PPPP) chairman Bilawal Bhutto-Zardari has emphasized that collaboration between Pakistan and India's intelligence agencies could play a crucial role in significantly reducing terrorism across South Asia. Speaking at a press conference at the United Nations Headquarters on June 3, 2025, Bhutto-Zardari urged both countries to overcome hostilities and engage in meaningful cooperation.

"I am completely confident that if ISI and RAW were ready to sit down and work together to fight these forces, we would see a significant decrease in terrorism in both India and Pakistan," he said, referring to the intelligence agencies of Pakistan and India respectively.

Bhutto-Zardari, currently leading a delegation to the U.S. to seek international support following the recent Indo-Pak conflict, also warned the global community about the heightened risk of conflict between the nuclear-armed neighbours. He credited the intervention of international players, particularly U.S. President Donald Trump and Secretary of State Marco Rubio, for brokering a cease-fire, calling it a "welcome first step"

essential.

The recent surge in tensions followed the April 22 Pahalgam terror attack in India, which led to Indian precision strikes on terror infrastructure in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir. Pakistan responded with military actions, which ceased after talks between the Directors General of Military Operations on May 10.

Bhutto-Zardari stressed that diplomacy remains the only viable path to peace, reiterating Pakistan's readiness to engage in broad dialogue, including counterterrorism cooperation. He proposed establishing a joint platform for both countries to raise concerns, investigate terrorist incidents, and ensure accountability.

On the water dispute front, Bhut-to-Zardari condemned India's suspension of the Indus Waters Treaty (IWT), calling it "an attempt to weaponise water." He warned that cutting off water supply to 200 million people would violate the U.N. Charter and be considered an act of war by Pakistan.

## Khamenei Rejects U.S. Nuclear Proposal, Affirms Iran's Commitment to Uranium Enrichment

Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei on Wednesday (June 4, 2025) firmly rejected a recent U.S. proposal aimed at reviving nuclear negotiations, declaring that the offer ran counter to Iran's national interests. In a televised speech, Khamenei reaffirmed that Iran would not abandon its uranium enrichment activities, a critical element of its nuclear program and a major point of contention in ongoing international talks.

"The enrichment of uranium is essential to our progress in nuclear science, and we will not compromise on it," Khamenei stated. He added that Iran would continue to pursue the development of nuclear technology, emphasizing that it is for peaceful purposes.

The rejection comes amid renewed efforts by Washington to bring Tehran back into compliance with the 2015 nuclear agreement, formally known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), from which the U.S. unilaterally withdrew in 2018 under



then-President Donald Trump. Since then, Iran has gradually expanded its nuclear activities in violation of the deal's original terms.

In a related development, Iran has warned European nations against leveraging a recent United Nations nu-

On Monday, an unnamed Iranian diplomat told Reuters that the latest American proposal was a "non-starter," criticizing it for failing to offer meaningful concessions on enrichment rights or broader economic relief. The diplomat added that Washington's position continues to ignore Iran's core demands, including recognition of its right to enrich uranium under the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT).

Tehran insists that its nuclear program is solely for civilian purposes, such as energy production and medical research. However, Western powers—particularly the U.S., U.K., France, and Germany—remain concerned that Iran's growing stockpile of highly enriched uranium could eventually be diverted toward the development of nuclear weapons.

In a related development, Iran has warned European nations against leveraging a recent United Nations nuclear watchdog report that criticized Tehran's lack of cooperation. Iranian officials said any attempt to exploit the report could trigger retaliation, further straining diplomatic relations.

Despite international concerns, Khamenei's speech makes it clear that Iran will continue to resist external pressure and maintain its current nuclear trajectory, setting the stage for further standoff with the West.

### **Pakistan to Chair Taliban Sanctions Committee**

#### Serve as Vice-Chair of UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee in 2025

Pakistan will chair the Taliban Sanctions Committee of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) in 2025 and also serve as vice-chair of the Council's Counter-Terrorism Committee. This announcement comes as part of the list of chairs and vice-chairs for the UNSC's subsidiary bodies for the year, highlighting Pakistan's significant role in the 15-member UN body.

