Indian Railways Proposes Vijayawada–Visakhapatnam Bullet Train Project

Indian Railways has taken a significant step toward transforming rail connectivity in Andhra Pradesh with a proposal to introduce a bullet train corridor between Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam — two of the state's most important urban and economic hubs. The proposal, recently submitted to the Railway Board, aims to pave the way for high-speed rail operations along this key route.

Under the plan, a dedicated high-speed rail corridor stretching roughly 350 kilometres would be constructed, enabling trains to operate at speeds of up to 320 km/h. If realised, the bullet train could cut travel times dramatically, offering passengers a fast, modern alternative to existing services and significantly improving connectivity along the state's eastern coast.

Railway officials have sought approval from the Railway Board to carry out a Final Location Survey (FLS) — an essential preliminary step that will define the exact alignment, station locations and other technical parameters. Pending approval, the FLS will kick-start detailed planning and design work, with construction likely to follow thereafter.

The proposed corridor is expected to pass through major intermediate towns such as Rajamahendravaram and Kakinada, helping broaden the economic and mobility benefits of high-speed rail across multiple districts. For passengers, the service would represent a quantum leap in travel experience compared with existing express trains that typically cover the trip in several hours.

In addition to the bullet train proposal, Indian Railways is also con-

sidering a semi-high-speed corridor between Vijayawada and Kurnool, designed to support speeds of around 220 km/h. This project, envisioned to connect interior regions via key junctions, would further expand the state's rail infrastructure footprint.

Railway planners have also mapped out proposals for new conventional lines, including links to devotional and remote regions such as the route from Hyderabad via Markapur to Srisaillam — a scheme that could improve access to the popular pilgrimage destination once operational.

The bullet train concept forms part of a broader strategy to strengthen Andhra Pradesh's rail network, increasing speeds and capacity while generating economic opportunities. High-speed corridors are expected to enhance regional integration, support industrial growth and reduce travel times for commuters and long-distance passengers alike.

Railway authorities have indicated that the proposals will now await formal approval from the Railway Board. If sanctioned, surveys and preparatory work could begin soon, setting the stage for one of the most ambitious rail upgrades ever undertaken in the state. Investors and stakeholders are watching closely, as enhanced connectivity could catalyse growth in sectors such as tourism, trade and urban development.

Local leaders have welcomed the initiative as a visionary move, noting that improved transit infrastructure will be crucial to meeting the demands of a rapidly modernising Andhra Pradesh. With formal clearances expected over the coming months, the bullet train proposal could herald a new era of high-speed travel in southern India.

Shivakumar Seeks Centre's Nod on Almatti Height Row

Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister and Water Resources Minister D. K. Shivakumar has urged the Government of India to intervene in the ongoing dispute with Andhra Pradesh over the proposed increase in height of the Almatti Dam on the Krishna River.

Addressing media persons in Bengaluru, Shivakumar said Karnataka is moving ahead with plans to raise the dam's height from 519 metres to 524 metres in accordance with tribunal awards and existing approvals. However, he alleged that objections from Andhra Pradesh are creating hurdles in obtaining necessary clearances, including those related to land acquisition.

The Deputy Chief Minister stated that the Karnataka gov-



ernment has already taken a policy decision to acquire around 1.33 lakh acres of land for the project. The estimated cost of the expansion is said to be nearly ₹70,000 crore. He warned that continued delays could escalate project costs and affect the state's long-term water management plans.

According to Shivakumar, Andhra Pradesh has report-

edly written to the Centre seeking to withhold certain approvals required for the project's execution. He expressed surprise at the resistance and maintained that there is no legal stay preventing Karnataka from proceeding with the dam height increase.

The Almatti Dam project, part of the Upper Krishna Project, is aimed at enhancing water storage capacity to benefit farmers and ensure drinking water supply in several drought-prone districts of Karnataka. State officials argue that the proposed increase falls within allocations determined by the Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal and does not violate any binding directives.

Shivakumar indicated that he plans to lead an all-party delegation to New Delhi during the ongoing Parliament session to present Karnataka's case before Union ministers,

including those from the Jal Shakti Ministry. He also appealed to Karnataka's Members of Parliament to raise the issue at the national level and press for early intervention.

