



Vijay's Solo Surge Redefines Tamil Nadu Politics

In a dramatic and unexpected turn of events, actor-turned-politician Vijay has carved out a remarkable victory, reshaping the political landscape of Tamil Nadu. Once dismissed as an unlikely contender, his party, Tamizhaga VetriKazhagam (TVK), stunned critics by securing a decisive mandate and propelling him to the Chief Minister's post. Pre-election skepticism—ranging from doubts about his party's viability to questions about his own electoral success—has now been firmly silenced.

Facing relentless criticism and multiple controversies, Vijay maintained his focus and resilience. From personal challenges to political attacks, including attempts to derail his film Jananayagan, every setback appeared to strengthen public sympathy in his favor. His campaign ultimately translated this support into a commanding tally of seats, eliminating the possibility of a fractured mandate and proving his ability to lead independently.

The outcome also reflects a broader shift in voter sentiment. After five years under M. K. Stalin's administration, a noticeable wave of dissatisfaction had begun to emerge. Statements by Udhayanidhi Stalin on sensitive issues further intensified public discontent, creating an opening that Vijay effectively capitalized on. Meanwhile, All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) concentrated its efforts on challenging the ruling government, even aligning with Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), but could not match the growing appeal of TVK.

A defining feature of Vijay's campaign was his unconventional approach to candidate selection. In a move that captured widespread attention, he nominated the son of his driver, Sabarinathan, from the Virugambakkam constituency—breaking long-standing norms dominated by wealth and influence. By contesting without alliances and urging voters to support his vision rather than individual candidates, Vijay created a strong personal connection with the electorate.

This landmark victory underscores a powerful message: when voters perceive a credible alternative, they are willing to embrace change wholeheartedly.



Trisha Sparks Political Buzz as Vijay Nears Power

Chennai: Tamil Nadu's political arena witnessed dramatic developments on the day of Assembly election results, as Tamizhaga VetriKazhagam (TVK) chief Vijay surged ahead with leads in over 100 constituencies, placing him firmly on course to form the next government. Amid this political wave, actress Trisha Krishnan, who is celebrating her 43rd birthday on Monday has unexpectedly become the centre of attention, triggering intense speculation about her possible entry into politics.

The buzz began early in the day when Trisha visited the sacred Tirumala Venkateswara Temple, offering prayers to Lord Venkateswara. While her fans stated that the visit was in connection with her birthday, netizens speculated that it was intended to seek divine blessings for Vijay's electoral success. The speculation intensified when she travelled directly from Tirumala to Vijay's residence in Neelankarai, Chennai and spent there more than an hour. Her visit to Vijay's residence quickly turned into a major talking point, with visuals and updates spreading rapidly across social media platforms. Trisha reportedly congratulated Vijay on his impressive electoral performance, further fuelling rumours of her growing proximity to the party's political developments.

The developments come at a time when TVK is making a remarkable debut in Tamil Nadu politics. With Vijay leading from both Trichy East and Perambur constituencies, the possibility of him winning both seats appears increasingly likely. According to election rules, he would have to vacate one seat if elected from both, setting off intense speculation over who might contest the resulting by-election.

Trisha's name has now emerged prominently in this context. Political observers point to earlier reports suggesting that TVK leaders had approached her during the ticket allocation phase, underlining her perceived importance within the party. Her sudden appearance at Vijay's residence on such a crucial day has only added weight to the speculation that she could be fielded as a candidate in the near future. Meanwhile, opposition parties have also weighed in on the developments. During the election campaign, leaders from major parties, including the BJP and DMK, had targeted the friendship between Vijay and Trisha, using it as a point of criticism. Remarks made by BJP leader Nainar Nagendran had sparked controversy, drawing attention to their personal association. However, the election trends suggest that such criticisms have had little impact on voters, who appear to have favoured TVK's message. Social media has since erupted with discussions, with hashtags like #VijayTrisha trending widely. Supporters view the developments as a sign of a new political narrative, while critics remain cautious, calling it premature speculation. At the same time, alternative possibilities are also being discussed. Some political observers suggest that Vijay's father, filmmaker S.A. Chandrasekar, could be considered for the vacant seat instead of Trisha. However, no official confirmation has been made by the party on this matter. As TVK edges closer to forming the government, the focus is not only on Vijay's political ascent but also on the evolving dynamics within his inner circle. Whether Trisha's visit marks the beginning of a political journey or remains a symbolic gesture, it has undeniably added a new layer of intrigue to Tamil Nadu's changing political landscape.

BJP Surge Halts Didi's Dominance in Bengal

The results of the Assembly elections in five states, often seen as a precursor to national trends, have delivered surprising outcomes. Contrary to most pre-poll projections that favored incumbent governments, a strong wave of anti-incumbency reshaped the political landscape. Except for Assam and Puducherry, ruling parties in major states like West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, and Kerala faced significant setbacks.

In West Bengal, the focused campaign against Mamata Banerjee proved effective, with the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its allies making major gains. The party, which had long aimed to capture power in the state, appears to have finally broken through after falling short in the 2021 elections. The ruling All India Trinamool



Congress (TMC), which previously secured a sweeping mandate, witnessed a sharp decline in its seat share.

Out of 294 constituencies, polling was conducted in 293 seats, with a re-election ordered in one segment. With the

majority mark set at 148, the BJP-led alliance surged well beyond that figure, taking a commanding lead. In contrast, the TMC, which had won over 200 seats in the previous election, was reduced to under 100 seats this time.

Mamata Banerjee, contesting from Bhabanipur, faced a tough challenge but managed to regain ground after an initial setback. Meanwhile, BJP leader Suwendu Adhikari retained prominence by securing victory in Nandigram. Several senior leaders and ministers from the ruling camp were also defeated, highlighting the scale of the shift in voter sentiment. Political observers attribute the outcome to multiple factors, including allegations of corruption against the ruling establishment and the BJP's aggressive campaign strategy. High-profile campaigning by Narendra Modi, along with sustained outreach efforts, played a crucial role in mobilizing voters. Overall, the results mark a major political shift in West Bengal, signaling the end of prolonged dominance by the TMC and a significant expansion of the BJP's influence in eastern India.

Kerala Returns to Tradition as UDF Sweeps to Power

Kerala, May 4 | TPN Bureau

The Assembly election results in Kerala have largely followed pre-poll expectations, with the Left Democratic Front (LDF) losing power after two consecutive terms. As widely anticipated, the United Democratic Front (UDF), led by the Congress, secured a clear majority and is set to form the next government. Out of the 140 Assembly constituencies, the required majority mark stood at 71 seats. While the LDF had hoped to achieve a rare third straight term, it fell well short, whereas the UDF registered a decisive victory. Meanwhile, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) once again failed



to make significant electoral gains in the state.

