Cm Revanth Reddy Sets \$3 Trillion Target and Unveils Guangdong Model for Telangana

Chief Minister Revan th Reddy asserted that Telan-gana, despite being a newly formed state, is aggressively moving forward in development (dhoosuku pothondi) and is currently establishing revolutionary goals for its future. Speaking at the inauguration of the ‘Telangana Rising Global Summit’ held at Future City, the Chief Minister articulated a monumental economic target: he aims for Telangana to grow into a \$3 trillion economy by 2047. This ambitious target is aligned with the national goal set by the Central Government, which envisions India as a \$30 trillion economy by the same year. The CM specified that Telanga-na’s aspiration is to contribute 10% of the country’s GDP (Desha GDP lo 10% undaalaneedhe thama aashayam). The sum-mit served as a critical pl atform where he formally invited ideas and opinions (aalochanalu, abhipraayalu aahvaa nistunnam) from both entre-preneurs and economists to collaboratively shape the state’s economic roadmap for the next two decades.

Reddy expressed absolute confidence in achieving the goal, stating, “Even though the goal is big, we are confident that we will achieve it through hard work.” He affirmed that success would require the full cooperation (andariki sahaakaaram) of all stakeholders. The Chief Minister took a moment to reflect on the sta-te’s foundation, stating that the dream of Telan-gana was realized under

the leadership of Sonia Gandhi and Manmohan Singh. He underscored th e state’s unique econom-ic contribution, highlig hting that Telangana, w ith only 2.9% of the coun-

try’s population, gener-ates approximately 5% of the national revenue (5% aadaayam isthunna am), demonstrating its strong economic efficie ncy.

In a key strategic an-nouncement, the CM re-vealed a distinct govern-ance model that no other Indian state has imple-mented: the state has been strategically divid-ed into three zones. These zones are uniquely dedicated to the core sec-tors of Services, Manu-facturing, and Agricul-ture, and are designated using the conceptual names of Cure, Pure, and Rare zones. Further-more, CM Revanth Reddy revealed that Telangana is drawing significant in-spiration from the eco-nomic success story of the Guangdong Province in China. He pointed out that Guangdong achieved the highest investments and rapid industrial gro wth within just 20 years. Accordingly, the Telan-gana government plans to implement the Guang-dong model (Guangdong namunaa amalucheyadalicchhaam) within the state to accelerate invest-ment and economic de-velopment. He also listed other economically ad-vanced nations—China, Japan, Germany, South Korea, and Singapore—as ideal models that Tel-angana seeks to emulate in its journey toward be-coming a global econom-ic powerhouse by 2047. The CM’s address set a tone of high ambition and strategic planning for the future of the state’s economy.

Global Companies Pledge 1.31 Lakh Crore Investments; Adani Details 25,000 Cr Green Data Center

The Telangana Global Rising Sum-mit at Future City immediately serve d as a platform for mon-umental investment an-nouncements from global and national in-dustry leaders, affirm-ing their confiden ce in the state’s economic vi-sion. The Director of an undisclosed firm, iden-tified only as Eric, took to the stage to ma ke a major commitme nt, publicly announcing the company’s plan to inject 1 Lakh Crore (Rs. 1 Lakh Crore) worth of investments into Telan-gana over the next ten years. This massive ple dge underscores the im-mediate success of the summit in attracting large-scale, long-term capital commitments.

Separately, former CII Chairman Dinesh offered strong praise for the state’s vision, par-ticularly commending the forward-thinking concept of a new urban centre named ‘Future City’. He stated that Tel-angana is already recog-

nized as a “fast-develop-ing state” (vegambga abhiruddhi chendhuttunna rashtram) glob-ally. Dinesh lauded the state government’s ef-fort to bring organiza-tions from across the world onto a single plat-form, calling it a great achievement. He em-phatically confirmed the industry’s support, stating that the CII and its members are “ready to partner in the Telan-gana Vision” (Telanga-na Vision lo bhaagas-waamulavadaanikisid dham), indicating a ro-bust collaboration be-tween the government and the industrial sec-tor. Karan Adani, Man-aging Director of Adani Ports and SEZ, provided detailed insight into the Adani Group’s signifi-cant and existing invest-ment footprint in Telan-gana, emphasizing that the summit perfectly reflects the state’s ambi-tious vision. He speci-fied that the Adani Gro-up is currently invest-ing in Green Data Cen-ters and Renewable En-ergy sectors, alongside its established presence in the Cement industry. Adani announc ed the

establishment of a De-fence and Aerosp ace Park and highlighted a pioneering project: the development of UAV (Unmanned Aerial Ve-hicle) Technology in Hyderabad, a first for In-dia. The UAVs manufac-tured here will be supp-lied to the Indian Arme d Forces and also sold in the global market. Cru-cially, Karan Adani an-nounced a substantial commitment of 25,000 crores for setting up a 48 MW Green Data Center. The Group is also fo-cused on boosting the state’s logistics capabil-ities, committing 4,000 crores for developing road infrastructure that connects various dist-riicts, and further add-ing to the cement indus-try investment with 2,000 crores for a new cement plant. These di-verse commitments col-lectively cement the Adani Group as a major strategic partner in Tel-angana’s multi-sectoral growth plan, reinforc-ing the state’s position as a preferred destina-tion for large-scale in-frastructure and tech investments.

Union Minister Kishan Reddy Praises National Growth

Union Minister Kishan Reddy, spe-aking at the Telan-gana Global Ris ing Summit in Future City, offered a bro ad perspective on Indi a’s impressive econom-ic growth trajectory over the past decade. He asserted that the ma ssive increase in fore ign investment (vides hi pettubadulu baar eegaa perigaayani) into the country is a direct result of the Central Government’s consist-ent adherence to trans-parency and accounta-bility (paardarshakata, jaawabudareethanam). He highlighted India’s transformation into a major global platform for international com-panies. To illustrate the nation’s rapid devel-opmental strides, Kishan Reddy provided key statistics: India now holds the second position globally in the production of cellph ones. Furthermore, he noted that the constr-uction of National Hig hways (NHs) across India has seen a massive 70% increase in the last ten years. He also pointed out the signifi-cant expansion of ur-ban infrastructure, not-ing that the Metro Rail network, which span ned only 240 km ten years ago, has now dra-



matically expanded to cover 1013 km across various Indian cities, underscoring the gov-ernment’s focus on modern infrastructure development.

Following the Union Minister’s national ove rview, State Minister Sridhar Babu took the opportunity to detail Telangana’s immedi-ate priorities and forward-looking vision. He proudly announced the completion of two years of the Congress government’s adminis-tration (Praja Palana) and asserted that Tel-angana has already es-tablished itself as a mo del state (adarshamga nilichaam) for many others in the produc-tion and construction sectors. The Minister emphasized that Telan-gana is rapidly advanc-ing across various sec-tors and holds a leading position in infrastruc-ture development (mou lika vasathulakalapa-na). He confirmed that the government is un-dertaking concerted ef-forts to ensure the state

achieves accelerated development over the next ten years. Minister Sridhar Babu then highlighted the state’s firm pivot towards fu-turistic technology, an-nouncing the ground-breaking plan to esta blish the country’s first ‘AI Village’ (AI Village nirministunnaam). He stressed that the gov-ernment is moving forward with a clear visio n (spashtamaina lakshyamtho), acting bold-ly and swiftly. In addi-tion to AI, the Minister confirmed that various initiatives are actively being pursued for the development of Quan-tum Technology (Qua ntum Technology abhirudhhiiki), reinfo rcing the government’s strategic intent to posi-tion Telangana at the forefront of deep tech-nological innovation. Minister Sridhar Babu concluded his address by confidently stating the government’s dual strength: “We have the vision, and we have the necessary plan.”

Minister Uttam Announces 97,000 Cr Deals with Singapore’s Agidc and Vietnam’s Vin Group

Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy an-nounced a signifi-cant breakthrough h in international econo mic relations at the Global Summit, confirming crucial investment deals with two key Asian com-panies totaling a massive 97,000 crores. This suc-cess was achieved follow-ing productive discus-sions focused on econ omic partnerships with Asian nations, which fea-tured the participation of official representativ es from Singapore, Thai-land, and Vietnam.

The first major agree-ment was secured with the AGIDC Company from Singapore, which si gned an impressive MoU worth 70,000 crores. Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy explained that this company specializes in advanced technology and will be establishing large-scale AI-based data centers (AI aadharitha data centers) within Tel-angana. This massive in-vestment into digital in-frastructure directly supports the state’s tech-nological ambitions, es-pecially its declared fo-cus on Artificial Intellige nce and Deep Tech.

