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TRUE POINT

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Heroes Must Follow Their Followers, Not the Other Way Around

A hero earns a following through heroism. But when he begins to display the traits of a villain, even his most loyal fans find it difficult to accept. Public support cannot be sustained by acting against the natural expectations of followers. Just as people cannot digest a Left party forming an alliance with the BJP, or the BJP joining hands with the Congress, fans also expect consistency from their heroes. They do not blindly follow every political turn taken by their favourite personalities.

The same happened in the case of Pawan Kalyan. After the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh, the Congress suffered a severe setback. At a time when the country was looking towards the BJP, Pawan Kalyan made his political entry and extended support to the BJP and the TDP. His fans immediately stood by his decision, and it had an impact on the election results. Had he supported Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy instead, it is doubtful whether the same response would have been seen. In the 2019 elections, Pawan allied with the Left parties, but many of his supporters did not vote for him. Those who were opposed to the TDP preferred the YSRCP. In 2024, however, the strong anti-incumbency against Jagan worked in Pawan's favour. A



leader's strategy succeeds only when it matches both his original support base and the prevailing political situation.

There is now speculation that Jr. NTR may eventually launch a political party. It is true that he has, on several occasions, expressed his desire to carry forward the legacy of his grandfather and become a political leader. As long as he was seen as being close to the TDP, his popularity remained intact. But when perceptions emerged that, due to the influence of Harikrishna, Kodali Nani and Vallabhaneni Vamsi, he was leaning towards the YSRCP, there was a noticeable impact. Even a well-received film failed to generate the expected collections. Realising this, Tarak maintained silence on politics and concentrated on his film career, eventually becoming one of the biggest

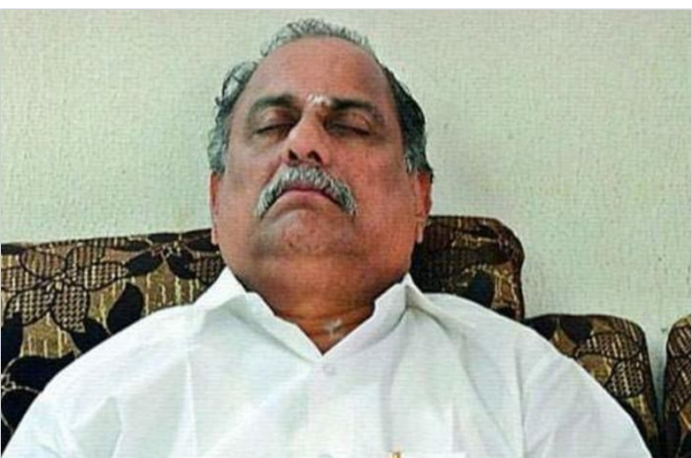
stars. As Nara Lokesh established himself first within the TDP and later in the government, the YSRCP allegedly tried to create the impression that TDP workers wanted Jr. NTR to take over the party. The apparent objective was to create confusion within the TDP ranks. However, it soon became clear that Lokesh is the undisputed political successor to N. Chandrababu Naidu. He now holds a strong grip over both the party and the government, leaving little room for confusion.

Political observers claim that the YSRCP now intends to use every possible issue to weaken the TDP and may attempt to capitalise on Tarak's leadership ambitions. However, Jagan Mohan Reddy has often been accused of using influential individuals for political advantage rather than

accommodating them as equals. The example of Mudragada Padmanabham, who was projected on the Kapu reservation issue but later found himself politically isolated, is often cited in this context.

Some believe that if Tarak enters politics, Lokesh may face a challenge. Certain leaders dissatisfied with Lokesh may also see Tarak as an alternative. But many argue that Tarak can succeed only if he enters as a leader of the TDP itself. Even a slight perception that he is helping Jagan politically could damage both his political future and his film career. His opportunity would arise only if the TDP faces a leadership crisis or if strong opposition emerges against Lokesh. Tarak may not be useful in defeating the TDP, but he could become relevant if circumstances ever create an opportunity to lead it. If he is seen as entering politics merely to weaken the TDP or strengthen Jagan, the consequences could extend to his popularity in cinema as well.

The same principle applies to Allu Arjun. His differences with the Mega family have already distanced a section of Mega fans. Many believe that this had an impact on the Telugu collections of Pushpa 2, even if effective public relations managed to soften that perception.

Kakinada : Former Minister and Kapu movement leader Mudragada Padmanabham, who played a significant role in Andhra Pradesh politics and social movements, passed away on Tuesday while undergoing treatment at a private hospital in Hyderabad. He was 73. Born on January 22, 1953, in

Kirlampudi village of the erstwhile East Godavari district, Mudragada entered politics at a young age following the footsteps of his father Veerarahgava Rao, who was popularly known as Kirlampudi Munsif and served as MLA from Prathipadu constituency.

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Jagan Demands ₹1 Crore Compensation for Fishermen Families

Former Chief Minister and YSRCP President Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy on Tuesday blamed the coalition government's alleged negligence for the death of six fishermen in a boat accident near Gangavaram Port and demanded 1 crore compensation for each affected family. Jagan Mohan Reddy, after consoling the families of the deceased and meeting the lone survivor Chinna, said seven fishermen had ventured into the sea for fishing when their boat capsized about 10 miles from Gangavaram Port. He alleged that despite repeated appeals and SOS messages from family members, officials failed to respond in time.

He said Chinna survived after swimming to safety and being rescued by a Chinese vessel, while the remaining fishermen lost their lives. Jagan alleged that timely inter-



vention by authorities could have saved others.

He criticised the government for limiting assistance to 10 lakh per family and demanded enhanced compensation. He said the YSRCP government had increased compensation for fishermen deaths from 5 lakh to 10 lakh and had earlier taken steps to bring back fishermen detained in Pakistan and Bangladesh through coordination with the Centre.

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AP First State to Launch Monthly Economic Reports, Says CM Naidu

Andhra Pradesh has become the first state in the country to introduce Monthly Economic Reports to monitor economic growth, improve governance and enable data-driven decision-making, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu said.

Addressing Ministers, Secretaries and Heads of Departments (HoDs) at the Secretariat, the Chief Minister said the government is focusing on efficient, transparent and outcome-based administration using technology and real-time



data. He advised senior officials to regularly visit the field and understand public issues.

Chandrababu Naidu said monthly reviews of Gross

State Domestic Product (GSDP), revenue receipts and departmental performance would help identify gaps and take corrective measures. He

stressed the need to improve citizen satisfaction through better service delivery and directed departments to achieve zero pendency in grievance disposal through the Public Grievance Redressal System (PGRS).

Highlighting revenue reforms, he said Artificial Intelligence-based tools introduced by the government helped increase revenue collections by 24 per cent across departments. Andhra Pradesh recorded nearly 20 per cent growth over 2017 levels during the previous year, he said.

The Chief Minister said

long-pending land issues were being resolved and Pattadar Passbooks were being distributed every month. He noted that issues in Shettipalli, Vatti Cherukuru, Kanggundi and Gutupalli were resolved, while 7.2 million Pattadar Passbooks were still pending for distribution.

He said electricity tariffs were not increased despite entering the third year of the government's tenure and reiterated the commitment of no tariff hike for five years. The government is also promoting induction stoves and solar power generation to

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Govt Approves ₹1,638 Crore for Expansion of Three Greenfield Ports

The State Government has approved administrative sanctions for land acquisition under Phase-2 expansion of three greenfield ports — Ramayapatnam, Mulapeta and Machilipatnam — with a total allocation of ₹1,638.52 crore for acquiring 6,248.54 acres.

Minister for Investments and Infrastructure BC Janardhan Reddy announced that the approvals were issued following the directions of Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu to strengthen coastal infrastructure and meet future port development requirements.

Addressing the media at the R&B and I&I Department office in the Secretariat, BC Janardhan Reddy said ₹851 crore has



been sanctioned for acquiring 2,924.45 acres of land for Phase-2 development of Ramayapatnam Greenfield Port. For Mulapeta Greenfield Port expansion, administrative sanctions of ₹440.52 crore have been granted for acquiring 1,903.39 acres, including salt-pan lands. He said Relief and Rehabilitation (R&R) measures would also be taken up as part of the land acquisition process. The Minister said ₹347 crore has been allocated

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What's Causing Unrest Around Yarlagadda?

Vijayawada : Political equations in the Gannavaram Assembly constituency appear to be witnessing fresh turbulence, with MLA Yarlagadda Venkatrao's recent public remarks over a government contract triggering discussions within political circles. His open expression of dissatisfaction has raised questions over whether internal differences are resurfacing among the ruling party leaders in the constituency.