The issue has once again brought inter-state water disputes into focus, with both Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh standing firm on their respective positions. While Karnataka views the project as critical for its irrigation and drinking water needs, Andhra Pradesh has reportedly raised concerns about potential downstream impacts.

Political observers note that resolution of the dispute will likely require careful coordination between the Centre and the concerned states. With legal, technical and political dimensions intertwined, the matter is expected to remain a key subject of discussion in the coming weeks.

Harsha Veena Secures Relief in MLA Arava Sridhar Threat Case

Railway Koduru — A local junior assistant, Harsha Veena, has been granted relief by the Andhra Pradesh High Court in a high profile case involving allegations of threats against Arava Sridhar, the MLA from the Railway Koduru constituency.

The court, after hearing Harsha Veena's plea for anticipatory bail, issued an order allowing her conditional protection from arrest. The decision came amid swirling controversy around claims made in a complaint that had been filed with the Railway Koduru police earlier. The case stemmed from allegations that Veena had threatened the MLA and demanded a substantial sum of money, which was reportedly claimed to be ₹25 crore.

During the hearing, the High Court imposed several conditions on Harsha Veena's bail, underscoring the need for her cooperation with the ongoing investigation. She was directed to furnish sureties and appear before the relevant magistrate within a stipulated period. In addition, the court instructed her to report regularly to the police station every Saturday and to ensure her presence during any inquiries.

Other conditions included surrendering her passport to the court or, if not in possession of one, submitting a sworn affidavit to that effect. The judge also emphasized that

Veena must not attempt to influence or intimidate witnesses, interfere with the investigation, or leave the district without prior court permission. The High Court made it clear that any violation of these terms could result in cancellation of her bail and further legal consequences.

The case has attracted attention in the district due to the involvement of a sitting legislator and the serious nature of the allegations. The complaint was reportedly filed by the mother of the MLA, and it alleged that Harsha Veena tried to coerce the MLA for financial gain while threatening to make damaging claims public.

Supporters of both sides have been vocal on social media and in local conversations, with the matter becoming a topic of political debate in the region. Observers note that such cases involving elected representatives often draw scrutiny not just for legal outcomes but also for their potential impact on public perceptions of political accountability.

With the anticipatory bail granted, Harsha Veena will avoid immediate arrest as long as she complies with the High Court's stringent terms. Police investigators will continue their inquiry into the matter, gathering evidence and statements to determine the next course of action. The case, which blends legal complexity and political sensitivities, is expected to evolve further as the investigation

Andhra Pradesh Launches India's First 'Driver-Cum-Guide' Initiative with Rapido

In a pioneering move set to redefine urban tourism, the Andhra Pradesh Tourism Department has partnered with Rapido to launch India's first "Driver-Cum-Guide" training programme. Unveiled during the Visakha Partnership Summit, the initiative aims to transform auto and cab drivers from mere transport providers into cultural ambassadors who can narrate the rich history and heritage of the state to visitors.

The pilot project began on February 24, 2026, in Vijayawada under the leadership of Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, Tourism Minister Kandula Durgesh, senior officials Ajay Jain and Amrapali Kata, and Rapido Co-Founder Pawan Guntupalli. The primary objective is to equip local drivers with professional skills and historical knowledge, enabling them to serve as tourism ambassadors.

A two-day intensive training session was conducted at the Tourism Department office in Auto Nagar, Vijayawada. Under the supervision of Executive Director (Projects) Seshagiri Rao and Marketing CEO Padmarani Seela, 280 drivers — including 32 cab drivers and 248 auto drivers — received certification. The programme covered knowledge of major tourist attractions, communication skills, safety standards, and professional etiquette. Drivers were trained to use digital tools such as the 'Bhashini' app and Google Translate to communicate effectively with foreign tourists.

Special emphasis was placed on storytelling techniques in collaboration with Jignasa Artworks, helping drivers present the historical significance of destinations like Amaravati, the Buddhist Circuit, and Nagarjuna Sagar in an engaging narrative format.

To help tourists easily identify certified participants, Rapido has introduced a dedicated "Tourist Guide" icon within its app. This feature allows users to select trained driver-guides, ensuring a safe, informative, and reliable travel experience.