The Taliban Sanctions Committee, officially known as the 1988 Sanctions Committee, is responsible for imposing an assets freeze, travel ban, and arms embargo on individuals and entities linked to the Taliban that threaten peace and security in Afghanistan. Alongside Pakistan, Guyana and Russia will act as vice-chairs of this committee.



Additionally, Pakistan will be vice-chair of the Counter-Terrorism Committee, which is chaired by Algeria. France and Russia also serve as vice-chairs for this committee. Pakistan will further co-chair the Informal Working Groups on Documentation

and Other Procedural Questions, as well as on General UNSC Sanctions Issues.

Pakistan is currently a non-permanent member of the Security Council for the 2025-26 term. The sanctions

committees, which include all 15 UNSC members, make decisions by consensus.

India, which was chair of the UNSC Counter-Terrorism Committee during its 2021-22 membership, has frequently criticized Pakistan for allegedly harboring a large number of UN-designated terrorists. Notably, Al-Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden was found hiding in Abbottabad, Pakistan, before being killed by U.S. Navy SEALs in 2011.

The five permanent UNSC members include China, France, Russia, the UK, and the U.S. Non-permanent members for 2025 also include Denmark, Greece, Guyana, Panama, South Korea, Sierra Leone, Slovenia, and Somalia.

In recent elections held on June 3, 2025, five new non-permanent members were elected for the 2026-27 term: Bahrain, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Liberia, Latvia, and Colombia



## Gold Prices Rise to Rs 99,000 per 10 Grams Amid Rupee **Depreciation**

old prices in the national capital gained Rs 70 on Tuesday, reaching Rs 99,000 per 10 grams, driven primarily by the weakening Indian rupee, according to the All India Sarafa Association. The precious metal, with 99.5% purity, also saw an increase of Rs 200 to Rs 98,600 per 10 grams on an inclusive tax basis.

Silver prices mirrored the upward trend, rising by Rs 100 to Rs 1,00,200 per

kilogram, inclusive of all taxes. The rupee's decline added pressure on domestic bullion prices as it fell 21 paise to settle at 85.60 against the US dollar, affected by a strong American currency and an outflow of foreign funds.

Despite the domestic gains, global spot gold prices dipped by USD 25.22 per ounce, or 0.75%, closing at USD 3,356.41 per ounce. This decline was attributed to profit-booking activities by investors.

Pranav Mer, Vice President of Commodity & Currency Research at JM Financial Services, explained that although gold prices have softened due to profit-booking, the underlying outlook remains positive. He highlighted that safe-haven demand has increased amid a broadly weaker US dollar, the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict, and rising economic uncertainty stemming from US-

led tariff disputes.

Adding to the market dynamics, Saumil Gandhi, Senior Analyst of Commodities at HDFC Securities, noted that traders are now focused on upcoming US macroeconomic data releases, including the JOLTS Job Openings report. Additionally, speeches from key members of the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) are expected to play a significant role in influencing bullion prices in the near

In summary, while global gold prices showed some retreat, domestic gold and silver prices rose due to the rupee's depreciation and ongoing geopolitical and economic uncertainties. Market participants continue to watch closely for US economic indicators and policy signals that could impact future price movements in precious metals.

## **Tata Technologies Shares** Fall 2.5% as TPG Likely Sells 2.1% Stake in Block Deal

Shares of Tata Technologies Ltd. opened lower on Wednesday, June 4, after a significant block deal involving around 2.1% of the company's equity came to light. According to exchange data, approximately 86 lakh shares

appears to be an offloading by US-based private equity firm TPG.

CNBC-TV18 reported that TPG Rise Climate, which held a 6.01% stake in Tata Technologies as of the March quarter, planned to sell up to 2.1% of its holdings through block deals. The offer price was set at Rs 744.5 per share, reflecting a discount of up to 3% from the previous day's closing price. However, the identities of buyers and sellers in the deal remain undisclosed.

Despite the share sale, Tata Technologies recently posted its March quarter results showing mixed performance. Revenue slightly declined year-on-year to Rs 1,286 crore, and EBITDA fell by 2% to Rs 233.5 crore, with margins narrowing to 18.2%. Nonetheless, the company reported a robust 20% year-onyear increase in consolidated profit after tax (PAT), which rose to Rs 189 crore in Q4 FY25 from Rs 157 crore the previous year.

