

A P on High Alert for Cyclone Ditwah

Vijayawada : The Andhra Pradesh government has gone on high alert following warnings of severe weather conditions due to Cyclone Ditwah, which is expected to bring heavy rains and strong winds across several southern districts over the next two days. Home Minister Vangalapudi Anitha has directed all district administrations in vulnerable zones to remain on constant vigil to ensure public safety and minimize damage.

According to official instructions, the districts of Tirupati, Chittoor, Kadapa, Nellore, and Prakasam are likely to face the most significant impact from the cyclone. Anitha held a review meeting with senior officials and emphasized the need for immediate preventive measures at the ground level. She instructed all Collectors and Superintendents of Police to remain accessible to the public 24 hours a day and to supervise prepared-



ness activities closely. The Home Minister stressed that local authorities must prioritize the safety of residents living in low-lying and dilapidated areas. She ordered the identification and relocation of vulnerable families to designated cyclone shelters and directed the immediate removal of unsafe hoardings and electrical structures that could pose risks during strong winds. To strengthen emergency response, State Disaster Response

Force (SDRF) and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) teams have been put on standby across the affected districts. The government has also established control rooms at both district and mandal levels to coordinate information flow, monitor developments, and respond swiftly to distress calls. These control rooms will function round the clock until the cyclone threat subsides. Officials have been asked to ensure the

availability of essential supplies, including food, water, and medical aid, in coastal and rural areas that may face accessibility issues. The Home Minister also urged farmers to exercise caution in their agricultural activities, particularly regarding crop management and livestock safety during the anticipated heavy rainfall. Public advisories have been issued through local media and communication networks, urging communi-

ties to remain indoors during high winds and avoid venturing near water bodies. The government has cautioned that the weather conditions are likely to persist until Monday, and citizens have been requested to cooperate fully with authorities. As the cyclone approaches the state's southern coast, administrative machinery across districts has been fully mobilized to mitigate risks and ensure timely emergency response.

AP to Establish Unified Commercial Hubs for Handloom, Handicrafts, and GCC Products

Vijayawada | The Andhra Pradesh government is set to launch unified commercial hubs integrating handloom, handicraft, and tribal products under one roof, Handlooms and Textiles Minister S. Savitha announced on Friday. These centers will house merchandise from APCO (Andhra Pradesh State Handloom Weavers Cooperative Society), Lepakshi Handicrafts, and the Girijan Cooperative Corporation (GCC), including Araku Coffee and other tribal goods.

Addressing a departmental review meeting in Vijayawada, the Minister said Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu had directed officials to work toward creating sustainable economic avenues for weavers, artisans, and tribal communities through integrated sales platforms. As part of the first phase, five major commercial hubs are planned across India, with key

locations in Andhra Pradesh to include Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam, and Tirupati. Savitha stated that detailed project planning has commenced, and officials have been instructed to draft comprehensive proposals for the initiative. She emphasized that the hubs would not only boost sales and visibility for traditional products but also serve as cultural ambassadors showcasing the craftsmanship of Andhra Pradesh to larger markets. Highlighting upcoming promotional events, the Minister announced that a 22-day Handloom and Handicrafts Exhibition will be organized in Tirupati from December 20 to January 10, coinciding with the Mukkoti Ekadasi festival. The exhibition, expected to draw large crowds of pilgrims and visitors, aims to enhance market reach for local artisans. Similar expos held earlier in Vijayawada, Guntur, and Rajahmundry had garnered strong public re-

sponse, prompting officials to intensify preparations for the Tirupati edition. In another key announcement, Savitha revealed that "Lepakshi Week" will be celebrated nationwide from December 8 to 14 to promote Andhra Pradesh's traditional arts and crafts. A special Lepakshi Utsav will take place in Kadapa on December 11, where the Minister will participate in cultural and promotional activities. She directed department officials to ensure the events are celebrated on a grand scale across all districts, reflecting the state's rich heritage and artistic legacy. The review meeting was attended by Handlooms and Textiles Advisor Suchitra Ella, Special Chief Secretary R.P. Sisodia, Commissioner Rekha Rani, Lepakshi Managing Director Vishwanath, and other senior officials, who discussed the progress of ongoing handloom sector initiatives and strategies to strengthen marketing networks.

Nidadavole Municipality Upgraded to "Special Grade"; Government Issues Landmark Order

Vijayawada | In a major administrative milestone for the West Godavari region, the Andhra Pradesh Government has officially upgraded Nidadavole Municipality from Grade-2 to "Special Grade," recognizing its rapid progress in development, population growth, and revenue enhancement. The Municipal Administration and Urban Development (MA&UD) Department issued Government Order (GO) Ms No. 242 on Friday, confirming that the elevated status takes immediate effect.

According to the GO, the decision followed a comprehensive evaluation of key performance indicators over the past three financial years. Municipal Administration Principal Secretary S. Suresh Kumar stated that Nidadavole met and exceeded the parameters for upgradation, including sustained improvement in income levels, civic infrastructure enhancement, and overall urban service delivery. The special grade classification will enable the municipality to access higher administrative powers, increased funding, and expanded jurisdiction for civic planning.

Milestone Tied to Diamond Jubilee The timing of the announcement carries special significance, coinciding with the Diamond Jubilee celebrations

marking the 60th anniversary of Nidadavole Municipality's establishment. The week-long celebrations saw enthusiastic participation from residents, civic leaders, and government representatives. Major Boost for Sports Infrastructure in Tirupati

State Government Approves 28 Acres for National-Level Sports Hub at Daminedu

TIRUPATI: In a significant move aimed at strengthening sports infrastructure and nurturing athletic talent, the Andhra Pradesh government has approved the allocation of 28 acres of land at Daminedu near Tirupati for establishing a world-class Sports Hub. The decision, cleared during the State Cabinet meeting on Friday, marks a major milestone in the government's vision to transform Andhra Pradesh into a sporting powerhouse. Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh (SAAP) Chairman A Ravi Naidu welcomed the Cabinet's approval and extended gratitude to Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu for taking swift action on the long-pending proposal. He recalled submitting a detailed representation to the Chief Minister earlier this year, pressing the need for a national-level sports facility in

Tirupati. He further mentioned that Ministers Nara Lokesh, Anagani Satyaprasad, and Mandipalli Ramprasad Reddy, along with district officials, were also apprised of the plan and extended their support for the project's realisation. Ravi Naidu described the decision as a turning point in the state's larger vision of building "Kreedandhra Pradesh," a long-term initiative to promote sports culture, identify young talent, and create state-of-the-art facilities for training and competition. He said the proposed Sports Village at Daminedu would not only cater to multiple sporting disciplines but also include modern training facilities, residential accommodation for athletes, and infrastructure for hosting national and international tournaments. "With this project, Tirupati is on its way to becoming a leading sports centre in

South India," Ravi Naidu said. "The Sports Hub will provide athletes access to world-class coaching and facilities, improve sports science and fitness training, and contribute to the region's economic and social growth through sports promotion." Officials indicated that the Sports Hub would be designed to meet national standards, promoting both mainstream and emerging sports. The project is also expected to attract private investments and partnerships aimed at developing the broader sports ecosystem in the state. Tirupati, already known for its prominence in education, healthcare, and religious tourism, is now poised to add sports excellence to its growing profile. The government's proactive approach and commitment to sports development are expected to create lasting opportunities for youth across Andhra Pradesh.

Visakhapatnam: The East Coast Railway (ECOR) has announced the temporary cancellation of several train services operating between Visakhapatnam and Vijayawada due to ongoing track modernisation and maintenance works. The cancellations will be in effect between January 27 and January 31, 2026. According to a press release issued on Friday, the modernization works are being carried out within the South Central Railway (SCR) zone, particularly on the busy Visakhapatnam-Vijayawada route. The railway authority stated that these maintenance activities are essential for the improvement of track safety, signalling systems, and passenger comfort. The East Coast Railway has appealed to passengers to take note of these cancellations and plan their journeys accordingly to avoid inconvenience. The affected trains include popular intercity and passen-

ger services, impacting travel across several key stations in Andhra Pradesh. Some of the major trains cancelled during this period include services between Vijayawada-Visakhapatnam, Guntur-Visakhapatnam, Lingampalli-Visakhapatnam, Rajahmundry-Visakhapatnam, Tirupati-Puri, Tirupati-Visakhapatnam, Machilipatnam-Visakhapatnam, and Guntur-Visakhapatnam. Both up and down services for these trains will remain suspended for the five-day period. Railway officials clarified that the cancellations are necessary to facilitate advanced infrastructural upgrades such as the replacement of old tracks, realignment of curves, and the installation of new automatic signalling systems. These improvements aim to reduce travel time and enhance the safety of both passengers and freight movement in the long run. Passengers who had already booked tickets for the affected dates

will be eligible for a full refund as per Indian Railways' guidelines. The authorities have also urged travellers to check the latest updates on the National Train Enquiry System (NTES) or the official Indian Railways website before commencing their journey. Senior railway officials further advised passengers to use alternative routes and train services operating from nearby stations wherever possible. The ECOR reiterated that these short-term disruptions are part of a broader plan to modernise railway infrastructure across the coastal corridor, which is expected to benefit millions of commuters in the future. The Visakhapatnam-Vijayawada route serves as one of the busiest railway corridors in Andhra Pradesh, linking industrial hubs, tourist destinations, and major cities. The temporary suspension is anticipated to streamline operations and enhance the overall efficiency of train movements once the modernization is completed.

