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Distance Degrees Dry Up in AP, Leaving Aspirants in the Lurch

For thousands of youth in the state, distance education has long been the only bridge between financial hardship and higher studies. Today, that bridge is weakening. Recent University Grants Commission (UGC) data points to a sharp decline in opportunities to pursue bachelor's degrees through Open and Distance Learning (ODL), raising concern among educationists and student groups.

A review of the UGC's April 10, 2026 list for the 2025-26 academic year shows that Andhra University is the only institution in the state offering a wide range of undergraduate distance courses, including BA, B.Com and BBA programmes. In contrast, major universities such as Sri Venkateswara University and Acharya Nagarjuna University are confined to postgraduate courses, leaving general degree aspirants with limited or no options.

This trend runs contrary to the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which aims to raise the Gross Enrolment Ratio in higher education to 50% by 2035 and integrate distance learning into the mainstream. The policy emphasizes access for working individuals, rural



youth, women, and those whose education was interrupted. However, experts say these goals are not being reflected on the ground.

Speaking to True Point, Dr. Kappagantula Ramakrishna, Vice Principal of KBN College, Vijayawada, described the situation as alarming. "Distance education is not an alternative; it is the only option for many. Students who work during the day, women resuming studies, and youth from poor families depend on it. If undergraduate courses disappear, we are effectively blocking their future," he said. The crisis has deepened as admission deadlines for the current academic cycle have already passed, leaving many aspirants without any opportunity this year. For daily wage earners, in-service em-

ployees, and unemployed youth preparing for government jobs, a basic degree is essential, but increasingly out of reach.

Student organisations have strongly criticised the situation. ABVP State Secretary, Yaganti Venkata Gopi, demanded urgent action. "The government must resolve this issue without delay. Denying distance education opportunities means denying the future of thousands of students and unemployed youth," he told True Point, calling for immediate expansion of undergraduate programmes.

There is also criticism that Andhra Pradesh Ambedkar Open University, expected to play a key role in distance learning, is yet to function at full capacity, further limiting access for students from poor

- and middle-class backgrounds. Responding to the concerns, speaking to True Point, APSCHE Chairman Prof. K. Madhu Murthy said that, following updated guidelines, universities are in the process of securing approvals from their Academic Senates. He noted that undergraduate courses would be introduced after preparing course material, adding that some universities are already a step ahead. Educationists warn that the issue goes beyond admissions, affecting social mobility, employment prospects, and family stability. They urge the government to expand UG distance education, and fully operationalise open universities, stressing that education is a right, not a privilege.

CM Announces 10% Hike in Student Diet Charges

Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday announced a 10 per cent increase in diet charges for students staying in government hostels and Gurukul institutions from the second quarter of the current financial year and directed officials to ensure better education, infrastructure and career opportunities for students from BC, SC, ST and Minority communities.

During a review meeting with Welfare Department officials at the Secretariat, the Chief Minister instructed that the revised diet charges should be implemented immediately despite the Finance Department's request to defer the decision due to financial constraints. He said education has the power to transform the lives of weaker sections.

Naidu directed officials to establish more Gurukul institutions across the state and give



priority to constructing Gurukul campuses instead of conventional hostels. He suggested developing campuses on the lines of biodiversity parks with modern facilities and assessing the benefits of implementing Net Zero practices in

residential schools.

The government has allocated Rs 100 crore as maintenance grants for hostels and residential schools. The Chief Minister instructed officials to establish special coaching centres for meritorious SC, ST, BC and Minority students to prepare them for competitive examinations such as IIT, NIT and NEET. He stressed recruiting the best teachers to provide quality coaching.

Naidu also directed officials to encourage NRIs to adopt welfare hostels, strengthen alumni networks of welfare hostels, residential schools, Gurukuls and Ashram schools, and promote voluntary partici-

pation by professionals willing to provide educational and medical services.

He instructed officials to ensure that welfare schemes such as SASKI, Poorvodaya and VBG Ram G reach eligible beneficiaries. He also emphasised improving livelihoods through horticulture crops, rubber, coffee and turmeric cultivation among weaker sections. The Chief Minister highlighted existing initiatives, including reservations in liquor shops for traditional toddy tappers, quarry quotas for Vaddera communities, and financial assistance to barbers, fishermen and handloom workers. Meanwhile, Naidu directed

AP Approves Compassionate End-of-Life Care Guidelines

The government has approved comprehensive guidelines to facilitate compassionate end-of-life care for terminally ill patients in line with the Supreme Court's directions. Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav approved the framework on Wednesday after reviewing it with senior officials.

The guidelines are intended for patients suffering from irreversible illnesses with no



possibility of recovery and who remain dependent on life-support systems such as ventilators. The government said the new protocol will ensure

legal protection for doctors and family members involved in end-of-life decisions while upholding a patient's right to die with dignity under Article 21 of the Constitution.

The framework provides for the creation of an advance directive by a mentally competent patient, nomination of a guardian, and mandatory review by both primary and secondary medical boards before any withdrawal or withholding of life-support treatment. The decision

Savitha Hails Govt's Welfare Boost for BC Students

BC Welfare, EWS Welfare, Handlooms and Textiles Minister S. Savitha welcomed the state government's decision to increase diet charges by 10 per cent for students in all welfare hostels and residential schools and sanction 500 crore under the SASCI scheme for the construction of permanent buildings for Mahatma Jyotiba Phule (MJP) residential institutions.

In a statement issued on Wednesday, the Minister thanked Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, describing the decisions as a reflection of the government's commitment to strengthening education and welfare for BC students. She said the enhanced diet charges would help provide better-quality and nutritious food in view of rising

prices.

Savitha noted that the coalition government had cleared 110 crore in pending diet bills left by the previous YSRCP government and has been regularly releasing diet and cosmetic charges. She added that six MJP girls' residential schools had recently been upgraded into junior colleges, while 10 new residential schools had been sanctioned.

The Minister said the government aims to make BC residential schools as comfortable as students' own homes by providing quality education, nutritious food and improved infrastructure, including inverters, CCTV cameras and RO plants. She said the allocation of 500 crore for permanent campuses would further strengthen residential education and thanked the Chief Minister on behalf of BC students across the state.

HappyNest Records 1.5 Million Safe Work Hours

The Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority (APCRDA) has announced that the HappyNest residential housing project in Amaravati has achieved 1.5 million safe man-hours without a Lost Time Injury (LTI), marking a significant milestone in construction safety.

Being executed through NCC Limited, the project comprises 1,200 residential apartments across 12 towers, each with 18 floors above the ground level. APCRDA said the achievement reflects its commitment to maintaining high standards of workplace safety, operational discipline and engineering excellence during the construction of the Capital City Amaravati and the Amaravati Government Complex.

to strict implementation of safety protocols, continuous monitoring, regular worker training and proactive preventive measures at the project site. Rajya Sabha MP Chintakayala Vijay Meets CM

During the interaction, Vijay briefed the Chief Minister on several key matters proposed to be raised in Parliament and held detailed discussions on issues related to Andhra Pradesh's development and interests.

According to an official statement, the discussions focused on ensuring that the state's priorities receive adequate attention during the parliamentary session. The Chief



Minister and the Rajya Sabha MP reviewed important subjects affecting Andhra Pradesh and deliberated on strategies to effectively present them before the Centre.

The meeting was held as

part of the state's efforts to secure greater support and attention for Andhra Pradesh's developmental requirements and other priority issues during the forthcoming session of Parliament.

Pattiseema Lifeline for Krishna Delta, Says Minister

Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu on Wednesday said the Pattiseema Lift Irrigation Scheme has emerged as a lifeline for the Krishna Delta by diverting surplus Godavari waters until the completion of the Polavaram Project. After inaugurating water release by switching on the pumps at the Pattiseema and Tadipudi lift irrigation schemes, the Minister said the 1,300-crore project had enabled cultivation worth thousands of crores and ensured water security for the delta region.

Offering Jala Harathi to the Godavari, Ramanaidu said over 442 TMC of water had been transferred to the Krishna Delta through Pattiseema, creating agricultural output worth nearly 50,000 crore. He credited Chief



Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu's foresight for initiating the river-linking project and criticised YSRCP President Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy for previously dismissing Pattiseema and failing to utilise it during his tenure.

The Minister said the state government is fully prepared to tackle the impact of a possible Super El Niño through advance planning and efficient water management. He noted that the Jaladhara-Jala Harathi programme has completed 98 days,

focusing on water conservation, groundwater recharge and strengthening irrigation infrastructure. Despite poor inflows into major Krishna basin reservoirs, Pulichintala currently holds 28 TMC of water due to prudent management, he said.

Ramanaidu also pointed out that irrigation experts had recorded July 5 as the first day in 70 years without inflows into the Godavari. Following an increase in inflows to 56,000 cusecs, the government decided to divert 8,000 cusecs daily through Pattiseema to the Krishna Delta. He appealed to farmers to support the government's water conservation efforts by cultivating less water-intensive crops wherever feasible, while reiterating that drinking water would remain the state's highest priority, followed by irrigation requirements.

Ramprasad Reddy Seeks ₹1,000 Crore Khelo India Support for AP Sports

State Minister for Transport, Youth Services and Sports Mandipalli Ramprasad Reddy sought Central support for strengthening sports infrastructure in Andhra Pradesh during his meetings in Delhi.

The Minister met Vineel Krishna, Joint Secretary, Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, and requested early sanction of Khelo India proposals worth 1,000 crore. The proposals include sports complexes, multipurpose halls, athletics



tracks, football fields, swimming pools and other modern facilities across the state.

