MIND GAME OF JAGAN, DANGER TO WHOM?

"If we are to come back to power, the enemy must be weakened. For that to happen, the state should not develop during their rule. If the state develops, the enemy becomes stronger. To prevent that, even the state itself has to be weakened—even at the cost of the people's future. Is this the concept that former Chief Minister Jagan is following? It appears so. Otherwise, fearing that if Amaravati stands, the Telugu Desam Party will stand strong, he stopped it in the past and introduced the concept of three capitals. The objective was clear, but since there was no clarity on how to implement it, he failed. Eventually, he lost power after facing defeat. Since all the policies and decisions originated from the objective of stopping the Telugu Desam Party, they failed. But political analysts say that Jagan now seems to be following the same formula once again.

That is why he has now brought up the name 'Mavigan.' At first, everyone took it as something funny. But only Jagan knows the serious agenda behind it. If the idea of Mavigan comes to the forefront,

Amaravati will become weak. Then, those planning to invest in Amaravati will fall into a dilemma. Investors are already haunted by the fear of what would happen if Jagan returns to power. Such statements are only increasing their confusion further. Political observers believe that Jagan is playing a kind of mind game. If 'Mavigan' means 'vote for us,' and Amaravati means 'vote for Chandrababu,' then Jagan must be very confident to make such a statement. They believe that the objective behind this declaration is to create doubt among people about whether Jagan may return to power.

It cannot be said that no mistakes are happening under the coalition government. Certainly, mistakes are taking place in some matters. Especially, there are strong allegations that the conduct of the MLAs is not good. But strangely, the YSR Congress Party is not highlighting those issues. Jagan is not paying attention to them. Instead, they are targeting the very things that the coalition government is projecting as its achievements. They repeatedly targeted the Visakhapatnam Data Centre issue. First, they claimed that they themselves had brought



the project. Then Jagan made that claim, while a leader from his own party described the data centre as a danger. When the DSC (teacher recruitment) was conducted, they alleged that something irregular had happened only in the sports quota. They kept repeating the

allegation so often that people became tired of hearing it. The government had to repeatedly issue clarifications.

Initially, after being reduced to just 11 seats, the YSR Congress Party became weak and silent. Analysts say that the strategy behind these cam-

paigns is to create the impression that the party is gradually becoming stronger. Those who admire Jagan justify this style of functioning, saying, 'That's our man. He is giving the coalition government a tough time. This time, power will belong to our man.' They are spreading this message aggressively. In fact, even some supporters of the coalition have begun wondering whether Jagan might actually return to power this time. Similar propaganda was seen before the previous elections, but everyone was shocked by the actual results. Therefore, propaganda is one thing, while reality can be entirely different. It can go either way. In 2019, Telugu Desam Party leaders were confident they would win again, but we saw what happened. In 2024, the reverse happened.

Jagan's campaign strategy is also moving from three directions, like a trident strategy. One, through the party; two, through their follower channels; and three, through social media. It appears that the YSR Congress Party is implementing its strategy quietly and steadily. TDP leaders say that, by observing how YouTubers behave and what they say at different times, it becomes clear that the YSR Congress

Party is behind them. They allege that wherever unrest occurs, or wherever caste or religious tensions arise, the YSR Congress Party has a role behind it. They say the Vijayawada CI Nagaraju and Sai Krishna incident reflected this. Using that issue, they created the narrative that Kapus were being neglected. Now, most recently, after the arrest of two YouTubers, they are portraying it as an issue of region and caste. Coalition workers criticize that some people are talking only about the arrests while ignoring what those YouTubers actually said in their videos. However, coalition leaders say that Jagan should remember history. They argue that when Kapus were provoked in the past, they ultimately rallied behind Pawan Kalyan. Even now, by organizing Kapu meetings, they have only united the Kapu community. Likewise, they allege that Dalit Christians are now being provoked, and that divisions among them are also becoming inevitable. In any case, they say that while formulating strategies to regain power, Jagan should ensure that neither the state nor the people suffer losses; otherwise, it is he who will ultimately suffer the consequences."

Naidu to Launch ₹16,350-Crore JSW Steel Plant

Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu will launch the construction of the JSW Rayalaseema Integrated Steel Plant at Sunnapurallapalli and Pedadanluru villages in YSR Kadapa district on July 3, marking a major milestone in the region's industrial development. The project is expected to usher in a new phase of manufacturing growth, investment and large-scale employment generation across Rayalaseema.

The integrated steel plant, to be developed by JSW Andhra Pradesh Steel Limited, will be constructed in two phases over 1,100 acres with a total investment of 16,350 crore. The first phase, involving an invest-

ment of ₹4,500 crore, will be followed by a second phase worth ₹11,850 crore, taking the plant's production capacity to 2 million tonnes per annum (MTPA). Commercial production is targeted to commence by March 2028. The project was initially approved in 2019 and witnessed foundation-laying ceremonies in both 2019 and 2023. However, despite repeated announcements, it failed to move beyond the preliminary stage during the previous government. After the formation of the present NDA government in 2024, the project was revived through continuous engagement with JSW, resolution of pending issues, timely policy interventions and coordinated efforts by various government P3

VBG Ram G Mission to Boost Rural Growth

The Government of India's flagship Viksit Bharat Guarantee for Rozgar Ajeevika Mission (VBG Ram G) was formally launched from Railway Koduru in Tirupati district on Thursday, marking the nationwide rollout of the rural development initiative. The programme was inaugurated by Union Minister for Rural Development and Agriculture Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan.

On the occasion, Union Ministers Pemmasani Chandrasekhar and Kamlesh Paswan released the official promotional song of the mission, while Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan unveiled the mission booklet.

Addressing the gathering, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu



bu Naidu described the launch of the mission from Railway Koduru as a historic milestone, recalling that the erstwhile National Rural Employment Guarantee programme had also originated from the Rayalaseema region. He said the new initiative would further strengthen rural livelihoods and infrastructure across Andhra Pradesh.

The Chief Minister announced that the State would implement the programme with 7,700 crore from the Central Government and an addi-

tional 4,000 crore from the State, creating a total outlay of over 11,000 crore. He said the mission, to be implemented under the leadership of Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, would transform villages by creating sustainable employment and durable public assets.

He explained that the scheme guarantees 125 days of employment while facilitating the construction of roads, drainage systems, canals and other rural infrastructure. The programme will be P3



Lokesh Launches Industry-Led SIU

Minister for Education, IT, Electronics & Communications and Real Time Governance (RTG) Nara Lokesh on Thursday launched Sri City International University (SIU), introducing an industry-led work-study education model aimed at making graduates job-ready in an AI-driven economy.

