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Naidu Envisions Nellore as National Growth Hub with Major Investments

Gudur, July 1 | TPN Bureau

N Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday said Nellore district will be developed into one of India's key centres for growth, development and wealth creation, driven by major infrastructure and industrial investments. He asserted that the NDA government remains committed to the welfare of the poor and ensuring dignified living conditions for all sections of society. Addressing the Pedala Sevala public meeting at Punnaravari- palem in Gudur constituency, the Chief Minister said balanced regional development is a core priority. He noted that Visakhapatnam, Amaravati and Tirupati are being envisioned as major regional growth centres, expressing confidence that Nellore would emerge as a national growth engine. Highlighting key projects, Naidu referred to Ramayapatnam Port, Krishnapatnam Port and the proposed shipbuilding centre at Dugarajapatnam. He said Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited is investing nearly 1 lakh crore in a refinery at Ramayapatnam, while industrial activity is also expected to expand at IFFCO Kisan Special Economic



Zone. Gudur has already attracted 27 major industries, with a Mega Furniture Park planned and Sri City emerging as a model industrial ecosystem. Enhanced national highways, railway expansion and port connectivity will further strengthen the district as a logistics hub, he added. Naidu said the government had rectified earlier administrative decisions by restoring Gudur to Nellore district, along with Saiduapuram and Kalavayipuram mandals, based on public demand. Governance, he emphasised, must reflect people's aspirations. He said pensions covering 28 categories, includ-

ing senior citizens, widows and persons with disabilities, are being delivered on the first day of every month. Over the past two years, the administration has focused on rebuilding governance and restoring institutions. The Chief Minister highlighted digital initiatives such as WhatsApp Governance and Mana Mitra for service delivery. Under the One Family-One Entrepreneur initiative, women are being encouraged to take up entrepreneurship, with DW-CRA groups continuing to play a key role. On irrigation, he said 36 priority projects are being fast-tracked, with 24,000 crore already spent. He reaf-

firmed commitment to completing the Veligonda Project, noting that 900 crore has been released for rehabilitation and the first phase will cost 2,500 crore. Naidu also mentioned ethanol production using maize to reduce fuel imports and announced that the Rayalaseema Steel Plant foundation stone will be laid on July 3. He condemned abusive social media posts targeting Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan's family and remarks against Home Minister Vangalapudi Anitha, urging people to reject divisive politics and support development-oriented governance.

Freedom of Speech Comes with Responsibility, Says Pawan Kalyan

Deputy Chief Minister Konidela Pawan Kalyan on Wednesday, issued a detailed message on social media on freedom of expression and the growing misuse of digital platforms. While affirming respect for the constitutional right to free speech, he said it is not absolute and is subject to reasonable restric-

tions under Article 19(2) of the Constitution, including national security, public order, decency, morality, defamation and incitement to crime. Pawan Kalyan said criticism of the government is welcome in a democracy, but freedom of speech cannot be used for abuse, threats, false allegations, targeting women, insulting religious beliefs or inciting violence. 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Jagan Criticises Coalition Govt, Reaffirms Mavigun Stand

Former Chief Minister and YSRCP President Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy on Wednesday launched a sharp attack on the coalition government, alleging a complete breakdown of law and order and reaffirming that the party would continue to stand by its "Mavigun" proposal as a key political agenda. Addressing the media at Tadepalli, he said the state was witnessing "Jungle Raj," with police allegedly being misused to target political opponents. He coined the slogan "Hey Ram, Save Andhra," accusing Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu of turning victims into accused and using law enforcement for political vendetta. He reiterated that Mavigun would remain a central election slogan and alleged large-scale corruption in the Amaravati capital project, claiming inflated payments were being made to contractors. He described Mavigun as a viable alternative with natural advantages and existing infrastructure. On the Dalit Christian issue, Jagan Mohan Reddy demanded that the Telugu Desam Party clearly state its position before the Justice Balakrishnan Commission. He accused TDP lead-



ers of attempting to incite caste and religious tensions while alleging Chandrababu Naidu remained silent. He said YSRCP had already supported the issue through an Assembly resolution. He also raised concerns over recent law and order incidents, including the custodial death of Sai Krishna, alleging the case was initially suppressed and later exposed after his visit to the victim's family. He questioned the missing CCTV footage and alleged attempts to dilute the investigation. He further cited the death of Dalit youth Kranthi Kumar, claiming police were downplaying the case despite video evidence, and referred to inci-

dents in Kurnool, Tenali and Srikakulam as signs of rising police excesses. Jagan Mohan Reddy alleged that names of YSRCP supporters were being removed from voter lists, affecting access to welfare schemes. He claimed farmers were suffering due to withdrawal of crop insurance, input subsidies and falling prices of key crops. He also criticised the rise of liquor-related activities, calling them culturally harmful. Concluding, he said governance standards had declined and asserted that YSRCP would continue to oppose corruption and administrative failure while firmly standing by the Mavigun proposal.

Over 2.45 Lakh Candidates Qualify in AP EAPCET 2026

More than 2.45 lakh candidates qualified in the Andhra Pradesh Engineering, Agriculture and Pharmacy Common Entrance Test (AP EAPCET) 2026, the results of which were announced by Human Resource Development Minister Nara Lokesh on Wednesday.

The examination was conducted by Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada (JNTUK) on behalf of the Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education (APSCHE) from May 12 to 15 and May 18 to 20 at 141 test centres across 25 districts in Andhra Pradesh and one centre in Hyderabad.

According to the AP EAPCET

2026 Convener, 1,82,317 of the 2,58,545 candidates who appeared in the Engineering stream qualified, registering a pass percentage of 70.52. In the Agriculture and Pharmacy stream, 63,546 of the 70,929 candidates cleared the examination, recording an 89.59 per cent pass rate. Female candidates performed better than their male counterparts in Engineering, securing a pass percentage of 71.65 compared to 69.63 among males.

Congratulating the successful candidates, Nara Lokesh said their achievement would contribute to the future growth of Andhra Pradesh. Rank cards are available on the AP EAPCET portal and through the State's WhatsApp Governance service.

Satya Kumar Calls for Respect and Safety for Doctors

Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav on Wednesday stressed the need for greater respect towards doctors and cautioned against disrupting their duties, stating that medical professionals provide hope and reassurance to patients and their families.

Addressing National Doctors' Day celebrations organised by the Indian Medical Association (IMA) in Proddatur of Kadapa district, he said doctors working in challenging conditions deserve a secure and supportive environment in hospitals. He urged the public to avoid arguments and abusive behaviour towards medical professionals and to recognise their service to society.

Satya Kumar Yadav said the coalition government had recruited around 3,000 doctors in the last two years and was spending nearly 320 crore annually on their salaries. He added that a zero-vacancy policy had been adopted and nearly 12,000 para-



medical posts were filled transparently.

He noted that these measures led to an 18 per cent rise in outpatient services and a 6.5 per cent increase in inpatient admissions in government hospitals. He also highlighted preventive healthcare initiatives such as the Sanjeevani scheme, door-to-door screening under the NCD-04 survey and expanded cancer care services.

The programme was organised under IMA State President Balaraju, State Secretary Subhash Chandra Bose, local president Vinod Kumar and general secretary Varun Kumar Reddy. Senior doctors S.K.V. Prasad Reddy, Giridhar, Swaroop Kumar Reddy and Suvarna were felicitated for their contributions.

Union Bank Waives SHG Loan Charges, Benefits 1.75 Lakh Groups

In a major relief to women's self-help groups (SHGs) in the state, Union Bank of India has waived processing and inspection charges levied on loans extended to SHGs, a move expected to provide substantial financial benefits to lakhs of women.

MSME, Rural Poverty Alleviation and NRI Empowerment Relations Minister Kondapalli Srinivas said the decision was taken following requests made during State Level Bankers' Committee (SLBC) meetings under the guidance of Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu and in coordination with SERP officials.

Until now, the bank charged processing fees on cash credit loans above Rs.10 lakh and

term loans exceeding Rs.5 lakh, besides quarterly inspection charges on loan accounts above Rs.5 lakh.

Kondapalli Srinivas said the waiver would save each SHG availing a Rs.20 lakh cash credit loan of nearly Rs.93,500 over three years. Around 1.75 lakh SHGs borrowing from Union Bank are expected to gain about Rs.586.25 crore annually from the exemption.

Union Bank currently serves 2,50,255 SHGs in Andhra Pradesh with loans exceeding Rs.20,359 crore, making it the leading lender in the SHG sector. The minister thanked the bank management for considering the government's request and said the decision would support the state's "One Family-One Entrepreneur" initiative aimed at promoting women-led enterprises.

Krishna Water Released from Prakasam Barrage for 30L Delta Farmers

Water was released from the Prakasam Barrage into the Krishna Delta canal system on Wednesday to ensure timely irrigation for farmers ahead of the kharif season.

District Collector G. Lakshmi-sha, along with public representatives and officials, formally released 3,200 cusecs of water through the Krishna Eastern Main Head Regulator into the eastern and western canals. Special prayers were also offered to the Krishna River as part of the ceremony.