The second significant deal was signed with the Vin Group from Viet-nam, securing a substan-tial investment commit-ment of 27,000 crores. The Vin Group plans a multi-faceted investment in the state, establishing facilities for Solar Plants,



Electric Vehicles (EVs), and Energy Storage solu-tions (Solar Plants, EV, Energy Storage). Minis-ter Uttam further de-tailed that, as part of this commitment, the Vin Group is also planning to establish a dedicated In-dustrial Township (In-dustrial Township) to house its opera-tions and supporting in-frastructure. This dual commitment strongly ad-vances Telangana’s goals in renewable energy and electric mobility. The Minister affirmed that the state government is intensely focusing its ef-forts on essential devel-opmental areas such as Technology and Skill De-velopment (Technology, Skill Development), which are considered vital for attracting and sus-taining these high-value, future-focused invest-ments and ensuring the

local population benefits from the influx of techn-ology.

In a symbolic move fol-lowing the announce-ments, the summit also hosted a major highlight where Chief Minister Revanth Reddy unveiled an Olectra Electric Car on the Future City prem-ises. The Chief Minister personally took the ini-tiative to drive the car (swayamga aayana car nadipaaru), underscor-ing the government’s se-rious commitment and enthusiasm for promot-ing Electric Vehicles and adopting sustainable and futuristic transportation technologies within the state. Telangana High Court Suspends CAT Order Allotting IAS Officer Amrapali To State

In a significant development concerning civil service cadre allocation, the Telangana High Court has issued interim orders that suspend the earlier directions given by the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT). The CAT had previously directed the allocation of IAS officer Amrapali Kata to the Telangana state cadre. This High Court ruling marks a temporary but notable setback for the officer, who has been involved in a continuous legal process to contest her initial cadre allocation.

The complex legal situation began in October last year, when the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), the central authority, issued official orders directing the allocation of IAS officer Amrapali to the Andhra Pradesh state cadre. Challenging both the legality and the basis of these DoPT orders, Amrapali approached the CAT for redressal. The Tribunal, after reviewing the arguments presented, subsequently issued a directive stating that Amrapali should be sent back to the Telangana cadre. The CAT’s decision was based on a proposed “swapping” arrangement involving another IAS officer, Harikiran, as a mechanism for the allocation change.

However, the DoPT vigorously objected to and challenged this CAT directive in court. The DoPT argued that the proposed “swapping” mechanism was not legally applicable in Amrapali’s case because the other officer involved, Harikiran, belongs to a reserved category. The department contended that such an exchange, or swapping procedure, was therefore not permissible under the current allocation rules and regulations, as it could potentially violate critical reservation guidelines and principles.

Consequently, the DoPT filed an appeal against the CAT’s decision in the Telangana High Court. The High Court, after considering the DoPT’s argument regarding the impermissibility of the swap due to the reserved category status of the other officer, issued an interim stay on the CAT’s previous decision. This suspension means the CAT’s order to reallocate Amrapali to Telangana is temporarily halted. The High Court has adjourned the next hearing on this complex administrative and legal matter for a period of six weeks, leaving the final cadre status of IAS officer Amrapali unresolved and subject to further judicial review.



Mynampally Hanumantha Rao Attacks BRS After Panchayat Wins

Congress leader Mynampally Hanumantha Rao addressed a media conference at his residence in Doolapally, Kuthbullapur, on December 8, where he strongly asserted the rising dominance of the Congress party in local politics, citing the recent Gram Panchayat elections. Hanumantha Rao announced a significant development in the Medak constituency, stating that out of the total 142 Gram Panchayat Sarpanch posts, 15 have been elected unanimously (Eka-greva), which he claimed is clear evidence of the shift in public support towards the Congress party.

His address quickly turned into a fierce attack on the opposition

BRS party. With the Congress government approaching its two-year mark, Hanumantha Rao reassured the public that all promises made would be "certainly implemented" within the full five-year term. He then sharply contrasted this with the previous BRS government, which he accused of being in power for a decade and failing to fulfill its promises to the people. He charged that the BRS is now resorting to "slinging mud" at the Congress on social media because of its political failures. He promised that the remaining guarantees would be delivered within the next three years, urging patience and trust from the electorate.

Hanumantha Rao pointed to the failure of



the BRS on several key issues, most prominently the delay in ration card distribution, stating,

"The ration card issue alone is enough to show your government failed." He claimed that the Congress government initiated the distribution of ration cards as a continuous process immediately upon taking office. He escalated his accusations of corruption against the BRS, charging that they engaged in large-scale "looting" from the Kale shwaram project to various "car scams". He accused the BRS of illegally accumulating a massive 1,500 crore party fund over ten years, along with "hundreds and thousands of acres of land". He mocked their failure to deliver on key promises like double-bedroom houses and jobs, especially to Dalits, asserting that the public removed the

BRS from power precisely because of this failure. He warned the BRS that the overwhelming "Congress wave" in the local elections would give them a "heart attack." He urged the BRS to stop creating "illusions" (apohalu) and using social media to divert public attention and impede the Congress government's development work. Finally, he appealed to the central and state governments to "ban" media organizations that show a one-sided bias in favor of political parties. Medak MLA Mynampally Rohit and other party officials attended the conference, endorsing the strong stance taken by Hanumantha Rao against the opposition.

BRS Releases Chargesheet Accusing Congress Of Two Years Of 'Incompetence And Chaos'

In a scathing counter-attack just as the Congress government approaches its two-year mark, senior BRS leader and former Minister T. Harish Rao released a comprehensive chargesheet at Telangana Bhavan. He accused Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy of running a "private limited government" marked by the collapse of governance, rampant corruption, and broken promises, summarizing the period as "two years of suffering" for the people

of Telangana. Harish Rao charged that the Congress failed both to implement its six key guarantees and to sustain the successful developmental initiatives launched by the BRS. He accused the regime of surviving solely on "self-praise, photo sessions, and Goebbels-style propaganda," while development and welfare systems sharply deteriorated. He mockingly dubbed the Chief Minister "Buildup Babai," suggesting the administration was high on hype but low on actual delivery, calling its performance "hollow, fruitless, and pointless."

Harish Rao drew a stark comparison, highlighting that the first two years of the BRS government saw the successful rollout of transformative schemes such as 24-hour power, Mission Bhagiratha, Mission Kakatiya, enhanced pensions, Kalyana Lakshmi, and TS-iPASS reforms. In sharp contrast, he claimed the Congress tenure has produced "nothing beyond rhetoric and revived corruption." He pointed

to instances of governance paralysis, criticizing the quick collapse of the promised daily Praja Darbar, which he claimed turned Praja Bhavan into a venue for "parties and receptions, not public service." He blamed "impulsive and immature decisions," such as the cancellation of the Metro Rail extension and the scrapping of Ph arma City, for stalling Hyderabad's growth and severely damaging investor confidence, leading to decreased state revenues. The chargesheet's most

aggressive section focused on alleged corruption, which Harish Rao charged had been institutionalized. He claimed that bills are cleared only after commissions are paid, alleging that ministers have imposed an unofficial "fixed tax" on approvals for building permissions, layout conversions, and contract bills. He specifically named these as the "R R tax, Bhatti tax, Uttam tax, and many others," alleging a new norm of "30 per cent commission" for every leader and claiming a portion of this

loot is sent to the high command in Delhi. Harish Rao issued a direct challenge to the Chief Minister, stating that "Not a single village has full loan waiver. If it is done, I will resign. Is Revanth Reddy ready?" He concluded by listing several alleged scams, including the Musi River-front land scam, the Ph arma City-Future City real estate scam, and the civil supplies racket, dubbing the current government "Scamgress" for its alleged involvement in corruption both "big or too small."



Kavitha Criticizes Congress Government Over Kukatpally Development And Land Sales

Telangana Jagruthi President Kalvakuntla Kavitha conducted a tour of the Kukatpally constituency on Monday, December 8, where she leveled sharp criticisms against the Congress government regarding local development and alleged financial mismanagement. Her visit began with a tribute, as she placed a floral garland on the statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar at the Y-Junction.