The university marks a major shift from the conventional higher education system by involving industry directly in designing academic curriculum, practical training and skill development. The initiative seeks to bridge the gap between classroom education and industry requirements, addressing the growing concern over graduate employability despite India producing more than nine million graduates every year.

Speaking at the launch, Nara Lokesh said universities must evolve in line with rapid technological advancements, particularly in Artificial Intelligence, advanced manufacturing and digital technologies. He stressed that industries should become active partners in education rather than merely recruiting graduates after they complete their studies.

"Technology is evolving at an unprecedented pace. Universities cannot continue updating their curriculum once every few years and expect graduates to remain relevant. When employers help shape what students learn, graduates enter the workforce ready to contribute from day one," he said. Unlike traditional universities, SIU will have its curricu-

lum co-designed and reviewed annually by industry partners. Companies will contribute to course content, practical training, projects and competency standards, ensuring students develop skills that match current and future workforce demands.

A key feature of the university is its Work-Study Dual Model, under which students will spend nearly one-third of their time in classrooms and the remaining period working with industry partners. Every student will begin paid internships from the first year, earning a minimum monthly stipend of 10,000, with opportunities for higher earnings based on performance. By graduation, students are expected to have more than two years of industry experience.

The university will leverage Sri City's industrial ecosystem, home to over 200 companies from more than 30 countries across sectors such as electronics, automotive, engineering, logistics and advanced manufacturing, providing students with extensive practical exposure.

SIU has also established Station-S, an on-campus incubation centre supporting around 10 startups in partnership with Gnan Circle Ventures, to promote innovation and entrepreneurship alongside technical education.

Admissions for the 2026-27 academic year will begin with undergraduate programmes in Computer Science & Engineering, Advanced Manufacturing, Finance & Accounts, and Digital Media & Communications, positioning SIU as a new model for industry-integrated higher education in India.



YS Jagan Alleges Police Harassment Drove Kranthi Kumar to Suicide

YSR Congress Party President and former Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy on Thursday visited the family of Kranthi Kumar at Krishnalanka in Vijayawada and assured them of legal and political support, alleging that sustained police harassment had driven the taxi driver to end his life.

Meeting Kranthi Kumar's wife, children and father, Jagan expressed condolences and described the family's condition as "heartbreaking." He said Kranthi Kumar, who was under 40 years of age, had allegedly been forced to report to the Krishnalanka Police Station daily for nearly three months despite having no pending convictions, and that the repeated harassment ultimately led to his suicide.

Jagan referred to a selfie video allegedly recorded by Kranthi Kumar before his death, in which he accused former Krishnalanka Circle Inspector Nagaraju and other police personnel of harassing him. He questioned why no action had been taken against those named in the video despite what he described as a clear dying declaration.

The former Chief Minister also alleged that the incident reflected a serious breakdown in the policing system. He claimed that despite the victim's father showing the video to the Vijayawada Police Commissioner, no action had followed. Jagan further raised concerns over the reported disappearance of CCTV footage from the Krishnalanka Police Station, where another custodial death had also been reported recently, P3

Court Grants 8-Day SIT Custody of Suspended CI Nagaraju in Sai Krishna Custodial Death Case

In a significant development in the Gade Sai Krishna custodial death case, a Vijayawada court on Thursday granted the Special Investigation Team (SIT) eight days of police custody of suspended Circle Inspector (CI) Nagaraju, one of the accused in the case.

The SIT had sought 12 days of custody to facilitate detailed interrogation as part of its ongoing investigation into the alleged custodial death. After hearing the petition, the court permitted the investigating agency to question Nagaraju for eight days.

As per the court's directions, the interrogation will begin on Friday and continue for eight days, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day. The court ordered that the questioning be conducted in the presence of Nagaraju's lawyer and be audio and video recorded. It also directed the SIT to submit the recordings before the court after the completion of the interrogation.

Nagaraju, who was arrested on June 23, is currently lodged in Rajamahendravaram Central Jail under judicial remand.



The case has drawn widespread attention following allegations surrounding the death of Gade Sai Krishna, who was taken into police custody nearly two months ago. According to his family members, Sai Krishna was illegally detained at the Krishnalanka Police Station and subjected to severe custodial torture, which allegedly led to his death.

The family has also alleged that police attempted to destroy evidence by cremating Sai Krishna's body at a local electric crematorium without informing his relatives or obtaining their consent. The al-

legations triggered public outrage and led to the constitution of a Special Investigation Team to probe the incident.

Following the investigation, CI Nagaraju was arrested and suspended from service. The SIT is expected to use the court-approved custody period to examine his role in the alleged custodial torture, the circumstances leading to Sai Krishna's death, and the alleged destruction of evidence.

The custodial death case remains under investigation, with the SIT continuing to gather evidence and question those involved.

VBG-RAMG Scheme to Bring ₹1,000 Crore Annually to AP - Pemmasani

Union Minister of State for Rural Development and Communications Dr. Pemmasani Chandrasekhar on Thursday said the newly launched Vikasit Bharat Guarantee for Rozgar Aajivika Mission Grammeen (VBG-RAMG) scheme would open new avenues for rural development and bring nearly 11,000 crore annually to Andhra Pradesh.

The scheme was launched at Mukkavaripalli village in Obulavaripalli mandal of Tirupati district by Union Minister for Rural Development and Agriculture Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Konidela Pawan Kalyan.

Addressing the gathering, Dr. Pemmasani said Andhra Pradesh had become the venue for a historic initiative aimed



at transforming rural India. He recalled that the country's first MGNREGA job card was issued in Andhra Pradesh and noted the programme's role in reducing migration in drought-prone Rayalaseema.

Highlighting reforms, he said Aadhaar seeding eliminated 4.43 crore fake job cards nationwide, while direct benefit transfers and geo-tagging enhanced transparency. He said the new framework focuses on employment generation, rural infrastructure, water security and income enhancement, with the Centre bearing 60 per cent of the cost and states contributing 40 per cent.

Andhra Pradesh Health Secretary Suresh Kumar has directed officials to ensure 100% registration of all pregnant women on the state health portal, stressing that accurate data is essential to safeguard the health of both mothers and newborns. He issued the directions during a review meeting with Health and Family Welfare Commissioner Chakradhar Babu at the department headquarters in Mangalagiri on Thursday.

Suresh Kumar instructed the state's more than 40,000 ASHA workers to ensure complete pregnancy registration and sought explanations for low registration rates in Srikakulam (85.43%), Eluru (87%), and Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema (87.36%) districts. He asked officials to replicate the best prac-



tices followed in Kurnool (98.16%), West Godavari (97.99%), and Alluri Sitarama Raju (96.90%) districts.

