# CM Chandrababu Naidu to Visit Tirupati on June 9

Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu will visit Tirupati district on June 9 to attend a massive public meeting at Daminedu. In preparation for the high-profile visit, District Collector S. Venkateswar, District SP L. Subbaraidu, and Chandragiri MLA PulivarthiNani inspected the venue on Sunday. The high-level delegation thoroughly reviewed the public meeting premises, stage construction progress, vehicle traffic routes, park-

ing lots, and designated entry and exit points for the public. Given the massive crowd anticipated for the event, Venkateswar directed all government departments to work in close coordination to complete the infrastructure arrangements well ahead of schedule. The Collector stressed that special focus must be placed on ensuring uninterrupted power supply, setting up emergency medical camps, enforcing strict security measures, and streamlining traffic control. He also instructed officials to install clear guidance sign-

boards across all parking areas to guarantee the smooth and hassle-free movement of vehicles. Furthermore, the administration is taking extensive precautions to counter the intense summer heat. Venkateswar ordered the wide-scale deployment of drinking water facilities and buttermilk distribution stations across the venue. Large-scale coolers, extensive shamianas, and other cooling amenities will be set up throughout the meeting premises, waiting zones, and parking areas to protect

attendees from the sun. A vast network of police, revenue, and departmental personnel have been deployed to oversee the execution of these extensive arrangements. The inspection program concluded with a review of department-wise duties, ensuring that public representatives and local administrators are aligned for the event. District Collector S. # Country's First Artificial Recharge Borewell Project Launched

A pioneering artificial infusion recharge borewell project has been successfully launched in Gunakanapalle village of Lingala mandal to combat summer water scarcity. Facing severe water shortages for domestic use and banana plantations, local residents and authorities designed this innovative groundwater restoration system. The initial lift irrigation scheme stalled due to land acquisition issues, prompting this

alternative initiative funded through MP Lads. Five specialized boreholes were drilled near the local pond and connected via a pipeline to the Lingala right canal, pushing water directly into the earth's crust to prevent evaporation losses. Within just two to three days of operation, the local groundwater table rose dramatically. Previously, farmers had to drill up to 1,200 feet for water, but levels are now available at 500 feet. Officials estimate that expanding this method could help store 120 TMC of

water underground between the Papagni and Chitravati rivers without expensive land acquisition. The breakthrough has provided a major boost to the local agricultural economy and permanently resolved drinking water issues. The village residents expressed immense gratitude to the leadership and administrative teams who made this engineering feat possible. Former CM YS Jagan Mohan Reddy, Kadapa MP YS Avinash Reddy, and the local authorities participated in the program.
