The public fallout between Tesla and SpaceX CEO Elon Musk and former US President Donald Trump has escalated sharply, sending shockwaves through political and financial circles. Elon Musk, reacting strongly to recent events, has hinted at forming a new political party, signaling a significant shift in his political engagement.

The dispute ignited when Musk criticized a recent government spending bill, calling it a "disgusting piece of garbage." Trump responded with threats to cancel government contracts awarded to Musk's companies. In retaliation, Musk warned about potentially decommissioning SpaceX's Dragon spacecraft. The tension further deepened as Musk alleged Trump's involvement in the Jeffrey Epstein files, which have not been made public. Musk tweeted, "Time to drop the really big bomb: [Donald Trump] is in the Epstein files. That is the real reason they have not been made public. Have a nice day, DJT!" Trump fired back via his social media platform Truth Social, expressing disappointment with Musk and accusing him of overreacting to the bill's

- Calls BRS a 'Demon Rajya Samithi'

TPN Correspondent | Bhuvanagiri Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy delivered a fiery speech during his tour of Aleru constituency in Bhuvanagiri district on Friday, where he launched various development works worth ₹1,500 crore. Addressing a massive public meeting, Revanth took sharp aim at the previous BRS government, declaring that his life's goal had been fulfilled the day he unseated the leader who sent him to jail.

"I told him the day I came out of jail that I would dethrone him. Not only

did I throw him out, but I also sat in that very chair. I had no other desire. I achieved my life's mission," said the Chief Minister, receiving thunderous applause from the crowd. "From now on, I will work

like your elder brother, to fulfill your dreams." Revanth Reddy also highlighted the state government's plans to develop the Yadagirigutta temple and surrounding region. "We have reverted the name from Yadadri to Yadagirigutta. We will ensure devotees can rest peacefully on the hill and that autos can move freely. Sixty kilograms of gold will be used for the gopuram of the temple. We have constituted the Yadagirigutta Temple Development Authority (YTDA), similar to TTD," he announced. The Chief Minister further revealed plans to develop

educational institutions in Yadagirigutta to university standards and promised to clean and rejuvenate the Musi river. "We will bring Godavari water into Musi. If Sabarmati and Ganga can be cleaned, why not Musi?" he asked.



Accusing the previous regime of massive corruption, Revanth launched a scathing attack on BRS. "They looted the state in the name of golden Telangana. Vasalamarri village was demolished to create a model village, but KCR never looked back. He left Telangana buried under ₹8 lakh crore debt, cheated students, farmers, and movement activists."

He dismissed the BRS party as morally bankrupt and unfit to question the current government. "They couldn't even complete a ₹2,000 crore SSELBC project despite having a ₹20 lakh crore budget. They turned Telangana into a Ravana forest. The leader himself admitted that demons joined his party. BRS is not Bharat Rashtra Samithi; it's Deyyala Rajya Samithi," he declared.

State Irrigation Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy on Friday strongly objected to the Andhra Pradesh government's move on the Banakacharla irrigation project, asserting that Telangana will not accept the project under any circumstances. He alleged that the project blatantly violates all norms related to inter-state water dispute resolution, including the guidelines issued by the GRMB, CWC, and the Apex Council. Prabhakar Rao to Reach Hyderabad on June 8 Midnight

 Former SIB chief to appear before SIT on June 9

TPN Correspondent | Telangana In a major development in the sensational phone tapping case, former SIB chief Prabhakar Rao has been granted permission to return to India after the Indian Embassy in the United States issued an emergency transit warrant. The warrant was granted following a Supreme Court directive after Prabhakar Rao's passport was officially cancelled.

Sources confirm that Prabhakar Rao is scheduled to depart from the US and will arrive in Hyderabad at midnight on June 8. He is expected to appear before the SIT (Special Investigation Team) for



questioning on the morning of June 9, marking a crucial step in the ongoing investigation into the phone tapping scandal that has rocked the state intelligence community.

The transit warrant was processed as an emergency request and was facilitated in coordination with the Indian judiciary and diplomatic channels. Officials clarified that this move is part of ongoing efforts to ensure cooperation from all accused involved in the conspiracy.

Phone Tapping Case Prabhakar Rao is regarded as one of the key masterminds in the phone tapping operation, which allegedly involved unauthorized surveillance of political leaders, journalists, and activists during the previous government's tenure. His return is expected to provide critical insights and evidence to the investigation, which has already seen several arrests and revelations.

> Authorities are making tight security arrangements for his arrival, and he is likely to be taken directly from the airport to a secure location for preliminary procedures before appearing before the SIT. This development comes amid growing political heat and widespread demand for accountability over the illegal surveillance scandal.



Powerful Telangana Under Congress Rule: Bhatti Vikramarka

Deputy CM counters BRS criticism, says surplus electricity and welfare are Congress hallmarks

Telangana Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka Mallu strongly defended the Congress government's performance at a public meeting in Nawabpet after inaugurating 33/11 kV substations in Jadcherla constituency. Referring to pre-election claims made by TRS leaders, Bhatti said, "They said there would be no electricity if Congress came to power. But today, not only have we ensured uninterrupted supply, we are moving forward with the aim of surplus power."