Yarlagadda Venkatrao recently questioned the process of awarding an airport-related contract to KMV Projects and held a press conference at his office to clarify his stand. He denied allegations that his objection was linked to the contract not being awarded to a person close to him. The MLA stated that, as Vice Chairman of the Airport Advisory Committee, seeking details regarding government expenditure and project decisions was part of his responsibility as an elected representative. He re-

jected claims of personal interest and challenged that he would resign from his MLA post and quit politics if any wrongdoing was proved. He also said that if he had any issue with the government, he would directly discuss it with Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu. However, political discussions within the constituency suggest that the issue may have deeper roots. Yarlagadda had earlier been associated

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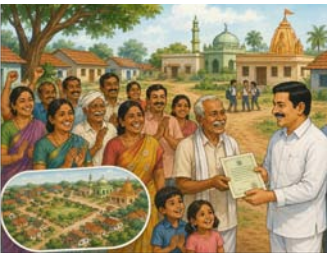
Century-Old Land Issue Resolved for 201 Families

Amaravati : The Alliance government has resolved a century-old land rights issue faced by 201 families in Pulladigunta village of Vatticherukuru mandal in Guntur district. The houses of these families, which were constructed decades ago, were listed under the prohibited category, preventing residents from obtaining full legal rights over their properties.

Pulladigunta, a hamlet of Karnepadu revenue village, had been classified as Topu Poramboke land. Though residents had been living there for nearly 100 years, paying Gram Panchayat taxes, electricity bills and exercising voting rights, they were denied ownership rights due to the land classification.

After the Alliance government assumed office, villagers brought the issue to the attention of Revenue, Registration



and Stamps Minister Anagani Satya Prasad. The Gram Panchayat passed a resolution requesting the government to remove the residential area from the prohibited list and reclassify it as a village settlement area.

Minister Anagani Satya Prasad took the matter to the notice of Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, following which officials conducted a detailed examination of village records. A re-survey revealed that houses and internal roads had been developed across 8.51 acres, where

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BJP Leaders to Visit Polavaram Project on July 16

The BJP leaders will visit the Polavaram Project on July 16 under the leadership of P.V.N. Madhav. Minister Bhupathiraju Srinivasa Varma, Satyakumar Yadav, party MPs, MLAs, MLCs, state office-bearers, spokespersons and media panellists will participate in the visit.

Addressing a press conference, BJP state spokesperson Mullapudi Renuka described Polavaram as Andhra Pradesh's "lifeline" and highlighted its engineering features, including the world's longest spillway, a 92-metre-deep diaphragm wall and the capacity to discharge 50 lakh cusecs of floodwater. She

said the project would provide irrigation to 7.2 lakh additional acres and supply water for drinking, industrial and future data centre needs.

Renuka blamed the Congress for decades of delay and accused the previous YSRCP government of stalling construction through reverse tendering, alleging that even five per cent of the work was not completed during its tenure. She said the NDA's "double-engine" government, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, has accelerated construction and appealed to party workers from Eluru, East Godavari and West Godavari districts to visit a success.

Later, he will participate in a coordination meeting with Telu-



gu Desam Party (TDP) leaders and workers of Proddatur constituency. The meeting will be held at the venue arranged at Dorasanipalle in Proddatur from 2:30 PM to 4:00 PM. The visit comes amid increased focus on industrial development and party coordination activities in Kadapa district.

Durgesh Resolves Tallapalem Waterlogging Issue

Minister Kandula Durgesh responded immediately to the waterlogging issue at the Tallapalem underbridge in Nidadavole mandal despite being in Mumbai, directing officials to take urgent measures to restore normal traffic.

Heavy water accumulation from nearby agricultural fields and canals had disrupted movement on the route towards Tade-palligudem. After receiving information about the issue, Durgesh reviewed the situation through a video call from Mumbai and instructed his personal staff, dis-

trict officials and alliance leaders to visit the spot and resolve the problem on a war footing.

Following his directions, Irrigation Executive Engineer, Nidadavole MPDO Anjaneya Sharma, Tahsildar Naik, minister's staff and alliance leaders inspected the location. Officials informed that the issue had recurred despite earlier attempts to remove the water.

The authorities cleared the stagnant water and restored movement at the underbridge. Residents and farmers appreciated Durgesh for using technology to address the issue promptly while being away from the constituency.

ECI Extends AP Voter Roll Revision Till July 24

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has extended the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Andhra Pradesh till July 24 following a request from the Chief Electoral Officer of the state. The Commission issued a revised schedule on Tuesday, modifying the timelines for various stages of the voter roll revision process with reference to July 1, 2026, as the qualifying date.

According to the revised schedule, house-to-house verifi-

cation by Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will continue until July 24, while the rationalisation and rearrangement of polling stations will also be completed by the same date. The draft electoral roll will be published on July 31.

The period for filing claims and objections has been fixed from July 31 to August 30, while their disposal will be completed between July 31 and September 28. The final electoral roll will be published on October 3. The ECI has directed officials to widely publicise the revised schedule and inform all recognised political parties accordingly.

Minister Subhash Demands Jaggireddy Apology

Labour Minister Vasamshetty Subhash on Tuesday condemned remarks made by YSRCP Konaseema district president Chirila Jaggireddy against Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu, alleging that the comments insulted backward classes (BCs).

Subhash said the repeated use of the term "Buda Bukkalodu" while criticising the Chief Minister was an insult to nomadic communities belonging to the BC category. He questioned whether BC communities could be treated with such disrespect and demanded that Jaggireddy issue a public apology.

The Minister alleged that YSRCP leaders were pursuing divisive politics and warned that attempts to create caste



tensions in Konaseema district would not be tolerated. He said political leaders should respect all sections of society in a democracy.

TDP Konaseema district president Guttula Sai also condemned the remarks and demanded an apology from Jaggireddy. BC state convener Pendramesh warned of a state-wide agitation if an apology was not issued.

District TDP leaders Gandham Pallam Raju and Akkala Rishwanth Roy were among those present.

Rajya Sabha Member V. Vijayendra Prasad, after visiting the Andhra Pradesh Pavilion at Bharat Mandapam, said the state's rich handloom heritage has immense potential in global markets. He stressed the need to use technologies like Virtual Reality (VR) to connect master weavers directly with international buyers.

He said demand for authentic



handmade and culturally rooted products among global consumers, including the Indian diaspora, offers Andhra Pradesh an opportunity to emerge as a major sourcing destination for handloom and textile products.

Lepakshi Handicrafts Development Corporation Chairman Paspuleti Hari Prasad appreciated the Department of Handlooms & Textiles for showcasing the state's handloom heritage, textile strengths and investment opportunities under AP Textile Policy 4.0. He said the government un-

der Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu is giving priority to the textile sector through investor-friendly policies and infrastructure development.

The Andhra Pradesh Pavilion, set up by the Department of Handlooms & Textiles in Hall No. 9, was inaugurated by Commissioner G. Rekha Rani. Odisha Puts Ganjam on COVID Alert Amid Reports from AP

The Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer (CDM&PHO), Ganjam, has directed all government health-care facilities in the district to strengthen COVID-19 surveillance and preparedness following reports of fresh COVID-19 cases and suspected fatalities in neighbouring Andhra Pradesh.

In an official communication issued on July 13, the CDM&PHO instructed the DMO (MS)-cum-Superintendent, City Hospital, Berhampur, and Superintendents of Sub-Divisional Hospitals (SDHs) and Community Health Centres (CHCs) to enhance testing, monitoring and hospital readiness.

Considering Ganjam's proximity to Andhra Pradesh and frequent cross-border movement, authorities have been asked to maintain a high alert. Hospitals must conduct mandatory COVID-19 testing for Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) patients and random

testing of at least five per cent of Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) cases. The order also directed hospitals to ensure functional isolation wards, oxygen-supported beds, oxygen plants and adequate medicine stocks.

Frontline health workers have been asked to monitor unusual fever and respiratory illness clusters.

Daily reports on testing, infrastructure readiness and logistics have been made mandatory as part of the preparedness measures.

Minister Mandipalli Ramprasad Reddy on Tuesday flagged off a special "Thank You CM Sir" bus in Vijayawada as a mark of gratitude to the coalition government for reducing taxes on private and tourist buses.

The bus was launched following a gratitude meeting organised by the Andhra Pradesh Private Bus Owners Welfare Association after the state Cabinet approved the reduction of interstate bus tax from 4,000 to 2,500. The minister attended the programme as the chief guest and later inspected the newly designed private bus equipped with modern facilities. Association representatives said the initia-

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tive was aimed at expressing their appreciation to Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and the coalition government for addressing long-pending issues faced by private bus operators. They welcomed the tax relief decision, stating that it would ease financial burdens and support the growth of the sector.