Drivers have expressed pride in their new role. "Until now, we were just drivers. Today, we are ambassadors showcasing Vijayawada's greatness to visitors," said Raju, an auto driver from NTR district. The initiative is also notable for the enthusiastic participation of a woman auto driver, marking a positive step toward women's empowerment and safety in tourism services.

Implemented under the Ministry of Tourism's Swadesh Darshan scheme as part of the Challenge-Based Destination Development Programme for Nagarjuna Sagar, the Vijayawada pilot will conclude on March 6. Encouraged by the positive response, the state government plans to expand the programme to Tirupati and Visakhapatnam soon.

Marking a significant step in wildlife conservation and public safety, Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan formally launched "Project Hanuman" in Mangalagiri. The initiative, introduced under the aegis of the Forest Department, aims to effectively address the growing instances of human-wildlife conflict across the state.

Tourism Minister and Guntur District In-Charge Minister Kandula Durgesh, who participated in the programme held at the AP SP Grounds, described the launch as a landmark moment coinciding with Wildlife Conservation Day. He stated that the "Hanuman" programme — an acronym for Healing and Nurturing Units for Monitoring, Aid and Nursing of Wildlife — stands on four key pillars: wildlife conservation, public safety, scientific monitoring, and integrated governance.

Minister Durgesh credited the visionary leadership of Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan for conceptualising the programme. He highlighted several proactive measures already



undertaken by the Forest Department, including the deployment of trained kumki elephants from Karnataka to mitigate elephant-related crop and life loss, enhanced red sanders protection in the Seshachalam forests, and the strengthening of forest research initiatives in Rajamahendravaram.

The primary objective of Project Hanuman is to reduce human-wildlife conflicts through

science- and technology-driven interventions. The minister stressed the urgent need to minimise damage to crops and property caused by wild animals while simultaneously ensuring the protection and conservation of wildlife. Under the initiative, swift rescue and relief operations will be undertaken, and wild animals straying into human habitations will be safely relocated to secure forest zones.

Durgesh further explained that the programme adopts a dual strategy — safeguarding human lives and livelihoods while nurturing wildlife populations responsibly. He underscored that the initiative will not be limited to the Forest Department alone but will function through coordinated efforts involving the Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Tourism, and other line departments.

Public participation, he noted, is central to the success of the programme. The government plans to involve local communities and voluntary organisations to foster awareness and promote harmonious coexistence between humans and wildlife. The initiative aims to eliminate fear and misunderstanding by encouraging informed and compassionate interaction.

The minister expressed confidence that under the leadership of Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, Andhra Pradesh will emerge as a national model in wildlife management and conservation through Project Hanuman.

Energy Minister Slams Jagan Over Power Decisions, Highlights Tech-Driven Reforms

Andhra Pradesh Energy Minister Gottipati Ravi Kumar on Tuesday strongly criticised former Chief Minister Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, alleging that decisions taken during the previous YSRCP regime severely damaged the state's reputation at the international level and caused substantial financial losses to the power sector.

Addressing the media in Amaravati, the minister stated that while opposition parties in any state are expected to prioritise development, investments, and public welfare, the previous government had instead focused on political interests at the cost of Andhra Pradesh's long-term growth. He alleged that the cancellation of Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) during the earlier administration created uncertainty among investors and sent negative signals globally.

Ravi Kumar pointed out that certain foreign investors had even approached the Prime Minister's Office expressing concerns over policy instability in Andhra Pradesh. Such controversial decisions, he said, not

only eroded investor confidence but also forced the state to bear heavy financial liabilities in the form of compensation, resulting in losses amounting to hundreds of crores of rupees in the power sector over the past five years.

The minister further remarked that it was ironic for the former leadership to speak about attracting investments after having allegedly undermined the state's credibility. He credited the coalition government led by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu for restoring stability and investor trust in the energy sector. He highlighted that, for the first time in the country's history, electricity charges had been "trued down," reflecting the government's commitment to reducing the burden on consumers while ensuring quality power supply.

Despite inheriting financial challenges, the present government is working to strengthen the power sector through transparent policies and administrative reforms, he said. Efforts are underway to rebuild confidence among investors who had



earlier exited the state due to policy uncertainties.