Supreme Court Rejects Pleas by Former MLA Pinnelli's Brothers in Palnadu Double Murder Case

New Delhi | Vijayawada: In a significant legal setback for the family of former YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) MLA from Macherla, Pinnelli Ramakrishna Reddy, the Supreme Court on Friday dismissed two petitions filed by his brothers in connection with the Palnadu double murder case. The apex court not only struck down their appeals but also cancelled the interim bail orders that had earlier been granted.

The division bench, comprising Justice Vikram Nath and Justice Sandeep Mehta, made it clear that the accused were not entitled



to anticipatory bail considering the gravity of the charges and their conduct during the investigation. Justice Sandeep Mehta observed that the brothers had failed to cooperate

with the probe despite earlier directions from the Supreme Court and that the materials on record suggested they had attempted to intimidate witnesses and tamper with evidence.

Representing the Andhra Pradesh government, state advocates argued that the accused had consistently evaded interrogation and obstructed the investigation process.

They informed the court that, although the investigating team made repeated efforts to question them, the brothers had not cooperated and had even influenced key witnesses.

After hearing the arguments, the apex court bench remarked that there was no legal barrier for the investigating authorities to proceed with the arrests of the accused immediately. It stressed that the law must take its own course, especially when custodial interrogation is found necessary in serious criminal cases such as murder. The defense counsel appearing on behalf of the accused sought two weeks' time

for their voluntary surrender.

However, Justice Mehta questioned the rationale of allowing additional time for surrender in a case where anticipatory bail had already been rejected. "How can time be granted when the court has already held that they are not eligible for pre-arrest bail?" Justice Mehta asked pointedly.

The court also expressed concern over alleged procedural irregularities during the investigation, particularly the way certain documents recorded under Section 161 of the Criminal Procedure Code, which contain witness statements, had

reached the hands of the accused. The judges sought an explanation from the state government on how such confidential materials had become accessible to the suspects.

Emphasizing the need for transparency and accountability, the Supreme Court observed that the ongoing investigation required the custodial presence of the accused to uncover the full extent of their involvement. The bench stated that granting them protection at this stage would seriously compromise the probe.

The Palnadu double murder case, which has drawn state-wide atten-

tion, involves the killing of two individuals allegedly linked to a political rivalry in Machherla constituency. The incident had sparked public outrage and led to high political tension in the region. With the Supreme Court's latest ruling, the probe is expected to intensify.

Law enforcement agencies are now free to arrest the accused and proceed with custodial interrogation. Legal experts describe this verdict as a strong message from the judiciary that serious criminal accusations cannot be shielded under the guise of political influence or procedural delay.

Former Minister Jogi Ramesh, Brother Taken into Third Day Custody in Fake Liquor Case

Vijayawada: In a key development in the ongoing investigation into the fake liquor racket, excise officials on Friday took former Andhra Pradesh minister Jogi Ramesh and his brother Ramu into their third consecutive day of custody for further interrogation. The duo underwent mandatory medical examinations before being escorted to the Excise Department office located in Guru Nanak Colony, Vijayawada, where questioning is expected to continue throughout the day.

According to sources within the department, investigators are focusing on verifying the alleged involvement of the Jogi brothers in supporting the primary accused, identified as Janardhan Rao and Jagannathan Rao. Both brothers were previously arrested earlier this week after officials reportedly gathered preliminary evidence linking them to the case.

Authorities suspect that the Jogi brothers provided backing and logistical assistance that facilitated the distribution of counterfeit liquor under the guise



of legitimate brands. The excise enforcement wing has been pursuing leads suggesting that the fake liquor racket had a wider operational network spanning multiple districts.

The illicit trade reportedly involved the production and sale of spurious liquor that evaded taxes, causing significant revenue losses to the state exchequer and posing potential health hazards to consumers. During the investigation, officials seized substantial quantities of adulterated liquor and related materials allegedly sourced through illegal supply channels.

Excise officers stated that the continued custodial interrogation of the Jogi brothers is crucial for establishing the extent of their involvement and tracing the financial transactions

that may have supported the operation. Forensic experts are also analyzing the seized liquor samples to determine their composition and degree of contamination.

Currently, Jogi Ramesh and his brother remain on judicial remand at the Vijayawada district jail, where they have been lodged since their arrest. Security around the excise office has been heightened due to the sensitivity of the case and the political significance attached to Jogi Ramesh, a former minister with a sizeable following in his constituency.

Further details from the interrogation are expected to shed more light on the network behind the fake liquor syndicate and identify additional individuals connected to the illegal operations.

CID Completes Inquiry of YV Subba Reddy in TTD Parakamani Theft Case

Vijayawada : The Andhra Pradesh Crime Investigation Department (CID) on Friday concluded its inquiry of Rajya Sabha MP and former TTD chairman YV Subba Reddy in connection with the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) 'Parakamani theft' case. The questioning took place at the CID office in Vijayawada and reportedly lasted for about one and a half hours.

After the interrogation, YV Subba Reddy addressed the media, stating that CID officials questioned him primarily about the alleged theft that had taken place in the Parakamani section where devotees' offerings are counted and recorded.

He said he had answered all questions asked by the investigators and assured complete cooperation with the authorities during the ongoing probe. "They asked whether the theft had happened during my tenure. I categorically clarified that the issue surfaced only after my tenure as chairman had ended," Subba Reddy told reporters.

He also urged that the inquiry should not be viewed through a political lens, asserting that he had no involvement in any wrongdoing. The case traces back to an incident in which TTD employee CV Ravikumar, who worked in

the Parakamani division, was accused of misappropriating large quantities of US dollars and gold from the temple's offerings. The complaint was initially filed on April 29, 2023, by then Assistant Vigilance and Security Officer (AVSO) Satish Kumar at the Tirumala I Town Police Station.

Investigators filed a chargesheet in the case on May 30, 2023. However, the matter took a surprising turn when, barely three and a half months later, on September 9, Ravikumar reportedly reached a compromise through the Lok Adalat. As part of the settlement, Ravikumar agreed to transfer seven of his personal properties to the TTD as a goodwill gesture.

The TTD governing board, headed by chairman YV Subba Reddy and then Executive Officer Dharma Reddy, accepted the properties as gifts from the accused. In light of these developments, the CID began examining whether there were any undisclosed agreements or procedural lapses behind this settlement.

Friday's questioning of Subba Reddy appears to be part of a broader effort by investigators to clarify the circumstances that led to the compromise and the manner in which the temple administration handled the issue.

Amaravati: Symbol of Farmers' Sacrifice and People's Dream, Says Minister Nara Lokesh

Amaravati: Andhra Pradesh Minister Nara Lokesh described Amaravati as a "capital blessed by the gods and built on the sacrifice of farmers," speaking at a major event marking the renewed development momentum in the region. Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman laid the foundation stone for the construction of several bank offices in Amaravati on Friday, signalling the central government's active support for reviving the state's capital city project.

Addressing the gathering after the ceremony, Lokesh recalled the difficult years that farmers and locals endured during the agitation for Amaravati's protection. "The previous YSR Congress government tried to destroy Amaravati. They spoke of three capitals but did not lay even a single brick anywhere."

Yet, today, Amaravati stands firm because of the spirit of its farmers and citizens," he said. Lokesh criticized the previous government for what he called "extravagant and misplaced priorities." "Over 700 crore rupees were spent just to build a palace-like residence in Visakhapatnam for one individual, while no steps were taken to move capital-related works forward," he alleged.

He reminded the audience that during the height of the Amaravati movement, around 3,000 farmers faced criminal cases and 270 lost their lives. "Despite all odds, we marched forward with the slogan 'Jai Amaravati,'" he said. Highlighting the voluntary land pooling by thousands of farmers for the capital project, Lokesh emphasized that the coalition government is now working with urgency to restore progress in Amaravati. "This city is not just a capital; it is a monument to farmers' faith and resolve," he added.

Lokesh also lauded Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, calling her "a true symbol of women's empowerment." He praised her outstanding contribution to national economic policy, noting that she is the first woman to have presented eight consecutive Union Budgets. "Her composure and clarity when answering opposition benches in Parliament are remarkable."

Her life and career are an inspiration and a lesson for all of us," he said. The event marked a renewed phase in Amaravati's development, signaling both state and central governments' resolve to transform the city into a vibrant administrative and financial hub.

Government Suspends Five Engineering Officials in Pithapuram Municipality Over Misuse of Funds

Kakinada District, Andhra Pradesh: In a significant administrative action, the state government has suspended five engineering officials linked to large-scale irregularities in municipal works sanctioned during the previous government's tenure. The suspended officers include three former Assistant Engineers (AEs) and two Deputy Executive Engineers (DEEs) who earlier served in the Pithapuram Municipality under the Public Health Engineering Department.

According to official sources, the vigilance and enforcement wing conducted a detailed probe into the implementation of 55 public works sanctioned under the previous regime at an estimated cost of 7.73 crore. The investigation revealed serious lapses in execution, including poor quality of construction, incom-

plete works, and payment of bills to contractors despite the absence of physical progress on certain projects. The inquiry also determined that the officials in question had failed to adhere to prescribed procedures for work inspections and financial documentation.

In some cases, records were reportedly fabricated to justify expenditure, leading to misuse of public funds. Following the findings, the government issued orders placing the officials under suspension pending disciplinary action. A senior official from the Municipal Administration Department informed that the decision reflects the government's renewed focus on accountability, transparency, and zero tolerance toward corruption in civic bodies.

The suspended engineers are accused of conspiring with contractors for wrongful financial gain and neglecting their



supervisory responsibilities, which resulted in loss to the public exchequer and compromised civic infrastructure standards. Sources indicate that apart from departmental proceedings, the vigilance authorities have recommended further legal examination to recover misused funds and to fix individual liabilities.