Ramprasad Reddy also sought 42.62 crore in Central funds for constructing a modern football turf in Rayachoti, Annamayya district. He said efforts are un-

derway to establish a sports hub in the district with Central assistance and that improved infrastructure would help rural youth access quality training and compete at national and international levels.

In another development, the Minister met former Indian boxer Vijender Singh Beniwal in Delhi and discussed plans to establish an international-standard boxing academy in Andhra Pradesh. They discussed promoting boxing, providing world-class coaching facilities and creating better opportunities for young athletes in the state.

The Business Partners' Conference, held at the APCRDA office in Amaravati, was chaired by Municipal Administration and Urban Development Minister P. Narayana. During the event, leading brands presented franchise opportunities in sectors including embroidery, beauty and wellness, food and beverage,



ages, retail, ice creams and millet products. Gomil, promoted by EBG Group Pvt. Ltd., and Beautitwa will receive special promotion under the "SWAYAM-AP" brand.

The initiative will support SHG families across Urban Local Bodies in establishing franchise units through MUDRA and CGTMSE loan linkages, bank partnerships, entrepreneurship training and technical guidance from MEPMA. Investment re-

quirements range from 2 lakh to 20 lakh for home-based units, kiosks, container outlets and boutique models.

Addressing the gathering, P. Narayana said the OFOE programme aims to ensure that every urban poor family has at least one sustainable livelihood enterprise, while empowering women entrepreneurs and strengthening the urban economy. Minister Orders Probe Into RIMS Hostel Illness

BC Welfare, EWS Welfare, Handlooms and Textiles Minister S. Savitha on Wednesday directed Kadapa district officials to ensure the best possible medical care for students who fell ill after allegedly consuming contaminated food at the RIMS Medical Hostel.

Expressing concern over the incident, Savitha spoke to District Collector Cherukuri Sridhar, District Medical and Health Officer Dr. Ravi Rathod and the

RIMS Hospital Superintendent, seeking a detailed report on the incident. She instructed officials to keep the affected students under continuous medical supervision and ensure they receive quality treatment.

Officials informed the Minister that the students' health condition was stable and that treatment was being provided at RIMS Hospital. They said some students were likely to be discharged by Wednesday night, while those who remained physically weak

would continue to receive medical care.

Savitha warned that negligence in the care of students would not be tolerated. She also directed authorities to conduct medical examinations for the remaining hostel residents and ensure that only fresh food and properly boiled and cooled drinking water are served. The Minister urged officials to remain vigilant in view of changing weather conditions to prevent similar incidents.

Kollu Ravindra Hands Over ₹10 Lakh Aid to Families of Missing Fishermen

Minister Kollu Ravindra, along with MLAs Vamsi Krishna Srinivas and Lokam Naga Madhavi, on Wednesday visited the families of six fishermen who went missing during a fishing expedition and assured them of the government's full support. At the AP Mechanised Boat Operators Association office in the Fishing Harbour, the leaders handed over financial assistance of 10 lakh each to the affected families.

Ravindra said seven fishermen had ventured into the sea, but only one, Chinna, survived. Despite extensive search operations by the Indian Coast Guard and the Indian Navy, the remaining six fishermen could not be traced and were presumed dead after four days. He said the compensation comprises 5 lakh each from the Fisheries Department and the Chief Minister's Relief Fund.

The Minister said assistance would also be provided for the lost fishing boat and reiterated that the government would continue extending all possible support to the affected families. He added that rescue efforts had been launched immediately after the accident was reported.



Later, Ravindra visited Chinna, the lone survivor, at a hospital in Visakhapatnam and reviewed his condition with doctors. He directed officials to provide the best possible medical treatment and assured Chinna and his family of financial assistance as well as a replacement for the fishing boat, valued at around 50 lakh, that was lost in the accident.

Ravindra said the coalition government has extended 3 crore in assistance to fishermen since assuming office and announced plans to restore the fishing boat insurance scheme and strengthen tracking systems in fishing vessels to improve safety. He also cautioned against attempts to politicise the tragedy, warning that strict action would be taken against those spreading misinformation or acting irresponsibly over the incident.

Temple Faith Should Not Be Sacrificed for Politics

Amaravati, July 8 | TPN Bureau

Minister Anam Ramanarayana Reddy on Wednesday condemned attempts to exploit religious faith for political gain and spread misinformation about Hindu temples, warning that the government would not tolerate any conspiracy to hurt devotees' sentiments. Addressing the media at the State Secretariat, he said the government is committed to transparent temple administration and improved facilities.

The Minister said the combined income of 22 major temples rose from 1,379.19 crore in 2023-24 to 1,503.90 crore in 2025-26, while pilgrim footfall increased from 634.68 lakh to 805.04 lakh. He said temples such as Vijayawada Kanaka



Durga, Annavaram, Srisaillam, Simhachalam, Dwaraka Tirumala, Srikalahasti and Kanipakam recorded steady growth.

Ramanarayana Reddy said free annaprasadam is being served at 111 temples for nearly three crore devotees annually, with plans to expand it to 59 more temples. He added that 789.92 crore has been sanctioned for 659 temple development projects and reiterated the government's focus on transparency and digital services.

Minister Calls for Stronger Digital Outreach

Information and Housing Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy on Wednesday directed the Andhra Pradesh Digital Corporation (APDC) to strengthen the state's digital communication strategy to ensure wider and more effective dissemination of government welfare schemes and development initiatives.

During a review meeting at the APDC office in Tadepalli, the Minister was informed that the government's social media platforms had recorded millions of viewer touchpoints over the past two years. Tele-MANAS Saves Youth After Suicide Attempt

A 21-year-old youth from Proddatur in Kadapa district was rescued after a suicide attempt through the timely intervention of the Tele-MANAS mental health helpline, the Andhra Pradesh Health Department said on Wednesday.

According to officials, the youth consumed rat poison on Tuesday following personal problems and later contacted the Tele-MANAS helpline (14416) after becoming anxious about his condition. Mental health professionals and counsellors at the Tele-MANAS centre operating from Vijayawada Government General Hospital immediately counselled him over the phone and also spoke to his father, who was unaware of the

incident.

Based on their advice, the youth was rushed to the Proddatur District Hospital, where doctors provided emergency treatment, including inducing vomiting, enabling him to recover. He was later discharged after his condition stabilised.

On Wednesday, Tele-MANAS staff conducted counselling sessions for both the youth and his father. Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav commended Tele-MANAS Consultant Dr. Sreekanth, counsellor Shaik, Proddatur District Mental Health Programme Psychiatrist Dr. Kavitha Prasanna, Clinical Psychologist K. Shilpa and Psychiatric Social Worker P. Bhaskar for their prompt response in saving the young man's life.

Will Police Arrest Prakash Raj in Ravan Row?

The arrest of YouTuber Ravan in the state has sparked a political debate, with actor Prakash Raj's comments on the issue drawing sharp reactions from government supporters and social media users.

Initially, cases were registered against Ravan for allegedly making objectionable remarks against Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, following which he was arrested. After his release on bail, further allegations surfaced regarding his remarks on religious issues and other controversial statements. Authorities later registered additional cases, including provisions under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA). Ravan is currently lodged in Nellore Central Jail as a remand prisoner.

The developments have led to differing reactions from political circles and civil society. Some people who had earlier expressed support for Ravan distanced themselves after serious charges were included, while others questioned the manner in which legal action was initiated.

Meanwhile, actor Prakash Raj has been regularly responding to the issue through his social media platforms. He



criticised the arrest and questioned the government's approach, stating that people were closely observing the developments.

Prakash Raj's remarks have drawn criticism from sections of social media users, who accused him of selectively responding to certain issues. Critics questioned his strong reaction to Ravan's arrest while pointing to his silence on other political developments involving parties and leaders with whom he has previously shared public platforms.

In one of his recent social media videos, Prakash Raj referred to the possibility of police examining Ravan's mobile phone as part of the investigation. He also raised concerns about whether those supporting Ravan could face pressure during the process. His comments led to further debate, with some users questioning the reasons behind his contin-

ued focus on the case.

Supporters of Prakash Raj, however, argue that his statements reflect concerns over freedom of expression and the manner in which criminal cases are handled. They maintain that questioning government action is part of a democratic process.

The controversy has also brought attention to Prakash Raj's political associations. He has previously participated in public events alongside leaders of the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) and expressed views on various political and social issues.

The ongoing debate over the Ravan case has highlighted wider discussions on freedom of speech, social media responsibility, religious sentiments, and the role of public figures in political matters. As the legal proceedings continue, further developments in the case are being closely watched.

BJP Plans Expansion in Andhra, Says PVN Madhav

BJP President PVN Madhav on Wednesday said the party is preparing a comprehensive strategy to expand its organisational presence across the state. He was addressing a workshop for BJP official spokespersons and media panellists in Vijayawada, attended by State Media In-charge Kilaru Dileep, State Chief Spokesperson Jayaprakash and Telugu and Sanskrit Languages Corporation Chairman R.D. Wilson.

Madhav alleged that several anti-national and divisive forces were operating in Andhra Pradesh and accused certain groups of attempting to provoke communal tensions, insult Hindu deities and encourage forced religious conversions. He said freedom of expression should not be misused to spread hatred or make statements supporting terrorism, adding that all religions should be respected while safeguarding one's own faith. Highlighting development initiatives, Madhav said the "double-en-

gine" governments led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu were accelerating Andhra Pradesh's growth. He cited green corridors, economic corridors, solar power expansion, the Google data centre, the steel plant, Amaravati development, Machilipatnam Port and the Polavaram Project as major initiatives. He also alleged corruption in the Obulapuram mining issue and said development should not be obstructed by political conspiracies.