Looking ahead, the minister emphasised that the energy sector is being modernised to meet future demands. The government is leveraging Artificial Intelligence (AI) and advanced IT tools to analyse weather patterns and forecast electricity demand more accurately. Innovative measures such as battery storage systems, battery swapping infrastructure, pumped

storage projects, and expansion of renewable energy sources are being promoted to provide reliable and affordable power to consumers.

Reaffirming the government's commitment, Ravi Kumar stated that the focus remains on delivering efficient, technology-driven, and cost-effective power solutions while safeguarding the state's financial and developmental interests.

Big Boost for Visakhapatnam's IT Sector: IBM Returns and Government Welcomes the Move

In a major boost to Andhra Pradesh's technology and investment landscape, global IT leader IBM has reaffirmed its presence in Visakhapatnam by registering IBM India Private Limited at the Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) unit in the city. This development marks a significant return of one of the world's largest IT corporations to the coastal city, reinforcing investor confidence and signalling renewed interest in the region's technology potential.

According to official announcements, IBM plans to export IT products worth approximately ₹322 crore over the next three years. The company's renewed operations in Visakhapatnam are expected to generate employment for around 500 professionals, further strengthening the city's IT job market. Previously, IBM operated in the region, including at Rushikonda's IT Park, before scaling back due to business conditions after the pandemic.

The STPI, which facilitates IT and software exports from designated units, publicly welcomed IBM's re-entry, highlighting it as a positive indicator of Andhra Pradesh's growing reputation as an investment-friendly destination. Local authorities and investment promoters hailed this move as a major achievement that aligns with the state's



broader agenda of attracting high-quality technology investments.

Government officials noted that Visakhapatnam has been rapidly emerging as a favoured destination for multinational and domestic technology firms alike. With global giants such as Google, Infosys, and TCS already establishing operations or expanding their footprint in the city, IBM's return adds momentum to the region's transformation into a vibrant IT hub. Industry leaders and state representatives believe that this trend will contribute to greater export revenues and sustainable economic growth.

In response to the positive developments, ministers and investment officials commented that the state government's proactive policies, infrastructure support, and ease-of-doing-business initiatives have been pivotal in attracting renewed corporate interest. They emphasized that Andhra Pradesh's strategic focus on building robust IT infrastructure, supported by policy incentives and collaborative governance, is delivering tangible results.

The return of IBM is expected to bolster Visakhapatnam's positioning not only as an important regional tech centre

but also as a contributor to India's broader IT export goals. With investment flows increasing and job opportunities expanding, industry analysts see this as a clear sign that Andhra Pradesh is gaining ground among technology investors and is well-placed to continue its growth trajectory in the coming years.

YSRCP MLC Arun Kumar Targets AP Government, Demands Council Discussion

In a significant development in Andhra Pradesh politics, Arun Kumar, Member of the Legislative Council (MLC) from the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP), has sharply criticised the state government led by N. 'Re-Survey Maze': Confusion and Allegations Surround Land Records in East Godavari

Fresh controversy has erupted in East Godavari district over alleged irregularities in the ongoing land re-survey process, leaving farmers and landowners anxious about the safety of their property records. What was introduced as a transparent and technology-driven initiative has now become a source of confusion, with several residents claiming discrepancies in survey numbers, boundaries, and ownership details.

The re-survey program, undertaken as part of the statewide land reforms initiative in Andhra Pradesh, aims to update decades-old land records using modern equipment such as GPS and digital mapping tools. Officials have repeatedly stated that the objective is to eliminate disputes, ensure clarity in ownership, and create a tamper-proof digital database. However, on the ground, many farmers allege that the process has instead created fresh complications.

Several villagers reported

that their land extents were either reduced or altered in the new digital records without proper verification. In some cases, boundaries between adjacent lands were reportedly shifted, leading to disputes among neighbors. Farmers claim that despite submitting old pattadar passbooks and registration documents, their grievances have not been promptly addressed.

Local revenue officials have responded by assuring the public that errors, if any, are technical and will be rectified after due verification. They maintain that the re-survey is a massive exercise covering thousands of acres and minor discrepancies are inevitable in the initial stages. Authorities have also urged landowners to approach grievance redressal centers set up at the mandal level to resolve issues.