Kerala's political pattern has

historically been defined by an alternating cycle of power between the LDF and the UDF.

Although Pinarayi Vijayan broke this trend by securing a second consecutive term in 2021, the latest results indicate that voters have reverted to their preference for change after five years. Elections for all constituencies were held on April 9, with a direct contest between the two dominant alliances.

Despite internal challenges within the Congress, including the gradual distancing of senior leaders such as Shashi Tharoor, the UDF managed to regain public trust. Allegations of corruption against the ruling Left government are believed to have significantly influenced voter sentiment, contributing to the LDF's decline.

The BJP, despite an aggressive campaign, could not translate its efforts into electoral success. The party raised multiple issues, including cultural and religious matters like the Sabarimala Temple controversy, but these failed to resonate widely with voters. Even administrative moves such as renaming the state to "Keralam" did not alter the electoral outcome.

With the UDF's victory confirmed, attention has now shifted to leadership selection. Prominent Congress figures like V. D. Sathesan, Ramesh Chennithala, and K. C. Venugopal is being considered for the Chief Minister's role. The final decision will rest with the party's central leadership.



BJP Hails Mandate in 5 States, Kishan Reddy Slams Opposition

Telugu Vote Bank Shapes Tamil Nadu Politics

Chennai: The political landscape of Tamil Nadu is witnessing a notable shift with the emergence of Tamizhaga VetriKazhagam (TVK) led by actor-turned-politician Vijay. Early trends suggest that TVK is gaining traction across several regions, with the sizable Telugu-speaking voter base playing a crucial role in this rise.

Estimates indicate that Tamil Nadu has nearly 1.4 crore (14 million) Telugu-speaking people, forming a significant share of the electorate in key regions. Telugu remains the second-largest linguistic group in the state, accounting for about 5.8% of the population, or over 42 lakh people. This makes them one of the most influential voter blocs in Tamil Nadu politics. TVK supporters highlight that the party is strategically focusing on Telugu-dominated pockets, particular-

ly in northern Tamil Nadu. Districts such as Tiruvallur, Vellore, Ranipet, Tiruttani, Krishnagiri, and Kanchipuram have a strong Telugu presence. The campaign mapping identifies at least six clusters, including Gummidipoondi, Ponneri, Katpadi, Gudiyattam, Arakkonam, and Hosur, regions considered electorally decisive.

Political parties have long recognised this demographic strength. Major Dravidian parties like DMK and AIADMK have historically

Telangana Set to Launch Cancer Registry Portal

The Health Department is in the final phase of launching a dedicated cancer registry website aimed at improving patient data management and treatment monitoring across the state. The initiative is being developed in collaboration with the MNJ Institute of Oncology and Regional Cancer Centre and the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). Officials confirmed that a draft memorandum of understanding has been prepared and is awaiting formal approval. A pilot phase of the project has already been completed, with all District Medical and Health Officers (DMHOs) trained to track cancer patients from initial diagnosis through treatment. They will also be responsible for uploading patient data onto the new portal. According



to officials, the platform is expected to go live within a week, as its design and structure are already in place. ICMR will play a crucial role in ensuring the accuracy and reliability of the data. It will verify the information submitted by the state, eliminate duplication, and return refined datasets for centralized storage. This process is expected to enhance the quality and credibility of the registry. Under the proposed system, major cancer diagnostic laboratories will have direct access to upload patient data,

although access will be restricted to their own entries. Smaller healthcare facilities will submit their records to respective DMHOs, who will forward them to ICMR for validation before inclusion in the central database. This layered approach aims to ensure both accuracy and consistency. A state-level expert committee, including specialists from Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, MNJ, and the Directorate of Medical Education, has been actively coordinating with district officials. Their discussions have focused on streamlining workflows, from patient registration to treatment updates, while also strengthening district cancer care centers. The new portal is expected to significantly improve cancer surveillance, data-driven planning, and patient care delivery across Telangana.

a strong position in Bengal despite political challenges.

Targeting opposition parties, he accused them of engaging in divisive politics and misleading narratives. He alleged that violence and pressure tactics against BJP workers in Bengal had failed to deter the party's rise. On Tamil Nadu and Kerala results, he claimed opposition alliances suffered internal divisions and failed to connect with people. He also criticized Congress leadership, saying the party has faced repeated electoral setbacks nationally.

Bandi Sanjay also made sharp personal political attacks on state leaders, alleging failures in governance and calling for accountability in various issues. He challenged rivals to respond with evidence



on corruption allegations and warned of exposing political links and irregularities.

He concluded by urging supporters to participate in the upcoming Prime Minister's public meeting in Telangana, calling it a historic event. He expressed confidence that a "saffron wave" is spreading across the country and would soon reach Telangana, strengthening the BJP's position in the state.

VAHAN Portal Speeds Up Vehicle Registration Process

The Transport Department has significantly streamlined vehicle registration services through the implementation of the VAHAN portal, developed by the National Informatics Centre. As of last Saturday, the system had successfully processed 89,392 temporary vehicle registrations across the state.

In addition to temporary registrations, the portal facilitated 3,223 online bookings and auctions for fancy registration numbers. Officials stated that 79,095 vehicles have already been assigned permanent registration numbers, representing nearly 88.5 percent of the total registrations processed so far.

Once a permanent registration number is allotted, vehicle dealers are responsible for obtaining high-security registration plates (HSRP), installing them on the vehicles, and uploading photographic proof to the VAHAN portal. This step is essential for generating and printing the final registration certificates.

The Transport Department is introducing the system in a phased manner to ensure smooth functioning and uninterrupted public access to services. The gradual rollout is intended to improve operational efficiency while minimizing technical disruptions during implementation.

According to department officials, the portal's performance has shown notable improvement in recent days, with faster approval rates and smoother processing of applications. This progress indicates that the system is stabilizing effectively.

Officials further noted that pending applications at verification and inspection stages are being closely monitored through daily reviews. As a result, the backlog has been significantly reduced, with fewer than 25 applications currently pending at each stage.

The digitized platform is expected to make vehicle registration services more transparent, efficient, and convenient for both dealers and vehicle owners across Telangana.



