#### **Ponnam Urges Centre for Defence Land Transfer, Rs 1,000 Cr Dues Clearance in Hyderabad**

yderabad, Oct 03: Telangana Transport Minister and Hyderabad incharge Ponnam Prabhakar has urged Defence Minister Rajnath Singh to expedite the transfer of defence lands to the state, highlighting their vital role in ongoing infrastructure and mobility projects across Hyderabad a n d Secunderabad.

The appeal, co-signed by GHMC Mayor Gadwala Vijaya Lakshmi, Rajya

Sabha MP Anil Kumar Yaday, and Secunderabad Cantonment MLA Ganesh, thanked the Centre for its in-principle approval to release certain defence lands for public use

The Minister emphasized that timely transfer of these lands would help meet the twin cities' growing infrastructure requirements and improve civic amenities for residents.

Ponnam also reminded the Defence Ministry that nearly Rs 1,000 crore in user charges from the Cantonment to the Telangana government remain unsettled, urging prompt clearance to strengthen civic services in these areas.

Highlighting delays in Secunderabad Cantonment Board elections, he called for immediate action to reinstate democratic governance and local ensure representation.

Expressing hope for a positive response, the Minister stressed that resolving these issues is crucial for Hyderabad's overall development.

## **Manjeera River Swells Again**

yderabad, Oct 03: The Edupayala Vana Durga Bhavani Temple in Papannapet, Medak district, is temporarily closed due to the swelling of the Manjeera River. On October 1, authorities released 1.09 lakh cusecs of water from the Vana Durga Dam, leading to increased water levels near the temple. As a precaution, the temple premises have been closed to devotees. Priests are conducting daily prayers at the Rajagopuram, and the festive idol of Goddess Vana Durga remains installed

The temple, located in the middle of the river, has faced similar closures in the past due to flooding. In August, the temple was closed for 28 days following heavy rains and water releases from upstream reservoirs. During that period, the sanctum was submerged, and devotees were advised to avoid the area.

Authorities have urged the public to stay away from the river until the water levels recede. The situation remains under close monitoring, and updates will be provided as conditions change.

yderabad, Oct 03: Telangana's GST collections for September painted a grim picture for the State's economy, plunging by 5 per cent compared to the same month last year—the lowest growth rate in India. The national average, by contrast, stood at a healthy 7 per cent.

Himachal Pradesh, another Congressruled State, was the only other region in negative territory at -4 per cent.

The decline is stark compared to the previous BRS government, which posted 33 per cent GST growth in September 2023, top-

ping national charts. Under Congress, growth slowed to 1 per cent in September 2024 before slipping further into negative territory

this year. Month-wise trends show a downward trajectory: collections rose 12 per cent in April, 6 per cent in May, 8 per cent in June, 10 per cent in July, and 12 per cent in August before the September slump. Officials noted that a new GST tariff, introduced in the last week of September, had minimal impact on

Reacting sharply, BRS working president KT Rama Rao blamed the Congress government for mishandling the economy. 'Two years ago, we led the nation in GST growth; today, we are at the bottom. This decline reflects the chaos and inexperience under Chief Minister Revanth Reddy," he said.

Rama Rao added that sectors from agriculture to IT thrived under the BRS regime, whereas under Congress rule, industries from farming to real estate are facing a downturn.



## **Task Force Seizes E-Cigarettes Worth** ₹2.5 Lakh in IS Sadan



he Commissioner's Task Force, South-East Zone, Hyderabad, along with IS Sadan Police, arrested a man for procuring and selling banned Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems (ENDS), commonly

known as E-cigarettes. On 2 October 2025, Tharif Hussain (30), a two-wheeler dealer from Khalander Nagar. IS Sadan, was caught with 90 flavoured E-cigarettes (ELFBAR 40,000 puffs), a Honda Activa, an iPhone, and ₹2,900 in cash. The total seizure is valued at approximately ₹2.5

Investigations revealed Hussain sourced the items from a man named Aizaz and sold them at inflated prices for profit. Officials emphasized that E-cigarettes, which contain nicotine, pose serious health risks and are prohibited for public sale.

The operation was conducted under inspector S Saidababu's supervision, supported by SIs K Rama Rao, M Madhu, and Task Force staff, in coordination with IS Sadan

#### **Congress leader's** son arrested after fatal road mishap

of businessman and Congress leader Ali Masqati, was taken into custody by Bandlaguda police on Friday, October 3, following a road accident that claimed the life of a 63-year-old man, Abdul Hasnath. Another individual, 55-year-old Sajeed, sustained injuries in the incident.

The police registered a case under Sections 106 (1) and 125 (a) for causing death by negligence and endangering life. The car involved in the accident has been seized.