Opposition voices, however, argue that the lack of proper awareness and ground-level coordination has led to mistrust among people. They demand a



thorough review of the process and greater transparency in updating records. Some farmers' associations have even called for a temporary halt to the re-survey until all pending objections are cleared.

Legal experts warn that inaccuracies in land records can have long-term consequences, especially in matters of loans, property sales, and inheritance. They stress the need for meticu-

lous cross-checking before finalizing digital entries.

As tensions rise, the district administration faces the challenge of restoring public confidence. While modernization of land records remains a crucial reform, ensuring accuracy and accountability will determine whether the re-survey becomes a milestone in governance—or remains, as critics describe it, a "re-survey maze."

Suraksha Convener Kudaravalli Venkata Narasayya Sentenced in Cheque Bounce Case

The Fifth Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court in Vijayawada on Tuesday sentenced Kudaravalli Venkata Narasayya, Convener of Suraksha, to four months of simple imprisonment in a cheque bounce case.

The court also imposed a fine of ₹4 lakh after examining the evidence and hearing arguments from both the complainant and the accused. The judgment was delivered following a detailed trial process.

According to the case records, the incident dates back to 2020 when Gogineni Venkateswara Rao, a resident of Ashok Nagar in Vijayawada, reportedly lent ₹5,65,000 to Narasayya. In order to repay the loan amount, Narasayya issued a cheque for the same sum. However, when the cheque was presented for clearance at the bank, it was dishonoured due to insufficient funds.

Subsequently, Venkateswara Rao approached the court and filed a complaint under the relevant provisions of the Negotiable Instruments Act. During the course of the trial, the court reviewed documentary evidence, including the dishonoured cheque and bank memo, and heard submissions from both parties before arriving at its verdict.

In its order, the court sentenced Narasayya to four months of simple imprisonment and directed him to pay a penalty of ₹4 lakh. The magistrate further stated that failure to pay the fine would result in an additional two months of imprisonment.

Legal sources indicate that Narasayya is reportedly facing similar cheque bounce cases in other courts as well. Further legal proceedings in those cases are awaited.

Kanaka Durga Temple Closes Doors for Lunar Eclipse, Darshan to Resume on March 4

Allegations of Irregularities in Nandigama Municipal Town Planning Office



Amaravathi 03.03.2026 TPN Bureau : Serious allegations have surfaced regarding the functioning of Town Planning Secretaries working in the Nandigama Municipal limits. It is being alleged that the Town Planning section in the municipal office is being informally operated like a private licensed planning office, raising concerns among applicants and local residents.

According to information gathered, over the past few years, several private builders in Nandigama town allegedly constructed buildings exceeding approved limits. While permissions were reportedly granted for G+3 (ground plus three floors) structures under CRDA norms, some builders are said to have extended constructions up to G+5 floors, violating regulations. Subsequently, CRDA authorities conducted inspections and filed charge sheets in court against municipal town planning officials over these irregularities.

In a recent development, the coalition government permitted the regularization of the additional two unauthorized floors under the Building Penalization Scheme (BPS). This decision reportedly provided relief to many building owners. It is estimated that nearly 400 applications have been submitted within Nandigama municipal limits seeking regularization under the BPS scheme.

However, allegations have now emerged that certain Town Planning Secretaries are collecting money from applicants, reportedly ranging between ₹5,000 to ₹10,000 depending on the case.

They are allegedly assuring applicants that they would handle the entire BPS process, including preparation of plans for the two additional floors eligible under the scheme. It is further alleged that the collected money is being shared and that building plans are being prepared through a private licensed Town Planning individual based in Vijayawada.

Sources claim that these activities are being carried out discreetly without the knowledge of higher authorities. Questions are being raised about whether the Municipal Commissioner, the Town Planning Officer, or the current in-charge Town Planning Supervisor are aware of these developments.

Applicants who have applied under the BPS scheme are now demanding a thorough inquiry and strict action against any officials found involved in malpractice. They are urging the Municipal Commissioner to conduct vigilance and ensure transparency in processing applications.

It may be recalled that earlier there were four private licensed Town Planning offices operating in Nandigama town. Following various allegations against some license holders, three licenses were reportedly cancelled, leaving only one active private Town Planning license office. Observers suggest that this situation may have indirectly contributed to the current controversy.