Industries Urged to Train Engineers for Future Jobs

IT and Industries Minister Duddilla Sridhar Babu has called on industries to actively participate in training engineering graduates and preparing them for employment. Highlighting the growing mismatch between academic curricula and industry expectations, he emphasized that companies should take responsibility for skill development as part of their corporate commitment.

The Minister made these remarks at an event held at a hotel in Begumpet to mark the 10-year milestone of city-based firm PSR Techhub. He congratulated founder P. Sriranga Rao for building the company into a successful enterprise within a decade, despite challenges in the rapidly evolving technology sector.

Recalling the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, Sridhar Babu noted that many organizations struggled to survive, but praised PSR Techhub for

sustaining operations and ensuring job security for its workforce. He also pointed out the challenges posed by emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence and stressed the need for continuous upskilling.

The Minister said the government is taking steps to support skill enhancement among engineers and announced plans to establish a dedicated training facility, referred to as an AI Hub. He added that reskilling programs are expected to begin within the next two months.

PSR Techhub Director P. Namayutha stated that the company currently operates across major Indian cities and plans to expand globally over the next three years. She said the workforce is expected to grow to around 1,000 employees. Following the Minister's suggestions, the company also intends to provide training to fresh graduates and offer job opportunities to deserving candidates.

Telangana Cabinet to Review Key Projects and Welfare Measures

The State Cabinet meeting, to be chaired by Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, is set to deliberate on a wide range of crucial policy matters, spanning irrigation, infrastructure, and employee welfare.

One of the primary agenda items is the revival of the Pranahita-Chevella project, along with initiating discussions with the Maharashtra government on constructing the TuVVMmidihatti barrage at an increased height of 150 meters, compared to the earlier 148 meters proposal. The Cabinet is also expected to examine water diversion plans from Tummidiatti to SripadaYelampalli, with multiple route options under consideration.

Employee welfare is another major focus. The government is likely to outline a plan to clear nearly Rs 6,000 crore in pending dues of employees and pensioners within 100 days. Discussions are expected on revising Pay Revision Commission (PRC) scales, settling Dearness Allowance arrears, improving health schemes, and addressing other pending payments. The possibility of PRC fitment for Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TGSRTC) staff and the



proposed merger of RTC employees with the state government are also on the agenda.

Infrastructure development, particularly the expansion of the Hyderabad Metro Rail, will be a key topic. Following the state government's recent takeover of Phase-I operations, the Cabinet is likely to push forward plans for Phase-II expansion. The project, proposed as a joint venture with the Central government, will require necessary approvals, with construction expected to begin within six months. Irrigation projects, including a review of the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation

Scheme, will also be discussed, focusing on technical modifications and future planning. Additionally, the Cabinet may consider several welfare initiatives, such as sanctioning new Aasara pensions, implementing the Indiramma insurance scheme, and addressing demands of Telangana movement activists. Preparations for events like Godavari Pushkaralu 2027, Census-related issues, expansion of cashless medical facilities, and completion of pending double-bedroom housing projects are also expected to be reviewed.

Uttam Kumar Reddy Orders Massive Push for Paddy Procurement Amid Rains

Irrigation and Civil Supplies Minister N. Uttam Kumar Reddy has directed officials to accelerate paddy procurement operations across Telangana in response to unseasonal rains affecting several districts and threatening crop damage.

Chairing a high-level video conference with district in-charge ministers, collectors, and senior officials, the Minister reviewed the ongoing procurement season and stressed the need for immediate action to protect farmers' produce from weather-related losses. He instructed the administration to remain on high alert as heavy summer showers continue to affect multiple regions.

So far, paddy procurement has crossed 14.80 lakh metric tonnes, with all 8,575 procurement centers fully operational. Over 1.84 lakh farmers have benefited, and approximately Rs 2,001.96 crore has been directly transferred to their bank accounts under Minimum Support Price (MSP) operations. Officials also noted that more than 8 lakh metric tonnes of coarse varieties have been procured this season.

The Minister emphasized that procurement efforts must be intensified in the coming days as arrivals are expected to increase significantly. Special focus has been placed on high-volume procurement centers in districts such as Nalgonda and Nizamabad.

Unseasonal rains accompanied by strong winds have al-

ready damaged paddy stocks in several districts including Nalgonda, Mahabubnagar, Khammam, Suryapet, and Kothagudem. Reports from Nalgonda indicated that nearly 299 metric tonnes of paddy were soaked during a sudden storm, despite precautionary measures.

Uttam Kumar Reddy directed officials to ensure tarpaulins are pre-positioned at all procurement centers based on daily weather forecasts. He also instructed that wet paddy be immediately transported to designated parboiled rice mills to minimize losses. The state has arranged sufficient storage capacity and mobilized over 18.5 crore gunny bags to support procurement operations.

He further stressed that district collectors and ministers must closely monitor operations and resolve transport or logistical issues without delay. The Minister reiterated that procurement will continue without interruption and warned officials to maintain strict preparedness in view of continued rainfall predictions.

Senior officials, including Civil Supplies Commissioner Stephen Ravindra, Transport Commissioner K. Ilambarathi, and Disaster Management Secretary D. Harichandana, participated in the review meeting. Ministers Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy, D. Sridhar Babu, AdhuriLakshman, PonnamPrabhakar, and Vakiti Srihari also joined the discussions.

Thummala Urges Centre to Expand MSP Support and Lift Procurement Caps

Referring to Telangana, he expressed confidence that the BJP would not gain ground in the state, adding that people would not trust those who had earlier made critical remarks about Telangana's formation.

Dayakar Credits Revanth Reddy for UDF Success

BRSV Protests at Secretariat Over G.O. 7, Seeks Fee Reimbursement Release

Tension prevailed near the Secretariat as activists of the BRSV staged a protest demanding the immediate withdrawal of G.O. No. 7 and the release of pending fee reimbursement dues. The demonstration, led by BRSV State Vice President Thunga Balu, highlighted growing concerns among students over the impact of the government order.

Addressing the gathering, Thunga Balu strongly criticized the Congress government, alleging that G.O. No. 7 could adversely affect nearly 14 lakh students across Telangana. He claimed the decision threatens the continuation of key support systems like fee reimbursement, which are crucial for students from economically weaker sections.

He argued that the policy would disproportionately impact students belonging to BC,

SC, ST, and minority communities, potentially disrupting their access to higher education. Referring to concerns raised earlier by K. T. Rama Rao, he said the government must avoid politicizing issues related to students' futures.

Thunga Balu expressed disappointment that instead of strengthening the education sector, the administration was allegedly introducing measures that weaken it. He accused the government of sidelining welfare initiatives that previously benefited students and warned that such steps could force many to discontinue their studies.