Addressing the gathering, the Collector said the state government was committed to farmers' welfare and ensuring adequate irrigation supply to delta regions. He said the release of water would benefit nearly 30 lakh farmers cultivating about 13.08 lakh acres under the Krishna Delta ayacut.

Lakshmisha stated that under the Jaladhara-Jalaharathi initiative launched by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, canal desiltation and repair works had



been completed to ensure water reaches the tail-end areas. Measures were also being taken to enhance groundwater recharge, he added.

State Water Users Associations Federation chairman Alla Gopalakrishna Rao said water was released as per the irrigation calendar, enabling farmers to complete paddy transplantation by the end of July and minimise cyclone-related crop losses later in the season. He said Rs. 64 crore had been spent on canal desiltation and strengthening works in the Krishna Delta, while Rs. 425 crore had been allocated statewide under

operation and maintenance works.

Former ZP Chairperson Gadde Anuradha urged farmers to use water judiciously in view of the possible impact of El Niño on rainfall and stressed the need to prioritise drinking water requirements before irrigation needs.

Krishna District Project Committee Chairman Devanaboyina Venkateswara Rao, Water Resources Department officials J. Gunakara Rao, B. Rambabu, R. Ravikiran and Anjaneya Prasad, along with irrigation officials and other representatives, attended the programme.

Proposals are being prepared to construct bridges connecting the right and left banks of the project,

while plans are also being examined to link Polavaram with Eluru, Kovvur and Rajamahendravaram through national highways.

Designs submitted by Nippon Koei envision developing the stretch from Polavaram to Bhadrachalam via Papi Hills as a tourism corridor featuring a museum, water sports facilities, temple tourism circuits, resorts, huts and amusement parks. The designs will soon be reviewed by the Chief Minister before finalisation.

Naidu to Launch Rs 3,847-Crore Projects During Kuppam Tour

Samagra Shiksha Part-Time Instructors (PTIs) on Wednesday announced support for the agitation proposed by AP JAC Amaravati over unresolved employee issues.

Unity Welfare Association State President Saikam Shivakumari Reddy said PTIs would join the movement as their long-pending demands remained unaddressed despite repeated representations to authorities.

She, along with association members, met AP JAC Amaravati State Chairman Boppraju Venkateswarlu at Revenue Bhavan and expressed solidarity with the proposed agitation.

Shivakumari Reddy demanded government orders allowing PTIs to work in two shifts to provide arts and health education to students. She also sought redesigna-



tion of posts as Vocational and Physical Education Teachers.

She urged implementation of ESI and EPS benefits under G.O. No. 73 issued in May 2023, stating that provisions had not been enforced. The association also demanded job security, minimum time scale benefits, enhancement of retirement age to 62 years and gratuity support after retirement.

She warned that PTIs would intensify their agitation if demands continued to remain unresolved.

Revenue Association Seeks Safeguards for Presidential Order 2025

The Andhra Pradesh Revenue Services Association has urged the state government to protect employees' service rights while implementing the Presidential Order-2025, calling for transparency, seniority protection and timely promotions. The demands were placed during a meeting convened by CCLA and Special Chief Secretary with recognised employees' associations at the CCLA office in API-IC Bhavan on Tuesday.

Association president and APJAC Amaravati chairman Bopparaju Venkateswarlu, general secretary Ramishetty Venkata Rajesh, NTR district president Battina Ramakrishna, CCLA Employees' Association president B. Pullayya and secretary R. Durga Prasad attended the meeting.

The association sought completion of all pending Deputy

It also requested adequate time for updating panels, transparent allocation based on employee options, special consideration for employees with exceptional circumstances, and shifting Alluri Sitarama Raju district to Zone-I and Polavaram district to Zone-II. Telugu Academy Chairman Threatens Legal Action Against Lakshmi Parvathi

Telugu and Sanskrit Academy Chairman R.D. Wilson (Sarith Chandra) on Tuesday strongly refuted allegations made by YSRCP leader and former Academy Chairperson N. Lakshmi Parvathi regarding irregularities in the functioning of the Academy and warned of legal action if she fails to withdraw her remarks. Addressing a press conference, Wilson described Lakshmi Parvathi’s accusations as baseless and defamatory. He asserted that the present administration follows a transparent system by awarding contracts through open tenders, unlike the previous regime, and called for a comprehensive inquiry into decisions taken during her tenure. Wilson said the Academy had not spent any funds on the proposed Virtual Academy project and clarified that a Detailed Project Report (DPR) was prepared only on

government directions. He also dismissed allegations concerning a proposed YouTube channel, stating that no expenditure had been incurred for the initiative. The Chairman defended Education Minister Nara Lokesh, stating that the minister only provides policy guidance and does not interfere in the Academy’s day-to-day affairs. He also highlighted efforts being made to recover funds allegedly due from Telangana and to strengthen the Academy through policy reforms. Accusing Lakshmi Parvathi of making irresponsible statements that damage the institution’s reputation, Wilson warned that he would file a defamation suit and initiate proceedings under the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act if the remarks are not retracted. He maintained that the Academy remains committed to transparency, accountability, and educational development.



Satya Kumar Slams Jagan Over Reservation Demand

Health and Medical Education Minister Satya Kumar Yadav on Wednesday launched a sharp attack on former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, accusing him of pursuing divisive politics and attempting to weaken Hindu society through his demand for reservations for Dalit Christians.

Responding to Jagan’s remarks at a recent press conference, the Minister said the demand was unconstitutional and contrary to the principles laid down by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. He pointed out that courts have previously ruled that individuals who convert to Christianity cannot continue to claim Scheduled Caste status under existing constitutional provisions.

Satya Kumar alleged that extending reservation benefits to converted communities would encourage religious conversions and undermine the rights of Scheduled

Castes within Hindu society. He reiterated that the Bharatiya Janata Party opposes such proposals.

The Minister also criticized Jagan’s latest political statements, describing them as “an old movie with a new release.” He said the former Chief Minister was repeating issues that had already been rejected by the people, including the three-capitals proposal.

Referring to recent controversies, Satya Kumar accused Jagan of displaying selective concern on public issues while ignoring incidents that occurred during the YSRCP government’s tenure. He claimed that the people of Andhra Pradesh are fully aware of such political tactics and would not be misled.

The Minister asserted that the state is currently being governed under the rule of law and maintained that those responsible for past irregularities would face legal consequences.

Ravi Kumar Slams Jagan Over ‘MaVigan’ Campaign

Andhra Pradesh Energy Minister Gottipati Ravi Kumar on Wednesday launched a sharp attack on YSR Congress Party president Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, alleging that the latter’s “MaVigan” campaign was aimed at obstructing the State’s development and creating uncertainty among investors.

In a statement, Ravi Kumar accused Jagan of adopting contradictory positions on the capital issue and misleading the public. He said the people had already rejected the YSRCP’s three-capitals proposal in the elections and warned that continuing to promote the policy would further weaken the party politically.

The Minister alleged that the



former Chief Minister was attempting to discourage industrial investments in Andhra Pradesh through his statements and political campaigns. He stressed that development and economic growth should remain the State’s priority rather than political confrontation.

Referring to the Amaravati capital project, Ravi Kumar said Jagan had initially supported the project, including

the pooling of nearly 30,000 acres of land by farmers, and had even expressed willingness to reside in Amaravati. However, he alleged that Jagan changed his stance after coming to power by advocating the three-capitals model.

Drawing a comparison with Hyderabad’s growth as a major employment and investment hub, the Minister said Amaravati also possesses the potential to emerge as a powerful economic engine for Andhra Pradesh. He alleged that repeated statements against Amaravati were creating confusion and slowing the State’s progress.

Ravi Kumar asserted that the coalition government remains committed to developing Amaravati and attracting investments for Andhra Pradesh’s future growth.



Lokesh Calls for Unity, Announces Door-to-Door Campaign from July 15

TDP National Working President Nara Lokesh on Wednesday urged party cadres to remain united and strengthen grassroots outreach, while announcing a statewide door-to-door campaign from July 15 to highlight the achievements of the alliance government.

Durgesh Hits Out at Jagan Over Capital Remarks

State Tourism, Culture and Cinematography Minister Kandula Durgesh on Wednesday strongly criticized former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy over his recent remarks on the capital issue, asserting that Andhra Pradesh’s capital is linked to the future and aspirations of 5.5 crore people and cannot be treated as a political slogan.

In a statement issued at Amaravati, Durgesh accused Jagan of taking contradictory stands on the capital city. He alleged that while Jagan had earlier supported Amaravati,

The Minister said a capital city is the heart of a state and that stability in governance is essential for attracting investments, generating employment and ensuring development. Frequent changes in capital policy, he argued, create uncertainty and hinder economic growth.

Durgesh maintained that the people had already expressed their support for Amaravati through the democratic process and that continuing to

raise alternative capital proposals disregards public sentiment. He alleged that the previous government failed to make significant progress on capital development during its tenure.

The Minister further stated that the present coalition government, under Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, is focused on restoring investor confidence and accelerating development. He urged the opposition to act responsibly and prioritize public welfare over political controversies.