Residents are calling for a transparent system to ensure that building regularization is carried out strictly as per norms, without unofficial payments or middlemen involvement.

CPM Padayatra Stages Protest Over Drinking Water Issue in Tadepalligudem

"Government Should Be Ashamed for Failing to Provide Drinking Water" – J.N.V. Gopalan



Amaravathi 03.03.2026 TPN Bureau : Strongly criticizing the government for its failure to ensure basic amenities, CPI(M) district secretary J. N. V. Gopalan said that a government unable to provide even drinking water to its people should be ashamed.

The CPI(M) district-level Praja Chaitanya Padayatra reached Tadepalligudem town on Tuesday, where it received a grand welcome from workers and women in large numbers. The padayatra team was greeted with harathi, flowers, and green shawls as a mark of solidarity and support. In Bhagalakshmi Peta area, members of the padayatra, along with local women, staged a dharna demanding immediate resolution of the drinking water problem. The protest was later withdrawn following assurances from officials.

Addressing the gathering, Gopalan stated that the drinking water crisis in the town has become severe and has been causing immense hardship to residents, particularly women who are forced to struggle daily for water. He alleged that officials have been more focused on serving public representatives rather than addressing the real concerns of the people.

He questioned how even minor civic issues remain unresolved and criticized the local MLA for failing to respond effectively to public grievances. "If immediate steps are not taken to resolve the drinking water issue, we will intensify our agitation along with women and lay siege to the municipal office," he warned.

The protest highlighted the growing dissatisfaction among

residents over inadequate basic infrastructure and civic services. Women participants voiced their frustration, stating that repeated complaints to authorities had not yielded concrete action. They demanded a permanent solution rather than temporary measures.

CPI(M) district secretariat members Karri Nageswara Rao, district committee members Soornidu Venkateswara Rao, A. Ajaya Kumari, P. Poorna, K. Tavitai Naidu, K. 

Gandhi argued that New Delhi's silence following the targeted killing of a foreign head of state is neither neutral nor principled, but amounts to an abdication of responsibility that undermines India's standing on the world stage.

In a strongly worded statement, Gandhi said the government's reluctance to explicitly condemn the killing of Iran's top leader raises serious questions about the direction and credibility of India's foreign policy. She said India's ties with Tehran, both civilisational and strategic, go back decades, and the silence appears inconsistent with the traditional values India has upheld in international relations. Gandhi argued that the issue should not be treated as a matter of routine diplomacy, but one that clearly warrants a principled stand.

According to her, the lack of commentary from New

Delhi, particularly after a major attack affecting Iranian leadership, cannot be dismissed as neutrality. Instead, Gandhi described the silence as a failure to uphold international law and sovereignty, suggesting that India's failure to articulate a clear position could signal "tacit endorsement of tragedy" or at least a reluctance to defend fundamental principles when they are challenged. She also urged that this topic be openly debated in Parliament to clarify India's official stance and reaffirm its commitment to global norms.

Gandhi's critique has sparked significant political discussion because it comes at a time when India is trying to maintain a careful diplomatic balance amid a volatile West Asia conflict involving the United States, Israel, and Iran. While the Indian government has called for restraint, dialogue, and de-escalation, it has stopped short of explicitly condemning the killing of Khamenei or detailing a strong position on the matter, a stance Gandhi finds troubling given India's historical emphasis on sovereignty and peaceful resolution of conflicts.

The comments by the Congress leader reflect broader criticism from sections of the political spectrum that believe India's response has been muted and inconsistent. Some critics argue that a clearer declaration of principles in defence of international law — especially in incidents involving the death of a foreign head of state — is essential to maintaining India's diplomatic credibility.

Gandhi's remarks underscore a growing domestic debate over how India should navigate the Middle East crisis and which principles should guide its foreign policy during global conflicts. This debate comes as thousands of Indian expatriates in the region face uncertainty amid escalating tensions, further complicating the diplomatic landscape for New Delhi.

In calling for a public parliamentary discussion and a more transparent approach, Sonia Gandhi has made clear that the opposition views India's current silence not as strategic restraint but as a missed opportunity to reaffirm long standing values in international affairs.