Expressing concern over the high number of Caesarean deliveries, he questioned the reasons behind C-section rates of 80.76% in Konaseema, 75% in Srikakulam, and 72.5% in West Godavari. Officials informed him that Caesarean deliveries account for 62% of births in private hospitals and 42% in gov-

YSRCP Questions AP GST Growth Claims

The YSR Congress Party has challenged the Andhra Pradesh government's claims of strong economic performance based on the latest GST collection figures, alleging that the reported growth is largely the result of a low-base effect rather than genuine economic expansion. In a statement released on Wednesday, the party criticized Andhra Pradesh Education and IT Minister Nara Lokesh for highlighting the state's GST growth as evidence of increased development and employment without examining the underlying data.

YSRCP pointed out that while the state's post-IGST settlement SGST collections recorded a 25% year-on-year growth during the first quarter of FY 2026-27, the correspond-

ing period in FY 2025-26 had registered a 7% decline, creating what it described as an "artificial growth" due to the low comparison base. The party further stated that SGST collections increased from 8,568 crore in Q1 FY 2024-25 to 9,978 crore in Q1 FY 2026-27, reflecting a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 7.9% over two years, which it argued was not exceptional. Comparing the figures with its tenure, YSRCP claimed that SGST revenues grew from 20,611 crore in 2018-19 to 31,130 crore in 2023-24, registering a CAGR of 8.6% despite challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic. The party accused Lokesh of selectively interpreting financial data for political credit while ignoring the state's broader fiscal performance over the past two years.

implemented with complete transparency using technologies such as geo-tagging and biometric authentication.

Naidu also announced that water from the Galeru-Nagari Project would be supplied to Koduru and groundwater levels would be improved through the Jaladhara initiative. Highlighting Andhra Pradesh's achievements in rural employment, he said the State created a Guinness World Record by conducting Gram Sabhas simultaneously in 13,226 villages. The programme has generated 55.44 crore man-days with an expenditure of 16,695 crore, resulting in the construction of 7,000 kilometres of CC roads, 40,000 cattle shelters, 15,500 water troughs, 1.07 lakh farm ponds, 1,373 kilometres of roads in tribal areas, and horticulture plantations across 1.66 lakh acres. For the current year, the government has set ambitious targets, including 10,000 kilometres of gravel roads, 1,500

kilometres of cement and BT roads, 500 kilometres of magic drains, and horticulture plantations over one lakh acres. The Chief Minister said the present government had restored 93 Centrally Sponsored Schemes, including the Jal Jeevan Mission, and was implementing projects worth 28,000 crore. He thanked the Central Government for its continued support, particularly for the reconstruction of Amaravati, and highlighted major investments coming to Andhra Pradesh, including the Google Data Centre, a fighter aircraft manufacturing unit at Puttaparthi, Hero MotoCorp's facility at Satyavedu, Royal Enfield's manufacturing unit in Tirupati, and a proposed horticulture hub at Madanapalle.

Speaking on the occasion, Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan said the Central Government had earmarked 7.5 lakh crore under the VBG Ram G Mission to accelerate rural development across the country

and would release 7,700 crore to Andhra Pradesh during the current nine-month period. He said Gram Sabhas would identify and approve development works in every panchayat, ensuring people's participation in rural planning.

The Union Minister handed over sanction letters for 74,212 houses under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana and 422 crore under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana to Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan. He also announced that the Centre would procure 2,16,250 metric tonnes of Totapuri mangoes under the Market Intervention Scheme, providing major relief to mango farmers in Andhra Pradesh. Minister Subhash Slams Jagan Over Capital Remarks

Minister Vasamsetti Subhash on Thursday launched a sharp attack on YSR Congress Party president Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, accusing him of creating confusion over the state's capital and misleading the public with repeated statements on Amaravati.

Speaking at the State Secretariat in Amaravati, the Minister questioned the purpose of Jagan's press conferences, alleging that the former Chief Minister neither answers questions from journalists nor addresses public concerns. He

said the people of Andhra Pradesh now expect development rather than political rhetoric.

Referring to Jagan's recent remarks on the capital issue, Subhash alleged that the previous YSRCP government failed to develop any of its proposed three capitals while creating uncertainty over the state's future. He also criticized the construction of government buildings at Rushikonda, claiming public funds were misused during the previous regime.

The Minister asserted that the NDA alliance government, under Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy

Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, is committed to completing the development of Amaravati and accelerating key projects such as Polavaram.

Subhash further alleged that the previous government discouraged investments and accused the opposition of attempting to obstruct fresh industrial investments through misinformation. He challenged the opposition to help bring investments to the state instead of engaging in what he termed "negative politics," and said the coalition government would continue to focus on Andhra Pradesh's development agenda.

YSRCP Slams Law and Order in Rajamahendravaram

YSRCP State Secretary and former corporator Vasamsetti Gangadhara Rao on Wednesday alleged a complete breakdown of law and order in Rajamahendravaram under the Alliance government and criticized the administration over civic issues, hospital management, and development works.

Addressing a press conference, Gangadhara Rao questioned City MLA Adireddy Srinivas over reports of his application for a gun licence, claiming it reflected the deteriorating security situation in the city. He alleged that recent rains exposed the poor drainage system, leaving low-lying areas such as Thummalava and Aryapuram flooded. He blamed civic authorities for failing to prevent waterlogging and demanded criminal action against those responsible.

The YSRCP leader also accused the government of filing false cases against opposition



leaders, citing BC leader Peetha Ramakrishna as an example. He alleged that the ruling coalition was targeting YSRCP leaders through politically motivated cases.

Gangadhara Rao further criticized the functioning of the Government General Hospital, alleging negligence in handling patient deaths and poor maintenance of the premises. He claimed the government was taking credit for edu-

cational improvements achieved under the previous YSRCP administration through the Nadu-Nedu programme.

He also demanded transparency in the utilization of Godavari Pushkaram funds and questioned the delay in completing major infrastructure projects, including the riverfront and Diwan Cheruvu bridge. Several YSRCP leaders attended the press conference.

MGNREGS Workers Neglected, Says YSRCP

Former MP Talari Rangaiah has accused the Andhra Pradesh coalition government of failing to protect the interests of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) workers, alleging that agricultural labourers across the state are facing severe hardship due to low wages and inadequate employment opportunities.

Addressing the media on Wednesday, Rangaiah said Andhra Pradesh continues to have one of the lowest MGNREGS wage rates in the country, with workers receiving only 308-312 per day after a marginal increase of 5. He claimed that while several states offer wages above 400 per day, nearly 47 lakh job card-holding families in Andhra Pradesh are struggling to sustain their livelihoods.