Vijayasai Reddy Alleges Attack on Hinduism, Targets YSRCP Support

Former MP Vijayasai Reddy said Indian culture is "magnificent" and called for strict action against those making derogatory remarks against deities, Hinduism, or the country. In a post on X, he asserted that both society and the law must respond firmly, irrespective of caste or religion.

No Compromise on Mid-Day Meal Quality: Collector Lakshmisha

District Collector Dr. G. Lakshmisha said nutritious food is essential for building a healthy future for students and stressed that there should be no compromise on the quality of meals served under the mid-day meal scheme in schools.

The Collector made a surprise inspection at the Zilla Parishad High School in Penuganchiprolu on Wednesday to review the implementation of the scheme. He examined the quality of food, adherence to the prescribed menu,



kitchen hygiene, storage of cooking ingredients, and availability of safe drinking water. He also reviewed the cooking process and issued instructions to the staff concerned.

Dr. Lakshmisha directed officials to ensure that students are

served hot, hygienic, and nutritious meals every day. He emphasized the need for maintaining cleanliness in kitchens and called for regular monitoring of food quality to avoid lapses.

During the visit, the Collector interacted with students and enquired about their studies, quality of food, and facilities available at the school. He advised them to make effective use of educational and welfare schemes provided by the government and to aim for higher goals in life.

The inspection highlighted the administration's focus on student health and welfare.

Balaji Stresses Fair Polls, PCPNDT Enforcement

Krishna District Collector and District Election Officer D.K. Balaji on Wednesday emphasised transparency in the ongoing Special Summary Revision (SSR) of electoral rolls and directed strict enforcement of the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PCPNDT) Act during two separate review meetings.

At a meeting with representatives of political parties at the Gannavaram Tahsildar's office, Balaji said the SSR exercise was being carried out impartially in accordance with Election Commission of India guidelines. He urged political parties to cooperate with Booth Level Officers (BLOs) to ensure that no eligible voter is left out of the electoral rolls.

The Collector explained that



door-to-door verification, collection of enumeration forms, digitisation of voter data and disposal of objections were progressing as per prescribed norms. He appealed to political parties to assist BLOs by providing information on shifted, deceased and tenant voters and by creating awareness among the public. He also informed that help desks and the Election Commission's helpline (1950) were available to assist voters.

Later, chairing the District Level Multi-Member Appropriate Authority Committee meeting at the Collectorate, Balaji warned that there would be no compromise in implementing the PCPNDT Act, which prohibits prenatal sex determination. The committee approved applications for registration, renewal and modification of permissions for several scanning centres after examining inspection reports and required documents.

The Collector also unveiled a poster publicising the state's toll-free complaint number 1800-233-2447 and urged citizens to report violations related to prenatal sex determination and gender discrimination. District Judge Gajula Venkateswarlu, District Medical and Health Officer Dr. P. Yugandhar, Additional SP V.V. Naidu and other officials attended the meeting.

R&B Chief Engineer Addresses Contractors' Concerns

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Complete Bank Linkage for Thalliki Vandanam Benefits: Shahid Babu

Krishna District Social Welfare Department Assistant Director Shaik Shahid Babu has urged eligible Intermediate SC students to immediately complete bank account formalities to avail benefits under the Andhra Pradesh government's 'Thalliki Vandanam' scheme.

In a press note issued on Wednesday, Shahid Babu said students without bank accounts should open one in their own name at the earliest. He also advised those who already have bank accounts to complete Aadhaar seeding and NPCI mapping, as financial assistance under the scheme would be directly credited only to accounts with the required verification.

He said the department had launched a special drive to clear pending cases across

Krishna district. The number of pending cases has been reduced from 4,230 on July 2 to 1,477 by July 6 through coordinated efforts by field-level officials.

According to the department, the remaining pending cases include 249 in Machilipatnam, 289 in Gannavaram, 386 in Gudivada, 122 in Avanigadda and 431 in Uyyuru.

Shahid Babu said Assistant Social Welfare Officers, wardens, Welfare and Education Assistants and college managers had been instructed to personally contact eligible students and ensure completion of bank account opening, Aadhaar seeding and NPCI mapping.

He appealed to all eligible students to complete the pending formalities without delay to receive financial assistance under the Thalliki Vandanam scheme.

Corporate Medicine at Doorstep of Poor: Minister Narayana

The free mega health camps, Narayana Netra Jyoti and Narayana Danta Suraksha, organized under the initiative of State Municipal Administration and Urban Development Minister Ponguru Narayana, achieved major success in Nellore's 49th Division. Co-Cluster Sheikh Khader Basha, President Bandi Prasad, and Medical Officers Sudha and Rafi stated that a state-of-the-art 'Nayana on Wheels' mobile clinic worth Rs 3 crore was deployed to bring corporate-level healthcare to the poor. Under Narayana Netrajyoti, 9,617 people received eye tests, 5,461 received free eyeglasses, and 143 underwent free surgeries. The dental wing treated 6,257 people. To ensure quality care, each camp limits examinations to 60 people daily. Computerized eye tests provide glasses within two days, while staff educate diabetic patients on preventing diabetic retinopathy and glaucoma.

Potpetalem Kaluju Bridge Construction at Brisk Pace: Giridhar Reddy

The project involves an investment of Rs 4,500 crore in the first phase and Rs 11,850 crore in the second phase. He criticized former Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy for failing to perform any work during his five-year rule and alleged that the YS family, along with Sajjala Ramakrishna Reddy, used the project for personal financial gains.

Educate Farmers on Mixed Crop Cultivation: District Collector Siri

Husband Slits Wife's Throat at Kadiri Hospital, Arrested

According to police, Gangaraju had earlier assaulted Sunitha, after which family members shifted her to the Kadiri Government Hospital



for treatment. While she was in the women's ward, he convinced her to move to a private hospital for better care. However, after taking her out of the ward, he attacked and killed her using a knife he

was carrying. Kadiri Town CI Narayana Reddy reached the spot promptly with his team and took the accused into custody. Police have registered a case and launched an investigation.

MLA Parthasarathi Assures Resolution of Civic Issues

Alleged Encroachment of Anganwadi Site Sparks Tension



Chandra T @ Anantapur Tension prevailed in Mutton Market Colony under Chinnampalli Gram Panchayat in Anantapur Rural mandal after allegations surfaced regarding the illegal encroachment of land earmarked for an Anganwadi school. According to residents, a plot designated for the construction of an Anganwadi centre was allegedly occupied by Malapati Ramu, who claims to be a local TDP leader, along with his associates. It is alleged that boundary markers were forcibly installed on the land, triggering concern among residents, particularly women in the colony. When questioned by local women, Malapati Ramu reportedly reacted strongly and allegedly issued threats, warning people against opposing his actions. Residents said the land is crucial for establishing an Anganwadi centre, which would provide early childhood education and nutrition support to children in the area. Women from the colony expressed concern that the encroachment could deprive children of access to basic educational facilities. They urged authorities to intervene and protect the land meant for public welfare. The incident has raised questions over the role of local officials, with residents calling upon panchayat and revenue authorities to take immediate action and ensure that the site is preserved for its intended purpose. As the issue gains attention, locals are awaiting a response from authorities regarding the allegations and possible measures to resolve the dispute. The development has also sparked wider discussion on safeguarding public land meant for education and community welfare from alleged misuse under political influence.

Finance Minister Payyavula Keshav Sanctions Rs 7.5 Lakh for Ill Child

Politics Must Not Drown an 87,000-Crore Project

The ‘ 87,000-crore project’ that was envisioned to bring water to Telangana has unfortunately become a platform for *challenges and counter-challenges* in politics. A project that was meant to irrigate lakhs of acres is today struggling in the midst of political rivalry. Before deciding ‘who is right and who is wrong’, the foremost responsibility is to ensure that ‘public money is not wasted’.

If the previous BRS Government led by K. Chandrashekar Rao committed mistakes in the planning or execution of the project, those responsible must certainly be held accountable. No one should be spared if public funds have been misused. However, accountability should not become a political weapon. Instead of arriving at a conclusion and taking corrective measures, the Congress Government appears to be spending more time projecting it as a “failed project.” The emphasis seems to be on highlighting political failures rather than identifying solutions to make the project functional.

On the other hand, the BRS maintains that it did not commit any mistake and argues that the Congress Government has failed to utilize or rectify the project. While both parties continue to trade accusations, the real question remains unanswered: ‘Will lakhs of acres receive water or not?’ If not, ‘What is the alternative?’

Equally important is the silence of farmers’ organizations, which should be at the forefront of demanding a practical solution. If water is reaching agricultural fields even without the project functioning as intended, then a fundamental question arises: Why was the project built at such an enormous cost?

The people deserve clear answers to these questions. Political leaders have a responsibility not merely to score points against one another but to safeguard public resources and fulfil the purpose for which such massive investments were made. It is time to end the controversy, move beyond political rhetoric, and focus on finding a lasting solution that serves the interests of Telangana’s farmers and taxpayers.

Memorization in the Age of AI: A Reflection from the Gita

At a recent roundtable conference on education, the keynote speaker reflected on the sweeping changes brought by the information age and the growing influence of Artificial Intelligence. He observed how vast amounts of information now reach us in seconds, reshaping the way we learn and remember. In contrast, he reminded the audience of an earlier era, when theologians and pundits devoted themselves to memorizing the Vedas and sacred texts, carrying entire traditions in their minds.