Rahul Gandhi Questions Government's "Silence" on West Asia Conflict, Asks If PM Modi Supports Assassination of a Head of State



Senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi has intensified his criticism of the Indian government's handling of the ongoing West Asia conflict, accusing it of remaining silent on crucial international developments and questioning whether such silence amounts to support for the assassination of a foreign head of state.

In a strong public statement, Rahul Gandhi said the government's muted response to the killing of a powerful foreign leader — referring to Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, the Supreme Leader of Iran — raises serious questions about India's foreign policy principles. He challenged the Narendra Modi government to clearly explain its position on the matter, arguing that remaining silent on actions that involve the assassination of a head of state undermines India's moral standing and could be interpreted as tacit approval.

Rahul Gandhi reiterated that the killing of any head of state should be condemned unequivocally under international law. He said India's position should not be influenced solely by strategic ties with other nations, but must be guided by fundamental principles of sovereignty, peaceful resolu-

tion of disputes, and respect for human life.

According to Gandhi, the Indian government's reluctance to publicly comment on the controversial assassination sends a confusing message. He questioned whether the silence signifies a shift in India's traditional foreign policy stance, which historically emphasised respect for international norms and the sovereignty of nations.

In his comments, Gandhi also pointed out that India has always maintained constructive relations with countries across the Middle East, including Iran. He highlighted longstanding cultural, economic, and civilisational ties, suggesting that ignoring a major geopolitical event involving a key regional partner could strain bilateral relations as well as India's broader diplomatic credibility.

The Congress leader asserted that neutrality is not achieved through silence but through clear articulation of values and principles. He called on the government to explain whether its position reflects a strategic choice or a departure from values that India has upheld in its foreign relations.

Rahul Gandhi's criticisms

come amid a wider debate within Indian political circles over how the government should navigate the intensifying conflict in the Middle East, particularly given the presence of millions of Indian expatriates in the region. There has been growing pressure on New Delhi to outline a clear and principled stance while simultaneously ensuring the safety of its citizens abroad.

Gandhi also urged the government to use parliamentary platforms to openly discuss India's response to major developments in West Asia, including the assassination of a foreign leader and its implications for global peace and security. He said that such debates are essential for transparency and for reaffirming India's commitment to international norms.

The opposition leader's remarks signify deeper political friction over foreign policy direction and the values that should guide India during periods of global crisis. His challenge to the government underscores the need for a public and nuanced discussion on how India positions itself on complex geopolitical issues involving both global powers and regional conflicts.

Middle East Turmoil Weighs on Gulf Markets; Energy Shares Lift Saudi Index

Global financial markets in the Gulf region have been rattled by renewed instability in the Middle East, as escalating tensions involving Iran, the United States and Israel continue to spook investors. The recent geopolitical developments have not only stirred political unease but also sent ripples through equity markets across the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC), with traders taking cautious positions amid rising risk aversion.

The impact of heightened uncertainty was most apparent in Gulf equity indices, which opened weaker this week as investors grappled with the prospect of broader regional escalation. Markets that had been on a steady recovery path were suddenly confronted with renewed nervousness, prompting a shift away from riskier assets and a flight toward safe haven sectors.

A prominent trend emerging in the region's stock exchanges is the divergent performance between broader market indices and energy shares. While benchmark indices such as those in Dubai and Abu Dhabi experienced downward pressure, energy stocks — particularly in Saudi Arabia — attracted fresh buying interest due to rising oil prices.

Crude oil has surged in global commodity markets as the risk of conflict-related supply disruptions grows. With Iran being a major oil producer and the Strait of Hormuz acting as a vital chokepoint for global oil shipments, any escalation in hostilities raises the threat of supply constraints. This has bolstered the outlook for oil companies, as investors anticipate stronger earnings for firms involved in hydrocarbon production and export.

In Saudi Arabia, where the economy remains heavily tied to energy, gains in energy stocks helped partially offset broader



market weakness. The Tadawul All Share Index exhibited relative resilience, supported by renewed demand for shares of oil giants and energy-related firms. Traders noted that higher crude prices generally translate into stronger state revenues and improved profitability for energy producers, factors that tend to support valuations even during periods of volatility.