He highlighted that under Congress rule, both industrial output and living standards have

increased, leading to a spike in electricity demand. The peak power demand in March 2023 under TRS was 15,497 MW, whereas under Congress, it rose to 17,162 MW by March 2025 — yet the state did not face a single power interruption. The Deputy CM said the government has already prepared a detailed plan to meet the projected power demand of 33,775 MW by 2035. He noted that with a stable and strong power supply, Telangana is now drawing global investors and is well-positioned to compete with the world.

Bhatti stated that no conspiracy or misinformation campaign can stop the rise



of Telangana. He said 90 lakh families are currently benefiting from the government's welfare programs. Among these schemes are 200 units of free electricity per household, six kilograms of fine rice

per person, a 40% hike in diet charges for school children, fee reimbursement for higher education, and up to ₹10 lakh free medical treatment under Rajiv Aarogyasri. He also noted that educated youth are be-

and self-employment support ₹70 crore in compensation to through Rajiv Yuva Vikasam. The Deputy CM said the government has waived off up to ₹2 lakh in farm loans, credited directly to farmers' accounts, while also providing ₹12,000 annually under Rythu Bharosa and the same amount to landless agricultural laborers under Indiramma Aatmeeya Bharosa. Additionally, the homeless are being given ₹5 lakh to build houses, and pensions continue to be paid regularly to the elderly and widows.

Kishan Reddy Launches Forum to Boost Critical Minerals Sector

Union Minister of Mines, Kishan Reddy, inaugurated the National Critical Minerals Mission Outreach Forum at the India Habitat Center on Friday, emphasizing the government's commitment to strengthening India's critical minerals sector under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Addressing the seminar, the Minister highlighted several key reforms that have transformed the minerals sector, including the transparent auctioning of mineral blocks. "So far, 34 mineral blocks have been successfully auctioned, increasing accountability and attracting investments," he said. He added that more blocks are being prepared for auction to boost mineral exploration and extraction. Over the past three years, the Geological Survey of India (GSI) has undertaken 445 exploration projects focused on

critical minerals, with funding allocated for 185 projects through the National Mineral Exploration Trust. The government has also forged bilateral agreements with countries like Australia, Argentina, and Chile to secure critical mineral supplies. Notably, the central government's company Kabil has commenced mining operations on 15,000 hectares in Catamarca province, Argentina.

The Minister pointed out that the National Critical Minerals Mission, approved earlier this year with a budget of ₹16,300 crore, is a vital step towards India's energy security and self-reliance. Central government companies plan to invest an additional ₹18,000 crore in the mission. The focus is on extracting minerals such as lithium, cobalt, and rare earth elements essential for clean energy technologies. "By 2040, the demand for critical minerals in India is expected to increase four to six times. Currently, India imports 100 percent of these minerals," Kishan Reddy stated. He added that the mining sector is playing a crucial role in powering India's ambition to become a developed nation by 2047. This financial year, India surpassed Japan to become the world's fourth-largest economy, underscoring the importance of strengthening the minerals sector.

The government has also lifted import duties on 12 critical minerals, including cobalt powder, lithium-ion battery scrap, lead, and zinc, to encourage domestic processing and reduce dependency on imports.

The Minister called for collaboration among government bodies, private sector companies, public sector undertakings, and academia to bolster the critical minerals processing industry. He urged industry representatives to invest in this sector and highlighted the role of the newly launched Outreach Forum in raising awareness about critical minerals, power security, and food security.

Supreme Court Issues Notices to KTR

Congress leader challenges Telangana HC verdict on ₹25,000 crore corruption remarks

TPN Correspondent | New Delhi The Supreme Court on Friday issued notices to Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president and former Telangana minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) over his allegations of massive corruption against the Congress government in the state. The court was hearing a petition filed by Congress leader Atram Suguna, who challenged an earlier Telangana High Court verdict that had quashed a case filed against KTR.KTR had earlier alleged that the Congress government in Telangana was involved in corruption worth ₹25,000 crore. In response, Congress leader Atram Suguna lodged a police complaint, leading to the registration of a case at the Utnoor police station. However, KTR sought relief from

the Telangana High Court, which ruled in his favor and ordered the quashing of the case. Dissatisfied with the High Court's order, Atram Suguna approached the Supreme Court. A bench headed by Justice Sanjay Karol took up the matter and, after reviewing the petitioner's arguments, issued notices to KTR. The apex court directed KTR to file his response within four weeks. This legal development is seen as a significant escalation in the political rivalry between the Congress and BRS in Telangana. The Supreme Court's notice puts the spotlight back on the corruption charges and the ongoing war of words between the two parties. Further proceedings in the case are expected to resume after KTR submits his reply.

Ponnam Slams BRS for Politicizing Gopinath's Illness

Congress Minister urges political sensitivity, calls out BJP-BRS nexus

Minister Ponnam Prabhakar expressed concern over the health condition of BRS MLA Maganti Gopinath and criticized BRS leaders for politicizing the situation. Speaking at Gandhi Bhavan, Ponnam said he had personally met Gopinath many times in his capacity as in-charge minister and is praying for his speedy recovery. He noted that Gopinath's deteriorating health has kept him away from public functions recently, and this should be a moment of concern, not political blame games.