The government is also said to be reviewing

all projects sanctioned during the same period in other urban local bodies across the district to identify potential irregularities. Public response in Pithapuram has been largely supportive of the move, with residents demanding stricter monitoring of municipal works and stronger punishment for officials involved in corruption.

Administrative ob-

servers noted that the case serves as a warning to municipal employees statewide that accountability lapses and financial misconduct will face swift action. This development marks another step in the government's ongoing efforts to strengthen oversight of public works and ensure proper utilization of funds intended for local development.

Ysr leaders criticise the CM

Amaravathi: The YSR Congress Party leaders Donthireddy Vemareddy and Balavajrababu (Diamond Babu) have strongly criticized Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu and his coalition government for the severe distress faced by nearly 30,000 small and marginal farmers of the Amaravati capital region.

These farmers, who surrendered 32,000 acres of land on the assurance of developed returnable plots, infrastructure, and livelihood support nearly a decade ago, have seen no fulfillment of these promises. They continue to face issues such as lack of returnable plots, no valid land documents, inaccessibility to bank loans, and unresolved disputes, leaving them with poor livelihoods and no financial security. Vemareddy pointed out that despite the government borrowing 2.50 lakh crore in 18 months, no visible development has oc-

curred in Amaravati or any other parts of the state.

He demanded a detailed white paper from Chandrababu Naidu on the utilization of such massive borrowings. The farmers who gave up their lands now struggle to fund their children's education, receive bank loans, or recover their livelihoods, while the government allegedly hides behind media narratives. Diamond Babu accused Chandrababu Naidu of deceiving farmers twice initially in 2015 and now by proposing another 40,000-acre land pooling despite the failure to develop even an inch of the land already acquired.

He claimed Naidu avoids meeting farmers, prioritizes promoting his son as his political heir, and neglects essential development work like roads and drains in Amaravati. Farmers and contractors remain unpaid, and the capital city is being perceived more as a business ven-

ture than a public project. The promised involvement of farmers' Joint Action Committee (JAC) in decision-making has been sidelined.

Both leaders warned that if Chandrababu Naidu continues with fresh land pooling without addressing previous commitments, YSRCP will mobilize a massive people's movement. They conveyed that farmers are now aware of the government's betrayal and are preparing to protest, with media propaganda no longer able to shield the government's failures.

This political contention highlights the deep grievances among Amaravati farmers over unmet promises and stalled development in the capital region under Chandrababu Naidu's government. The farmers' plight involves severe financial distress and broken trust, adding pressure on the state government to respond transparently and responsibly to their demands.



New Bridge Between Barrankula and Ganapeswaram Inaugurated at a Cost of .80 Lakh

Nagayalanka, Krishna District: A long-awaited bridge connecting Barrankula and Ganapeswar am villages in the Nagayalanka Mandal of Krishna district was inaugurated on Friday, marking a significant milestone in improving rural connectivity in the region. The bridge, constructed across the Mangaleru medium drainage channel, was built at a cost of 80 lakh through the MP-LADS (Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme) funds.

Police Commissioner Rajasekhara Babu Urges Public to Stay Alert Against Digital Arrest and Online Frauds

Vijayawada: As part of the ongoing Cyber Suraksha initiative, NTR District Police Commissioner SV Rajasekhara Babu, conducted a special awareness session for members of the Bar Association on Thursday, focusing on digital arrest scams and emerging cybercrime threats.

Speaking at the program, the Commissioner stressed that the so-

called "digital arrest" is a non-existent concept in Indian law, and urged citizens to stay vigilant. He clarified that agencies such as the CBI, Police, Customs or ED never conduct arrests through video calls, adding that cybercriminals are increasingly using threats and impersonation tactics to extort money. He advised the public not to panic if they receive threatening video calls claiming that they or their family members are being arrested. Victims should immediately contact the nearest police station or the national cybercrime helpline 1930, especially

within the first 24 hours of losing money, to increase the chances of recovery. He also urged people to alert family members and neighbours about these scams. Commissioner Rajasekhara Babu highlighted several innovative initiatives introduced under the Commissionerate, including the installation of nearly 10,000 CCTV cameras, which have played a crucial role in solving major cases. He also noted that advanced technologies like Astra are improving traffic management.

The Commissioner warned citizens against falling for investment

scams circulating on Facebook, Telegram, WhatsApp, Instagram and other social media platforms. He advised the public not to invest in any scheme without a verified Demat account and to be wary of unrealistic returns.

The awareness program was attended by Cyber Crime DCP Krishna Prasanna, ACP Rajasekhara, Inspectors Gunaram and Durgaprasad, as well as Bejawada Bar Association President & AP State Bar Federation President AK Basha, General Secretary KV Rangarao, Council Member Chalasani Ajay Kumar and nearly 300 lawyers.

MP Balarashouri Announces Rs. 6,000-Crore Drinking Water Project for Krishna District

TPN Bureau | November 28, Nagayalanka: A major drinking water project worth Rs. 6,000 crore is being planned to meet the needs of the combined Krishna district, announced Machilipatnam MP Vallabhaneni Balashouri. The MP made the announcement while participating as chief guest at a free medical camp organised by the Bondada Foundation on Friday in Parracheevuru village of Nagayalanka mandal, marking the birthday celebrations of Bondada Group Chairman Bondada Ra-

Minister’s Son and PA Accused of Harassment; Victim Lodges Complaint with SP

Parvathipuram: In a shocking development, a woman from Andhra Pradesh has lodged a formal complaint against the son and personal assistant (PA) of a state minister; alleging mental harassment, threats, and attempts to exploit her under the guise of personal favors. The complaint, submitted to the Superintendent of Police (SP) with the support of local women’s associations, has sparked outrage and demands for an impartial probe.

According to the victim’s statement, the minister’s PA, identified as Satish, repeatedly threatened her to comply with personal demands from the minister’s family. She alleged that Satish called her frequently and insisted that she “come for an hour,” suggesting improper intentions.

When she resisted, the victim claims, the PA used the minister’s name to pressure and intimidate her. The woman further accused the minister’s son, identified as Prudhvi, of communicating with her through messages, allegedly asking her to visit his friends and threatening consequences if she refused. She claimed that when she tried to bring the matter to the attention of the minister herself, she was insulted and humiliated in front of a group of nearly thirty people.

“The minister supported her PA instead

of protecting me. She used abusive language and accused me of lying in public,” the complainant said in her statement. Outraged by the alleged misuse of political power and influence, the woman approached women’s rights groups seeking justice. Together, they filed a detailed complaint with the district police, urging for a criminal case against both PA Satish and Prudhvi. The women’s organizations accompanying the victim have demanded that the government immediately suspend the accused officials and ensure a transparent investigation.

“This case represents how power is being used to silence victims and how women continue to face intimidation even from those in public office,” a representative of the women’s group said. Police sources confirmed that they have received the complaint and begun a preliminary inquiry. Statements from all concerned parties, including the victim, are being recorded.

Officials stated that further action will be taken based on evidence and legal scrutiny. The case has generated widespread media attention, with several social groups calling for accountability at the ministerial level. Women’s associations have announced plans to organize demonstrations if the matter is not handled impartially and swiftly.

RSS Leaders Emphasize Building an Ideal and Strong Hindu Society

Husband Sends Death Certificate to Wife Who Left Home in Kadapa District

Kadapa: A bizarre and disturbing incident has come to light from Muddanoor mandal in YSR Kadapa district, where a husband allegedly made and sent a fake death certificate in his wife’s name after she left their home following domestic disputes. The unusual episode has shocked local residents and prompted a police investigation into the matter.

According to reports, the couple, identified as Maruthi Raju and Adilakshmi, have been married for several years and have three children. However, disagreements and frequent quarrels had strained their relationship in recent months. About a month ago, Adilakshmi reportedly left her marital home without informing her husband and went to stay with her parents in another village. Since then, she had been living there with her children, refusing to return to her husband due to ongoing marital discord. Angered by her prolonged absence and unwillingness to return, Maruthi Raju allegedly took an extreme and malicious step. He is said to have fabricated a death certificate in his wife’s name and mailed it directly to her parental home, intending either to intimidate her or express anger over her decision to leave. The envelope reportedly contained

an official-looking certificate declaring “Adilakshmi” as deceased. Shocked and distressed to receive a document declaring her own death while she was alive, Adilakshmi immediately approached the police for help. Officers at the Muddanoor police station registered a complaint and launched an inquiry into the source and authenticity of the document.

During investigation, it was discovered that the certificate was illicitly prepared using her late mother’s death certificate, which had been altered and reprinted with Adilakshmi’s name and other forged details. Police questioned Maruthi Raju, who confessed to the act during interrogation. He admitted to tampering with the original document and sending it to his wife out of anger. Authorities have seized the forged certificate and initiated legal proceedings against him under relevant sections for document forgery and harassment.

The incident has sparked widespread discussion in the locality, with many expressing concern over how personal disputes are escalating into such shocking acts. Police have advised couples facing marital conflict to seek mediation or counseling rather than resorting to illegal and harmful actions that can have serious legal consequences.

Why Imran Khan the Pathan spooks Punjabi General Asim Munir

Former Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan's continued influence and Pashtun roots have emerged as a source of unease for Pakistan Army Chief General Asim Munir, despite Munir's control over the military and state institutions. Analysts suggest that Munir's fear is not merely political but deeply tied to ethnic and regional dynamics in Pakistan.