## Zimbabwe to Cull Elephants and Distribute Meat Amid Population Surge



Zimbabwe has announced plans to cull dozens of elephants and distribute the meat to local communities in an effort to manage its rapidly growing elephant population. The controversial move, reported by AFP and confirmed by Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Authority (ZimParks), will take place in the Save Valley Conservancy, a vast private game reserve in the country's southeast.

ZimParks revealed that the initial culling phase will target 50 elephants. The meat obtained from this operation will be shared with local residents, while the ivory will remain government property and be handed over to ZimParks for safekeeping.

Zimbabwe, home to the world's second-largest elephant population after Botswana, is struggling with the consequences of overpopulation in some reserves. A 2024 aerial survey showed that Save Valley Conservancy currently holds approximately 2,550 elephants—more than triple its estimated carrying capacity of 800. Over the last five years, at least 200 elephants have been relocated to other parks, but the population continues to grow beyond sustainable levels.

Elephant meat is rarely consumed globally due to ethical and legal concerns, but in some regions, it is considered a delicacy. Those who have eaten it describe the taste as similar to gamey beef or pork, with a dense, fibrous texture and slightly sweet undertones. Culinary sources like Chef's Resource and Eat Delights report that the meat is lean, rich in protein, iron, and B-vitamins, and often requires slow cooking methods such as braising or stewing to tenderize.

This isn't Zimbabwe's first large-scale cull. In 2024, the country culled 200 elephants amid a severe drought that caused widespread food shortages. However, this new plan has reignited criticism from conservationists and animal rights groups, who argue that elephants are vital for tourism and the ecological balance of the region.

Adding to the debate, the country cannot sell its stockpile of ivory due to international bans on ivory trading. The announcement also followed the arrest of four individuals in Harare with over 230 kilograms of ivory, allegedly attempting to sell it illegally.

The government has not specified how many elephants will be culled in total or over what time frame, leaving many questions unanswered.

### Durex's Bold '2 Virgins' Ad Sets Internet Abuzz Ahead of IPL 2025 Final Between RCB and PBKS

The IPL 2025 final between Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) and Punjab Kings (PBKS) has taken a cheeky turn thanks to a risqué ad from sexual wellness brand Durex. Known for its bold and witty marketing, Durex dropped a viral ad that instantly lit up social media, combining clever wordplay with cricket fanfare.

The brand's ad, which reads "18 years and 2 virgins. Who will get lucky?", plays on the fact that neither RCB nor PBKS has ever clinched an IPL title in the league's 18-year history. The clever double entendre quickly caught fire online, with fans dubbing it "marketing gold." Durex followed up with an Instagram caption that read, "First times are always special! Social media platforms erupted with reactions. On X (formerly Twitter), user @TravisbickleCSK shared the ad with the comment, "Durex always delivers," garnering over 1.3 million views. # AIIMS Doctors Successfully Operate on 254 kg 'Super-Super Obese' Man in High-Risk Bariatric Surgery



In a remarkable achievement in bariatric medicine, doctors at Delhi's All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) have successfully performed a high-risk weight loss surgery on a 31-year-old man from Uttar Pradesh, who weighed an astounding 254 kilograms. The patient, a government employee, was classified as 'super-super obese' with a body mass index (BMI) of 75.5 — nearly three times the threshold for morbid obesity.

The patient had struggled with obesity since childhood and had attempted numerous weight loss methods over the years. Despite a dedicated three-year effort involving strict diet control and regular exercise, his weight remained dangerously high. Although he had previously lost around 90 kilograms over a decade ago, he regained it due to health setbacks and lack of sustainable intervention.

Realizing that conventional methods were no longer effective, the medical team at AIIMS, led by Dr. Manjunath Maruti Pol, opted for a surgical solution. They performed a 'one-anastomosis gastric bypass', a type of bariatric surgery that drastically reduces stomach size to about 60–80 ml and reconfigures

the digestive tract to promote rapid weight loss. The procedure also triggers favorable hormonal changes that help regulate blood sugar, hypertension, and cholesterol.