Speaking to the media afterward, Kavitha emphasized Kukatpally's immense significance, describing it as a "Mini India" because of its diverse population. However, she contrasted this cultural importance with the lack of economic accessibility, highlighting the severe hardship faced by the working class: "The poor here cannot even afford to rent a house." She strongly criticized the government's priorities, accusing the Congress administration of selling land worth an estimated 2,000



crores in the Medchal district (which includes Kukatpally) but failing to spend even a single rupee on the development of the Kukatpally constituency itself. She pointed to a stark absence of basic amenities, including the lack of even a single stadium in the area. Kavitha questioned the validity of the government's grand ambitions, asking how Hyderabad could be called a "Global City" when a key area like Kukatpally suffers

from severe infrastructural shortcomings, such as the "intense traffic problem" near the JNTU Metro Station. She charged the ruling party with political neglect, asserting that leaders only visit the area to ask for votes during elections and fail to address the public's grievances at any other time. She also criticized the opposition BRS (her own party's) relative silence, stating that since the ruling party is neglecting the issues and the opposition

is not actively questioning them, Telangana Jagruthi has taken on the responsibility to question the government on behalf of the people. Kavitha concluded with a firm demand to the Congress government, insisting that they must stop merely "selling lands" and instead focus seriously on the development of Kukatpally, ensuring the promised 'Global City' benefits reach all its residents.

BJP MLA Rakesh Reddy followed Raja On Party's Strategy

A growing internal dissent regarding the political strategy of the state leadership has emerged within the Telangana unit of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). Following recent critical comments by Goshamahal ML A T. Raja Singh, Armoor MLA P. Rakesh Reddy has now joined the criticism, publicly urging for a significant change in the party's strategic "format" to effectively secure power in Telangana.

Rakesh Reddy voiced his displeasure with the State BJP leadership while speaking at a party protest program held in Hyderabad on Sunday. His critique centered on a direct comparison between the BJP's performance in Telangana and its successes in other states. He specifically cited the party's strong organizational performance and electoral achievements in states like Maharashtra and Bihar, contrasting them with the party's perceived struggles and strategic failures in Telangana. The MLA mentioned that the public is actively ques-



tioning local BJP leaders about the party's overall performance and effectiveness within the state, indicating a lack of clear direction or visible success that voters can rally behind. The joining of Rakesh Reddy, a sitting MLA, with the criticisms previously raised by Raja Singh underscores a significant internal demand for strategic overhaul. Both leaders, by publicly

expressing their discontent and calling for a change in the "format" or strategy, are signaling that the current state leadership's approach is deemed insufficient to achieve the party's goal of unseating the Congress and gaining power in Telangana. Their public statements reflect a feeling among some party ranks that the BJP needs to adopt a more aggressive, or-

ganized, and perhaps localized strategy that resonates more effectively with the Telangana electorate, mirroring the successful models used in other parts of the country where the party has secured major electoral victories. This public push for change puts immediate pressure on the state leadership to reassess and reform its political action plan.

DGP B. Shivadhar Reddy Conducts Extensive Inspection of Global Summit Security Arrangements; Holds Courtesy Meeting with Korea’s Consul General

The public outreach initiative took place on Monday in the Babu Bagh Colony area of the Ramgopalpet division. The Corporator, responding to a call from the local Babu Bagh Women Welfare Association, walk



ed through the colony for approximately two hours, accompanied by officials from various key government departments, police officers, and local women representatives. During this extensive tour, local women brought numerous critical issues directly to the Corporator’s attention. The primary concerns raised by the colony residents included the significant disturbance caused by the haphazard parking of vehicles on the roads, creating congestion and safety issues, and the particularly worrying menace of drunkards (mandhubabula bedada) causing security threats and public nuisance during night hours. The Corporator immediately responded to the safety concerns by directing the local Police Inspector, Narsing Rao, to take swift and effective action to resolve these problems immediately. Furthermore, residents pointed out a severe public health

issue, reporting that sewage was overflowing (drainage ponguntundi) from three different locations. The Corporator immediately brought this issue to the attention of the Water Board official, Ashish, giving firm instructions to take immediate steps to find a permanent “solution” or “relief” (moksham kaligela) for the drainage problem. She also raised technical issues concerning essential services, specifically pointing out the persistent problem of low voltage electricity (Low Current) to the Electrical officials, Durga Prasad and Shivaram.

Government Services to the People: MLA Sri Ganesh Reviews ‘Cantonment Vani’ Preparations

Cantonment MLA Sri Ganesh undertook a crucial and active inspection of the operational arrangements for the upcoming ‘Cantonment Vani’ public outreach program, which is specifically designed to bring government services closer to the people, similar to the operations of the Chief Minister’s Office. The key event is scheduled to be held on Wednesday, December 10, at the Gun Bazaar Community Hall in Rasoolpura (Ward 2). MLA Sri Ganesh, accompanied by local Congress party leaders, personally reviewed all the logistical and physical arrangements on Monday, December 8. The primary focus of the review was to ensure that citizens attending the ‘Cantonment Vani’ would face “no inconvenience whatsoever” (entuvanti ibbandhi lekundaa) while submitting their petitions and that the event would operate in an orderly, efficient, and accessible manner for all. Following

the detailed site inspection, MLA Sri Ganesh briefed the media representatives, explaining the core objective and significant benefits of the ‘Cantonment Vani’ program. He explicitly stated that the platform has been established to enable officials from various key state government departments to directly receive public petitions and appeals from the citizens. Specifically, senior officials from critical state government bodies, including the Revenue, Electricity, Civil Supplies, Police, and Forest Departments, will be present. In addition to these state officials, the Cantonment Board Chief Executive Officer (CEO), along with senior officials from core Cantonment Board departments such as Health, Sanitation, Engineering, Electricity, and Water Departments, will also participate in the event.
The MLA strongly emphasized that these officials will be authorized to personally receive the public’s griev-

ances (neruga sweet karinchina), and their central commitment is to work towards the “swift resolution” of these presented issues. He highlighted the significant benefit of the arrangement, which is designed to “eliminate the need for people to endlessly commute to government offices” (prabhuthva kaaryaalaayaalakuthirigae panilekundaa) by bringing problem-solving services directly to them. MLA Sri Ganesh concluded his address by issuing a sincere public appeal to all residents of the constituency, urging them to fully “utilize this rare opportunity” (sadvin chesukovaalini) provided by the ‘Cantonment Vani’ to get their long-standing issues addressed quickly and efficiently. He further noted that the program is intended to reduce the distance between government systems and the public, thereby making governance more transparent and accessible, marking it as an important welfare initiative.

Hyderabad Realtor Brutally Murdered in Broad Daylight

A chilling and horrific murder occurred on a public road in Hyderabad, sending shockwaves through the city. The victim was ambushed and brutally killed by unidentified assailants in a highly organized attack, suggesting a premeditated crime. The incident took place within the jurisdiction of the Jawahar Nagar Police Station under the Rachakonda Commissionerate. The victim was identified by the police as Venkata Ratnam, a real estate businessman. Police investigation

strongly concluded that the assailants had carried out the killing according to a “pre-planned scheme” (pakka pathakam prakaramae), strongly pointing towards a motive related to his business dealings or a personal feud.
The tragic incident unfolded near the Foster Billabong School in Saketh Colony. The victim, Venkata Ratnam, was traveling alone on his motorcycle when he was swiftly pursued (vambadinchinaaru) by the assailants on another bike. Choosing a public road during the day, the attackers selected their

moment and launched a savage and unprovoked attack on the realtor right in the middle of the road.
The assault was executed with extreme brutality and lethal force: the assailants first attacked the victim using a machete (Veta Kathathi). Not satisfied with the initial brutal assault, they then fired a revolver (revolver tho shoot chesi) at him, completing the heinous act in front of terrified passersby. The sudden, loud sound of gunshots (tupakula shabdham) and the horrifying sight of the violence sent local

residents into a state of panic and fear (bhayaan-dolanalaku gurayayaru).
After committing the murder, the assailants immediately fled the scene on their bike. Local residents promptly informed the police, who rushed immediately to the crime scene (ghatanaa sthalaaniki cherukunnaru). The realtor, Venkata Ratnam, was confirmed to have died instantly on the spot (spotlae mruthi chesinatlu) due to the combined severity of the injuries. Police transported the body to a government hospital for a post-mortem examination and informed the victim’s family members of the tragic death. Crucially, the police recovered a spent bullet (bullet nu) from the crime scene, which will serve as key evidence in the investigation. The police have registered a formal case and initiated a detailed investigation to determine the exact motive—whether financial, personal, or business-related—and to swiftly identify and apprehend the assailants responsible for this shocking act of violence committed in the city’s jurisdiction.

