

CMRF Works As Sanjeevini For The Poor, Says Minister Narayana

State Municipal and Urban Development Minister Dr Ponguru Narayana distributed Chief Minister Relief Fund cheques worth Rs 32,17,600 to 49 beneficiaries at his camp office in Nellore City constituency on Thursday. Speaking on the occasion, Narayana stated that despite severe financial constraints, the Chief Minister is consistently releasing funds to support the underprivileged. He emphasized that the CMRF operates as a vital life-saver, or Sanjeevini, for poor families during medical and financial crises. The minister revealed that over the last two years, the



government has provided financial assistance totaling Rs 4,04,98,692 to 433 individuals within the constituency. Highlighting healthcare initiatives, Narayana mentioned that the Narayana Netrajyothi and Dantha Suraksha programs were

specifically launched to deliver corporate-level medical care to the poor completely free of cost. Within a short span of four months, these health initiatives conducted through medical examinations for 10,000 people, distributed free eyeglasses to 5,000 individuals, and provided comprehensive dental check-ups for another 5,000 citizens. Narayana reiterated that the coalition government places equal emphasis on welfare programs and infrastructure development. He assured the public that the ongoing underground drainage projects in the city would achieve 100 per cent completion by December. The cheque distribution event witnessed active participation from local leaders, party workers, and beneficiaries who expressed their gratitude to the administration. Former municipal chairperson Tallapaka Anuradha, former ZPTC Vijetha Reddy, and TDP city party president Mamidala Madhu participated in this program.

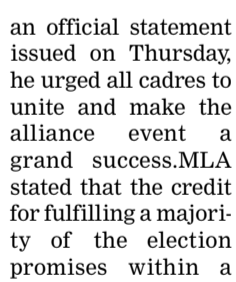

Free Knee Surgeries Restore Mobility For Underprivileged Patients

Doctors at Apollo District Head Government Hospital successfully performed free knee replacement surgeries on two underprivileged patients, restoring their mobility. M Challayya, a 76-year-old from Chinnampalle village in Yadamarri mandal, who suffered from chronic knee pain, began walking the day after his operation. He recovered fully under expert physiotherapy care. Similarly, P Sunitha, a 47-year-old from Peddaramapuram village in Pakala mandal, found relief here after being unable to afford the expensive surgery at private hospitals in Tirupati and Bengaluru.



The successful surgeries were performed by an orthopedic team including Dr Haribabu, Dr Ashok, Dr Ashish, Dr Karthik, Dr Mogalish, and Dr Akhil. The complex surgeries brought immense relief to the families who praised the high-quality free medical services. Medical Superintendent Dr

Stage Set For JSW Steel Plant Construction In Jammalamadugu

The state government is preparing to commence the long-awaited steel plant construction work very soon, announced District Collector Sridhar Cherukuri. Alongside local MLA C Adinarayana Reddy and JSW Group representatives, the District Collector inspected the initial foundation site at Sunnapuralla Palle village in Jammalamadugu constituency. "The mega project, planned across 3,500 acres with an investment of Rs 8,800 crore, aims for an annual production capacity of 3 million tons. Since the first phase had stalled over the past three years, the current administration under Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu is fast-tracking infrastructure and amenity development.



Arrangements, including reviewing helipads, are underway for an official stone-laying ceremony by the Chief Minister. The plant is expected to generate thousands of employment opportunities for local youth. Following the site inspection, officials interacted with farmers from Sunnapuralla, Sirigapalle, and Peddaluru villages, promising legal protections

and fair benefits. The collaborative inspection included a technical and administrative delegation to review land leases and necessary infrastructure.