Ponnam condemned the attempts by BRS leaders to connect Gopinath's illness to the recent death of a BRS activist in Borabanda, calling it irresponsible and inappropriate. He said it is not right to politicize the illness of a sitting MLA or to use it as an opportunity for political manipulation. He also responded to internal BRS allegations blaming Congress leader Baba Fasiuddin for the activist's death, terming them baseless and driven by internal factionalism.

Calling out BJP leader Etela Rajender, Ponnam demanded that he reveal the truth behind the internal dynamics that led to his own exit from BRS, urging him not to engage in political management or opportunistic alliances. He also accused the BJP and BRS of maintain-

ing a covert understanding, suggesting that Harish Rao's alleged secret meeting with BJP leaders was a clear indication of their coordination.

Ponnam further slammed the BJP for siding with Andhra Pradesh on the Krishna river water dispute, stating that the party is failing to protect Telangana's interests. He urged the BJP leadership to respond responsibly and stop acting against Telangana in such critical matters.



No Politics on Vemulawada temple, Says Konda Surekha

Telangana Endowment Minister Konda Surekha has urged political parties to avoid politicizing the recent incident involving Rajanna Kodela. Speaking on Friday, she questioned what the BRS government had accomplished during its 10-year rule, especially regarding promised funds for the Vemulawada temple, which she said were never released. She blamed the plight of Kodela on the previous regime's neglect and said her government acted swiftly in response to the incident.

Surekha highlighted that under the Congress-led government. significant developments were made, including the successful organization of Saraswati Pushkaram, which saw the participation of 30 lakh devotees without issues. She pointed out the expan-



sion work at Bhadrakali Temple costing crores and criticized the BRS for carving images of KCR on the Yadagirigutta temple gopuram made of 63 kg of gold, questioning their right to speak on religious matters.

The minister also recalled various religious programs conducted during the Congress tenure, such as mass Deepotsavam, Surekha condemned the

river aartis, and Maha Kumbhabhishekam for Kaleshwaram and Yadagirigutta, questioning whether similar efforts were made during BRS rule. She accused BRS leaders of spreading falsehoods and likened their political responses to fabricated stories, urging people not to be misled.

Car Catches Fire on Durgam **Cheruvu Cable Bridge**

A sudden fire broke out in a moving car on the Durgam Cheruvu Cable Bridge on Friday evening, sparking panic among commuters and causing significant traffic disruption in the area. The incident occurred around 4:30 PM, as the vehicle was heading towards Road No. 45.

Fortunately, the occupants of the car managed to escape before the flames spread further. Videos and images shared by netizens on social media showed plumes of smoke rising from the burning vehicle, with many reporting that a fire engine was delayed due to a traffic jam near the Mindspace Flyover but was on its way to the site. The Cyberabad Police, in an update on X (formerly Twitter), stated, "As of 4:32 PM, traffic on the Durgam Cheruvu Cable Bridge towards Road 45 is slow due to the incident. Madhapur traffic police are on the ground managing the situation and are working to ease the congestion." Authorities have not yet confirmed the cause of the fire. Traffic movement in the vicinity was severely impacted, with police advising motorists to expect delays and cooperate with the ongoing management efforts until normalcy is restored.

Natural farming is key to international market demand

₹35,000 crore deposited into farmers' accounts so far in Telangana Government to establish oil palm factory and buffer stock of fertilizers

Telangana Agriculture Minister Tummala Nageswara Rao gave a clarion call to farmers, urging them to align agricultural practices with both domestic needs and global market demands. Speaking at the Rythu Mahotsavam held in Husnabad, the Minister emphasized that increasing farmers' income should be the core goal of agricultural policy, and this can be achieved only by cultivating crops that humanity truly needs and doing so sustainably.

He pointed out the alarming overuse of chemical fertilizers, noting, "If our grandfathers used two kg of urea, today we are using 150 kg." Stressing the importance of returning to nat-

ural and organic fertilizers, he said this shift is essential if Telangana's produce is to gain acceptance and demand in international markets.

Tummala strongly advocated for evidence-based farming, urging farmers to learn from agricultural university VCs, scientists, professors, and experienced farmers. "What our land needs, what brings more income - that's what we should grow," he said. Citing the irony of importing vegetables from other states, he envisioned a future where Telangana supplies vegetables to foreign nations.

Highlighting the Telangana government's efforts to protect farmers' interests, the Minister revealed that ₹35,000 crore has already been deposited in farmers' accounts under various welfare schemes. He assured that the next installment of financial support will reach farmers before the sowing season begins this year.

He urged the central government to act responsibly "The Centre must buy grain from the farmers at the Minimum Support Price it has announced. It should also support the oil palm sector and not just make promises." Tummala cautioned against politicizing agriculture, stating, "On this issue, both the government and opposition should work in unity for farmers' welfare."

Finally, he called on farmers to actively participate in the three-day Rythu Mahotsavam by expressing their



challenges and sharing their field-level experiences. He concluded with a vision: "Let Husnabad be filled with

greenery and dairy prosperity in the days to come."