BJP Reaffirms Support for Amaravati, Slams Jagan's Capital Remarks

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) on Wednesday strongly criticized YSR Congress Party president Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy over his remarks about contesting future elections with the “Mavigan Agenda,” alleging that such statements create uncertainty and hinder Andhra Pradesh’s development. In a statement, BJP Andhra Pradesh Chief Spokesperson Valluru Jayaprakash Narayana asserted that Amaravati’s status as the state capital has already attained constitutional, legal, and

administrative clarity. He said the Union Government has formally recognized Amaravati as the capital and continues to extend full support for its development.

Jayaprakash Narayana maintained that reopening the capital debate at a time when the state is seeking investments from national and international companies sends a negative message and could affect investor confidence. He described Amaravati as a symbol of the aspirations and self-respect of the people of Andhra Pradesh rather than a political issue. The BJP leader said the NDA government in Andhra

Pradesh, led by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu with the support of Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, remains committed to developing Amaravati as the state capital. He asserted that the BJP would continue to support projects aimed at strengthening the state’s growth, including Amaravati’s development, completion of the Polavaram Project, industrial expansion, and job creation.

He also urged political leaders to respect democratic mandates and focus on development, investment, and public welfare rather than creating disputes over settled issues.

Durgesh Accuses Jagan of Creating Confusion Over State Capital

A fresh political controversy has erupted in the state over former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy’s reported remarks on the “Mavigan” agenda and the capital issue, drawing sharp criticism from leaders of the ruling alliance.

Tourism, Culture and Cinematography Minister Kandula Durgesh accused Jagan Mohan Reddy of creating confusion over the state capital despite the people’s verdict and legal clarity on Amaravati. He

asserted that a capital city is not a political slogan or an issue to be altered according to changing political interests, but a matter linked to the future and aspirations of over five crore people of Andhra Pradesh. The Minister said Amaravati represents the state’s growth, investment potential and employment opportunities for youth. Repeated debates over shifting the capital, he argued, could adversely affect investor confidence and hinder development. He maintained that sustainable progress is possible only with a

stable capital and alleged that the previous government’s three-capitals proposal had caused uncertainty and slowed development.

Durgesh further stated that the NDA-led government under Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, with the support of the Centre, is committed to strengthening Amaravati and accelerating infrastructure and economic growth. He urged the opposition to act responsibly and focus on public welfare rather than reviving capital-related disputes.

Atchannaidu Dares Jagan to Open Debate on Agriculture

Agriculture Minister Kinjarapu Atchannaidu on Tuesday launched a sharp attack on YSRCP president and former chief minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, accusing him of neglecting the farming sector during his five-year tenure and resorting to “crocodile tears” over farmers’ issues after losing power.

Addressing a press conference, Atchannaidu challenged Jagan to a public debate on agriculture and alleged that the former chief minister was attempting to gain political mileage by making what he termed misleading statements on farmers’ welfare.

The minister defended the coalition government’s performance, citing measures taken in tobacco procurement, e-crop registration, crop insurance, input subsidy, aquaculture, fertiliser supply and support to mango growers. He said the government had spent more than Rs.273 crore to support HD Burley tobacco farmers and ensured minimum support mechanisms through coordination with the Centre and the Tobacco Board.

Atchannaidu claimed e-crop registration had increased significantly under the coalition



government and said Rs.324.22 crore had already been released as input subsidy for crop losses during 2024-25. He also highlighted the implementation of the Annadata Sukhibhava scheme, under which eligible farmers receive Rs.20,000 annually, including Central assistance.

The minister alleged that the previous YSRCP government had left large pending liabilities in crop insurance and drip irrigation sectors and accused it of weakening natural farming initiatives. He maintained that the coalition government had restored transparency and efficiency in agriculture-related schemes and reiterated its commitment to farmer welfare.

Atchannaidu asserted that farmers had already delivered their verdict on the previous regime and urged Jagan to explain the shortcomings of his administration before criticising the present government.



Maldives Delegation Visits NTR District, Studies Rural Development Initiatives

CPM Demands Extension of Voter Revision Deadline

The Communist Party of India (Marxist) has demanded an extension of the deadline for the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls, alleging that the exercise could result in the disenfranchisement of eligible voters. During a field visit in Mogalrajapuram, Vijayawada, CPM State Secretariat member Ch. Babu Rao interacted with residents and reviewed the implementation of the voter verification process. He claimed that many citizens are facing difficulties in submitting required documents and proving their eligibility. Babu Rao alleged that the burden of producing proof of past voter registration has been unfairly placed on citizens, particularly younger voters who may not have access to records dating back decades. He urged authori-

ties to take responsibility for verifying historical voter details instead of shifting the burden onto the public. The CPM leader also expressed concern over delays in document distribution and data uploading, stating that inadequate staffing has affected the smooth conduct of the exercise. He called for additional personnel, door-to-door awareness campaigns, booth-level meetings, and Gram Sabha consultations to ensure that no eligible voter is left out. Babu Rao warned that exclusion from electoral rolls could adversely affect access to welfare benefits and other government services. He urged the Election Commission to extend the July 15 deadline and ensure that every eligible citizen retains the right to vote. The CPM also appealed to political parties and civil society groups to actively support efforts aimed at protecting voting rights.

Uma Hails 'NTR Bharosa', Slams YSRCP Over Pension Record

TDP State General Secretary and former minister Devineni Umamaheswara Rao on Tuesday said the Alliance government has reaffirmed its commitment to the welfare of the poor through the implementation of the 'NTR Bharosa' pension scheme. Participating in the pension distribution programme at Gollapudi in Vijayawada Rural mandal, Uma distributed pensions to beneficiaries and praised Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu for fulfilling the promise of increasing social pensions soon after assuming office. NTR Bharosa Pensions Distributed Across State

Burglary in Shantinagar Raises Safety Concerns

A major burglary in Shantinagar has triggered concerns over public safety, with CPM leaders urging the police and government to take stronger measures to curb thefts in residential areas. According to reports, unidentified thieves broke into the residence of SK Nagina Maqbool Basha near Bhaskar Rao Kottu Center in Shantinagar while the family was away attending the Rottella Panduga festival in Nellore. Upon returning home, family members found the house ransacked and the almirah broken open. The victims reported the loss of 60 sovereigns of gold ornaments and cash, making it one of the significant thefts reported in the locality in recent times. Residents have expressed concern over a rise in burglaries in areas falling under the limits of the Payakapuram and Nunna police stations, alleging that thieves are targeting houses when occupants are away. SFI Urges Early Completion of Admissions

The Students' Federation of India (SFI) has urged the Higher Education Department to expedite the admission process for various higher education courses and release a common academic calendar for the new academic year. SFI State Secretary K. Prasanna Kumar and State Vice-President B. Ravi submitted a representation to Higher Education Joint Director Chappidi Krishna, seeking immediate action on admissions for Engineering, Degree, PG, Law, and other professional courses. Addressing the media, Prasanna Kumar said delays in admissions every year force thousands of students to seek admission in private institutions and universities outside Andhra Pradesh. He noted that although examination results have already been declared, the admission process has not yet been finalized. He pointed out that admissions for the previous academic year were completed only in September, resulting in academic delays and students taking semester examinations much later than scheduled. SFI demanded that admissions for PG, Law, and other higher education courses be completed by July to ensure smooth academic functioning. The student organization also requested that admissions be conducted through an offline



mode and called for the publication of a common academic calendar for all higher education institutions. Expressing concern over the proposed implementation of the Face Recognition System (FRS), SFI warned of potential technical difficulties, particularly in tribal and remote areas. The organization suggested introducing the system on a pilot basis before statewide implementation to avoid inconvenience to students.



State Marks Doctors' Day with Health and Rural Development Initiatives

Commissioner Reviews NTR Bharosa Pension Distribution

Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) Commissioner H.M. Dhyanachandra on Wednesday reviewed the distribution of NTR Bharosa pensions and personally handed over pensions to beneficiaries in the Old Rajarajeswaripeta area. In total, 60,203 pensions were distributed across the three circles. Later, the Commissioner inspected JP Apartments in Old Rajarajeswaripeta and reviewed local civic issues. He directed municipal officials to take immediate measures to resolve drainage problems and clear blockages to ensure the uninterrupted flow of sewage. Zonal Commissioner Satyanarayana, CDO Srikanth, Executive Engineer J. Srinivas, and other municipal officials accompanied the Commissioner during the inspection and pension distribution programme.