In making this point, he recalled a recent conversation with me. He mentioned that Swathi is now engaged in Bhagavad Gita studies, and as part of that journey, she is memorizing verses from the Gita. His reflection led to a provocative question: in the near future, will anyone continue the practice of memorization? The Value of Memorization

The question is not trivial. AI can provide instant meanings, analyses, and reviews of the Bhagavad Gita. Yet memorization is not about recall—it is about internalizing wisdom. Reciting shlokas embeds rhythm, meaning, and philosophy into the mind, shaping thought patterns and emotional resilience. It is a discipline that strengthens focus and offers peace in moments of confusion.

When verses are memorized, they become available not just on a device but within the self. In moments of stress or uncertain-

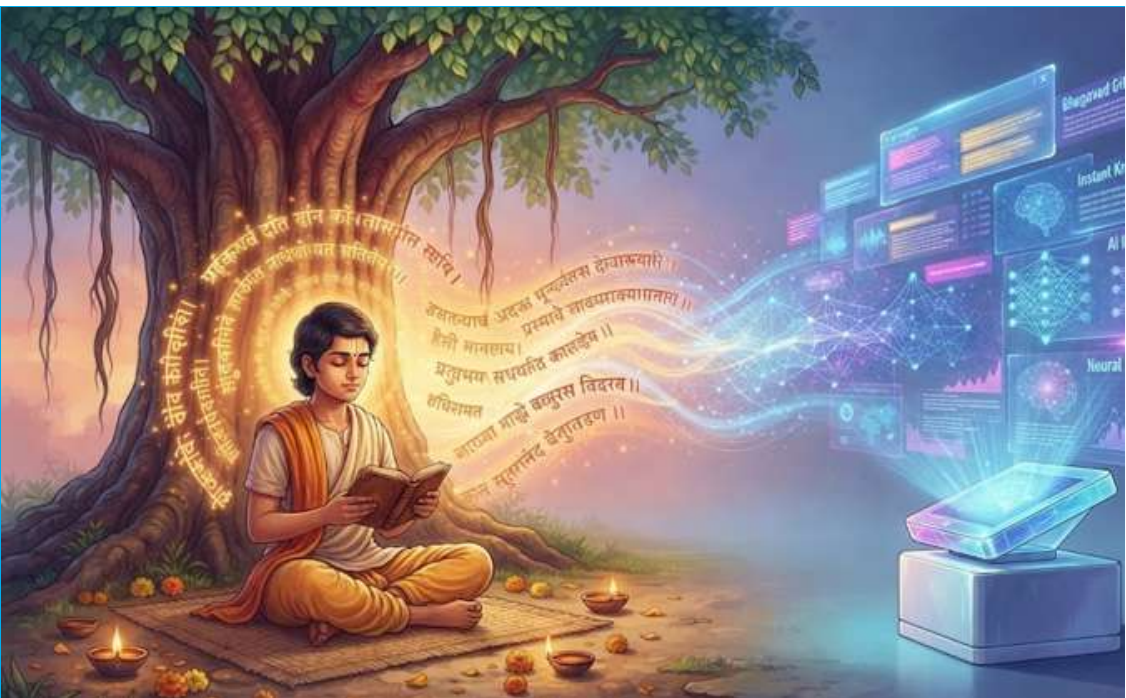
ty, the mind can draw upon them instantly, without needing to “search.” This immediacy is what makes memorization transformative.

Tradition Meets Technology
Memorization once served as the backbone of cultural continuity. Oral traditions preserved knowledge across generations, ensuring that wisdom was not lost even when written texts were scarce. Today, technology has reduced our reliance on memory—calculators replaced mental arithmetic, mobiles replaced memorized phone numbers, and now AI replaces the need to recall facts.

Yet practices like memorizing the Gita remain relevant, not as a necessity for information storage, but as a path to personal transformation. AI can explain meanings, but memorization ensures those meanings live within us. It is the difference between reading wisdom and living it.

When Politics Divides, Democracy Suffers

Democracy, at its core, is meant to foster collective progress and peaceful coexistence. It is a system where differences are debated, not weaponized, and where governance is rooted in public welfare rather than political rivalry. However, the current political climate in Andhra Pradesh raises a troubling question: is politics still serving the people, or is it steadily dividing them?

Across the state, there is a growing perception that politics has moved away from its primary purpose. What should ideally be a contest of ideas, policies, and development agendas is increasingly turning into a battleground of personal attacks, allegations, and constant confrontation. Social observers point out that political intensity, which traditionally peaks during election seasons, now persists throughout the year. As a result, ordinary citizens are left navigating an atmosphere of continuous tension.

People fundamentally seek peace and stability in their daily lives. Development, welfare, and economic growth naturally follow when society is harmonious. Yet, in Andhra Pradesh, public discourse appears to be dominated by criticism of opponents rather than constructive dialogue. This shift has led to a growing sense of disillusionment among citizens who expect politics to address real issues affecting their lives.

Recent remarks by Janasena MLA Mandali Buddha Prasad have added weight to this concern. His candid reflection on whether one should continue in such a political environment has sparked widespread

debate. Analysts view this as a symptom of a deeper issue—the steady erosion of civility and mutual respect in political engagement. When elected representatives themselves express discomfort, it signals a broader systemic problem that cannot be ignored.

Critics argue that political leaders, instead of competing to solve public problems, are increasingly focused on weakening their opponents. The rise of social media has amplified this trend, turning political communication into a relentless cycle of propaganda, misinformation, and personal attacks. Meaningful criticism, which is essential for a healthy democracy, is often overshadowed by sensationalism. This not only dilutes the quality of political discourse but also widens societal divisions.

The role of certain media outlets and digital platforms has also come under scrutiny. Observers note that prioritizing sensational narratives over factual reporting contributes to polarization. When media becomes an extension of political battles rather than a neutral platform for information, it undermines public trust and deepens existing divides.

At the same time, opposition parties and civil society groups have raised concerns over the government’s response to dissent. Allegations that the gov-

ernment is taking legal action against critics have sparked debate about the balance between maintaining law and order and protecting democratic freedoms. The government, led by YSRCP, maintains that its actions are strictly within the framework of law and are necessary to ensure stability. However, this ongoing tension highlights the delicate balance that must be maintained in any democracy.

Beyond political narratives and institutional debates, the real impact is felt at the grassroots level. Increasingly, political differences are straining personal relationships—families, friendships, and communities are experiencing divisions along political lines. Intellectuals warn that such social fragmentation is unhealthy and poses a long-term risk to societal cohesion.

For democracy to thrive, both the ruling party and the opposition must exercise restraint and responsibility. Politics should not be about perpetual conflict but about constructive engagement. Mutual respect, tolerance of differing views, and a commitment to dialogue are essential pillars of a functioning democracy. Ultimately, the purpose of politics must return to its fundamental goal—serving the people. There is a growing and justified demand among citizens for governance that prioritizes public welfare over political rivalry. If democracy is to remain meaningful, it must unite rather than divide. The path forward lies not in louder arguments, but in wiser conversations.

The Middle Ground: Agnosticism and Pluralism

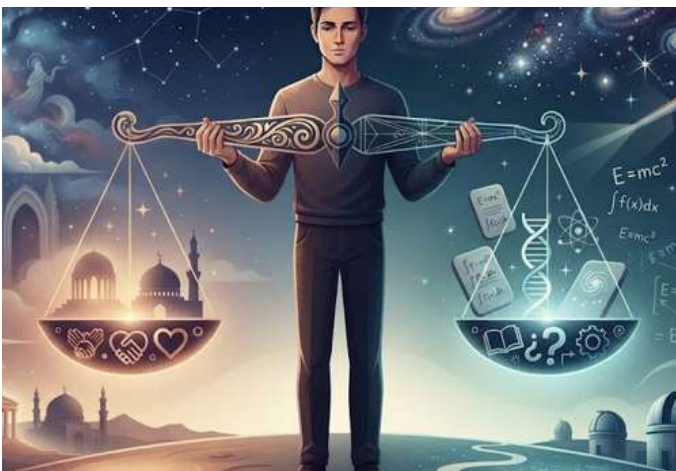

BJP Fields Youth Leader Abhishek Kumar Against Prashant Kishor

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has named Abhishek Kumar, a young party leader, as its candidate for the crucial Bankipur Assembly bypoll in Bihar. He will take on Jan Suraj Party founder Prashant Kishor, setting the stage for a high-profile contest between two first-time electoral candidates.

The bypoll was necessitated after the Bankipur seat fell vacant following the election of former MLA Nitin Nabin to the Rajya Sabha. Considered a BJP stronghold, the constituency has emerged as one of the most closely watched political battles in Bihar.

Abhishek Kumar is a prominent leader of the Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM) and has served as the state vice-president of the BJP's youth wing. He has been actively involved in grassroots organizational work and is regarded as a close associate of senior BJP leader Nitin Nabin. His selection reflects the party's strategy of promoting young leaders with strong local connections.

The BJP believes Abhishek Kumar's organizational experience and connect with party workers will help retain the Bankipur seat. Senior party leaders have described his can-

didature as a recognition of dedicated grassroots workers rather than relying only on established political faces.

On the other side, Prashant Kishor is making his electoral debut after years of working as one of India's most influential political strategists. Through his Jan Suraj Party, he has been campaigning for governance reforms and political change in Bihar. His decision to contest from Bankipur, traditionally a BJP bastion, has made the bypoll a major political contest.

The election is expected to draw significant attention as it will test Prashant Kishor's popularity as a political leader against the BJP's strong organizational network. Apart from the BJP and Jan Suraj Party, other political parties are also in the fray, making the contest highly competitive.