Liquor Seized in Train Raid from Goa to Hyderabad

STF and DTF teams seize 48 bottles aboard Vasco da Gama Express

Banned Drug Seized in Karimnagar

Banned skin care soap containing Permethrin,

Indiramma Housing Scheme Expanded to Cities to Support Urban Poor

TPN Correspondent | Hyderabad: The Telangana government, under the leadership of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, is now focusing on constructing Indiramma houses in urban areas to ensure that poor families living in city slums can own homes without risking their livelihoods. State Revenue, Housing, and Information and Public Relations Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy announced this development during a recent review of the housing project. Minister Srinivasa Reddy explained that many poor families in Hyderabad's slums prefer to stay close to the city due to livelihood concerns. Earlier, the government built 42,000 houses away from Hyderabad, but only about 13,000 were occupied. Considering this, the government has decided to build multi-storey Indiramma houses (G+3) within city limits, starting with 16 slum areas in Hyderabad. Similar plans are in progress for other cities, including Warangal, Nizamabad, Mahabubnagar, Nalgonda, and Karimnagar. The Minister also highlighted the government's focus on tribal welfare. So far, 22,016 Indiramma houses have been sanctioned for tribal communities across the state, including 13,266 houses in tribal development areas such as Bhadrachalam, Utnoor, Eturunagaram, and Munnanur. Officials have been directed to quickly identify beneficiaries and begin construction. Srinivasa Reddy stressed that the government is committed to proactively sanctioning and building Indiramma houses, with continuous monitoring to ensure progress. He pointed out that no other state government has invested as much as five lakh rupees per house for the poor. The state is determined to fulfill its promise to provide housing to every eligible citizen under this scheme. Officials have been urged to work diligently to ensure the timely completion of this housing initiative, which aims to improve the living standards of Telangana's urban and tribal poor.

Mahabubnagar MLA **Slams Etela Rajender**

Mahabubnagar MLA Yonnem Srinivas Reddy criticized former minister Etela Rajender's remarks on the collapse of the Medigadda project in the Kaleshwaram lift irrigation scheme. Addressing concerns over the formation of the PC



Ghosh Commission, which was set up to investigate planning, design flaws, financial irregularities, and technical issues related to the project, Srinivas Reddy highlighted that the CAG report pointed to corruption, lack of supervision, and poor quality in the project execution.

He mocked BJP leaders for forming factions and issuing notices to Etela Rajender, stating that mistakes require accountability and inquiry even

at the highest levels, including the Prime Minister. Comparing the current commission to historical ones formed post-independence, he said many prominent leaders had to appear before similar bodies.

Srinivas Reddy noted the project cost surged from ₹82,000 crores to ₹1,20,000 crores and distanced himself from the payment of ₹538 crores to VA-PCO for the DPR, asserting he had no role in the design or execution. He blamed the Kalvakuntla family, including Chief Minister KCR, for the irregularities, revealing that BRS had received electoral bonds worth ₹1,400 crores from 2018 to 2023, which were allegedly tied to the Kaleshwaram project. He questioned why the BJP did not push forward during the commission proceedings and said the political family acts as if notices to KCR are equivalent to serving God. The MLA demanded that KCR appear before the commission soon so the public can know the truth. He also urged leaders Harish Rao and KCR not to delay their response.

The issue remains a focal point of political debate as investigations continue into the Medigadda project collapse and its financial and technical failures.

Cetrimide, and Menthol seized

In a significant crackdown on the illegal circulation of banned medicines, the Drugs Control Administration (DCA), Telangana, has seized a prohibited drug combination from a medical distributor in Karimnagar. The banned product, a medicated skin care soap containing Permethrin IP 1.0%, Cetrimide IP 0.5% and Menthol IP 1.0%, was found during a raid on PLN Pharma Distributors.

The product, branded as 'Dr. Ethix's MediSkin Medicated Skin Care Soap', was illegally manufactured by Maxwell Pharma, located at Industrial Plot No. 6 & 7, Sector 5, Parwanoo, Solan, Himachal Pradesh It was manufactured for Dr. Ethix's Products and Services Pvt. Ltd. Guindy, Chennai, despite the Government of India's prohibition on this combination in 2018.

Acting on specific intelligence inputs regarding the illegal sale of banned drugs, DCA officials from the Karimnagar zone conducted a surprise inspection at the premises. The seized soap contained the fixed-dose combination (FDC) of Permethrin + Cetrimide + Menthol, which the Central Government banned on September 7, 2018, citing a lack of therapeutic justification.

The inspection was carried out by Sri M. Srinivasulu, Assistant Director, Karimnagar, and Sri P. Karthik Bharadwaj, Drugs Inspector Karimnagar. Officials have initiated further investigations and assured that stringent legal action will be taken against all parties involved in the illegal manufacture and distribution of the banned drug. Authorities have reiterated that the manufacture, sale, and distribution of prohibited drugs is a serious offence, posing significant risks to public health. The DCA is intensifying surprise checks across the state to curb the circulation of banned and unsafe medicines, ensuring public safety.

The department has urged medical shops and distributors to remain vigilant and refrain from stocking or selling banned medicines, warning that violators will face strict consequences under existing drug control laws.

Will Nepal Witness the Return of the **Monarchy? A Nation at a Crossroads**

dramatic scenes as a massive pro-monarchy rally, led by former Home Minister Kamal Thapa, attempted to march toward Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli's residence. The crowd chanted slogans calling for the restoration of the Hindu monarchy, abolished in 2008. Police responded with force-batons and tear gas—ultimately arresting Thapa and several others. Hours later, they were released.