Fake Currency Racket Busted; Two Arrested

Ibrahimpatnam Police in NTR district busted a counterfeit currency circulation racket and arrested two persons while seizing fake currency notes worth 4.5 lakh in 500 denominations. According to police, acting on a tip-off received on the night of June 30, officers conducted a raid at a poultry farm located on Jio Tower Road in the Khaji Manyam area of Ibrahimpatnam. During the operation, police apprehended Gunja Mangarao (40) of Ibrahimpatnam and Vallabhaneni Pavan Kumar alias Pavan (31) of Bhavanipuram, Vijayawada. Police recovered nine bundles of counterfeit 500 notes, amounting to 4,50,000, from the accused. A case was registered

and the seized notes were taken into custody. During interrogation, investigators reportedly learned that an accused identified as Raja, a resident of Anantapur and currently absconding, had established contact with Mangarao while the latter was lodged in Bengaluru Jail. After their release, Raja allegedly supplied counterfeit currency to Mangarao, who, in turn, passed the notes to Pavan Kumar and another associate for circulation in and around Vijayawada. Police identified two more accused, Raju and Raja, who are currently absconding. Authorities have formed three special teams to trace and apprehend the remaining suspects. Further investigation is underway to determine the source and extent of the counterfeit currency network.

Prices of e-Vehicles Should Be Slashed

Electric vehicles (EVs) are no longer a futuristic concept; they are becoming an essential part of India's strategy to reduce pollution and dependence on fossil fuels. Both the Union and State Governments have been encouraging the adoption of electric mobility through subsidies, policy incentives, and infrastructure development. Yet, one major obstacle continues to stand in the way of mass adoption—the high price of electric vehicles.

Despite limited charging infrastructure in many parts of the country, people are showing a willingness to shift towards electric scooters and cars. This reflects growing public awareness about environmental protection and the long-term benefits of EVs. However, affordability remains the biggest challenge. For many middle-class and low-income families, the cost of purchasing an electric vehicle is still beyond their reach.

The Delhi Government's decision to gradually phase out non-electric scooters and auto-rickshaws is a bold step towards tackling the city's severe air pollution. While the objective is commendable, such policies must also consider the financial realities of ordinary citizens. Setting deadlines without ensuring affordable alternatives may place an unfair burden on those who depend on these vehicles for their livelihood.

If governments are serious about accelerating the transition to clean mobility, reducing vehicle prices should become a top priority. Greater subsidies, tax concessions, low-interest financing, and incentives for manufacturers can help bring down costs. Public investment in charging infrastructure must also go hand in hand with promoting EV ownership.

Governments have often extended substantial financial support to industries in the name of economic growth. Extending similar support to ordinary citizens for purchasing electric vehicles would be an investment in cleaner cities, better public health, and a sustainable future.

India's vision for widespread electric mobility, as envisaged by policymakers, can become a reality only when electric vehicles are not merely environmentally friendly but also financially accessible to every household.

From Loneliness to Social Connection: A Path to Healthier Societies

Health, according to the WHO, is a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being and not just the absence of disease or infirmity. The recent report released by the “WHO Commission on Social Connection” speaks about in-depth issues related to social health and its importance. Social health is a key part of our overall well-being. At the heart of social health lies social connection—how we relate to and interact with others—which has a profound impact on our health. This report is based on careful research, expert advice, and real-life experiences and examples.

Importance of Social Health
Humans are social by nature. Mankind survived and thrived by working together. Our brains are wired to connect with others. From the moment we are born and throughout our lifetime, social interactions shape our brain and, subsequently, our mental health. Social health matters as much as our physical and mental health. All three are interlinked. Without good social health, it is hard to enjoy good health. Social disconnection is gradually increasing as technology burgeons. Due to social disconnection, 1 in 6 persons feels lonely globally. Social disconnection increases the risk of death due to heart problems, stroke, depression, and anxiety. Loneliness is leading to 8.71 lakh deaths annually across the globe. The COVID-19 lockdowns and other social restrictions kept people apart, and many felt lonely and isolated. Currently, the digital AI era is rapidly and pro-

foundly changing our lifestyles, enhancing the scope of social disconnection.

Social Connection Means...

Social connection is about the many ways we relate to and interact with others. It includes family, friends, classmates, coworkers, neighbours—even people we chat with online. Social connection has three dimensions: structure (social human networks, talking, spending time), function (practical help, emotional support, and information you give and receive), and quality (how your relationships make you feel). We can connect with people in both online and offline modes.

Social Disconnection: Loneliness and Social Isolation

Social disconnection results when a person does not have enough social contact, does not feel supported by the relationships they have, or when the relationships are strained or negative. Loneliness is a painful feeling that occurs when the relationships you have do not match what you want or need. You may feel lonely even when surrounded by people. You may have friends but not feel understood or supported. Life after a breakup, moving to new places, or losing loved ones are occasions when individuals may feel lonely. If loneliness lasts for a long time, it may lead to serious health problems. Social isolation is more about numbers—having very few relationships or not meeting people frequently. Someone who lives alone and rarely



talks to others might be socially isolated. A person can be isolated but not feel lonely—some people like being alone. However, social isolation can harm physical and mental health, especially in the long run.

Impact of Social Disconnection, Loneliness, and Social Isolation

Loneliness is common everywhere, among all age groups, and affects males and females equally. Young people between 13 and 29 years of age feel the loneliest. Globally, around 17–21 % feel lonely, with higher levels among teenagers. This may be because teenagers seek stronger social connections. People in poorer countries with low income are more likely to feel lonely (24 %) than those in richer countries (11 %). Poverty may limit movement and opportunities to meet others, making it harder to maintain relationships. Social isolation is another challenge to overall health. Up to

1 in 3 adults are isolated, and 1 in 4 teenagers are socially isolated. People with disabilities, refugees, migrants, LGBTQ+ individuals, indigenous groups, and ethnic minorities are more prone to loneliness and/or social isolation. The impacts include effects on mortality, physical and mental health, brain development, education, work, and the economy.

Causes of Loneliness and Social Isolation

The reasons for loneliness and isolation differ from person to person and may arise from personal life, lifestyle, relationships, neighbourhoods, and government policies. Health, education, income, personality, type of work, communities, life transitions, and digital technology all play a role. Higher education and income groups often have better chances of maintaining relationships. Long-term health issues may lead to loneliness. Having few relatives and friends

can also contribute. Some individuals are shy or anxious, making communication difficult. Safe and supportive communities enhance social health. Moving to new places or losing a job can lead to loneliness. The impact of digital technology is mixed. While it may help some cope, excessive screen time or negative online experiences can worsen loneliness. Young people's mental health is particularly affected.

In short, staying socially connected is not just good for individuals—it is vital for society. Let us advocate, campaign, network, and collaborate to reduce loneliness and isolation by strengthening social connections. Awareness through social media, television programs, public events, and campaigns can help. Local, national, and global efforts, along with supportive government policies, can significantly improve social connection through community and relationship-based strategies.

Fee Regulation in Education: Reform or Repetition?

The Andhra Pradesh government's proposed move to introduce fresh regulations on fees in private schools and intermediate colleges raises a familiar yet critical question: will this initiative genuinely ease the financial burden on parents, or will it become another well-intentioned policy that falters in implementation?

For over two decades, the state has witnessed a steady expansion of private educational institutions, while the establishment of new government institutions—from KG to PG—has remained negligible. This vacuum has effectively handed over the responsibility of education to private players, leaving parents with limited choices and mounting financial pressure. Despite significant public expenditure on schemes such as Amma Vodi and Thalli Deevana, concerns about affordability and quality continue to persist.

Historically, attempts to regulate school fees have not yielded the desired results. The District Fee Regulatory Committee (DFRC), constituted in 2009, was tasked with approving fee structures for schools. However, weak enforcement and legal challenges rendered it largely ineffective. Schools continued to hike fees arbitrarily,

often disregarding stipulated norms. Later, the Andhra Pradesh School Education Regulatory and Monitoring Commission (APSERMC) attempted to impose caps on fees in 2021, but its efforts were struck down by the High Court, which emphasized the need to curb profiteering rather than impose rigid fee controls.

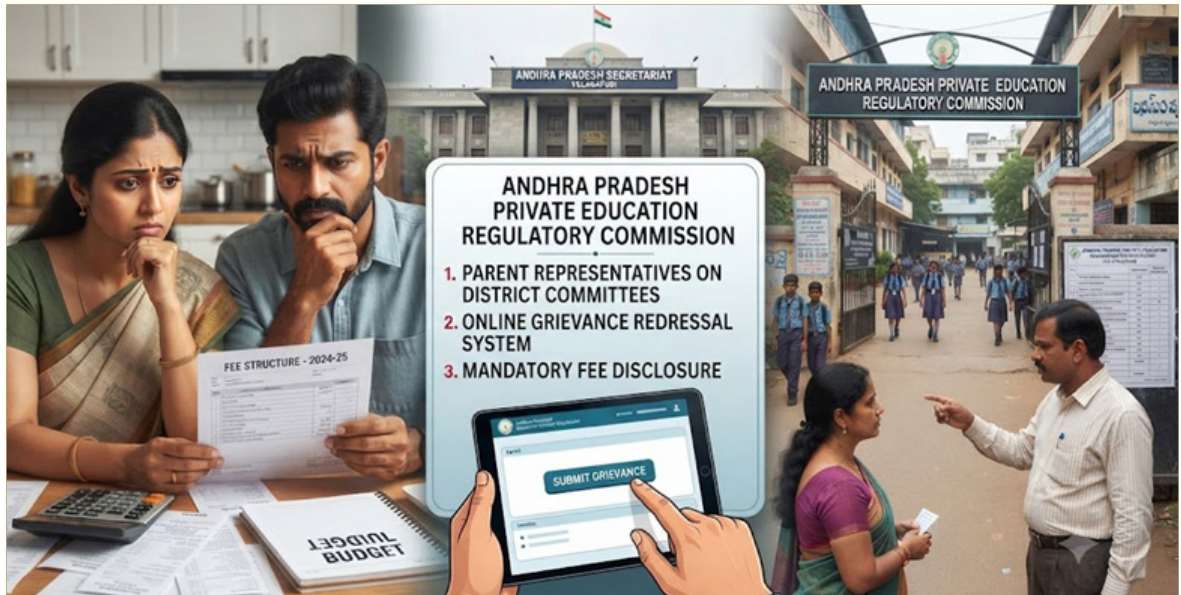
The new policy appears to acknowledge these past shortcomings. Its proposal to include parent representatives in district-level committees is a welcome step, potentially giving parents a stronger voice in decision-making. Similarly, the introduction of an online grievance redressal system could empower parents to report issues such as hidden charges, forced purchases, and unjustified fee hikes.