Conversely, Gulf markets with more diversified economic structures saw greater sensitivity to geopolitical jitters. Dubai and Abu Dhabi bourses, while still buoyed by sectors such as finance and real estate, exhibited net losses as investors weighed the potential ripple effects of heightened conflict. Banking and tourism-related stocks, in particular, came under pressure as investor confidence waned amid broader uncertainty.

Regional investors also point-

ed to wider global market trends that compounded local pressures. International equity markets have been increasingly volatile in response to geopolitical developments, rising energy prices, and concerns about inflationary pressures. In turn, this has prompted GCC investors to adopt more cautious stances, reducing exposure to equities and seeking shelter in defensive sectors or assets perceived as safer.

Currency markets reflected a similar risk off mood, with some Gulf currencies experiencing mild depreciation against the US dollar as capital flows shifted in favor of legacy safe haven assets. Meanwhile, demand for gold and other precious metals has strengthened, consistent with classic investor behavior during periods of geopolitical stress.

Amid these market move-

ments, financial analysts emphasized that the current sell off should be viewed in the context of broader market fundamentals. While short term volatility remains elevated, underlying economic indicators such as government revenues, fiscal buffers, and long term growth prospects in the GCC remain comparatively strong.

However, analysts also cautioned that continued escalation could lead to deeper market corrections, especially if global oil supply chains are disrupted or if investor risk sentiment deteriorates further.

In the meantime, Gulf markets will remain on edge, with traders carefully monitoring developments in the Middle East, global oil dynamics, and international policy responses, as these factors will be key in determining market direction in the days ahead.

Trump Backtracks on 'Boots on the Ground' Threat After US Embassy in Riyadh Attacked Amid Rising Middle East Tensions



Tensions in the Middle East have escalated sharply following a direct attack on the US Embassy in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, amid ongoing hostilities involving the United States, Iran, and Israel. The incident prompted a notable shift in President Donald Trump's approach to military involvement in the region.

On Tuesday, two drones struck the US diplomatic mission in Riyadh, igniting a fire and causing material damage to the embassy compound. Fortunately, no casualties were immediately reported. Saudi authorities confirmed the attacks after videos circulated online showing smoke rising from the Diplomatic Quarter in the Saudi capital. The broader market sentiment remained fragile, with most sectors ending in the red.

Experts believe that the key trigger behind the current volatility is the uncertainty surrounding oil supply disruptions. The Strait of Hormuz, a critical route for global oil shipments, remains under threat, adding to fears of supply shocks. Any prolonged disruption could have far-reaching consequences for global trade

and inflation trends.

Apart from geopolitical tensions, foreign institutional investor (FII) activity will also play a crucial role in determining market direction. Recent sessions have seen significant selling by foreign investors, which has added pressure on domestic equities. Currency movements, particularly the weakening of the Indian rupee, are also being closely watched.

Sectorally, oil marketing companies, aviation firms, and paint stocks are expected to remain under pressure due to rising crude prices. On the other hand, upstream oil companies may see some support as higher crude prices can improve their realizations.

Market participants are also likely to keep an eye on upcoming global economic data and central

bank signals, as these could influence interest rate expectations. Any indication of prolonged inflation could delay rate cuts, further dampening investor sentiment.

Analysts advise investors to remain cautious in the near term, as volatility is expected to persist. While long-term fundamentals of the Indian economy remain intact, short-term movements are likely to be driven by global developments and geopolitical risks.

In summary, a combination of weak global cues, rising oil prices, and geopolitical tensions is set to weigh heavily on Indian markets at the opening bell. The sharp fall in Gift Nifty underscores the fragile sentiment, suggesting that investors should brace for a turbulent trading session ahead.

“Tried To Trap Me”: Tenant Exposes Hidden Clause in Bengaluru Rent Agreement



A tenant in Bengaluru has gone viral after accusing their landlord of quietly altering the rent agreement without prior notice, bringing attention to transparency issues in the city's rental market.

The situation emerged when the tenant, who had been living in the same apartment since 2022, renewed their lease in 2026. Before signing the updated agreement, they reportedly confirmed with the landlord whether any terms had changed. The landlord allegedly assured them that everything remained the same. 