He further alleged that



around 18 lakh MGNREGS job cards had been removed for political reasons and questioned Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, who also oversees the department, for not reviewing the implementation of the scheme despite promising accountability.

Rangaiah said labourers from Anantapur, western Kur-nool, North Andhra and Prakasam districts are increasingly migrating in search of work due to inadequate em-

ployment and low wages. He announced that he would write to the Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee seeking corrective measures to safeguard workers' interests.

The former MP also criticized the coalition government for allegedly failing to improve rural infrastructure and demanded immediate steps to ensure fair wages and better employment opportunities for agricultural labourers across Andhra Pradesh.



Ravikumar Slams Jagan Over Capital Issue

Minister Gottipati Ravikumar on Thursday criticised YSR Congress Party president and former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy over his remarks on Amaravati, alleging that the former government had failed to develop the capital despite making repeated promises.

Participating in a public grievance redressal programme at the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) central office in Amaravati, the Minister said a large number of people attended the event to submit petitions on various public issues.

Addressing the media, Ravikumar claimed the YSRCP had been reduced to 11 Assembly seats after contesting the elections with the three-capitals proposal. He alleged that if the party continued with what he

termed "misleading politics" on the capital issue, it would face further rejection from the electorate.

The Minister accused Jagan of attempting to obstruct Amaravati's development, alleging that the previous government spent around 450 crore on constructing a government complex at Rushikonda while failing to advance capital infrastructure in Amaravati.

Ravikumar further claimed that Jagan had earlier supported Amaravati as the capital and even sought land there before changing his stand. He said the coalition government, under Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, is committed to completing Amaravati's development while simultaneously attracting investments to accelerate Andhra Pradesh's economic growth.

Minister Dola Criticises Jagan Over Capital Remarks

Social Welfare Minister Dr. Dola Sree Bala Veeranjanya Swamy on Thursday launched a sharp attack on YSR Congress Party president and former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy over his recent remarks on the state capital, accusing him of repeatedly changing his stand for political reasons.

Addressing a press conference in Ongole, the Minister alleged that Jagan was shifting his position on the capital issue "like the demon Maricha changing his guise." He questioned the former Chief Minister's reference to "Mavigan" and asked whom he intended to mislead with the new terminology.

Dr. Dola asserted that Amaravati remains the capital of Andhra Pradesh, stating that

Parliament had approved it and that the Central Government had issued a gazette notification recognizing it. He alleged that Jagan had earlier advocated the three-capital proposal and was now introducing new narratives to confuse the public. The Minister further accused the YSRCP chief of following "a politics of deception and betrayal," claiming that his statements on the capital lacked consistency. He said there was no need for the public to pay attention to what he described as contradictory remarks. Reaffirming the coalition government's commitment to Amaravati, Dr. Dola said the state administration would continue focusing on the development of the capital city and would not be distracted by what he termed politically motivated statements from the opposition.



YSRCP Alleges Neglect of MGNREGS Workers

YSRCP Panchayat Raj Wing State President Vennapusa Ravindra Reddy on Wednesday accused the Alliance government of failing to protect the interests of MGNREGS workers and alleged that the revised rural employment policy would impose a heavy financial burden on Andhra Pradesh.

Addressing a press conference at the YSRCP central office in Tadepalli, Ravindra Reddy claimed that the state government had misled the public over the Centre's Viksit Bharat Guarantee for Rozgar and Aajivika Mission-Gramin (VBG-RAM-G) scheme. He alleged that Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu had failed to secure a substantial wage hike for workers, while Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan had not questioned the Centre

over the issue.

He said the Centre's revised funding pattern from 90:10 to 60:40 would increase the state's financial responsibility and questioned how the government would fund its promise of providing 125 days of employment. According to him, while the Centre would provide 7,707 crore, the state would need to arrange the remaining 15,039 crore.

Ravindra Reddy also criticized the 5 increase in wages for MGNREGS workers in Andhra Pradesh, alleging it was significantly lower than hikes announced in several other states. He further demanded an explanation regarding the alleged diversion of panchayat funds and challenged the Alliance government to an open debate on the implementation of the employment guarantee scheme.

He said special precautions are being taken to prevent waterborne diseases, which are more common during the rainy season. Whenever low chlorine levels are detected in any part of the supply net-

work, immediate corrective measures, including additional chlorination, are being undertaken to maintain water quality.

The Commissioner said RC testing is being conducted daily across the city, while selected samples are also being sent to laboratories for detailed analysis wherever necessary. He urged residents to store drinking water in clean containers, avoid wastage, and cooperate with the civic body's efforts to ensure a safe and uninterrupted water supply throughout the monsoon season.

Undavalli Residents Seek Relief from Traffic Gridlock

Residents of Undavalli have appealed to the authorities to take immediate steps to address the persistent traffic congestion on the village's main road, saying the daily commute has become increasingly difficult.

The road, a crucial link between Vijayawada and Amaravati, has witnessed a significant rise in vehicular traffic over the years. Commuters reportedly spend nearly 15 minutes travelling the short stretch between the Coastal Bank junction and the cremation ground junction due to heavy congestion.

Residents said the problem becomes more severe during peak of-



fice, school, and college hours, when long queues of vehicles cause delays and inconvenience. They pointed out that Undavalli serves as a major gateway to the Amaravati capital region, resulting in a continuous increase in traffic volume.

Expressing concern that the is-

sue has remained unresolved for decades, locals urged officials to widen the existing road and introduce effective traffic management measures. They said improving the road infrastructure is essential to ensure smooth traffic flow and reduce the daily hardships faced by thousands of commuters.

NTR District Launches Rural Welfare Push

Lakshmisha, along with Mylavaram MLA Vasantha Venkata Krishna Prasad, inaugurated the VB-G-Ram-G (Viksit Bharat-Guarantee for Rozgar and Aajivika Mission-Grameen) scheme at Chevuturu in G. Konduru mandal. The initiative increases employment guarantee work from 100 to 125 days and raises daily wages from 307 to 312, while focusing

on creating durable rural infrastructure, improving groundwater recharge, and enhancing village connectivity.

Reviewing the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls at A. Konduru, the Collector said 97.38% of enumeration forms had been distributed and 31.71% digitised. He directed Booth Level Officers to complete the remaining work impartially and in line with Election Commission guidelines.

Dr. Lakshmisha also announced that a Special Public Grievance Redressal System (PGRS) programme will be held on July 3 at Auto Nagar in Vijayawada East to receive public petitions and ensure prompt resolution of grievances.