The rift between Khan and Munir is widely considered personal. Khan had removed Munir from the position of ISI chief in 2019, citing corruption probes involving Khan's wife, Bushra Bibi. Since then, the former cricket star-turned-politician has remained a persistent thorn in Munir's side. Khan's charisma and moral authority, coupled with his victimhood and resistance, continue to challenge Munir's legitimacy as Pakistan's de facto ruler. Pashtun resentment against the Punjabi-dominated establishment amplifies this tension. Pathans, historically sidelined in Pakistan's power hierarchy dominated by Punjabis, have long-

standing grievances over underdevelopment in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) and perceived ethnic bias. These feelings have been intensified by recent tensions involving Afghan refugees, airstrikes in eastern Afghanistan, and aggressive deportation policies, fueling anti-establishment sentiment among Pashtuns.

Khan, jailed since August 2023 on graft charges, embodies Pashtun defiance and commands a substantial support base in KP, the only province where his party, PTI, retains political power. Thousands of his supporters have gathered outside Adiala Jail in Rawalpindi demanding access to him, creating further pressure on Munir's administration.

Reports of Khan's possible death, though unverified, have sparked fears of widespread unrest across Pashtun regions. Munir's response has been a severe state crackdown, restricting access to Khan and closely controlling information about his condition. Analysts ar-

gue that Munir's moves are aimed at preventing mass mobilization and ethnic unrest, particularly from KP and Pashtun-dominated areas. The army chief's recent consolidation of power, including lifetime immunity and expanded authority over the military and judiciary under the 27th Constitutional Amendment, highlights his attempt to secure his position amid growing challenges.

Observers suggest that Khan's continued popularity and Pashtun identity pose a unique threat to Munir, as releasing or mistreating Khan could trigger mass protests or even ethnic backlash. Khan's political survival and symbolic stature have thus become a crucial factor in Pakistan's fragile power dynamics, turning a personal rivalry into a broader ethnic and national security concern.

Imran Khan, for Munir, represents not just a political opponent but a mobilizing force for marginalized Pashtuns, making him a singular challenge to the Punjabi-led establishment's authority.

Karnataka Congress Tussle Hinges on Rahul Gandhi



The ongoing power tussle in Karnataka Congress between Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar has intensified, with all major developments pointing toward Congress leader Rahul Gandhi as the ultimate decision-maker. The high-stakes battle is testing the party's ability to balance ambitions, caste equations, and political stability in the southern state.

DK Shivakumar, who belongs to the influential OBC Vokkaliga community, is pushing for a clear transition plan to eventually succeed Siddaramaiah. His demands include a formal timeline for transfer of power, a firm directive from the high command to Siddaramaiah regarding stepping down, and support from party factions to ensure a smooth handover. Shivakumar's camp argues that this transition is a long-promised

arrangement, necessary to maintain party stability and discipline.

Siddaramaiah, a veteran leader and representative of the 'AHINDA' coalition of minorities, OBCs, and Dalits, is determined to maintain his authority until at least after the state budget session. He has resisted calls for immediate change, citing potential disruptions, and has sought to end speculation around his exit through strategic moves, including a cabinet reshuffle to reinforce his command. Siddaramaiah also emphasizes the need for public backing from Rahul Gandhi, which would solidify his position and signal stability to his supporters.

Meanwhile, other regional leaders add complexity to the scenario.

Senior Dalit leader and Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge is closely observing developments and could serve as a compromise candidate. Satish Jarkiholi, a known critic of Shivakumar, has ambitions to become state Congress president, while G Parameshwara has publicly expressed interest in the chief ministership. These multiple power centers make internal consensus a challenging task for the high command.

The Congress leadership faces a delicate balancing act. Any abrupt shift risks alienating key caste blocs—the OBC Vokkaliga support base crucial to Shivakumar and Siddaramaiah's AHINDA coalition of minorities and backward classes. The party must navigate factional loyal-

ties, electoral considerations, and public perception, all while ensuring stability in a state where political equations can shift rapidly.

As Karnataka Congress grapples with competing ambitions and strategic maneuvers, Rahul Gandhi's role as mediator and arbiter becomes decisive. His intervention will likely determine the future leadership structure, manage internal friction, and maintain the coalition that delivered the party a strong mandate. With multiple stakeholders, intricate caste dynamics, and high political stakes, the ultimate resolution hinges on the Congress high command's ability to reconcile ambitions without destabilizing the party.

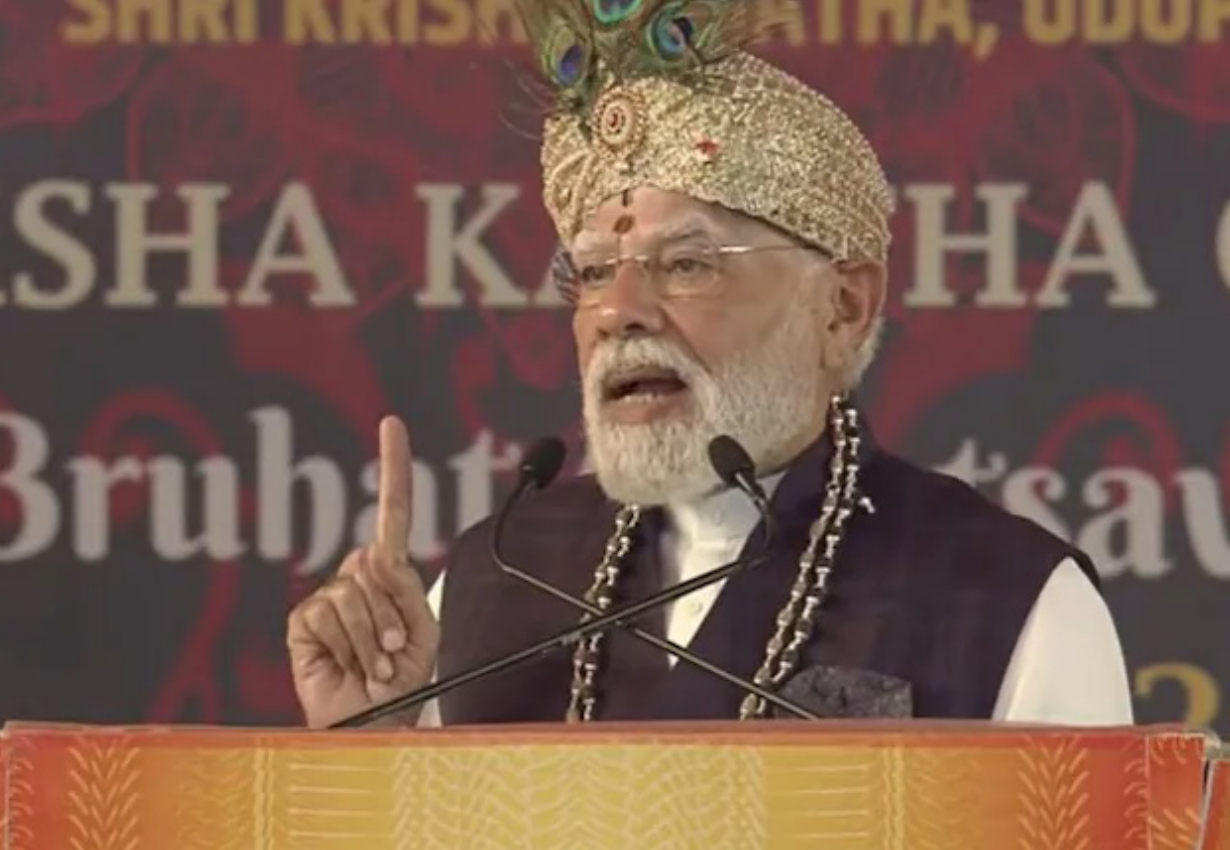


“New India Neither Bows Nor Hesitates From Protecting Its People”: PM Modi

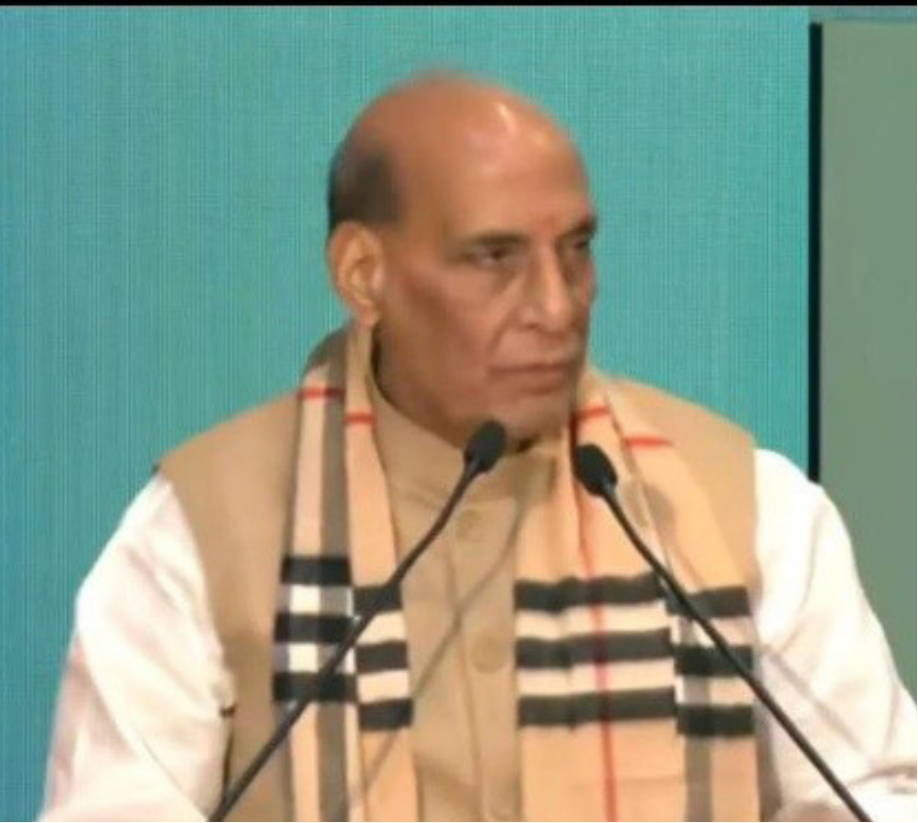

77-Foot Lord Ram Statue, Tallest In The World, Unveiled By PM Modi In Goa

The mutt, one of India's oldest monastic institutions, is celebrating 550 years of spiritual, cultural, and social contributions. The mutt premises, established 370 years ago, will host programmes from November 27 to December 7, attracting 7,000 to 10,000 visitors daily. The statue is expected to become a major center of devotion and cultural tourism in the region.