The BRSV leader demanded that G.O. No. 7 be revoked without delay and that the government issue an apology to students. He also cautioned that if the concerns of the student community are ignored, protests could intensify in the coming days.

BJP Conducts Bhoomi Puja Ahead of PM Modi's Rally

Woman, Son Held for Murder

According to police, tensions had escalated in re-

cent months, with the man allegedly harassing both the woman and her son. On Sunday night, the duo is suspected to have attacked him with a sharp weapon, resulting in his death. After the incident, they allegedly attempted to conceal the crime by placing the body in a gunny bag and moving it. Acting on a tip-off, police reached the spot, recovered the body, and detained the suspects. A case has been registered, and further investigation is underway.

CCTV Awareness Drive

Head Constable Missing After Duty

A head constable serving as a gunman to a senior police officer in the city has been reported missing since Saturday evening. According to police, he was last seen around 4 pm after signing off from duty but did not return home.

Officials said the constable left behind his two-wheeler, house keys, and lunch box at the workplace, raising concerns about his sudden disappearance. Following a complaint filed by his wife, the police launched a search operation and began examining CCTV footage for clues. Visuals reportedly show him near Hussainsagar lake and later in the vicinity of the HYDRABAD office along the lake shore.

Preliminary inquiries suggest that the constable may

have been under significant emotional stress. Sources indicated that he had recently been reprimanded by a senior officer in front of colleagues, which may have affected him deeply. It is also alleged that he faced pressure to share personal details of a woman complainant associated with a women's safety unit, which he reportedly refused.

The constable is said to have submitted a written complaint to an officer of ACP rank regarding the incident. However, no immediate action was taken, which may have further distressed him, sources added.

Police teams are continuing efforts to trace his whereabouts, and investigations are ongoing to determine the circumstances surrounding his disappearance.

Cyberabad Police Transfers 65 SHOs in Major Reshuffle

In a significant administrative move, Cyberabad Police Commissioner M. Ramesh ordered the transfer of 65 Station House Officer (SHO)-rank officials as part of a restructuring exercise aimed at improving field-level policing. Several officers have been directed to report to Multi Zone-2 as part of the reshuffle. According to officials, the transfers are intended to strengthen law and order, enhance transparency,

and boost operational efficiency across police stations. The move is also seen as the beginning of wider changes likely to be implemented across the state police system.

Among those transferred to Multi Zone-2 are officers from key police stations, including Chandanagar, RC Puram, Ameenpur, IDA Bolaram, Kolur, Raidurgam, Cyber Crimes, Medchal, Pet Basheerabad, and Jeedimetla, along with a traffic official from Medchal.

Sources indicated that several officers had been serving

in the same postings for extended periods, prompting the department to initiate transfers for administrative balance and better governance. Regular rotation of personnel is also expected to bring fresh perspectives to policing and improve service delivery.

Officials added that similar reshuffles are likely to be carried out in other commissionerates within the city in the near future as part of ongoing efforts to streamline operations and maintain effective law enforcement.

Commissioner Srijana sets Deadline for cleanliness

Municipal Corporation Commissioner Srijana conducted a surprise inspection of Kompally Circle-56 to assess civic issues and sanitation conditions. During her visit on Monday, she focused on key public concerns and reviewed the overall situation in the area.

fielded Telugu-origin candidates to consolidate this vote bank, especially in closely contested constituencies.

Against this backdrop, TVK's rise signals a fresh political recalibration. Its outreach, as reflected in campaign material, directly appeals to Telugu voters while emphasising inclusivity and representation. Observers believe the party is consciously fielding candidates from Telugu-speaking backgrounds in targeted regions to strengthen its base.

According to sources, TVK has fielded candidates in constituencies with notable Telugu presence. P. Revanth Saran is contesting from Maduravoyal, M.L. Vijay Prabh from Madhavaram, S.R. Sambangi from Veppanahalli, M. Ambarish from Hosur, and G. Suresh from Thalli. Notably, major Dravidian parties have also recognised this voter base, with AIADMK allotting seats to 11 Telugu-origin candidates and DMK to 13 candidates. These constituencies, particularly in northern and western Tamil Nadu, have mixed linguistic demographics, where Telugu voters can influence outcomes.

Another key dimension is cultural assimilation. Over time, many Telugu-origin families have adopted Tamil as

their primary language while retaining their cultural identity. This dual identity makes them a unique and influential voter group, often shaping electoral outcomes without being distinctly categorised.

With over 5.67 crore voters in Tamil Nadu and a significant Telugu-speaking segment among them, the ongoing elections underline the importance of linguistic dynamics in politics. TVK's initial performance suggests that tapping into this voter base may have provided it with a strategic advantage.

As counting progresses, attention remains on whether this consolidation of Telugu voters will translate into a decisive mandate for TVK, potentially reshaping the state's political landscape.

Speaking to True Point, S. Rama Krishna, Founder of the Sri Krishna Devaraya Employees Association, said, "We firmly believe that the Telugu-speaking community has long been a silent yet decisive force in Tamil Nadu's socio-political landscape. With growing awareness and unity, their voice is becoming more visible and influential. It is essential that every political platform, including emerging forces, ensures fair representation and respect for Telugu identity while upholding harmony and inclusiveness."

Work-Site School Launched for Migrant Children

RamchanderNaik stated that compensation and other forms of assistance would be processed on priority to provide immediate financial relief. He emphasized that the welfare of farmers and agricultural workers remains a key focus for the government. In view of

the recent unseasonal rains, he assured that steps would be taken to minimize the impact of such natural calamities on rural livelihoods. Following his hospital visit, the MLA inspected a procurement centre at Kuravimandal headquarters. During interactions with farmers and officials, he directed authorities to improve arrangements and ensure smooth functioning of procurement operations. He stressed that recent rains should not disrupt the process and that farmers must not face difficulties in selling their produce. RamchanderNaik also criticized the opposition BRS, alleging that it was politicizing natural disasters. He reiterated that the government is committed to safeguarding farmers' interests and ensuring uninterrupted support during the ongoing agricultural season.