With both principal candidates entering electoral politics for the first time, the Bankipur bypoll is being viewed as more than just a local election. The outcome could influence the political narrative in Bihar ahead of future electoral battles and provide an indication of voter sentiment toward emerging political alternatives and established parties alike.



India Plans Longest Bullet Train Corridor from Delhi to Siliguri

India is moving ahead with an ambitious high-speed rail expansion plan that could transform long-distance travel across the country. The proposed Delhi-Varanasi-Siliguri bullet train corridor is set to become one of India's biggest railway infrastructure projects, with the potential to reduce travel time between Delhi and Siliguri to around six hours.

The corridor is part of the government's broader plan to develop multiple high-speed rail networks across India. Among the proposed routes, the Delhi-Varanasi-Siliguri line stands out as one of the longest, connecting the national capital with eastern India and serving as an important gateway towards the Northeast.

The proposed high-speed corridor is expected to cover approximately 1,700 kilometres, making it longer than India's first bullet train project between Mumbai and Ahmedabad. The route is planned to connect major cities including Delhi, Noida, Mathura, Agra, Lucknow, Varanasi, Patna, Begusarai, Khagaria, Katihar, and New Jalpaiguri (Siliguri).

At present, travelling from Delhi to Siliguri by conventional trains takes nearly 20 hours. The bullet train project aims to reduce this journey significantly by using dedicated high-speed tracks and trains capable of reaching speeds of up to 320 kmph.

The project is expected to improve connectivity between northern, eastern, and north-

eastern regions of India. Faster transportation links could boost tourism, encourage business activity, improve passenger convenience, and create new economic opportunities around the proposed stations.

Another major high-speed rail route under consideration is the Delhi-Lucknow-Varanasi corridor, which is expected to strengthen connectivity across Uttar Pradesh. The proposed network could reduce travel time between major cities and provide a faster alternative to existing rail and road transportation.

Railway authorities are currently focusing on surveys, feasibility studies, and detailed planning before moving towards construction. The project will require significant investment, land acquisition, and advanced engineering solutions to build dedicated high-speed infrastructure.

The bullet train network is part of India's larger vision to modernize railway infrastructure and introduce faster, safer, and more efficient modes of transportation. The ongoing Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train project is expected to provide valuable experience for future high-speed rail corridors.

If completed, the Delhi-Siliguri bullet train corridor could bring a major change in India's transportation system by connecting key regions with high-speed rail connectivity. The project has the potential to strengthen economic links, reduce travel time, and redefine the future of railway travel in the country.

Shah Assures Full Central Support to States Amid Heavy Rains

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Wednesday reviewed the flood and heavy rain situation in Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Jammu & Kashmir, speaking separately with the chief ministers of the three regions and assuring them of all possible assistance from the Centre. The move comes as intense monsoon rains continue to disrupt normal life in several parts of the country.

During his conversations, Shah spoke with Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, and Jammu & Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah to assess the impact of heavy rainfall and the preparedness of state administrations in handling the situation. He assured the leaders that the Central government would extend every possible support for rescue, relief, and rehabilitation efforts.

Several parts of Maharashtra, especially Mumbai and nearby districts, have been experiencing heavy rainfall, leading to waterlogging, traffic disruptions, and delays in rail services. Gujarat has also witnessed widespread rains, while parts of Jammu & Kashmir have been affected by flash



floods and landslides caused by persistent monsoon activity.

Shah emphasized that the Centre is closely monitoring the evolving weather situation and remains in constant touch with the affected states. He assured the chief ministers that additional resources would be made available if required to strengthen rescue and relief operations.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has forecast continued heavy to very heavy rainfall in several regions, prompting authorities to remain on high alert. Disaster response agencies, including the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and state emergency teams, have been deployed in vulnerable areas to assist local administrations

and respond to emergencies.

Authorities have urged residents in low-lying and flood-prone areas to remain cautious, avoid unnecessary travel, and follow official weather advisories. Emergency teams are continuing rescue and monitoring operations as the southwest monsoon remains active across western and northern India.

The Central government has reiterated its commitment to providing all necessary assistance until the situation returns to normal. Coordination between central agencies and state governments is expected to continue to ensure timely relief, safeguard lives, and minimize damage caused by the ongoing heavy rains and flooding.

‘Abuse-Proof’ Fadnavis Defends Mumbai-Pune Missing Link

Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis strongly defended the Mumbai-Pune 'Missing Link' expressway project in the State Assembly after the Opposition criticized the government over a recent landslide that temporarily disrupted traffic. Declaring that he was "abuse-proof," Fadnavis rejected allegations of corruption and structural failure.

The controversy erupted after heavy monsoon rains triggered a landslide on the recently inaugurated 7,000-crore Missing Link project, forcing authorities to suspend traffic for nearly 18 hours. Opposition parties accused the government of poor construction quality and misuse of public funds.

Responding to the criticism, Fadnavis accused the Opposition of spreading misinformation and making baseless allegations. He asserted that the project remains structurally sound and said the incident was caused by an extreme natural event rather than engineering flaws.

The Chief Minister clarified that the landslide damaged an outer protective arch after



mountain debris fell on it, but stressed that the tunnel and the main structural components remained completely safe. He said the integrated safety systems functioned effectively, enabling emergency teams to respond immediately and clear the debris before reopening the route.

Fadnavis also claimed that the previous Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government had stalled the project, citing multiple objections. According to him, the current government revived and completed the project despite those challenges.

Taking a swipe at criticism on social media, Fadnavis remarked that he had become "abuse-proof" after years in public life. He said political attacks did not concern him but

warned that he would not tolerate attempts to defame Maharashtra or undermine major infrastructure projects.

Highlighting the significance of the expressway, he noted that the Missing Link includes India's tallest cable-stayed bridge and some of the world's widest twin tunnels, making travel between Mumbai and Pune faster and safer while bypassing the accident-prone ghat section.

Drawing a comparison with the Konkan Railway, Fadnavis said that major infrastructure projects often face initial challenges but improve over time through engineering solutions and continuous maintenance. He argued that development should not be halted because of isolated incidents.

The Chief Minister also reviewed the broader monsoon situation in Maharashtra, stating that disaster management teams are actively engaged in relief operations across rain-affected districts. He assured the Assembly that the government remains committed to ensuring public safety while continuing with ambitious infrastructure development across the state.

Maa Baglamukhi Temple Donation Row: Inquiry Ordered

A controversy has emerged at the famous Maa Baglamukhi Temple in Madhya Pradesh's Agar-Malwa district, where allegations have surfaced that cash, gold, and silver offerings from devotees were collected through a private system outside the official temple management structure. The district administration has ordered an inquiry into the matter.

According to the allegations, an unauthorized committee was collecting donations and valuable offerings from devotees inside the temple premises by issuing private receipts. It is also alleged that the collected funds were deposited into private bank accounts instead of being properly recorded through the official temple management system.

The Maa Baglamukhi Temple at Nalkhedra is managed by a government-constituted temple committee headed by the local Sub-Divisional Magistrate. However, complaints received by the administration claim that another group, operating in the name of a private service committee, had been collecting donations since 2024 without official approval.

Following the complaints, Agar-Malwa Collector Preeti Yadav formed a three-member in-



quiry committee to investigate the allegations. The panel has been tasked with examining temple records, receipt books, bank details, and other financial documents. Statements of people associated with the matter will also be recorded as part of the investigation.

The inquiry committee will determine whether any financial irregularities occurred and identify those responsible if violations are established. Officials have stated that strict action will be taken against anyone found guilty of wrongdoing. The issue has triggered political reactions in Madhya Pradesh, with opposition leaders demanding a transparent investigation into the management of devotees' donations. They have called for accountability and proper handling of temple funds.

The state government has maintained that any person found involved in financial misconduct will face action. Officials have also clarified that the alleged private donation collection system was not part of the officially recognized temple management process. Maa Baglamukhi Temple is one of Madhya Pradesh's prominent religious destinations and attracts thousands of devotees every year. The temple is especially known for special rituals and religious ceremonies, drawing visitors from different parts of the country.

The controversy has once again highlighted concerns over transparency in the management of religious donations. The final report of the inquiry committee is expected to reveal whether the allegations are true and what further steps will be taken by the authorities.



Congress Rules Out Leadership Change in Punjab

The Congress has firmly ruled out any change in its Punjab leadership ahead of the upcoming Assembly elections, putting an end to speculation over a possible reshuffle in the state unit. The party leadership has made it clear that the current organizational structure will remain unchanged as it focuses on strengthening its election campaign.

AICC General Secretary and Punjab in-charge Bhupesh Baghel stated that the party high command has taken a final decision and that Amarinder Singh Raja Warring will continue as the president of the Punjab Congress. He emphasized that the appointment of a state party chief is a well-considered decision and is not subject to change due to internal pressure or political speculation.

Baghel dismissed reports of an imminent leadership change, saying the Congress is concentrating on preparations for the Assembly elections rather than internal disagreements. He stressed that party discipline would be strictly maintained and that all leaders are expected to work together to strengthen the party's prospects in the state.

The clarification comes amid reports of differences within the Punjab Congress, with some leaders and supporters seeking

a larger role for former Chief Minister Charanjit Singh Channi. However, the party leadership has reiterated that organizational appointments have already been finalized and there is no plan to revisit those decisions.

Baghel urged party workers and leaders to focus on building the organization at the grassroots level instead of engaging in internal politics. He said personal ambitions should not take precedence over the party's larger objective of returning to power in Punjab.