PM Modi's visit to Goa followed his earlier engagements in Udupi, Karnataka, where he participated in the Laksha Kantha Gita Parayana, during which over one lakh devotees recited the Bhagwad Gita. In Udupi, the Prime Minister inaugurated the Suvarna



Teertha Mantapa and dedicated the Kanaka Kavacha, a golden cover for Kanakana Kindi, the sacred window associated with saint Kanakadasa.

Addressing the gathering, Modi praised Udupi as the "karmabhoomi of Jana Sangh and BJP's model of good gov-

Rahul Gandhi Calls Air Pollution “Health

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Friday urged Parliament to hold a detailed discussion on the severe air pollution plaguing Delhi, calling it a "health emergency". He criticized Prime Minister Narendra Modi for remaining silent and questioned the government's lack of urgency and accountability in addressing the crisis.

Speaking to mothers at his residence, Gandhi shared a video highlighting their concerns. He said, "Every mother I meet tells me the same thing: her child is growing up breathing toxic air. They are exhausted, scared, and angry. Modi ji, India's children are choking in front of us. How can you stay silent?"

Gandhi demanded a strict

and enforceable action plan to curb pollution, insisting that India's children deserve clean air, not excuses or political distractions. He emphasized the need for immediate parliamentary attention and actionable measures to tackle the worsening situation.

Delhi has been experiencing very poor air quality for the past 15 days, with forecasts indicating the conditions will persist in the coming week. The Air Quality Early Warning System predicts the pollution levels will remain in the 'very poor' to 'severe' categories throughout the winter.

Health experts have warned that prolonged exposure to toxic air increases the risk of airway inflammation, reduced lung function, and aggravation of pre-existing respiratory or cardiac

conditions. Doctors have urged residents, especially children, asthma patients, smokers, and people with underlying health issues, to undergo regular diagnostic screenings to detect early signs of pollution-related health deterioration.

The Delhi pollution crisis has reignited debates over government responsibility and the need for concrete, enforceable measures to protect citizens. Gandhi's call for parliamentary action underscores growing public concern and demands for accountability amid escalating health risks linked to toxic air.

The Opposition leader's appeal stresses that clean air is a fundamental necessity, urging the government to treat the ongoing pollution crisis as a national priority rather than a seasonal inconvenience.

‘Remove 18% GST on air purifiers’: Kejriwal

Former Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Friday demanded that the Central Government immediately remove the 18% GST on air and water purifiers, citing the worsening air quality in Delhi-NCR.

In a post on X in Hindi, Kejriwal emphasized that clean air and clean water are fundamental rights of every citizen. He criticized the government, saying, "In Delhi and across North India, the air has become deadly. Instead of providing solutions, the government is collecting more taxes from the public."

The AAP supremo highlighted that families attempting to protect themselves by buying air purifiers are forced to bear an additional financial burden due

to the GST, calling it "out-right injustice." He urged the Centre to act promptly: "If you cannot provide solutions, at least stop burdening the pockets of the people."

Delhi's air quality has remained in the 'very poor' category for over two weeks, and the Air Quality Early Warning System forecasts that it is likely to remain at dangerous levels over the coming week. Experts have warned that prolonged exposure to toxic air triggers airway inflammation, reduces lung function, and aggravates pre-existing conditions, particularly in children, asthma patients, smokers, and those with cardiac or respiratory illnesses.

Health professionals have emphasized the importance of preventive

screenings to detect early signs of pollution-related health deterioration, noting that rising pollution levels make such measures increasingly urgent.

Kejriwal's demand adds to growing public and political pressure on the government to tackle the pollution crisis effectively. While citizens are struggling to mitigate health risks, the imposition of GST on protective devices has sparked criticism that the government is adding financial strain instead of offering solutions.

As Delhi faces one of its most severe pollution episodes in recent years, calls for policy interventions, fiscal relief, and urgent public health measures are gaining momentum, with Kejriwal urging the Centre to act immediately.

Imran Khan ‘dead or alive’?
Son demands proof of life

Rumours over the alleged death of former Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan have intensified after an unverified Afghan media report claimed he was killed inside Adiala Jail. The claims, circulating widely on social media, prompted his son Kasim Khan to demand immediate proof that his father is alive, as well as urgent access for family members.

Kasim, in a post on X, said his father has been detained for 845 days and has allegedly spent the past six weeks in a death cell, held in complete isolation with no contact with family. He claimed that despite court orders, Khan’s sisters have repeatedly been denied visits. “No phone calls, no visits, and no information about his well-being,” he wrote, calling the secrecy “deliberate” and accusing authorities of concealing Khan’s condition.

He urged international human rights organisations to intervene, demanding confirmation of Imran’s safety, restoration of family access, an end to “inhumane isolation”,

and the release of what he termed a political prisoner.

Imran’s sister Aleema Khanum also alleged that court-mandated visits were not being honoured. The family’s concerns escalated on Wednesday when PTI supporters and Khan’s sisters staged a sit-in outside Adiala Jail, drawing thousands. Some supporters reportedly attempted to breach the jail checkpoint before police assured Aleema that a meeting would be arranged.

Adiala Jail officials, however, firmly denied all death rumours. In an official statement, authorities said Imran Khan is in “completely good health”, remains inside Adiala Jail, and is receiving “all necessary care”. They dismissed reports of his transfer or deteriorating condition as “baseless”.

Khan, imprisoned since August 2023, faces multiple cases he says are politically motivated. Earlier this year, he and his wife were convicted in a corruption case and sentenced to long prison terms. Despite the government’s assurances, concerns over Khan’s isolation and safety continue to fuel tensions across Pakistan.

Putin to Visit India on
December 4–5 for Annual
Summit, MEA Confirms

The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has confirmed that Russian President Vladimir Putin will undertake a state visit to India from December 4-5, following an invitation from Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The visit marks Putin’s first trip to India since 2021 and will include participation in the 23rd India–Russia Annual Summit.

According to the MEA, President Droupadi Murmu will receive Putin and host a state banquet in his honour. The summit will allow both nations’ leaders to review progress in bilateral cooperation, strengthen their ‘Special and Privileged Strategic Partnership’, and exchange views on key regional and global developments.

The two leaders last met in person in September this year in Tianjin, China, on the sidelines of the SCO Summit. Preparations for the annual summit have been underway, with MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal noting that both countries are working to deepen ties across strategic sectors.

The Kremlin also under-

scored the significance of the upcoming visit. Citing a statement from Russian state agency TASS, Moscow said the trip will provide an opportunity to discuss an “extensive agenda” covering political, economic, scientific, technological, cultural and humanitarian cooperation. These issues will be central to Putin’s talks with the Indian delegation led by Prime Minister Modi.

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar, who met Putin in Moscow last week, conveyed the Prime Minister’s greetings and reviewed preparations for the summit. He later wrote that he deeply valued Putin’s perspectives on enhancing bilateral ties.

Further signalling the importance of the visit, Kremlin spokesperson Dmitry Peskov confirmed that Russia is “actively preparing” for Putin’s arrival, expected to be “meaningful” for both nations.

India and Russia’s strategic partnership, formalised in 2000 and elevated in 2010, continues to anchor cooperation across defence, energy, trade, and emerging technologies—areas expected to feature prominently during the December summit.

US Will Permanently Pause Migration
From All ‘3rd World Countries’: Trump

Two West Virginia National Guard members were critically injured in a brazen shooting on Wednesday afternoon, just blocks from the White House, in what authorities are investigating as a targeted act of violence. The incident occurred near a busy metro station as downtown streets and offices were bustling, heightening concerns over security in the nation’s capital.

The suspected shooter, identified as 29-year-old Afghan national Rahmanullah Lakanwal, came to the United States during the 2021 Afghanistan airlift under Operation Allies Welcome and had been resettled in Bellingham, Washington. Lakanwal reportedly lived in Washington state after his arrival. Law enforcement officials confirmed he was shot four times during



the confrontation and taken into custody, though he is also severely wounded.

Speaking at a media briefing, US President Donald Trump condemned the attack as

“an act of evil, hatred, and terror” and blamed his predecessor, Joe Biden, stating that the suspect was brought to the US under the Biden administration. Trump described Af-



ghanistan as a “hell-hole” and vowed to re-examine the entry of all aliens from Afghanistan during Biden’s presidency. He called the shooter an “animal” and warned he

would “pay a very steep price.”