Addressing the gathering, Ramprasad Reddy said the government was committed to strengthening the transport sec-

tor and ensuring the welfare of private operators. He noted that the tax reduction was made possible under the leadership of the Chief Minister and assured continued efforts to resolve industry concerns while prioritising passenger safety. The minister also announced plans to establish dedicated terminals for private bus operators under the BOT model to improve infrastructure and streamline operations.

On the occasion, he unveiled the new logo of the Andhra Pradesh Private Bus Association. Association president Gautham Kiran, along with representatives and members, participated in the programme and expressed optimism about the future of the private transport sector in the state.

MHPS Forms Legal Team to Protect Voting Rights

The Minority Human Protection Society (MHPS) conducted a state-level legal team meeting to discuss measures for safeguarding citizens' constitutional right to vote and ensuring support during the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process.

The meeting was chaired by MHPS State President and Andhra Pradesh State Urdu Academy Chairman Mohammed Farooq Shubli. Addressing the media, Farooq Shubli welcomed the Election Commission's decision to extend the SIR deadline by 10 days and urged for a further extension to provide sufficient time for eligible voters to complete the process.

He said the primary objective was to ensure that no eligible voter loses the right to exercise



their franchise due to procedural difficulties. The MHPS legal team, he added, would extend legal assistance to people from all communities who face challenges after the completion of the SIR process.

During the meeting, participants discussed issues being faced by citizens, the need for a transparent and comprehensive revision process, and measures required to protect voting rights. A 20-member legal team comprising advocates has been formed to provide assistance across the state.

High Court senior advocate Mohammed Saleem Pasha will head the legal team, while former RTI Commissioner and former judge Imtiaz will serve as an adviser. District-level legal coordination committees will also be established to address voter-related concerns.

The meeting was attended by senior advocates, legal team members, MHPS state representatives and other members who discussed the future course of action to ensure constitutional protection of voting rights.

43.30 Lakh Students to Undergo Eye Screening

The Andhra Pradesh government will conduct eye screening tests for 43.30 lakh students across the state from July 15, Health Minister Satyakumar Yadav announced on Tuesday.

The programme will cover students aged between 6 and 18 years studying in government, aided and private schools. As part of the National Programme for Control of Blind-

ness and Visual Impairment, the Health and School Education departments will jointly implement the initiative.

The minister said 2.50 lakh students identified with vision problems will be provided free spectacles, with an estimated expenditure of around Rs 7 crore. The distribution target has been increased from the earlier 95,000 after the Centre approved the state's proposal based on the satisfactory implementation of the

programme.

Students requiring further treatment will be referred to government eye hospitals, district hospitals and recognised voluntary organisation hospitals. Satyakumar Yadav said early detection and treatment of vision problems would improve students' education, concentration and overall development. He urged officials, teachers and parents to ensure successful implementation of the programme.

Singapore Extends Support for Amaravati Development

Discussions focused on areas of collaboration for the construction of Amaravati, including technology transfer, expert training, planning support and sharing Singapore's experience in executing world-class infrastructure projects.

The Singapore representatives said their government is committed to assisting Andhra Pradesh in building Amaravati as a global-standard capital city by extending expertise in quality, planning and technical aspects. They also expressed readiness to provide advisory support and strengthen institutional cooperation.

VMC Chief says 14,833 voters were classified as uncollectible

Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) Commissioner Dhyanaachandra on Tuesday reviewed the progress of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR)-2026 of electoral rolls and inspected ongoing drainage works aimed at providing a permanent solution to rainwater stagnation in the city.

At a review meeting held with representatives of political parties at the VMC Command Control Room, the Commissioner said that as of 10 a.m., details of 2,59,724 out of 2,77,822 voters in the Vijayawada Central Assembly constituency had been digitised. Of these, 1,99,564 voters were mapped with the 2002 electoral roll, while 60,160 were digitised under the "No Mapping" category. He added that 14,833 voters were classified as uncollectible due to reasons such as absence, migration, death or duplicate

entries.

Representatives of the Congress, CPI, CPM, TDP, YSRCP and Jana Sena attended the meeting along with election officials and discussed the progress of the revision process.

Earlier, the Commissioner inspected flood-prone areas including Vidyadharapuram, Bypass Road, RTC Workshop Road, HB Colony and Urmila Subbarao Nagar. He said two 2x2-metre single-cell box culverts are being constructed across the Bypass Road to ensure quicker discharge of rainwater and prevent flooding during the monsoon.

The proposed drainage system is expected to benefit HB Colony, Kundala Bazaar, Crombe Road, Nagayya Hotel Centre, RTC Workshop Road, Telephone Colony, Lalitha Nagar Road and Rythu Bazaar Road. Dhyanaachandra directed engineering officials to maintain quality standards and complete the works within the stipulated timeframe.

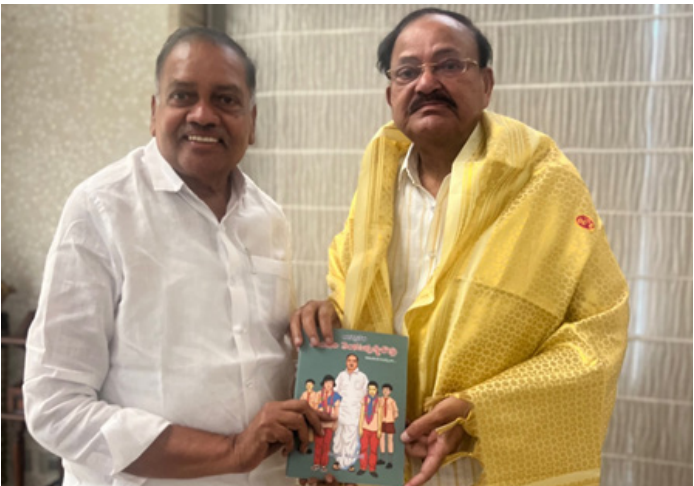


honoured for their contributions to the field of psychology.

No Need to Panic Over COVID Cases in AP: Health Officials

Tirupati: A fresh discussion over COVID-19 cases in Andhra Pradesh has created concern among people, but health authorities and medical experts have clarified that the situation remains under control and there is no need for panic. Officials said only a few cases have been detected and there is no evidence of widespread transmission in the state.

The issue came into focus after two COVID-19-related deaths were reported in Kadapa and Annamayya districts in recent days. A 60-year-old man from Rajampet in Annamayya district, who had existing health complications, died while undergoing



treatment at a hospital in Vellore. A 43-year-old man from Kadapa also died at Kadapa RIMS due to a lung infection.

At present, only one active COVID-19 patient is undergoing treatment at Kadapa RIMS. Health authorities

have already made arrangements, including dedicated isolation facilities, to manage such cases. A 24/7 control room has been established in Kadapa, while 10-bed special COVID isolation wards have been prepared at King George Hospital (KGH),

Visakhapatnam, and other government hospitals across the state.

Medical experts and health department officials said the reported cases were identified after patients with severe respiratory symptoms were tested. They clarified that there is no sudden surge of infections and advised people with symptoms to undergo testing without delay.

Doctors said the severity of COVID-19 remains low due to widespread vaccination and natural immunity among people. They pointed out that the two deceased patients had serious underlying health conditions, including kidney-related ailments, diabetes and asthma.

Experts advised people to follow basic precautions, including wearing masks in crowded places, maintaining hand hygiene and avoiding close contact with elderly persons and those suffering from heart, kidney or lung-related diseases if they show symptoms.

Doctors also suggested immediate medical consultation and adequate rest for those experiencing fever, cough or body aches.

Health authorities reiterated that the situation in Andhra Pradesh is being closely monitored and people need not worry. They said the government will issue necessary advisories if any major developments arise.

TTD Board approves major infrastructure, welfare initiatives

APSPDCL Prioritizes Uninterrupted Power and Solar Projects

APSPDCL Chairman and Managing Director Siva Sankar Lotheti has directed officials and field staff to work with the singular objective of providing quality and uninterrupted power supply to consumers. The CMD issued stern warnings regarding operational delays. He mandated that whenever a transformer fails, it must be replaced within the stipulated timeframe across the company's jurisdiction. Three Arrested in Major Renigunta MDMA Drug Bust

The Renigunta police have seized a large quantity of MDMA, a dangerous synthetic psychotropic drug that has been increasingly misleading the local youth. Following up on an operation initiated on July 10, Renigunta DSP Srinivasa Rao revealed details of the bust during a media conference. He stated that the police successfully arrested three accused who



were smuggling the contraband from Bangalore to distribute it locally in small packets. The arrested individuals have been identified as Gunasekhar, Ashwini Kumar,

and Rahul Yadav. One of the accused is currently pursuing a B.Tech degree at a prominent college, while the other two reside in Tirupati. Law enforcement officials recovered

62 grams of MDMA, four mobile phones, two digital weighing machines, and two Royal Enfield motorcycles. DSP Srinivasa Rao noted that the drug is popularly referred to as 'XT', 'Mouli', 'EXTC', or 'Mandy', warning that it induces hallucinations far more hazardous than ganja. To keep the region clean, police are continuously monitoring the district in accordance with orders from the DGP. This specific raid was successfully executed under

the leadership of Renigunta CI Jayachandra, SI Srinivasulu, and their staff. Tirupati District SP L. Subbaraidu highly congratulated the team for this significant breakthrough. Moving forward, the police are actively investigating the network's Bangalore-based links. Furthermore, authorities plan to identify addicted students, summon their parents for counselling, and refer them to de-addiction centres at Ruia or SVIMS if necessary.