Manhunt Intensifies After Armed Jewellery Robbery

Karimnagar, May 4 | TPN Bureau
Police have launched an extensive manhunt to trace an armed gang involved in a daring robbery at a jewellery showroom in Jyothi Nagar, Karimnagar, on Sunday. Senior officials, including Inspector General S. Chandrasekhar Reddy, reached the town soon after the incident to oversee the investigation and coordinate efforts to capture the accused, who reportedly fired shots during the crime. Preliminary investigation suggests the involvement of an organized inter-state gang, believed to be linked to the notorious "Parli Gang" from Maharashtra. Officials suspect the group is well-trained, equipped with sophisticated weapons, and experienced in executing planned robberies with swift escape strategies. Forensic experts collected fingerprints from the scene, but initial checks showed no match with local criminal records. Authorities are now cross-verifying the data with national

databases to identify the suspects. Investigators believe the gang used a carefully designed escape plan, possibly transporting motorcycles in larger vehicles such as container trucks or buses to evade detection. Based on technical surveillance, the suspects are believed to have fled via University Road, moving past Kothapally and towards Mothe village through routes with minimal CCTV coverage. Their escape path may have extended through interior areas towards district borders, with a possible exit towards Maharashtra via National Highway 63. Police also identified suspicious mobile numbers active during the robbery that were switched off immediately afterward. Investigators are examining links to a recent incident in KomaramBheem district, suspecting the same gang's involvement. Authorities remain hopeful of a breakthrough through coordinated intelligence and field operations.

Flash Rains Cause Widespread Damage

Hyderabad, May 04 | TPN Bureau

Unseasonal rains accompanied by lightning and strong winds caused extensive damage across several districts of Telangana on Sunday, severely impacting agriculture and daily life. In a tragic incident, a farmer identified as Neelam Venkanna (42) lost his life after being struck by lightning while working at an IKP procurement centre in Sudanapally village of Mahabubabad district. He sustained critical injuries and died on the spot. The sudden downpour disrupted harvesting and post-harvest activities, with large quantities of paddy laid out on roads for drying getting

soaked. Crops transported to market yards were also damaged despite farmers' attempts to protect them with tarpaulins. Mango orchards suffered significant losses due to high-speed winds, adding to the distress of cultivators. In Mahabubabad town, maize and paddy brought to the agricultural market yard were damaged by rainwater. Similar scenes were reported in Khammam district, where maize stocks at procurement centres in Nelakondapalli were drenched. In areas including Khammam city, Chintakani, Wyra, Karepalli, and Kusumanchi, paddy left out for drying was spoiled due to the sudden showers. In Bhadradi-Kothagudem

district, maize bags stored at the Illendu market yard were submerged in stagnant rainwater, resulting in further losses. Meanwhile, in Nalgonda district, strong winds uprooted trees and electricity poles, and blew away tin sheets from sheds, causing property damage. Mancherial district also faced disruptions, particularly in Kyatanpalli, where fallen trees blocked roads and hindered traffic movement for several hours. Power supply was interrupted in multiple areas due to damaged infrastructure. The unexpected weather has left farmers counting losses and raised concerns over crop protection during the ongoing season.

Police Summer Camp Launched

A month-long summer camp aimed at nurturing discipline, fitness, and skill development among children was inaugurated across Adilabad district under the supervision of the police. District SP Akhil Mahajan formally launched the initiative, which is being conducted as part of the "Police for You" outreach program. The program is designed to provide a constructive and engaging environment for children during the summer holidays, encouraging them to stay active and reduce excessive screen time. In addition to sports training, participants will also be introduced to awareness sessions on police functioning, including visits to police stations, correctional facilities, and demonstrations by canine units. These activities aim to

give students a better understanding of law enforcement. The SP expressed confidence that the camp would positively influence the participants and appreciated parents for encouraging their children to take part. He also interacted with students at various activity sections and joined them in sports like archery and volleyball, motivating them to actively engage in all sessions. Senior police officials and trainers were present at the inauguration, ensuring smooth conduct of the program across all centers.



Police Bust Fake Currency & Black Money Fraud Gang

Warangal, May 04 | TPN Bureau

Warangal police arrested eight individuals involved in manufacturing counterfeit currency and running a "black money conversion" fraud racket, officials said on Monday. The accused allegedly cheated victims by promising to triple their money through illegal currency exchange schemes. The arrested persons have been identified as Saganti Kiran, Neerati Shiva, NeeratiRanjit, Gudikandula Ravi, PorikaRajkumar, TanamalaRajasekhar, MuduruKolaYakambaram, and ChenuSaikiran. Police have registered cases against all the accused and are continuing further investigation into

their activities. According to police, the gang operated across multiple districts, including Secunderabad, Mulugu, Kothagudem, Chatrinaka, and Narsampet. The group had two separate operational methods. Three of the accused were involved in producing fake Rs 100 currency notes using laptops, color printers, and printing materials, which they circulated in local markets. The remaining five members carried out a "1:3 money exchange scam," where they convinced victims that blackened bundles of paper could be converted into multiple times higher-value currency using chemical treatment. They reportedly used iodine and sodium thiosulphate to manipulate

genuine Rs 500 notes to mislead victims and gain their trust before handing over bundles of worthless paper. During the operation, police seized Rs 1.48 lakh in cash, counterfeit notes, printing equipment, 13 mobile phones, and two cars. The total value of seized property is estimated at around Rs 28 lakh. VVThe arrests were made through a coordinated effort by the Warangal Task Force and Narsampet police teams. Senior officials praised the teams for successfully dismantling the racket and preventing further fraud. Police have warned the public to remain cautious of such financial scams and not fall prey to promises of unrealistic returns or currency conversion schemes.

Record Assistant Suspended for Negligence

Karimnagar, May 4 | TPN Bureau

Peddapalli District Collector Koya Sri Harsha has suspended K. Chiranjeevi, a record assistant working at the Kamanpurmandaltahsildar office, over allegations of negligence and failure to perform duties. As per official orders, the employee was reportedly absent on multiple occasions without

prior information. He is also said to have ignored official calls and failed to respond to memos issued by higher authorities seeking clarification. The Collector noted that such conduct indicates a lack of responsibility expected from a government employee. The suspension has been enforced under the Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules to facilitate a departmental inquiry into the matter. The order has come into immediate effect. During the inquiry period, the official has been instructed not to leave the headquarters without prior approval. The Collector reiterated that strict measures will be taken against employees who neglect their responsibilities, emphasizing the need for accountability and discipline in public service.