According to the FIR accessed by Siasat. com, the accident took place on September 30 near Alhamdulilah Hotel, close to Al

Falaknuma Fly-over bridge. The victims were traveling on a two-wheeler when a Fortuner car hit them from behind, causing them to fall. Abdul Hasnath suffered head, knee, and abdominal injuries, while Sajeed was injured in his left

Both injured men were initially taken to Asra Hospital, where Abdul Hasnath succumbed to his injuries. Sajeed has been shifted to Bhagwandevi Hospital at Gulzarhouse.

A relative of the deceased told local media that while the accused's family sent Rs 70,000–80,000 for hospital expenses, they have insisted that Rehan Masqati meet them personally.



## India-Pak Asia Cup Row: War, Minus The Shooting

ed as a "gentleman's game," has once again revealed its sharp political undercurrents. Last month's Asia Cup in Dubai reignited nationalistic tensions between India and Pakistan, raising questions about whether George Orwell's famed phrase— "sport is war minus the shooting"—still holds true, or if it has evolved into something far more aggressive.

Orwell's 1945 essay on the sporting spirit warned that international sports often fuel national rivalries and stir up aggression rather than goodwill. His cautionary words feel eerily relevant today, especially after fiery public commentary linked India's Asia Cup victory to the military's Operation Sindoor, carried out in the aftermath of the Pahalgam terror attack. The lines between sport, nationalism, and political

more with each tournament.

In Dubai, symbolic gestures on the field mirrored this tension. Visuals of Pakistani players mimicking rifle stances with their bats, Indian players refusing handshakes, and the trophy snub involving Pakistan's Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi sparked outrage and debate. While cricket should unite, it appeared to deepen divides—ironically, even as the tournament was held under the banner of the Asian Cricket Council.

Yet history offers more complex narratives. In 1965, amid a real war between India and Pakistan, cricket legends Mansur Ali Khan Pataudi and Hanif Mohammad played together in a "Rest of the World" team, even co-signing an appeal to end the conflict. Similarly, the 1996 World Cup, co-hosted by India,

briefly felt like a post-partition reconciliation.

The deeper point, as Caribbean-born historian C.L.R. James once asked: "What do they know of cricket who only cricket know?" Cricket, like all sport, is never just about the game—it reflects social, political, and historical tensions. The West Indies' rise in the 1970s, captured in the documentary Fire in Babylon, showcased how former colonies beat their ex-rulers at their own game, turning cricket into a symbol of resistance.

As right-wing nationalism rises globally, cricket is caught between being a sport of fair play and a proxy battleground for unresolved rivalries. Perhaps Orwell wasn't entirely wrong—but maybe, just maybe, cricket can still surprise us and remain a metaphor for unity, not division.



#### **RSS Marks 100 Years of Nation-Building Through Character-Building**

mi, the Rashtriva Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) completes a century of its existence. Founded in 1925 by Dr. Keshav Baliram Hedgewar, the RSS began its journey in a deeply colonised Bharat, determined to revive the nation's cultural and spiritual identity through the transformation of individual citizens. Inspired by Swami Vivekananda, Dr. Hedgewar envisioned an organisation that would go beyond political independence, aiming for intellectual and spiritual regeneration of the nation.

From its inception in Nagpur to its nationwide presence today, the RSS has steadily expanded through grassroots initiatives such as daily shakhas, disaster relief, and character development. Its message found resonance even in conflict-prone areas like Kannur, Kerala, where its influence among youth reportedly led to increased discipline and social responsibility—drawing both praise and



violent opposition from political rivals.

In 1981, a young police officer posted in Tellicherry (Kannur) witnessed first-hand the violent backlash against RSS sympathisers and the organisation's with CPM cadres. Political tensions escalated when large caches of explosives were discovered in the homes of political leaders, prompting accusations against the officer and culminating in the dismissal of the Kerala government under President's Rule.

The organisation's footprint in the North-East was equally significant. In areas afflicted by

insurgency and ethnic militancy, RSS pracharaks quietly worked alongside locals, learning their languages and customs, offering education, medical help, and emotional support—often at grea personal risk. The 1999 killing of four pracharaks in Tripura highlighted the dangers they faced from militant groups and evangelical hostility.

One of the RSS's most impactful initiatives was the **Students Experience** in Interstate Living (SEIL) programme, launched in 1965. It built cultural bridges between North-East students and host

families across India, fostering long-lasting bonds and national integration. Many of these students later became top civil servants, military officers, and administrators.

Now marking 100 years, the RSS continues to be a transformative socio-cultural force, promoting national pride and unity across communities. As it steps into its second century, tributes pour in for its founder Dr. Hedgewar, his successors, and lakhs of volunteers who have contributed selflessly to the vision of Ek Bharat, Shresh-

#### **Al-Generated Islamophobic Content Surged in India Since Mid-2024**

cial Intelligence (AI)-generated Islamophobic content has been observed in India since mid-2024, according to a new report by the Centre for the Study of Organised Hate (CSOH), a Washington, DC-based nonprofit think tank. The report, titled "AIgenerated Imagery and the New Frontier of Islamophobia in India", tracks how AI technology is increasingly being used to amplify hate speech and bigotry, particularly against the Muslim community.