Transparency measures—such as mandating schools to declare fee structures in advance—are also promising. Drawing lessons from other states like Telangana and Tamil Nadu indicates a willingness to adopt best practices. If implemented effectively, these steps could offer some degree of financial relief and accountability. However, the key challenge remains unchanged: enforcement. Previous regulatory frameworks failed not because of a lack of policy, but due to inadequate implementation. Without strict monitoring and timely action, even the most well-designed system risks becoming ineffective.

There is also a need for balance. While curbing excessive fees is essential, overregulation could inadvertently impact the functioning of quality institutions. Education, by its very nature, involves costs, and policies must ensure that regulation does not stifle innovation or sustainability in the sector. The High Court's earlier observation—that decisions should involve consultation with school management—remains relevant and must be carefully considered.

At the heart of the issue lies the role of parents, which has historically been minimal. The new policy offers an opportunity to change that dynamic. But for this shift to be meaningful, parents must actively engage, raise concerns, and utilize the mechanisms provided.

Ultimately, the success of this policy will depend not on its intent, but on its execution. Regulation on paper alone cannot bring relief. It requires consistent enforcement, stakeholder cooperation, and a genuine commitment to safeguarding both affordability and quality in education. The government must ensure that this reform does not become another chapter in a cycle of unfulfilled promises. For parents and students alike, the stakes are too high to allow history to repeat itself.



Democratizing Technology

Confronting the Reality of Techno-Casteism in India

Over the past three decades, public movements and civic responses in India have undergone a profound transformation. From the nationwide outrage following the Nirbhaya incident to the Shaheen Bagh protests, the year-long farmers' agitation, and recent youth-led digital mobilizations, social media has emerged as a powerful platform for public expression. At a time when mainstream media is often perceived as constrained by corporate and political interests, digital platforms such as Facebook, X, and Instagram have enabled citizens to organize, protest, and amplify their voices. However, beneath this apparent democratization lies a troubling reality: digital spaces in India are far from equal and are increasingly shaped by existing social hierarchies, particularly caste.

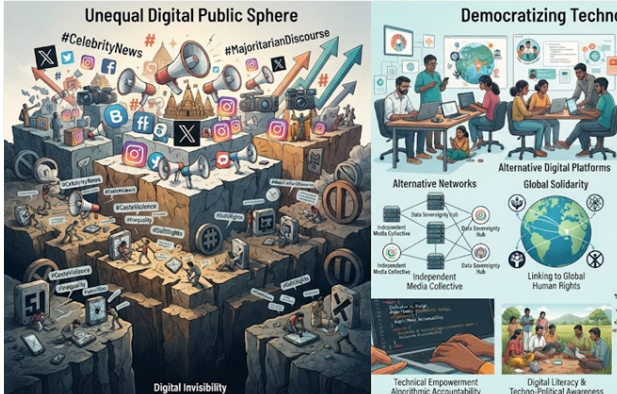
While social media appears inclusive, its functioning reflects deep-rooted inequalities. Issues concerning dominant social groups often gain rapid visibility and traction, while atrocities against marginalized communities—particularly SC, ST, BC, and minority groups—receive limited attention. Incidents of caste-based violence or discrimination rarely achieve the same digital momentum as other issues, revealing an imbalance in

whose voices are heard and amplified. This disparity highlights what can be termed “techno-casteism”—the extension of caste-based dominance into digital ecosystems.

Theoretical frameworks help explain this phenomenon. Philosopher Jürgen Habermas envisioned the “public sphere” as a space for rational and equal participation. In contrast, India's digital public sphere is shaped by unequal access to cultural capital, economic resources, and technological influence. Similarly, Herbert Marcuse's critique of the “culture industry” is relevant in understanding how media and technology, while appearing liberating, often reinforce dominant ideologies. In the Indian context, algorithms, content moderation systems, and platform policies may unintentionally—or systematically—reflect caste and social biases, marginalizing already underrepresented voices.

This raises a critical question: how can technology be democratized in such a context?

First, there is a need to build alternative digital platforms and knowledge systems. Marginalized communities must move beyond reliance on mainstream platforms and invest in independent digital publications, data repositories, and communication



networks. Documenting caste-based discrimination through credible, evidence-based research can strengthen advocacy and counter invisibility.

Second, the struggle must extend to the global arena. Linking caste discrimination with international human rights frameworks can generate global awareness and accountability. Producing content in widely accessible languages and connecting local struggles with global movements against inequality can put pressure on technology companies to recognize and address caste-based biases within their systems.

Third, technical empowerment is essential. Marginalized communities must not remain passive users of technology but actively participate in its creation and governance. Encouraging representation in fields such as artificial intelligence, data science, and software development is critical. Inclusive approaches to AI and algorithm design can help challenge embedded biases and create more equitable digital systems.

Equally important is fostering digital solidarity. Collective responses across marginalized groups can amplify issues that would otherwise remain overlooked. An incident affecting one community must be seen as a shared concern, triggering broader digital engagement and sustained advocacy. Expanding digital literacy in rural and underserved areas, along with promoting techno-political awareness, can further strengthen this collective capacity.

Ultimately, technology is not neutral; it reflects the values and power structures of those who design and control it. Addressing techno-casteism requires both structural reform and social awareness. The principles of “Educate, Agitate, Organize” remain as relevant in the digital age as they were in earlier struggles for equality.

Only through conscious effort, inclusive participation, and sustained resistance can digital spaces evolve into truly democratic platforms. Until then, the promise of technology as an equalizer will remain incomplete.

Trump Sets New Deadline for Iran Nuclear Deal

US President Donald Trump has intensified pressure on Iran by setting a fresh deadline for reaching a new nuclear agreement, signalling that Washington is prepared to adopt a tougher approach if diplomatic efforts fail. The move comes amid heightened tensions in the Middle East, with concerns over Iran's nuclear programme and the security of key global shipping routes continuing to dominate international discussions.

Speaking about the issue, Trump stressed that the United States remains open to negotiations but expects Iran to engage seriously in efforts to curb its nuclear activities. He warned that if a deal is not reached within the specified timeframe, the US could consider stronger measures, although he did not elaborate on the exact steps that might follow.

The renewed push for a nu-



clear agreement comes after months of uncertainty over diplomatic efforts between Washington and Tehran. While both sides have expressed interest in avoiding a wider conflict, deep differences over uranium enrichment, sanctions relief and regional security continue to hinder progress.

One of the major concerns surrounding the standoff is the Strait of Hormuz, a strategi-

cally important waterway through which a significant share of the world's oil supply passes. Any escalation in tensions or disruption to shipping in the region could have far-reaching consequences for global energy markets and international trade.

The Trump administration has maintained that preventing Iran from acquiring nuclear weapons remains a top foreign

policy priority. At the same time, US officials have indicated that diplomacy remains the preferred path, provided Iran demonstrates a willingness to comply with international commitments.

Iran, however, has consistently maintained that its nuclear programme is intended for peaceful purposes. Tehran has repeatedly argued that it will not negotiate under pressure and has called for the removal of sanctions as part of any future agreement.

With the new deadline now in place, global attention is focused on whether renewed diplomatic engagement can break the prolonged deadlock. As both nations weigh their next moves, the coming weeks are expected to be critical in determining whether negotiations can produce a breakthrough or whether tensions in the region will escalate further.

Netanyahu's Goal Against Iran Remains Elusive



Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has repeatedly declared that his government is committed to achieving "total victory" against Iran and the network of armed groups it supports across the Middle East. However, despite military successes and intensified operations, analysts believe that eliminating the Iranian threat remains a highly complex and long-term challenge.

Israel has significantly expanded its military campaign in recent years, targeting Iranian military infrastructure, weapons facilities and allied militias operating in countries such as Syria and Lebanon. The government argues that these operations are necessary to prevent Iran from strengthening its regional influence and advancing its nuclear ambitions.