MP Sanctions Rs 34.4 Lakh for Hand Pumps in Water-Scarce Areas

Khammam MP RamasahayamRaghuram Reddy has sanctioned Rs 34.4 lakh under MP-LADS funds for the installation of 43 hand pumps in Khammam and BhadradiKothagudem districts to tackle drinking water shortages during the summer. Officials have been instructed to take up the works across 20 mandals in the erstwhile Khammam district, prioritizing villages facing acute water scarcity. Out of the total allocation, Rs 4.80 lakh has been earmarked for Enkurumandal, where six hand pumps will be installed. Other identified mandals include Lakshmidivipalli, Chunchupalli, Sujathanagar, Aswaraopeta, Wyra, Bonakal, Madhira, Annapureddy, Mulakalappalli, Dammapeta, Konijerla, Mudigonda, Tallada, Nelakondapalli, Errupalem, Kalluru, Kothagudem, and Chandrugonda. The Rural Water Supply de-



partment will execute the projects using the sanctioned funds. The MP directed officials to expedite administrative approvals and ensure timely completion of all works. Special emphasis has been placed on agency areas and SC/ST habitations to prevent water shortages and ensure access to safe drinking water during the peak summer months.

Migrant Worker's Body Brought Home After Delay

The mortal remains of a migrant worker from Jagtial district were finally repatriated from Bahrain after a prolonged delay, with the help of social worker Shaik Chand Pasha. The deceased, Mukkera Prasad (40), hailed from Kondapur village in Metpallymandal and had been working in Bahrain for the past 15 months. According to available information, Prasad suffered a heart attack and passed away on March 16. However, the process of bringing his body back to India was delayed for nearly 45 days. The delay was reportedly caused after an unidentified individual falsely claimed to be a relative of the deceased and allegedly demanded Rs 10 lakh from the employer, leading to complications. As a re-

sult, the body remained in the mortuary of Salmaniya Hospital during this period. After being approached by Prasad's brother, Rajesh, Chand Pasha intervened and took up the matter. He coordinated with the employer and officials at the Indian Embassy in Bahrain to resolve the issue. Following discussions, the employer agreed to provide financial support of Rs 1.50 lakh to the family, along with Rs 80,000 towards pending legal dues. Further assistance from the NRI Cell and the state government's protocol department helped in arranging a free ambulance service upon the body's arrival in India. The mortal remains were received at the airport and later transported to Kondapur village, where the final rites were performed by family members.

Prashant Kishor Says Vijay's Political Rise Was Predictable, Calls It a 'Structured Surge'

The two-kilometre march, held as part of the government's 100-day "NashaMukt Jammu & Kashmir" campaign, saw participation from students, government employees, officials, and citizens from across the Kashmir Valley. Participants carried placards and raised slogans against drug abuse, turning the event into a powerful show of collective resolve.

Addressing the gathering after the march, Sinha called for



a united effort to eliminate drugs from society. He urged people to work towards a future where "no child is lost to drugs" and no family suffers due to addiction, stressing that the fight requires community involvement alongside govern-

ment action.

The padyatra comes amid an aggressive crackdown on drug trafficking in the Union Territory. In just 22 days, authorities have registered hundreds of cases and arrested 518 drug peddlers, signaling a zero-tol-

erance approach toward the narcotics trade.

Officials revealed that 481 FIRs were filed during this period, while several properties linked to drug money were also targeted. Houses built using proceeds from drug trafficking have been demolished, and assets worth crores have been seized as part of the ongoing campaign.

The administration has also taken additional measures to tighten enforcement, including recommending the cancellation of more than 300 driving licences linked to those involved in drug-related activities. These steps reflect a broader strategy combining awareness drives with strict legal action.

The anti-drug campaign, launched earlier in April, fo-

cus on multiple fronts such as public awareness, youth engagement, rehabilitation, and strong enforcement against traffickers. Authorities have described it as a "whole-of-government" approach aimed at tackling the issue at its roots.

The large turnout for the padyatra underscores rising public awareness and concern over drug abuse in the region. US-Led Task Force Launches Project Freedom to Reopen Strait of Hormuz

The United States has officially launched a major maritime operation in the Strait of Hormuz, aiming to restore shipping movement through one of the world's most critical oil routes amid ongoing tensions with Iran.

The initiative, part of what US President Donald Trump has called "Project Freedom," involves a US-led task force guiding stranded commercial vessels through the strait. The move comes after months of disruption caused by conflict in the region, which has left thousands of ships stuck and severely impacted global trade and energy supplies. To ensure safer navigation, authorities have established an "enhanced security area" south of the usual shipping lanes. Ships have been advised to re-route through Omani waters and coordinate closely with local authorities due to heavy traffic and safety concerns. One of the biggest risks in the region remains naval mines. Officials have warned that traditional routes through the strait are highly dangerous, as mines have not been fully



cleared or mapped. This has forced shipping operators to exercise extreme caution, even as the US tries to restore confidence in the route. The operation marks a sig-

nificant escalation in US involvement in the region. While the mission is being framed as a humanitarian effort to free stranded vessels and stabilise global supply

chains, it also carries geopolitical risks. Analysts warn that the move could strain the fragile ceasefire between the US and Iran, which has held despite unresolved tensions

following the recent conflict. Iran has responded strongly to the development, insisting that any movement through the strait must be coordinated with its forces. It has warned of potential retaliation if foreign military presence increases or if ships pass through without its approval.

The Strait of Hormuz is a vital chokepoint for global oil shipments, handling a significant portion of the world's energy trade. Any disruption in this narrow passage has immediate ripple effects on oil prices, global markets, and supply chains. While the US-led task force aims to normalise shipping activity, uncertainty remains high. It is still unclear how many vessels will participate in the guided transit or how Iran will react in the coming days. Overall, the launch of "Project Freedom" represents a crucial but risky step toward reopening the strait. Its success will depend not only on military coordination but also on diplomatic efforts to prevent further escalation in an already volatile region



Oil Prices Ease Slightly as Trump Signals Help for Stranded Ships in Hormuz

Global oil prices saw a modest dip after US President Donald Trump announced that the United States would assist ships stranded in the Strait of Hormuz, offering some relief to markets rattled by ongoing geopolitical tensions.

The statement comes amid a prolonged disruption in one of the world's most critical oil transit routes, where thousands of vessels have been stuck due to escalating conflict between the US and Iran. Trump's assurance that the US would help guide ships safely through the strait raised hopes of easing supply bottlenecks, leading to a slight cooling in crude prices.

Despite the decline, oil prices remain elevated, hovering above the \$100 per barrel mark. The continued uncertainty in the region and the absence of a clear resolution between the US and Iran are keeping markets on edge.