The study analysed 1,326 AI-generated images and videos posted between May 2023 and May 2025, across 297 social media accounts on X, Facebook, and Instagram. While such content was "minimal" throughout 2023 and the early part of 2024, a dramatic increase began around June 2024, with two notable peaks in September 2024 and March 2025.

The September surge aligned with the spread of the "Rail Jihad" conspiracy theory, while March's spike coincided with the viral trend of Ghibli Art, which was manipulated to include hate-filled visuals. The report noted that none of the 187 reported posts which violated platform guidelines—were taken down, pointing to a serious failure of content moderation by social me-

dia platforms. The hateful AI-gener-

Sexualisation of Muslim women - the most engaged-with content, reaching 6.7 million views. These AI-generated images often depicted Muslim women in burqas, surrounded by men, with captions suggesting incestuous ties.

Conspiratorial narratives – including tropes like Love Jihad, Population Jihad, and Rail Jihad, falsely linking Muslims to national threats.

Dehumanising rhetoric - posts depicting Muslims as animals or threats to public order, which made up 23.4% of the dataset.

Aestheticised violence - images normalising or glorifying ated content focused on violence against

The content drew total engagement of 27.3 million across platforms. X led with the highest volume and reach-509 posts, 24.1 million views, and over 5.6 lakh likes. Instagram followed with 462 posts, and Facebook had 355 posts.

The report also named Hindu nationalist media platforms like OpIndia. Sudarshan News, and Panchjanya as key amplifiers of synthetic hate, embedding AI-generated Islamophobia into mainstream narratives.

The findings underscore a troubling trend: the fusion of AI tools with ideological propaganda, pushing Islamophobic hate deeper into India's digital and political discourse.

## Pakistan lost several fighter jets in Operation Sindoor: IAF chief

ir Chief Marshal Amar Preet Singh on Friday revealed that India dealt significant blows to Pakistan's air assets, including U.S.-made F-16s and Chinese-supplied JF-17 fighter jets, during the recently concluded Operation Sindoor.

Addressing a press conference as part of the 93rd Indian Air Force Day celebrations

at the Air Force Auditorium in Delhi, the IAF chief provided rare operational insights into the high-intensity mission. "The operation successfully neutralised key Pakistani air assets, degrading their offensive capabilities," Singh stated, adding that damage assessments confirmed hits on several front-line aircraft.

The disclosure marks the first official confirmation of the extent of damage inflicted on Pakistan's Air Force during the operation, which had remained under wraps due to diplomatic sensitivities. Operation Sindoor was carried out in response to escalating cross-border threats and intelligence inputs regarding imminent aerial aggression.

In addition to the operational highlights, Air Chief Marshal Singh laid out the Air Force's long-term vision under Roadmap 2047, which includes fleet modernization, enhanced joint operations capabilities, and greater reliance on indigedefence nous technologies.

A major highlight of the roadmap is the proposed Sudarshan Chakra Air Defence System, a domestically developed integrated air shield aimed at countering both manned and unmanned aerial threats. Singh said the system is in advanced conceptual stages and will serve as India's first fully indigenous multi-tiered air defence network.

The IAF chief reaffirmed India's commitment to maintaining aerial superiority in the region, while also stressing the importance of self-reliance and technological innovation. He praised the efforts of defence PSUs and private players working on cutting-edge aviation

projects. The Air Force Day events included aerial displays and tributes to fallen air warriors, showcasing India's evolving military air power and its future trajectory.



#### **PM Modi to Launch ₹62,000-Cr Youth Empowerment Initiatives**

rime Minister Narendra Modi is set to unveil a comprehensive package of youth-focused initiatives worth over ₹62,000 crore on Saturday (October 4), aimed at transforming education, skill development, and entrepreneurship across

The centrepiece of the launch will be PM-SETU (Pradhan Mantri Skilling and Employability Transformation through Upgraded ITIs), a ₹60,000 crore scheme to upgrade 1,000 government ITIs. PM Modi will also inaugurate 1,200 Vocational Skill Labs across Navodaya Vidyalayas and Eklavya Model Schools in 34 states and UTs. These labs will provide hands-on training in 12 sectors including IT, agriculture, electronics, logistics, and tourism aligned with NEP 2020 and the CBSE curriculum.

In a strong push for Bihar's development, Modi will relaunch two revamped state schemes:

#### MK Stalin Slams BJP For "No Genuine Concern" Over Karur Stampede

amil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Friday accused the BJPled Centre of showing "no genuine concern" over the Karur stampede tragedy and instead attempting to politicise the incident ahead of the 2026 Assembly elections.