While Israeli forces have carried out a series of precision strikes that have weakened some of Iran's military capabilities, experts note that Tehran continues to possess extensive resources, regional

alliances and strategic influence. This has made it difficult for Israel to achieve the decisive outcome envisioned by Netanyahu.

Iran's support for groups such as Hezbollah in Lebanon and other allied organisations across the region remains a major security concern for Israel. Even if military operations reduce the capabilities of these groups, analysts argue that rebuilding networks and restoring influence could take relatively little time, making any victory temporary rather than permanent.

The conflict has also placed increasing pressure on Israel's economy, military and diplomatic relations. Extended military operations require significant financial resources and manpower, while the humanitarian impact of regional conflicts has drawn growing international scrutiny. Many global leaders continue to call for diplomatic efforts to prevent a broader regional war.

Netanyahu, however, has maintained that Israel cannot

afford to ease pressure on Iran, insisting that national security remains the government's highest priority. His administration believes that sustained military action is essential to preventing future threats and ensuring the country's long-term safety.

At the same time, observers argue that a lasting solution is unlikely to come through military action alone. They believe that diplomacy, regional cooperation and international engagement will ultimately be necessary to address the underlying political and security challenges that have fueled tensions for decades.

As the conflict continues to evolve, Israel's campaign against Iran remains one of the defining issues in Middle Eastern geopolitics. Whether Netanyahu's goal of "total victory" can ever be fully achieved remains uncertain, but the pursuit of that objective is expected to continue shaping Israel's security policies and regional strategy for years to come.

US Finalises Alien Registration Rule

The United States has officially finalised its alien registration rule, introducing new compliance requirements for certain non-citizens living in the country. Issued by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), the regulation is aimed at strengthening immigration enforcement by ensuring that foreign nationals who are required to register with the government do so and keep their records up to date.

Under the new rule, most foreign nationals who have already completed the standard immigration process, including many H-1B visa holders, international students and lawful permanent residents, are not required to register again because they are already considered registered through their



visa issuance and entry records.

However, the regulation introduces new obligations for certain groups. Children who were previously registered before turning 14 must apply for re-registration and submit biometric information, including fingerprints, within 30 days of their 14th birthday. In addition, all registered non-citizens aged

18 and above are required to carry proof of registration at all times while residing in the United States.

The DHS estimates that between 2.2 million and 3.2 million people could ultimately be affected by the rule. Many of them are individuals who entered the country without formal inspection or whose information was never fully captured

in the federal immigration system. Authorities believe the updated registration framework will improve record-keeping and help immigration agencies monitor compliance more effectively. Failure to comply with the registration requirements could lead to serious consequences, including fines, imprisonment or other legal penalties. The government has stated that enforcing the rule will remain a priority as part of its broader immigration strategy.

The finalisation of the regulation marks another step in the US government's efforts to tighten immigration oversight while clarifying which categories of immigrants must meet additional registration and documentation requirements.

New Tools May Boost Trump Deportations

US President Donald Trump is reportedly preparing to accelerate deportations using new legal and technological tools after facing a setback in his effort to end birthright citizenship. While the court ruling limited one aspect of his immigration agenda, recent legal developments have opened up alternative ways for the administration to pursue its broader goal of increasing deportations.

According to reports, the administration is planning a more targeted approach rather than conducting large-scale immigration raids in major cities. Officials are expected to rely heavily on data analysis, digital records and advanced targeting systems to identify individuals who may be eligible for deportation. The strategy is aimed at making enforcement operations more efficient while avoiding the public backlash



often associated with high-profile raids.

A major boost to the administration's plans came after a federal appeals court allowed the expanded use of expedited removal, a process that enables immigration authorities to deport certain undocumented immigrants without a full court hearing. Under the policy, individuals who cannot prove they have lived in the United States continuously for more than two

years could face swift removal from the country.

The administration is also expected to make greater use of government databases and digital information to locate people living in the country without legal status. Officials believe that technology-driven enforcement can help immigration agencies identify potential targets more quickly and carry out deportations with fewer personnel.

Immigration advocates, however, have raised concerns that expanded use of expedited removal and data-based enforcement could increase the risk of wrongful deportations and reduce due process protections for affected individuals. Civil rights groups argue that rapid deportation procedures may not provide enough opportunity for people to prove their legal status or challenge removal orders.

Despite the legal setback on birthright citizenship, the latest developments indicate that immigration enforcement remains a central priority for the Trump administration. With new legal authority and technology-driven strategies at its disposal, the administration appears determined to intensify deportation efforts in the coming months, even as court challenges and political debate over immigration policy continue.

China Launches 350 kmph Bullet Train

China has expanded its high-speed rail network with the launch of a new 350 kmph bullet train connecting Xi'an in Shaanxi Province with Shiyang in Hubei Province. The new railway, which passes through the rugged Qinling Mountains, is expected to significantly improve connectivity between central and western China while reducing travel time by more than six hours.

The service officially began with the departure of the first high-speed train from the newly inaugurated Xi'an East Railway Station. Covering a distance of about 257 kilometres, the new rail corridor is designed to operate at speeds of up to 350 kmph, making it one of the fastest railway lines in the country.

One of the biggest benefits of the project is the dramatic reduction in travel time. The journey between Xi'an and Shiyang, which previously took more than six hours, can now be completed in around one hour. The railway also connects with the existing Wuhan-Shiyang high-speed line, reducing travel time between Xi'an and Wuhan to just 2 hours and



41 minutes.

Constructing the railway through the Qinling Mountains posed significant engineering challenges due to the region's mountainous terrain. The successful completion of the project highlights China's continued investment in advanced railway infrastructure and its expertise in building high-speed transport systems across difficult landscapes.

The new corridor is expect-

ed to boost tourism, trade and economic cooperation between Shaanxi and Hubei provinces. Faster connectivity will improve the movement of people and goods, strengthen regional integration and create new opportunities for businesses and local industries. Authorities also expect the railway to support long-term economic development by encouraging investment and increasing access to key urban

centres.

China already operates the world's largest high-speed rail network, and the latest addition reinforces its commitment to expanding modern transportation infrastructure. The Xi'an-Shiyang railway is expected to play an important role in enhancing mobility, promoting regional growth and making travel faster, safer and more convenient for millions of passengers.

Pakistan Seeks Support on Indus Issue

Pakistan has stepped up its diplomatic campaign over the suspension of the Indus Waters Treaty (IWT), warning that undermining the decades-old agreement could have serious consequences for the international rules-based order. At an international conference held in Islamabad, senior Pakistani leaders urged the global community to intervene, describing the treaty as a cornerstone of regional peace and stability.

Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister Ishaq Dar said the Indus Waters Treaty is far more than a water-sharing arrangement, calling it a symbol of peaceful cooperation between two nuclear-armed neighbours. He argued that using water as a political tool would set a dangerous precedent and weaken confidence in interna-

tional agreements.

Pakistan Peoples Party chairman Bilawal Bhutto Zardari also addressed the conference, asserting that the Indus River is the country's lifeline and warning that any attempt to reduce or divert Pakistan's allocated water would be viewed as a serious threat to national security. He maintained that Pakistan would continue to defend its water rights through diplomatic and legal means while calling for adherence to international law.

Another strong statement came from Pakistan's Climate Change Minister Musadik Malik, who argued that the future of the Indus Waters Treaty would determine the credibility of post-World War II international agreements. He warned that if such a long-standing treaty could be sus-

pended, confidence in other global accords would also be undermined.

India suspended its participation in the 1960 World Bank-brokered treaty following the April 2025 Pahalgam terror attack, stating that the agreement would remain in abeyance until Pakistan takes credible and irreversible steps to end cross-border terrorism. The move marked one of the sharpest downturns in bilateral relations in recent years.

As diplomatic tensions continue, the future of the Indus Waters Treaty remains uncertain. The dispute has become a key flashpoint in India-Pakistan relations, with both countries standing firm on their respective positions while the international community closely monitors developments.



Sensex Rebounds 444 Points, Nifty Reclaims 24,000

Indian benchmark equity indices bounced back strongly on Wednesday, snapping a two-day losing streak as broad-based buying across key sectors lifted investor sentiment. The BSE Sensex surged 444 points, while the Nifty 50 reclaimed the crucial 24,000 mark, ending the session on a positive note despite continued weakness in information technology stocks.

The market opened on a firm note, supported by encouraging global cues and sustained buying interest in domestic equities. Buying momentum gathered pace through the day, helping the Nifty touch an intraday high of nearly 24,050 before closing close to that level. The recovery came after two consecutive sessions of losses

and reflected renewed optimism among investors.

Auto, FMCG, realty and financial stocks emerged as the biggest gainers, providing the primary support to the benchmark indices. Strong monthly automobile sales boosted investor confidence in auto stocks, while heavyweight consumer goods companies also witnessed healthy buying. Realty shares joined the rally, adding to the market's overall strength.