MLA meets with Collector on constituency development

Citizens Allowed to File Claims from July 31 to August 30: Collector

District Collector S. Venkateswar announced that the Election Commission of India has extended the door-to-door voter verification campaign in Andhra Pradesh until July 24, 2026. Addressing a press conference alongside Joint Collector R. Govinda Rao and DRO G. Narasimulu, the Collector emphasized that the draft electoral roll and the ASD (Absent, Shifted, Deceased) list will be published on July 31. Citizens can submit claims and objections from July 31 to August 30, with all issues slated for resolution by September 28, followed by the final publication of the electoral roll on October 3. Venkateswar warned that



holding voting rights in two locations is a legal offence subject to criminal prosecution. Currently, the district has 17,69,438 registered voters. While 14,77,424 forms have been collected, those not mapped to parental records or census data will not be removed; instead, they will be given opportunities to verify their status using official identity documents. Names of those unavailable or shifted will appear on the ASD list,

which allows individuals to file objections with relevant residential proof for investigation. The Collector urged political parties and voters to utilize this extension to ensure electoral accuracy. The meeting was attended by District Collector S. Venkateswar, Joint Collector R. Govinda Rao, and DRO G. Narasimulu.

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Collector Directs Expedited Progress for Industrial Projects

District Collector Dr. A. Siri has directed Andhra Pradesh Industrial Infrastructure Corporation (APIIC) officials to accelerate infrastructure development for the ambitious Drone City and National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC) projects. During an inspection on Tuesday, the Collector reviewed the first phase of Drone City, spanning 600 acres in Komarolu village, Orvakallu mandal. Currently, infrastructure including roads, drainage, culverts, and power supply is being developed across an initial 120-acre zone. The Collector emphasized the necessity for high-



quality work and swift completion. Following this, the Collector reviewed the NICDC project near Guttapadu, which is being implemented over 2,621 acres with a three-year deadline. While officials confirmed that first-year targets, including essential utility infrastructure and treatment plants, have been met, the Collector ordered strict adherence to the project timeline to avoid any delays. Emphasizing that both projects are vital for the industrial growth of Kurnool district, the Collector urged officials to maintain strong coordination.

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Free Cancer Screening Camp Organized by SWIMS

In accordance with state government directives to rapidly expand cancer awareness and mobile screenings across Tirupati district, Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences (SVIMS) will host a free cancer screening medical camp. The camp is scheduled to take place at the Rajiv Nagar Jeevakona Urban PHC on July 16 and 20. Organized under the directives of SVIMS Director cum Vice Chancellor RV Kumar, this health initiative operates in collaboration with the District Medical and Health Department using a specialized Pink Bus. The mobile unit will provide oral cancer tests for both men and women, mammograms for female breast cancer screening, and Pap smear tests for cervical cancer detection. The medical camp will be conducted under the guidance of Anju D'Ade, Head of the Department of Community Medicine. Nodal Officers Bhavani and Sivasantosh will supervise the screening camp.

Collector to Conduct Village Inspection

Where Is the Anti-Corruption Drive In Andhra Pradesh?

The Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) in Telangana has been making headlines with its relentless crackdown on corrupt public servants. Hardly a week passes without reports of raids on government officials, disproportionate assets being unearthed, or arrests made in bribery cases. In one of the recent operations, the ACB reportedly uncovered assets worth nearly 500 crore belonging to officials under investigation. Such actions send a strong message that corruption, irrespective of the rank of the accused, will not be tolerated.

This naturally raises a question in the minds of people in the neighbouring state of Andhra Pradesh. Why is the ACB in Andhra Pradesh not displaying the same level of activity? Corruption is not a problem confined to one state alone. Public complaints about bribery, irregularities in government offices, and misuse of authority continue to surface from different parts of Andhra Pradesh as well. Yet, large-scale ACB operations are rarely seen.

The silence has led to several questions. Is the ACB waiting for permission from the government before taking action? Is the agency lacking the resources or operational freedom required to investigate corruption? Or is the government convinced that corruption has been eradicated from the state? If none of these explanations is true, then the authorities owe an answer to the public regarding the apparent lack of visible anti-corruption initiatives.

An effective Anti-Corruption Bureau is essential for strengthening public confidence in governance. Honest officers deserve protection, while dishonest officials must be held accountable without fear or favour. Fighting corruption should never become a matter of political convenience or selective enforcement. The rule of law must prevail equally in every state.

People do not expect miracles, but they do expect action. A proactive and independent anti-corruption mechanism reassures citizens that public money is protected and that integrity in administration remains a priority. Andhra Pradesh, like every other state, must ensure that its anti-corruption institutions function with transparency, independence, and determination. Only then can the public truly believe that the fight against corruption is real and not merely a promise.

Unlocking Horizons: The Value of Language Skills!



Ludwig Wittgenstein, A Philosopher, says that Language profoundly shapes how we perceive, understand, and interact with the world. Language is the primary tool for processing thoughts, acquiring new information, and expressing views and knowledge. It is necessary for learning, and it helps students to understand complex concepts, share ideas, build memory, and nurture critical thinking skills. Research highlights that language learning is a powerful tool for individual development, yielding major cognitive, academic, and socio-cultural benefits. Language renovates the brain to improve memory and problem-solving abilities. Even though in the current trends of education, students need to be exposed to different languages, the mother tongue is crucial at the foundational stage, as it fosters a sense of self-worth and cultural identity. The NEP 2020 language policy mandates a Three-Language Formula, requiring students to study three languages, with at least two being indigenous Indian languages. It heavily promotes instruction in the mother tongue or local language and ensures no specific language is forced upon any state. The policy recommends that, wherever possible, the medium of instruction up to Grade 5 (and preferably till Grade 8) should be the home language, mother tongue, or local regional language. Considering these mandates and belief in mother tongue education, most of the states have introduced English language as an option or for-

eign language choice within the framework and provided bilingual textbooks for better learning and to boost academic performance.

Student performance and dropout from schools

Despite all these reforms and frameworks, four out of every 10 children who enter the system drop out before completing higher secondary education due to a lack of learning and substandard pedagogical practices. It is very alarming to make our classrooms more learner-friendly, supportive, inclusive, and experiential to foster quality. India's enrolment is truly remarkable, with 98.1% age between 6-14 years, but retention and quality have become major challenges at all levels. There are 76.6% of children in standard III grade who are unable to read a Standard II level textbook, and 74% of children are unable to do the substation; it means three out of 4 children in rural government schools have not achieved the most basic reading benchmark as per ASER 2024.

Major Hurdles.

The Indian education system is challenging us with severe multigrade and multilingual classrooms and a pedagogical crisis. There are one lakh+ schools (DISE 2025-26) with single teachers in India; 89% of these schools are in very remote and tribal villages, as stated by NITI Aayog. A single teacher is to manage multigrades, multi-level students, multilingual challenges, and administrative responsibilities in a single room with limited resources. On the other hand,



at higher grades, major learning deficits among students, mainly due to linguistic diversity, rigid classroom transactions, and running behind in syllabus completion without ensuring basic and pre-requisite competencies of the students. Alongside rote learning, memorization without understanding the concepts, no scope for critical thinking, and student participation in the classroom process with deeply root-issues. Regarding teacher professional development, many teachers are experiencing training as occasional, lecture-based sessions rather than sustained & practice-centred learning, with no special focus on structured language teaching, which determines

the students' academic performance, a foundation for better learning with reading, writing, and comprehension as reinforced by the NEP 2020.

Ground realities

Most of the studies indicate the need for language competencies among students to achieve age- and grade-appropriate competencies across the country. PARAKH 2024 report indicated that language benchmark alignment drops from 65% in Class 3 to 57% in Class 6, and hits a low of 54% by Class 9. The assessment was evaluated over 21 lakh students across India and identified critical gaps in foundational literacy and communication, and indicated that many stu-

dents are yet to develop higher-order reading skills such as inference, critical thinking, and reflective engagement, which are essential for understanding complex subjects and concepts.