Speaking at a government function in Ramanathapuram, Stalin questioned the urgency behind dispatching a delegation of NDA MPs to Karur, where a stampede at a political rally claimed 41 lives. He contrasted this with the Centre's inaction during other national tragedies, mil Nadu's interests

such as the Manipur violence, Morbi bridge collapse, and Kumbh Mela stampede.

"It's not out of concern. It's a political move aimed at gaining mileage ahead of the 2026 elections," Stalin said. He called the BJP a "parasite" trying to exploit the tragedy for political gain and reiterated that Tamil Nadu remains out of the BJP's reach, despite efforts to co-opt local figures.

Stalin also criticised Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for her swift visit to Karur while allegedly ignoring Tamil Nadu during three major natural disasters. He further took aim at the AIADMK, accusing it of betraying Taby aligning with the BJP.

The CM also invoked history, alleging that the RSS had once plotted an attack on former CM K. Kamaraj, vowing to continue protecting Tamil Nadu under the "Dravidian Model 2.0."

He also blamed the Centre for failing to prevent attacks on Tamil fishermen by the Sri Lankan coast guard and emphasized that retrieving Katchatheevu from Sri Lanka is vital to resolving the

ongoing issue. During his visit, Stalin inaugurated development projects worth ₹738 crore, including a new government school in Thangachimadam and a student hostel Paramakudi.



#### Air India to Shift 60 Domestic Flights to Delhi Airport's **Terminal 2 from October 26**

ir India has announced the relocation of 60 domestic flights to Terminal 2 (T2) of Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport from October 26, 2025, due to ongoing expansion works at Terminal 3 (T3).

Air India Express will also move all its domestic operations to the newly upgraded Terminal 1 (T1), the airline said in a statement. The changes come as Delhi International Airport Ltd (DIAL) undertakes terminal expansion at T3 to boost international passenger capacity.

"Terminal enlargement works will reduce domestic capacity at T3, necessitating the relocation of certain domestic operations," the airline noted.

All international flights for both Air India and Air India Express will continwith no changes to their schedules or terminals.

## **Muttaqi to Visit India Next Week**

**Taliban 'Foreign Minister' Amir Khan**

n a significant diplomatic development, Taliban administration's 'Foreign Minister' Amir Khan Muttaqi is scheduled to visit India next week, officials from the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) confirmed on Thursday (October 2). This will mark the first high-level visit by a Taliban official to India since the group seized power in Afghanistan on August

According to MEA sources, the visit will focus on developmental cooperation, particularly India's assistance in addressing critical shortages of essential medicines and agricultural products in Afghanistan. The war-torn country has been grappling with a humanitarian crisis following the international withdrawal and the imposition of sanctions after the Taliban

takeover. The visit has been in the works for several months, but was delayed due to concerns over Muttagi's status under international sanctions. Like many senior Taliban leaders, he remains listed under United Nations and U.S. sanctions related to the group's past violent actions during the war against U.S. and NATO forces since

India, which has not officially recognized the Taliban regime, has nonetheless maintained limited diplomatic engagement through its technical mission in Kabul and continued hu-

manitarian support, including food grains, vaccines, and medical aid. The Indian government has also supported regional dialogues on Afghanistan's stability and counter-terrorism measures.

Muttaqi's visit is expected to be low-key, with no formal bilateral agreements anticipated. However, it marks a notable shift in India's Afghanistan outreach, focusing on humanitarian and developmental diplomacy over political recognition.

India had previously hosted Muttaqi at a regional conference in Tashkent but had stopped short of direct bilateral meetings. His upcoming visit could open doors to deeper engagement amid evolving geopolitical dynamics in South and Central Asia.



## **Trump Embraces Project** 2025, Pushes Federal Cuts **Amid Shutdown**

Project 2025, authored by The Heritage Foundation and many Trump allies, outlines sweeping changes to centralize executive power, cut the federal workforce, curb could face permanent immigration, and discies. While Trump denied any association with the plan during his 2024 campaign, several of its authors—including Vought, Stephen Miller, and John Rat-cliffe—now hold key roles i n his administration.

#### **Indonesia School Collapse: 8 Dead, 50 Students Still Missing in Sidoarjo Tragedy**

he death toll from the collapse of the Al-Khoziny Islamic boarding school in Sidoarjo, East Java, has risen to eight, with three more bodies recovered from the debris early Friday. Over 50 students remain missing, and 105 others have been injured, many suffering head injuries and broken bones, authorities confirmed.

The building, part of a century-old religious school, collapsed on

dreds of students were gathered in the prayer hall. Rescue crews have been working around the clock, initially using bare hands and basic tools, but switched to heavy excavators on Thursday after signs of life beneath the rubble diminished.