In response to the shooting, Trump ordered 500 additional National Guard troops deployed to Washington, DC, and extended

his support to all military and law enforcement personnel. The shooting has renewed debate over Trump’s militarisation of American cities, particularly in Democrat-run areas, which has faced criticism and lawsuits from local officials.

FBI Director Kash Patel and Washington Mayor Muriel Bowser confirmed that the two guardsmen are hospitalized in critical condition. The FBI is investigating the attack as a possible act of terrorism. Authorities continue to search for motives and any potential accomplices, while the city remains on heightened alert following the shocking attack.

The incident has sparked national outrage and raised urgent questions about security protocols for National Guard members deployed in the capital.

Cyclone Ditwah Batters Sri Lanka, 56 Dead as Floods
and Landslips Worsen

Sri Lanka is reeling from the devastating impact of Cyclone Ditwah, which has triggered severe flooding, widespread landslips, and powerful winds across the island. As of Friday morning (November 28, 2025), authorities have confirmed at least 56 deaths, while dozens more remain missing as rescue teams struggle to reach isolated communities.

Over the past two days, torrential rains have pounded multiple districts, with some areas recording unprecedented levels of rainfall. Roads, bridges, and key highways have been inundated or blocked by landslips, severely hampering emergency response efforts. In Badulla, one of the worst-affected regions, major road sections have collapsed under continuous downpours, leaving residents stranded and



prompting urgent evacuations.

The Sri Lankan Disaster Management Centre has warned

that conditions may deteriorate further as Cyclone Ditwah continues to move north and north-west, heading

toward the Tamil Nadu coast. Coastal and low-lying regions remain on high alert, with authorities urging resi-

dents to relocate to safer ground. Temporary shelters have been set up in schools, temples, and public buildings to

accommodate those displaced.

In a significant humanitarian gesture, India has agreed to deploy helicopters from INS Vikrant, its aircraft carrier currently docked in Colombo, to assist with ongoing rescue and relief operations. The aircraft are expected to support aerial surveys, transport essential supplies, and aid in evacuations from cut-off areas. Sri Lankan officials welcomed the move, calling it a “critical boost” to their emergency response capabilities.

With more rain forecast over the weekend, emergency teams are racing against time to locate the missing, clear roadways, and deliver aid to affected families. Authorities have urged the public to follow safety advisories closely as the nation confronts one of its most damaging weather events in recent years.

Hong Kong Fire Death Toll Rises to 94 as Rescue Ends

Hong Kong’s authorities are nearing the end of search and rescue operations after the city’s worst fire in nearly 80 years engulfed the Wang Fuk Court housing complex in Tai Po, leaving at least 94 dead and

dozens still unaccounted for. The massive blaze, which began on Wednesday afternoon, has devastated the eight-tower estate home to more than 4,600 residents.

Firefighters reported that the blaze was largely contained, though it spread rapid-

ly due to ongoing renovations. The buildings were covered in bamboo scaffolding and green mesh at the time of the fire, which likely contributed to the speed and intensity of the flames. Authorities confirmed that the complex had been undergoing extensive re-

furbishment, raising questions about fire safety compliance.

In the wake of the disaster, three men, including two directors and an engineering consultant of the construction company overseeing the renovations, have been arrested on suspicion of man-

slaughter. Investigations are ongoing to determine if negligence or safety violations contributed to the high death toll.

Rescue teams have been working tirelessly to locate survivors amid the charred ruins. Emergency crews reported retrieving doz-

ens of residents from the wreckage, though the scale of the fire has made recovery operations extremely challenging. Hospitals in Hong Kong have admitted numerous injured residents, with some in critical condition due to smoke inhalation and burns.

The tragedy has sparked widespread outrage and grief across Hong Kong, with officials promising a full investigation into the circumstances surrounding the fire. Authorities have also urged residents of other high-rise estates undergoing renovations to exercise caution and ensure compliance with fire safety regulations.

The Wang Fuk Court fire is now considered one of the deadliest residential fires in Hong Kong’s modern history, underscoring concerns about building safety standards in densely populated urban areas. Families of victims continue to seek information on missing loved ones as authorities work to conclude recovery operations.

SBI and Bharti Airtel Lead Top Firms’ Market Valuation Gains

The combined market valuation of seven of India's top-10 most valued companies soared by 1,18,328.29 crore last week, reflecting renewed investor optimism in equities. State Bank of India (SBI) and Bharti Airtel emerged as the biggest gainers during this period, as the BSE benchmark surged 721.53 points, or 0.88 per cent.

SBI's market capitalisation jumped 35,953.25 crore, taking its valuation to 7,95,910 crore, while Bharti Airtel added 33,214.77 crore, reaching 11,18,952.64 crore. Reliance Industries, continuing its dominance, saw its market cap rise 17,389.23 crore to 19,04,898.51 crore. Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) also posted gains, climbing 12,952.75 crore to 11,46,879.47 crore.

Other winners included Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC), whose valuation edged higher by 12,460.25 crore to 5,65,612.92 crore, and Infosys,



which rose 6,127.73 crore to 6,39,901.03 crore. HDFC Bank's market cap inched up by

230.31 crore, taking it to 14,84,816.26 crore.

On the flip side, some major companies saw declines. ICICI Bank's valuation fell 10,707.87 crore to 10,01,654.46 crore, Bajaj Finance dipped 6,346.93 crore to 6,17,892.72 crore, and Hindustan Unilever lost 5,039.87 crore, standing at 6,01,225.16 crore.

Overall, the week highlighted strong performance by state-owned and tech-centric firms, signaling sustained investor confidence amid positive market sentiment. Reliance Industries retained its position as the most valued company in India, followed by HDFC Bank, TCS, Bharti Airtel, ICICI Bank, SBI, Infosys, Bajaj Finance, and Hindustan Unilever.

As equities continue to show momentum, investors are closely watching the performance of these blue-chip companies, whose market movements often influence broader market trends and investor strategies.

India's Forex Reserves Cross USD 700 Billion, Third Weekly Rise in a Row



India's foreign exchange reserves rose by USD 4.698 billion in the week ending September 12, reaching USD 702.966 billion, according to the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) latest 'Weekly Statistical Supplement.' This marks the third consecutive week of gains and sees the much-anticipated USD 700 billion milestone crossed.

The largest component of the reserves, India's foreign currency assets (FCA), increased by USD 2.537 billion to USD 587.014 billion. Gold reserves also contributed to the rise, climbing USD 2.12 billion to reach USD 92.419 billion.

RBI Governor Sanjay Malhotra, following the latest monetary policy review, emphasized that India's foreign exchange reserves are sufficient to cover approximately 11 months of the country's imports. This provides a strong buffer to manage external shocks and support the stability of the Indian rupee.

Historical trends show India steadily building its forex

reserves over recent years. In 2023, the country added roughly USD 58 billion to the kitty, reversing a cumulative decline of USD 71 billion in 2022. In 2024, reserves rose by over USD 20 billion, while 2025 has already seen a cumulative increase of about USD 53 billion so far.

Foreign exchange reserves, or FX reserves, are assets held by a country's central bank, primarily in major reserve currencies such as the US Dollar, with smaller portions in the Euro, Japanese Yen, and Pound Sterling. The RBI actively manages these reserves to stabilize the rupee, buying dollars when the rupee strengthens and selling them when it weakens.

With the forex kitty crossing the USD 700 billion mark, India's external stability outlook remains strong, giving policymakers greater flexibility to respond to global volatility and reinforcing confidence in the country's economic resilience amid global uncertainties.

Major Carmakers Slash Prices Ahead of Navaratri, GST Cut Benefits



Buyers are in for a bonanza as leading automakers Maruti Suzuki, Tata Motors, Hyundai Motor India, and luxury carmakers like Mercedes-Benz and BMW announce significant price cuts effective from September 22, coinciding with the start of the auspicious Navaratri period. Two-wheeler makers are also joining the trend, passing on GST benefits to customers.

Maruti Suzuki India, the country's largest carmaker, has reduced vehicle prices by

up to 1.29 lakh. The company aims to attract two-wheeler users to four-wheelers by offering additional discounts on small cars beyond the GST cut of 8.5%. Popular models such as S-Presso, Alto K10, Celerio, Wagon-R, and Ignis have seen price reductions ranging from 71,300 to 1,29,600. Premium models including Swift, Baleno, Dzire, Fronx, Brezza, Grand Vitara, Jimny, Ertiga, and XL6 also received substantial cuts, with savings of up to 1.12 lakh.

Tata Motors has cut prices across its passenger vehicles by 75,000 to 1.45 lakh, including Rs 85,000 off the compact SUV Punch and Rs 1.55 lakh on Nexon. Premium SUVs Harrier and Safari now cost 1.4 lakh and 1.45 lakh less, respectively. Mahindra & Mahindra has already reduced prices by up to 1.56 lakh on models like Bolero, XUV300, Thar, and Scorpio Classic. Hyundai, Honda, Kia, and Toyota are also implementing reductions, with Hyundai Tucson seeing

the highest cut of 2.4 lakh. Luxury automakers have followed suit. Mercedes-Benz announced reductions ranging from 2 lakh (A-Class) to 10 lakh (S-Class), while BMW Motor India is cutting prices by up to 13.6 lakh across its portfolio. Audi and Jaguar Land Rover have also reduced prices, with cuts ranging from 2.6 lakh to 30.4 lakh.

In the two-wheeler segment, Hero MotoCorp and Honda Motorcycle & Scooter

India are lowering prices by up to 15,743 and 18,800, respectively.