The Congress has already finalized its key election committees, with Raja Warring continuing as the state unit chief while senior leaders have been assigned important campaign and organizational responsibilities. The leadership believes the existing structure provides the right combination of experience, stability, and representation to effectively challenge the ruling Aam Aadmi Party and other political opponents.

By ruling out any leadership change, the Congress hopes to end speculation and project a united front ahead of the crucial Punjab Assembly elections. The party is aiming to strengthen its grassroots network, maintain internal unity, and present itself as a strong alternative to the ruling government as it prepares for the electoral battle.



12,000 Police, Drones Deployed for Secure Puri Rath Yatra

Odisha Police has announced a massive security arrangement for the annual Puri Rath Yatra, deploying around 12,000 police personnel along with advanced surveillance systems to ensure the smooth conduct of the grand religious festival. The security plan focuses on crowd management, traffic regulation, emergency response, and the safety of lakhs of devotees expected to participate.

The Rath Yatra will witness a huge gathering of devotees in Puri, prompting authorities to prepare a multi-layer security strategy covering land, sea, and air surveillance. Officials have planned extensive arrangements to prevent any untoward incidents and ensure the festival proceeds peacefully.

As part of the security measures, drones and anti-drone systems will be deployed to monitor aerial activity and prevent unauthorized drone operations. Security teams will maintain continuous surveillance across important locations to quickly identify and respond to possible threats.

A special maritime security arrangement has also been planned, with the Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard, and Odisha Police Maritime units conducting coordinated patrols along the coastal areas. Quick Response Teams will be positioned at strategic locations to handle emergency situations.

Several central and state security agencies, including the CRPF, BSF, Railway Protection Force, and Coast Guard, will

assist Odisha Police during the festival. Authorities have also arranged anti-sabotage checks, bomb disposal squads, sniffer dog teams, and special tactical units as part of the overall security framework.

Special focus has been placed on crowd control and preventing stampede-like situations. Barricading arrangements, regulated entry and exit points, emergency routes, and coordination between police personnel and district administration officials have been planned to manage the movement of devotees effectively.

Police teams have also intensified security checks at hotels, lodges, railway stations, bus terminals, and other public areas in Puri. Authorities are monitoring suspicious activities and carrying out verification procedures to maintain law and order throughout the festival period. With a massive number of devotees expected to attend the historic celebration, Odisha is combining traditional security methods with modern technology to ensure a safe and peaceful Rath Yatra. The use of drones, surveillance systems, and deployment of multiple security agencies reflects the scale of preparations for one of India's biggest religious gatherings.

The state administration has assured devotees that all necessary precautions are being taken to maintain safety, provide smooth arrangements, and ensure the successful completion of the nine-day festival.



Oil Prices Surge Over 2% as US-Iran Tensions

Global crude oil prices climbed more than 2% after renewed military tensions between the United States and Iran heightened concerns over the security of the Strait of Hormuz, one of the world's most critical oil transit routes. The latest escalation has raised fears of supply disruptions, pushing energy prices higher in international markets.

The rise in oil prices comes amid fresh military exchanges in the Gulf region, increasing uncertainty over the movement of crude shipments through the Strait of Hormuz. Nearly 20% of the world's oil supply passes through this narrow waterway, making any threat to its security a major concern for global energy markets.

Investors reacted swiftly to reports of heightened tensions, with traders pricing in the possibility of supply interruptions if the conflict intensifies. Shipping companies are also closely monitoring the situation, as increased military activity could affect the safe passage of oil tankers and commercial vessels operating in the region.

Higher crude prices have renewed concerns about global inflation, as rising energy costs could increase transportation and manufacturing expenses worldwide. Economists warn that sustained increases in oil prices may complicate the efforts of central banks to manage inflation while supporting economic growth.

Energy-importing countries, including India, are expected to closely monitor developments since higher crude prices could translate into increased fuel import costs and put pressure on domestic inflation. Governments may also face challenges in managing fuel prices if the geopolitical situation worsens.

Financial markets reflected growing uncertainty, with investors shifting toward safer assets while keeping a close watch on further geopolitical developments. Market participants believe that oil prices could remain volatile as long as tensions persist in the Gulf region. Despite the current spike, analysts note that the extent of any long-term price increase will depend on whether the conflict disrupts actual oil production or shipping operations. If exports through the Strait of Hormuz continue without major interruptions, prices could stabilize. However, any escalation affecting the flow of crude oil could lead to sharper price gains.

With geopolitical risks rising and energy markets remaining sensitive to developments in West Asia, traders and policymakers around the world are expected to closely track the evolving situation. The coming days will be crucial in determining whether diplomatic efforts can ease tensions or whether further military action will continue to drive volatility in global oil markets.



Pakistan Links Offender Deportation to Extradition Demand from UK

Pakistan has reportedly informed the United Kingdom that it is willing to accept the deportation of a convicted child sex offender of Pakistani origin only if Britain also extradites two Pakistanis accused by Islamabad of spreading anti-state propaganda and criticizing Army Chief General Asim Munir. The reported demand has added a new dimension to diplomatic discussions between the two countries.

The convicted offender, widely known by the nickname "Daddy," was a central figure in the Rochdale child grooming gang scandal that shocked the United Kingdom. British authorities have been attempting to deport him after he completed a lengthy prison sentence for multiple child sexual abuse offences, but legal and diplomatic challenges have delayed the process.

According to reports, Pakistan has requested the extradition of former government adviser Shahzad Akbar and journalist and former military officer Adil Raja. Islamabad accuses both individuals of spreading false information and engaging in activities considered harmful to the state while living in the UK. Both men have denied the allegations, claiming the charges are politically motivated.

British authorities are re-

portedly reluctant to link the deportation of a convicted criminal with the extradition of political figures. Legal experts point out that criminal deportation and political asylum are governed by separate legal frameworks, making such an arrangement difficult to implement under UK law.

The issue has reignited debate in Britain over immigration policies and the deportation of foreign nationals convicted of serious crimes. Several politicians and victims' rights groups have argued that individuals convicted of grave offences should be deported after completing their prison sentences.

The matter has also highlighted broader differences between the UK and Pakistan over extradition agreements, political asylum, and freedom of expression. Human rights organizations have expressed concerns that political critics deported to Pakistan could face legal action or persecution upon their return.

At present, discussions between the two governments are ongoing, but there is no indication that the UK is willing to accept Pakistan's reported conditions. As negotiations continue, both sides are expected to balance legal obligations, diplomatic relations, and human rights considerations before reaching any final decision.

Trump Ends Iran Ceasefire, Signals Talks

US President Donald Trump has declared that the interim ceasefire agreement with Iran is effectively "over" following a fresh wave of military escalation between the two countries. However, despite the renewed hostilities, Trump indicated that diplomatic negotiations for a broader peace agreement could continue.

The latest developments came after the United States launched fresh military strikes on Iranian targets in response to attacks on American military installations in Bahrain and Kuwait. The renewed exchange of fire has significantly weakened hopes of preserving the temporary ceasefire that had been negotiated earlier this year.

Speaking on the escalating conflict, Trump accused Iran of repeatedly violating the terms of the ceasefire and warned that Washington would respond forcefully to any further attacks on US personnel or interests. At the same time, he stressed that his administration remained willing to pursue diplomatic engagement if Iran demonstrated a genuine commitment to peace.

The renewed conflict has further heightened tensions



across West Asia, particularly around the Strait of Hormuz, one of the world's most critical oil shipping routes. The uncertainty has already triggered a sharp rise in global crude oil prices and increased concerns over disruptions to international energy supplies.

Military exchanges between the two nations have intensified in recent days. The US carried out airstrikes targeting Iranian military infrastructure, while Iran responded with missile and drone attacks on American bases in the Gulf region. Both sides have accused each other of breaching the ceasefire agreement and vvdDespite the deteriorating security situation, Trump reiterated that negotiations aimed at achieving a long-term peace settlement had not been abandoned. He suggested that

diplomatic channels remain open, although the immediate priority would be ensuring the safety of American forces and protecting strategic interests in the region.

The latest escalation has drawn concern from several countries, with fears that prolonged military action could destabilize the region further, disrupt global trade, and intensify volatility in energy markets. Governments around the world are closely monitoring developments, urging both Washington and Tehran to return to dialogue and avoid a wider conflict.

As tensions continue to rise, financial markets remain on edge, with investors watching geopolitical developments closely for signs of either further escalation or renewed diplomatic efforts.

Trump Revives Greenland Push, Backs Turkey at NATO Summit

US President Donald Trump reignited debate within the NATO alliance by once again calling for the United States to take control of Greenland while criticizing several NATO allies for what he described as a lack of support during the recent conflict with Iran. His remarks came as leaders gathered in Ankara, Turkey, for the NATO summit.

During a meeting with Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan, Trump said several European allies had failed to stand firmly with Washington during the Iran crisis. He specifically expressed disappointment with countries including Britain, France, Germany, and Italy, arguing that the alliance had not fully backed US interests during the conflict.

Trump also revived his long-standing proposal that Greenland should come under US control, describing the Arctic island as strategically vital for American national security. He argued that its location has become increasingly important due to growing Russian and Chinese activity in the Arctic region. However, Denmark has consistently rejected any suggestion of transferring sovereignty over Greenland, maintaining that the autonomous territory is not for sale.



In a major policy announcement, Trump said the United States would lift sanctions imposed on Turkey in 2020 following Ankara's purchase of the Russian S-400 missile defence system. He also indicated that Washington is willing to consider selling F-35 stealth fighter jets to Turkey, a move that could significantly improve defence ties between the two NATO allies, although it would still require approval from the US Congress.