Samantha Makes First Public Appearance Post-Wedding, Spotted in Gachibowli

IndiGo Cancels 112 Flights at Hyderabad Airport Amid Operational Issues

The Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA) in Hyderabad experienced significant and widespread operational disruptions on Monday as IndiGo Airlines, a major domestic carrier, announced large-scale flight cancellations. This drastic measure severely impacted hundreds of passengers travelling to and from various states, resulting in considerable inconvenience, confusion, and travel delays throughout the day. A total of 112 IndiGo flights were canceled in a single day, highlighting the severity of the underlying operational issues the airline was facing.
According to specific details provided by airline officials, the total number of cancellations was split almost equally between arrivals and departures. The list of canceled flights included 54 IndiGo flights that were originally scheduled to de-

part from RGIA for various destinations across the country. Additionally, a significant number of 58 incoming flights that were scheduled to arrive at RGIA from different states were also canceled. This mass cancellation underscored the immediate operational challenges faced by the airline on that specific day, leading to unavoidable schedule alterations and delays across the entire network connected to Hyderabad. The sheer scale of the disruption, with over a hundred flights affected, constituted a major air travel crisis at one of South India’s busiest international and domestic travel hubs. The widespread cancellations made it clear that a major systemic issue was impacting the airline’s schedule reliability.
IndiGo immediately issued an urgent public advisory, strongly urging all passengers who had booked tickets to or from Hyderabad to check their flight sta-

tus (flight status) well in advance of their scheduled departure time. The airline requested affected passengers to contact their customer support channels or consult the airline’s official website and other public communication platforms for the most updated information regarding the operational cancellations. Furthermore, IndiGo strongly advised passengers whose flights were confirmed to be canceled to immediately make “alternative travel arrangements” (alternative travel arrangements), taking into consideration the scope and severe impact of the ongoing operational disruptions. The heavy reliance on prompt self-action by passengers emphasized the crisis management approach. This massive disruption forced airport management and airline ground staff to handle a large volume of stranded and rerouted passengers throughout the day.

Severe Cold-Wave Like Conditions Prevail Across Hyderabad and Telangana Districts

Severe cold-wave like conditions have suddenly gripped Telangana, causing minimum temperatures to plummet drastically across Hyderabad and numerous districts. Mercury levels fell sharply to single digits in multiple parts of the state over the last 24 hours, marking a significant change in the weather pattern and prompting health advisories. The state capital and its surrounding regions experienced a particularly noticeable drop in tem-



perature. According to the data meticulously collected and released by the Telangana Development Planning Society (TGDPs), the lowest minimum temperature recorded within the Hyderabad metropolitan area was a chilling 8.4°C. This reading was specifically recorded at the Hyderabad Central University campus in Serilingampally, measured during the period between Sunday evening and the early hours of Monday morning, highlighting the intensity of the cold wave in the city's west-

ern suburbs.

The TGDPs data further detailed the widespread nature of the cold conditions across the capital. Other key locations in Hyderabad where minimum temperatures fell considerably include: Rajendranagar, which recorded 10.1°C; Alwal and BHEL, which both registered 10.6°C; RC Puram saw temperatures drop to 12.2°C; and both Neredmet and Chandanagar recorded minimum temperatures of 12.4°C. These figures clearly illustrate that the

chilling air was not confined to a single locality but was prevalent across the entire city's geography. Moving beyond the capital, the severe cold was even more pronounced across the districts of Telangana, with many areas reporting minimum temperatures ranging between a brisk 6°C and 10°C. The prevalence of temperatures at or near the 6°C mark indicates significant ground frost conditions in certain pockets, which can affect agriculture and put vulnerable populations at high risk.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a forecast indicating that these severe cold conditions are not expected to abate immediately. In fact, the IMD predicts that the state will continue to experience colder nights over the next two to three days.

This persistent cold is expected to affect isolated pockets across Telangana, increasing the severity of the challenge for the general public, especially for the elderly, children, and homeless populations. The continuous drop in temperature necessitates a collective effort from citizens to take essential precautions, such as ensuring proper heating, wearing adequate warm clothing, and avoiding unnecessary exposure during the late night and early morning hours when the temperatures are at their lowest point. The current weather system has caused widespread shivering and has necessitated the deployment of local resources to manage the cold's impact across the region.

Woman Brutally Murdered By Live-In Partner In Bhainsa, Nirmal District

A shocking and brutal murder has been reported from Bhainsa town in the Nirmal district of Telangana, where a 27-year-old woman was tragically killed in an act of domestic violence on Monday morning. The horrific incident took place at a tea point she operated, located near the Santo Shimata Temple within the town limits. According to details gathered from local residents, the deceased woman was originally from Kumsara village. She had been previously married and was the mother of two children. However, she had obtained a divorce from her husband and was living separately, away from her family. During this period, she formed a relationship with a man identified as Nagesh, a resident of

Ambedkar Nagar in Bhainsa. The two had been living together (sahajeevanam chesunnaru) as live-in partners. The woman had been running the tea point as a means of earning a livelihood (upadhi kosam) to support herself and her children.

The devastating tragedy unfolded on Monday morning when the sound of screams (kekalu) emanating from the tea point alerted the local residents nearby. Rushing to the scene, the horrified locals discovered the woman's body. She was lying dead in a pool of blood (raktapu mudugulo vigatajeevigaa), having been brutally murdered, reportedly at the hands of Nagesh. The suspect, Nagesh, was found calmly sitting right next to the deceased woman's body. The locals immediately raised the alarm and informed the police about the shocking discovery.

Upon receiving the information, Bhainsa police officers, including the Circle Inspector (CI) Gopinath, swiftly arrived at the scene of the crime. The police immediately took Nagesh into custody (aduloki teeskunnaru), arresting him on the spot as the prime suspect in the murder. CI Gopinath confirmed that the police have registered a formal case (Case nonda chesi) in connection with the brutal murder under relevant sections of the law. He stated that a detailed investigation (Dharvastu chepattinattu) has been initiated to ascertain the exact motive behind the heinous crime, which is strongly suspected to be a result of a personal dispute between the live-in partners. The investigation will focus on any recent quarrels, the circumstances leading up to the killing, and gathering forensic evidence. The brutal killing in a public space has sent a wave of shock and concern through Bhainsa, further highlighting the grim consequences of domestic violence and disputes in intimate relationships.

Cybercrime Police Seek Extended Custody of iBomma Administrator Ravi



Hyderabad: In a significant development in the ongoing investigation into major film piracy cases, the Cybercrime Police have taken another step forward by filing a revision petition seeking an extension of custody for iBomma administrator Ravi, who was recently arrested for his alleged involvement in large-scale piracy operations.

The police, in their petition, stated that the three-day custody period granted earlier by the court for interrogation is insufficient for a thorough investigation. The court had approved one day of custody for each of the three registered cases, amounting to a total of three days. However, officials argued that

the probe spans four cases in total, and examining all aspects within such a short duration is not feasible.

The Cybercrime Police emphasized that a minimum of five days of custodial interrogation is necessary to uncover vital information linked to the piracy of high-budget and recently released films such as Kuber, Kishkindha Puri, Tandale, and HIT. Investigators believe that Ravi possesses crucial details regarding the distribution networks, financial channels, and the broader ecosystem behind the large-scale illegal release and circulation of these films.

The petition notes that extended custody is essential to extract complete information

about the modus operandi, technical infrastructure, and any potential collaboration with national or international piracy syndicates. With online film piracy causing significant revenue loss to the film industry, the police are treating this case as a high-priority investigation.

As the court evaluates the revision petition, all eyes are now on the impending decision. Whether the court will accept the police department's request for extended custody remains to be seen. The ruling is expected to play a key role in directing the next phase of the investigation into one of the most notable piracy crackdowns in recent times.

Man Chokes To Death On Chicken Piece In Sircilla

A highly unusual and devastating domestic accident was reported from the Rajanna Sircilla district, resulting in the sudden death of a 45-year-old man. The deceased, identified as Pati Surender, a resident of Gollapally in Yellareddy mandal, tragically passed away on Sunday afternoon. Surender, who was known to the villagers as a trolley auto driver who also worked at a local kirana store, was having a routine lunch with his family members at their residence in the KCR double-bedroom colony when the fatal incident occurred. While consuming a chicken curry, a large chicken piece unexpectedly became lodged in his throat. The obstruction caused immediate and severe difficulty in breathing (Suffered severe difficulty in breathing), rapidly escalating into a life-threatening emergency. His family members,

witnessing the sudden and severe distress, immediately tried to help him by attempting to pull out the lodged piece. Despite their desperate and frantic efforts to clear the airway obstruction, they were tragically unsuccessful in their attempts to save him. The villagers and family were unable to dislodge the food item in time, leading to his unfortunate and premature demise due to suffocation. The tragic and unexpected nature of the death sent shockwaves through the small community. Pati Surender is survived by his wife and two young daughters, leaving the family in deep grief over the sudden and unforeseen loss of their patriarch. This incident serves as a stark reminder of the acute and sudden danger associated with choking, which can rapidly lead to death if the obstruction is not cleared immediately.

