

Super Six Schemes Boost Public Trust in Coalition Government : Minister

Transport and Chittoor District In-charge Minister M. Ramprasad Reddy has said that the successful implementation of the "Super Six" promises has significantly strengthened public trust in the coalition government. Speaking at the district-level event titled "Two Years of Trust - Development and Welfare" held at PVKN Degree College in Chittoor, the Minister said the government, under the leadership of Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, and Minister Nara Lokesh, has been implementing welfare and development programmes in a balanced manner. He noted that the coalition govern-



ment has completed two years in office and has ensured benefits reach all sections of society. He highlighted that nearly 64 lakh people are receiving social security pensions in the State. He also mentioned that special focus is being given to farmers,

women, labourers, and backward communities. The Minister said that the State has attracted significant investments due to strong leadership, creating better employment opportunities for youth. He added that Chittoor district alone has received

PalleVeeksham: Collector Promises Pattas and Infrastructure in PidataPoluru

He announced that drinking water supply will be ensured within two weeks through the rural water supply department, and village roads will be upgraded with BT paving. During the event, house pattas were distributed to beneficiaries like Penchalamma and Seenayya, while a family member certificate was handed over to Venkatamma. Shukla inspected the DRDA stall,

handed over cheques worth Rs 4 lakh to self-help group associations, distributed PMDS seeds through the Agriculture Department, and provided feeder kits through the Animal Husbandry Department.