However, the gains were partially capped by continued selling pressure in the IT sector. Technology stocks remained under pressure following weaker-than-expected quarterly guidance from KPIT Technologies, which dampened sentiment across the sector. Investors



tors also remained cautious about the outlook for export-oriented IT companies amid global economic uncertainties. Market breadth remained

positive throughout the session, with advancing stocks comfortably outnumbering declining ones. More than 160 companies on the BSE touched fresh 52-week highs, indicating that buying interest extended beyond frontline stocks and into the broader market. The strong participation across sectors suggested improving investor confidence after recent volatility.

Analysts attributed the day's rally to a combination of supportive global market trends, encouraging domestic data and sector-specific buying. Positive cues from international markets, robust automobile sales numbers and strength in FMCG stocks helped offset concerns surrounding the IT sector.

The rebound also reflected value buying after the recent correction in benchmark indices. Going forward, market participants are expected to keep a close watch on upcoming corporate earnings, global economic developments, foreign institutional investor activity and macroeconomic indicators. While the recovery has improved near-term sentiment, analysts believe sustained momentum will depend on earnings growth and global market stability.

The strong finish has nevertheless provided relief to investors, with both the Sensex and Nifty ending the day on a positive note and setting the stage for the remainder of the week's trading sessions.

Ashok Leyland Shares Jump 5% After June Vehicle Sales Rise 25%

Shares of commercial vehicle manufacturer Ashok Leyland rallied as much as 5% on Wednesday after the company reported a strong 25% year-on-year increase in total vehicle sales for June, boosting investor confidence and driving buying interest in the stock. The impressive sales performance reinforced optimism about sustained demand in the commercial vehicle segment and lifted the company's market sentiment.

During the trading session, Ashok Leyland's stock climbed to an intraday high of 165.75 on the National Stock Exchange. Although some profit booking at higher levels trimmed the gains later in the day, the stock still ended the session with a healthy increase, reflecting investors' positive response to the company's latest sales numbers.

The company reported total vehicle sales of 19,194 units in June, compared with 15,333 units sold during the same month last year. The robust growth was driven by improved demand across several commercial vehicle categories, highlighting the company's strong market position and



consistent operational performance.

Ashok Leyland has been witnessing healthy demand in both medium and heavy commercial vehicles, supported by increased infrastructure activity, logistics demand and replacement purchases. The latest sales figures indicate that

the commercial vehicle industry continues to recover steadily, benefiting manufacturers with strong product portfolios and extensive dealer networks.

The company's performance also contributed to the broader strength seen in auto stocks, which remained among the

top-performing sectors during the trading session. Investors were encouraged by positive monthly sales updates from several automobile manufacturers, resulting in buying across the sector. Ashok Leyland emerged as one of the biggest gainers following its better-than-expected sales growth.

Market analysts believe that continued government spending on infrastructure, improving freight movement and stable economic activity are likely to support demand for commercial vehicles in the coming months. They also expect fleet replacement demand and higher construction activity to remain key growth drivers for companies such as Ashok Leyland.

Investors will now closely watch the company's upcoming quarterly financial results to assess whether the strong sales momentum translates into higher revenues and profitability. For now, the healthy June sales performance has strengthened confidence in Ashok Leyland's growth outlook and reaffirmed its position as one of India's leading commercial vehicle manufacturers.

SEBI Bars 221 Entities in Major Pump-and-Dump Crackdown

In one of its biggest enforcement actions against stock market manipulation, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has barred 221 entities from accessing the securities market for periods ranging from one to seven years. The regulator also imposed a 10 crore penalty on alleged mastermind Hanif Shekh for orchestrating a large-scale pump-and-dump operation that misled thousands of retail investors.

According to SEBI's detailed order, the accused entities artificially inflated the prices and trading volumes of select stocks through synchronized and manipulative trades. Once the share prices were driven higher, they allegedly lured unsuspecting investors by circulating bulk SMS messages and promotional recommendations, encouraging them to purchase the stocks at inflated prices.

After attracting retail investors, the operators allegedly sold their holdings at the elevated prices, earning substantial illegal profits while leaving late entrants with heavy losses as the stock prices eventually crashed. This fraudulent practice, commonly known as a "pump-and-dump" scheme, is considered one of the most harmful forms of market manipulation.

SEBI's investigation found



that the proceeds generated from the scheme were routed through multiple conduit entities in an attempt to conceal the identity of the ultimate beneficiaries. The regulator said the complex network of transactions was designed to disguise the flow of illicit gains and make it difficult to trace those responsible for the manipulation.

Besides imposing a 10 crore monetary penalty on Hanif Shekh, SEBI directed all 221 entities to stay away from the securities market for varying periods depending on their level of involvement in the scheme. The regulator stated that such stringent action was necessary to protect investors and maintain confidence in India's capital markets.

The order underscores SEBI's increasing focus on curbing fraudulent trading practices, particularly those targeting small investors through misleading recom-

mendations circulated via text messages and other communication channels. The regulator has repeatedly warned investors against acting on unsolicited stock tips and has urged them to rely only on registered investment advisers before making investment decisions.

Market experts believe the latest crackdown sends a strong message that manipulative practices will invite severe regulatory action. They also noted that stricter surveillance systems and data analytics have enabled SEBI to detect complex trading patterns more effectively than in the past.

The action is expected to strengthen investor confidence by reinforcing the regulator's commitment to ensuring fair and transparent markets. It also serves as a reminder for retail investors to exercise caution and verify the credibility of investment recommendations before investing in the stock market.

Jio BlackRock to Launch Two Global Funds

Jio BlackRock Asset Management is preparing to expand its global investment offerings by launching its first two outbound funds from Gujarat's GIFT City within the next two months. The move marks a significant milestone for the joint venture between Jio Financial Services and global investment giant BlackRock as it strengthens its presence in international investing and offers Indian investors greater access to overseas markets.

According to the company's Chief Investment Officer, Rishi Kohli, the first two funds will focus on global equities and emerging markets. The products are currently in the advanced stages of regulatory filings after the company secured the necessary approvals to operate from GIFT City. The initiative is aimed at providing investors with diversified international investment opportunities beyond domestic markets.

Kohli revealed that the fund house evaluated nearly ten investment products from BlackRock's extensive global portfolio before narrowing the list to the first two offerings. The selection was based on feedback received from family offices, wealth managers and distribution partners, who expressed strong demand for global investment products that go beyond traditional index-based exposure.

The company believes outbound investment products represent an attractive opportunity as Indian investors increasingly seek geographical diversification. While many investors currently invest in popular global indices such as the S&P 500 and Nasdaq, Jio BlackRock intends to offer ac-



tively managed global investment strategies that provide exposure to a broader range of international markets.

Following the launch of the outbound funds, Jio BlackRock also plans to introduce inbound investment products through GIFT City. These offerings are expected to be rolled out around six months later and will allow overseas investors to access Indian investment opportunities through the international financial services hub.

GIFT City has emerged as India's gateway for cross-border financial services, ena-

bling asset management companies to launch products catering to both domestic and international investors under a globally competitive regulatory framework. Jio BlackRock's expansion into the hub reflects its broader strategy of building a comprehensive investment platform with access to global markets.

The latest announcement comes as the asset management company continues to expand its product portfolio following its entry into the Indian mutual fund industry. By combining Jio Financial Services' digital reach with Black-

Rock's global investment expertise, the company aims to offer a wide range of investment solutions for retail as well as institutional investors.

With regulatory approvals in place and product filings progressing, the launch of the two global funds is expected to take place within the next two months. The move is likely to strengthen Jio BlackRock's position in the rapidly evolving asset management industry while providing Indian investors with easier access to international investment opportunities.

Advit Jewels Hits Lower Circuit After Strong Listing

The stock market witnessed contrasting performances from two newly listed companies on Wednesday, as Advit Jewels slipped into the lower circuit after a stellar debut, while Waterways Leisure Tourism, the operator of Cordelia Cruises, extended its losses following a weak market listing. The sharp moves have prompted market experts to advise investors to remain cautious before taking fresh positions in either stock.

Advit Jewels made an impressive debut on the exchanges, listing at 187 on the BSE and 188.90 on the NSE, representing premiums of 35.5% and 36.9%, respectively, over its IPO issue price of 138. The strong listing reflected robust investor demand, following the IPO's overwhelming subscription of more than 212 times.

However, the initial enthusiasm was short-lived. Soon after listing, investors rushed to book profits, dragging the stock to its 5% lower circuit at 179.46. Analysts noted that such volatility is common in newly listed stocks, especially after a sharp listing premium, as early investors seek to lock in gains.

Despite the decline, market experts remain optimistic about Advit Jewels' long-term prospects. The company has reported strong financial growth over the past two years, nearly tripling its revenue while maintaining healthy



EBITDA margins of around 29-30%. It has also delivered a robust return on net worth, factors that supported its premium valuation during the IPO. However, analysts caution that the company is still relatively small, with limited geographical diversification, making the stock susceptible to near-term volatility. Investors who received IPO allotments may continue to hold for the medium term, while fresh investors are advised to wait for a few quarterly results before making significant investments. In contrast, Waterways Leisure Tourism, which operates the Cordelia Cruises brand, had a disappointing stock market debut. The shares listed at 690 on the BSE and 681 on the NSE, both significantly below the IPO issue price of 808. Selling pressure continued after listing, extending the stock's losses as inves-

tors remained concerned about the company's valuation and near-term growth prospects. Analysts believe the divergent performances highlight the importance of evaluating individual company fundamentals rather than relying solely on IPO hype. While Advit Jewels benefited from strong financials and investor enthusiasm, Cordelia's weaker listing reflects concerns over pricing and future earnings potential.