Need of the hour

Requires pedagogical transformation from rote method to child-centric, with a special focus on language learning with a strategy of "Language across the curriculum". Teachers need to adopt language teaching irrespective of their subject. If language teaching is weak, it affects the student's performance even in complex subjects like science, mathematics, and other subjects. "The limits of my language

mean the limits of my world." It means it hinders the entire academic cycle, which leads to dropping out of school and students become out of school.

In this circumstances, we can draw a proven pedagogical strategy from a proof of concept of LIP - "Learning Improvement Programme" which was designed and being implemented jointly by Department of School Education, AP & Telangana, Bal Raksha Bharat (Save the Children), Centre for Innovations in Public Systems (ASCI) and UNICEF to support the children who are behind the learning in grades 6-9 with a special focus on Language across the curriculum, integrating the Teaching and practice period with regular syllabus,

bridging pre-requisite competencies, peer learning, creating a print rich environment to inculcating reading habits, inclusion of mother tongue, reduction of screen time and create an opportunity for student participation.

Experiential and project based learning, encourage student and teacher quality conversations, encouraging elocution and writing competitions, conduct language melas to build a strong foundation for students under the lenses of inclusion.

Punjab BJP Leader Faces Heat Over Viral Video

A political controversy has erupted in Punjab after a purported video of a BJP leader went viral, in which she is allegedly heard making remarks about deleting voter names to help her party win elections. The comments triggered strong criticism from the Congress, which demanded action from the Election Commission.

In the viral clip, the leader is allegedly heard referring to the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process and mentioning the deletion of around 20,000-25,000 votes to help elect a party candidate. The remarks led to accusations that the electoral process could be misused for political advantage.

Punjab Congress leaders strongly criticised the statement and called for immediate intervention by the Election Commission. They argued that every eligible voter has a constitutional right to vote and urged authorities to ensure that the electoral process remains free, fair, and transparent.

Reacting to the controversy, the BJP leader rejected the allegations and claimed that her remarks were taken out of context. She clarified that the discussion was related only to the removal of fake or duplicate voters and not genuine voters.

She also stated that no political leader has the authority to directly add or remove names from electoral rolls, as the process is handled by election authorities according to legal procedures.

The leader further alleged that the video may have been selectively edited or manipulated and called for an investigation into its authenticity. She maintained that her intention was to highlight the need to remove illegal voter registrations rather than target genuine voters.

Authorities have taken note of the viral video and are examining whether the footage is authentic or altered. Officials said further action would depend on the findings of the inquiry.

The controversy has intensified the political debate in Punjab over electoral rolls, voter verification, and election transparency. With future elections approaching, issues related to voter lists and election procedures are expected to remain a major political flashpoint in the state.



NBW Issued Against LeT Founder Hafiz Saeed

A special court has issued a non-bailable warrant against Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) founder Hafiz Saeed in connection with the Pahalgalam terror attack case, marking a major development in the ongoing investigation.

The warrant was issued after investigating agencies named Hafiz Saeed as an accused in the case and sought legal action against him. Authorities have alleged that he was involved in the conspiracy behind the attack and played a role through his links with the banned terror organisation Lashkar-e-Taiba.

The Pahalgalam attack in Jammu and Kashmir resulted in the deaths of several civilians, including tourists, and triggered widespread outrage across the country. The incident intensified concerns over cross-border terrorism and security threats in the region.

According to investigators, Hafiz Saeed is currently based in Pakistan and has not appeared before Indian authorities. The agencies have argued that legal proceedings are necessary as the accused has allegedly avoided facing the investigation.

The court's order is considered an important step in the legal process and could pave the way for further action under existing laws. Authorities are examining all available legal options to proceed with the case and ensure that those accused of involvement in terror activities face trial.

Hafiz Saeed, who has been designated as a terrorist by India and several international agencies, has previously been accused of involvement in major terror operations, including the 2008 Mumbai attacks. He has denied allegations against him.

The latest development is expected to increase pressure on terror networks operating across borders. Indian security agencies have maintained that individuals responsible for attacks on Indian soil must be brought before the law, regardless of their location.

The issuance of the non-bailable warrant marks a significant stage in the Pahalgalam attack investigation. Authorities are expected to continue pursuing legal measures to establish the role of the accused and complete the judicial process.

India Launches UNSC Seat Campaign

India has officially launched its campaign for a non-permanent seat on the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) for the 2028-29 term, with External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar meeting UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres in New York.

During the meeting, Jaishankar and Guterres discussed several major global issues, including conflicts in West Asia, Ukraine, and Sudan, along with challenges facing international peace and security. The discussions come at a time when global geopolitical tensions are increasing and the role of multilateral institutions is under greater focus.

India formally launched its UNSC campaign under the theme "SHANTI: India for the United Nations Security Council 2028-29 - Norms, Trust, Integrity" at an event held at the UN headquarters. The campaign highlights India's focus on global peace, cooperation, transparency, and reforms in international institutions.

The bid is part of India's larger effort to secure a greater role in global decision-making platforms. India has consistently argued that the structure of the



UN Security Council should reflect current global realities and provide stronger representation to developing nations.

The election for the non-permanent seat will be held through the UN General Assembly, where countries from different regional groups vote to select members for two-year terms. India is expected to seek support from nations across regions by highlighting its contributions to UN peacekeeping missions, development partnerships, and initiatives supporting the Global South.

Jaishankar's meeting with the UN chief also comes amid India's push for reforms in global governance structures. New Delhi has repeatedly emphasized the need for a more representative and effective Security Council capable of addressing modern challenges such as conflicts, terrorism, climate change, and economic instability.

The launch of the campaign marks another major step in India's diplomatic outreach efforts. With growing economic and strategic influence, India aims to strengthen its presence in international forums and contribute more actively to shaping global policies.

The coming months will see India engage in extensive diplomatic consultations with UN member states to build support for its candidature and strengthen its case for a seat at the world's top security body.

Merger Claim Sparks Fresh Shiv Sena Row

The political battle within the Shiv Sena has intensified after the Uddhav Thackeray-led Shiv Sena (UBT) rejected claims of a merger with the Eknath Shinde faction, calling such assertions baseless and legally invalid. The party has also warned rebel Lok Sabha MPs against seeking recognition based on the alleged merger.

The Uddhav Sena sent letters to MPs who recently moved towards the Shinde faction, stating that the original party leadership had neither initiated nor approved any merger proposal. The party reminded the MPs that they were elected to the Lok Sabha on the Shiv Sena (UBT) symbol and mandate.

The party argued that individual legislators cannot independently declare a merger without approval from the original political organisation. According to the Uddhav faction, any such move would violate the principles of the anti-defection law and could not be accepted without proper legal procedures.

The Shiv Sena (UBT) leadership has also informed the Lok Sabha Speaker that it would oppose any request seeking recognition of a separate group or merger by the MPs. The party maintained that elected representatives do not have the authority to decide the future of the organisation on their own.



The dispute comes amid the long-running internal conflict within the Shiv Sena, which witnessed a major split after Eknath Shinde's rebellion in 2022. The political crisis resulted in a change of government in Maharashtra and triggered a prolonged legal battle over the party's name, symbol, and leadership.

The Shinde faction and the rebel MPs have maintained their position, while the Uddhav camp continues to challenge their claims on political and legal grounds. The issue is expected to lead to further debates over constitutional provisions, merger rules, and the rights of elected representatives.

With both factions continuing their fight for legitimacy and control over the Shiv Sena's legacy, the latest development has added another chapter to Maharashtra's ongoing political struggle. The final outcome could have significant implications for the future of the party and state politics.

Karur TVK Leader Held After Woman's Complaint

A functionary of Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam (TVK) has been taken into police custody in Karur district, Tamil Nadu, after a woman accused him of harassing her for several months and attempting to abduct her.

According to the complaint filed by the woman, the accused TVK leader allegedly harassed her for around three months. She claimed that he repeatedly followed her, stood near her workplace, and made inappropriate remarks and gestures, causing distress and fear.

The woman reportedly informed her family members about the alleged harassment. Following this, her husband began accompanying her while travelling to and from work as a precautionary measure.

The situation escalated when the woman was returning home from work and the accused allegedly stopped her on the road. She raised an alarm and informed her relatives, who immediately rushed to the spot.

According to police officials, an altercation broke out between the accused and the woman's relatives. The incident has created tensions in the area and triggered discussions over women's safety, law and order, and the responsibility of political party members.



