As part of 'Special Intensive Revision - 2026', an orientation workshop was organized on Saturday at Indira Priyadarshini Auditorium of Sri Padmavati Mahila University with booth level agents of recognized national and state level political parties. The session detailed the necessity, purpose, and processes of the Special Comprehensive Revision, highlighting elector mapping and the enumeration sched-

She instructed agents to collect and submit the latest passport size color photograph of current voters to the booth level officers. TTD Releases Tirumala September Darshan and Seva Quota Schedule

The Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) on Saturday released the comprehensive online quota schedule for various darshan formats, arjitha sevas, and accommodation bookings for the month of September 2026. Devotees planning a pilgrimage to the hill shrine are advised to note the respective dates and timings to secure their bookings. According to the official release, the

online registration for the Electronic Dip system for premium Arjitha Sevas-including Suprabhatam, Thomala Seva, Archana, and Ashtadala Pada Padmaradhana Seva-will open at 10 AM on June 18. The registration window will close at 10 AM on June 20. Lucky dip winners must complete their ticket payments between June 20 and June 22 (before 12 Noon) to confirm their slots. Other major Arjitha Sevas, including Kalyanotsavam, Unjal Seva, Arjitha Brahmot-

savam, and Sahasra Deepalankara Seva, will feature a direct booking format starting at 10 AM on June 22. This will be followed by the release of the Virtual Sevas quota and corresponding darshan slots later that day at 3 PM. The following day, June 23, will handle multiple specialty quotas. The booking for AngapradaKshinam tokens will open at 10 AM, followed by the Srivani Trust Darshan tickets at 11 AM. The dedicated quota for senior citizens and

physically challenged pilgrims will go live at 3 PM. The highly sought-after Special Entry Darshan (Rs. 300) tickets are scheduled for release at 10 AM on June 24. Simultaneously, the accommodation booking quota for guest houses in both Tirumala and Tirupati will open at 3 PM on the same day. TTD officials have strongly cautioned devotees to use only the official website, ttdevasthanams.ap.gov.in, for all transactions to prevent falling prey to fraudulent platforms.
