Chandragiri MLA Praises State's Two-Year Developmental Milestone

State governance has rapidly progressed under the leadership of Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu over the last two years, stated Chandragiri legislator Pulivarthi Nani during a developmental welfare program. He described the Chief Minister as an administrative system focused on long-term growth rather than votes, citing landmarks from IT to AI, alongside major industrial



arrivals like Google, Royal Enfield, and AMCA fighter jet manufacturers.

The legislator lauded Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan for standing as a strong pillar of support in transforming rural governance and streamlining drinking water connectivity. He also commended State IT Minister Nara Lokesh for winning public trust through his extensive 3,132-kilometre Yuvagalam padayatra. Collector Himanshu Shukla Conducts Field Visit to Palicherlapadu

YSRCP Protests Against Coalition Government's Failures

The YSR Congress Party launched a massive protest in Anantapur against CM Chandrababu Naidu for failing to implement election promises over the past two years. Led by YSRCP District President and Anantapur Urban Assembly Constituency Coordinator Anantha Venkataramireddy, party ranks released black balloons at Lalitha Kala Parishad. The protesters marched in a large rally to the Tower Clock, where they



formed a human chain. They carried placards highlighting government failures, particularly regarding irregularities in DSC appointments made under Education Minister Nara Lokesh. They also held a funeral procession with an effigy

of the coalition government, leading to brief arguments with the police. Anantha Venkataramireddy demanded an immediate CBI probe into the DSC process. He criticized the government for denying the promised financial aid to women and unemployed youth, and warned that agitations would continue. The protest concluded under the leadership of YSRCP District President Anantha Venkataramireddy, condemning the policies of CM Chandrababu Naidu and Education Minister Nara Lokesh.