This protest is part of a growing wave of monarchist sentiment sweeping through Nepal, driven by economic hardship and public frustration with corruption among republican leaders. Ironically, Thapa, who once suppressed anti-monarchy protests as Home Minister during the 2006 uprising, is now leading calls to restore the very system he helped dismantle

On June 1, Kathmandu witnessed The monarchy in Nepal was abolished following a mass uprising against King Gyanendra's rule, resulting in the country's transition to a Republic. International support, particularly from India, the U.S., and China, endorsed the change. The King vacated the Narayanhiti Royal Palace, which was later converted into a museum. Yet, almost two decades later, dissatisfaction with the current political system has sparked a resurgence in royalist activity.

Smaller political parties, intellectuals, and even members of the royal family are joining the call for a return to constitutional monarchy. King Gyanendra himself has become more visible, attending public events and meeting with pro-monarchy leaders. His return from Pokhara recently drew thousands to welcome him—highlighting the depth of public discontent.

However, constitutional hurdles make any real change improbable. Nepal's current Constitution has no provision for reinstating a monarchy. A two-thirds majority in Parliament would be required to amend it—an unlikely feat given the monarchists' limited representation. Most major political parties remain firmly opposed to such a reversal. Though monarchists are trying to court support from India and China, both nations have shown little interest in supporting a royal restoration. Even within the royal family, uncertainty looms over succession, as former King Gyanendra's son lacks public support, while his grandson is still studying abroad.

For now, a return of the monarchy seems more symbolic than feasible—a reflection of public disillusionment, but not yet a political reality.

The core issue under debate is whether to continue exempting traditional card payments from certain reporting requirements while denying the same relief to instant payment systems (IPS) like India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI), despite IPS often having equal or superior security measures.

Currently, FATF's rules favor card net-

tries, assuming they are less risky. However, evidence contradicts this. UPI handled over \$2.2 trillion in transactions in FY 2023-24, with a fraud rate below 0.01%, lower than many card payment systems in OECD countries. UPI employs real-time monitoring, dual-factor authentication, and strong regulatory oversight, making it highly secure. Yet, IPS systems do not receive the same regulatory exemptions, putting them at a competitive disadvantage.

India, along with countries like Brazil, Indonesia, and Malaysia, has strongly pushed FATF to adopt a fairer approach—treating payment systems FATF Secretariat has even suggested a middle ground: exempt IPS that meet specific AML and counter-terrorism financing (CFT) standards. Still, some FATF members remain hesitant to make this change.

This hesitation risks perpetuating an outdated framework that favors legacy Western card networks over innovative payment solutions emerging in developing countries. Such bias undermines the FATF's goal of technology-neutral and globally inclusive standards. It also raises questions about the organization's legitimacy and fairness in the eyes of the Global South, where IPS are critical for finan-



cial inclusion.

India insists that if equitable treatment for IPS is not included, the entire R.16 reform should be postponed. With FATF's current leadership prioritizing financial inclusion, sidelining

IPS would contradict this focus. The world watches as FATF decides whether to embrace innovation and fairness or cling to legacy rules that hinder progress.

Over 166 people, including foreign nationals, lost their lives in the nearly 60-hour siege, which remains one of the deadliest terror attacks on Indian soil. Investigations into the wider network of conspirators are ongoing.

Indian Navy to Commission First Next-Gen Anti-Submarine Ship 'Arnala' on June 18

major milestone in India's maritime defense capabilities, the Indian Navy will commission its first next-generation Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW-SWC), named 'Arnala', on June 18 at the Naval Dockyard in Visakhapatnam.

Built by Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) under a public-private partnership with L&T Shipbuilders, 'Arnala' is the lead ship of a 16-vessel fleet being constructed at an estimated cost of ₹13,000 crore. The ship will be formally inducted into service in a ceremony presided over by Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan.

New Delhi, June 6, 2025 — Marking a Designed for subsurface surveillance in coastal and shallow waters, 'Arnala' is also equipped to carry out search and rescue operations, mine laying, and low-intensity maritime combat missions. With its advanced sonar systems and maneuverability, the ship will enhance India's ability to detect and neutralize underwater threats, especially enemy submarines operating close to the coastline.

> The ASW-SWC project is being jointly executed by two of India's premier shipyards — GRSE in Kolkata and Cochin Shipyard Limited, each tasked with building eight ships. The induction of these vessels will significantly augment the Navy's coastal defense

preparedness and underwater warfare capabilities.

Named after the historic Arnala Fort off the Vasai coast in Maharashtra, the ship symbolizes India's maritime legacy and strategic vision. "With The Man Who Lost His Mind?" Trump Rejects Talks Of A Call With Musk

Less than 24 hours after a fiery exchange of words and social media attacks, rumors circulated about a potential phone call between U.S. President Donald Trump and Tesla CEO Elon Musk, aimed at de-escalating their very public dispute. However, the damage had already been done. Elon Musk's companies saw their valuation tumble by over \$150 billion, while Trump faced mounting allegations threatening to shake his presidency.

A Missed Call?

Reports initially suggested that President Trump's aides had scheduled a call with Musk for Friday morning, which was later confirmed by a White House official. However, just hours before the call was to take place, another official contradicted the statement, claiming there were no plans for a conversation.

