Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysore, on Monday. The partnership aims to integrate advanced scientific methods into the food systems of the temple board. This collaborative initiative will introduce scientific

protocols across food preparation, distribution, storage, and testing processes. The primary objective is to enhance the safety, nutrition, and overall quality of Srivari prasadam while strictly preserving their traditional character, authentic taste, and cultural value. Under this pact, joint teams will develop rigorous quality-control standards and stan-

dard operating procedures to minimize contamination risks. The research institute will advise on upgrading procurement and testing workflows, including specialized assessments for ghee purity and aroma profiling. Furthermore, research-led packaging interventions will be developed to extend the shelf life and stability of the sacred offerings. The insti-

tute will also provide structured technical training for in-house food analysts and handlers in advanced analytical techniques and contaminant detection. Senior scientists will conduct regular facility visits to support implementation, validation studies, and storage planning. Food analysts, handlers, and senior scientists participated in this program.

Pushpayaga Mahotsavam Celebrated Grandly at Venugopalaswamy Temple

Government Working to Ensure Remunerative Price for Totapuri Mango Farmers: Special Chief Secretary B. Rajasekhara

Agriculture Department Special Chief Secretary B. Rajasekhara stated during a hybrid zoom meeting that the government is making all efforts to secure remunerative prices for Totapuri mango farmers. District Collector Sumanth Kumar noted that Chittoor district started purchases at Rs 7 per kg, but lower rates elsewhere

prompting discussions for a uniform state-wide pricing policy. Over 30,000 of the region's 50,000 mango farmers reside in Chittoor alone. To assist growers, authorities are monitoring local pulp industries through MRO inspections. Out of 31 juice factories in the district, 28 are functional, though only 14 are currently purchasing Totapuri mangoes. Rajasekhara announced that a high-level meeting will be

held with the Chief Minister next week to finalize price increases and ensure maximum benefits for the farming community. Coca-Cola and AP Food Processing Society representatives also joined the talks. The meeting was attended by Agriculture Department Special Chief Secretary B. Rajasekhara, District Collector Sumanth Kumar, Horticulture Department DD Satish, and ED Koteswara Rao.

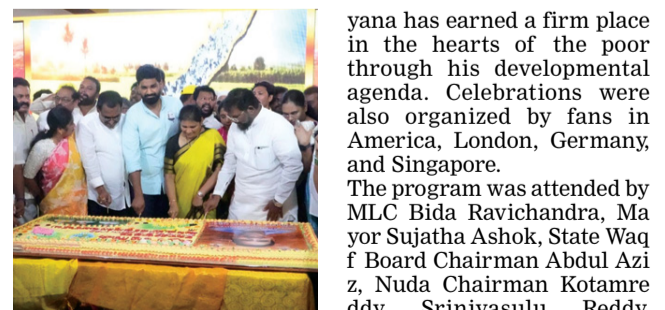