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan welcomed the announcement and expressed optimism about strengthening defence cooperation with the United States. The development could mark a significant improvement in relations between Washington and Ankara after years of strained ties over military and security issues.

Speaking about the war in Ukraine, Trump said he believed both Russian President Vladimir

Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy were interested in reaching a negotiated settlement to end the conflict. He stressed the need for diplomacy while reaffirming America's commitment to NATO's collective security. Meanwhile, NATO leaders announced new multinational defence procurement initiatives worth around \$50 billion, aimed at enhancing the alliance's military readiness and addressing emerging global security challenges.

The summit highlighted continuing differences among NATO members over defence spending, regional conflicts, and strategic priorities. Despite these disagreements, alliance leaders reiterated their commitment to strengthening collective defence and maintaining unity in the face of growing geopolitical tensions involving Russia, the Middle East, and the Arctic region.

Japan's 500-kmph Maglev Train Set to Revolutionize High-Speed Travel

Japan is moving closer to transforming rail travel with its next-generation Superconducting Maglev train, a cutting-edge high-speed rail project that is expected to connect Tokyo and Nagoya in just 40 minutes. Capable of reaching speeds of up to 500 kmph, the Maglev train is designed to become one of the fastest commercial rail services in the world.

The project is part of the Chuo Shinkansen high-speed rail corridor, which uses advanced magnetic levitation technology instead of conventional wheels. The trains float above the guideway using powerful superconducting magnets, eliminating friction and allowing them to travel at extremely high speeds while ensuring a smooth and quiet ride.

Once operational, the Maglev service will cut the travel time between Tokyo's Shinagawa Station and Nagoya from the current journey of around 90 minutes by bullet train to approximately 40 minutes. The route is expected to significantly improve connectivity between two of Japan's largest economic and industrial hubs. The ambitious project involves extensive engineering work, with nearly 90 percent of the route passing through tun-



nels to minimize environmental impact and accommodate Japan's mountainous terrain. Construction has faced delays due to environmental concerns, rising costs, and complex tunneling operations, but authorities continue to push the project forward.

The Maglev system has already demonstrated its capabilities during testing, setting a world speed record of 603 kmph for a manned train. The commercial service, however, will operate at a maximum speed of around 500 kmph to ensure safety and reliability. Officials believe the project will not only reduce travel time but also strengthen regional economic growth, ease congestion on existing transport networks, and provide a more efficient mode of intercity travel. The new line is expected to sup-

port business travel, tourism, and long-term infrastructure development. The technology also represents a major step forward in sustainable transportation. Since the trains operate using electric power and magnetic levitation, they are expected to offer an environmentally friendly alternative to short-haul air travel by reducing carbon emissions and improving energy efficiency.

Although the project has encountered construction challenges and rising expenses, Japan continues to view the Maglev railway as a landmark investment in the future of transportation. Once completed, it is expected to redefine high-speed rail travel and reinforce Japan's position as a global leader in advanced railway technology.



Fresh US-Iran Strikes Raise Fears of Wider Gulf Conflict

The conflict between the United States and Iran has escalated once again, with both countries carrying out fresh military strikes that have intensified tensions across the Gulf region. The latest exchanges have increased fears of a broader regional conflict and raised concerns over the security of global energy supplies.

The fresh round of hostilities follows a series of retaliatory attacks after recent US military operations targeting Iranian-linked facilities. Iran responded with missile and drone strikes aimed at American military assets and strategic locations in the Gulf, prompting further military action by the United States.

Pakistan Cargo Plane Goes Missing Over Arabian Sea

A Pakistan-registered K2 Airways cargo aircraft disappeared from radar over the Arabian Sea while flying from Sharjah in the United Arab Emirates to Karachi, triggering a large-scale search and rescue operation by Pakistani authorities. The Boeing 737-400 freighter was carrying five crew members when it lost contact with air traffic control.

According to aviation officials, the aircraft reported a navigation system malfunction shortly before communication was lost. Flight-tracking data indicated unusual altitude changes in the aircraft's final minutes, followed by a steep descent before it vanished from radar approximately 155 nautical miles southwest of Karachi. The exact cause of the disappearance remains unknown, and authorities have not confirmed whether the aircraft crashed.

Pakistan's Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, and other maritime agencies have launched an extensive search operation in the Arabian Sea. Naval ships, surveillance aircraft, helicopters, and nearby commercial vessels have been deployed to locate the missing aircraft and its crew. Rescue teams continue to search the suspected area despite challenging sea conditions.

The missing aircraft belonged to Karachi-based K2 Airways, a private cargo airline. The Boeing 737 freighter had been operating regular cargo services be-

tween regional destinations and was on a routine flight when the incident occurred. Airline officials have said they are fully cooperating with investigators and government agencies involved in the search.

Aviation experts have described the aircraft's final flight path as unusual. Even in the event of an engine failure, a commercial aircraft is generally expected to glide for some distance before descending. However, the sudden altitude fluctuations and rapid loss of height recorded before radar contact was lost have raised several questions that investigators will seek to answer.

Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has directed authorities to intensify the search and rescue mission and ensure that all available resources are deployed to locate the aircraft. Officials have assured the families of the crew that they will continue to receive timely updates as the operation progresses.

The disappearance has once again highlighted the importance of aviation safety and emergency response capabilities in the region. While investigators continue to examine all possible causes behind the incident, the immediate priority remains locating the aircraft, recovering the crew, and determining exactly what happened during its final moments. Search operations are expected to continue until definitive information is obtained.

Sensex Crashes 1,677 Points as US-Iran Tensions

Indian stock markets witnessed a sharp sell-off as escalating tensions between the United States and Iran rattled investor confidence, triggering heavy selling across sectors. Concerns over rising geopolitical risks, surging crude oil prices, and weak global cues pushed benchmark indices deep into the red, making it one of the steepest market declines in recent months.

The trading session began on a weak note, but selling pressure intensified as the day progressed. The Nifty 50 slipped below the crucial 24,000 mark and touched an intraday low of 23,805.20 after reports of renewed hostilities in the Middle East heightened fears of a prolonged conflict. Investors rushed to book profits and reduce exposure to equities amid growing uncertainty.

At the close of trade, the BSE Sensex plunged 1,677.12 points, or 2.15%, to settle at 76,503.60, while the Nifty 50 dropped 516.65 points, or 2.12%, to end at 23,882.05. The sharp decline erased significant investor



wealth in a single session and reflected the cautious mood prevailing across global financial markets.

The sell-off was broad-based, with almost every major sector ending in negative territory. Banking and financial stocks led the decline, while information technology, auto, metal, realty, oil & gas, and capital goods stocks also witnessed heavy losses. Mid-cap and small-cap stocks were equally affected as investors shifted away from riskier assets.

A major concern for investors was the sharp rise in crude oil

prices following the renewed geopolitical tensions. As India imports the majority of its crude oil requirements, higher oil prices raise fears of increased inflation, a wider trade deficit, and pressure on corporate earnings. Rising fuel costs could also impact consumer spending and economic growth, prompting investors to adopt a cautious approach.

Market experts believe that while India's economic fundamentals remain strong, external factors are currently dominating investor sentiment. Geopolitical developments, fluctua-

Global Markets Sink as Trump Declares US-Iran Ceasefire 'Over'

The announcement triggered a sharp sell-off across global equities, while crude oil prices surged amid concerns over potential supply disruptions.

Wall Street futures fell by more than one percent, signaling a weak start for US markets. Investor sentiment turned sharply negative as geopolitical tensions intensified, prompting traders to move away from riskier assets and seek safer investment options such as gold and the US dollar.

Global investors also shifted money into traditional safe-haven assets. Gold prices moved higher, while demand for the US dollar increased as investors sought stability during the period of heightened uncertainty. Bond yields fluctuated as market participants reassessed the outlook for the global

economy.

Market experts believe that geopolitical developments are likely to remain the key driver of financial markets in the coming days. Any further escalation between the United States and Iran could increase volatility across equities, commodities, and currency markets. Conversely, signs of renewed diplomatic efforts could help restore investor confidence. Despite the sharp market reaction, analysts advise long-term investors to avoid panic selling and remain focused on quality investments. India Inc Set for Uneven Q1 Results as Banking and Infra Outperform

India Inc's earnings season for the first quarter of FY2025-26 is expected to present a mixed picture, with private banks, Larsen & Toubro (L&T), Siemens, and Bharat Electronics Ltd. (BEL) likely to emerge as the key growth drivers. However, weak performance from oil marketing companies (OMCs) could limit the overall growth in corporate profits.

Market analysts expect private sector banks to post healthy earnings, supported by steady loan growth, stable asset quality, and resilient net interest income. Strong credit demand across retail and corporate segments, along with disciplined risk management, is likely to help banks maintain solid profitability despite a challenging interest rate environment.

Infrastructure and capital goods companies are also expected to deliver encouraging results. L&T is projected to benefit from a robust order book, continued execution of large



infrastructure projects, and sustained government spending on public infrastructure. Siemens is likely to report improved earnings, driven by rising demand in industrial automation, electrification, and engineering solutions. Meanwhile, BEL is expected to continue its strong momentum, supported by increased defence spending and healthy order inflows from the government.

In contrast, oil marketing companies may report weaker earnings during the quarter.

Volatility in global crude oil prices, pressure on marketing margins, and fluctuations in fuel pricing are expected to impact profitability. These factors could significantly drag down the aggregate earnings growth of listed companies, offsetting gains made by stronger-performing sectors.