Officials said the collapsed structure was a two-storey building that was undergoing unauthorised construction of two additional concrete floors. The weakened foundation failed during a concrete pour, triggering the disaster. Police

Most of the victims were male students aged between 12 and 19, from classes VII to XII. Female students, who were praying in a separate section, managed to escape unharmed, according survivors.

Suharyanto, head of Indonesia's National Disaster Mitigation Agency, reported that two bodies were found in the prayer area and one near an exit-suggesting he had been trying to flee. "We're racing against time and the heat," he said,

#### **Massive Fire Erupts at Chevron Refinery Near** Los Angeles

massive fire broke out late Thursday night (October 2) at the Chevron oil refinery in El Segundo, just outside Los Angeles, sending flames and thick smoke billowing into the sky, visible from miles away.

Chevron confirmed the incident and stated that its emergency response teams had acted swiftly to bring the fire under control. The company also reported that no injuries were sustained during the spect for any possible

California Governor Gavin Newsom's office said it was closely monitoring the situation and was in touch with state and local emergency services to ensure the protection of nearby communities.

"State and local authorities are coordinating closely to assess air quality and ensure safety protocols are being followed," the Governor's office said in a brief statement.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation. El Segundo is home to one of Chevron's largest refineries, processing over 270,000 barrels of crude oil per day, making it a critical component of the region's fuel supply.

#### **Putin Hails PM Modi** as "Wise Leader", **Backs India's Strategic Autonomy**

ussian President Vladimir Putin praised Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi as a "very wise leader" who always prioritises the interests of his country, during a speech at the Valdai Discussion Club in Sochi on Thursday. He emphasised the special and strategic partnership between India and Russia, calling it a relationship built on deep trust and mutual respect.

"Prime Minister Modi is a very wise leader who thinks first about his country. India and Russia share a privileged strategic partnership, and people in India have not forgotten this," said Putin, as reported by Russia Today.

Putin's remarks come amid reports of his upcoming visit to India later this year. Ahead of this, Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov is expected to travel to New Delhi to prepare for the summit and hold discussions on key bilateral

During his address, Putin also defended India's continued purchase of Russian oil despite international pressure, particularly from the United States. He warned that any halt in oil imports from Russia could cost India USD 9–10 billion in economic losses.

'There is no political aspect here; it's purely economic. If India stops buying our energy resources, it will incur substantial losses. But if it doesn't, there could be sanctions. Either way, the impact is the same. So why give in, especially at domestic political cost?" Putin said, expressing confidence in India's refusal to be "humiliated" by external

The statement comes just two weeks after former US President Donald Trump accused India and China of being the "primary funders" of the Ukraine war due to their continued import of Russian oil.

Putin's praise reinforces growing geopolitical cooperation between New Delhi and Moscow, even as global tensions

#### Sarah Mullally Named First Female Archbishop of Canterbury

Historic appointment marks new era for Church of England

**CANTERBURY** 

n a historic move, Sarah Mullally, the current Bishop of London, has been appointed as the new Archbishop of Canterbury, making her the first woman to lead the Church of England in its 1,400-year history.

The announcement was made on Friday (October 3), ending an 11-month leadership vacuum following the resignation of former Archbishop Justin Welby in November 2024. Welby stepped down amid a major scandal involving the cover-up of child abuse within the Church, which had shaken public confidence and prompted calls for institutional

Mullally's elevation to justice." the Church's highest office marks a significant milestone not only for the Anglican community in the UK but also for its 85 million global adherents. The Archbishop of Canterbury serves as the ceremonial head of the worldwide Anglican Communion.

A former chief nursing officer of England before entering the clergy, Mullally has been widely respected for her pastoral care and administrative leadership. She has also been a strong advocate for inclusivity and transparency within the Church.

"I am deeply honoured by this calling," said Archbishop Mullally in a brief statement. "At this pivotal time, the Church must be a beacon of

However, her appointment may cause friction with conservative Anglican branches, particu-

larly in parts of Africa and Asia, where theological opposition to female leadership remains strong. Some leaders have already expressed concern that the move could further deepen doctrinal divisions within the Communion.

Despite this, Church officials see her appointment as a progressive step forward. "This is a moment of transformation," said a spokesperson for the Church. "Archbishop Mullally embodies the future of a compassionate, courageous, and inclusive Church.

She will be formally enthroned at Canterbury Cathedral later this year.











### **Maruti Suzuki Becomes First Carmaker to Deliver Cars to Kashmir by Rail**

n a historic develop-ment, Maruti Suzuki India Limited has become the first automobile manufacturer in India to transport vehicles to Kashmir by rail, with its first shipment arriving at the newly inaugurated Anantnag railway terminal on Friday.