Given the patient's weight and related complications, the operation was considered extremely high-risk. Prior to the surgery, a comprehensive medical protocol was followed. The patient was put on a C-PAP machine to manage obstructive sleep apnoea, while his blood pressure and diabetes were brought under control. He also underwent physiotherapy and a supervised weight loss program to improve his physical strength and enhance surgical outcomes.

Post-surgery, the patient responded well to treatment and was discharged after a stable recovery period. Doctors now anticipate significant weight loss and health improvements in the coming months as part of his post-operative care.

This case highlights the growing capabilities of Indian healthcare institutions like AIIMS in tackling severe obesity and offers hope to many battling extreme weight-related health challenges.

## Stampede at RCB Victory Celebrations...

11 people confirmed dead, more than 50 Injured...

A celebratory night turned tragic in Bengaluru as a massive stampede at the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium claimed the lives of at least 11 people and left over 50 injured during Royal Challengers Bangalore's (RCB) IPL victory celebration. The incident occurred late Tuesday night when thousands of fans swarmed the stadium to join the team's triumphant celebrations following their maiden Indian Premier League title win. Chaos erupted as the excited crowd surged forward to get closer to the stage where the players were expected to appear. The sudden rush led to a deadly stampede, resulting in multiple fatalities and injuries. Among the deceased are six men and four women, with the identity of one victim yet to be confirmed.

Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar, who addressed the media shortly after the incident, expressed shock over the tragedy. "I cannot confirm the exact number of casualties at this moment. Initial reports suggest multiple deaths and several injuries. More than 5,000 police personnel were deployed for security, but the crowd was uncontrollably enthusiastic," he stated. He added, "They were mostly young

to nearby hospitals. Hospital authorities confirmed that many of the victims suffered injuries due to trampling and suffocation.

Visuals from the venue showed utter chaos with broken barricades and fans helping each other out of the densely packed venue. Authorities said that the stadium was filled far beyond its expected capacity, and crowd management protocols were reportedly inadequate.

Eyewitnesses described the scene as horrifying. "People started pushing from behind and no one could breathe. Some collapsed on the ground, and others fell on top of them," said one fan who managed to escape the chaos with minor injuries.

As the city mourns the lives lost in a celebration that was meant to unite fans in joy, questions are being raised over the preparedness of the organizers and law enforcement agencies. An inquiry into the incident is expected to begin soon, with Chief Minister Siddaramaiah expected to visit the site and the hospitals treating the injured later today.

RCB, which had finally clinched the IPL trophy after years of close finishes, has yet to release an official statement on the tragedy.

### **India Suffer Disappointing** 0-2 Defeat to Thailand in **International Friendly**

Tndia endured **L**a sobering 0-2 Thaito land in an international football friendly on Wednesday, raising concerns ahead of their upcoming AFC Asian qualifying Cup clash against Hong Kong. The match, played at the Thammasat Stadium in Bangkok, saw the hosts dominate from the start, with goals from Benjamin Davis in the 8th minute and Poramet Arjvilai in the 59th sealing a deserved win for the Thais.



Ranked 99th in the FIFA world rankings, Thailand looked the superior side throughout, outplaying an uninspired Indian team currently ranked 127th. The result marks a setback for Igor Štimac's men, who had beaten Thailand in their last two encounters — a 4-1 win in the 2019 AFC Asian Cup and a 1-0 victory in the 2019 King's Cup.

Thailand struck early when Davis found the net with a composed finish following a defensive lapse. India struggled to regain momentum, and though there was a brief spell of attacking intent in the first half, clearcut chances were scarce.

Veteran striker Sunil Chhetri, who had scored twice in India's previous AFC Asian Cup triumph over Thailand, nearly brought India level in the 24th minute. The Marvel Cinematic Universe is poised to shatter all previous records with its upcoming mega-production, Avengers: Doomsday. Touted as the most expensive film ever made in the history of cinema, this colossal crossover event is estimated to carry a jaw-dropping budget of \$1 billion.