Tension Builds Ahead of Ichoda Major Gram Panchayat Elections

With just two days left for the Ichoda Major Gram Panchayat elections, political activity has reached a peak and tension is mounting among the candidates contesting for the Sarpanch position. Locally, the Sarpanch post holds significant influence—almost comparable to that of an MLA within the village constituency—making the competition even more intense.

The Ichoda Major Gram Panchayat, reserved for the ST category, has five candidates in the race. As polling day approaches, the key questions resonating among the voters are: Who truly stands in the main contest? Who has the winning edge?

For nearly 15 years, the local governance has been dominated by one

family. According to villagers and community elders, Chauhan Devanand had reportedly secured the Sarpanch position multiple times using a disputed ST certificate, despite belonging to a different community. Based on complaints from members of the Lambada community, district authorities reviewed the matter, following which the High Court cancelled his ST certificate, rendering him ineligible to contest.

Following this setback, Devanand's nomination for the present election was rejected. In a strategic move to retain influence over the Panchayat, he has now fielded his daughter-in-law, who belongs to a Scheduled Tribe community, as a candidate. This development has sparked discus-

sions and curiosity among the electorate regarding whether the family can maintain its long-held hold on local leadership or whether voters will opt for a change.

With five ST candidates actively campaigning, ground-level dynamics are rapidly shifting. Community sentiment, local alliances, government welfare beneficiaries, and longstanding leadership impressions are all expected to play a crucial role in determining the outcome.

As the election day nears, the atmosphere in Ichoda Major is charged with anticipation. Voters and observers alike are keenly watching how the final phase of campaigning unfolds and which candidate will ultimately

Priyanka Gandhi Questions Timing of “Vande Mataram” Debate, Links It to Bengal Elections

Indian cricket superstar Virat Kohli has taken a major step in transforming his lifestyle and athleisure brand, One8, by investing ₹40 crore and partnering with Indian sportswear startup Agilitas Sports. The move marks a strategic shift from his previous association with global sportswear brand Puma to becoming an equity stakeholder in a home-grown company, giving him greater control over the brand he co-founded.

Under the deal, Kohli has acquired a 1.94 percent stake in Agilitas through compulsorily convertible preference shares, enabling him to have a direct role in decision-making, design, manufacturing, marketing, and overall strategic growth. The partnership also positions One8 as an independent global brand under the management of Agilitas, which will be responsible for scaling operations and expanding its footprint in both domestic and international markets.

One8, originally launched in 2017 under Puma, has been known for its mix of sports performance wear and casual lifestyle apparel. With Kohli’s investment and Agilitas’s operational support, the brand is set to en-



ter a new phase aimed at establishing itself as a major player in the athleisure and sportswear market. Plans include refreshed product lines, footwear expansions, and a stronger presence in retail, e-commerce, and international distribution channels.

Industry analysts say the move reflects Kohli’s long-term vision to own and control his brand rather than simply endorsing a multinational company. While his previous contract with Puma

was reportedly worth ₹110 crore, and renewal offers were estimated around ₹300 crore, Kohli chose to invest in Agilitas to retain strategic control and ensure his brand’s identity aligns with his vision. This decision highlights a growing trend among athletes and celebrities in India who prefer ownership and equity over endorsement fees alone, aiming for sustainable brand growth and global recognition.

Agilitas Sports, founded

in 2023 by former Puma India executive Abhishek Ganguly, operates as a full-stack sportswear platform. The startup handles everything from manufacturing to distribution and licensing, allowing brands like One8 to leverage its infrastructure and expertise to scale efficiently. Kohli’s association brings not just capital, but significant brand value and credibility, further boosting the startup’s profile and ambitions.

The partnership also

carries broader implications for India’s sportswear industry. With the athleisure market rapidly expanding, driven by rising fitness awareness and lifestyle trends, domestic brands are increasingly competing with global giants. By backing a home-grown venture, Kohli and Agilitas aim to capture a larger share of this growing market while offering high-quality, performance-driven products with a distinctly Indian identity.

Beyond commercial objectives, this move represents Kohli’s desire to shape a lasting brand legacy. By investing directly and becoming a stakeholder, he has transitioned from a brand ambassador to a strategic owner, ensuring that One8’s direction, values, and global expansion remain aligned with his vision.

As One8 enters this new chapter, the coming years will reveal whether the combination of celebrity influence, homegrown infrastructure, and strategic investment can propel it into the top tier of global sportswear brands. For Kohli, this venture is not only a business opportunity but also a statement of intent to create a sustainable, globally recognized Indian lifestyle brand.

Club Owners Flee After Deadly Goa Fire, Probe Intensifies



A major controversy has erupted after the owners of a popular nightclub in Goa allegedly fled the country just hours after a devastating fire at their venue killed 25 people, triggering nationwide outrage and raising serious questions about safety compliance and accountability.

The tragic blaze broke out late at night at a crowded nightclub in the northern part of Goa. According to officials, the fire spread rapidly through the premises, trapping several workers and guests inside. Most of the victims reportedly died due to suffocation as toxic smoke filled the enclosed areas, while others suffered fatal burn injuries. The suddenness of the incident left little time for evacuation, turning a festive evening into a scene of chaos and horror.

Soon after the incident, police registered criminal cases against the club’s owners, management staff, and event organisers on charges related to negligence and violation of safety norms. Investigators revealed that the establishment allegedly lacked mandatory fire safety clearances and had insufficient emer-

gency exits. Early findings also suggested that the building structure may not have been authorised for high-capacity commercial use.

What has shocked authorities and the public alike is the revelation that the club’s owners are believed to have flown out of India within hours of the incident. Immigration records indicated that they left the country before police could detain or question them. Their sudden departure has been widely condemned as an attempt to evade law enforcement and avoid responsibility for the tragedy.

In response, law enforcement agencies have issued lookout circulars and alerted airports and international authorities to track their movements. Efforts are underway to secure their return through international legal cooperation. Senior police officials confirmed that extradition proceedings may be initiated if the accused do not return voluntarily.

The Goa government has ordered a high-level magisterial inquiry into the incident. Several local officials have been suspended for their alleged failure to properly inspect the premises

and enforce safety regulations. The building has been sealed, and similar venues across the state are now being inspected to prevent any repeat of such a disaster.

Families of the victims have demanded swift justice and strict punishment for those responsible. Survivors and eyewitnesses described harrowing scenes of panic, blocked exits, and overwhelming smoke that made escape nearly impossible. Many questioned how such a venue was allowed to operate without basic fire safety arrangements.

The tragedy has sparked a broader debate about lax enforcement of safety rules in nightlife and entertainment venues, not just in Goa but across the country. Public safety experts have called for stricter compliance checks, regular audits, and harsh penalties for violations.

As investigations continue, the focus remains on bringing the accused to justice and ensuring that accountability is not avoided. The incident stands as a grim reminder of the consequences of negligence and the urgent need for stronger oversight to protect lives in public spaces.

Congress Suspends Navjot Kaur Sidhu After Controversial Remark

The Indian National Congress has suspended Navjot Kaur Sidhu, wife of former Punjab Congress president Navjot Singh Sidhu, following a major political backlash over her controversial public remarks. The decision comes just days after her statement sparked outrage across party circles and opposition parties.

The controversy erupted when Navjot Kaur Sidhu allegedly claimed that becoming a Chief Minister requires a “suitcase of ₹500 crore.” The remark, made during an interaction with the media, was seen as suggesting that top political posts could be obtained through money rather than merit. The statement quickly went viral and triggered sharp reactions from rival political parties, who accused the Congress of openly admitting to corruption in its ranks.

Reacting quickly to the damage caused by the comment, the Punjab unit of the Congress announced her suspension with immediate effect. Senior party leaders said the remark had caused serious harm to the party’s reputation and discipline, especially at a time when the Congress is trying to rebuild its image and strengthen its organisational structure in Punjab.

Navjot Kaur Sidhu later issued a clarification,



saying that her words had been misunderstood. She claimed she never meant that such a transaction actually takes place, and insisted that neither she nor her husband had offered or received money for any political post. However, the clarification did little to calm the political storm, as opposition parties continued to target the Congress over the statement.

The episode has once again highlighted the internal tensions within the Punjab Congress. The Sidhu family has been at the centre of several political controversies in recent years, and this latest incident has further strained relations between different factions of the party. Many senior leaders reportedly felt that such public comments were irresponsible and undermined the party’s fight against corruption.