The woman's family has alleged that there was a delay in police response and questioned the handling of the complaint. They demanded strict action against the accused and a fair investigation into the allegations.

Police have stated that an investigation is underway and further legal action will be taken based on the evidence collected. Statements from the complainant, witnesses, and other individuals involved are being examined as part of the probe.

The incident has created tensions in the area and triggered discussions over women's safety, law and order, and the responsibility of political party members.

The accused leader is currently under medical observation following the alleged assault. Authorities are continuing their investigation to determine the facts of the case and decide the next course of action.

The controversy has also created challenges for Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam, which is working to strengthen its political presence in Tamil Nadu. The party is expected to face questions over the conduct of its local functionaries as the investigation progresses.

Assam Repatriates 1,679 Illegal Immigrants in Two Years

The Assam government has said that more than 1,600 illegal immigrants have been repatriated to Bangladesh over the past two years as part of its efforts to address the issue of undocumented migration in the state.

According to the state government, a total of 1,679 illegal immigrants were sent back to Bangladesh during the last two years. The action included deportation, expulsion, and other procedures carried out under existing immigration laws.

The government stated that among those sent back were people declared as foreigners by Foreigners Tribunals operating in Assam. These tribunals are responsible for examining cases where an individual's citizenship status is under question and deciding whether they are Indian citizens or foreigners.

The issue of illegal immigration has remained a major political and social concern in Assam for several decades due to the state's long international border with Bangladesh. Authorities have repeatedly highlighted the need to identify individuals staying in India without valid documents and take action according to the law.

Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said that the repatriation process was carried out by following legal procedures. He added that cases pending before courts were handled according to judicial directions and that action was taken only after completing necessary verification processes.

The Assam government has also discussed the status of D-voters, or doubtful voters, in the state. These cases involve individuals whose citizenship documents or nationality are under scrutiny, and many such matters are examined by Foreigners Tribunals.

The issue of migration has frequently triggered political debates in Assam, with different parties raising concerns over border security, citizenship verification, and protection of genuine citizens. The government has maintained that its measures are aimed at preventing illegal migration while ensuring that legitimate residents are not affected.

The latest figures highlight Assam's continued focus on migration-related challenges. With border management and citizenship verification remaining sensitive issues, the government's actions are expected to remain an important political and social topic in the state.



Prashant Kishor Enters Poll Fray With ₹96 Crore Assets

Jan Suraj Party founder Prashant Kishor has declared assets worth nearly 96 crore in his election affidavit while filing his nomination for the Bankipur Assembly bypoll in Bihar. The disclosure has drawn significant attention as he enters a major electoral contest after years of working as a political strategist.

According to the affidavit, Prashant Kishor has declared total assets of around 96.06 crore, including movable and immovable properties. His wife Dr. Jahanvi Das has declared assets worth approximately 101.93 crore, taking the combined family wealth close to 198 crore.

The affidavit reveals that a significant portion of Kishor's wealth comes from his business interests, investments, financial assets, and properties. The details provide insight into his financial background before formally entering active politics.

Prashant Kishor, who previously worked as a political strategist for several national and regional leaders, launched the Jan Suraj movement and later transformed it into a political platform. His decision to contest the Bankipur seat has increased the political significance of the bypoll.

Bankipur is considered an important constituency in Bihar politics, and Kishor's entry has turned the contest into a closely watched battle. India Summons Iran Envoy Over Ship Attack

The Indian government has lodged a strong diplomatic protest with Iran after an Indian crew member was killed in a missile strike on a merchant vessel transiting the Strait of Hormuz. Following the incident, the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) summoned the Iranian envoy in New Delhi to seek an explanation and express India's serious concern over the attack.

According to official reports, two merchant tankers travelling through the southern passage of the Strait of Hormuz were hit during the attack. One Indian sailor lost his life, while several other crew members were injured, including multiple Indian nationals. Some of the injured are reported to be in serious condition.

India strongly condemned the attack and stressed that the safety and security of Indian citizens working on commercial ships remains a top priority. During the meeting with the Iranian diplomat, the government conveyed its deep concern over the loss of life and called for the protection of civilian shipping in one of the world's busiest maritime corridors. The government has urged all parties involved in the regional conflict to avoid actions that could endanger civilian lives or disrupt global maritime trade.



Man Claiming to Be US Citizen Held at Nepal Border

A 36-year-old man claiming to be a US citizen has been arrested near the India-Nepal border in Uttar Pradesh after allegedly attempting to cross into Nepal without carrying valid travel documents. The incident has prompted a detailed investigation by Indian security agencies.

The man identified himself as Jordan Brown, claiming he is a resident of California and a former US Navy officer. He was intercepted by personnel of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) during a routine patrol near the Sonauli border in Maharajganj district. According to officials, he allegedly tried to flee when asked to stop but was quickly apprehended.

During questioning, Brown reportedly told investigators that he had travelled to Thailand on a tourist visa, where he lost his passport. He further claimed that he entered India through Sri Lanka and had been travelling across different parts of the country before reaching the Nepal border.

Authorities said Brown was not carrying any valid passport, visa, or identity documents at the time of his arrest. His claims regarding his identity, travel history, and former

military service are currently being verified. Indian officials have also informed the US Embassy about the incident as part of the verification process.

Police have registered a case under the Foreigners Act and other relevant legal provisions. Investigators are examining how he entered India without proper documentation, how long he remained in the country, and the purpose behind his attempt to cross into Nepal through the sensitive border region.

The arrest has drawn attention because of the strategic importance of the India-Nepal border, where security agencies remain on high alert against illegal crossings and other cross-border activities. Officials have stressed that the investigation is ongoing, and no conclusions have yet been drawn regarding Brown's intentions.

Further action will depend on the outcome of identity verification and the findings of the ongoing investigation. Authorities are also coordinating with relevant diplomatic and security agencies to establish the complete facts surrounding the case.

Trump Reaffirms Strong US Support for Saudi Arabia

US President Donald Trump has reaffirmed America's strong support for Saudi Arabia as tensions in the Middle East continue to escalate amid the ongoing confrontation involving Iran and the Iran-backed Houthi rebels in Yemen.

UK to Declare IRGC a Terror Group



The United Kingdom is set to designate Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) as a terrorist organization under new national security legislation, marking a significant shift in Britain's approach toward Tehran.

The move comes after a series of antisemitic attacks and alleged Iran-linked hostile activities in the UK, including suspected plots targeting Jewish communities, Iranian dissidents, journalists, and activists. British authorities believe the IRGC and its affiliated proxy groups have been involved in operations that threaten the country's national security.

Under the proposed measures, supporting the IRGC or acting on its behalf could become a criminal offence, giving law enforcement agencies

broader powers to investigate, arrest, and prosecute individuals linked to the organization. The new framework is intended to close legal loopholes and strengthen Britain's ability to respond to foreign state-backed threats.

Prime Minister Keir Starmer's government has argued that the tougher stance is necessary to counter growing security risks posed by hostile foreign actors operating inside the UK. Officials say the legislation will help prevent espionage, sabotage, intimidation, and other activities allegedly carried out through proxy organizations.

The IRGC is one of Iran's most powerful military institutions and plays a central role in the country's defence, intelligence, and overseas operations. Western governments have re-

peatedly accused the force of supporting armed groups and conducting covert operations beyond Iran's borders, allegations that Tehran has consistently rejected.

Security experts believe the UK's decision aligns Britain more closely with several of its allies that have already taken strong action against the IRGC. The move is also expected to increase pressure on Iran at a time of heightened tensions across the Middle East.

The proposed designation is subject to parliamentary approval before it comes into force. If approved, it would provide British authorities with expanded legal powers to crack down on activities linked to the IRGC and other state-backed organizations considered a threat to national security.



UAE Plans Strategic Port to Boost Trade Security

The United Arab Emirates (UAE) is moving ahead with plans to develop a new port on its eastern coastline, a strategic project aimed at reducing its dependence on the Strait of Hormuz, one of the world's most important and vulnerable maritime trade routes.

The decision comes amid growing geopolitical tensions in the Middle East and concerns that any military confrontation involving Iran could disrupt shipping through the narrow waterway. The Strait of Hormuz handles a significant share of the world's crude oil and liquefied natural gas exports, making it a critical artery for global energy supplies.

By developing a port on the eastern coast facing the Arabian Sea, the UAE hopes to create an alternative route for trade and energy exports that bypasses the Strait of Hormuz. The project is expected to strengthen the country's supply chain resilience and reduce risks associated with potential regional conflicts.

The proposed port will also complement the UAE's existing infrastructure investments, including pipelines and logistics networks designed to transport oil and other goods without relying entirely on the Strait of Hormuz. Officials believe these measures will enhance the country's long-term energy security and economic stability.