AP Raises Retirement Age to 62

Andhra Pradesh Government has enhanced the retirement age from 60 to 62 years for regular employees working in state government undertakings, corporations, and societies covered under Schedules 9 and 10 of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014. The orders were issued by Finance Department Principal Secretary Piyush Kumar through G.O.Ms. No. 45.

The revised retirement age has been given retrospective effect from January 1, 2022, bringing these employees on par with regular state government staff. The government said employees who retired at the age of 60 will be eligible for re-induction into service, subject to prescribed conditions. Those who continued in service up to



62 years under interim court orders will have their service regularised with all eligible benefits.

Employees rejoining service will not receive salary for the period they remained out of service, though the interval will count for seniority, promotions, and notional annual increments. They must refund retirement benefits already received, including gratuity, computed pension, and earned leave encashment. All concerned organisations have been directed to amend their service rules accordingly.

VMC Clears Budameru Canal Ahead of Monsoon

Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) has intensified efforts to remove water hyacinth and plastic waste from the Budameru canal as part of its monsoon preparedness drive to prevent urban flooding. Municipal Commissioner Dhyanachandra on Thursday inspected a special sanitation operation at Ramakrishnapuram in the 30th Division of Circle-2. The drive utilised long-arm excavators, boats, and trucks to clear accumulated aquatic vegetation and plastic waste obstructing the canal.

The Commissioner said the initiative is aimed at ensuring the free flow of rainwater and preventing waterlogging in vulnerable areas during the monsoon season. He noted that re-



moving water hyacinth and solid waste would improve the canal's drainage capacity and reduce the risk of flooding in low-lying localities.

Dhyanachandra said similar cleaning operations are being undertaken across major canals, drains, and outfall channels in the city. He urged residents not to dump plastic waste or garbage into waterways and stressed that public cooperation is vital to maintaining clean drainage systems and preventing monsoon-related flooding.

Employment Scheme Launched in Tiruvuru

Viksit Bharat-Guarantee for Rozgar and Aajivika Mission (Grameen) (VBG-RAMJI) was launched at Lakshimpuram village in Tiruvuru constituency on Thursday, with Tiruvuru MLA Kolikapudi Srinivasa Rao inaugurating the programme.

MONITORING SYSTEM NEEDED ON YOUTUBERS AND PUBLIC SPEECHES

The issue now is how to protect it. Because more and more people are misusing it. Taking shelter behind it, they are speaking recklessly. Ignoring the principle that your freedom should not hurt another person, they say whatever they like. Then, when the other side reacts strongly, files cases, and the matter goes as far as arrests, they call it injustice. It is mainly the social group of those who are arrested that argues this.

Some YouTubers speak however they wish. It is evident that they are speaking from one particular side. Even so, they present their views as if they are the absolute truth. Instead of leaving the judgment to the people, they themselves arrive at conclusions and announce them.

One YouTuber, while saying that tension had arisen over the arrest of the YouTuber Prashna Ravan, claimed that both sides had become ready to clash. According to him, one side consisted of Dalit Christian minorities, while the other side consisted of Jana Sena and coalition supporters. Why should it be presented that way? Wasn't it done deliberately? Could he not have simply said it was a clash between those supporting Prashna Ravan and Jana Sena supporters? Instead, by identifying one side through caste and religion and the other through the name of a political party, doesn't it imply that all those caste and religious groups are opposed to that political party? What kind of journalism is this?

Prashna Ravan's real name is Joseph. His videos had earned him considerable recognition in the past. He used to strongly criticize the BJP and saffron groups. Now he appears to be speaking as though he has aligned himself with YSR Congress circles that oppose the coalition government. Everyone has seen that these people speak against the coalition, against Chandrababu, and against Pawan Kalyan, and whenever they are arrested, YSR Congress supporters come out onto the streets in their support.

Because of these developments, a situation is emerging where even if people who speak honestly are arrested, the public no longer pays attention.

One advocate, while speaking at a Dalit Christian gathering, spoke in a highly offensive manner about the Deputy Speaker. He spoke in a way that could directly create a law-and-order problem and provoke religious tensions.

On the other hand, another YouTuber has been posting a series of messages against Ambedkar. By insulting Ambedkar, he is provoking Ambedkar's supporters.

To bring this situation under control, a monitoring system is essential. Otherwise, people will become victims of poisonous strategies that divide society along caste and religious lines for political purposes.

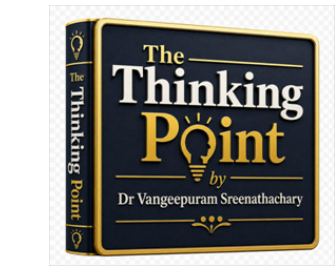

Everychild learns mathematics. Many learn science. Some master technology. They are taught how to solve equations, write computer programs, analyse data, and prepare for successful careers. Yet one of life's most important subjects is rarely taught in any classroom—how to understand and manage one's own emotions. The consequences of this missing lesson are becoming increasingly visible in our homes, educational institutions, workplaces, and society. Intelligence has advanced rapidly. Emotional maturity has not always kept pace. We have taught generations how to make a living, but not always how to live.

Recent incidents involving broken relationships, violent reactions to rejection, and emotionally driven crimes have once again forced society to confront an uncomfortable truth. These incidents are not merely failures of law and order. They are often failures of emotional understanding. While every individual must remain accountable for his or her actions, such incidents also compel us to ask a deeper question: Are we preparing our young people to face life's emotional challenges with the same seriousness with which we prepare them for academic examinations?

Modern education has achieved remarkable success in expanding knowledge and opportunity. Students today have access to world-class information, digital technologies, and global careers. Yet many struggle with rejection, disappointment, failure, criticism, loneliness, and conflict. They know how to compete, but not always how to cope. They know how to communicate instantly, but not necessarily how to communicate meaningfully. They know how to pursue success, but not always how to preserve emotional balance



while pursuing it.

This concern is supported by global mental-health trends. The World Health Organization has repeatedly warned that depression, anxiety, loneliness and stress are rising concerns among young people across the world. According to the WHO, one in seven adolescents globally experiences a mental health condition. Studies on emotional intelligence also show that self-awareness, empathy, impulse control and relationship skills strongly influence decision-making, mental well-being and social behaviour. These findings remind us that emotional maturity is not a soft skill; it is a survival skill for modern life.