Political observers believe the suspension is

also a message by the Congress high command that indiscipline and public statements damaging the party’s image will not be tolerated. The party appears keen to avoid giving its rivals fresh ammunition, especially with future electoral battles on the horizon.

The controversy has sparked a wider debate about the influence of money in politics and the need for greater transparency in political appointments across parties. While the Congress has distanced itself from the remark, the issue has reignited discussions about political funding and internal democracy.

For now, Navjot Kaur Sidhu remains suspended from the party, and the incident stands as a reminder of how a single controversial comment can trigger major political consequences in India’s highly competitive political landscape.

Paramount Makes Rival Bid to Acquire Warner Bros Discovery

Paramount Skydance has launched a rival bid to acquire Warner Bros Discovery, seeking to outmanoeuvre Netflix in its ongoing effort to purchase the studio and streaming networks. Backed by the billionaire Ellison family, Paramount has offered shareholders \$30 per share for the entirety of Warner Bros, including its traditional television networks, valuing the company at roughly \$108.4 billion — higher than Netflix’s \$83 billion proposal.

Paramount’s leadership claims the offer is a “superior alternative” to Netflix’s deal, delivering more immediate cash to shareholders and increasing the likelihood of regulatory approval. President Donald Trump has raised potential competition concerns over Netflix’s acquisition, suggesting the merger might concentrate too much power in the hands of a single company.

The saga began months ago when Paramount submitted initial offers to purchase Warner Bros, prompting the studio, home to HBO and iconic franchises ranging from Looney Tunes to Harry Potter, to open a formal bidding process. Warner Bros initially selected Netflix as the winning bidder, planning to spin off other parts of its business, including CNN, into an independent company as part of the deal.

Paramount’s offer, which includes the traditional television networks, is designed to achieve greater scale and potential cost savings. Larry Ellison, whose family backs Paramount, criticized Warner Bros’ spin-off plan, arguing it would leave traditional networks struggling and undervalued, potentially harming shareholders. He suggested that Netflix’s takeover would grant the streaming giant excessive influence over actors and industry players, calling it “a horrible deal for Hollywood.”

Ellison also noted his “great conversations” with former President Trump

regarding the bid, emphasizing that competition concerns were being considered. Paramount’s bid is supported by financial partners including Jared Kushner, Trump’s son-in-law, according to SEC filings. Analysts view Paramount as a strong suitor in part due to these political connections, which could ease regulatory scrutiny in both the U.S. and Europe.

Market reactions to the bid were immediate: Warner Bros shares rose more than 6% in early trading, Paramount’s stock also gained, while Netflix shares fell over 3%. Netflix, the world’s largest streaming platform with more than 300 million subscribers, expressed confidence in winning regulatory approval and maintaining its growth trajectory through the acquisition.

Industry analysts note that Paramount’s bid is as much defensive as it is strategic, aimed at preventing competitors from obtaining Warner Bros’ vast content library and strengthening rival positions in the media landscape. More than 70% of U.S. HBO Max subscribers also subscribe to Netflix, highlighting the competitive dynamics driving these corporate manoeuvres.

Ben Barringer, head of technology research at Quilter Cheviot, said Paramount needs the deal more than Netflix, describing it as essential for Paramount to remain competitive in an era dominated by scale-driven streaming platforms. “Paramount remains a legacy entertainment provider that lacks the scale required for the modern age,” he said.

As the bidding war continues, the outcome will reshape the media and entertainment landscape, determining the control of one of Hollywood’s most valuable content libraries and influencing the future dynamics of streaming, traditional television, and global media competition.

Trump Administration to Deny Visas for Fact Checkers and Content Moderators



The Trump administration has announced a new visa policy targeting individuals who have worked as fact-checkers, content moderators, online-safety officers, or in similar roles. Under this directive, visa applications may be denied if the applicant is found to have been “responsible for, or complicit in, censorship or attempted censorship of protected speech in the United States.”

The policy is expected to primarily affect H 1B visa applicants, which includes many skilled workers from countries such as India, but it also applies across other visa categories, including work, student, and tourist visas. Visa officers will examine applicants’ professional histories, social media activity, and public profiles to determine involvement in roles linked to content moderation, misinformation control, trust-and-safety work, or fact-checking. Those deemed to have engaged in such activities could face outright denial of their visa applications.

This policy could have a significant impact on Indian professionals. India supplies a large share of the global tech workforce, and many Indians employed by multinational technology companies work in content moderation or trust-and-safety roles. Under the new rules, such individuals could be barred from working in the U.S., even if they meet all other eligibility criteria.

The scope of the policy extends beyond H 1B visas. Students, journalists, and even tourists with a history in online-safety roles may be affected. Critics have noted that the directive’s broad definition of “censorship” could lead to arbitrary visa denials, conflating legitimate content moderation with suppression of speech.

Civil liberties advocates have warned that the visa crackdown threatens free expression and undermines online safety efforts. Profes-

sionals in content moderation do not censor speech but work to protect users from harmful or illegal material. The policy, they argue, penalizes individuals performing essential safety functions and may discourage skilled professionals from entering the U.S. workforce.

The tech industry is likely to feel the effects of this policy. Companies dependent on global trust-and-safety teams could face staffing shortages or increased costs if key personnel are disqualified from U.S. employment. Individuals currently abroad who seek to travel or work in the United States could experience uncertainty, delays, or rejections solely based on prior employment roles.

Looking ahead, the enforcement of this policy may hinge on further clarifications from the U.S. government regarding the definitions of “censorship” and “content moderation.” Legal challenges may also arise, with experts suggesting that penalizing professionals who work to safeguard online expression could conflict with principles of free speech.

The new visa restrictions are expected to influence global tech migration patterns. Skilled workers may seek employment in countries other than the U.S., potentially reshaping where content moderation and trust-and-safety infrastructure are concentrated.

In summary, the Trump administration’s visa ban represents a significant shift in U.S. immigration and tech policy. It has far-reaching implications for individuals who have worked in content moderation or fact-checking roles, particularly in India, while posing challenges for the tech industry in maintaining adequate safety and moderation staffing. The policy underscores the intersection of immigration, technology, and free speech in shaping global workforce dynamics.

Powerful Earthquake Strikes Northern Japan, Tsunami Alert Issued



A strong earthquake struck off the northern coast of Japan on Monday evening, prompting tsunami warnings and immediate emergency responses across the affected region. The Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA) initially reported the tremor as magnitude 7.2, later revised to 7.6, highlighting the intensity of the seismic activity beneath the Pacific Ocean. The epicentre was located off the coasts of Aomori and Hokkaido prefectures, at a depth of approximately 50 to 80 kilometres below sea level.

The quake triggered a tsunami alert for several northern prefectures, including Aomori, Hokkaido, and Iwate. Authorities warned residents in coastal areas of possible sea-level rises of up to three meters and urged immediate evacuation to higher ground. Ports and harbours in affected regions recorded waves reaching up to 40 centimetres, with some towns experiencing localized surges.

Emergency services reacted swiftly to the natural disaster. Local governments ordered the evacuation of vulnerable communities and suspended train services to minimize risk to passengers. In Aomori’s

Hachinohe town, several injuries were reported at a hotel when the tremors shook buildings near the coast. Authorities also conducted safety inspections of nuclear facilities, critical infrastructure, and transportation networks to ensure no additional hazards had arisen from the quake.

The earthquake has brought back memories of Japan’s vulnerability to natural disasters, particularly its history of devastating tsunamis and seismic events due to its position along the Pacific “Ring of Fire.” Past incidents, including the 2011 Tohoku earthquake and

tsunami, have shaped the nation’s comprehensive disaster preparedness and early-warning systems. In the current event, these systems allowed authorities to issue warnings quickly, helping residents evacuate and potentially preventing large-scale casualties.

While coastal communities have been most directly affected, tremors were felt in inland cities, including Tokyo, although no alerts were issued for these regions. Officials continue to monitor aftershocks, which are common following a quake of this magnitude. Disaster-re-

sponse teams have been mobilized across affected areas to provide medical assistance, supplies, and logistical support as needed.

Authorities have stressed the importance of following official instructions and avoiding low-lying areas until the “all-clear” is issued. Many ports remain closed, and coastal travel has been temporarily suspended. Residents are being advised to remain vigilant for aftershocks and any further tsunami warnings, as seismic activity often occurs in clusters following a major earthquake.

Deadly Clashes on Thai-Cambodia Border Force Thousands to Flee

Tensions flared once again along the Thailand-Cambodia border on Monday, forcing thousands of residents on both sides to evacuate as fresh clashes left at least five people dead. Both nations have blamed each other for initiating the violence, marking the most serious confrontation since a ceasefire agreement was reached in July.