The move reflects growing

concerns among Gulf nations over the vulnerability of maritime trade routes during periods of heightened regional tensions. Recent conflicts and security incidents in the region have reinforced the need for alternative export and shipping corridors.

Industry experts believe the new port could improve the UAE's position as a global logistics and trade hub by providing greater operational flexibility for shipping companies and exporters. It could also attract additional investments in transportation, storage, and industrial infrastructure along the country's eastern coast.

The project is expected to support the UAE's broader strategy of diversifying its economy while strengthening its role in international trade. Improved connectivity to global shipping routes could enhance the country's competitiveness and reduce disruptions caused by geopolitical uncertainties.

Although construction timelines and investment details have not yet been officially disclosed, the proposed port is viewed as a significant strategic initiative. As regional tensions continue to influence global energy markets, the UAE's efforts to develop alternative trade routes are expected to play an increasingly important role in ensuring stable exports and uninterrupted commercial activity.



Six Dead After PoK Protest Turns Violent

At least six civilians were killed after Pakistani security forces allegedly opened fire during violent clashes in Pakistan-Occupied Kashmir (PoK), further escalating tensions in the region.

The incident reportedly took place near Rawalakot, where large groups of people had gathered to protest against the authorities. The demonstrations soon turned violent, leading to confrontations between protesters and security personnel. According to reports, the forces opened fire to disperse the crowd, resulting in multiple fatalities and several injuries.

Among those killed were several local residents, while many others sustained injuries during the clashes. The violence has intensified unrest in the region, where public resentment against Islamabad has been growing over political, economic, and administrative issues.

Eyewitnesses claimed that security personnel used live ammunition after the protests spiralled out of control. Videos and images circulating on social media appeared to show chaotic scenes, with protesters running for safety and injured civilians being rushed to near-

by hospitals.

Sensex, Nifty End Lower Amid Global Worries

Indian benchmark equity indices ended lower on Tuesday as weak global cues and rising geopolitical tensions weighed heavily on investor sentiment. Selling pressure in IT, financial and auto stocks dragged the markets lower, while pharma stocks emerged as the biggest gainers during the session.

The BSE Sensex declined 561 points to close at around 77,055, while the NSE Nifty 50 slipped nearly 159 points to settle close to 24,052, after witnessing a

volatile trading session. Both indices recovered from their intraday lows but failed to end in positive territory.

Investor sentiment remained under pressure due to escalating tensions in the Middle East, which pushed global crude oil prices higher. Rising oil prices have renewed concerns over inflation and India's import bill, prompting investors to adopt a cautious approach. Weak global markets further added to the negative mood.

Among sectoral indices, IT stocks witnessed heavy selling, with several frontline technology companies ending lower. Banking, financial services, automobile and metal stocks also remained under pressure throughout the day.

On the positive side, the pharma sector bucked the broader market trend. Pharmaceutical stocks attracted buying interest as investors shifted towards defensive sectors amid growing market uncertainty. Healthcare shares

also ended with notable gains.

The broader market also reflected weakness, with both the mid-cap and small-cap indices closing in the red. Market breadth remained negative, indicating that declining stocks outnumbered advancing ones across the exchanges.

Analysts believe that volatility is likely to continue in the coming sessions as investors closely monitor geopolitical developments, crude oil prices, global market trends and upcoming corporate earnings.

The progress of the earnings season will play a crucial role in determining the market's near-term direction.

Despite the day's decline, market experts maintain that the long-term fundamentals of the Indian economy remain strong. However, they advise investors to remain cautious in the short term, avoid aggressive positions during periods of heightened volatility, and focus on fundamentally strong companies.

With global uncertainties



continuing to dominate investor sentiment, market participants are expected to keep a close watch on international

developments, institutional investment flows, crude oil prices, and quarterly earnings for fresh market cues.

Pharma Stocks Shine Amid Market Weakness

The Nifty Pharma index outperformed the broader market on Tuesday, rising nearly 1% even as benchmark indices ended the day in the red. Strong buying interest in pharmaceutical stocks helped the sector emerge as one of the top performers, with Biocon and Divi's Laboratories leading the gains.

Several frontline pharma companies, including Sun Pharma, Cipla, and Dr. Reddy's Laboratories, also traded higher, reflecting renewed investor confidence in the healthcare sector. The rally stood out against a weak overall market, where concerns over global uncertainties and geopolitical tensions weighed on sentiment.

According to market analysts, three key factors drove the sharp rise in pharma stocks.

First, India's pharmaceutical market recorded over 13% year-on-year growth in June sales, marking the strongest monthly growth since October 2023. The



healthy demand outlook has improved investor confidence in the sector's earnings potential.

Second, investors shifted towards defensive sectors amid increased market volatility. With global uncertainties, rising crude oil prices, and geopolitical concerns affecting broader equities, pharmaceutical companies were viewed as relatively safe investments due to their stable earnings and resilient business models.

Third, expectations of strong quarterly earnings and continued export demand encouraged fresh buying in pharma stocks. Analysts believe improving domestic sales, steady global demand, and a healthy product pipeline could support revenue growth for leading pharmaceutical companies in the coming quarters.

Biocon and Divi's Laboratories emerged among the biggest gainers during the session,

while other major players such as Sun Pharma, Cipla, and Dr. Reddy's Laboratories also posted healthy gains. The broad-based buying indicated growing optimism across the pharmaceutical sector rather than interest in just a few individual stocks.

The proposed reforms are designed to simplify the process of raising capital through equity offerings and other financing methods. Policymakers believe the changes will help companies respond more quickly to growing investment needs, particularly in high-tech sectors that require significant capital expenditure.

SK Hynix, one of the world's largest manufacturers of memory chips, is expected to be among the biggest beneficiaries. The company has been investing heavily in advanced semiconductor technologies, including high-bandwidth memory (HBM) chips that are witnessing strong global demand due to the rap-



id growth of artificial intelligence (AI) applications.

Industry experts believe easier access to capital would allow SK Hynix to accelerate investments in manufacturing capacity, research and development, and next-generation chip technologies. This could strengthen its competitive position against global rivals in the rapidly evolving semiconductor market.

The proposed policy changes also reflect South Korea's

broader strategy of supporting its semiconductor industry, which remains a key pillar of the country's economy and export growth. The government has been introducing several initiatives to encourage investment and maintain the nation's leadership in the global chip industry.

Market participants welcomed the proposal, noting that more flexible fundraising regulations could improve financial efficiency for large

corporations while also benefiting smaller technology companies looking to expand their operations.

The reforms come at a time when semiconductor companies worldwide are increasing investments to meet rising demand for AI processors, data centers, and high-performance computing solutions. Easier capital access could help South Korean firms respond more effectively to these opportunities.

Although the proposal has generated positive sentiment in financial markets, the regulatory changes are still subject to the legislative process before they can be implemented. Investors will closely monitor further developments and assess how the new framework could influence corporate fundraising and long-term growth across South Korea's technology sector.

If approved, the reforms could provide a significant boost to companies like SK Hynix, enabling them to raise funds more efficiently and strengthen their position in the highly competitive global semiconductor industry.

Student's ₹81,000 France Budget Goes Viral

An Indian student studying in France has gone viral after sharing a detailed breakdown of her monthly expenses, revealing that she spends nearly 81,000 every month to manage her life abroad. While many viewers appreciated the transparency of her financial planning, others questioned whether some of the figures—particularly her grocery expenses—were realistic, sparking a lively debate on social media.

The student, Reine, a 20-year-old pursuing her bachelor's de-

gree in the French city of Lille, posted a video on Instagram explaining how she manages her monthly budget. According to her, housing is by far the biggest expense. She pays approximately 60,000 per month for shared accommodation that includes a private bathroom, making rent the largest portion of her overall spending.

Apart from rent, Reine said she spends around 10,900 on groceries every month. She explained that the relatively low food bill is possible because she prepares most of her meals at

home instead of eating out frequently. Her disciplined approach to cooking and meal planning, she said, helps her keep grocery costs under control.

Transportation is another essential expense. Reine purchases a student travel pass that costs about 3,500 per month, allowing her to commute conveniently within Lille. In addition, she allocates 5,400 to 7,600 every month for personal expenses such as shopping, meeting friends for coffee, dining occasionally at Indian restaurants,

and enjoying weekend outings. The student also clarified that living expenses can differ significantly depending on the city, accommodation choices, and individual lifestyle. She stressed that her figures reflect her personal experience and are meant to give prospective students a realistic idea of what everyday life in France might cost.