Psychologists often describe emotional maturity as the ability to recognise, understand, and regulate one's emotions while responding to others with empathy, self-control, and responsibility. It is the capacity to disagree without hatred, to experience disappointment without destruction, and to accept rejection without losing one's dignity. Emotional maturity does not eliminate pain; it teaches us how to respond to pain wisely. One of the greatest misconceptions of our time is that intelligence alone guarantees good judgement. History and everyday life repeatedly prove otherwise. Brilliant minds have made disastrous personal decisions, while people with modest academic achievements have demonstrated extraordinary wisdom, compassion, and



resilience. Intelligence enables people to solve problems. Emotional maturity helps them avoid creating unnecessary ones. Emotional maturity is the steering wheel that determines where intelligence will take us.

Technology has transformed the way we live, work, and communicate. Social media connects billions of people within seconds, yet meaningful human connection often remains elusive. Digital platforms reward speed, comparison, and instant reactions, while emotional growth still demands patience, reflection, conversation, and lived experience. No application can teach empathy. No algorithm can replace wisdom. The human heart still learns best through relationships built on trust, respect, and understanding.

India's changing social landscape makes emotional maturity even more important. Smaller families, rapid urbanisation, migration for education and employment, intense academic competition, and increasing digital dependence have changed the way people build relationships. Many young people spend more time interacting through screens than through meaningful conversations. At the same time, mental health challenges, loneliness,

stress, and anxiety are becoming more visible across age groups. These changes call not only for better healthcare but also for stronger emotional education.

Families remain the first school of emotional learning. Children observe how adults handle disagreement, disappointment, anger, forgiveness, and compassion. Schools and colleges can strengthen this foundation by giving greater importance to emotional intelligence, conflict resolution, respectful relationships, ethical decision-making, and mental well-being alongside academic excellence. Employers too have a responsibility to create workplaces where empathy, communication, and psychological well-being are valued as much as technical competence. The media also plays a crucial role. Every tragic incident should become an opportunity not merely to report what happened but to explore why it happened and what society can learn from it. Public discussion must move beyond blame towards understanding, prevention, and responsibility. A mature society is one that learns from its mistakes rather than simply reacting to them. The greatest challenge before us is not a shortage of knowledge but a shortage of

emotional wisdom. A society that teaches children how to solve equations but not emotional conflicts leaves them only half educated. Knowledge helps us earn a living. Emotional maturity teaches us how to live with ourselves and with others. One builds careers. The other builds character. One creates professionals. The other creates responsible human beings. Every truly developed nation must nurture both. As India prepares its young people for the opportunities of the twenty-first century, let us remember that the future will not be shaped by technology alone, nor by economic growth alone. It will also be shaped by the quality of our relationships, the strength of our character, and the wisdom with which we respond to life's inevitable challenges. The future belongs not merely to the most intelligent minds, but to the most emotionally mature hearts. Nations will be remembered not only for the technologies they invent, but also for the character they nurture. Schools will not truly succeed until they educate both the mind and the heart. For in the end, intelligence may open doors—but emotional maturity determines what we do once we walk through them.

Will Pawan Kalyan's Vision Become Reality? Is It Practically Achievable?

A close look at Jana Sena Party president Pawan Kalyan's speech at the party's organizational meeting in Mangalagiri, where he addressed the functioning of the Information Collection Committees for party-building, reveals three central themes. The first is organizational restructuring, the second is his stand on caste politics, and the third is his political attack on the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP). The real question, however, is how far his words align with his actions. Pawan appeared clear and confident while speaking about organizational restructuring. Yet, whether this vision can be translated into reality remains uncertain. His assertion that "I will build the party with those who have stood by me for the last 12 years" and his emphasis on a "Cadre-to-Leadership" model represent a healthy democratic approach. Unlike many political parties where leadership positions are handed down from the top, Jana Sena's proposal to identify grassroots workers and elevate them to leadership positions can certainly be seen as an innovative experiment.

"I Will Never Use Caste as Political Capital" — How Realistic Is This Claim?

Perhaps the most striking statement in Pawan's speech was his declaration that he would never use caste as a po-

litical investment. His belief that history can only be created through the acceptance of all communities is undoubtedly an idealistic and positive message. Yet political reality presents a different picture. Pawan himself has long been identified as a prominent leader of the Kapu community. In the past, he actively championed the cause of Kapu reservations and raised several issues concerning the community. In the same speech, he alleged that there is a deliberate political conspiracy to portray Kapus negatively. This creates an apparent contradiction. On one hand, he rejects caste-based politics; on the other, he makes the political targeting of the Kapu community a major subject of discussion. His supporters describe this as "defensive politics"—arguing that he is merely responding to attempts to malign a community. Critics, however, contend that while claiming to reject caste politics, he continues to keep caste at the center of political discourse.

Pawan strongly criticized the language used by YSRCP leaders and reminded the audience of the personal attacks made against him and his family during the previous government's tenure. His criticism is not without merit. There is widespread agreement that po-



litical discourse in Andhra Pradesh deteriorated significantly during those years. However, his simultaneous advice to Jana Sena leaders—that they should respond in the same language whenever necessary and launch counterat-

tacks—raises an important question. Will such an approach elevate political culture, or merely perpetuate the cycle of hostility? Had he instead urged his party to respond through policy-based criticism rather than personal

attacks, it would have conveyed a much stronger democratic message.

This was undoubtedly one of the strongest and most impactful themes of Pawan's speech. Without rejecting welfare schemes outright, he argued

that equal importance must be given to infrastructure, employment generation, education, and healthcare. Economically, this reflects a balanced developmental approach. More importantly, it attempts to provide direction to the younger

generation rather than merely offering electoral promises. However, this principle will ultimately be tested by the performance of the coalition government currently in power.

The speech clearly suggests that Pawan Kalyan now seeks to transform himself from an agitational leader into the architect of a lasting political institution. Following Jana Sena's success in the 2024 elections, he appears determined to build the party into a permanent political organization rather than one dependent solely on his personal charisma. For that vision to succeed, however, several conditions must be fulfilled. Committee appointments must be genuinely transparent. Merit should outweigh personal loyalty. Internal democracy must become a reality rather than a slogan. Most importantly, leadership beyond caste considerations should be reflected not only in speeches but also in candidate selection and organizational appointments. Only then can Pawan's long-term aspirations stand a realistic chance of being fulfilled. Pawan Kalyan's speech clearly reflects an effort to provide Jana Sena with an ideological foundation and long-term organizational direction. His emphasis on party-building, youth empowerment, and institutional strengthening sends positive political signals. Nevertheless, his assertion that he does not believe in caste politics sits somewhat uneasily alongside his extensive discussion of political conspiracies targeting the Kapu community.