For traders, experts recommend avoiding impulsive decisions immediately after listing. Existing investors in Advit Jewels may consider partial profit booking or holding with a long-term perspective, while those interested in Cordelia are advised to wait until the stock stabilises and establishes a clear trading trend before taking fresh exposure.

₹3.6 Lakh a Month: The Cost of Living in Dubai

An Indian couple living in Dubai has gone viral after sharing a detailed breakdown of their monthly expenses, revealing that they spend between 13,000 and 14,000 UAE dirhams (approximately 3.34 lakh to 3.6 lakh) every month. Interestingly, the total does not include travel, luxury shopping, or other lifestyle indulgences, prompting many social media users to call it a realistic picture of life in the UAE.

The couple, who regularly post videos about their life in Dubai, explained that their biggest monthly expense is a 6,000-dirham EMI, which accounts for nearly half of their overall budget. Apart from loan repayments, they spend around 1,500 dirhams every month on household utilities, including electricity, water, internet and other essential services.

Food is another major expense. Since they rarely cook at home, their grocery bill is relatively low at around 500 dirhams a month. However, frequent dining out signifi-



cantly increases their food budget, with restaurant bills touching nearly 1,500 dirhams every month. Their spending pattern highlights how convenience and eating out can substantially raise the cost of living in Dubai.

Transportation also takes up a sizeable portion of their monthly expenses. The husband spends nearly 1,700 dirhams on his car, covering fuel, parking charges and Salik toll fees. Meanwhile, the wife, who commutes regularly between Dubai and Abu Dhabi for work,

spends between 1,700 and 2,000 dirhams each month on travel.

In addition to these recurring expenses, the couple pays 250 dirhams every week for domestic cleaning services. They also allocate another 1,000 dirhams every month for miscellaneous expenses, which include everyday purchases and other unavoidable costs.

Adding all these expenses together, the couple estimated that their fixed monthly expenditure comes to around 13,000 to 14,000 dirhams, or

roughly 3.6 lakh. They clarified that this figure does not include vacations, shopping, entertainment or other discretionary spending, meaning their actual monthly expenses could be even higher depending on their lifestyle and personal choices. The video has sparked widespread discussion on social media, with many viewers appreciating the couple's honesty in sharing the financial realities of living in Dubai. Several users commented that the expense breakdown appeared far more realistic than the commonly circulated claims suggesting that people can comfortably live in the city on much smaller budgets. Others noted that households with children would likely face even higher costs due to school fees and additional family-related expenses.

The viral post has once again highlighted the high cost of living in Dubai while reminding aspiring expatriates that careful financial planning is essential before making the move.

Microsoft Employee's Honest Post Goes Viral



A Microsoft employee's candid post about being laid off has gone viral, offering an unusual perspective on job losses in the tech industry. Instead of expressing anger or disappointment, the employee said they felt relieved, explaining that the uncertainty surrounding possible layoffs had been far more exhausting than the layoff itself.

The post, shared on the anonymous workplace platform Blind, surfaced as Microsoft reportedly prepares another round of workforce reductions. The employee revealed that they had already sensed what was coming after noticing several changes at work. According to the post, they had been quietly reassigned from projects, received less feedback from their manager and felt increasingly sidelined, making it clear that their role was at risk.

The employee wrote that while losing a job is never enjoyable, months of speculation and anxiety had taken a much greater emotional toll. They said they were relieved because the uncertainty was finally ending. The constant rumours, organisational restructuring and discussions about improving efficiency

had created a stressful work environment, with employees frequently wondering whether they would be the next to lose their jobs.

The post struck a chord with many professionals, especially those working in the technology sector, where layoffs have become increasingly common over the past few years. Several users praised the employee for expressing feelings that many workers experience but rarely admit publicly. Others shared similar stories of living through prolonged uncertainty before eventually receiving layoff notices.

According to reports, Microsoft is expected to cut a small percentage of its global workforce as part of its continued

focus on cost management and increased investment in artificial intelligence. While the latest round of layoffs is expected to affect fewer employees than previous cuts, it reflects the broader restructuring taking place across the technology industry.

The employee concluded the post by saying that although they might feel differently once the layoff actually happens, they currently view it as an opportunity for a fresh start. Their message has resonated widely online, highlighting the emotional burden of prolonged workplace uncertainty and sparking conversations about the mental health challenges employees face during periods of corporate restructuring.

How a ₹23,000 Salary Led to ₹3 Lakh Debt



A 27-year-old man has gone viral after revealing how reckless spending on parties, spa visits and credit cards left him trapped in more than 3 lakh of debt, despite earning only 23,000 a month. His candid confession on social media has sparked widespread discussion about financial discipline and the dangers of overspending.

In a post titled "Fell in a debt trap because of my foolishness," the man admitted that poor financial decisions and an extravagant lifestyle pushed him into a severe debt crisis. He shared that he had accumulated liabilities through multiple personal loans and maxed-out credit cards, making it increasingly difficult to manage his monthly finances.

The man explained that after paying rent and other household expenses, he is left with enough money to contribute only about 4,000 a month towards loan repayments. He had also applied for a fresh personal loan of 3 lakh in the hope of consolidating his existing debt into a single, longer-term repayment plan. However, all his loan applications were rejected.

He further revealed that nearly 80 per cent of his outstanding credit card dues had already been converted into Equated Monthly Instalments (EMIs). Even then, keeping up with the repayments has become nearly impossible on his current salary. As a result, his credit score has started declining due to high credit utilisation, making it even harder to secure financial assistance.

Calling himself a "27-year-old fool," the man admitted that the money had been spent entirely on parties and spa visits, leaving him with little to show for the debt he had accumulated. He added that he is the sole earning member of his family, making the financial burden even more stressful.

The post attracted hundreds

of responses from social media users, many of whom offered practical financial advice. Some suggested negotiating loan settlements with lenders, while others warned against damaging his credit history through defaults. Several users encouraged him to adopt a frugal lifestyle, increase his income by switching jobs or taking up additional work, and systematically repay the debt over the next few years.

The viral post has become a cautionary tale about the risks of uncontrolled spending and excessive reliance on credit. It also highlights the importance of budgeting, responsible borrowing and maintaining financial discipline, especially for young professionals at the beginning of their careers.

Mexico's 'Batman' Vigilante Sparks Debate Over Street Justice



A mysterious masked vigilante has captured global attention after a series of incidents in Mexico earned the individual the nickname "Batman of Lagos de Moreno." The unidentified figure has sparked a heated debate over whether the actions represent a fight against crime or a dangerous case of vigilante justice.

The incidents occurred in Lagos de Moreno, a municipality in the Mexican state of Jalisco, where several men accused of stealing motorcycles were found bound to street poles with heavy-duty duct tape. In many cases, the alleged stolen motorcycles were left beside them, while the suspects' faces were marked with the Spanish word "ratero," meaning "thief." Some also had moustaches and cat whiskers drawn on their faces, adding to the bizarre nature of the incidents.

Rare Miyazaki Mangoes Stolen from Orchard, Loss Runs into Lakhs

In a bizarre and rare incident, nine premium Miyazaki mangoes, considered among the world's most expensive fruits, were stolen from a private orchard in Barkagaon area of Jharkhand's Hazaribagh district. The fruit grower has estimated the loss to be worth several lakh rupees.

The orchard owner, Praveen Kumar, said the theft took place during the night when unidentified persons entered his farm and plucked the mangoes. The stolen fruit weighed around 1.5 kg in total. According to him, the market value of the rare variety could go up to nearly Rs 4 lakh, depending on quality and demand.

Praveen Kumar had procured two Miyazaki mango saplings from West Bengal about a year ago at a cost of Rs 2,400. After careful nurturing and continuous monitoring, the trees bore fruit for the first time this season. "I had been taking care of the plants every day. But when I checked in the morning, nine mangoes were missing," he said, expressing shock over the incident.

Miyazaki mangoes, originally from Japan, are known for their deep red to purplish colour, exceptional sweetness and rich aroma. Often referred to as the "Egg of the Sun," this variety is cultivated under highly controlled conditions, including regulated temperature and sunlight exposure. Farmers typically use protective coverings and reflective techniques to enhance fruit quality.

Globally, Miyazaki mangoes are treated as luxury produce, sometimes fetching extremely

high prices in international markets and auctions. While domestically grown varieties may be priced lower, they still command significant value due to their rarity.

The unusual theft has drawn attention in the region, highlighting how even agricultural produce is now being targeted due to its high market value. Local authorities are yet to confirm whether a formal complaint has been registered, but the incident has left growers concerned about the security of high-value crops.