In an early morning phone interview with ABC News, Trump dismissed the idea with a sharp



News, Trump dismissed the idea with a sharp jab, saying, "You mean the man who has lost his mind?" Trump added that he was "not par-

ticularly" interested in speaking with Musk and implied that it was Musk who sought the conversation, not the other way around.

The Fallout: A Bitter Break-Up

This public snub came after a volatile week that saw the relationship between the two billionaires go from friendly to explosive. Their falling-out centered around the controversial 'One Big Beautiful Bill,' which Trump passed, removing tax cuts for electric vehicle manufacturers, including Tesla. Musk, who had fought fiercely to retain these tax incentives, saw Tesla's stock plummet by over 14%, wiping out \$150 billion in value.

Musk, feeling betrayed, publicly reminded Trump that his political career owed much to Musk's financial and moral backing during the 2024 election. The once-close relationship between Trump and Musk, which had been characterized by mutual praise, appeared to be irreparably damaged after these events.

School Bombing in Northwest Pakistan Highlights Ongoing Threat to Education

A government high school in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's Tank district was bombed early Friday morning by unidentified assailants, in yet another attack targeting educational institutions in northwest Pakistan, police confirmed.

The explosion occurred in Akbari village, under the jurisdiction of the Gul Imam police station. According to police sources, the attackers used explosives to destroy the school

building, causing several classrooms to collapse. No casualties were reported, but the infrastructure suffered significant damage.

No militant group has claimed responsibility so far. However, local authorities suspect splinter factions of the banned Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP), which are known to operate in the Tank district and have a history of targeting schools — particularly those educating girls.



This incident follows a deadly school bus explosion in Balochistan that killed five people, including three children, underscoring the persistent risks faced by students and educators across Pakistan's volatile regions.

The Pakistani Taliban held sway in many parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and nearby tribal areas for years until military operations pushed them back. However, sporadic violence continues, with educational institutions remaining prime targets. The 2012 attack on Malala Yousafzai in Swat Valley — a vocal advocate for girls' education shocked the world and brought global attention to the issue. Malala later became a Nobel Peace Prize laureate.

Japan's Ispace Loses Contact With Moon Lander 'Resilience' After Touchdown Attempt

Japanese space startup Ispace has announced it was unable to re-establish communication with its uncrewed lunar lander Resilience following a touchdown attempt on the Moon early Friday morning. The mission, dubbed Hakuto-R Mission 2, was Ispace's second bid to achieve a successful lunar landing after a failed attempt in 2023.

Resilience was aiming to make Ispace the first private company outside the United States to land a spacecraft on the Moon. The planned touchdown was scheduled for 4:17 a.m. JST (1917 GMT, Thursday), following a meticulously planned hour-long descent from lunar orbit.

This marks the second unsuccessful attempt by Ispace to land on the Moon. Its first mission in April 2023 ended in failure when the lander crashed during the final descent phase due to a navigation error.

These attacks are part of a long-standing campaign by extremist groups opposing formal education, especially for girls. However, no confirmation of a successful landing or subsequent data transmission was received. The company stated that it is currently analyzing telemetry data to determine what went wrong during the critical final moments of the descent.

"We have not been able to establish communication with the lander after the expected touchdown time," Ispace said in a statement. "We are continuing to investigate the situation and will

Despite the setback, Ispace remains one of the leading contenders in the private lunar exploration sector, aiming to provide commercial transport services to the Moon in partnership with international space agencies and commercial partners.

Industry analysts say while the mission may not have ended in success, it reflects the growing ambition and capabilities of private aerospace firms in advancing space exploration beyond Earth orbit.

Former Nepal PM Madhav Kumar Nepal Charged in Patanjali Land Misappropriation Case

Kathmandu: In a significant political and legal development, Nepal's anti-corruption body has filed a graft case against former Prime Minister and CPN-Unified Socialist chairman Madhav Kumar Nepal, along with 93 others. The charges relate to a land misappropriation scandal involving Patanjali Yogpeeth-Nepal.

The Commission of Inquiry into

Abuse of Authority (CIAA) on Thursday formally accused Madhav Nepal of facilitating the questionable purchase of government and public land in the Kavre district, roughly 40 kilometers from Kathmandu. The land was reportedly allocated for Patanjali Yogpeeth to establish a yoga center and herbal farming project — a venture said to be backed by Indian spiritual leader and Patanjali founder Baba Ramdev.

The CIAA alleges that the transaction was carried out in violation of land acquisition norms and that Nepal, during his tenure, played a key role in bypassing regulatory processes to benefit the or-



ganization.

As a direct consequence of the chargesheet, Madhav Nepal, a sitting member of Nepal's federal parliament, has automatically lost his parliamentary seat — in accordance with the country's legal provisions disqualifying indicted individuals from holding public office.

The filing of the case has stirred political waters in Nepal, with oppo-

sition parties demanding broader investigations into alleged collusion between political figures and foreign-linked entities. Patanjali's land dealings in Nepal have long been under scrutiny, with civil society groups raising concerns over transparency, land use, and national interest.

This marks one of the most high-profile corruption cases in recent Nepalese political history, implicating a former prime minister and a prominent political leader. The case now heads to the Special Court, where proceedings will determine the extent of legal culpability of Madhav Nepal and others involved in the deal.