Thailand’s Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul stressed that his country “never wanted violence” but pledged to use “necessary means to preserve its sovereignty.” Meanwhile, Cambodia’s former leader Hun Sen accused Thai “invaders” of provoking retaliation. Since May, rising tensions between the neighbours have claimed over 40 lives, disrupted daily life, and prompted import bans and travel restrictions.

The Thai army reported responding to Cambodian fire in Ubon Ratchathani Province, including air strikes along the disputed



border. Cambodia’s Defence ministry, however, asserted that Thai forces initiated the attack in Preah Vihear province. The Monday fighting reportedly killed at least one Thai soldier and four Cambodian civilians, leaving about a dozen others wounded.

Beyond the immediate casualties, the border clashes have taken a heavy toll on children living in affected areas. Thai teacher Siksaka Pongsuwan highlighted the hidden victims of the conflict: children whose education and daily routines are repeatedly interrupted. Nearly 650 schools across five Thai provinces were ordered to close on Monday for safety reasons, while chaotic scenes

were also reported at schools in Cambodian border provinces as parents rushed to take their children home.

This is not the first disruption for children in the region. In July, during critical examinations, five days of intense fighting forced schools to shift to online classes, a solution that was not accessible to all students due to limited internet access and inadequate distribution of digital devices. Social media posts from Cambodian journalist Mech Dara depicted children fleeing schools and eating meals in underground bunkers, highlighting the profound psychological impact of the ongoing conflict.

Pongsuwan described the dilemma faced by local

residents: whether to stay in their villages amid intermittent gunfire or evacuate in search of safety, knowing that either choice carries risk. “If you ask whether we’re scared, yes we are... Should we leave? Will it really be safer? Or should we stay?” he said.

The current flare-up is part of a century-old territorial dispute over an 800-kilometer border that has roots dating back to the French colonial period in Cambodia. The conflict escalated in July when Cambodian forces launched a rocket barrage into Thailand, prompting Thai air strikes. Following days of fighting, the countries agreed to an “immediate and unconditional ceasefire,” bro-

kered by Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim.

In October, a formal ceasefire ceremony was held in Malaysia, with former U.S. President Donald Trump present, where he hailed the agreement as a historic achievement. However, just two weeks later, Thailand suspended parts of the agreement after two of its soldiers were injured by a landmine near the border. Cambodia maintains that it remains committed to the ceasefire, while the cycle of violence continues to threaten lives and disrupt communities along the contested border.

As the latest clashes demonstrate, resolving the long-standing border dispute remains a complex challenge, with civilians — particularly children — bearing the brunt of the conflict. The situation underscores the urgent need for renewed dialogue and robust mechanisms to protect vulnerable populations amid ongoing tensions.

Europe Faces Dual Challenges: Ukraine Summit Highlights Divisions, Greek Farmers Protest

European leaders convened in London on Monday for a high-stakes summit with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, seeking to map out a path toward peace and reconstruction for Ukraine amid ongoing conflict with Russia. The meeting brought together Ukrainian and European leaders, including the United Kingdom’s Prime Minister Keir Starmer, France’s President Emmanuel Macron, and Germany’s Chancellor Friedrich Merz, aiming to unify Europe’s approach to supporting Ukraine. However, sharp differences emerged over a U.S.-backed peace proposal, revealing underlying tensions within the bloc.

While all parties reaffirmed their support for Ukraine, disagreements surfaced regarding the terms of the proposed peace plan. Chancellor Merz expressed scepticism about several aspects, warning that certain clauses could compromise

European unity and risk Ukraine’s territorial integrity. President Macron, meanwhile, stressed that Europe still holds leverage and must use it strategically, advocating a balance between diplomatic pressure on Russia and the reconstruction of Ukraine. President Zelenskyy emphasized Kyiv’s commitment to safeguarding its territory and sovereignty but acknowledged that consensus among European allies remained elusive.

Following the summit, Zelenskyy is scheduled to travel to Brussels for additional talks with EU and NATO officials, underscoring the importance of European support in security guarantees, humanitarian aid, and reconstruction. Observers note that the divided response to the U.S. peace plan highlights the challenges Europe faces in coordinating a unified approach to the ongoing war while managing internal political and economic pressures. Simultaneously,

Europe is grappling with domestic unrest. In Greece, frustrated farmers staged a dramatic protest at Crete International Airport, blocking runways and vandalizing police vehicles over delayed European Union subsidies. The demonstrations forced the cancellation of multiple flights, causing significant disruption for travelers and businesses. Farmers cited rising input costs and bureaucratic delays as the cause of their protests, demanding immediate government intervention and timely disbursement of financial support. The Greek government has responded by calling for dialogue while warning that continued disruption would not be tolerated. Authorities are coordinating with law enforcement to restore order and maintain essential services, emphasizing that the safety of citizens and the functioning of critical infrastructure are priorities. The protests highlight the mounting economic and

social pressures facing European nations, particularly as inflation, energy costs, and policy delays affect vulnerable communities.

The twin developments — the Ukraine summit and Greek farmers’ unrest — illustrate the multiple crises Europe must manage simultaneously. While European leaders work to sustain international solidarity in the face of war, domestic economic and social challenges are testing their governance and resilience. The situation underscores the difficulty of balancing foreign policy priorities with internal stability, especially as public patience grows thin amid economic strain.

For Ukraine, European divisions could complicate reconstruction efforts and delay security guarantees, potentially affecting the long-term trajectory of the conflict. In Greece, the protests serve as a stark reminder that economic stress can quickly escalate into disruptive civil ac-



tion, with potential ripple effects on tourism, trade, and public confidence in government institutions.

As Europe navigates these overlapping crises, the coming weeks will be critical in determining whether political cohesion and effective crisis management can be maintained. Leaders must reconcile differences, address citizen concerns, and uphold regional stability, all while ensuring that Europe continues to play a credible role in global diplomacy and humanitarian assistance. The outcomes of these challenges will shape both the continent’s internal cohesion and its international standing for years to come.

Finance Ministry Confirms No DA-Basic Pay Merger Under 8th Pay Commission



The Ministry of Finance has officially clarified that there are no plans to merge Dearness Allowance (DA) or Dearness Relief (DR) with basic pay under the 8th Central Pay Commission (8th CPC). This clarification comes amid speculation and rising expectations among central government employees and pensioners that the DA, which has risen steadily over the years, might be merged with basic pay to enhance salaries and pensions.

In a written reply to Parliament on 1 December 2025, the Minister of State for Finance, Pankaj Chaudhary,

stated that there is “no proposal regarding merger of the existing dearness allowance with the basic pay” under consideration at present. The statement has put to rest rumors that a significant portion of employees’ pay would be restructured by merging DA with basic pay, which had become a recurring demand among employee unions as DA levels reached more than 58 percent of the basic salary.

Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief are designed to protect central government employees and pensioners from inflation. DA is a cost-of-living adjust-

ment that is revised twice a year based on the Consumer Price Index. Similarly, DR is paid to pensioners, ensuring that retirees receive an adjustment that maintains the real value of their pension. The merger of DA with basic pay would not only raise monthly salaries and pensions but would also have cascading effects on allowances, benefits, and pension calculations, which are linked to basic pay. Such a move would involve significant budgetary implications for the government.

The clarification by the Finance Ministry indicates that, for now, the existing

structure of separate basic pay and DA will continue. This means that allowances calculated as a percentage of basic pay, such as house rent allowance (HRA) and travel allowance (TA), will remain unaffected by DA revisions. Similarly, pension calculations for retired employees will continue to follow the current norms without incorporating DA into the basic pension amount. The government has emphasized that any changes to the pay structure will be formally announced, and until then, employees and pensioners should continue to follow the existing system.

The 8th Pay Commission, tasked with reviewing and recommending improvements to the pay structure of central government employees, will continue to evaluate overall compensation, allowances, and benefits. However, the Terms of Reference (ToR) for the commission do not currently include a proposal to merge DA with basic pay. This decision provides clarity for employees who had been awaiting possible changes, enabling them to plan their finances and expectations accordingly.

While the DA continues to rise in response to inflation,

its separate disbursement ensures that employees and pensioners receive timely adjustments to cope with rising prices. Merging DA with basic pay could have resulted in higher salaries but would have also increased the financial burden on the government and affected other linked benefits. The Finance Ministry’s statement underscores that the government remains committed to maintaining a clear and predictable pay structure while ensuring that employees are adequately compensated for inflationary pressures.