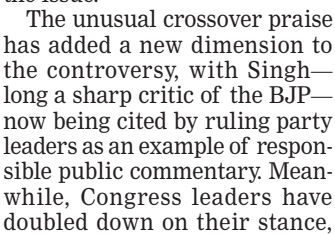

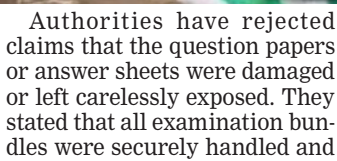

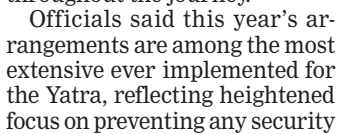

Russia Imports Petrol From India Amid Fuel Crisis

Russia has started importing petrol from India to tackle a growing fuel shortage triggered by repeated Ukrainian drone attacks on its oil refineries and energy infrastructure. The move marks a significant shift in energy trade, with Russia turning to India for refined fuel supplies despite being one of the world's largest crude oil producers.

The fuel crunch has spread across several regions of Russia, leading to rationing, long queues at petrol stations and rising gasoline prices. The shortages have intensified during the peak summer season, when fuel demand is traditionally high due to increased travel and agricultural activity.

According to industry sources, at least 60,000 metric tonnes of gasoline have already been shipped from India to Russia through two tankers. Moscow is reportedly planning to import up to 400,000 metric tonnes of petrol every month from multiple countries, including Belarus, to stabilise domestic supplies.

The shortages have been largely attributed to sustained Ukrainian strikes on Russian

oil refineries, fuel depots and other energy facilities. These attacks have disrupted refining operations, reducing gasoline production and creating supply gaps across the country.

India has emerged as a key energy partner for Russia since the start of the Ukraine conflict, purchasing large volumes of discounted Russian crude oil. Indian refiners process the crude domestically, and some of the refined products are now being exported back to Russia to help address the current supply crisis.

Russian authorities have acknowledged the fuel shortages and introduced measures to ease the crisis, including subsidies, tax changes and increased imports. The government hopes these steps will improve fuel availability and bring stability to domestic markets in the coming weeks.

The development highlights how the prolonged conflict has reshaped global energy flows, with India playing an increasingly important role in international fuel markets while maintaining its strategic energy ties with Russia.



India-Bound Oil Tanker Safely Reaches Odisha After Gunfire

An oil tanker carrying nearly 2 million barrels of Iraqi crude oil has safely reached Paradip Port in Odisha after surviving a gunfire incident while passing through the strategically important Strait of Hormuz. The vessel's successful arrival has brought relief amid heightened tensions in the Middle East and concerns over the security of global shipping routes.

The tanker, MT Sanmar Herald, was transporting Basrah Medium and Basrah Heavy crude oil from Iraq to India when it reportedly came under gunfire near Iranian waters. During the incident, the ship sustained shrapnel damage to its bridge. However, no injuries were reported among the crew, and the vessel remained operational.

To ensure the safety of everyone on board, the crew altered the ship's course after the attack and continued its journey towards the Indian coast without facing any further security threats. The vessel later arrived off the Odisha coast and anchored about 22 kilometres from Paradip Port, where crude oil unloading began

through the port's Single Point Mooring (SPM) system.

According to the Paradip Port Authority, the tanker maintained continuous coordination with the Indian Navy throughout its voyage. The port described the vessel's arrival as a remarkable display of courage and resilience, highlighting the successful completion of a challenging journey through one of the world's most sensitive maritime routes.

The Strait of Hormuz is one of the world's busiest oil transit routes, with a significant share of global crude exports passing through it every day. Recent geopolitical tensions in the region have increased security risks for commercial shipping, prompting vessels to exercise extra caution while navigating the waterway.

Despite the tense situation, the safe arrival of the MT Sanmar Herald ensures the uninterrupted delivery of crude oil to India and underscores the importance of close coordination between merchant vessels and maritime security agencies during periods of regional instability.

Trump Shifts Focus To ‘Birth Tourism’ Crackdown

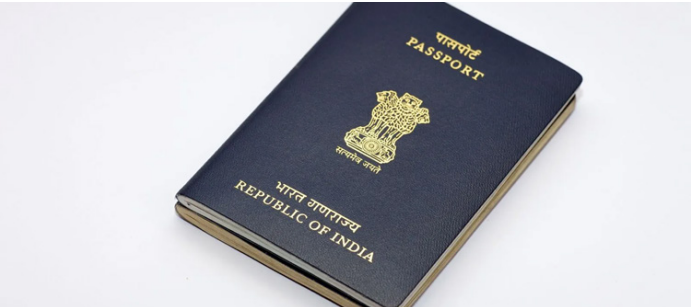
After the US Supreme Court rejected his administration's attempt to restrict birthright citizenship, President Donald Trump is reportedly shifting focus to a new strategy aimed at curbing so-called "birth tourism"—the practice of foreign nationals travelling to the United States to give birth so their children receive US citizenship.

The new approach is expected to target pregnant foreign visitors rather than birthright citizens

themselves. According to reports, the administration is considering stricter visa enforcement, increased scrutiny of visa applicants suspected of travelling for childbirth, and stronger action against organised birth tourism networks.

The move comes after the Supreme Court ruled that children born in the United States to parents who are in the country illegally or temporarily remain entitled to American citizenship

Indian Passport Services Cost More In UAE



Indian nationals living in the UAE will now have to pay higher fees for passport-related services, with the revised charges coming into effect from July 1, 2026. The updated fee structure applies to a wide range of services, including fresh passport applications, renewals, Tatkaal services, replacement of lost or damaged passports, and Police Clearance Certificates (PCCs).

The revised rates have been introduced by the Ministry of External Affairs and are being implemented across the Indian Embassy in Abu Dhabi, the Consulate General of India in Dubai, and all Indian Consular Application Centres (ICACs) in the UAE.

Under the new fee structure, applicants seeking fresh passports or renewals will have to pay more than before. Charges for Tatkaal services have also been increased, while the cost of replacing lost or damaged passports has gone up across different categories. Fees for

minors and Police Clearance Certificates have likewise been revised.

The fee revision follows changes to India's passport service rules and is aimed at standardising charges for Indian citizens applying both within the country and abroad. The revised pricing affects millions of Indians residing in the UAE, one of the largest overseas Indian communities in the world.

Alongside the fee hike, passport and consular services in the UAE are also undergoing an operational transition. Al Hind Tours and Travels has

taken over as the new outsourced service provider for passport, visa and other consular services, replacing the previous agencies. During the transition, Indian missions have introduced temporary walk-in arrangements for certain services until the new centres become fully operational.

Officials have advised applicants to check the latest fee structure and updated service guidelines before submitting their applications to avoid inconvenience. The revised charges are now applicable to all eligible passport and related services across the UAE.