US Army Develops 3D-Printed Skin to Heal Soldiers' Battle Wounds The US Army is advancing cutting-edge bioprinting technology to produce 3D-print-

The US Army is advancing cutting-edge bioprinting technology to produce 3D-printed skin and tissues that could revolutionize battlefield medicine. In collaboration with the University of Hawaii, the US Army Combat Capabilities Development Command Chemical Biological Center (DEVCOM CBC) has launched a research initiative aimed at treating soldiers' injuries more effectively particularly severe burns and wounds.

Bioprinting uses bio-inks made from living cells, proteins, and nutrients to create three-dimensional, functional replicas of human tissues and organs. The technology holds immense potential for military medicine, enabling rapid tissue repair and even organ regeneration on the battlefield or in remote areas.

Under a Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA), DEVCOM CBC and the University of Hawaii are executing two joint work statements (JWS). One of these focuses on developing advanced organ models using bioprinting. Dr. Jason Barnhill, an associate research professor at the John A. Burns School of Medicine (JABSOM), is partnering with DEVCOM CBC's bioengineering expert Priscilla Lee to create tools for evaluating chemical compounds and responses in



human tissue.

Dean Sam Shomaker of JABSOM highlighted the global impact of the project, saying, "These efforts have the potential to save the lives of frontline soldiers and civilians. Introducing innovative biofabrication technologies to remote regions supports not only USINDOPACOM's mission but global humanitarian efforts."

Lee is specifically researching immune responses using bioprinted cell culture models, which could lead to new biomaterials for treating wounds from burns, toxic gas exposure, and antibiotic-resistant infections.

Bioprinting stands as a beacon of innovation in medicine, with its ultimate goal being the ability to print entire organs using a patient's own cells. If successful, this technology may redefine how we treat injuries — both in combat zones and in hospitals worldwide.

Adani Group's Tax Contribution Soars to Rs 74,945 Crore in FY25, Up 29%



The Adani Group announced a significant 29% increase in its total tax contribution to the exchequer for fiscal year 2025, reaching Rs 74,945 crore compared to Rs 58,104 crore in FY24. This growth reflects the company's expanding business operations and its commitment to tax transparency as part of its broader Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) framework.

Out of the total tax contribution, direct taxes amounted to Rs 28,720 crore, while indirect taxes contributed Rs 45,407 crore. Other contributions, including social security benefits for employees, totaled Rs 818 crore. To give context, the Rs 74,945 crore tax paid by the group is nearly equivalent to the cost of building the entire Mumbai Metro network or hosting a modern Olympic Games.

Key contributors within the group's portfolio include Adani Enterprises Limited (AEL), Adani Cement Limited (ACL), Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone (APSEZ), and Adani Green Energy Limited (AGEL). The tax details are disclosed through independent annual reports of seven publicly listed Adani entities, including Adani Energy Solutions Limited, Adani Power Limited, Adani Total Gas Limited, and Ambuja Cements Limited. Additionally, the figures incorporate taxes paid by NDTV, ACC, and Sanghi Industries, which are held by these entities.

The Group has also published a detailed document titled 'Basis of Preparation and Approach to Tax' on the websites of its listed companies. This document offers a comprehensive breakdown of global taxes paid, including direct taxes, indirect taxes collected on behalf of stakeholders, and other contributions.

Emphasizing transparency, the Adani Group stated that this voluntary initiative aims to build stakeholder trust and promote accountability in global tax practices. The group continues to balance rapid growth with social responsibility, focusing on transforming India's infrastructure while creating long-term value. RBI Slashes Repo Rate by 50 bps to Spur Growth, Shifts Policy Stance to Neutral

Gold Loan Stocks Surge as RBI Proposes Higher LTV Limit for Small Loans

In a significant move aimed at stimulating economic growth, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on June 6, 2025, reduced the policy repo rate by 50 basis points to 5.50%. This marks the second rate cut this year, following a cumulative reduction of 100 bps since February 2025.

RBI Governor Sanjay Malhotra, while delivering the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) statement, emphasized that the decision is aligned with the central bank's medium-term inflation target of 4% (within a +/- 2% band), while simultaneously supporting growth recovery. With this adjustment, the Standing Deposit

Facility (SDF) rate now stands at 5.25%, and both the Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate have been revised to 5.75%.

In addition to the repo rate cut, the RBI also announced a reduction in the Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) by 100 basis points, bringing it down to 3.0% of net demand and time liabilities (NDTL). This cut will be implemented in a staggered manner throughout the year to infuse durable liquidity into the banking system.

The RBI has also revised its monetary policy stance from "accommodative" to "neutral," signaling a cautious approach ahead. "Monetary

policy space has narrowed after recent rate cuts. From here, our stance will depend on incoming data and evolving global conditions," Governor Malhotra noted.

For FY26, the central bank projects real GDP growth at 6.5%, with quarterly estimates ranging between 6.3% and 6.7%. CPI inflation is projected to average 3.7% for the year, assuming a normal monsoon, with risks deemed evenly balanced.

The move reflects the RBI's balancing act between fostering growth and maintaining price stability in a volatile global economic environment.