According to Maruti Suzuki India Senior Executive Officer Partho Banerjee, "With car penetration in India at just 34 per 1,000 people, there is no better time to put India on wheels." Consumers are expected to benefit significantly from these combined GST-related and additional price cuts, making the festive season an ideal time for vehicle purchases.

Wholesale Price Inflation at Two-Year Low, Core Inflation Rises



India's factory gate inflation, measured by the Wholesale Price Index (WPI), stood at a two-

year low of -0.58% in July, continuing the deflationary trend observed in June. Analysts

attribute the recent change in the wholesale price trajectory to an upswing in food prices

after months of decline.

Paras Jasrai, Associate Director at India

Ratings and Research, noted that food prices played a significant role in reversing the deflationary trend. In August 2025, food prices rose 0.2% compared with the same month last year, while the decline in vegetable prices slowed to 14.2% year-on-year—the slowest pace in six months. Edible oils recorded a sharp increase of 22.9% in August, marking the highest surge in three months.

Jewellery prices also climbed significantly, rising 32.6% year-on-year in August, contributing to a rise in core inflation, which reached a five-month high of 1.6%. Experts expect core inflation to remain around 1.8% through the end of 2025 due to a low base effect, keeping overall price pressures in check.

Food items accounted for 73 basis points of the

110 basis points uptick in the headline WPI between July and August, highlighting the dominant role of essential commodities in inflation trends. Non-food manufactured items, which make up the core WPI, added 27 basis points to the headline print, according to Rahul Agrawal, Senior Economist at ICRA.

While deflationary pressures have eased, the rise in essential commodity prices indicates that inflation dynamics remain sensitive to changes in food and commodity markets. Policymakers and analysts will continue to monitor WPI and core inflation trends closely as India navigates supply-side pressures and prepares for the upcoming festive season, where consumer demand is expected to rise.

India Emerges as Leading Flexible Office Market Globally



Driven by strong global demand, India has become one of the world's most mature flexible office ecosystems, with international firms accounting for 72 per cent of flex space absorption in 2024, according to Cushman & Wakefield's Global Trends in Flexible Office 2025 report. The remaining 28 per cent of demand came from startups, leveraging flexible offices to manage costs, attract talent, and scale efficiently in a competitive landscape.

India scored a perfect 100 on Cushman & Wakefield's maturity index, surpassing global peers including the UK at 98, France at 97, the US at 81, and Japan and Singapore at 77. The score reflects multiple metrics, including flexible inventory as a share of total office space, number of operators, leasing activity, emerging agreement structures, and overall market depth.

Ramita Arora, Managing Director Bengaluru & Head – Flex, India, Cushman & Wakefield, highlighted India's market maturity, diversity of operators, and ability to pivot with demand, noting that many Western markets are still evolving. Flexible office demand in

India has risen nearly six-fold since 2020, with 2024 alone seeing flex space account for 15 per cent of new office leasing. Operator expansion has surged, with 33.5 million square feet leased between 2022 and 2024—equivalent to over 500,000 seats. Annual take-up has tripled over five years, confirming flexible workspace as a mainstream solution rather than an alternate option.

India is now the largest flexible office market in APAC, with 79.7 million square feet of stock across the top eight cities, expected to reach 85 million square feet by year-end and surpass 100 million by 2026. Managed office and enterprise models now dominate, accounting for 70-80 per cent of demand. Bengaluru leads with 30 per cent of national flex inventory, followed by Delhi NCR, Pune, and Hyderabad.

Institutional interest is growing, with four operators already public and more IPOs anticipated. The next 3-5 years are expected to see consolidation, with leading players strengthening market share while niche operators continue to meet specialised needs.

Apple to Launch iPhone 20 and iPhone 18e in Early 2027 for 20th Anniversary



Apple is gearing up to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the iPhone with the launch of two new models in the first half of 2027: the iPhone 20 and the iPhone 18e. This move marks a significant shift in Apple's naming strategy, skipping the iPhone 19 to honor two decades since the original iPhone's debut in January 2007.

According to industry analyst Heo Moo-yeol, Apple will release the iPhone 20 alongside the iPhone 18e, a model expected to be separate from the flagship lineup. This early 2027 launch will break from the company's traditional September release schedule, which it has followed since the iPhone 5 in 2012.

The rest of the iPhone 20 series — including the Air, Pro, and Pro Max versions — are an-

ticipated to arrive in the second half of 2027. Additionally, Apple plans to introduce the second-generation iPhone Fold, following the expected debut of its first foldable iPhone in 2026.

Interestingly, Apple may discontinue the standard iPhone 18 model next year, focusing instead on the iPhone 18 Pro, Pro Max, and a new iPhone Air successor, alongside the foldable iPhone. This shift could reduce panel demand by about 20 million units compared to previous years.

The iPhone Fold is projected to see strong sales, with Apple aiming to ship over 8 million units in its first year. Overall, Apple's 2027 lineup promises innovation and commemorates a milestone for one of the world's most influential tech products.

YouTube Adds Daily Timer to 'Shorts' to Combat Doomscrolling



NASA's rover Perseverance has discovered an unusual 80-centimeter rock in the Ver-nodden area of Mars' Jezero Crater, sparking excitement among scientists. The rock, named "Phippsaksla," stood out due to its size and structured appearance compared to surrounding stones.

Images captured by Perseverance's Left Mastcam-Z camera on September 19, 2025, show Phippsaksla both up close and from a distance, revealing details that prompted the team to investigate further.

To analyze its composition, the rover used its SuperCam instrument, which fires laser pulses at targets and examines the reflected light. Preliminary findings indicate that the rock contains iron and nickel, elements uncommon in typical Martian geology but often found in asteroids, suggesting that the rock may have formed elsewhere in the solar system.

"This could be a meteorite," NASA scientists noted, though further study is required to confirm its origin and how long it has been on the Martian surface.

Phippsaksla joins a growing

list of metal-rich rocks identified on Mars by previous missions. The Curiosity rover documented several iron-nickel meteorites, including the one-meter-wide "Lebanon" in 2014 and "Cacao" in 2023. Earlier rovers, Spirit and Opportunity, also recorded similar findings, offering valuable insights into materials that have traveled across the solar system to reach Mars.

Each metallic discovery enhances understanding of the diverse composition of objects impacting Mars, helping scientists piece together the planet's history and its interactions with space debris.

For Perseverance, Phippsaksla represents a new chapter in exploring extraterrestrial meteorites. The research team will continue analyzing data to determine its precise origin, composition, and the story it tells about Mars' cosmic neighborhood.

This discovery highlights how even a single rock can provide profound insights, reinforcing the importance of ongoing robotic exploration in expanding humanity's knowledge of the solar system.

Amazon Plans to Replace 500,000 Employees with Robots by 2033

Amazon Inc., the global e-commerce giant, is set to transform its workforce by automating a significant portion of its operations, aiming to replace approximately 500,000 employees with robots by 2033. According to a report by The New York Times, this move highlights Amazon's aggressive push towards robotics and automation within its sprawling fulfillment network.

Amazon's robotics team is targeting automation for up to 75% of its operations. If successful, this shift could allow the company to avoid hiring an estimated 160,000 additional employees by 2027 alone. The initiative is part of Amazon's broader strategy to streamline its supply chain and reduce reliance on human labor, especially for repetitive and physically demanding tasks in warehouses.

The company has already invested heavily in robotic technology,



using machines to handle sorting, packing, and transporting goods within fulfillment centers. This next phase

would significantly scale up these efforts, with robots performing more complex tasks and improving overall

efficiency.

While automation promises faster delivery times and cost savings, it also raises con-

cerns about job displacement. Labor advocates warn that large-scale replacement of workers with robots

could impact thousands of families reliant on Amazon's workforce for their livelihoods.

Amazon has not officially confirmed the exact numbers but has consistently emphasized that automation helps employees focus on higher-value activities. The company also points out that technological advancements have historically created new jobs even as some roles become obsolete.

This move comes amid growing competition in the e-commerce space, pushing Amazon to leverage technology to maintain its market dominance. The coming years will reveal how successfully Amazon balances automation with workforce management in one of the world's largest employment ecosystems.

As automation reshapes the future of work, Amazon's plans are a significant marker of the broader trends affecting industries globally.

Meta Boosts Safety Tools to Protect Older Adults from Online Scams on Messenger

Meta, the parent company of Facebook and Messenger, has announced new safety measures aimed at protecting older adults from online scams. The company is rolling out advanced scam detection features on its Messenger platform, designed to warn users when they receive messages that may be potentially fraudulent.

As part of its ongoing commitment to user safety, Meta is currently testing these enhanced scam detection tools that analyze incoming chats for suspicious content. When a message is flagged as "potentially scammy," users will receive an alert warning them before engaging further. This new feature is especially targeted at older adults, who are often more vulnerable to online fraud.

In addition to the technical upgrades, Meta is launching awareness campaigns to educate users about common online scams and how to recognize them. The initiatives include informational prompts and tips to help users stay vigilant and avoid falling prey to deceptive messages.



Online scams have been on the rise globally, with fraudsters increasingly exploiting messaging apps to trick people into sharing personal information, sending money, or clicking on malicious links. Older adults are often targeted because of their relatively low-

Donyell Malen Stars as Aston Villa and Nottingham Forest Win in Europa League



Donyell Malen scored twice to guide Aston Villa to a 2-1 victory over Young Boys in a Europa League clash on Thursday, a match briefly marred by crowd trouble. Malen opened the scoring with a header from a Youri Tielemans cross but was hit on the head by an object thrown from the away supporters' section while celebrating. Despite a minor cut, the Dutch forward shrugged off the incident and doubled Villa's lead just before half-time, assisted by Morgan Rogers.