The inaugural consignment included over 100 units of popular Maruti Suzuki models such as the Brezza, Dzire, WagonR, and S-Presso. The vehicles were dispatched from the company's recently launched in-plant railway siding at Manesar, Harvana.

Covering a journey of more than 850 kilometers, the train traversed several key rail corridors and notably crossed

way arch bridge over the Chenab river, symbolising the growing reach and capability of India's rail infrastructure.

"This is a significant milestone in our effort to enhance our logistics efficiency while reducing carbon footprint. The use of rail transport for vehicle delivery to Kashmir will not only cut down delivery time but also ensure safer and more sustainable transportation," a Maruti Suzuki spokesperson said.

The use of the railway network to access the Kashmir Valley marks a major shift in automotive logistics, which has traditionally depended on road transport for vehicle movement to the region. The new Anantto streamline supply chains for the Northern market and bring down costs and delays due to road blockages, especially during harsh

This initiative aligns with Maruti Suzuki's broader strategy to increase rail-based logistics and improve lastmile delivery. The company has been steadily expanding its rail network reach and aims to ramp up rail dispatches to more destinations across India.

#### OpenAl Hits \$500 **Billion Valuation After Major Share Sale**



penAI, the artificial intelligence company behind Chat-GPT, has reached a staggering \$500 billion valuation following a large-scale secondary share sale involving current and former employees, a source familiar with the matter con-

firmed on Thursday. In the deal, employees sold approximately \$6.6 billion worth of shares to a consortium of global investors, including Thrive Capital, Soft-Bank, Dragoneer Investment Group, Abu Dhabi's M.G.X., and T. Rowe Price. The transaction marks one of the most significant private tech funding rounds in recent

The source, who requested anonymity due to lack of authorisation to speak publicly, said the secondary share sale was part of a larger \$10 billion offering previously authorised by the company. The deal represents a substantial jump from OpenAI's earlier \$300 billion valuation, reflecting strong investor confidence in the company's rapid growth, surging revenue, and dominant posi-

tion in the AI space.

The new valuation places OpenAI among the top five most valuable private tech companies globally, rivaling the likes of SpaceX and ByteDance. The move also signals robust market interest in generative AI technologies, which have seen explosive adoption across industries from finance to healthcare.

Founded in 2015, OpenAI has seen a meteoric rise since the launch of ChatGPT in late 2022, with its tools becoming central to enterprise productivity, education, and software development. The company now licenses its technology to major firms, while continuing to develop advanced multimodal AI

Neither OpenAI nor the listed investors immediately responded to media queries regarding

the transaction. The massive valuation milestone comes amid growing discussions around the future of AI regulation, ethical deployment, and the broader impact of artificial intelligence on global labor markets and

## India anchor of stability in volatile world: RBI Governor

dia (RBI) Governor Sanjay Malhotra on Friday reaffirmed that India's macroeconomic fundamentals remain strong, positioning the country as a pillar of stability in an increasingly volatile global environment.

Speaking at the Kautilya Economic Conclave 2025 in New Delhi, Malhotra emphasized that India continues to demonstrate economic resilience, backed by low inflation, robust foreign exchange reserves, a manageable current account deficit, and healthy balance sheets across both the banking and cor-

porate sectors. "India has become an anchor of stability in a turbulent world," said Malhotra, highlighting the country's

consistent performance even as many global economies face headwinds from inflation, geopolitical tensions, and slowing growth.

He noted that inflation has remained within the targeted tolerance band, and foreign exchange reserves provide a strong buffer against external shocks. As of the latest figures. India's forex reserves remain comfortably above \$600 billion.

On the banking front, Malhotra said that Indian banks are now better capitalized, more profitable, and are maintaining low levels of non-performing assets (NPAs). He also praised the prudence of corporate India in managing leverage and adapting to shifting global

conditions. The RBI Governor's

remarks come amid global economic uncertainty driven by rising interest rates in advanced economies, supply chain disruptions, and geopolitical risks, including the prolonged conflict in Eastern Europe and energy market volatility.

Malhotra concluded that maintaining policy discipline, ensuring financial stability, and continuing structural reforms will be key to sustaining India's strong economic position.

#### **Rupee Slides 7 Paise to** 88.78 Against Dollar, Near **All-Time Low**

he Indian rupee weakened by 7 paise to close at 88.78 (provisional) against the U.S. dollar on Friday, approaching its alltime low, amid sustained demand for the greenback from importers and ongoing foreign fund outflows

Forex traders noted that the USD/INR pair continues to hover near record lows, pressured by heightened global uncertainties, including trade tensions and geopolitical risks.

"Persistent dollar demand, especially from oil importers, and the broader strength of the U.S. dollar index are weighing on the rupee." said a senior currency analyst. "Additionally, concerns over capital outflows and global risk aversion are putting pressure on emerging market currencies, including the INR."