Analysts believe the overall earnings season will highlight the widening gap between sectors benefiting from domestic economic growth and those facing external market pressures.

Banking, infrastructure, capital goods, and defence are expected to remain among the strongest performers, reflecting continued investment activity and government-led spending.

On the other hand, sectors closely linked to commodity price movements may continue to experience earnings pressure due to volatile global conditions. Investors are therefore expected to closely monitor management commentary on future demand, order pipelines, margin trends, and capital expenditure plans, as these will provide important signals about the outlook for the rest of the financial year.

Overall, while the first-quarter earnings season is expected to deliver healthy growth in select sectors, the weakness in oil marketing companies could prevent broader corporate earnings from showing stronger expansion, making stock-specific performance more important for investors.

Laser Power & Infra IPO: Power Sector Potential vs Falling GMP Challenge

Laser Power & Infra Ltd. is set to launch its 742-crore initial public offering (IPO) on July 9, but a sharp decline in the grey market premium (GMP) has made investors more cautious ahead of the issue. While the company operates in India's fast-growing power transmission and distribution sector, market experts advise investors to focus on the company's long-term fundamentals rather than short-term GMP movements.

The IPO has been priced in a band of 203-214 per share and comprises a fresh issue worth 542 crore along with an Offer for Sale (OFS) of 200 crore by existing promoters. At the upper end of the price band, the company is valued at nearly 3,000 crore. The public issue will close on July 13, and the shares are expected to be listed on the BSE and NSE on July 16.

The company plans to use the proceeds from the fresh issue primarily to reduce its outstanding debt, while the remaining funds will be utilized for general corporate purposes. Lower debt levels are expected to strengthen its balance sheet and provide greater financial flexibility for future expansion.

Laser Power & Infra manufactures power cables, conductors, and transmission prod-



ucts, besides executing engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) projects. With more than three decades of experience in the industry, the company is well-positioned to benefit from India's rising investments in power infrastructure, electrification, and transmission networks.

Despite its strong business prospects, the grey market premium has declined considerably in recent days, indicating that expectations of strong listing gains have weakened. The fall in GMP reflects cautious investor sentiment and softer demand in the unofficial market. However, analysts caution that GMP should not be treated as the sole indicator of an IPO's potential performance.

Brokers believe the company offers investors an opportunity to participate in India's

long-term infrastructure and power sector growth, driven by increasing electricity demand and continued government spending on transmission and distribution projects.

At the same time, investors should remain mindful of potential risks, including dependence on large customers, volatility in raw material prices, and execution challenges associated with EPC projects.

Overall, Laser Power & Infra's IPO appears suitable for investors with a medium- to long-term investment horizon who are optimistic about India's infrastructure growth story. However, those looking for immediate listing gains may prefer to remain cautious, as the declining grey market premium points to a relatively muted stock market debut.

Gold Slumps on Rate Fears as Strong US Dollar Dulls Safe-Haven Appeal

Gold prices witnessed a sharp decline in futures trading on Wednesday, with the precious metal falling 2,308 per 10 grams on the Multi Commodity Exchange (MCX). The drop was largely driven by a stronger US dollar and rising crude oil prices, which reduced the appeal of gold as a safe-haven investment.

Market analysts said renewed geopolitical tensions in West Asia pushed crude oil prices higher, raising concerns over inflation. Higher oil prices strengthened expectations that major central banks, particularly the US Federal Reserve, could keep interest rates elevated for a longer period. This boosted the US dollar, making gold more expensive for overseas buyers and reducing demand for the yellow metal.

On the MCX, gold contracts for August delivery declined sharply as traders trimmed their positions amid weak global market sentiment. International gold



prices also moved lower, reflecting concerns over persistent inflation and the possibility of tighter monetary policy in the United States.

Although gold is traditionally considered a hedge against inflation and geopolitical uncertainty, higher interest rates tend to reduce its attractiveness because the metal does not generate any interest income. Investors often shift towards interest-bearing assets during such periods, putting pressure on bullion prices.

Analysts believe gold prices

are likely to remain volatile in the near term as global markets closely monitor developments in the Middle East, fluctuations in crude oil prices, and upcoming US economic data. Any signals regarding future interest rate decisions by the Federal Reserve are expected to significantly influence the direction of gold prices.

Market participants are also keeping an eye on the movement of the US dollar and bond yields, both of which play a crucial role in determining bullion prices. A

stronger dollar generally weighs on gold, while lower bond yields tend to support the precious metal.

Despite the recent correction, experts believe the long-term outlook for gold remains constructive, supported by ongoing geopolitical uncertainties, central bank purchases, and sustained investor interest in safe-haven assets. However, short-term price movements are expected to remain highly sensitive to global macroeconomic developments.

For investors, the current environment calls for caution, as gold prices may continue to witness sharp fluctuations depending on inflation trends, monetary policy expectations, energy prices, and overall global market sentiment. While long-term investors may continue to view gold as a portfolio diversifier, short-term traders should be prepared for increased volatility in the bullion market.

PGIM India Freezes New SIP Entries in Overseas Funds

PGIM India Mutual Fund has temporarily suspended fresh Systematic Investment Plan (SIP) registrations in three of its overseas fund schemes, effective July 9. The decision has been taken to ensure compliance with the overseas investment limits prescribed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).

The suspension applies to the PGIM India Global Equity Opportunities Fund of Fund, PGIM India Emerging Markets Equity Fund of Fund, and the PGIM India Global Select Real Estate Se-

curities Fund of Fund. Fresh SIP registrations submitted after the prescribed cut-off date will not be accepted. However, investors who have already registered SIPs before the deadline will continue to have their investments processed without any interruption.

This is the latest in a series of measures introduced by the fund house to regulate inflows into its international schemes. Earlier, PGIM India had capped fresh SIP investments at 50,000 per day per investor per scheme

and had also suspended fresh Systematic Transfer Plan (STP) registrations, while allowing existing SIPs and STPs to continue. The company had previously paused fresh subscriptions to these schemes before reopening them with revised investment limits.

The restrictions are primarily aimed at ensuring that the mutual fund remains within the regulatory ceiling for overseas investments applicable to Indian asset management companies. Since the overall industry limit

for investing in foreign securities is closely monitored, many mutual funds have imposed similar restrictions whenever they approach the maximum permissible investment threshold.

Importantly, the latest decision affects only new SIP registrations. Existing SIPs will continue without any changes, and investors can continue holding, redeeming, or switching their investments as per the scheme rules. Other investor services remain unaffected.

The three overseas schemes

offer Indian investors exposure to global equity markets and international real estate securities, helping diversify portfolios beyond domestic investments. Such funds have gained popularity among investors seeking geographical diversification and access to global growth opportunities.

However, regulatory limits on overseas investments have led several fund houses to periodically restrict fresh inflows until additional investment capacity becomes available.



For existing investors, the latest move does not alter their investment plans or returns. New investors interested in these schemes will have to wait until PGIM India Mutual Fund reopens fresh SIP registrations after sufficient regulatory head-

room becomes available.

The development highlights the continued demand for international investment opportunities among Indian investors, even as mutual fund companies balance investor interest with regulatory compliance.

Train Coach Turned Into a Honeymoon Suite

A video showing a First AC train coach transformed into a romantic honeymoon suite has gone viral on social media, drawing widespread attention and mixed reactions. 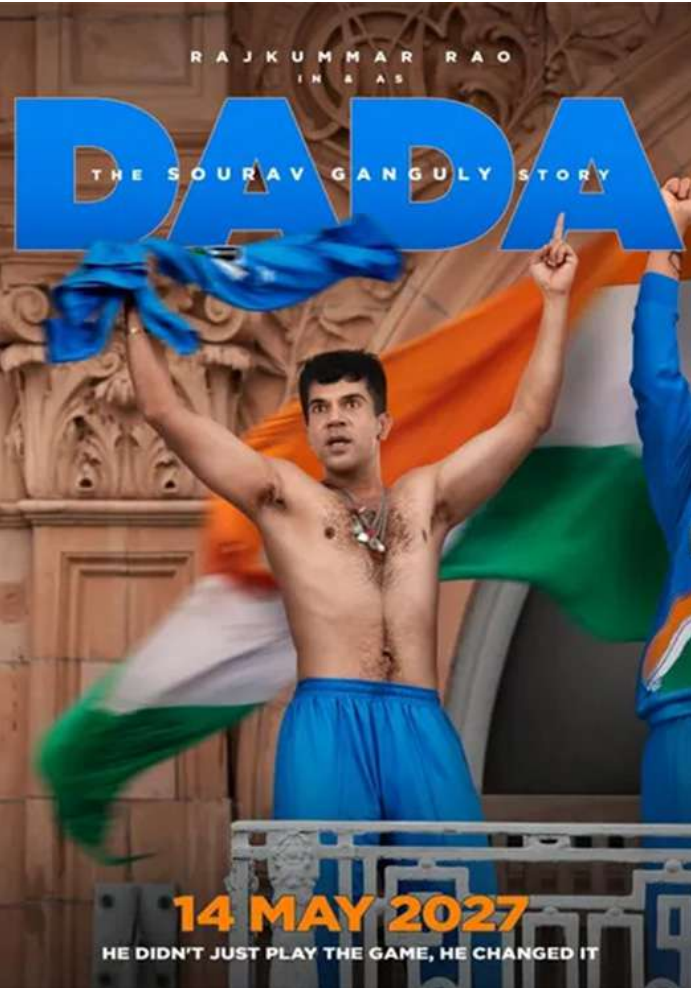