The match saw brief interruptions as Young Boys fans clashed with police. Captain Loris Benito intervened to calm the situation. Joel Monteiro pulled one back in the 90th minute for the Swiss side, but Villa secured their fourth win in five group-stage games, sitting just behind Lyon and Midtjylland on goal difference. The victory continues Villa's impressive form, marking 10 wins in 12 matches across competitions after a five-game winless start to the Premier League season.

Malen told TNT Sports he was "fine" after the incident and praised the team's turnaround.

Nottingham Forest also recorded a commanding 3-0 win over Malmo at the City Ground. Ryan Yates opened the scoring with a curling effort, followed by Arnaud Kalimuendo's first goal for the club and Nikola Milenkovic's strike to seal the win. The result lifted Sean Dyche's side to 16th place in the group with eight points. Yates called the match "unbelievable" and emphasized the special European nights at home.

Elsewhere in the Europa League, Lyon crushed Maccabi Tel Aviv 6-0 with a hat-trick from Corentin Tolisso, while Midtjylland suffered a 2-1 loss to Roma, ending their perfect run. Celtic defeated Feyenoord 3-1, and Rangers drew 1-1 with Braga, with both teams reduced to 10 men.

The latest round of fixtures has intensified the race for Europa League playoff positions, with Aston Villa and Nottingham Forest consolidating their strong starts in the competition.

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India to Host Sri Lanka for Five-Match Women's T20I Series

India will host Sri Lanka for a five-match women's T20I series from December 21 to 30, with the first two games scheduled in Visakhapatnam and the remaining three fixtures in Thiruvananthapuram, the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) announced on Friday. BCCI Secretary Devajit Saikia confirmed that the first two matches will be held at the ACA-VDCA Cricket Stadium in Visakhapatnam on December 21 and 23. The final three games are set for December 26, 28, and 30 at the Greenfield International Stadium in Thiruvananthapuram.

The series comes as India's first international outing after their historic maiden Women's ODI World Cup victory in Navi Mumbai earlier this month. It will also form an essential part of India's preparations for the 2026 ICC Women's T20 World Cup, scheduled in England from June 12 to July 5.

Visakhapatnam has previously hosted India's



league matches against South Africa and Australia during the 2025 Women's ODI World Cup, as well as a ten-day pre-tournament camp. Thiruvananthapuram will host women's international cricket for the first time, having previously hosted men's T20Is, ODIs, and youth matches.

The T20I series announcement follows the postponement of Bangladesh's scheduled tour to India in December due to political tensions, which had earlier impacted India men's tour of Bangladesh, now rescheduled for September 2026.

Following the T20I series, India will host the fourth edition of the Women's Premier League (WPL) from January 9 to February 5, 2026, across Navi Mumbai and Vadodara. The national team will then embark on a multi-format tour of Australia from February 15 to March 6, providing further preparation ahead of the 2026 T20 World Cup.

The Sri Lanka series is expected to offer India an opportunity to consolidate their post-World Cup momentum while giving emerging players valuable exposure ahead of the next global T20 tournament. Fans across the two host cities are set to witness high-octane action as the Indian women aim to continue their winning run on home soil.

Sultan Azlan Shah Cup: Selvam's Late Strike Seals 3-2 Win for India Over New Zealand



Ipoh, Malaysia – Selvam Karthi scored the decisive goal in the final quarter as India edged past New Zealand 3-2 in the Sultan Azlan Shah Cup on Thursday, November 27, 2025.

India got off to a fast start with Amit Rohidas opening the scoring in the 4th minute. New Zealand fought back, but Sanjay extended India's lead in the 32nd minute. The Kiwis responded strongly, with George Baker netting twice in the 42nd and 48th minutes to level the score at 2-2.

The match remained tense as New Zealand attempted to dominate the midfield in the opening minutes, but the Indian defense held firm under pressure. In the final quarter, Selvam Karthi broke the deadlock with a clinical finish, securing India's second consecutive win in the tournament.

India had previously recorded a thrilling 4-3 victory against the hosts Malaysia on Wednesday, November 26. With two wins from their opening matches, India looks well-positioned to advance in the tournament.

Sri Lanka defeated Pakistan by six runs in a thrilling Tri-nation T20I clash at the Rawalpindi Cricket Stadium on Thursday, successfully defending their total of 184 and securing a spot in the November 29 final against the same opponents.

Sri Lanka posted a challenging total thanks to a fiery 76 off 48 balls from opener Kamil Mishara, who struck six fours and three sixes. Nawaz's quickfire 27 helped keep Pakistan in contention, but the duo fell short in the final overs.

Sri Lanka's Dushmantha Chameera emerged as the match-winner, taking 4-20 and defending 10 runs in the last over. He dismissed Faheem on the fifth ball when Pakistan needed seven from two, securing the six-run victory and earning the Player of the Match award.

Earlier in the innings, Eshan Malinga bowled tightly, picking up two wickets for 54 runs, while Maheesh Theekshana and Dasun Shanaka bowled economically without taking wickets. Pakistan's chase saw some late resistance, but Sri Lanka's balanced bowling attack and timely hitting proved decisive.

With this win, Sri Lanka booked their place in the final of the Tri-nation T20I series, ending Pakistan's hopes of a sixth consecutive T20I victory.

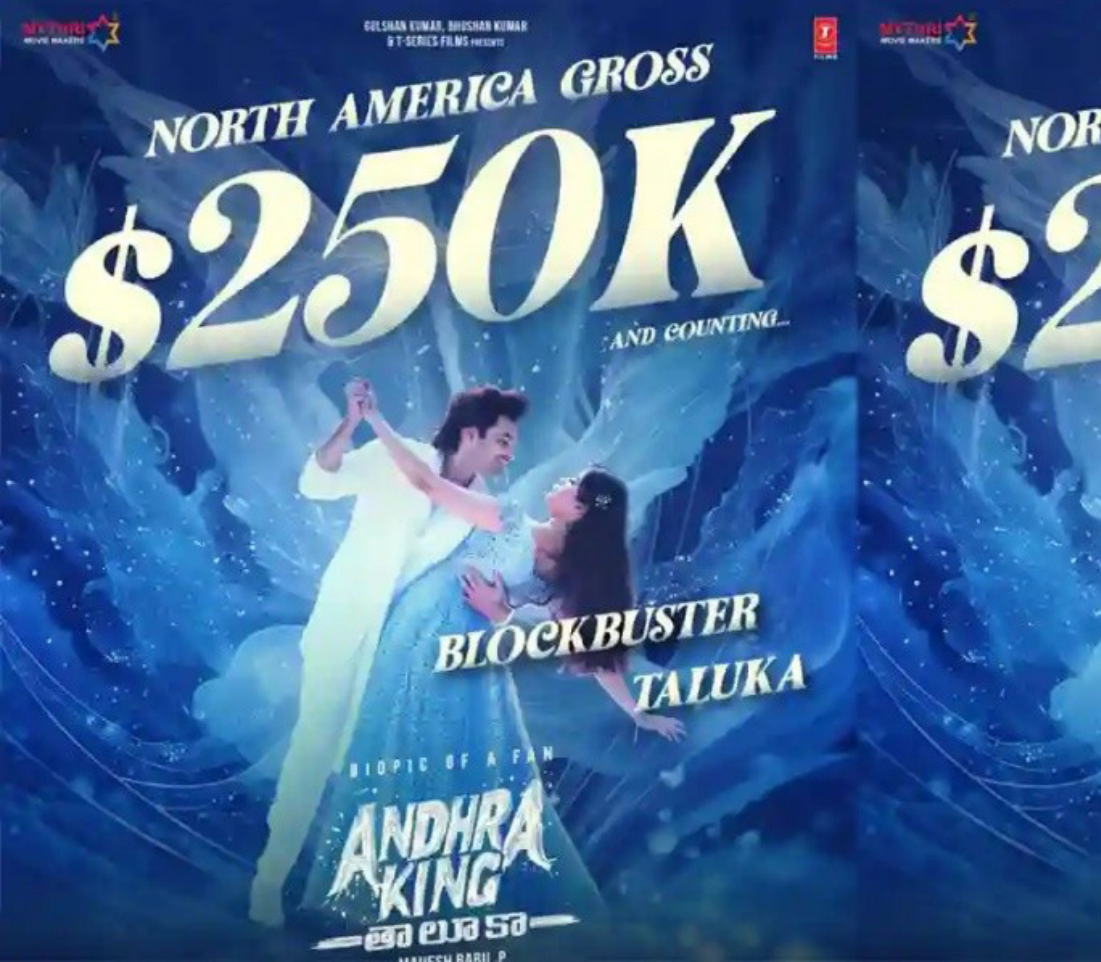

excels as an “angry young man,” delivering a powerful portrayal marked by intensity and vulnerability. Kriti Sanon once again proves her versatility, showcasing a range of emotions with remarkable precision. Their chemistry, combined with lighter moments and well-crafted emotional beats, keeps the initial hour engaging. Prakash Raj also shines in a brief but impactful supporting role.

However, the second half loses its grip. The narrative becomes overly complex, with character motivations turning murky and actions becoming excessively dramatic. The war backdrop feels underdeveloped, and several plot threads add confusion rather than substance. The pace slows considerably, diminishing the impact of the strong start. Editing inconsistencies further weaken the flow.

Despite outstanding performances and Rahman’s evocative music, Tere Ishk Mein struggles to maintain momentum. A promising beginning gives way to a muddled and stretched finale, resulting in a film that falls short of its potential.