The Strait of Hormuz is a vital global chokepoint, handling a significant share of the world's oil shipments. Any disruption in this narrow passage has immediate consequences for global energy markets, pushing prices higher and in-

creasing volatility. Trump's announcement is part of a broader effort, often referred to as 'Project Freedom', aimed at restoring navigation and stabilising supply chains. The initiative involves guiding commercial vessels through safer routes and helping clear congestion caused by months of tension and restricted movement.

However, the situation remains fragile. Iran has warned that any foreign intervention in the strait must be coordinated with its forces, raising concerns about potential retaliation and further escalation.

Market reactions reflect this delicate balance. While the promise of US assistance has eased immediate supply fears, investors remain cautious due to conflicting signals from both sides and the risk of renewed conflict.

Overall, the slight drop in oil prices offers temporary relief, but the broader outlook remains uncertain. Much will depend on how effectively the US-led efforts can restore shipping activity and whether diplomatic tensions in the region can be contained in the coming days.



Suspected Hantavirus Outbreak on Atlantic Cruise Ship Leaves 3 Dead

A suspected outbreak of the rare and potentially deadly hantavirus on a cruise ship in the Atlantic Ocean has resulted in the deaths of three passengers, raising serious concerns among health authorities and maritime officials.

According to reports, several passengers aboard the vessel began showing symptoms such as fever, fatigue, and respiratory distress during the voyage. Medical teams on board initially treated the cases as a general illness, but as conditions worsened and fatalities were reported, suspicions turned toward hantavirus—a rare virus typically transmitted through contact with infected rodents or their droppings.

Health authorities were alerted, and the ship was placed under close monitoring as it continued its journey. Emergency protocols were activated, including isolating symptomatic passengers and conducting preliminary medical evaluations to prevent further spread.

Hantavirus infections are uncommon but can be severe, often leading to hantavirus pulmonary syndrome (HPS), a condition that affects the lungs and can be fatal if not treated promptly. The virus is not generally transmitted from person to person, but confined environments like cruise ships raise concerns about indirect

exposure and contamination. Experts believe the source of the outbreak may be linked to rodent exposure on the ship or contaminated supplies, though investigations are ongoing. Officials are working to trace the origin and determine whether proper safety and sanitation protocols were followed.

Passengers and crew members have been advised to remain cautious, with many undergoing medical screening upon arrival at port. Authorities are also coordinating with international health agencies to monitor any potential spread beyond the ship.

The incident has reignited concerns about health risks in closed environments such as cruise ships, which have previously been associated with outbreaks of infectious diseases. It also highlights the importance of strict hygiene measures, pest control, and rapid response systems in preventing such situations.

While officials have not yet officially confirmed hantavirus as the cause, the suspected outbreak has prompted heightened vigilance. Further testing and analysis are expected to provide clarity in the coming days. Overall, the tragic deaths underscore the seriousness of the situation and the need for swift action to contain any potential outbreak, ensuring the safety of passengers and preventing further loss of life.

Canada Labels Khalistani Extremists a National Security Threat Amid Rising Concerns

Canada has officially classified Khalistani extremists as a national security threat, marking a significant shift in its stance as concerns grow over extremist activities within the country. In its latest public safety report, the Canadian government highlighted that violent extremism linked to Khalistani elements poses a serious risk to national security. The report noted that while not all supporters of the Khalistan movement are involved in unlawful activities, a small but concerning segment has been associated with extremist ideologies and actions. Authorities pointed out that these elements have been involved in activities such as promoting violence, issuing threats, and supporting radical agendas. The designation aims to help law enforcement agencies better monitor and counter such threats while maintaining a distinction between peaceful political expression and extremist behavior.

The report also underlined the importance of safeguarding citizens while upholding democratic values such as freedom of speech and peaceful activism. Experts believe the classification could lead to stricter surveillance, intelligence-sharing, and potential legal action against individuals or groups found to be engaging in extremist activities. It may also impact immigration policies and community monitoring efforts. However, the decision is likely to be sensitive, especially within sections of the Sikh community in Canada. Authorities have reiterated that their focus is strictly on individuals or groups involved in extremism, not on any religious or cultural community as a whole. Overall, Canada's move signals a more assertive approach toward tackling internal security threats, while also attempting to balance civil liberties. It marks an important development in both domestic security policy and international relations, particularly with India.

Iran Urges US to Drop Excessive Demands, Says Ending War Is Top Priority

Iran has called on the United States to scale back what it described as "excessive demands," stressing that its primary focus at this stage is to bring an end to the ongoing conflict between the two nations.

In a recent statement, Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesperson Esmail Baqaei said that Tehran remains open to negotiations but only if Washington adopts a more "reasonable approach." He made it clear that the continuation of talks depends on the US easing its stance and abandoning conditions that Iran considers unrealistic.

"At this stage, our priority is to end the war," Baqaei said during a televised briefing, underlining Iran's willingness to pursue a resolution—provided its concerns are addressed.

The remarks come at a time when diplomatic efforts be-

tween the two countries have largely stalled, despite a ceasefire that came into effect in early April. While both sides have engaged in indirect negotiations through mediators, progress has been slow due to disagreements over key conditions for ending the conflict.

Iran has consistently argued that US proposals include demands that are "unreasonable and unrealistic," which have hindered meaningful progress in talks. These include issues related to sanctions, military presence in the region, and broader geopolitical conditions tied to the conflict.

At the same time, Tehran has signalled that it is not against dialogue. Instead, it is seeking a balanced agreement that respects its position while ensuring a lasting end to hostilities. The latest statement suggests that Iran is willing to move forward with negotiations—but

only if both sides show flexibility.

The ongoing tensions stem from a broader conflict involving the US, Iran, and regional allies, which has had significant global implications, including disruptions to oil supply routes and increased geopolitical uncertainty.

Despite the tough rhetoric, the emphasis on ending the war indicates that diplomatic channels remain open, albeit fragile. Analysts believe that the coming days will be crucial in determining whether both sides can bridge their differences and reach a mutually acceptable agreement.

For now, Iran's message is clear: it is ready to pursue peace, but not at the cost of accepting terms it views as excessive—setting the stage for a critical phase in US-Iran negotiations.



Nepal Plans Mass Cancellation of 1,600 Politically Motivated Appointments

Nepal's government is set to undertake a sweeping administrative overhaul by cancelling nearly 1,600 appointments deemed "politically motivated," in one of the most significant bureaucratic reforms in recent years.

The move comes through an ordinance approved by President Ramchandra Paudel, following recommendations from the council of ministers led by Prime Minister Balendra Shah. Once implemented, the measure will terminate the positions of around 1,594 officials across a wide range of public institutions.