In conclusion, central government employees and pensioners will continue to receive DA and DR separately from basic pay under the 8th Pay Commission. While discussions around pay revision continue, there is no current proposal to merge DA into basic pay. Employees and pensioners are advised to continue following the existing framework for salaries and pensions, as allowances and benefits tied to basic pay will remain unchanged. The government’s clarification ensures stability and transparency in the pay system, even as the 8th Pay Commission works on overall compensation reforms.

Starlink Reveals Subscription Price for India, Targets Rural Connectivity

Satellite-based internet service provider Starlink has officially revealed its subscription pricing for the Indian market, marking a major step toward the commercial launch of high-speed satellite internet in the country. The announcement has generated strong interest, especially among users in rural and remote regions where traditional broadband connectivity remains unreliable or completely unavailable.

According to the details shared, Starlink’s residential internet plan in India will cost approximately ₹6,000 per month. In addition to the monthly fee, customers will be required to pay a one-time hardware and installation charge of around ₹34,000. This equipment includes a satellite dish, mounting bracket, router, cables, and power supply that are essential for connecting to the low-earth orbit satellite network.

The service promises unlimited data usage, removing concerns about data caps or speed throttling that are common with some conventional broadband

and mobile internet plans. One of Starlink’s key selling points is its ability to provide high-speed and low-latency internet even in geographically challenging areas such as mountains, forests, deserts, and remote villages. The company claims that its satellite network can deliver consistent connectivity with uptime of more than 99 percent, even during adverse weather conditions.

Starlink’s entry into India comes at a time when the country is seeing rapid digital growth, with increasing dependence on online education, remote work, digital payments, and e-commerce. However, large parts of rural and semi-urban India still suffer from patchy or slow internet access due to the high cost of laying fiber-optic cables or building mobile towers in difficult terrain. Satellite internet services like Starlink aim to bridge this digital divide by delivering internet directly from space to users’ homes and offices.

Despite the technological promise, the pricing has



raised questions about affordability. Compared to existing fiber and mobile data plans in urban India, Starlink’s monthly charges are significantly higher. This means the service is likely to attract a niche user base initially, including people living in remote areas, professionals who require stable internet for work, and businesses operating in locations with poor connectivity. For many average urban households, the high cost may make traditional broadband and 4G/5G services a more practical option.

The company has also announced a 30-day trial period for new users, allowing customers to test the service before fully committing. This move is expected to help build trust and demonstrate the performance of satellite-based internet in real-world Indian conditions. Industry experts believe that as the satellite network expands and more users come on board, prices could gradually become more competitive in the future.

Starlink has not yet disclosed pricing details for business or enterprise-level

plans in India. Further announcements are expected in the coming months as the company completes regulatory approvals and finalizes its rollout strategy.

Overall, Starlink’s pricing announcement marks an important milestone in India’s digital journey. While the service may not replace traditional broadband in cities anytime soon, it has the potential to transform connectivity in rural and underserved regions, bringing reliable high-speed internet to areas that have long remained off the digital grid.

Public Sector Banks Write Off ₹6 Lakh Crore in Bad Loans, Government Informs Parliament



India’s public sector banks (PSBs) have written off bad loans worth more than ₹6 lakh crore over the past five and a half years, the government informed Parliament, highlighting the scale of the clean-up exercise undertaken to strengthen the banking system.

According to official data shared by the Ministry of Finance, PSBs wrote off around ₹6.15 lakh crore in

non-performing assets (NPAs) between the financial years 2020–21 and 2025–26 (up to September 30, 2025). The government clarified that these write-offs are an accounting practice and do not mean that the loans have been waived. Borrowers remain legally liable to repay their dues, and banks continue to pursue recovery through legal and institutional channels.

The write-off process allows banks to remove long-pending bad loans from their balance sheets after making full provisions against them. This helps banks present a more accurate picture of their financial health and frees up capital for fresh lending. Officials emphasized that recovery measures remain active under various laws, including proceedings through debt recovery tri-

bunals, asset seizures, and insolvency processes.

Over the years, public sector banks have faced mounting stress due to large corporate defaults, infrastructure project delays, and economic slowdowns. To address the problem, the government and the Reserve Bank of India have pushed banks to recognize stressed assets early and clean up their balance sheets. The large-scale write-offs reflect this strategy of resolving legacy bad loans rather than allowing them to remain indefinitely on books.

At the same time, the government highlighted that PSBs have strengthened their financial position by raising funds from the market and improving internal controls and credit appraisal systems. This has helped reduce the overall ratio of bad loans in the banking system and restore confidence in public sector banks.

However, the high value of write-offs has sparked

debate about borrower accountability and the impact on public finances. Critics argue that repeated write-offs could create moral hazard if defaulters are not held responsible. The government insisted that strict monitoring and recovery efforts are in place to ensure that wilful defaulters face legal consequences.

Experts believe that while write-offs are necessary for banking sector stability, long-term reforms are equally important. Strengthening credit risk management, improving project appraisal, and faster resolution of stressed assets are seen as key to preventing a repeat of such large-scale loan problems in the future.

The disclosure underscores the challenges faced by India’s banking sector and the continued efforts to balance financial stability with accountability, as banks work toward healthier balance sheets and sustainable credit growth.

SBI Home Loan Portfolio Crosses ₹9 Lakh Crore, Sets New Banking Milestone



The State Bank of India (SBI) has achieved a major milestone in the housing finance sector, with its home loan portfolio crossing the ₹9 lakh crore mark. This landmark achievement highlights the strong and sustained demand for housing loans across the country and underlines SBI’s dominant position in India’s mortgage market.

Bank officials said the milestone reflects robust growth in the retail lending segment, driven by rising urbanization, increasing preference for home ownership, and improved access to affordable credit. Rupee Slips to 90.09 Against Dollar as Global and Domestic Pressures Weigh on Currency



The Indian rupee weakened further in the foreign exchange market, closing at ₹90.09 against the US dollar after falling by 14 paise in a single trading session. The decline reflects a mix of global uncertainties and domestic demand for foreign currency, highlighting the growing pressure on emerging market currencies in an increasingly volatile global environment.

Market participants said the rupee remained under pressure throughout the day as importer demand for dollars stayed strong, particularly from oil marketing companies and firms dependent on imported raw materials. India’s heavy dependence on crude oil imports makes the currency especially sensitive to fluctuations in global oil prices, and rising energy costs tend to increase the country’s demand for dollars, weakening the local currency.

In addition to import-driven demand, continued outflows by foreign institutional investors added to the negative sentiment. Global investors have been trimming their exposure to emerging markets as they seek safer assets amid concerns over global economic growth, geopolitical tensions, and uncertainty around future interest rate policies in major economies. These outflows reduce the supply of dollars in the domestic market, putting further pressure on the rupee.

The weakening of the rupee has broader implications for the Indian economy. A softer currency makes imports more expensive, which can lead to higher prices for fuel, electronics, fertilizers, and industrial inputs. This, in turn, can add to inflationary pressures at a time when households are already coping with rising costs of living. Businesses that rely heavily on imported components may also face higher operating costs, which

could be passed on to consumers.

However, the weaker rupee is not without its benefits. Export-oriented sectors such as information technology, pharmaceuticals, textiles, and engineering goods stand to gain, as their foreign earnings translate into higher revenues in rupee terms. Remittances from Indians working overseas also become more valuable when converted into domestic currency, offering some relief to recipient households.

Currency analysts believe the rupee’s movement is also linked to the global strength of the US dollar, which has been buoyed by expectations that the US central bank may keep interest rates elevated for longer than previously expected. A stronger dollar typically weighs on other currencies, particularly those of developing economies that are more vulnerable to capital flow reversals.

Looking ahead, the direction of the rupee is likely to be influenced by several key factors, including global crude oil prices, foreign investment flows, and any possible intervention by the Reserve Bank of India to curb excessive volatility. While the central bank has substantial foreign exchange reserves to manage sharp movements, it generally allows the market to determine the currency’s value within a broad range.

For now, the rupee’s fall to the 90 level against the dollar is being closely watched by policymakers, businesses, and investors. Any further sharp depreciation could amplify inflation risks and increase the cost of servicing foreign debt, while a period of stability would help restore confidence. As global economic signals remain mixed, the rupee is expected to remain volatile in the near term.

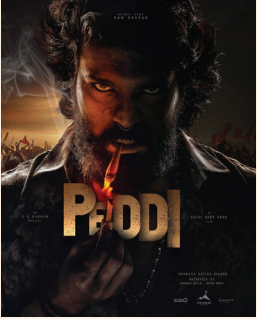