At the interbank foreign exchange market, the domestic currency opened weak and moved within a narrow range during the session. It eventually settled at 88.78 per U.S. dollar, down from the previous close of 88.71.


The rupee's depreciation also reflects the pressure of foreign institutional investor (FII) outflows, as they continue to pull money from Indian equities amid expectations of prolonged high interest rates in advanced economies.

Market participants are closely watching the U.S. Federal Reserve's policy outlook, as hawkish commentary could further dampen sentiment and accelerate capital flight from emerging markets.

Despite India's strong macroeconomic fundamentals, including healthy forex reserves and robust GDP growth, the rupee remains vulnerable to external shocks, especially given rising crude oil prices and global monetary tightening.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is expected to continue monitoring the currency closely and intervene if necessary to curb excessive volatility, though it has so far maintained a hands-off approach to allow for orderly market-driven

adjustments. Market experts expect the rupee to remain under pressure in the near term unless there is a significant easing in global financial market stress or a reversal in foreign fund outflows.

## Boiled Egg Explodes Like a Bomb: Experts Warn Against Microwave Danger

shocked social media users by showing the dangerous outcome of a seemingly harmless kitchen habit—reheating a boiled egg in the microwave. In the clip, a woman takes out a microwaved boiled egg and attempts to slice it open with a knife. Within seconds, the egg explodes violently, releasing hot steam and scalding her face and eyes.

While it may sound like a rare accident, experts warn that this is a real and recurring danger. According to the American Academy of Ophthalmology, such explosions can ries, including corneal burns, which could poten-burns, which could burns, tially impact vision.

So why do eggs explode after microwaving? The science behind it is simple but alarming. When a boiled egg is reheated, particularly in a microwave, steam builds up inside the yolk. Since the outer shell or membrane holds the pressure in, slicing or poking the egg causes a sudden release of superheated steam, much like a mini pressure cooker blast.

This thermal reaction can be powerful enough to cause burns on the skin and damage to the eyes, as shown in the viral footage. Other videos similar incidents, proving this is not an isolated

Experts strongly advise people not to microwave boiled eggs, especially whole ones, whether shelled or unshelled. Instead, they recommend using safer reheating methods such as cutting the egg into pieces before warming or simply eating it cold.

This incident serves as a powerful reminder that even routine kitchen tasks can carry risks. As awareness grows, safety experts hope such warnings will prevent future injuries caused by every-



# Apple Halts Vision Pro Revamp to Focus on Al-Powered Smart Glasses

n a strategic shift, Apple has reportedly paused the development of a revamped Vision Pro headset to focus on AI-powered smart glasses, according to a Bloomberg News report citing sources familiar with the matter.

The tech giant was working on a lighter and more affordable version of the Vision Pro, codenamed N100, with a targeted release in 2027. However, the company has now decided to reallocate resources and staff from the Vision Pro project to accelerate the development of its upcoming smart glasses.

Apple is said to be working on at least two types of smart glasses. The first version, internally referred to as N50, will reportedly lack its own display and instead pair with an iPhone, functioning as an AI-assisted wearable. The company is aiming to unveil the device as early as next year, with a full release planned for 2027.

Unlike the Vision Pro. which focuses on immer-



sive mixed-reality experiences, Apple's glasses are expected to rely heavily on voice interactions and artificial intelligence, providing users with contextual information, navigation, and assistance through audio and minimal visual cues. This marks a move toward everyday wearable tech, rather than niche high-end headsets.

The decision comes amid growing competition in the smart glasses space, particularly from Meta Platforms, which recently launched the

latest version of its Ray-Ban Meta smart glasses powered by AI.

With AI becoming the next battleground in consumer tech, Apple's pivot highlights the company's ambition to lead in wearable AI devices. While Vision Pro continues to sell in limited quantities, Apple's longterm focus now appears to be on making AI glasses the next major product category—one that's lightweight, user-friendly, and deeply integrated with the Apple

#### Wikipedia May Open Its Knowledge Base to Al Models via New Embedding Project

n a significant development for artificial intelligence research, Wikimedia Deutschland has announced a new initiative that could grant AI models direct access to Wikipedia's structured knowledge base. Launched on October 1, the initiative is called the Wikidata Embedding Project and aims to enhance how AI systems understand and utilize factual information.

At the core of the project is a vector-based semantic search system. which enables machines to comprehend the meaning and relationships between words and concepts—a critical component for improving Large Language Models (LLMs). The system will allow AI tools to navigate and extract knowledge from over 120 million articles across Wikipedia and its sister sites.