The decision primarily targets appointments made by previous governments, including those during the interim administration that followed Nepal's 2025 "Gen Z" protests.



These protests, driven by public anger over corruption and governance issues, paved the way for a major political shift and the rise of Shah's government.

Those affected include individuals holding key positions such as vice-chancellors, rectors, university deans, heads

of constitutional bodies, and officials in state-owned enterprises and government boards. The sweeping nature of the ordinance also means that appointments across education, healthcare, media, and public administration sectors will be impacted simultaneously.

The ordinance will amend

over 100 laws and has been designed to remove what the government views as entrenched political influence in public institutions. Officials say the goal is to improve transparency, enhance efficiency, and move toward a more merit-based system of governance.

However, the scale of the move has raised concerns. Experts warn that the sudden removal of such a large number of officials could disrupt the functioning of key institutions. Many organisations may face leadership gaps, and routine decision-making could be delayed due to the absence of authorised signatories.

Sectors like education and healthcare are expected to be particularly affected, as universities and public health institutions rely heavily on ap-

pointed leadership for operations and policy decisions. Reports suggest that several major bodies could temporarily struggle to function smoothly until new appointments are made.

The government has not yet clarified the timeline or mechanism for filling the vacant positions, adding to uncertainty about how quickly normal functioning can be restored.

Overall, the move signals the Shah administration's intent to break from past practices and assert control over governance structures. While supporters view it as a necessary step toward reform and accountability, critics caution that the abrupt overhaul could create short-term instability even as it aims for long-term institutional change.



Market Rebounds Strongly, Sensex Gains 356 Points, Nifty Ends Above 24,100

Indian equity markets staged a notable recovery on May 4, bouncing back after recent losses and ending the day on a positive note. Benchmark indices—the BSE Sensex and NSE Nifty 50—both closed higher, reflecting improved investor sentiment driven by a mix of domestic and global factors.

The Sensex rose by 355.90 points, or 0.46 percent, to settle at 77,269.40, while the Nifty climbed 121.75 points, or 0.51 percent, closing above the crucial 24,100 mark at 24,119.30. Despite some volatility during the session, the indices managed to hold onto gains by the closing

bell.

Markets opened on a strong footing and even approached higher levels during early trade, with the Nifty nearing 24,300. However, profit booking in the later part of the session trimmed some of these gains, highlighting cautious optimism among investors.

The rebound was largely supported by positive triggers such as robust auto sales data for April, easing crude oil prices, and favourable political developments. These factors collectively boosted market confidence after the sharp sell-off seen in the previous sessions.

Broad-based buying was

visible across sectors, with midcap and smallcap indices also rising by around 0.5 percent each, indicating wider participation in the rally. Realty and metal stocks performed well, while IT stocks lagged, acting as a drag on the overall market.

A key highlight of the session was the strong momentum in individual stocks. More than 180 companies on the BSE touched their 52-week highs, including prominent names such as BHEL, Adani Green Energy, Siemens, Bajaj Auto, and Bandhan Bank. Notably, BHEL surged around 7.5 percent following strong quarterly earnings, contributing to

the positive market tone.

The rally also aligned with broader global cues. Easing crude oil prices and improving geopolitical signals helped reduce market anxiety, while positive domestic political trends added further support to investor sentiment.

The upcoming CKYC 2.0 system is expected to play a crucial role in achieving the government's "One Nation, One KYC" objective. This initiative aims to ensure that individuals do not have to repeatedly complete verification processes across different financial platforms such as banks, mutual funds, and insurance services.

However, Pandey also pointed out that authentication remains a key challenge. Without reliable verification mecha-



nisms, shared KYC data could become inaccurate or untrustworthy. To address this, SEBI is working closely with other regulators and institutions to build a robust and interoperable system that ensures both security and efficiency.

The push for a unified KYC framework has also received strong backing from Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. She has stressed the need for a seamless, secure, and portable KYC experience, urging regulators to act with urgency so that citizens can access financial services without repetitive paperwork.

CKYC 2.0 is expected to significantly improve user experi-

ence by digitising and standardising KYC processes. It will help streamline customer onboarding, reduce compliance burdens, and enhance coordination among financial regulators. The system is being developed with inputs from multiple stakeholders, including CERSAI, which is leading the initiative. Overall, the rollout of CKYC 2.0 marks a critical step toward modernising India's financial infrastructure. By enabling a unified and efficient KYC system, regulators aim to make financial services more accessible, transparent, and user-friendly—benefiting both investors and institutions in the long run.

Ambuja Cements Q4 Profit Jumps on Tax Credit, Margins Take a Hit

Ambuja Cements reported a sharp rise in its standalone net profit for the fourth quarter of FY26, driven largely by a one-time tax credit. However, the company's operating performance remained under pressure, with margins contracting significantly due to rising costs. The Adani Group-owned cement maker posted a standalone net profit of 1,644 crore, nearly three times higher than 555 crore in the same quarter last year. This surge was primarily supported by a tax credit of 1,462 crore, compared to a tax expense in the year-ago period. Despite the strong bottom-line growth, the underlying business performance showed signs of weakness. On a consolidated basis, profit after tax declined to 569 crore from 856 crore a year earlier, indicating that the headline growth was largely due to exceptional gains rather than



core operations. Revenue, however, remained robust. The company reported a record quarterly revenue of 10,915 crore, marking a 9% year-on-year increase. This growth was driven by strong demand and a 10% rise in cement sales volumes, which reached an all-time high of 19.9 million tonnes during the quarter. Operating profitabili-

ty, on the other hand, came under pressure. EBITDA fell to 1,464 crore from 1,868 crore in the previous year, while EBITDA margins dropped sharply to 13.4% from 18.7%. Higher input costs, particularly fuel, diesel, and logistics—played a major role in squeezing margins. The company's standalone EBITDA also saw a steep decline of over 38%, with

margins narrowing to 9.3% compared to 16% last year. This reflects the broader cost pressures faced by the cement industry despite strong volume growth. Industry trends remained supportive during the quarter, with infrastructure spending and construction activity driving demand. However, rising expenses linked to global factors, including geopolitical tensions and energy prices, continue to weigh on profitability. Overall, while Ambuja Cements delivered impressive profit growth on paper, the results highlight a divergence between reported earnings and operational strength. The sharp margin contraction underscores ongoing cost challenges, suggesting that sustaining profitability will depend on managing expenses and maintaining pricing power in the coming quarters.



Loco Pilot Stops Train to Save Buffalo, Wins Hearts Online