Gold loan stocks saw a notable rally on Frijay Malhotra proposed a hike in the loan-tovalue (LTV) ratio for small-ticket gold loans. The new guideline suggests increasing the LTV ratio to 85% for gold loans up to ₹2.5 lakh, compared to the current limit of 75%. This change is aimed at boosting lending flexibility for non-banking financial companies (NBFCs).

The announcement triggered sharp buying in shares of gold-financing firms. Muthoot Finance surged over 7% intraday, trading at ₹2,450.40 against its previous close of ₹2,294.60. Manappuram Finance also rose more than 5%, touching ₹248.46 from an opening price of ₹234.84. IIFL Finance and other lenders in the gold loan segment witnessed similar upward momentum.

The LTV ratio defines the maximum loan one can receive against the pledged gold. A higher LTV ratio means customers can borrow more money for the same gold value, which

is expected to increase loan disbursements and widen the customer base for gold financiers. This move is also seen as a potential earnings booster for NBFCs specializing in gold-backed lending.

The RBI's revised proposal comes as a shift from earlier draft norms, which had suggested a uniform 75% LTV cap for both banks and NBFCs. In addition to the LTV hike, the RBI also announced simplified operational norms, including no mandatory credit appraisal for small-ticket loans and relaxed end-use monitoring, especially for non-PSL loans.

Governor Malhotra noted that final guidelines would be released by today or Monday morning, emphasizing regulatory clarity and compliance consistency.

The announcement followed a broader 50 basis points repo rate cut to 5.50%, sparking optimism across the financial and banking sectors.





Customer Allegedly Finds Ants in Maggi Ordered from Zepto Café

Company Responds Amid Rising Concerns

A^{c u s t o m e r ' s} shocking discovery of ants in a bowl of Maggi noodles ordered from Zepto Cafe has sparked outrage on social media. The incident, highlighted in a viral Instagram video, shows four bowls of noodles — one empty and three partially eaten — with multiple dead ants clearly visible at the bottom.

The post quickly gained traction, amassing over two million views.

Tagging Zepto's official handle, the customer wrote, "@zeptonow this is disgusting. However, I'm shocked to see their cafe still operating with deceptive offers like 'Buy 1 get 1 free' — serving food with insects is unacceptable! They're prioritizing fast delivery over hygiene and health."

Zepto, a 10-minute quick-commerce food delivery platform, responded in the comments section: "Hey! At Zepto, we take quality seriously, and we regret any inconvenience caused if this product doesn't meet your expectations. In a recent inspection, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) found "serious non-compliance" at Zepto's Dharavi warehouse in Mumbai. Issues included fungal growth on food, expired items, and poor storage conditions. As a result, the FDA has suspended the food business license for that warehouse, raising broader concerns about the company's overall food safety standards.

Chenab Rail Bridge: Inside the Tech Powering the World's Tallest Railway Bridge

I way bridge in the world, is set to be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, marking a milestone in India's infrastructure journey. Located in the Reasi district of Jammu and Kashmir, the bridge spans 1,315 meters across the deep Chenab River gorge and is a part of the ambitious Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link (USBRL) project.

Constructed by Afcons Infrastructure under the Konkan Railway Corporation, the bridge towers 359 meters above the riverbed—making it 35 meters taller than the Eiffel Tower. With a total project cost of ₹1,486 crore, the Chenab Rail Bridge has a designed lifespan of 120 years and is built to withstand wind speeds of up to 266 kmph and train speeds of 100 kmph.

The bridge's unique two-rib steel arch with open spandrel design ensures strength and flexibility. Each of its massive steel segments weighs 34 metric

The Chenab Rail Bridge, hailed as the highest rail- tonnes and was installed using the world's tallest cable crane, supported by a 127-meter-high pylon—taller than Delhi's Qutub Minar.

> To withstand the harsh environment and seismic activity in the region (zone V), the bridge is made from weathering steel, which resists corrosion and adapts to extreme temperatures ranging from -20°C to 45°C. Its 5.84 lakh kilometers of welds—almost equal to the distance between Jammu Tawi and New Delhi—were tested using Phased Array Ultrasonic Testing, a first for Indian Railways.



These are part of a real-time Structural Health Monitoring (SHM) system that tracks wind, load, vibration, and temperature. If any abnormal readings are detected, automated alerts are sent to halt train movement, ensuring complete operational safety.

Chawla was a member of India's historic 2007 T20 World Cup-winning squad and the 2011 ODI World Cup team. He represented India in 3 Tests, 25 ODIs, and 7 T20Is, taking 43 wickets in total across formats.

"From representing India at the highest level to being part of the victorious 2007 T20 and 2011 ODI World Cup squads, every moment in this incredible journey has been nothing short of a blessing," he wrote.

Chawla also enjoyed a fruitful IPL career, playing for multiple franchises including Punjab Kings, Kolkata Knight Riders, Chennai Super Kings, and Mumbai Indians. He was part of KKR's 2014 title-winning squad and famously scored the winning runs in the final



against Punjab Kings.

He extended his heartfelt thanks to his coaches, the IPL franchises, and especially his late father. "A special mention to my late father, whose belief in me lit the path I walked. Without him, this journey would never have been possible," Chawla said.

Starting his career at just 15, Chawla made headlines when he bowled out Sachin Tendulkar with a googly in the Challenger Series in 2005-06. He ends his domestic career with over 1,000 wickets — a remarkable achievement for a modern leg-spinner.