Her video quickly attracted thousands of comments. While several viewers praised her budgeting skills and found the expense breakdown useful,

many questioned how she managed to keep her monthly grocery bill below 11,000 in France. Others argued that her rent appeared unusually high for shared accommodation in Lille, with some claiming they had rented private studios for considerably less.

Some users responded humorously, with one commenting that her monthly budget exceeded their entire annual budget, highlighting the stark contrast in living costs and spending habits across countries. Others pointed out that international



students often have vastly different experiences depending on their accommodation, city, and personal lifestyle choices. The discussion has once again drawn attention to the financial realities of studying

A 29-year-old IT professional earning nearly 7 lakh a month has sparked an intense discussion online after revealing that, despite his impressive income and substantial savings, he still doesn't feel financially secure. funds, 2 lakh in stocks, and 10 lakh in fixed deposits, taking his total savings to more than 80 lakh.

Financial coach Anshuman Sharma questioned whether continuing such an exhausting lifestyle was really necessary. He pointed out that Rohit has no wedding-related debt, owns two properties, and has savings equivalent to nearly four years of his current expenses. Sharma suggested that instead of aggressively saving 4 lakh every month, Rohit could choose

to save 2 lakh, spend more time with his newborn child, and still retire only a few years later than originally planned.

Rohit responded that his long-term goal is to accumulate 7-8 crore within the next five to six years. Once he reaches that target, he plans to quit his day job and continue working only in his higher-paying night role. ₹2.1 Crore Job Offer Sparks Online Debate

A 21-year-old Indian engineering student has gone viral after sharing screenshots of an unexpected job offer that allegedly came from a Pakistan-based company. The offer, promising an annual salary of up to 2.1 crore along with visa sponsorship, has triggered widespread debate online, with many questioning whether it was a genuine opportunity, a recruitment scam, or simply an attempt to gain attention on social media.

The student, identified as Aditya, posted screenshots on X showing a WhatsApp conversation with a recruiter claiming to represent a company headquartered in Karachi, Pakistan. According to the messages, the recruiter reached out after finding Aditya's profile and offered him an onsite position with a salary ranging between \$180,000 and \$220,000 per year (approximately 1.7 crore to 2.1 crore). The recruiter also claimed that the role included visa sponsorship and that most of the company's employees worked in the UK time zone.

Sharing the screenshots, Aditya asked social media users whether he should consider accepting the offer. His post quickly went viral, attracting thousands of reactions, comments, and shares.

The unusually high salary package and the fact that the company was allegedly based in Pakistan immediately caught people's attention. While some users responded with humour, joking that they too would relocate for such a lucrative package, others remained highly sceptical.

Many social media users pointed out that unsolicited job offers promising exceptionally high salaries, overseas relocation, and visa sponsorship are common warning signs associated with recruitment scams. Several advised the stu-



dent to thoroughly verify the company's background, recruiter credentials, and employment details before responding.

Others questioned whether the post itself was authentic, suggesting it might be an example of "engagement farming"—a strategy where users post sensational or controversial content primarily to generate likes, comments, shares, and online visibility rather than provide genuine information. As the discussion intensified, many users urged job seekers to remain cautious while dealing with unsolicited offers received through messaging platforms. They stressed the importance of conducting background

checks, verifying company websites, confirming recruiter identities, and avoiding sharing personal or financial information until the legitimacy of an offer is established.

So far, the authenticity of the recruiter, the company, and the job offer has not been independently verified. Whether it was a genuine recruitment attempt, a scam, or simply a viral social media experiment remains unclear.

The incident has nevertheless sparked an important conversation about online recruitment, digital scams, and the need for greater caution as high-paying international job offers continue to circulate across social media platforms.

Viral Post Warns Youth Against EMIs

A social media post advising young people to avoid falling into the trap of Equated Monthly Installments (EMIs) has ignited a heated debate online. The post argues that while EMIs may make expensive purchases seem affordable, they often end up restricting financial freedom and forcing people into years of repayments.

The man behind the viral post urged youngsters to think carefully before financing lifestyle purchases such as smartphones, cars, luxury gadgets, and other non-essential items. According to him, taking loans for depreciating assets can lead to unnecessary financial stress and reduce one's ability to save or invest for the future.

He explained that many young professionals begin their careers with multiple EMIs, leaving a significant portion of their monthly salary committed to repayments. As a result, they often struggle to build an emergency fund, invest consistently, or pursue personal goals because a large share of their income is already earmarked



for loan obligations. The post emphasized that financial independence is achieved not by earning a high salary alone but by controlling expenses and avoiding unnecessary debt. He also advised prioritizing investments, emergency savings, and long-term wealth creation over lifestyle upgrades. According to his message, avoiding debt early in life provides greater flexibility to

switch careers, start a business, travel, or handle unexpected financial emergencies without the burden of monthly repayments.

The advice quickly went viral, attracting mixed reactions from social media users. Many agreed with the message, saying that consumer culture and easy financing options have encouraged people to live beyond their means. Several users shared personal experiences of feeling trapped by multiple EMIs despite earning good salaries.

However, others argued that not all loans are harmful. Many

pointed out that home loans and education loans are often necessary investments that can improve long-term financial stability and career prospects. Some also said that responsible borrowing, when managed within one's income, can help individuals build assets without waiting for years to save the entire amount.

Labrador Rescued After Cannabis Poisoning

A five-year-old black Labrador named Tokyo had a terrifying experience after reportedly consuming discarded cannabis while hiking on Ben Nevis, the highest mountain in the United Kingdom. The incident led to a dramatic mountain rescue operation and has sparked concern among pet owners about hidden dangers on popular hiking trails.

Tokyo was hiking with her owner, Christina Bluhme, an experienced dog trainer from Surrey, England, along with her son and another pet dog. The group had climbed several hours up the mountain when Tokyo suddenly began behaving unusually. She started staggering, lost the use of her legs, and drifted in and out of consciousness, leaving her owner fearing the worst.

With the dog unable to walk and the weather deteriorating rapidly, Christina called for emergency assistance. Fortunately, members of the Lochaber Mountain Rescue Team, who were already returning from another rescue mission, reached the group and immediately stepped in to help.

The rescue team carefully placed the 25-kilogram Labrador on a stretcher and carried her down the steep, rocky mountain trail. Tokyo was



then rushed to a veterinary clinic in Fort William, where doctors initially suspected a spinal injury. However, after further examination and consultation with a poison control centre, veterinarians concluded that the dog's symptoms were consistent with cannabis toxicity, likely caused by ingesting cannabis discarded along the hiking route.

Veterinarians treated Tokyo with activated charcoal and supportive care. Thankfully, she responded well to treatment and made a full recovery by the following day.

Relieved after the ordeal, Christina expressed heartfelt gratitude to the rescue volunteers and veterinary staff, saying their quick response saved Tokyo's life. She also urged fellow dog owners to remain vigilant, warning that harmful

substances can sometimes be found even in remote and scenic outdoor locations. Experts say dogs are significantly more sensitive to cannabis than humans because they possess a higher concentration of cannabinoid receptors in their brains. Even a small amount can cause symptoms such as disorientation, loss of balance, vomiting, lethargy, seizures, and, in severe cases, unconsciousness or coma.

The incident has also highlighted the dedication of volunteer mountain rescue teams, whose timely intervention prevented the situation from turning into a tragedy. It serves as an important reminder for hikers and pet owners alike to remain cautious and ensure outdoor spaces are kept free of litter and potentially dangerous substances.

India Plans ODI Rotation Ahead of World Cup

With the 2027 ICC ODI World Cup drawing closer, the Indian cricket team management is reportedly working on a comprehensive rotation policy aimed at keeping senior players fresh and injury-free for the marquee tournament. Mind games have long been

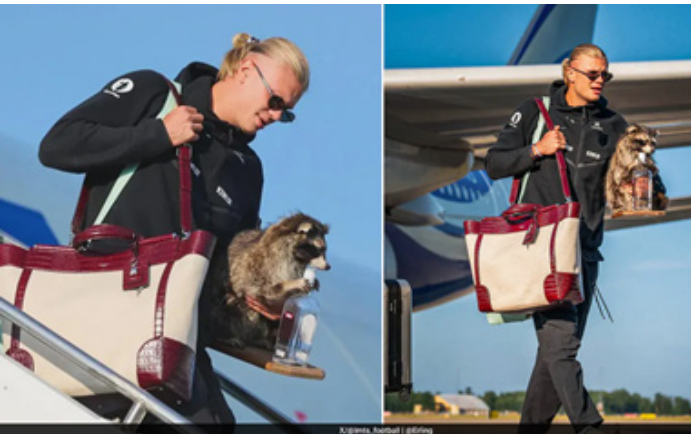