Unlike open web crawls like Common Crawl, which gather massive but uncurated



data from across the internet, Wikipedia's content is community-edited and better structured, making it more reliable and factual for AI training. While some skepticism exists around Wikipedia's accuracy, experts agree it provides far higher data quality and consistency than most unfiltered online The potential inte-

gration of Wikipedia into AI models could improve the accuracy, transparency, and trustworthiness of machinegenerated content. It also opens the door for AI-powered tools to offer better search results, recommendations, summarizations, and even fact-checking capabilities.

However, Wikimedia has not yet confirmed whether this access will be extended to commercial AI developers, or if it will be limited to open-source and research-based use cases.

As AI models become increasingly central to

## **Instagram Testing Reels as Default Tab in Major App Update**

game-changing move, Meta is testing a new feature that would make Reels the default tab when users open Instagram. The announcement was made by Instagram head Adam Mosseri in a recent post on Threads, confirming that the test is currently limited and opt-in, with India among the first markets to experience it.

This test marks one of the biggest potential updates to the platform's user interface in recent years. Traditionally, Instagram opens to the Home feed, showing posts from followed accounts. But with the massive popularity of short-form video, Meta appears to be shifting its focus to Reels to boost engagement.

Reels, Instagram's answer to TikTok, has played a major role in the platform's growth. Instagram recently surpassed three billion



monthly active users, with executives crediting Reels and DMs as the key drivers of that milestone. Earlier this year, Instagram also extended Reels' maximum length to three minutes, giving creators more flexibility.

While the test is still in its early stages, reactions have been mixed. Some users welcome the change, especially those

who primarily use Instagram for video content. Others, however, worry that it might reduce the visibility of photo posts and updates from friends and family.

Meta has not confirmed whether this change will roll out globally or remain a regional experiment. However, such tests usually hint at broader strategic shifts. If successful, the Reelsdefault experience could become the new normal on Instagram.

#### Mirabai Chanu Wins Silver at World **Weightlifting Championships 2025**

star Mirabai Chanu added another silver to her illustrious career, finishing second in the 48kg category at the World Weightlifting Championships 2025 held in Forde, Norway.

Chanu, a former world champion (2017) and Tokyo Olympic silver medallist, lifted a combined 199kg — 84kg in snatch and 115kg in clean and jerk — to secure the silver medal. This marks her third podium finish at the the Tokyo Olympics World Championships, after gold in 2017 and silver in 2022.

Returning to the 48kg

weight class after competing in the 49kg division for years, Chanu appeared slightly rusty in the snatch segment, failing twice at 87kg and managing only 84kg. However, she staged a strong comeback in the clean and jerk, successfully lifting 109kg, 112kg, and finally 115kg, equaling her personal best from

The gold medal went to North Korea's Ri Song Gum, who delivered a record-breaking total of 213kg (91kg in snatch and 122kg in clean and jerk). She set two new world records with her final lifts in clean and jerk and Thailand's Thanya-

thon Sukcharoen claimed the bronze with a 198kg total (88kg

India's chief coach

Vijay Sharma had earlier stated that the aim at this championship was to cross the 200kg mark and prepare Chanu to return to her top form in the lighter weight category.

While Chanu narrowly missed that target, her silver medal performance signals strong progress ahead of the Paris 2024 Olympic cycle, reinforcing her status as one of India's most consistent weightlifting champions.

#### Djokovic Unfazed by Losses to Alcaraz, **Sinner Ahead of Shanghai Masters**

campaign at the Shanghai Masters 2025, tennis legend Novak Djokovic has made it clear that he's not discouraged by his recent string of high-profile losses to Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner, the top two players in the world.

The 24-time Grand Slam champion, now 38, has faced a two-year Grand Slam title drought, with Alcaraz and Sinner increasingly getting the better of him

on the biggest stages. Djokovic lost to Alcaraz in back-to-back Wimbledon finals in 2023 and 2024, and most recently at the US Open 2025 semi-final. Meanwhile, Sinner has beaten Djokovic in their last five encounters, including at Roland Garros and Wimbledon 2025 semi-finals.

Despite these setbacks, Djokovic remains focused. "I'm not discouraged. I'm still working as hard as I possibly can to challenge these guys—or ly," Djokovic said, as quoted by the ATP. He emphasized his preference for best-of-threeset tournaments, saying they provide a better opportunity for strong performances at this stage in his career.

Djokovic opens his Shanghai campaign against Marin Cilic, with a potential semifinal clash against world No. 2 Sinner looming. Although he trails the Italian 4-6 in head-to-head, Djokovic

umphed over both Sinner and Alcaraz, including wins at the 2023 ATP Finals and the Paris Olympics.

Alcaraz, now world No. 1, has won four Grand Slam titles since Djokovic's last major win at the 2023 US Open, marking a shift in men's tennis dominance.

Still, Djokovic remains committed to competing at the highest level, saying, "I want to see how far I can go. I still believe I can win.