What Is ‘Semiquincentennial’? Explained



As the United States prepares to celebrate the 250th anniversary of its Independence on July 4, 2026, one unusual word has taken the internet by surprise: Semiquincentennial. While many people are familiar with terms like centennial (100 years) and bicentennial (200 years), the lengthy and rarely used word has sparked widespread curiosity online.

The term "Semiquincentennial" simply refers to a 250th anniversary. It is derived from Latin, where "semi" means half and "quincentennial" refers to 500 years. Together, the word literally means half of 500 years, or 250 years. It is the official term being used to mark the United States' quarter-millennium celebration.

Although the word is technically correct, many people have found it difficult to pronounce and remember. As a result, alternatives such as "America250" and "Quarter Millennium" have become more popular in public discussions

and promotional campaigns surrounding the historic milestone.

The anniversary commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, when the thirteen American colonies formally declared independence from British rule. The 250th anniversary is expected to be one of the biggest national celebrations in U.S. history, featuring cultural events, exhibitions, educational programmes and community activities across the country.

The official celebrations are

being coordinated under the America250 initiative, which was established by the U.S. Congress to oversee commemorative events. Preparations have been underway for several years, with states and cities planning special programmes to honour the nation's history and achievements.

The unusual term has become a talking point on social media, with many users joking about its complexity while others have been searching for its meaning. Couple Arrested After Empire State Proposal



A dramatic marriage proposal high above New York City ended with arrests after a couple illegally climbed to the top of the Empire State Building's antenna spire, one of the most restricted sections of the iconic skyscraper.

The couple, identified as Russian rooftop climbers Angela Nikolau and Ivan Beerkus, scaled the 1,454-foot landmark without safety equipment before unfurling a large black banner carrying a message promoting peace. Their daring stunt quickly drew the attention of authorities and bystanders below.

After displaying the banner, the pair climbed down to a lower platform on the antenna, where Beerkus got down on one knee and proposed to Nikolau. She accepted the proposal, and the couple embraced while suspended hundreds of feet above the ground, with the moment captured on cameras and shared on social media.

The stunt prompted a major response from the New York Police Department, which deployed emergency personnel, drones and helicopters to monitor the situation. Streets around the Empire State Building were temporarily closed as

a precaution while officers ensured the climbers descended safely.

Once they returned to an accessible section of the building, both were taken into custody without incident. Authorities later charged them with offences including burglary, criminal trespass and reckless endangerment. No injuries were reported during the operation.

The Empire State Building's management condemned the unauthorized climb, noting that the landmark offers official proposal packages for couples wishing to celebrate special occasions safely. Officials also praised emergency responders for handling the situation without harm to the public.

The couple is well known for performing extreme rooftop climbs around the world and previously featured in a documentary showcasing their high-risk adventures. Their latest stunt has reignited debate over security at famous landmarks and the growing trend of thrill-seekers risking their lives for social media content.

Despite the romantic proposal, authorities have stressed that illegally accessing restricted areas of major buildings poses serious safety risks and can endanger both climbers and emergency responders.



India Sends Delegation To Iran Leader's Funeral

India has sent a multi-party delegation to attend the funeral of Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, underscoring New Delhi's commitment to maintaining diplomatic ties with Tehran despite Prime Minister Narendra Modi not attending the ceremony.

Prime Minister Modi did not travel to Iran for the funeral due to prior commitments and scheduling constraints. Instead, the government opted to send a delegation to convey India's condolences and solidarity with the Iranian people during the period of national mourning.

India and Iran share longstanding historical, cultural and strategic ties. The two countries have cooperated on several fronts, including trade, energy, regional connectivity and the development of the

Chabahar Port, which is considered crucial for India's access to Central Asia and Afghanistan.

Diplomatic observers believe India's decision to send a delegation rather than the Prime Minister strikes a balance between maintaining strong bilateral relations and managing domestic as well as international commitments. Such representation at state funerals is a common diplomatic practice and reflects the importance countries place on preserving official ties. US Deportees Caught In Venezuela Earthquake Tragedy

A group of Venezuelan migrants deported from the United States found themselves at the centre of a devastating tragedy after powerful earthquakes struck Venezuela just hours after their arrival. What was meant to be the end of a difficult journey turned into a desperate fight for survival as many of the deportees were caught in one of the country's deadliest natural disasters.

More than 140 Venezuelan deportees had arrived on a flight from the US as part of Washington's ongoing immigration crackdown. After landing, they were taken to temporary accommodation in La Guaira while authorities completed processing procedures. Before many could reunite with their families, twin earthquakes struck the region, causing widespread destruction.

The hotel where many of the deportees were staying collapsed during the quake, leaving scores trapped beneath the rubble. Survivors described scenes of panic as buildings crumbled around them and people desperately searched for loved ones. Several deportees managed to escape, while many others remain missing or are feared dead.

The incident has drawn international attention because of the tragic timing of the deportation flight. Human rights organisations have called for greater transparency regarding the missing deportees and urged authorities to provide regular updates to affected families.

As rescue efforts continue, the story has become a heart-breaking reminder of how lives already marked by displacement and uncertainty can be further devastated by unforeseen natural disasters.

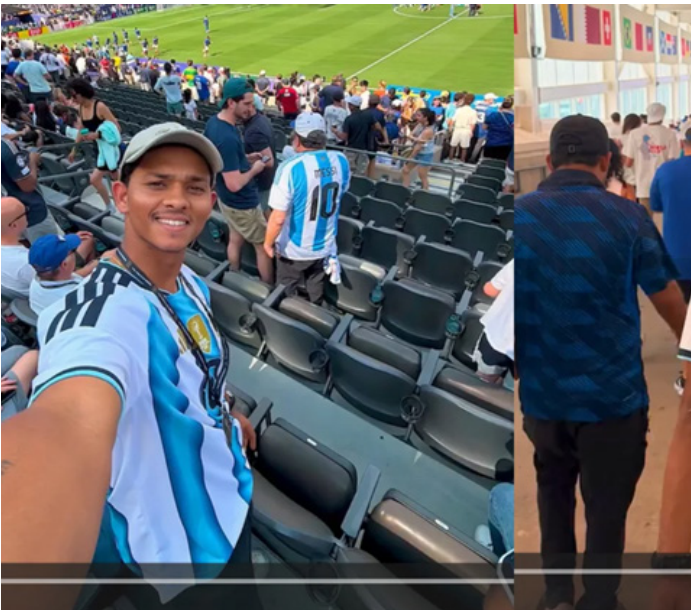
His innings provided Bengaluru Blasters with a solid platform after he stitched together an important partnership with Rohan Patil. The
